(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen with graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

The single view is a front view of a display screen with graphical user interface, showing the new design. The outer edge of the portion of the display screen is understood to be congruent with the outer edge of the graphical user interface. The rectangular broken line that extends around the outermost periphery defines the bounds of the claimed design, although the boundary line itself forms no part of the claimed design. The other broken lines are for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design. Subject matter shown in broken lines in the drawings forms no part of the claimed design.
