DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1-FIG. 4 are views of a first embodiment and FIG. 5-FIG. 8 are views of a second embodiment of a scoop sponge showing our new design;

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of the scoop sponge;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the back elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left-hand elevation view thereof, the right-hand elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof; and

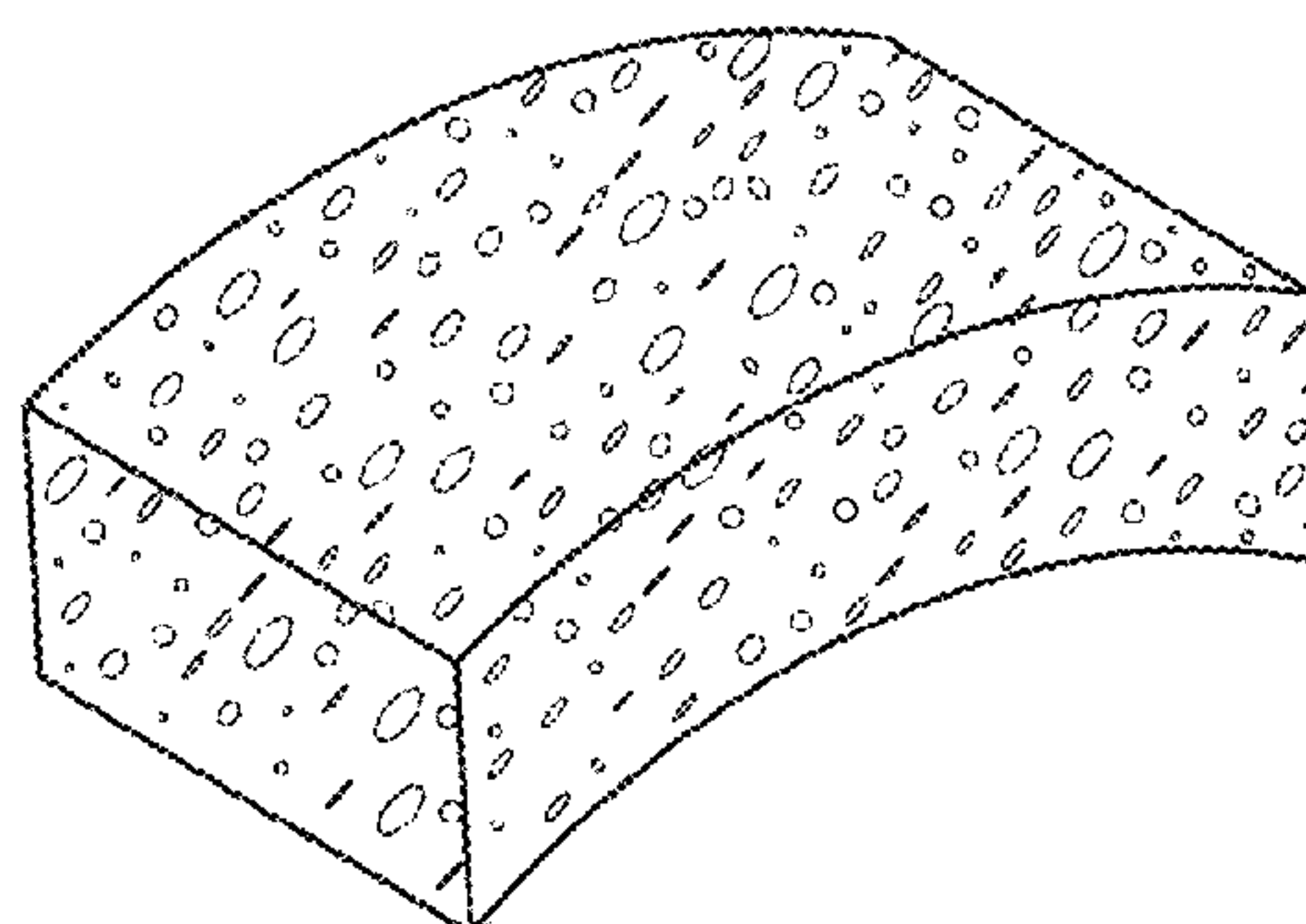
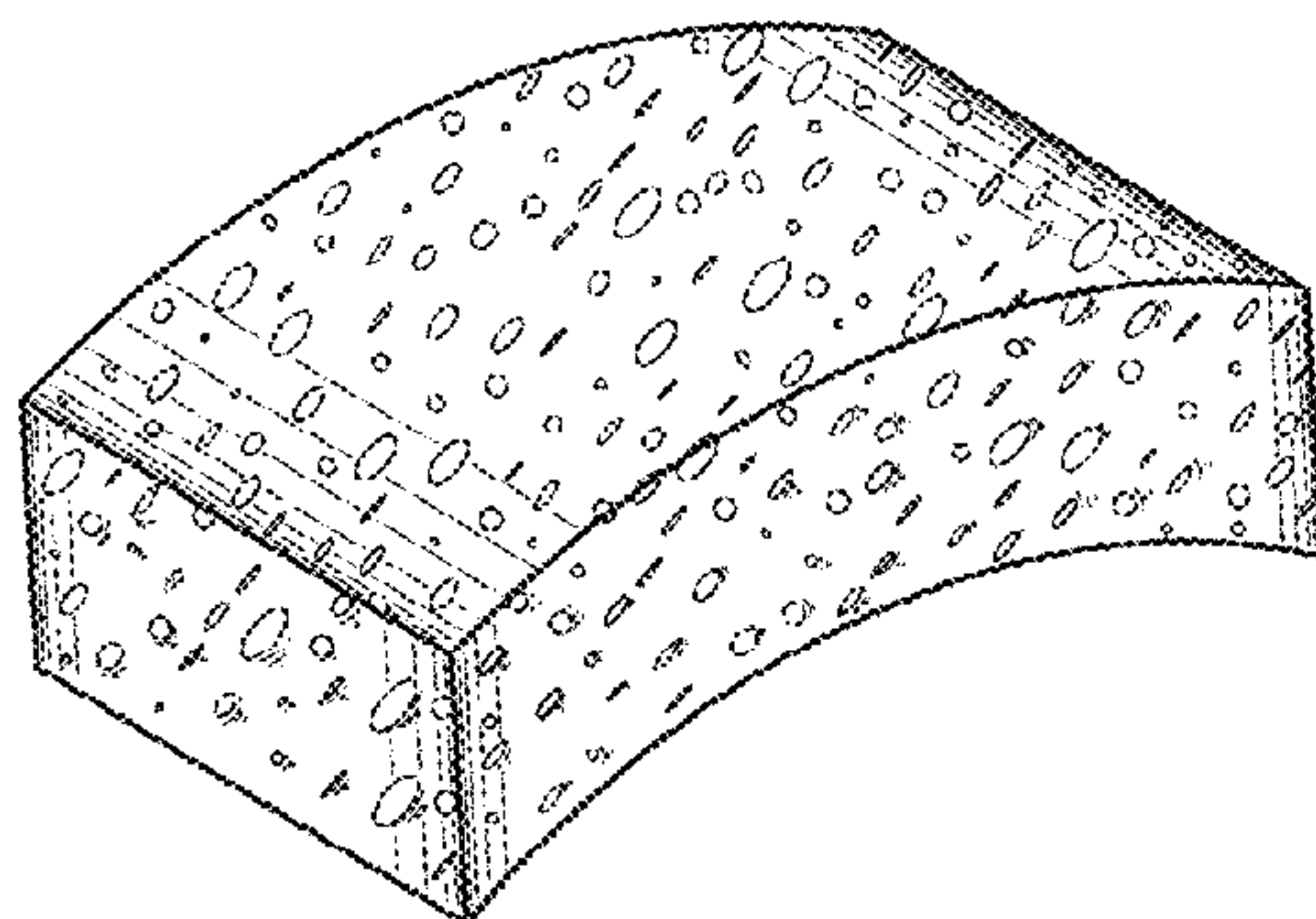
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the second embodiment of the scoop sponge;

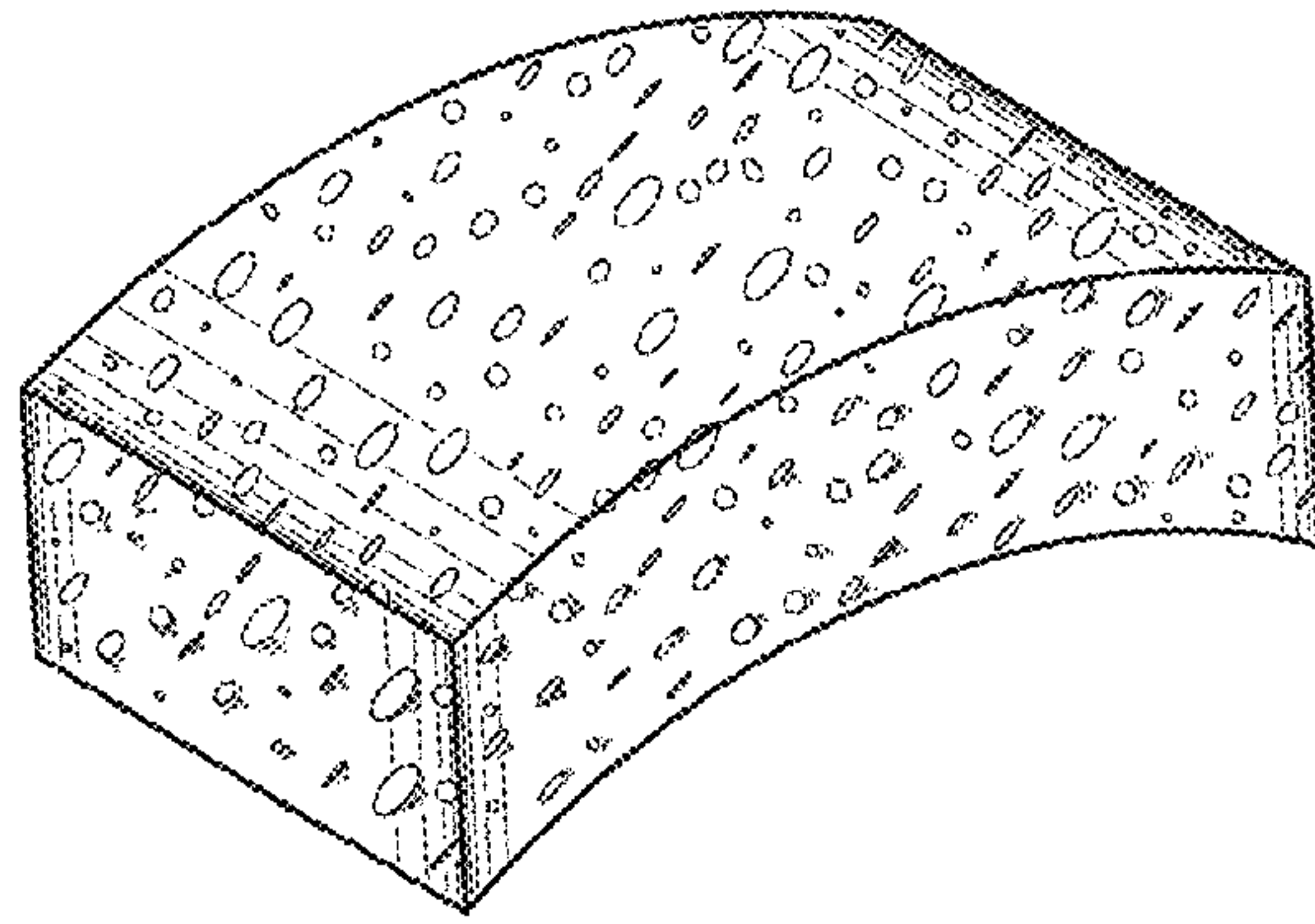

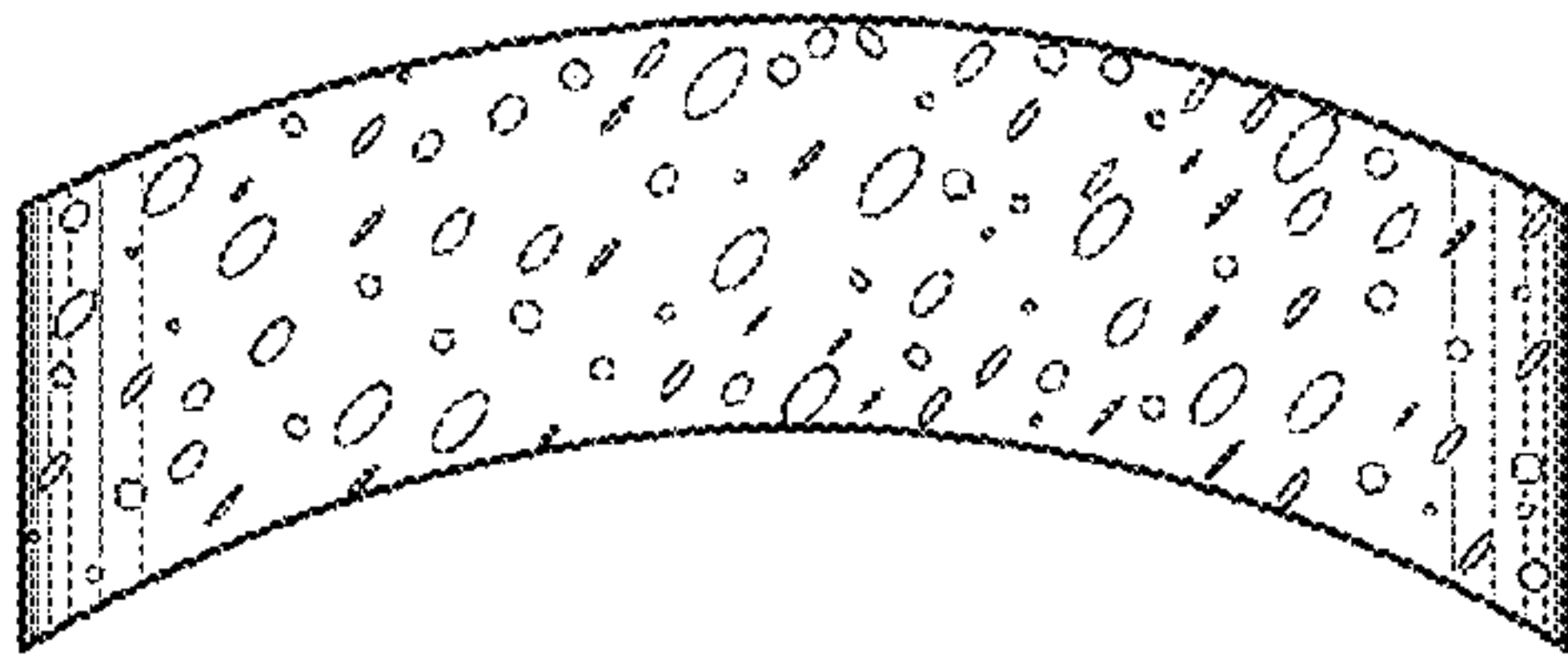

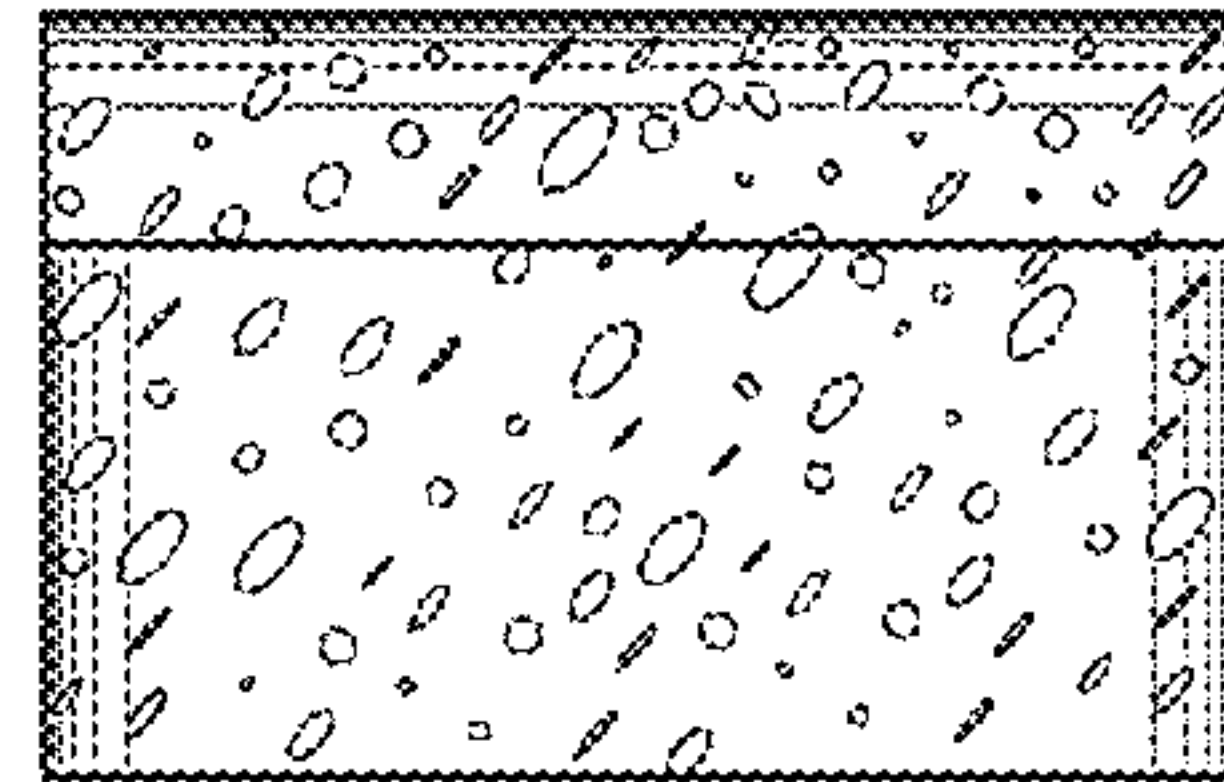

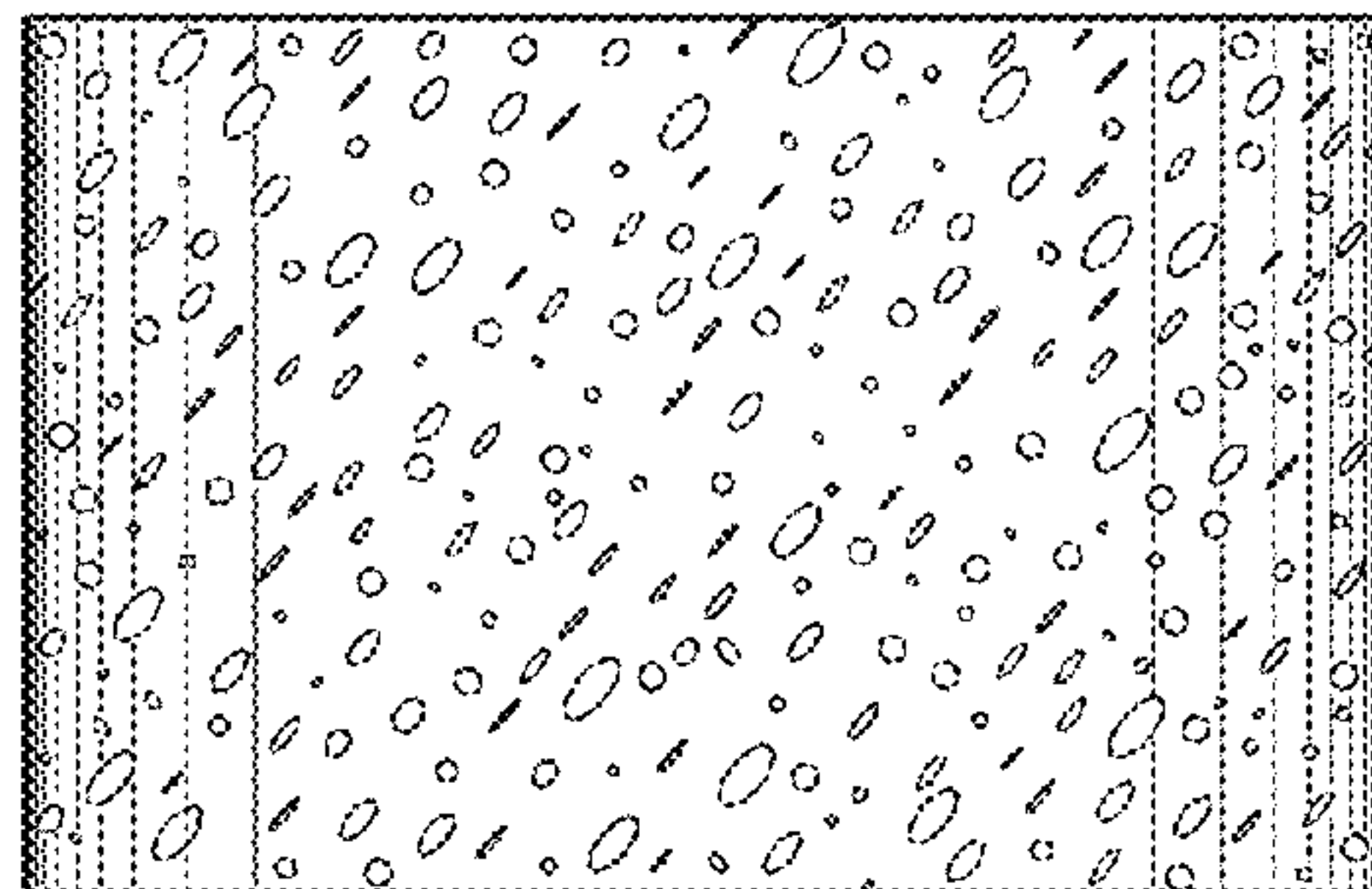

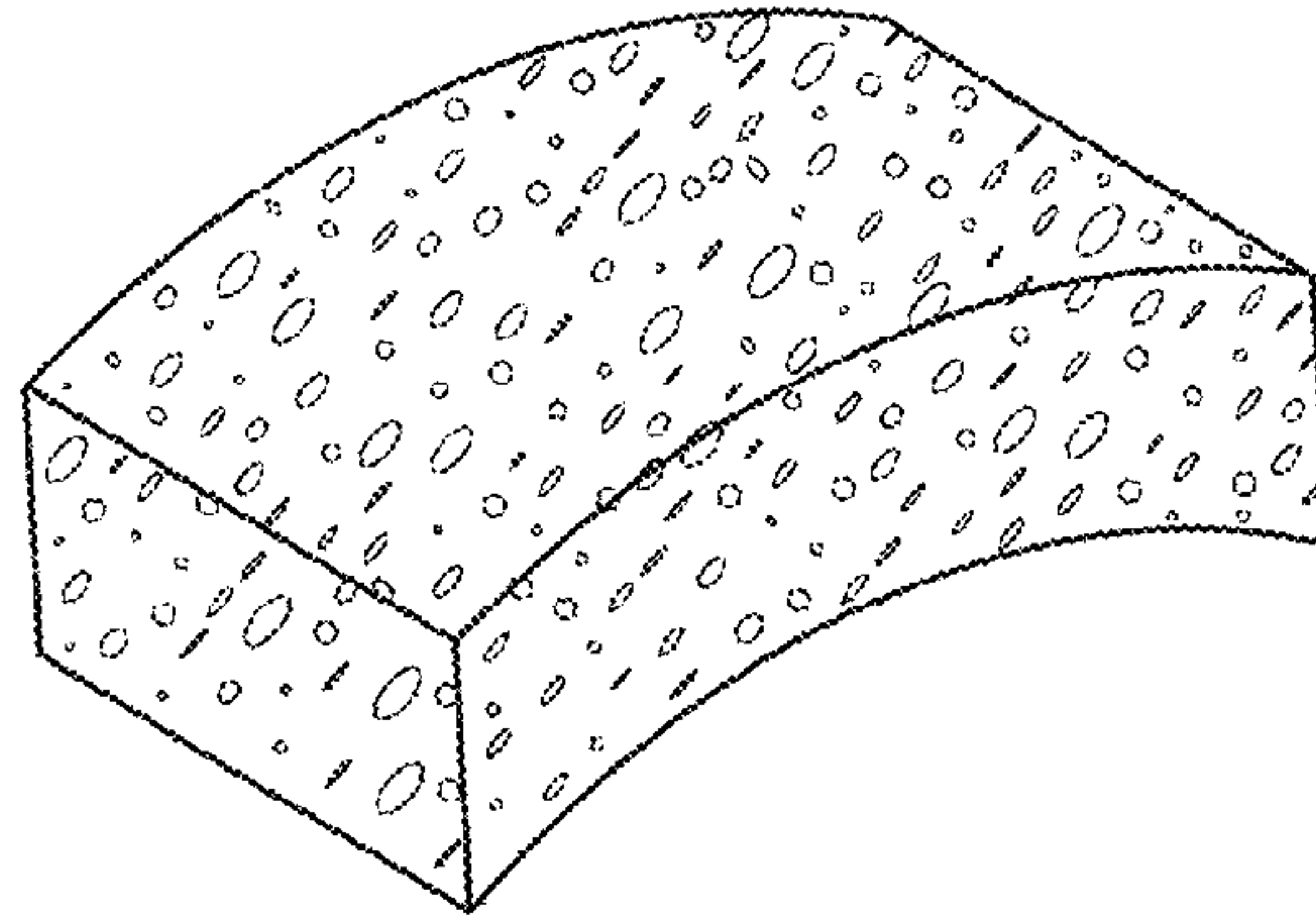

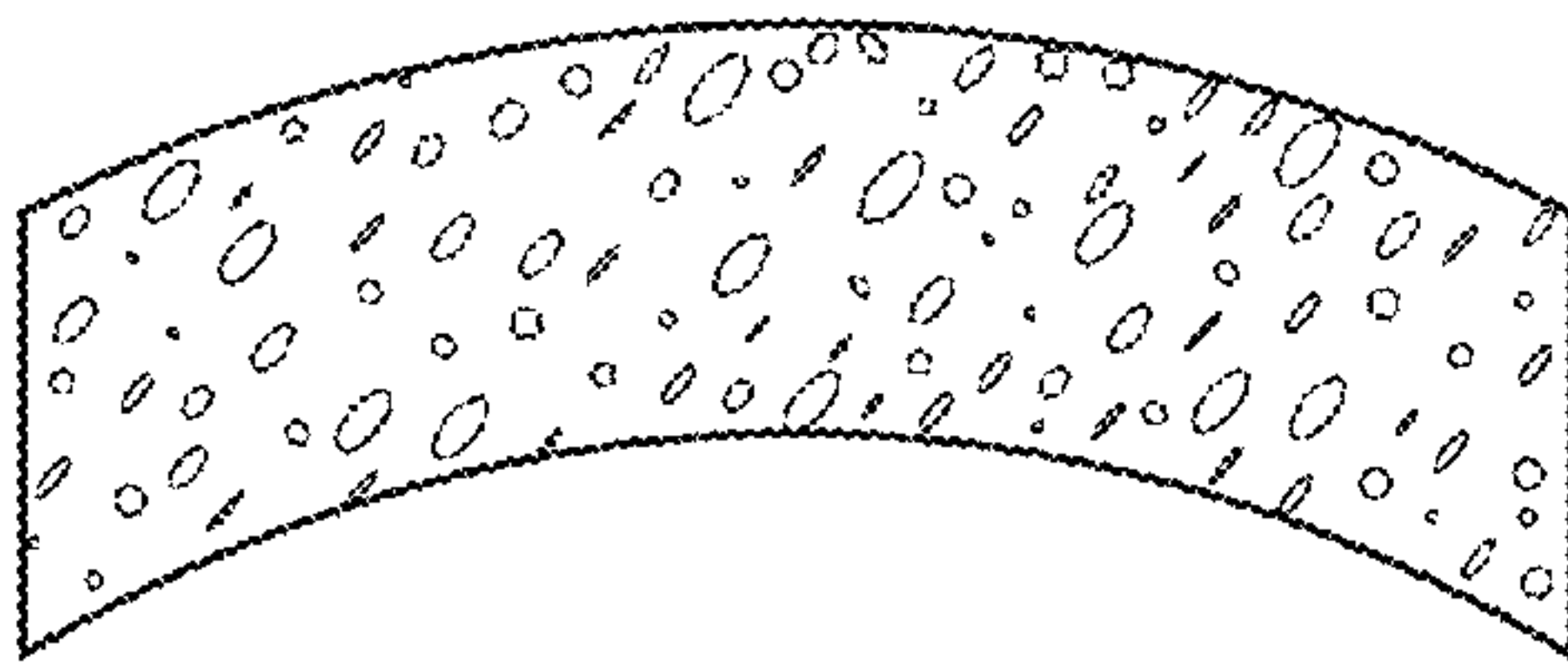

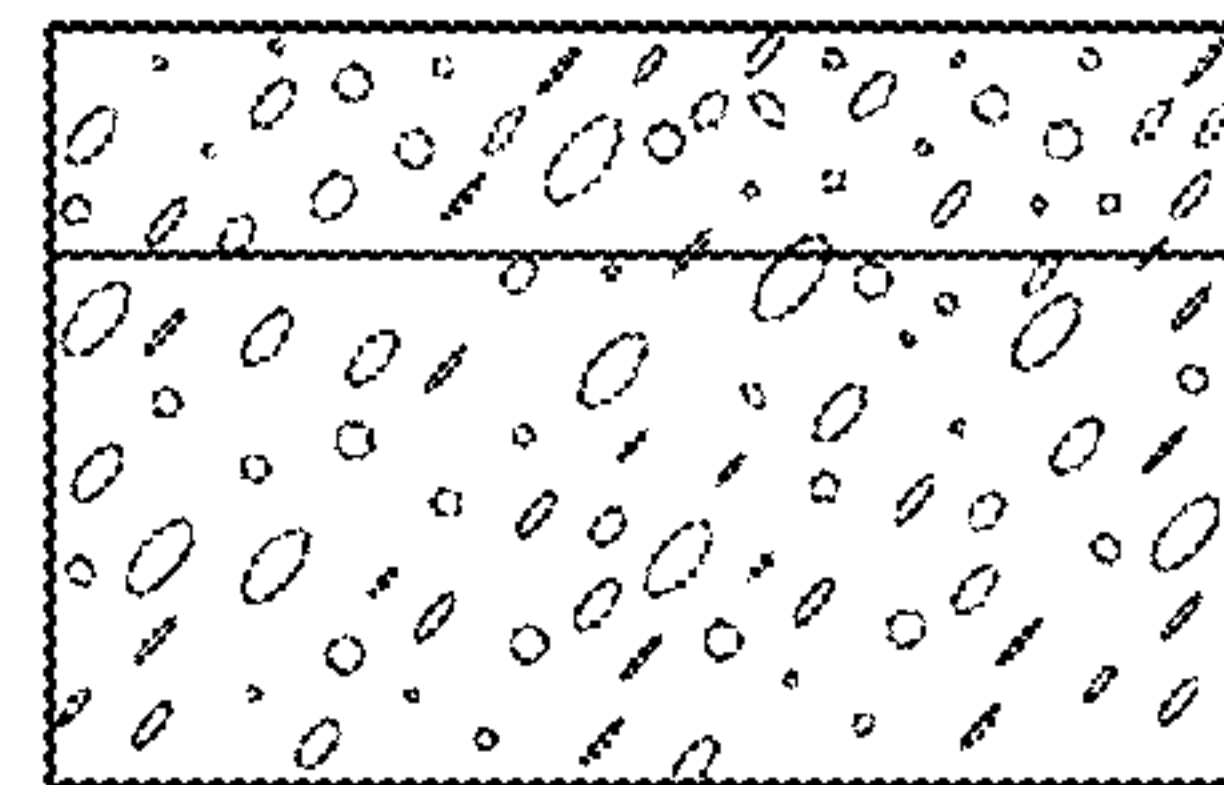

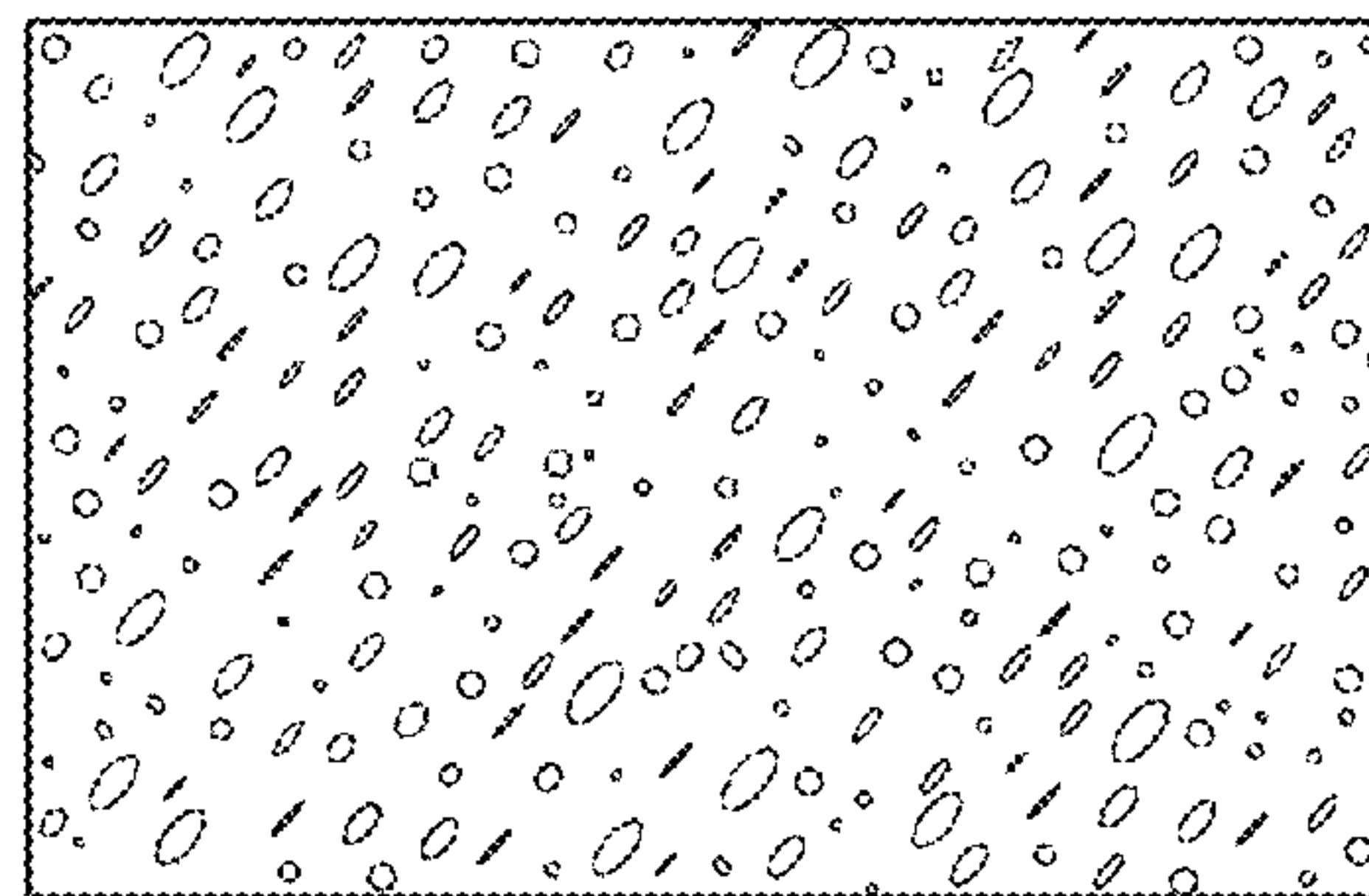
