(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a kneepad, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the kneepad of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the kneepad of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a back view of the kneepad of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the kneepad of FIG. 1, as seen from the right side of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a side view of the kneepad of FIG. 1, as seen from the left side of FIG. 2;

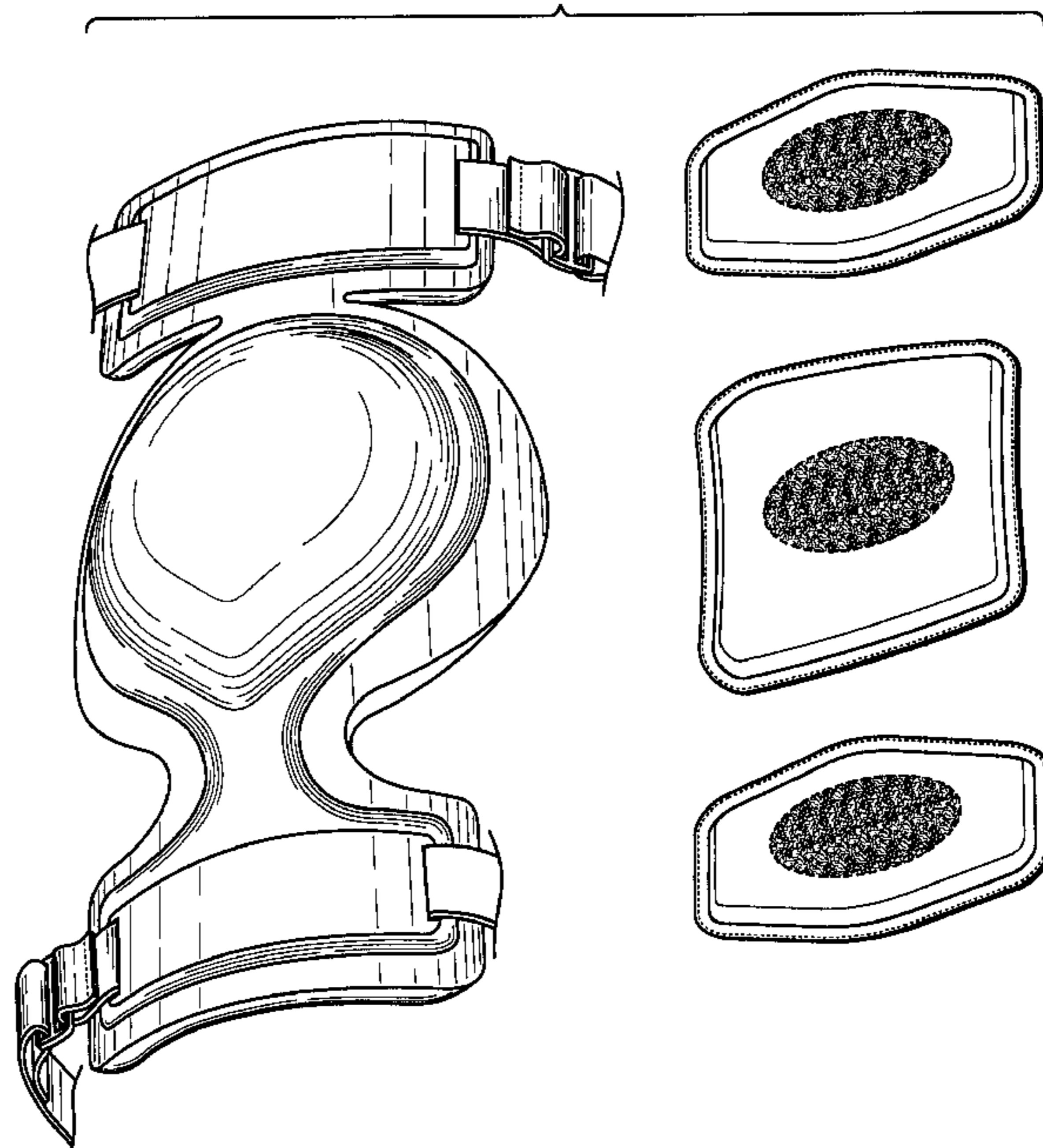
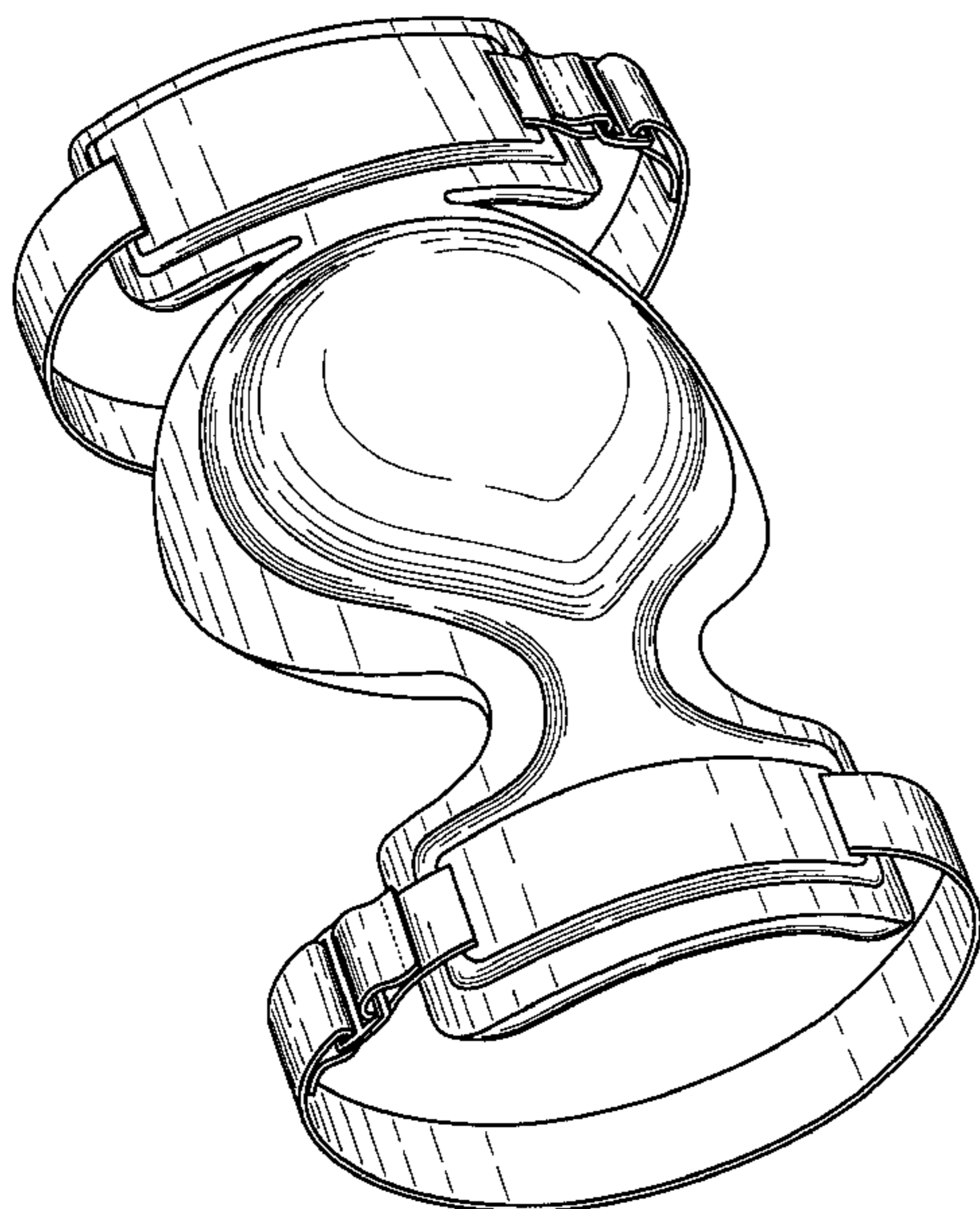
FIG. 6 is a top plan view in elevation of the kneepad, as seen from the top side of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the kneepad, as seen from the bottom side of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 8 is an exploded view of a portion of the KNEEPAD of FIG. 1 illustrating removable cushion pads.

The broken lines in the drawings are for the purpose of illustrating stitching and portions of the kneepad and form no part of the claimed design.

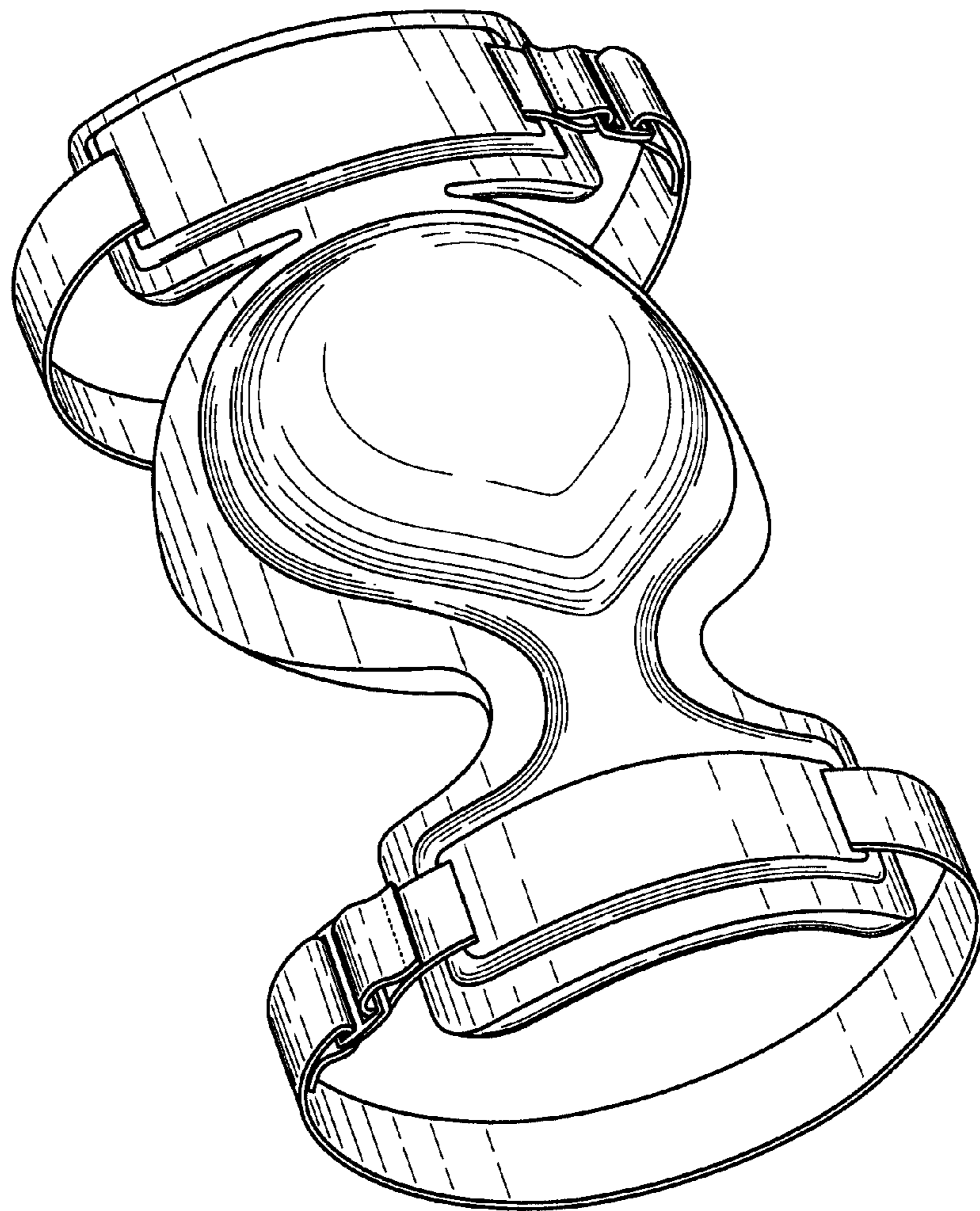

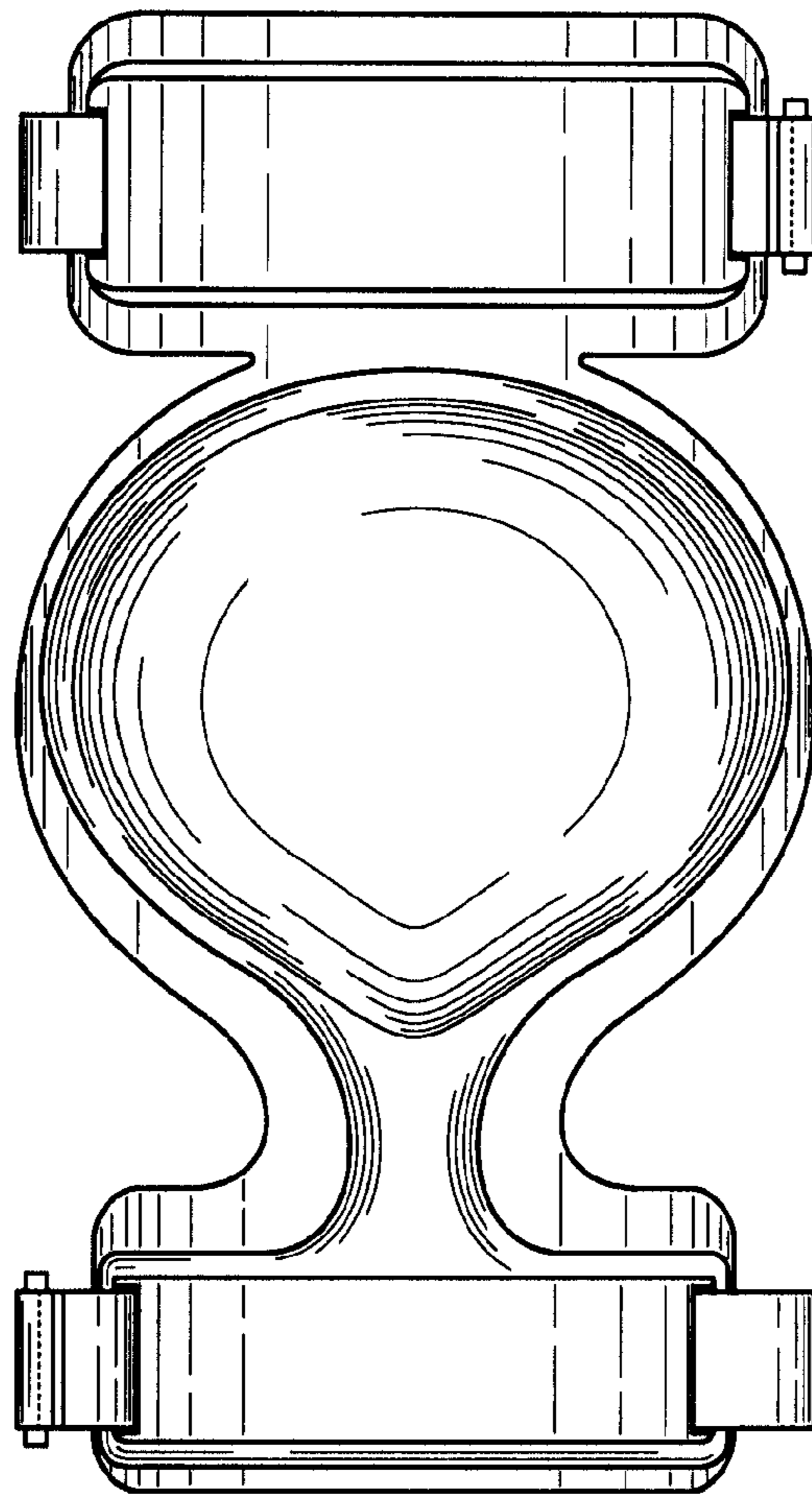

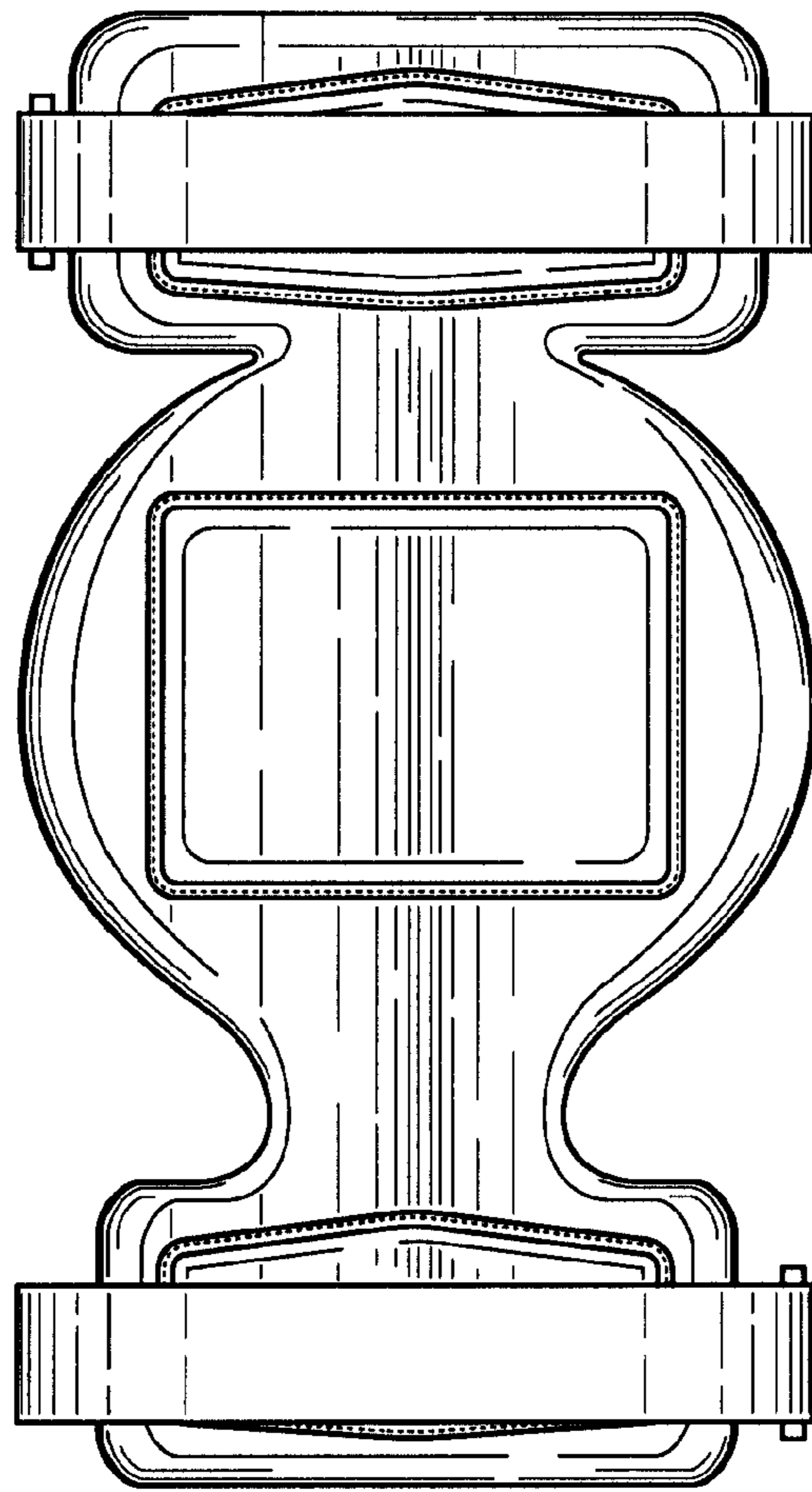

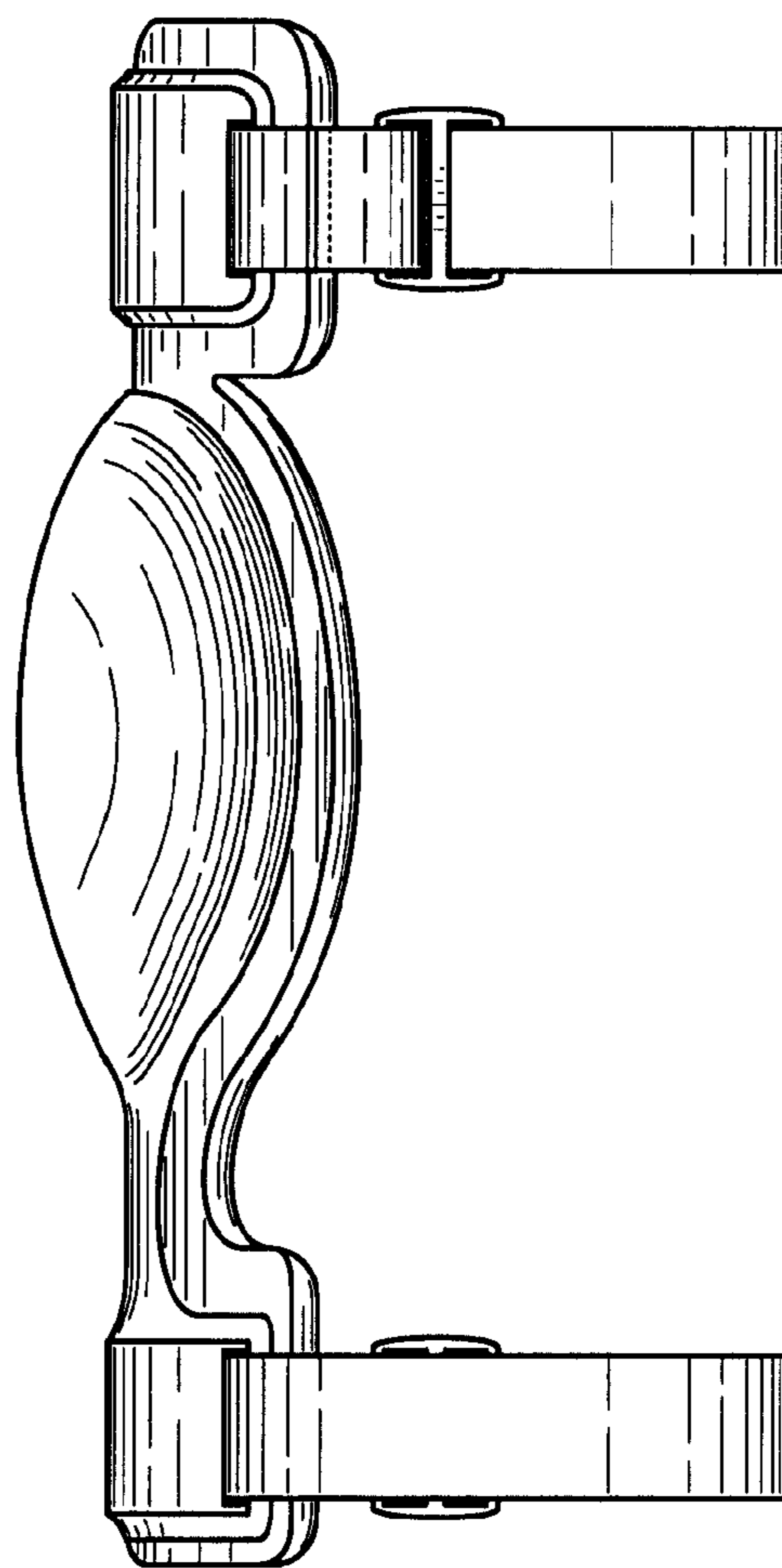

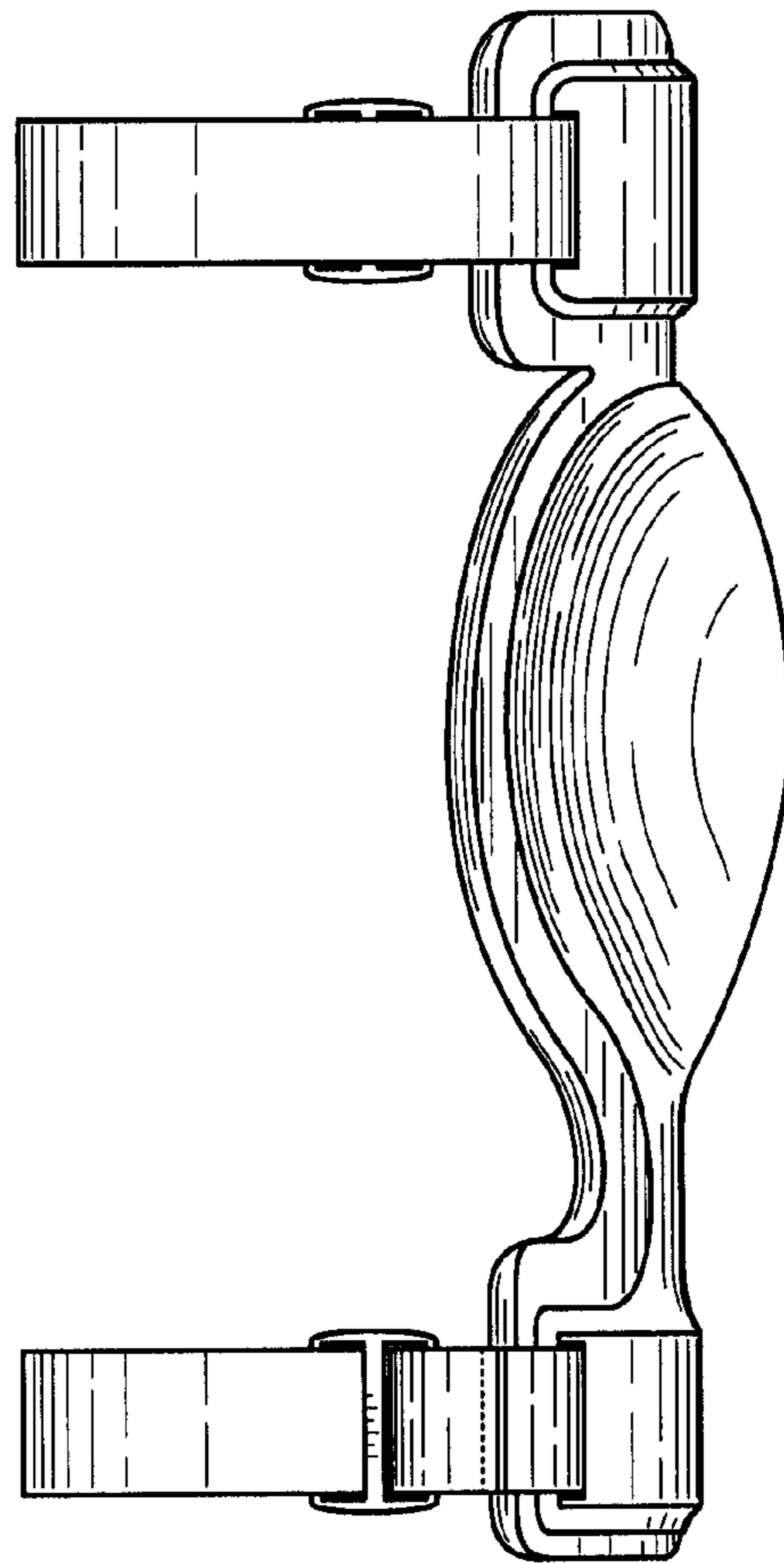

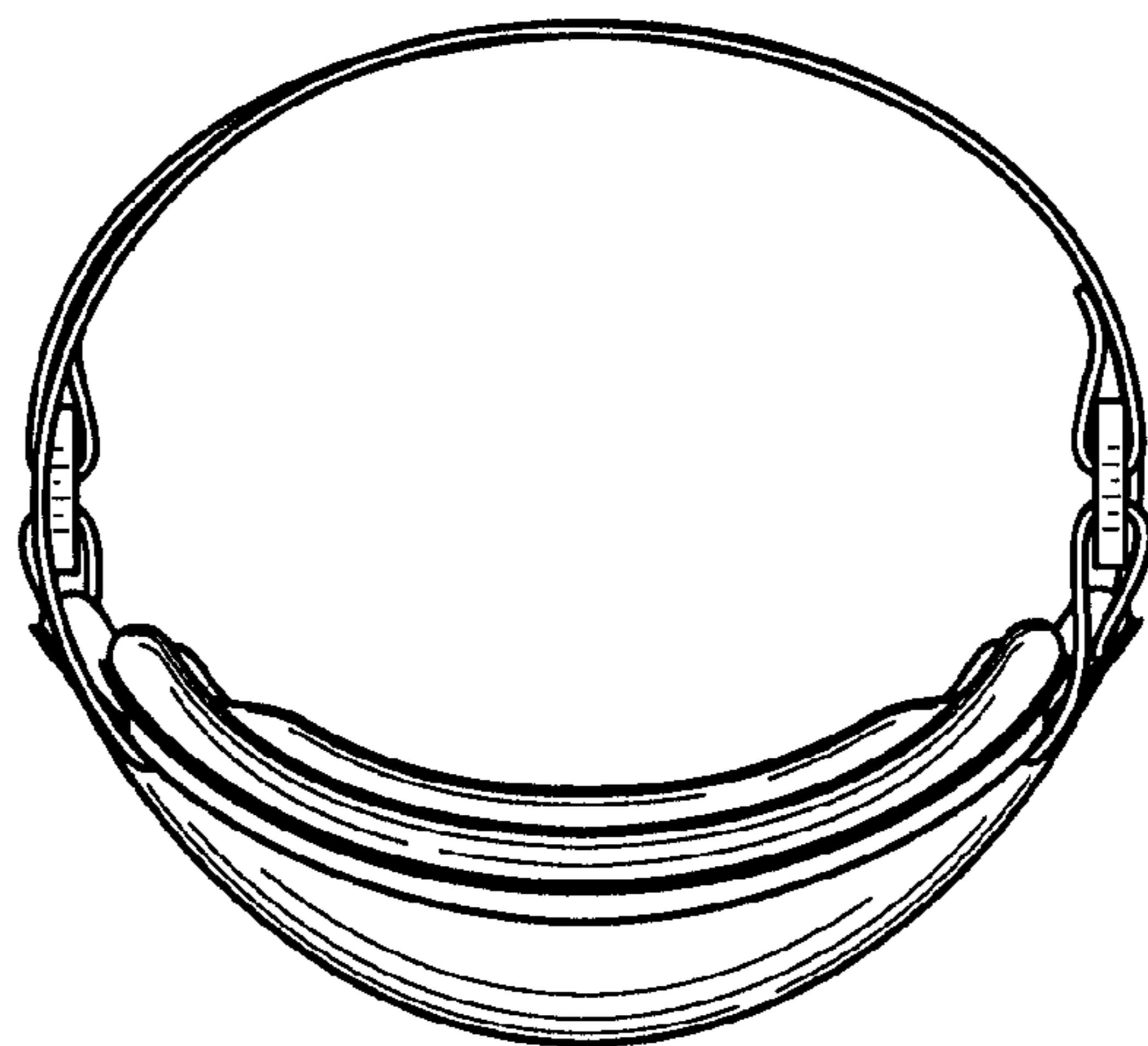

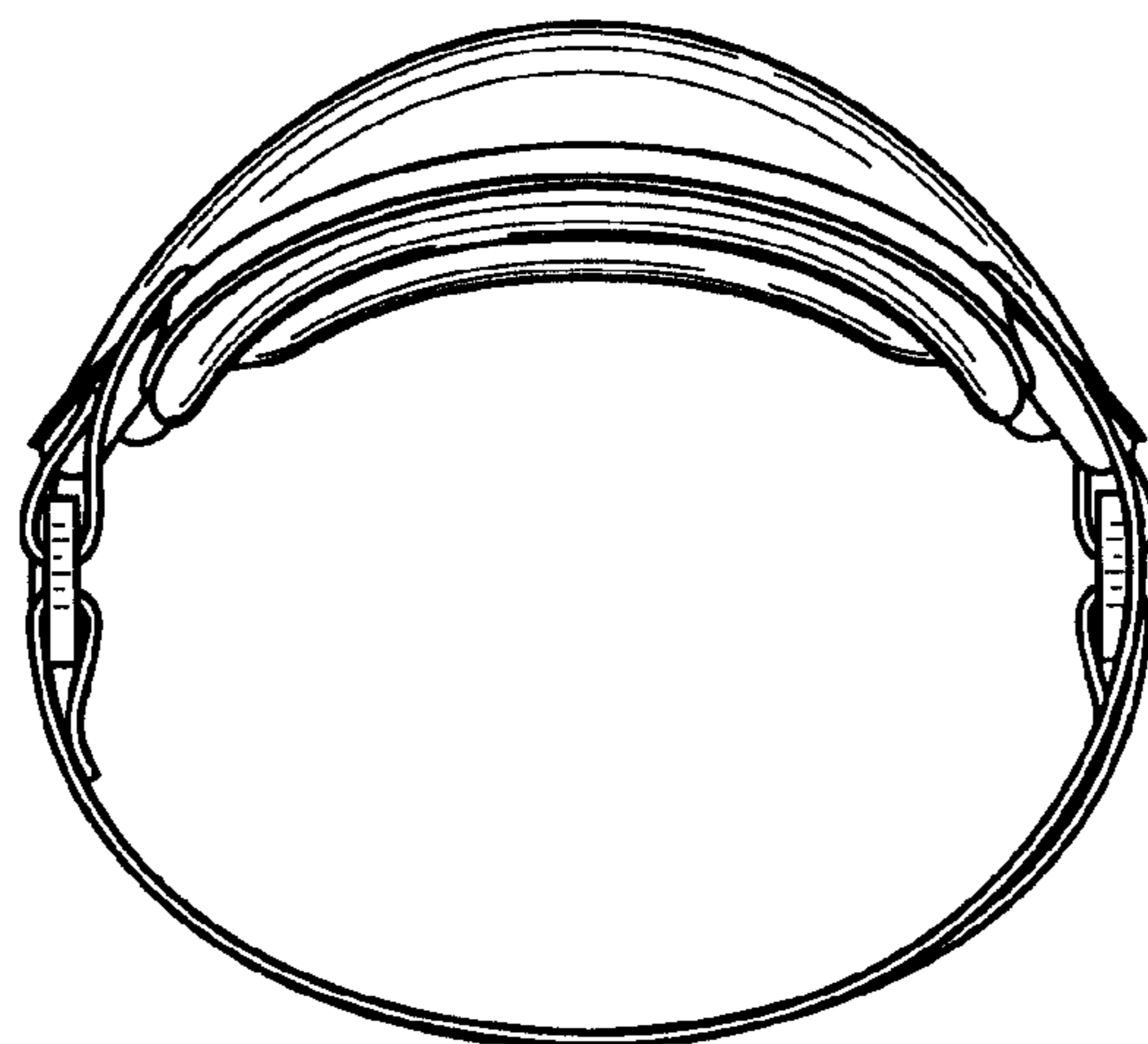

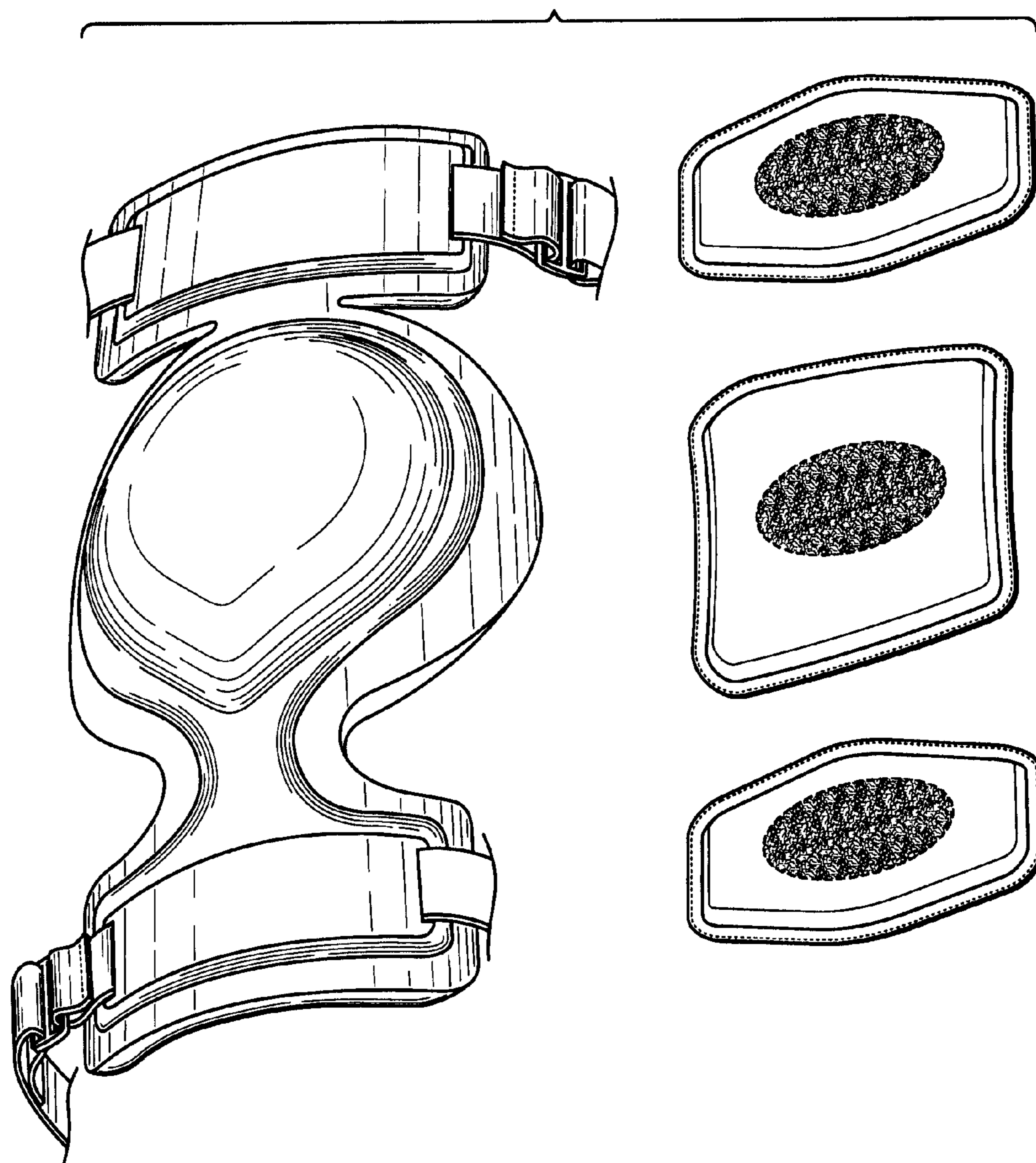
