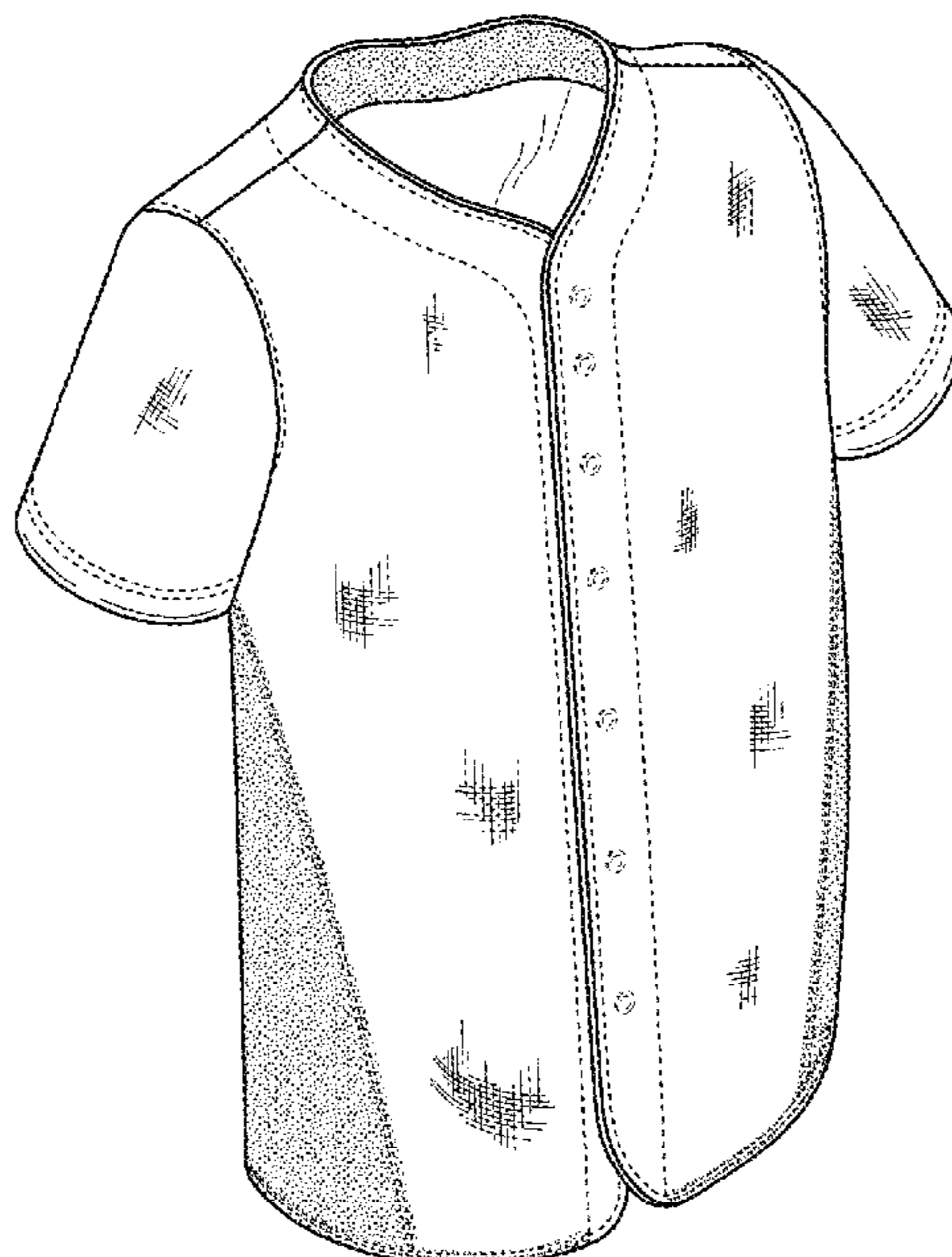
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jersey, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a jersey in a closed position;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of the jersey in an open position.
 The stitching and buttons shown in broken lines on the jersey form no parts of the claimed design.
 The stippled surface shading represents a mesh fabric and the cross-hatched surface shading represents non-mesh fabric.

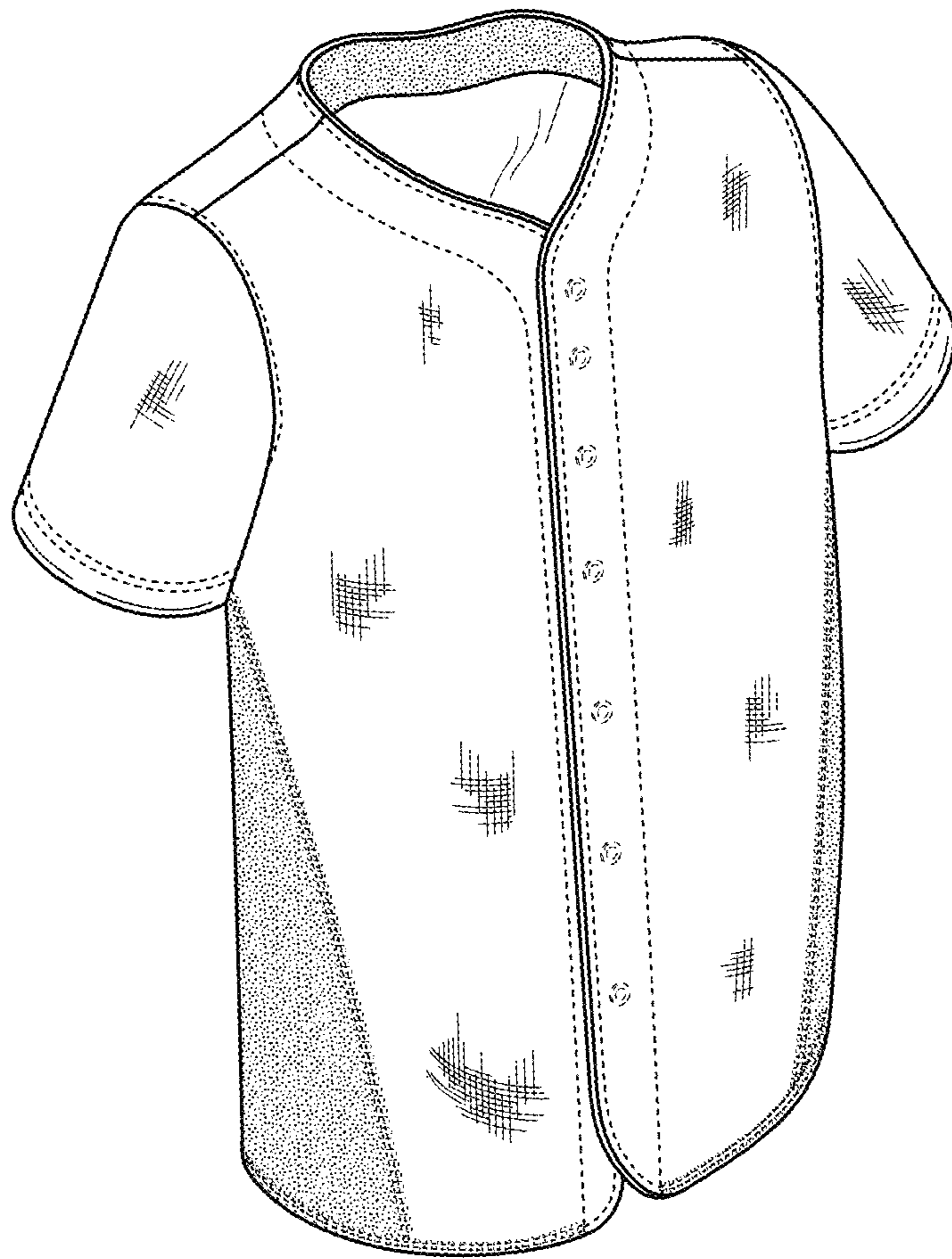

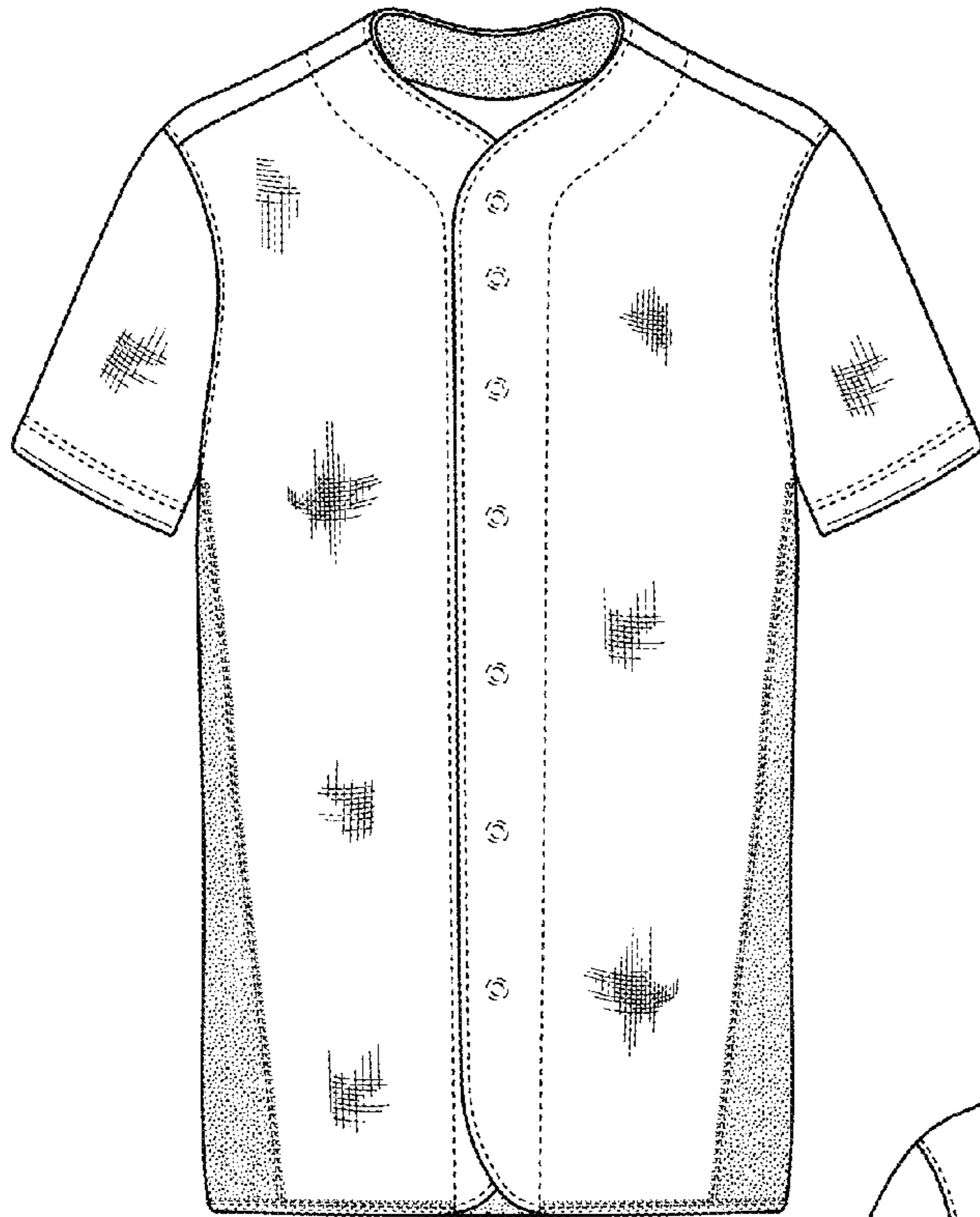

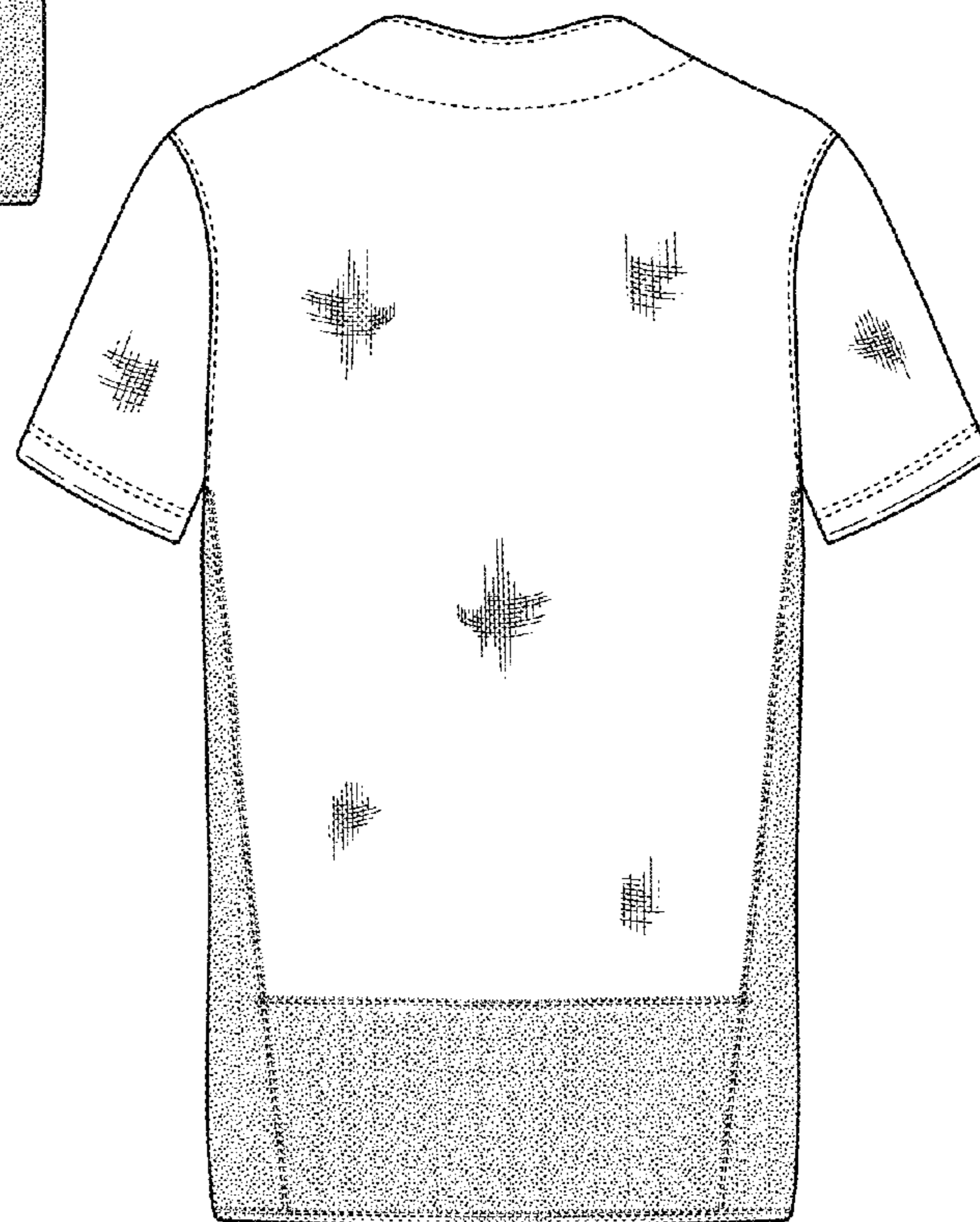

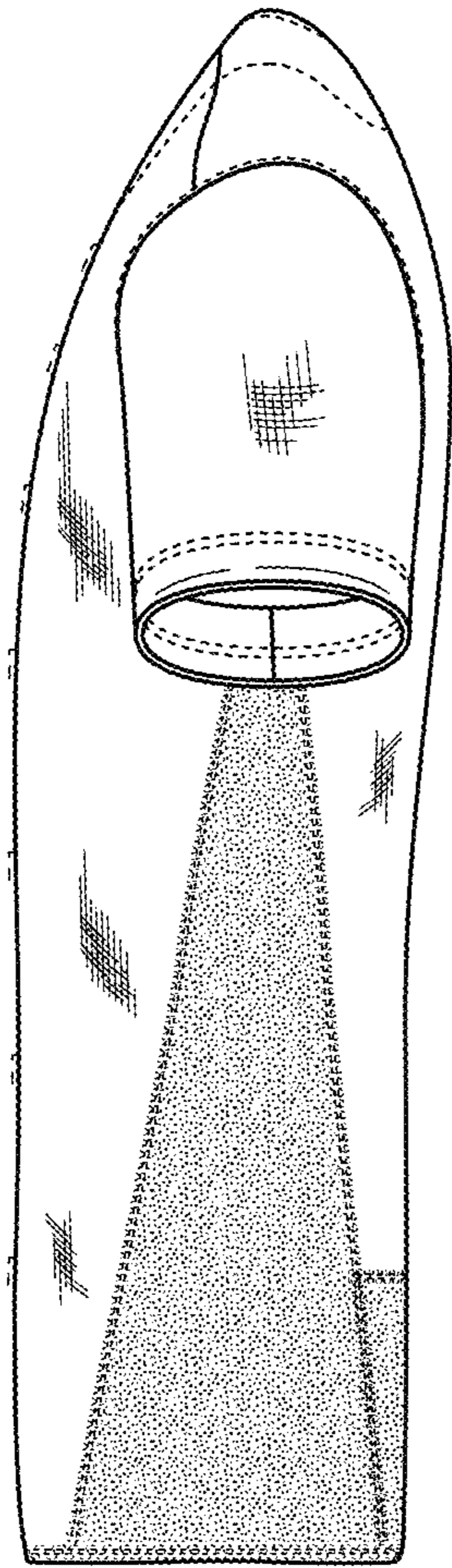

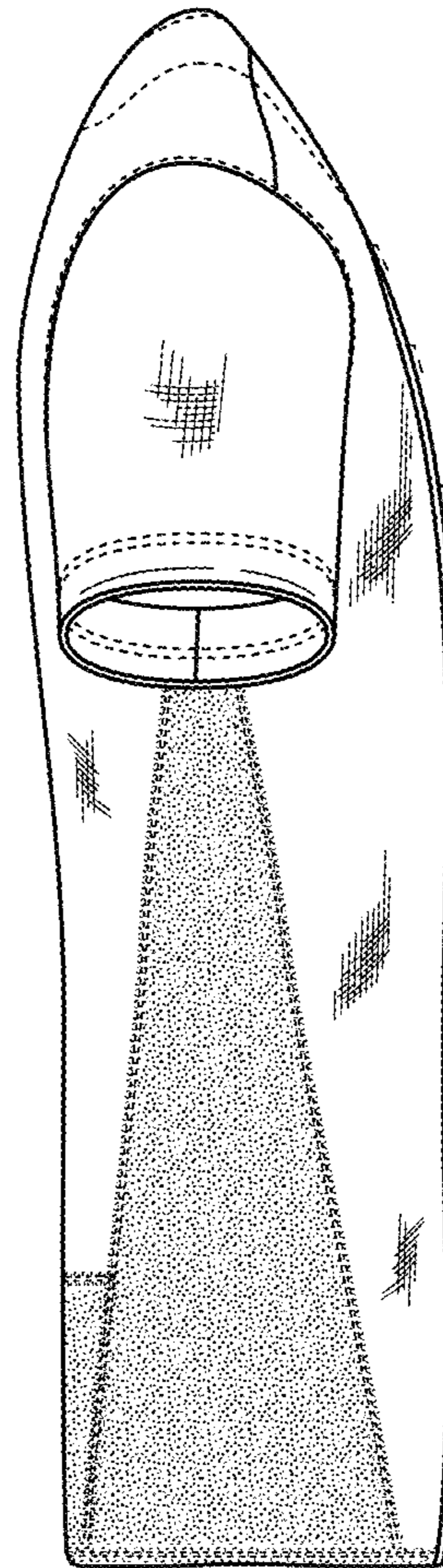

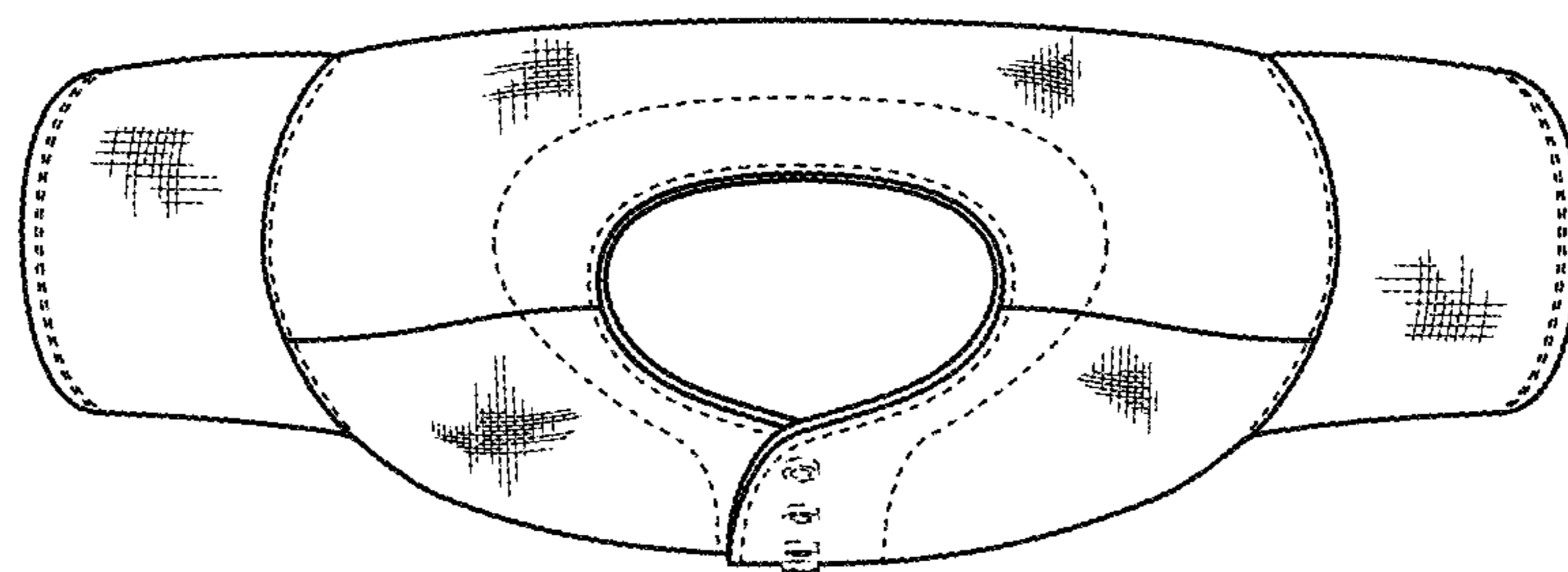
