(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an infant garment, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of an infant garment showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1, with the overlay shown detached and exposing a cutout in the infant garment;  
 FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1, in an alternate environment;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1, in the alternate environment;  
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of FIG. 1, in the alternate environment;  
 FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 1, in the alternate environment;  
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 1, in the alternate environment;  
 FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1, in a second alternate environment; and,  
 FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1, in the second alternate environment.

The broken line showing around the overlay is included for the purpose of illustrating stitching and is part of the claimed design. The broken line showing of sleeves, lower portions of the garment, buttons, and a ribbon forms no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing across the bodice of the garment is included for the purpose of illustrating the bounds of the claimed design and forms no part thereof.

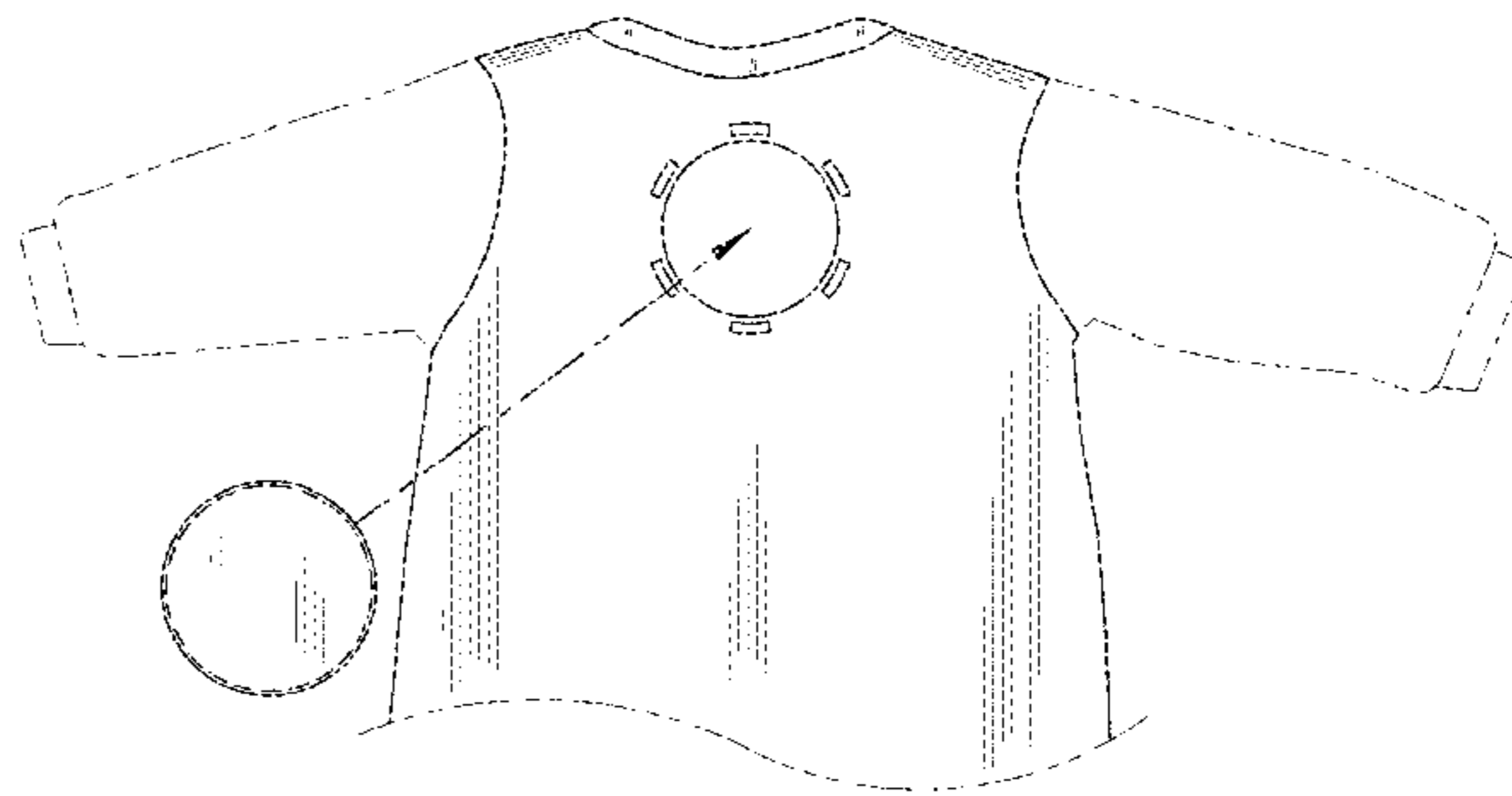
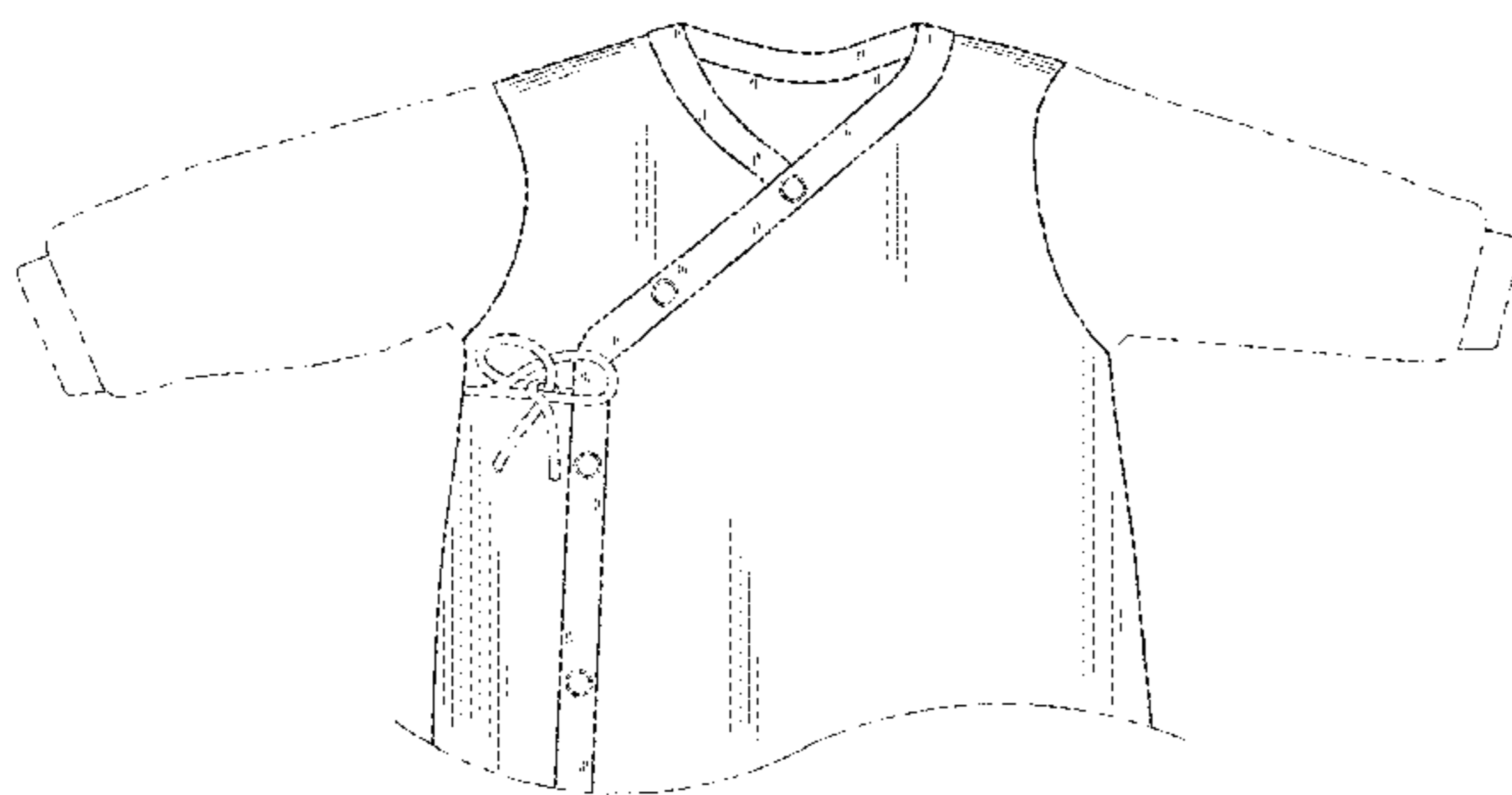

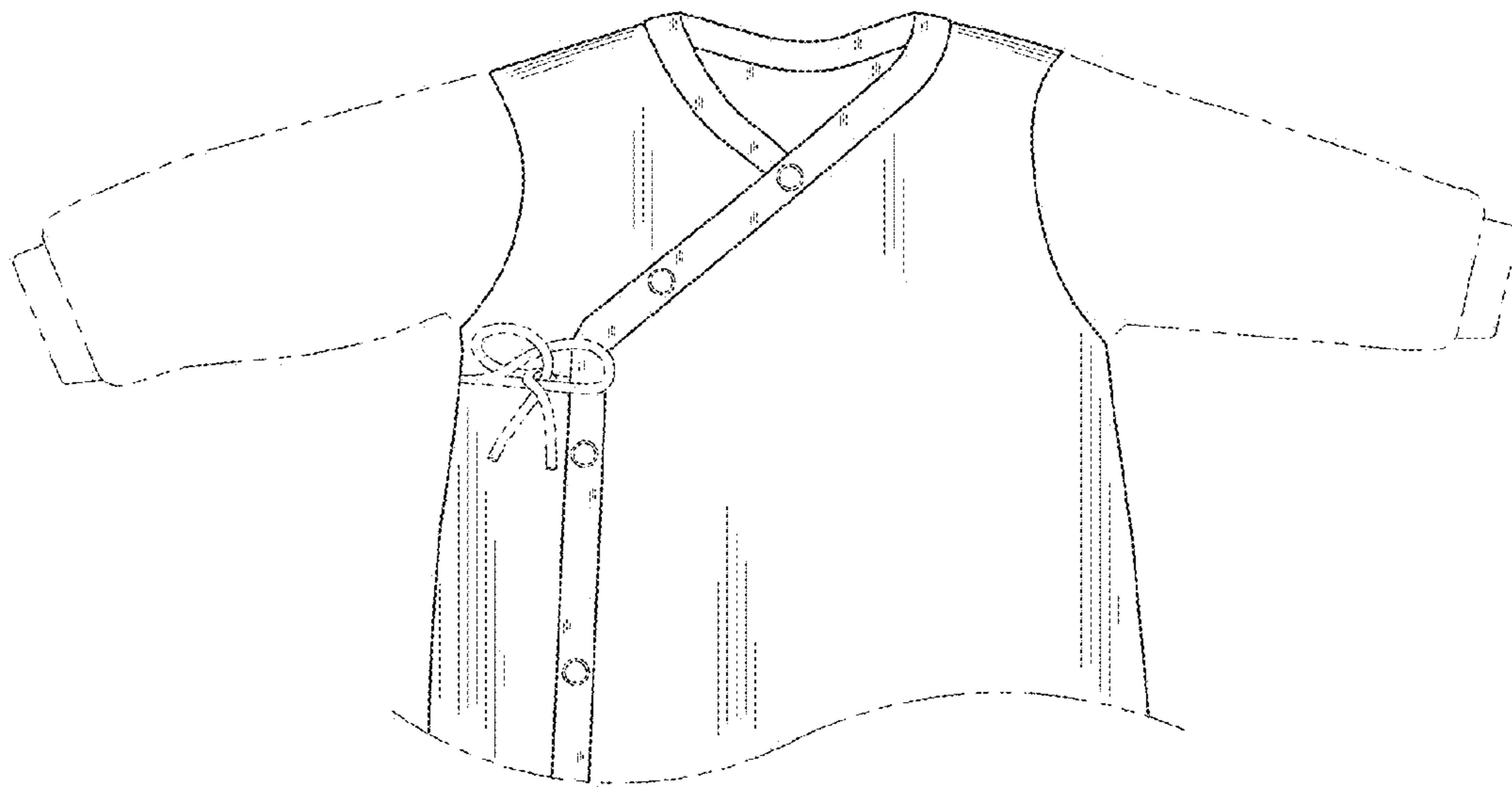

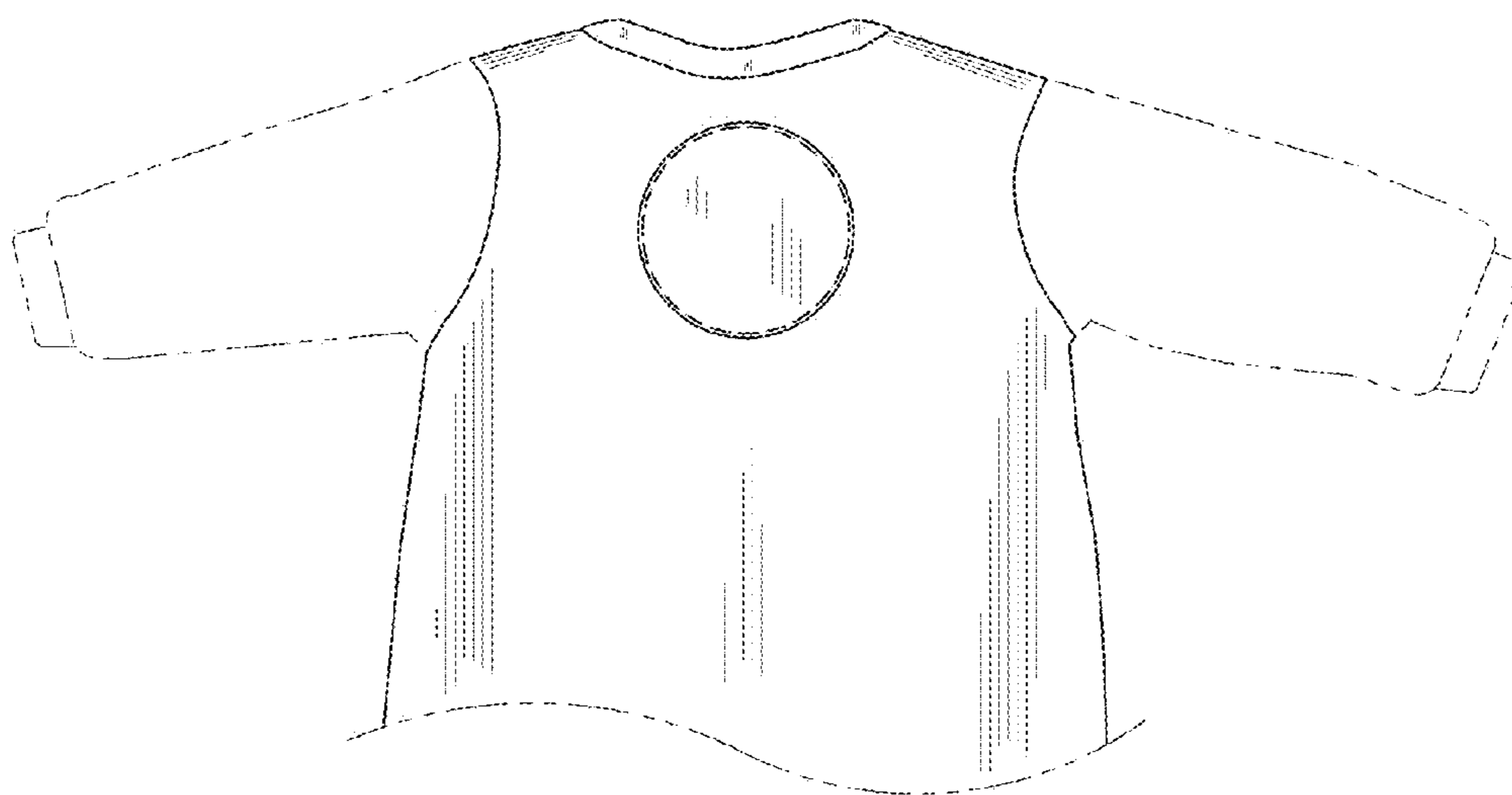

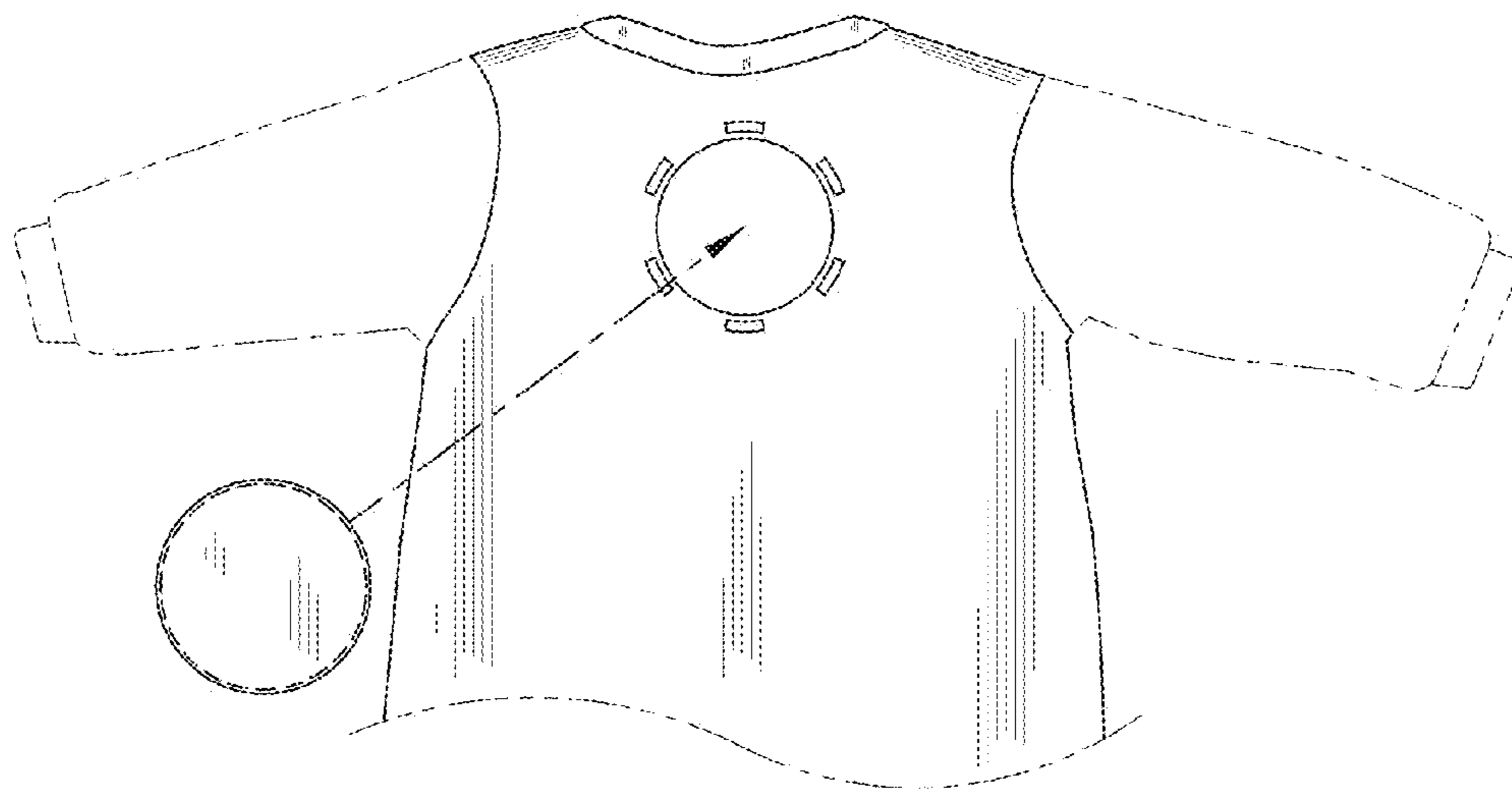

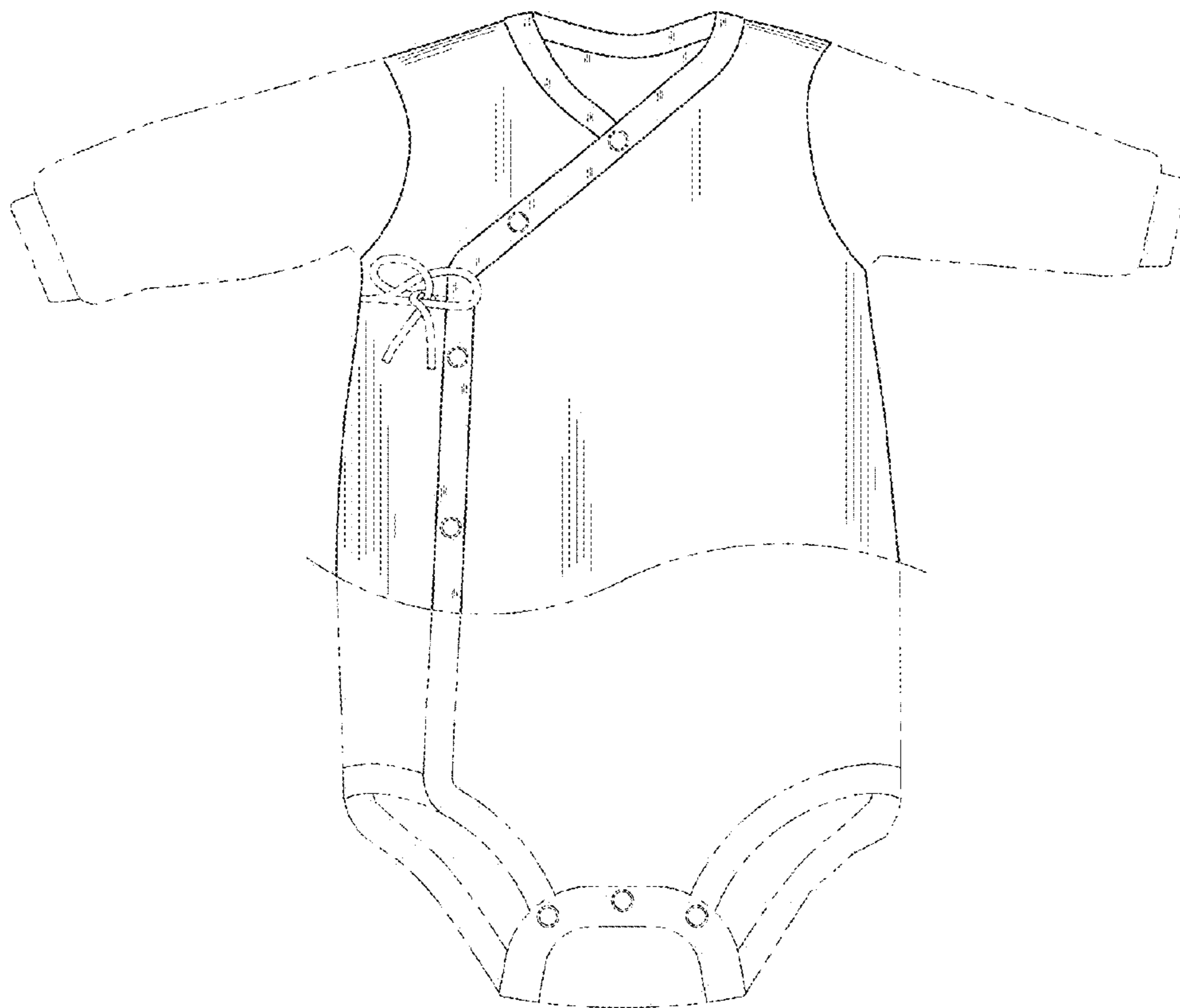

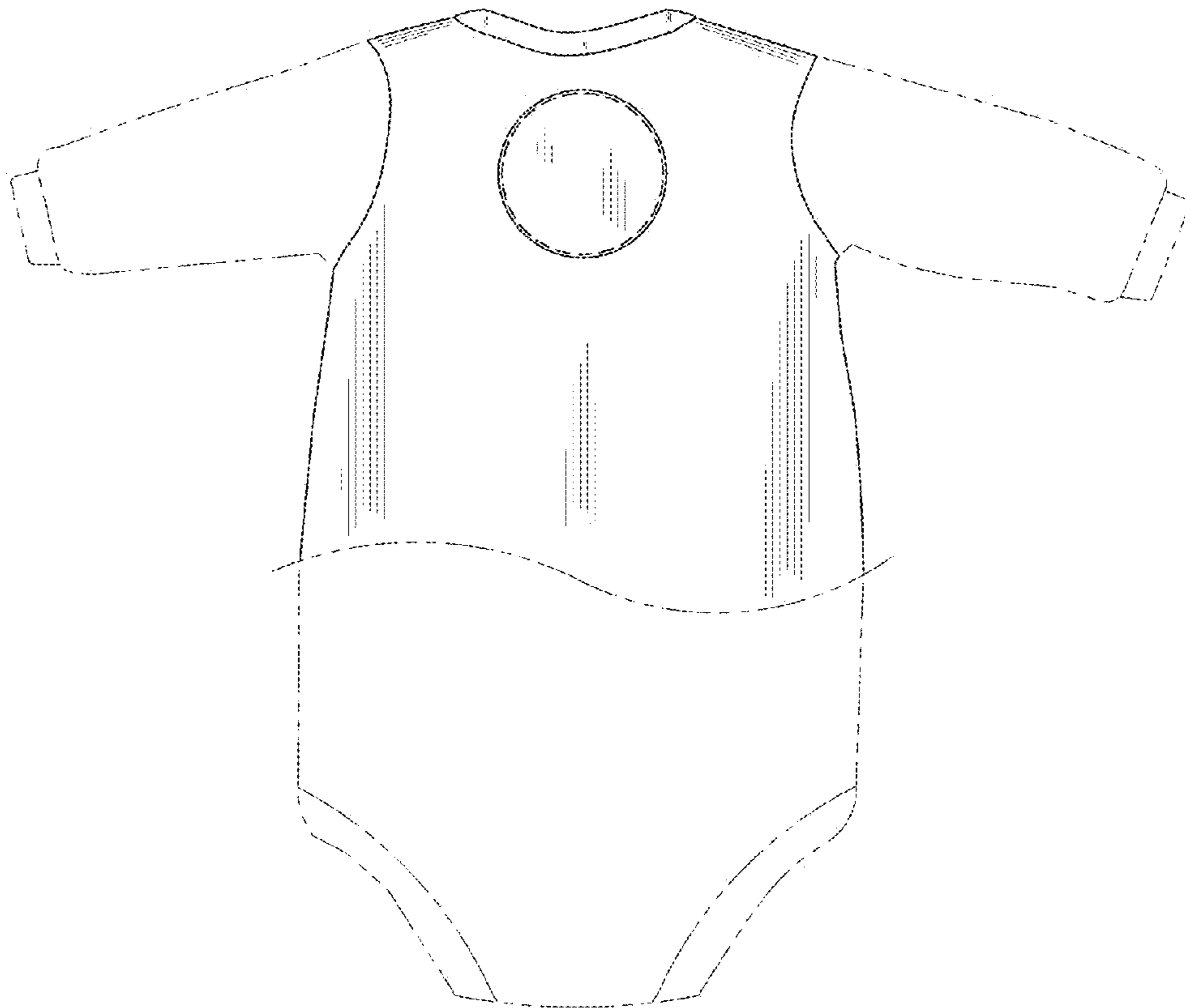

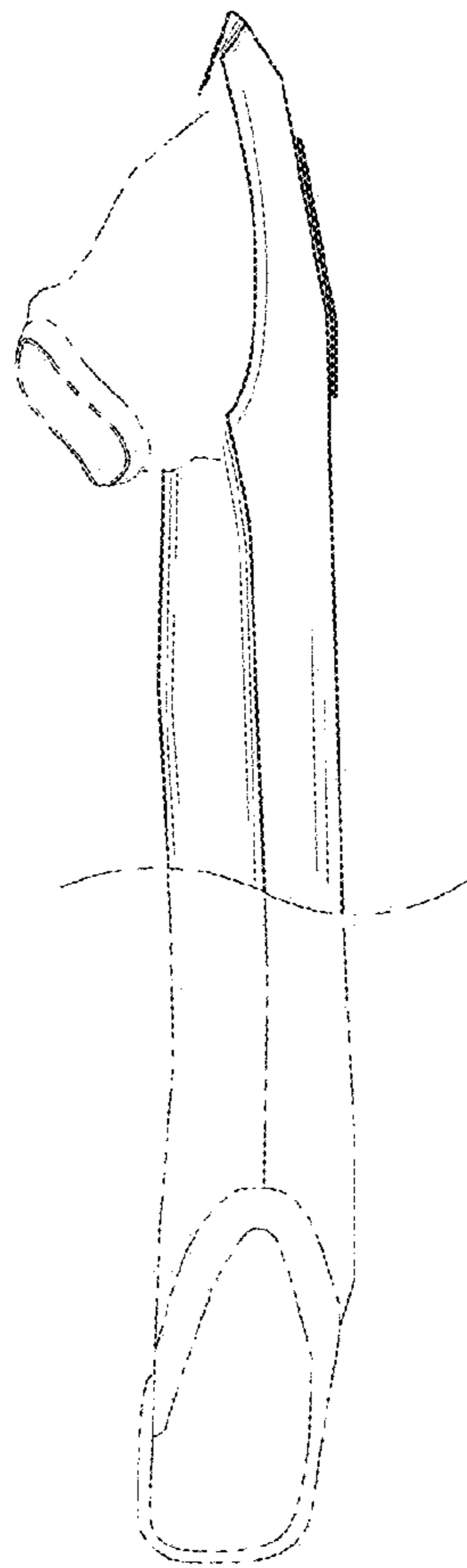

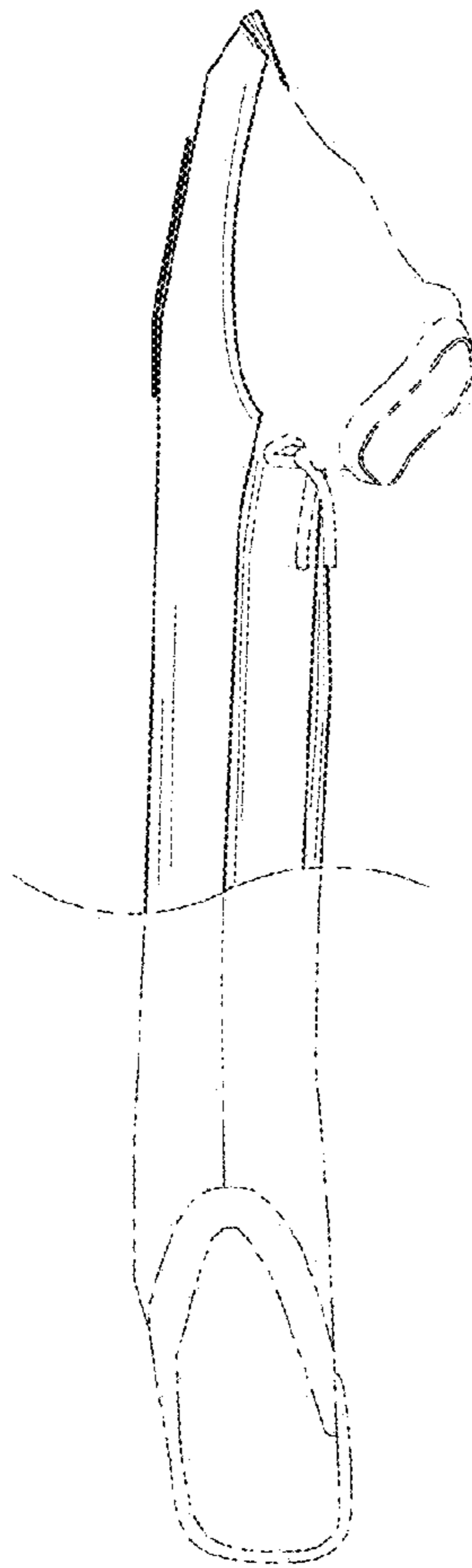

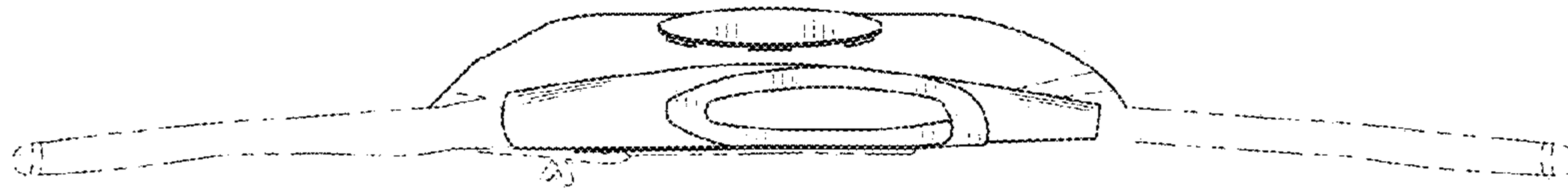

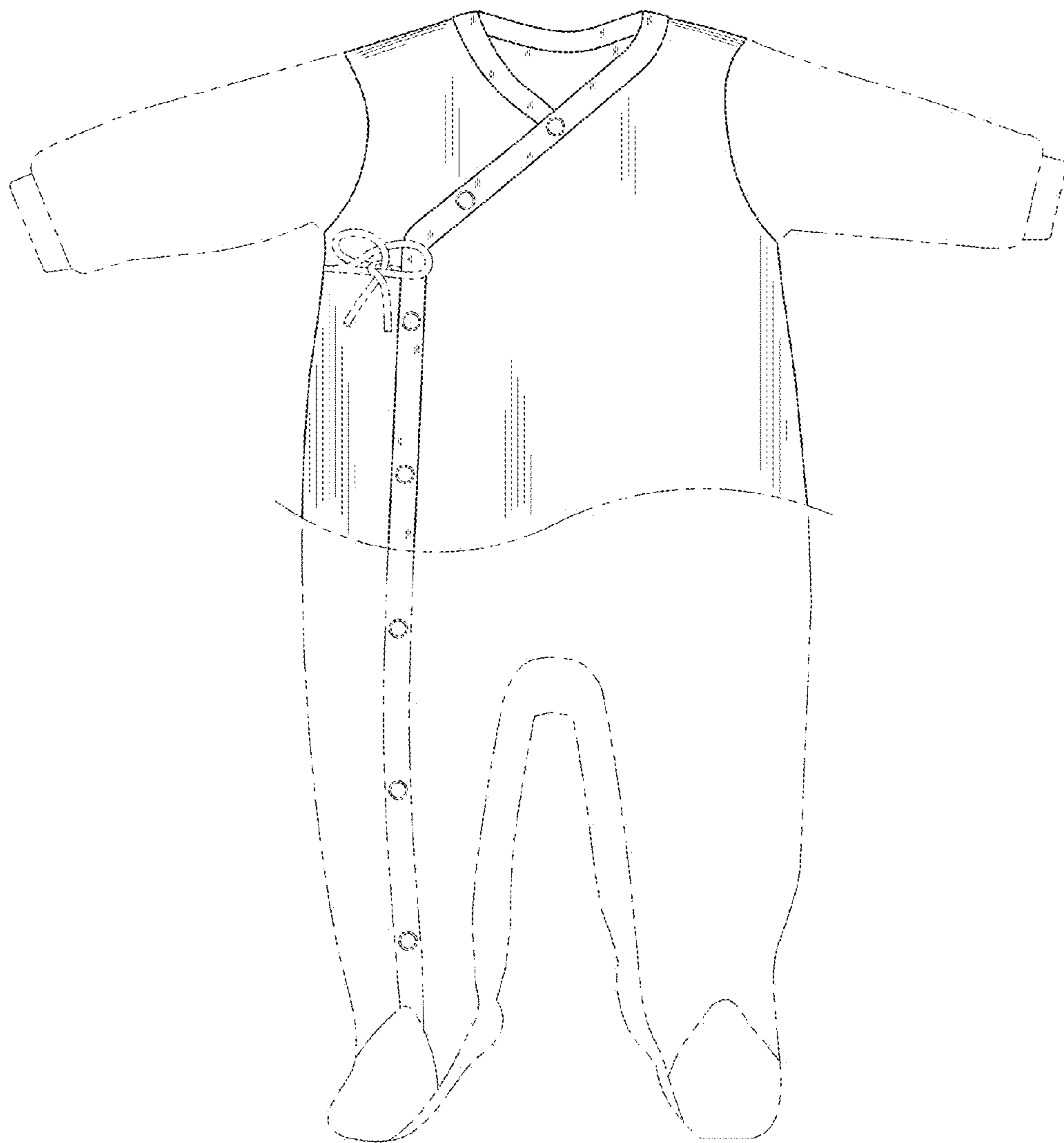
