DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of the heater dish and
wax cup of the present invention inserted in a wax melting
system.

FIG. 2 is a top, front perspective view of the heater dish and
wax cup shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a bottom, front left side perspective view of the
heater dish and wax cup shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the heater dish and wax cup shown
in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the heater dish and wax cup shown
in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the heater dish and wax
cup shown in FIG. 1, the rear view being a mirror image
thereof.

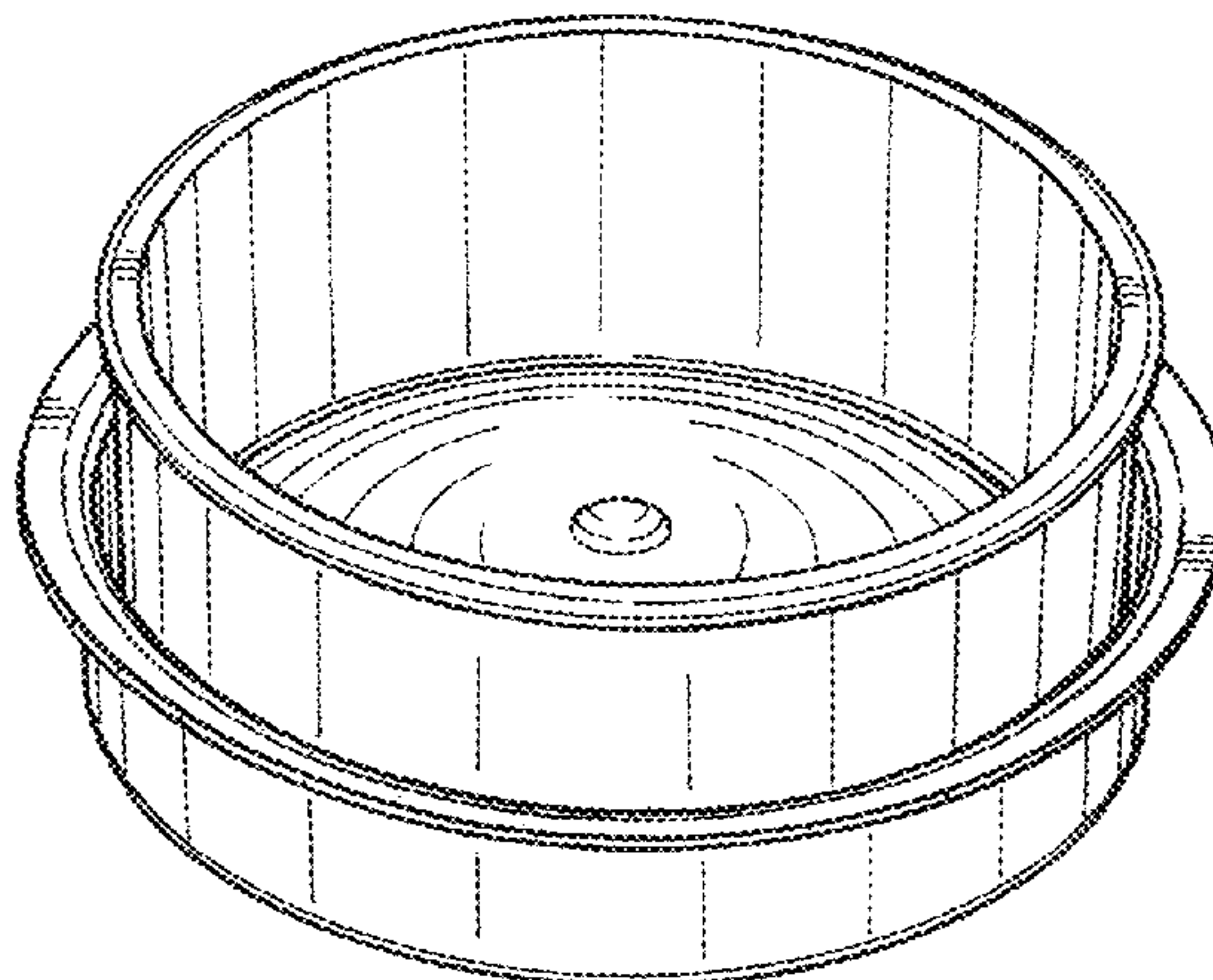
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of the heater dish and wax

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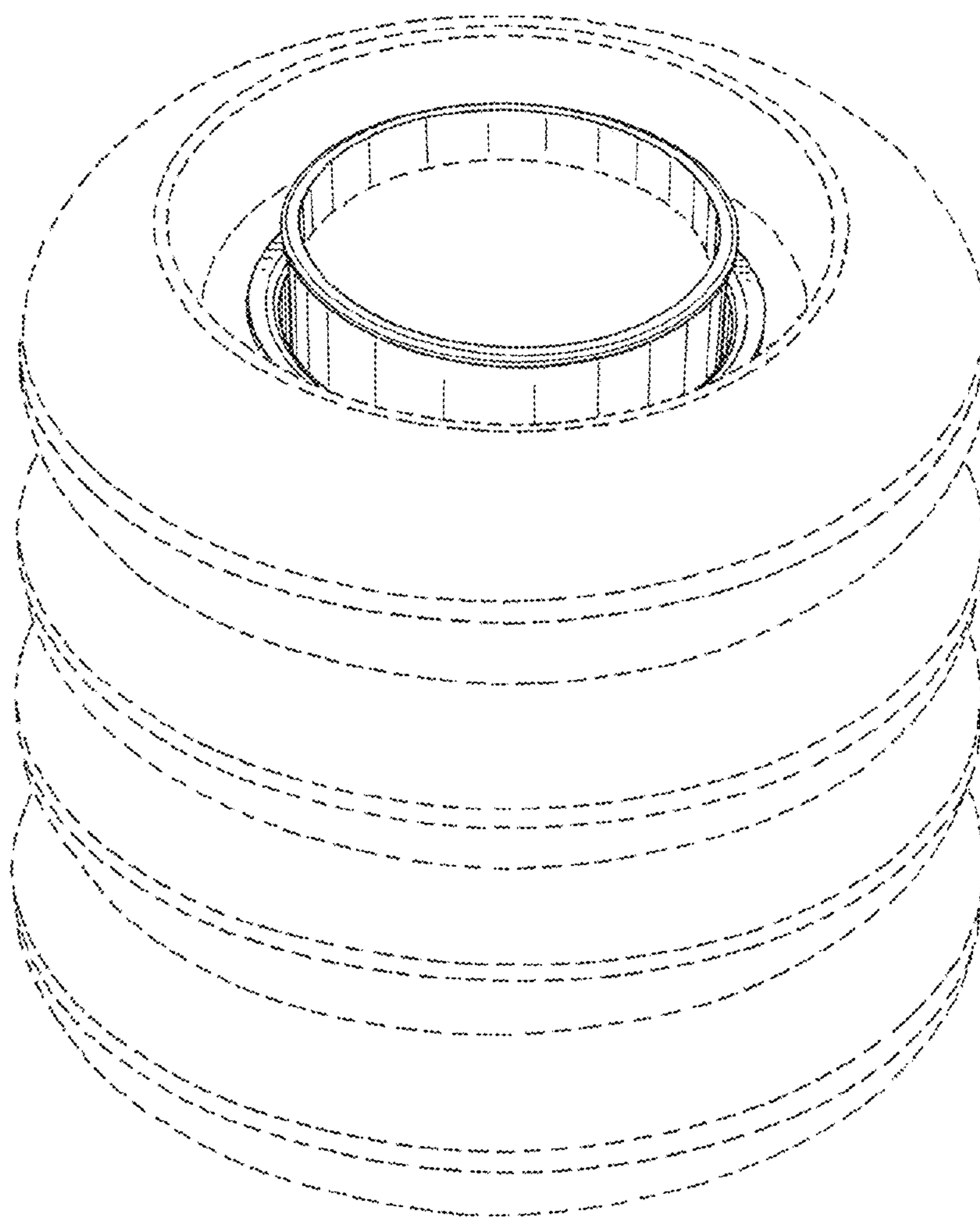

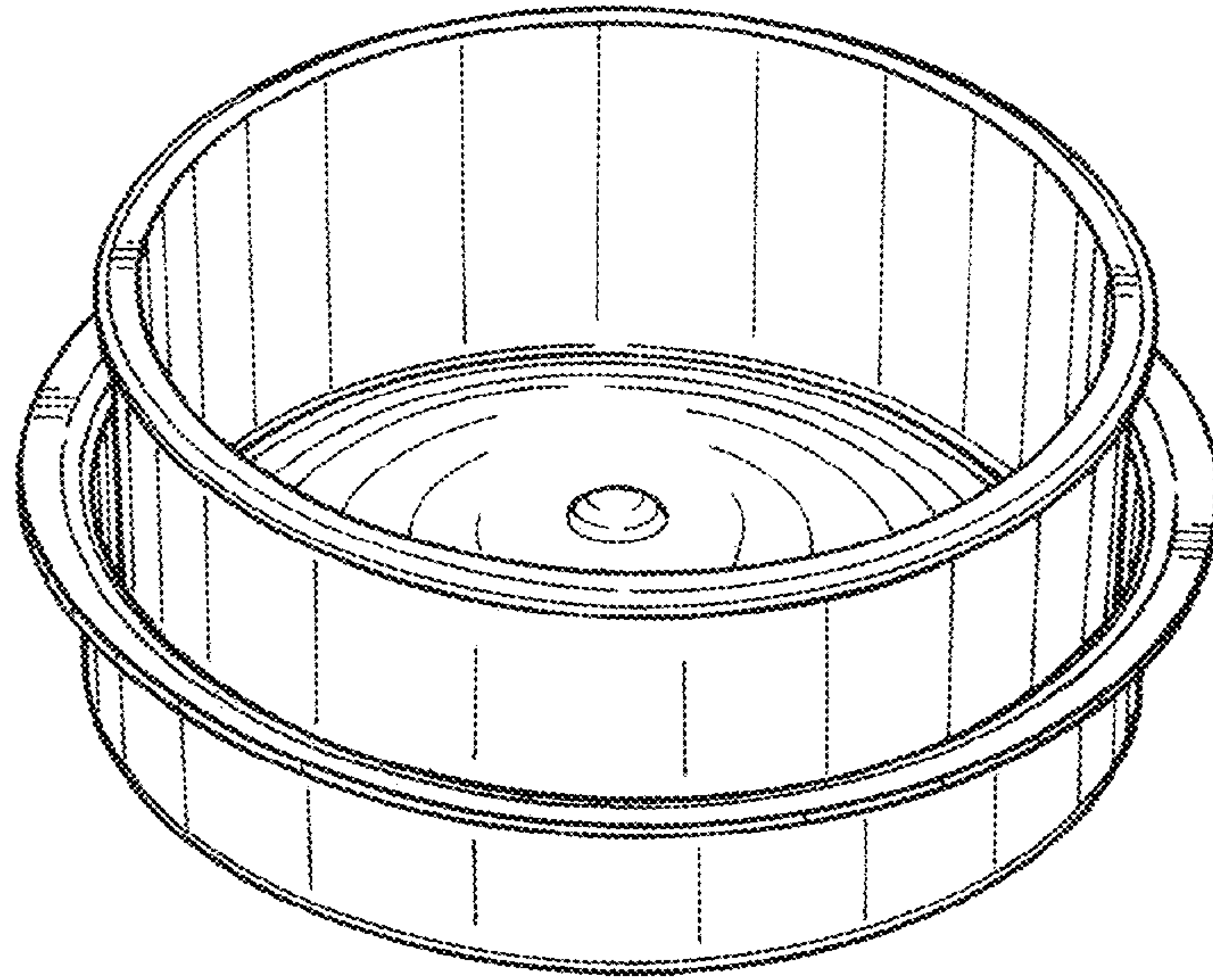

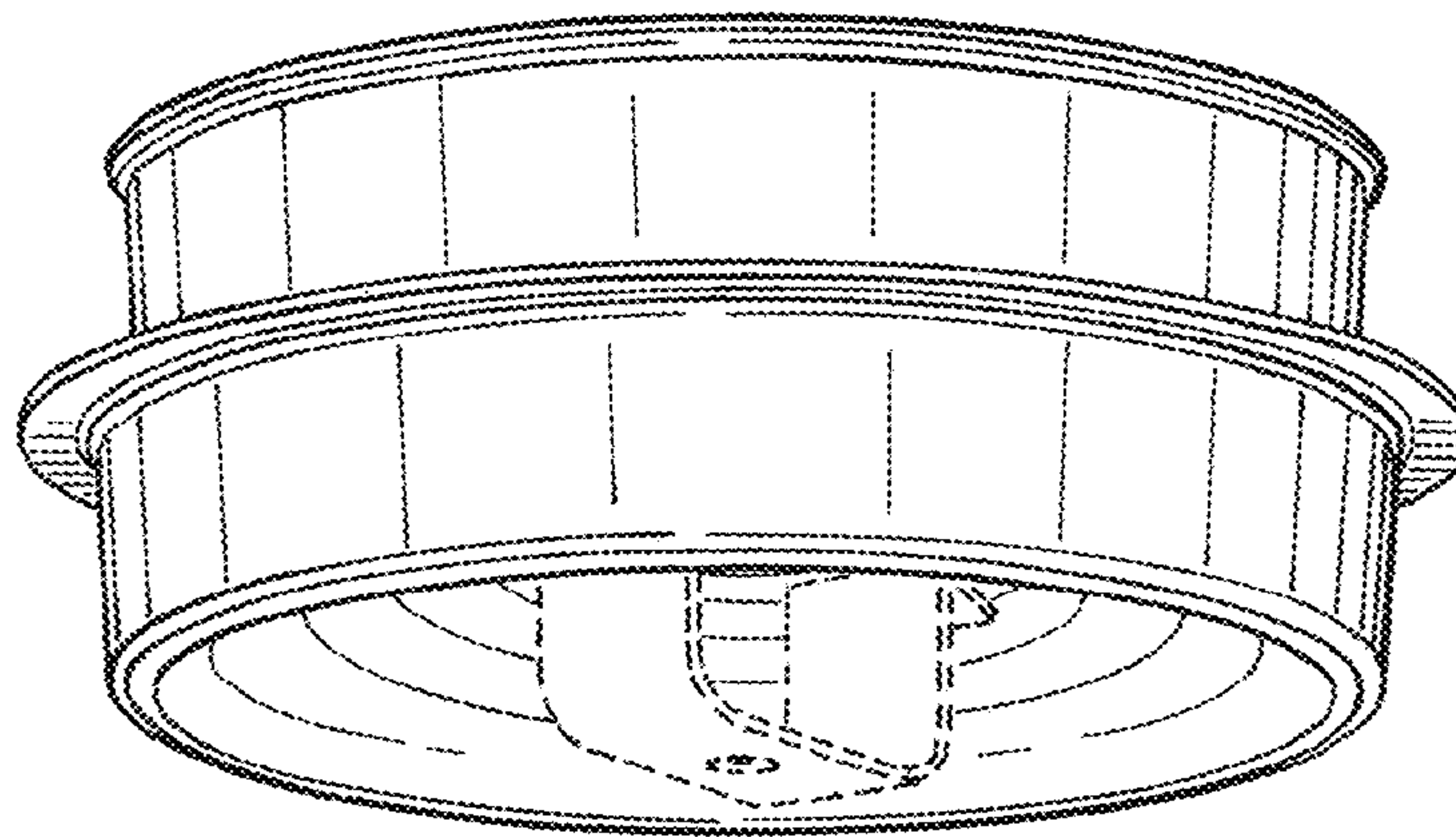

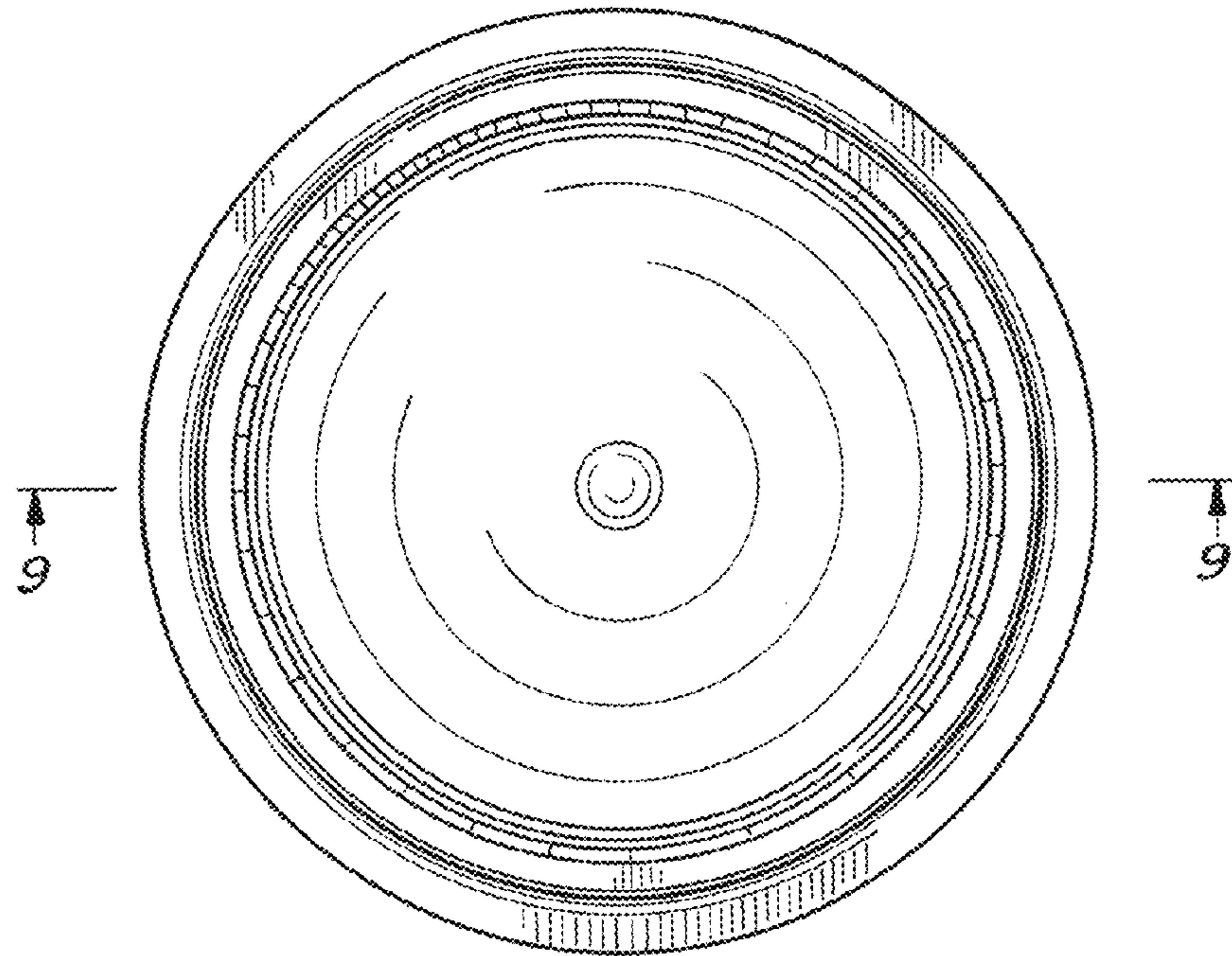

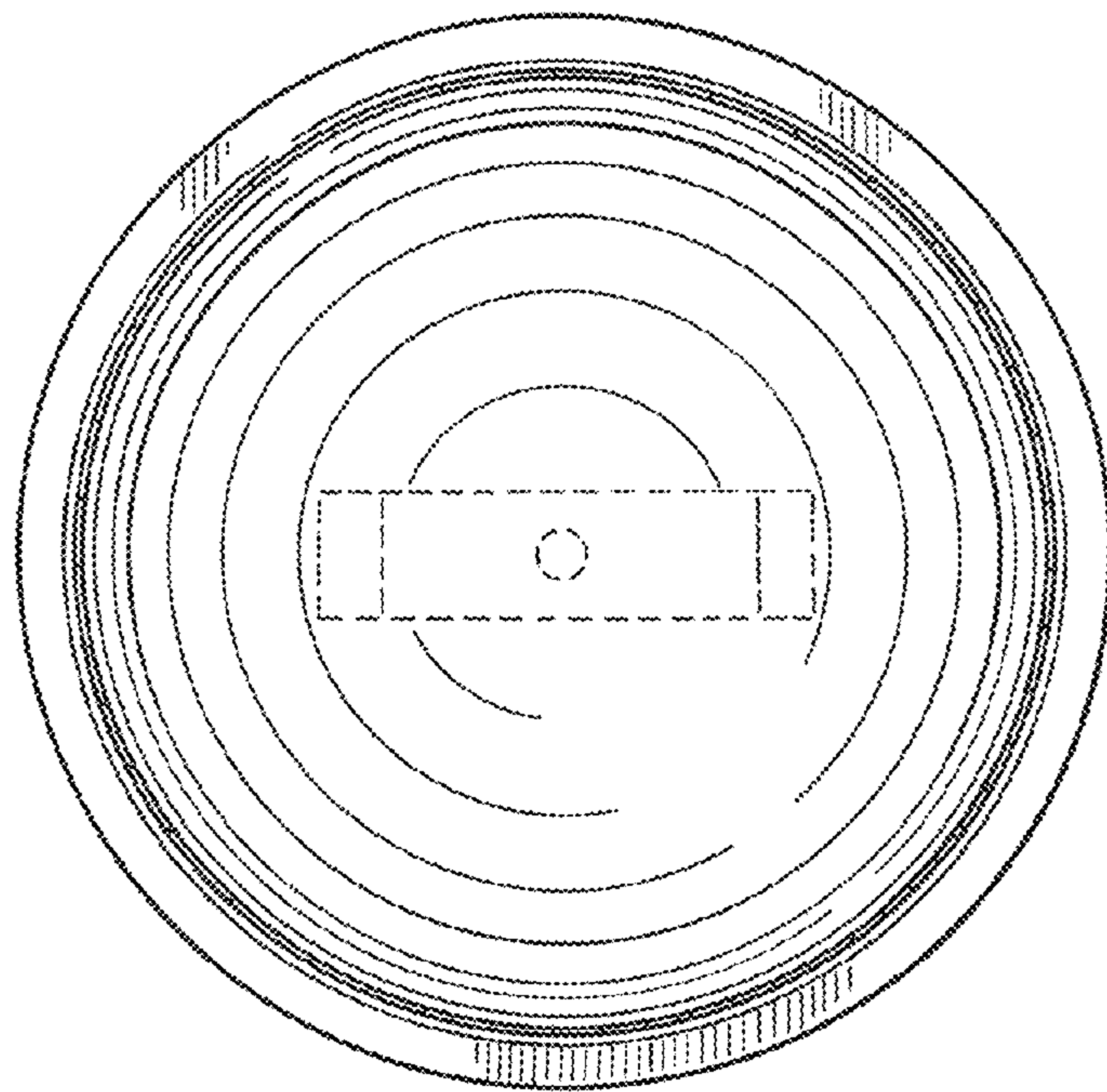

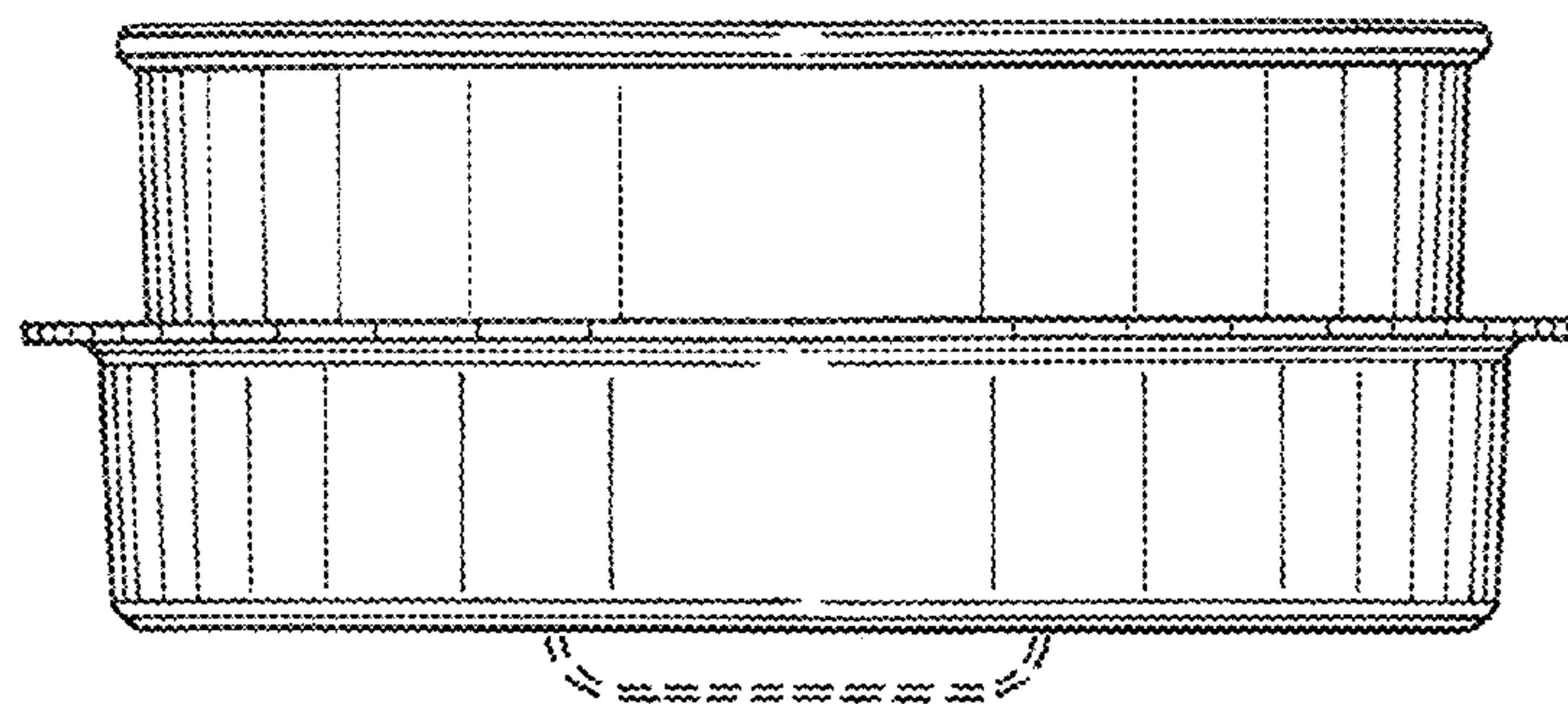

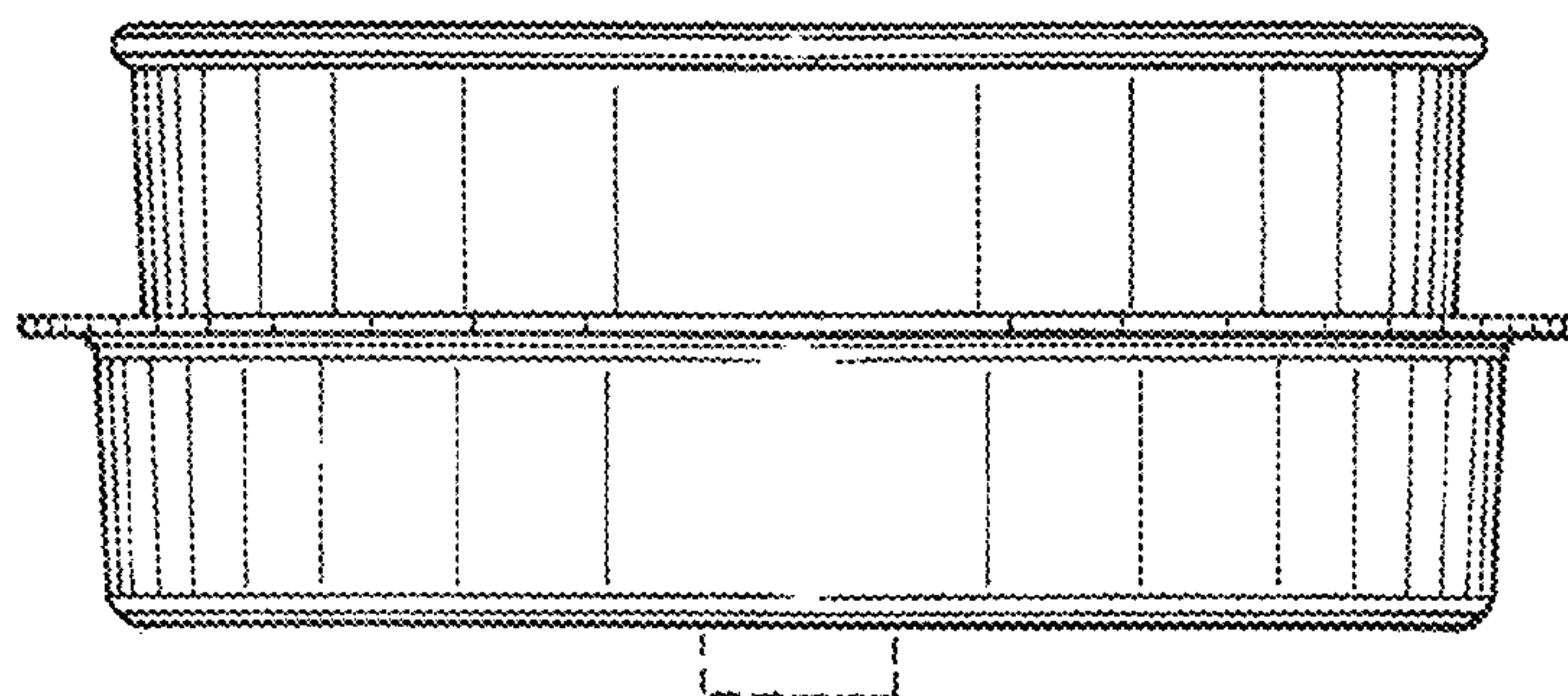

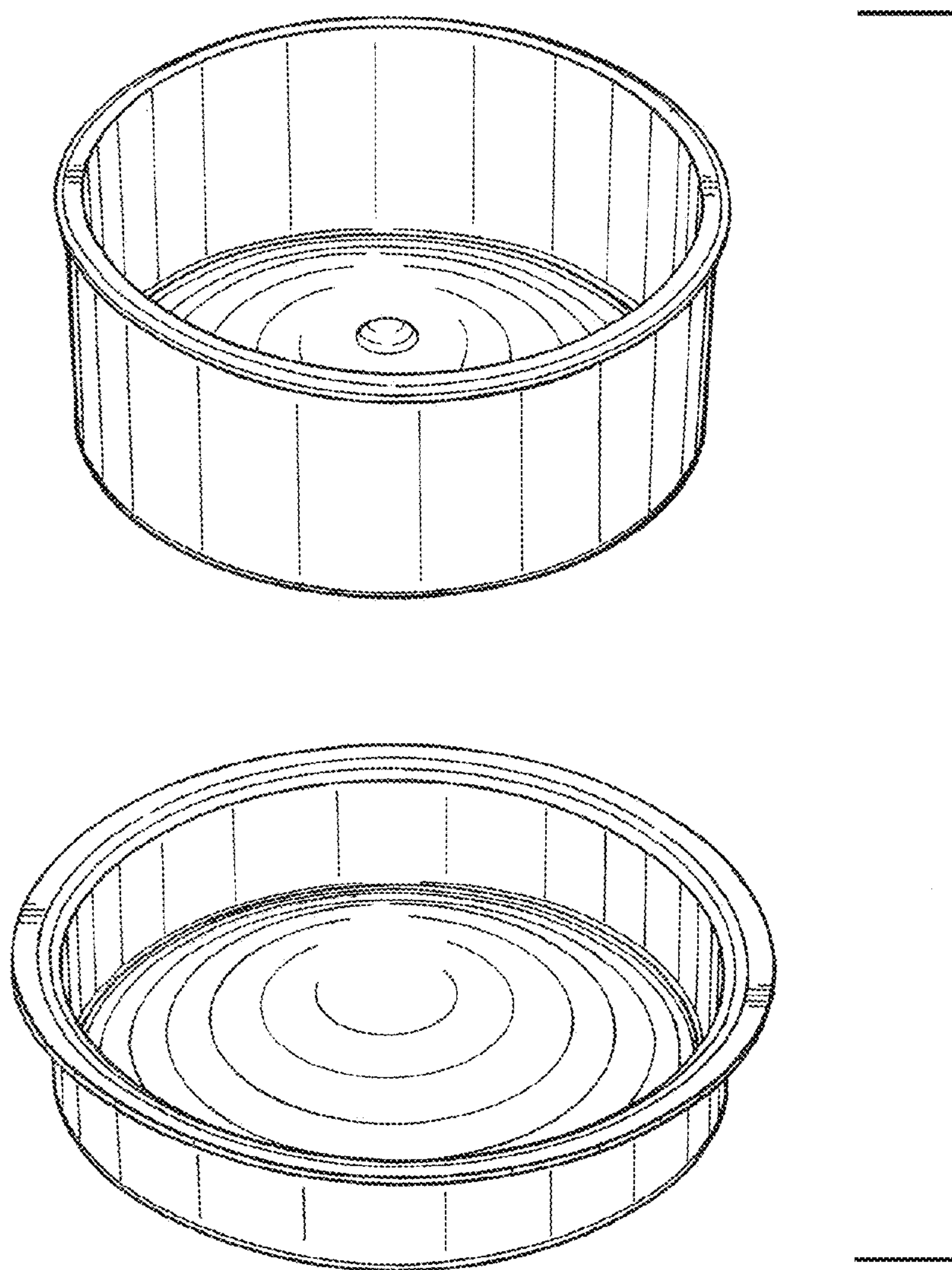

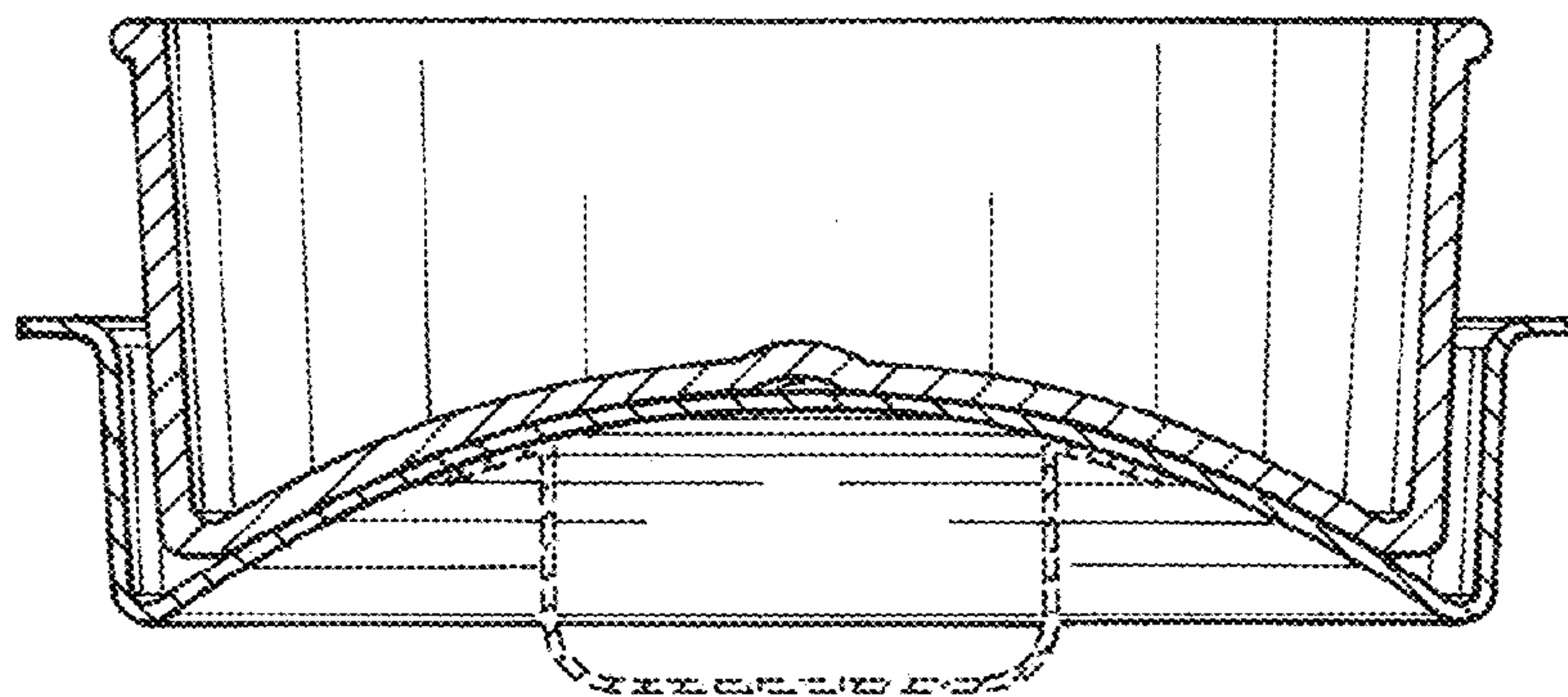
