DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a mobile phone showing our new design;

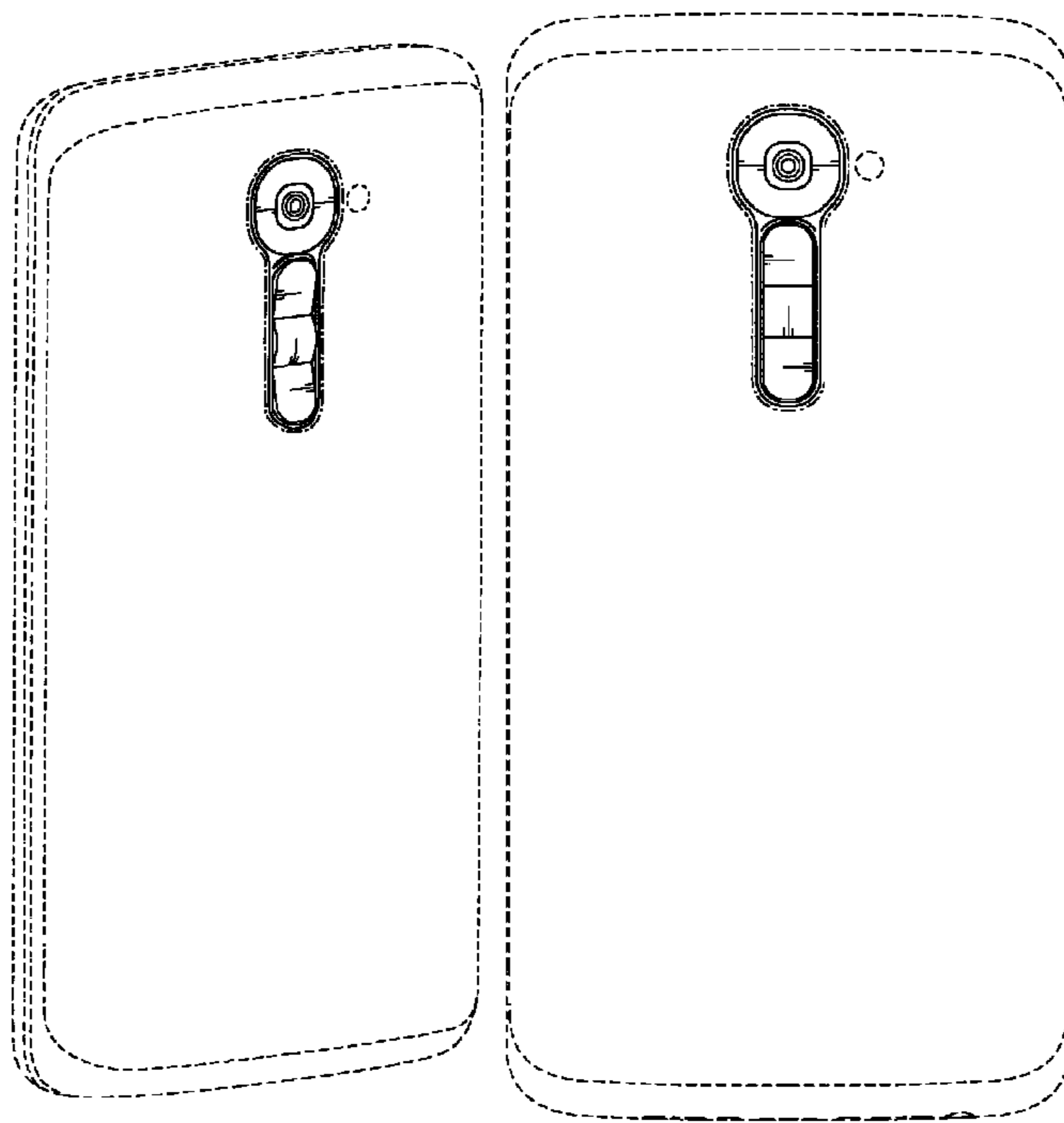

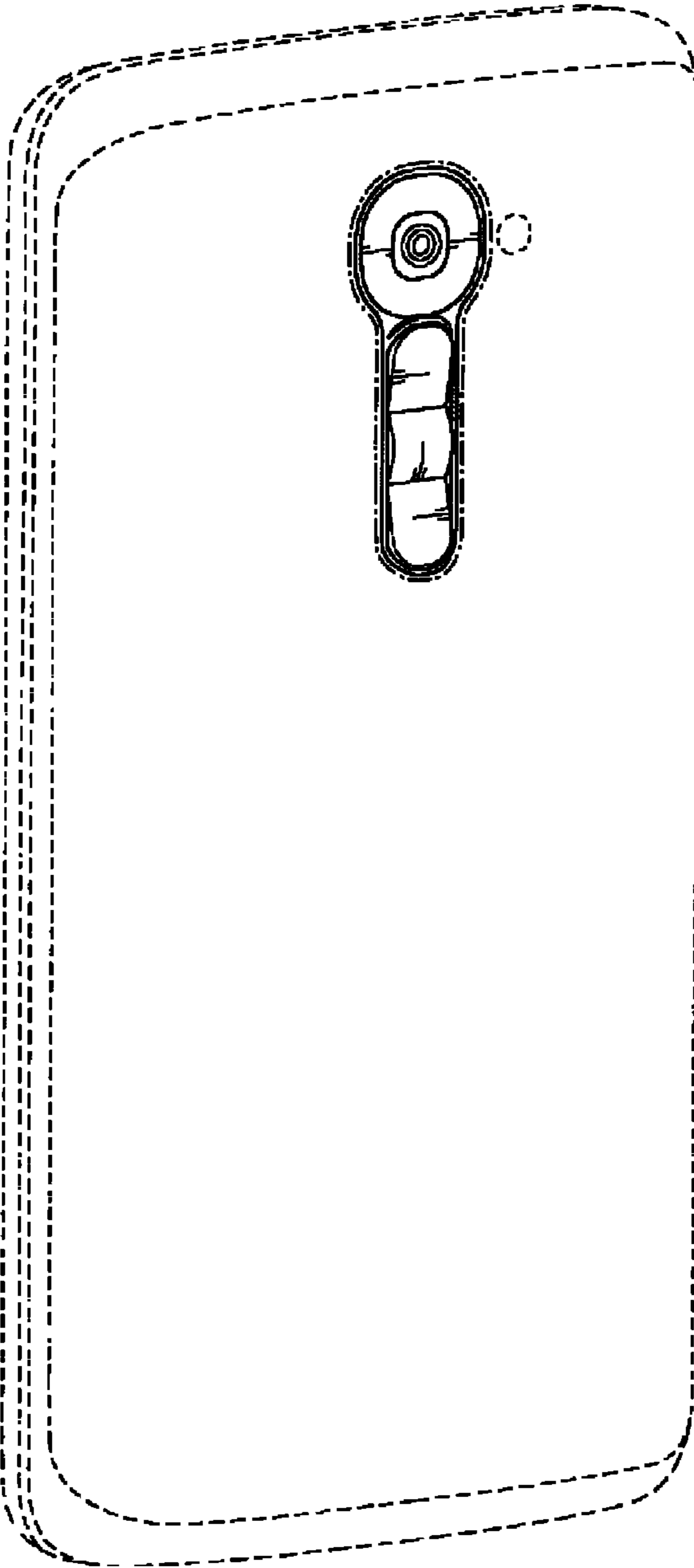

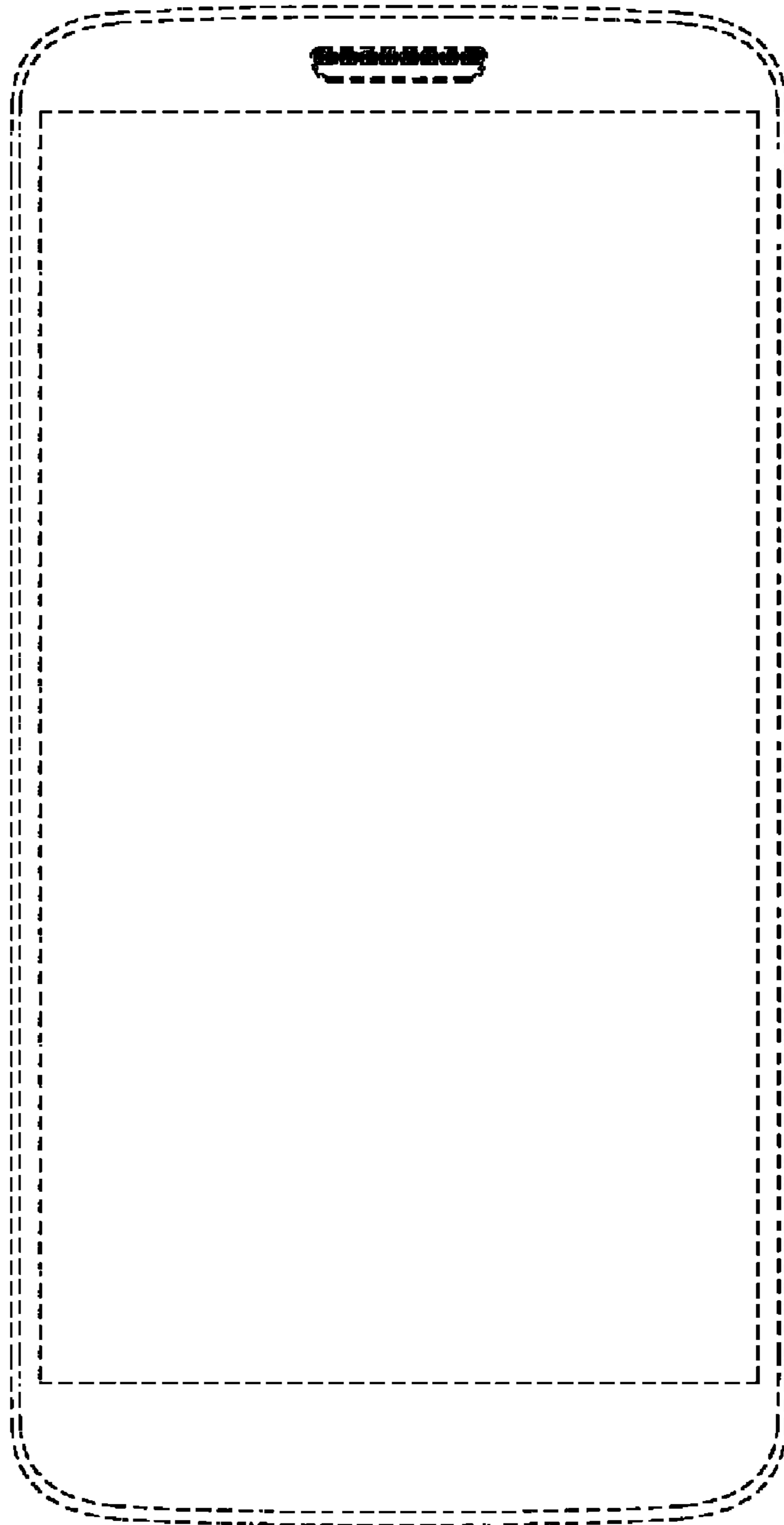

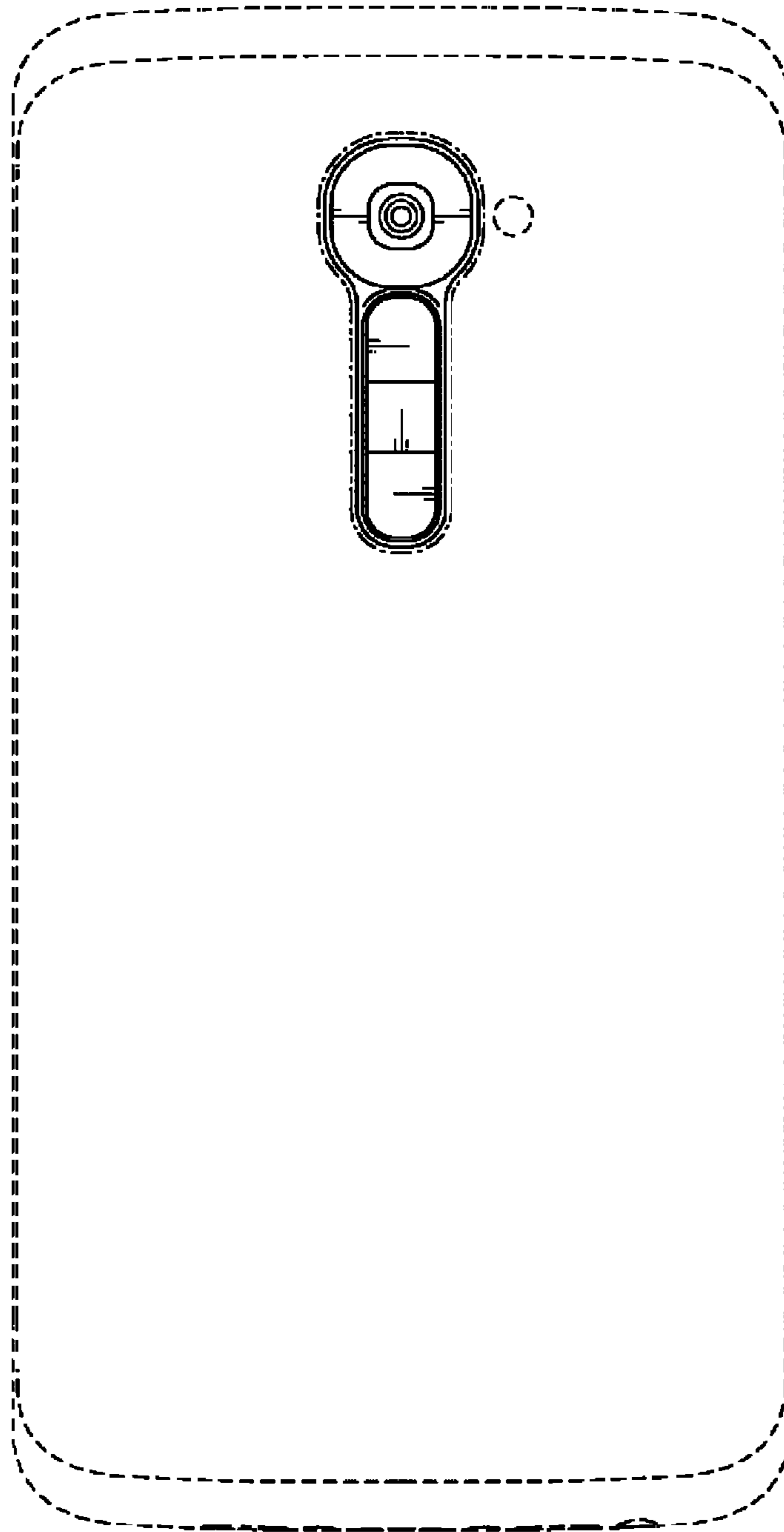

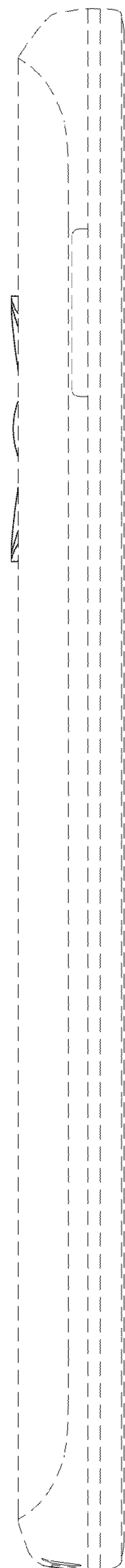

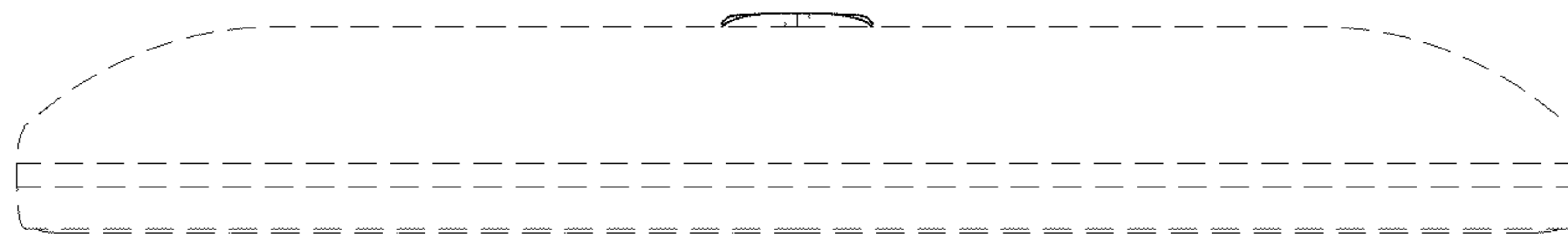

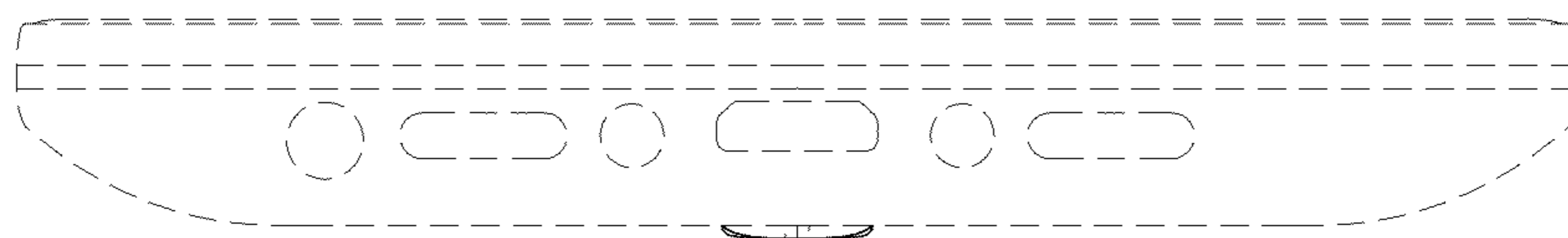
