(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a financial services store, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a financial services store including three stations with each access door being open.

FIG. 2 is another perspective view of the financial services store of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the financial services store of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is another perspective view of the financial services store of FIG. 1 with each access door being closed.

FIG. 5 is another perspective view of the financial services store of FIG. 4.

FIG. 6 is a front view of the financial services store of FIG. 4.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a financial services store including a single station with the access door being open.

FIG. 8 is another perspective view of the financial services store of FIG. 7.

FIG. 9 is a front view of the financial services store of FIG. 7.

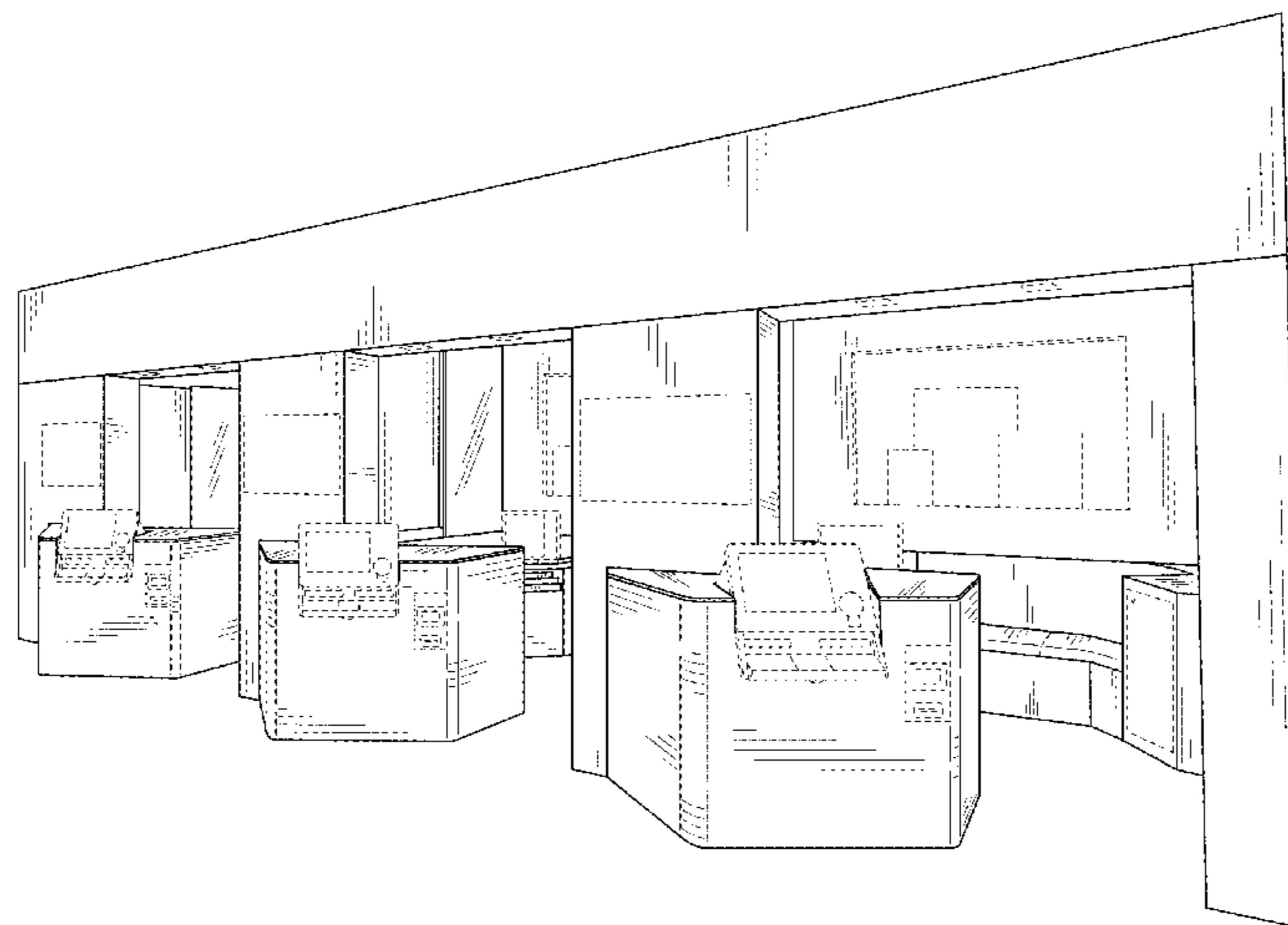
FIG. 10 is another perspective view of the financial services store of FIG. 7 with the access door being closed.

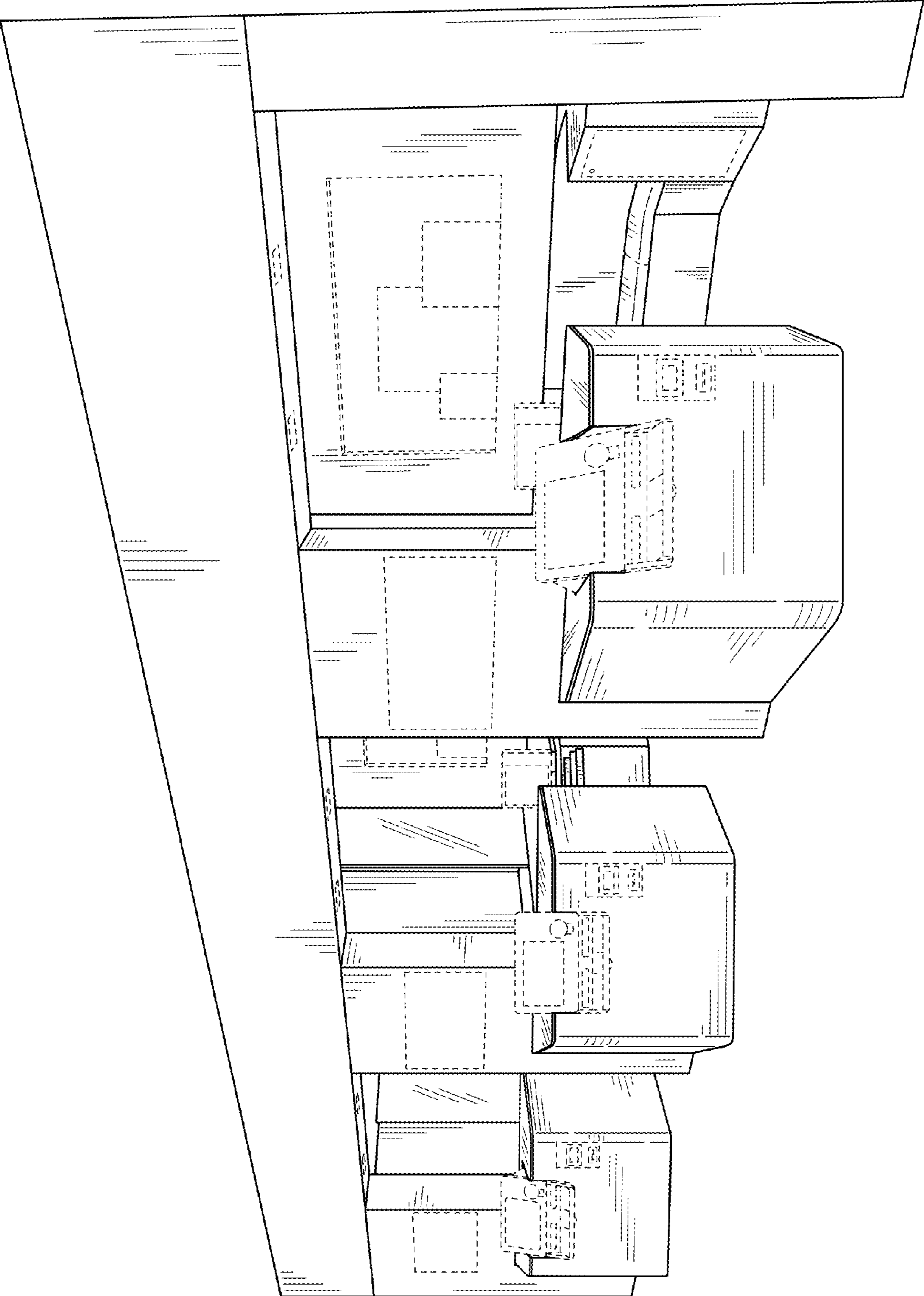

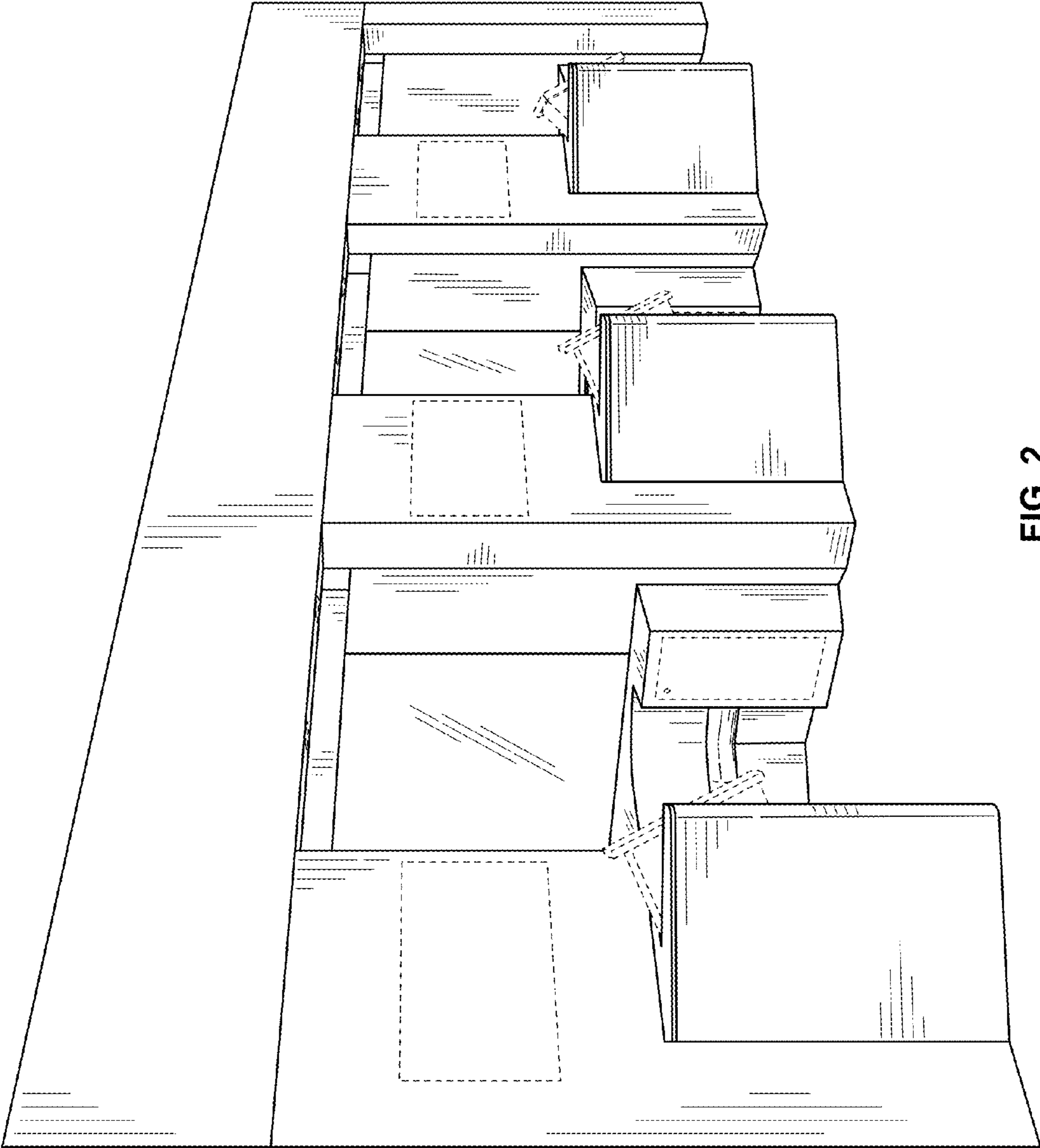

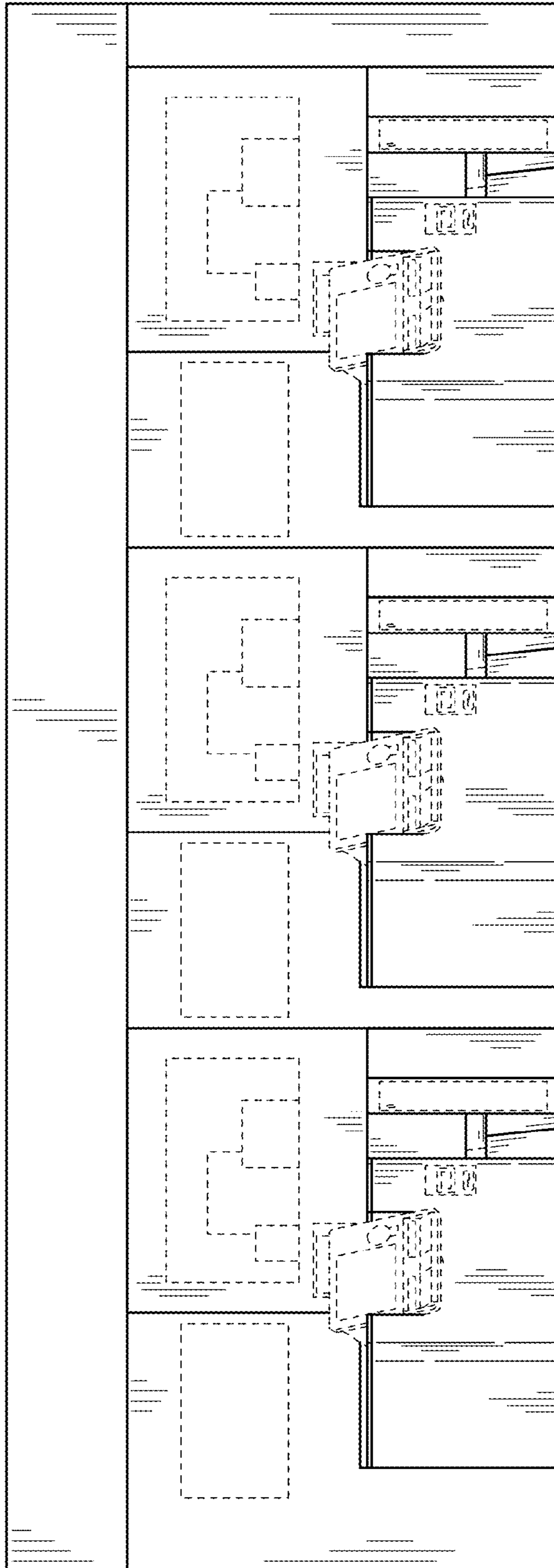

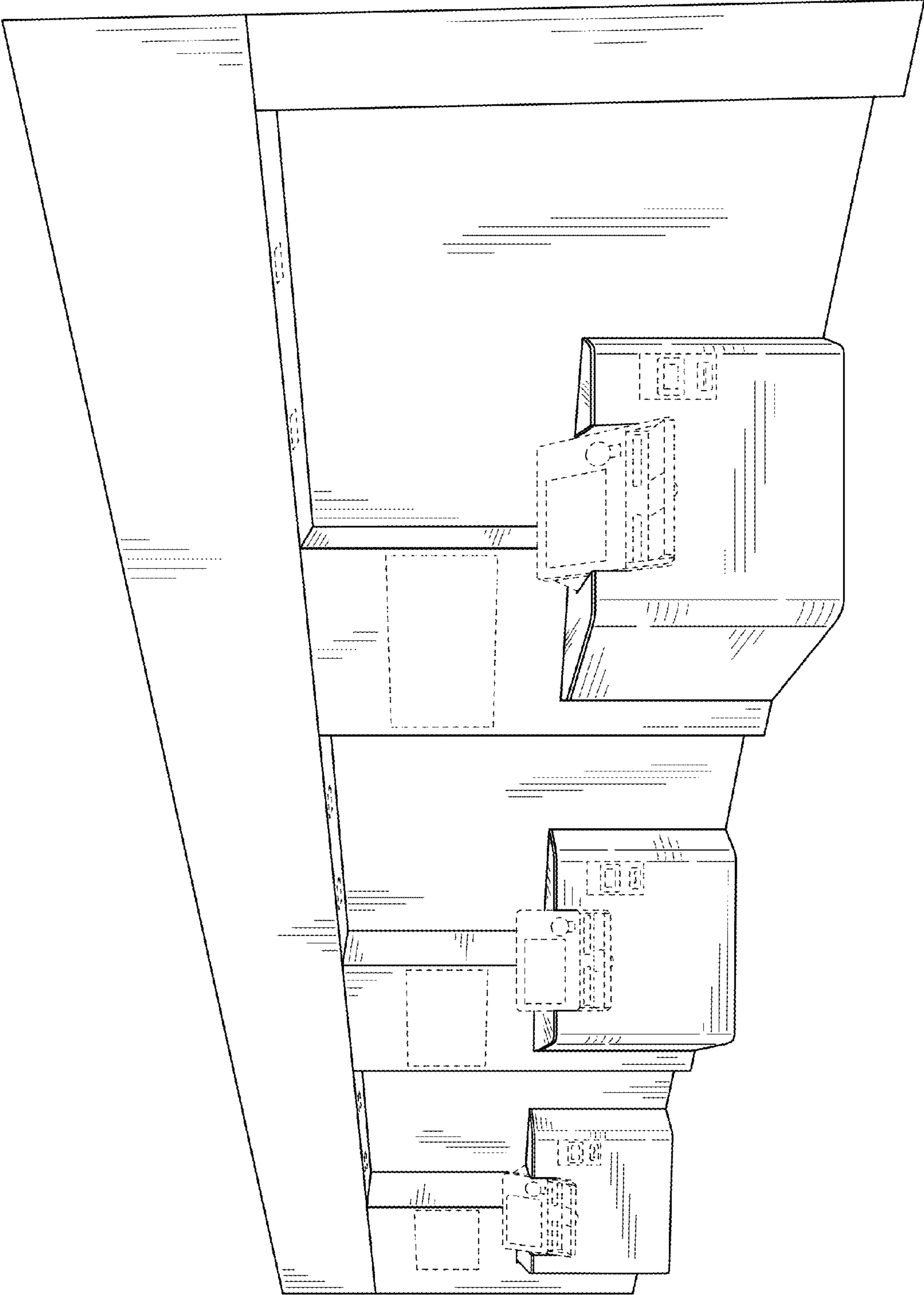

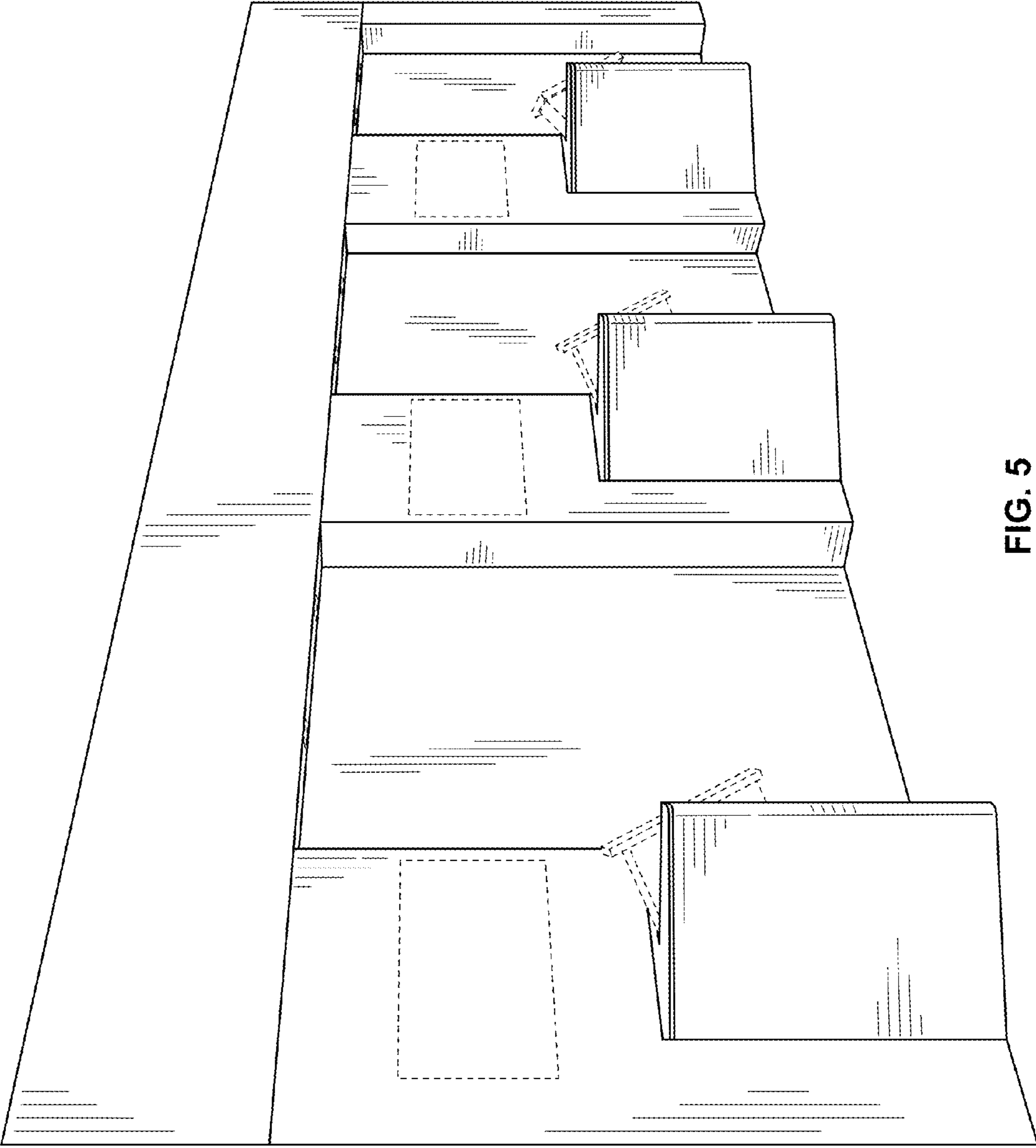

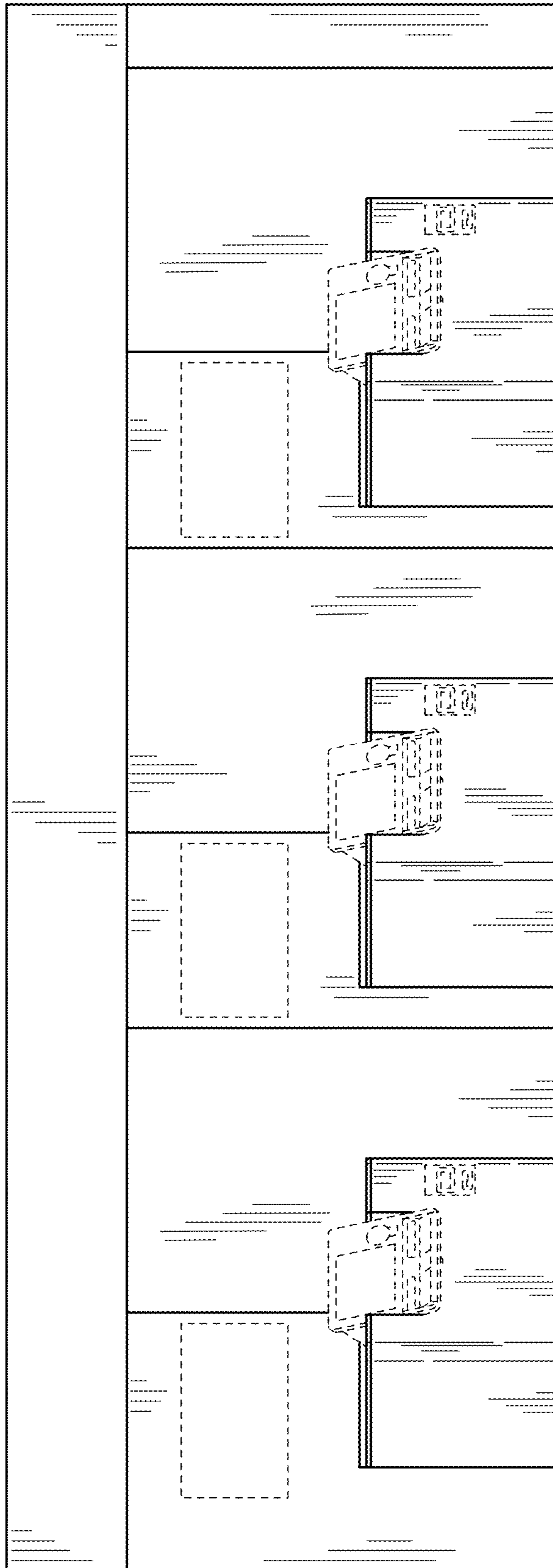

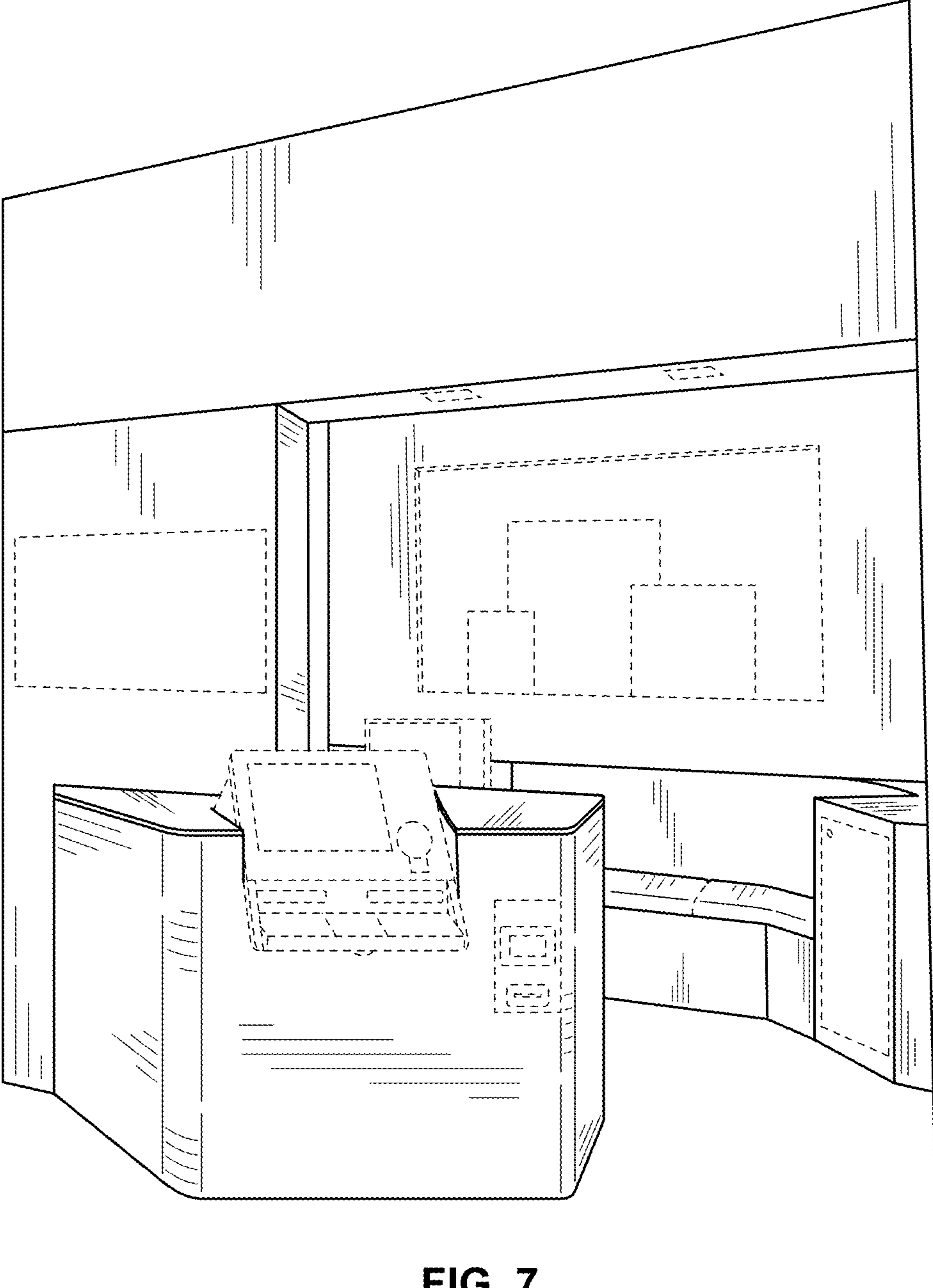

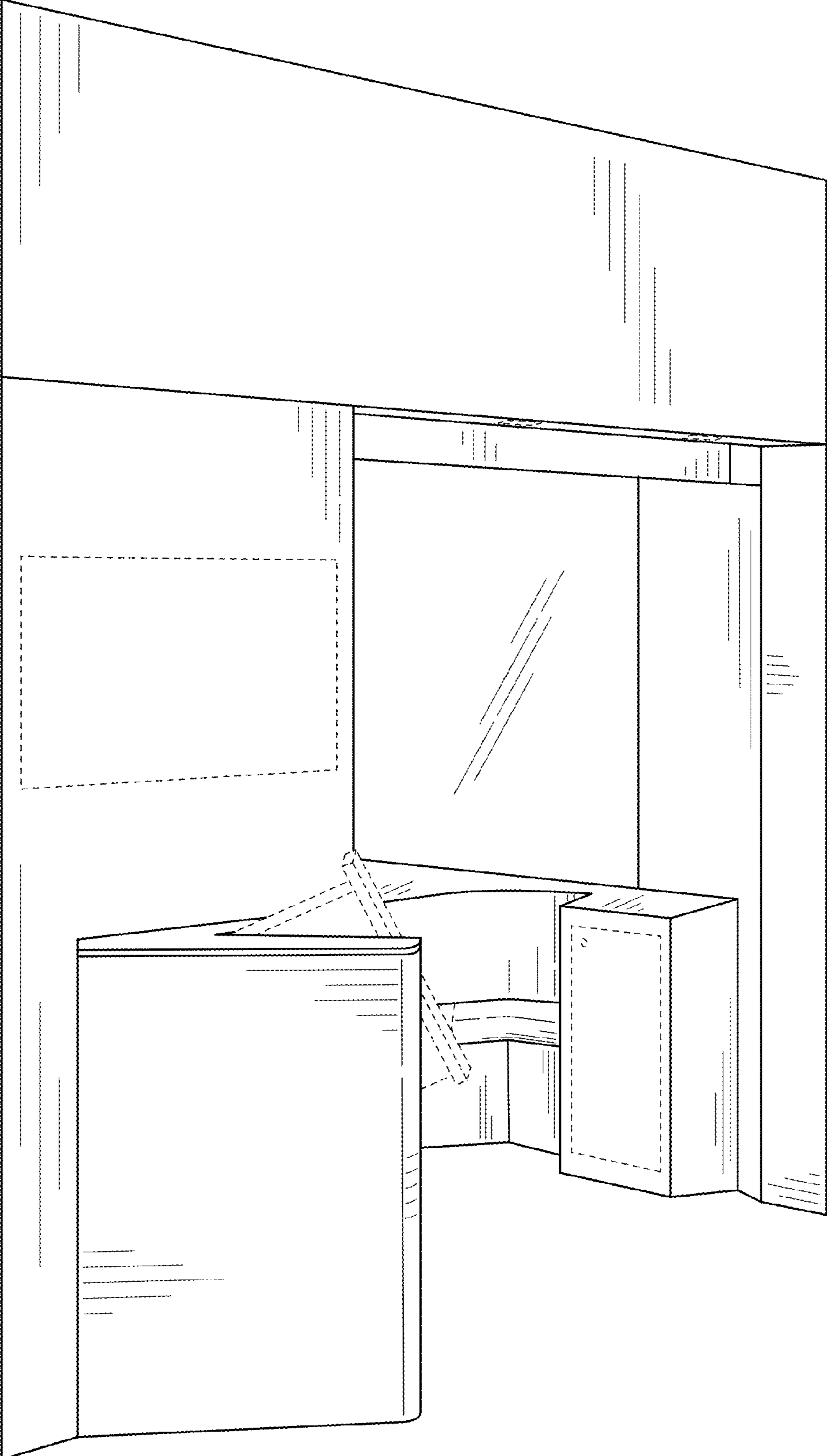

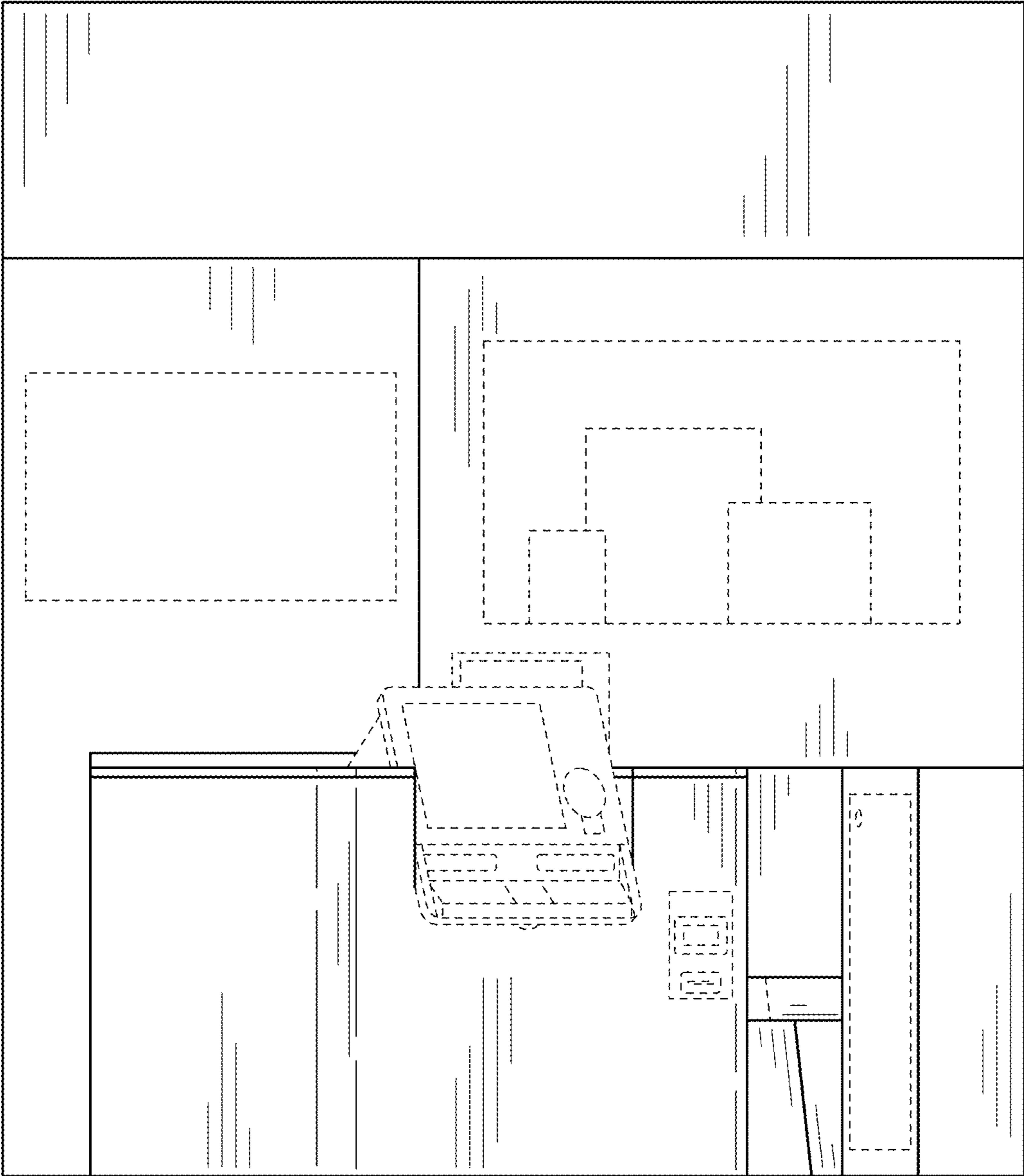

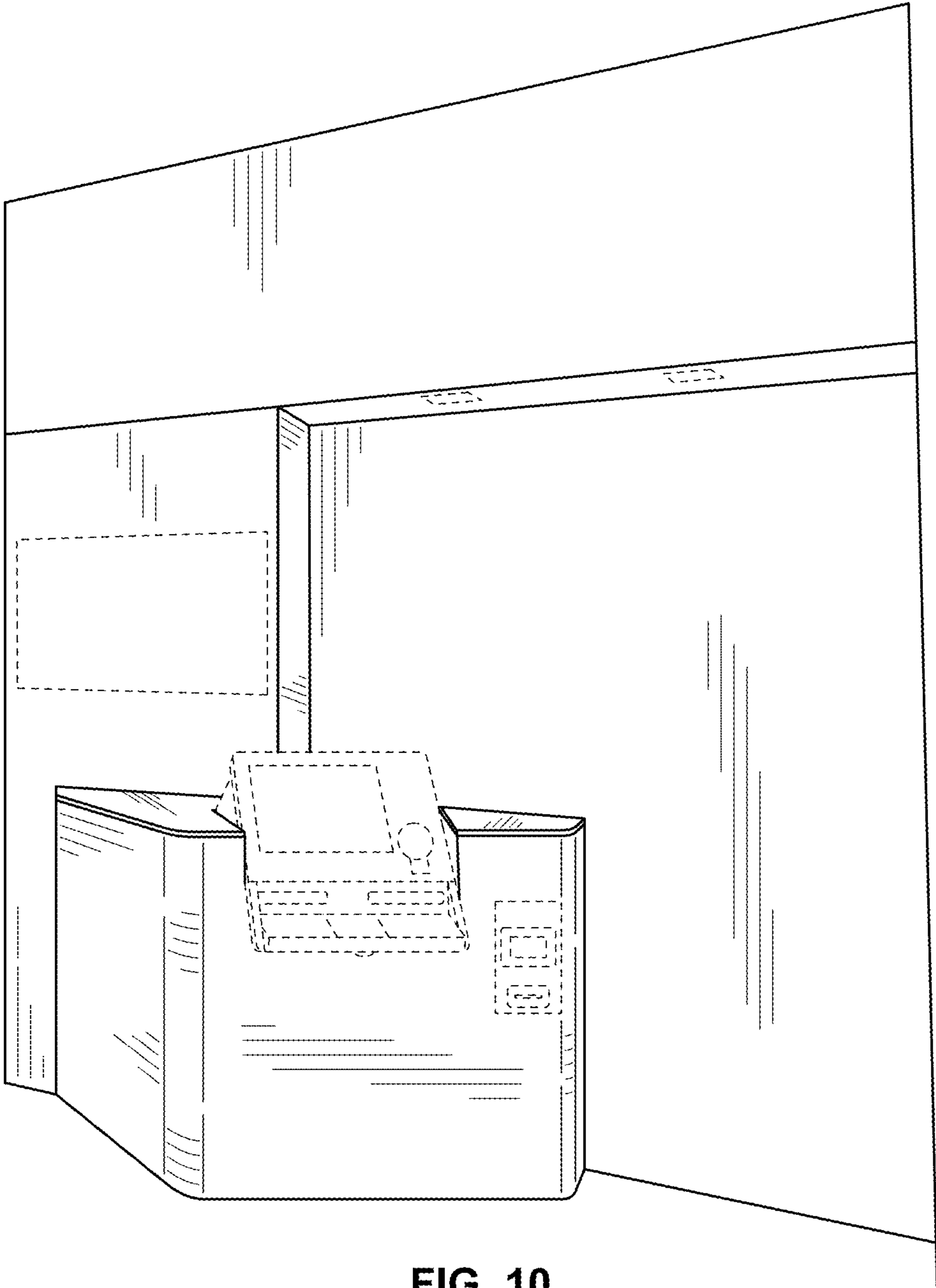

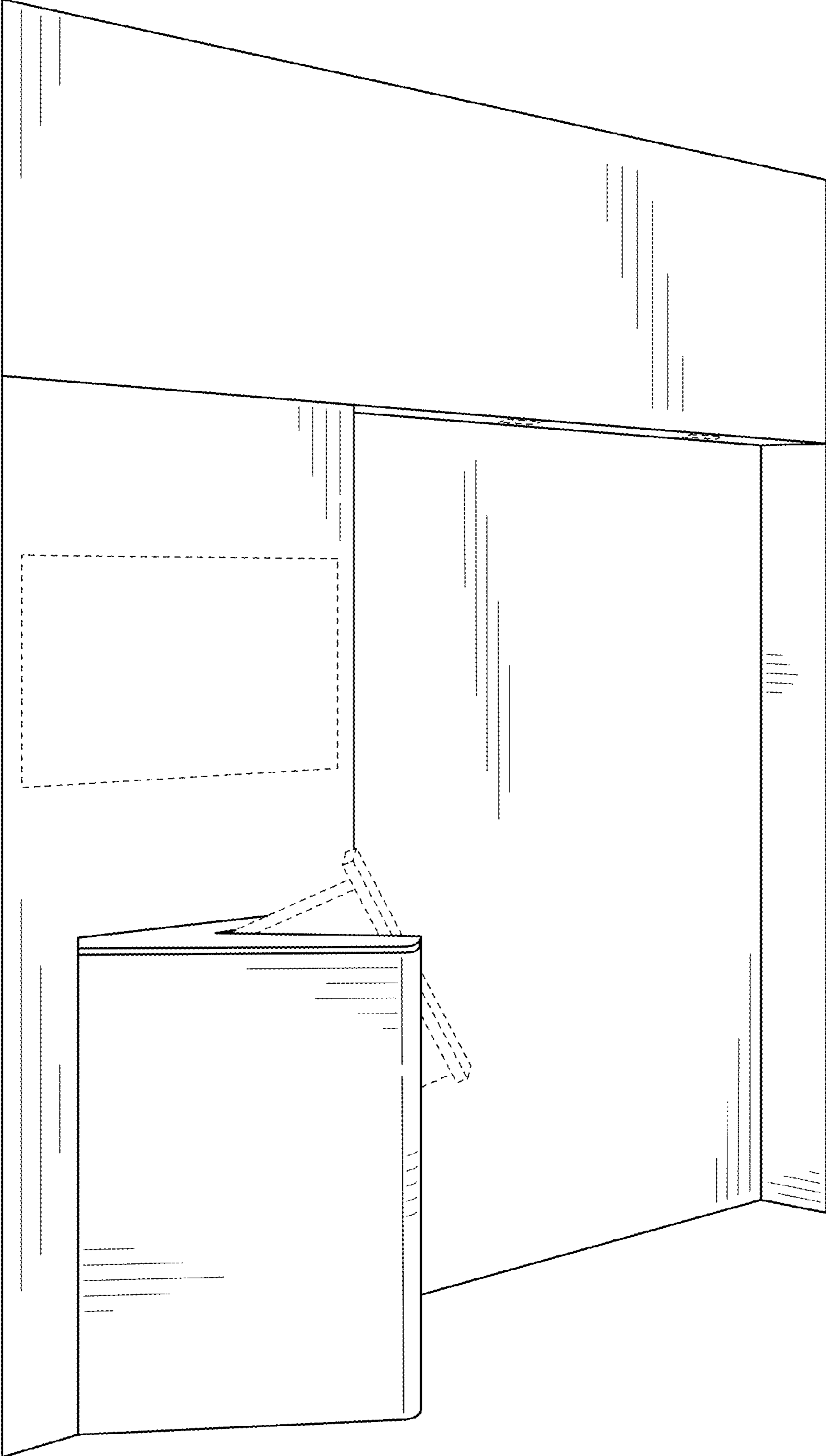

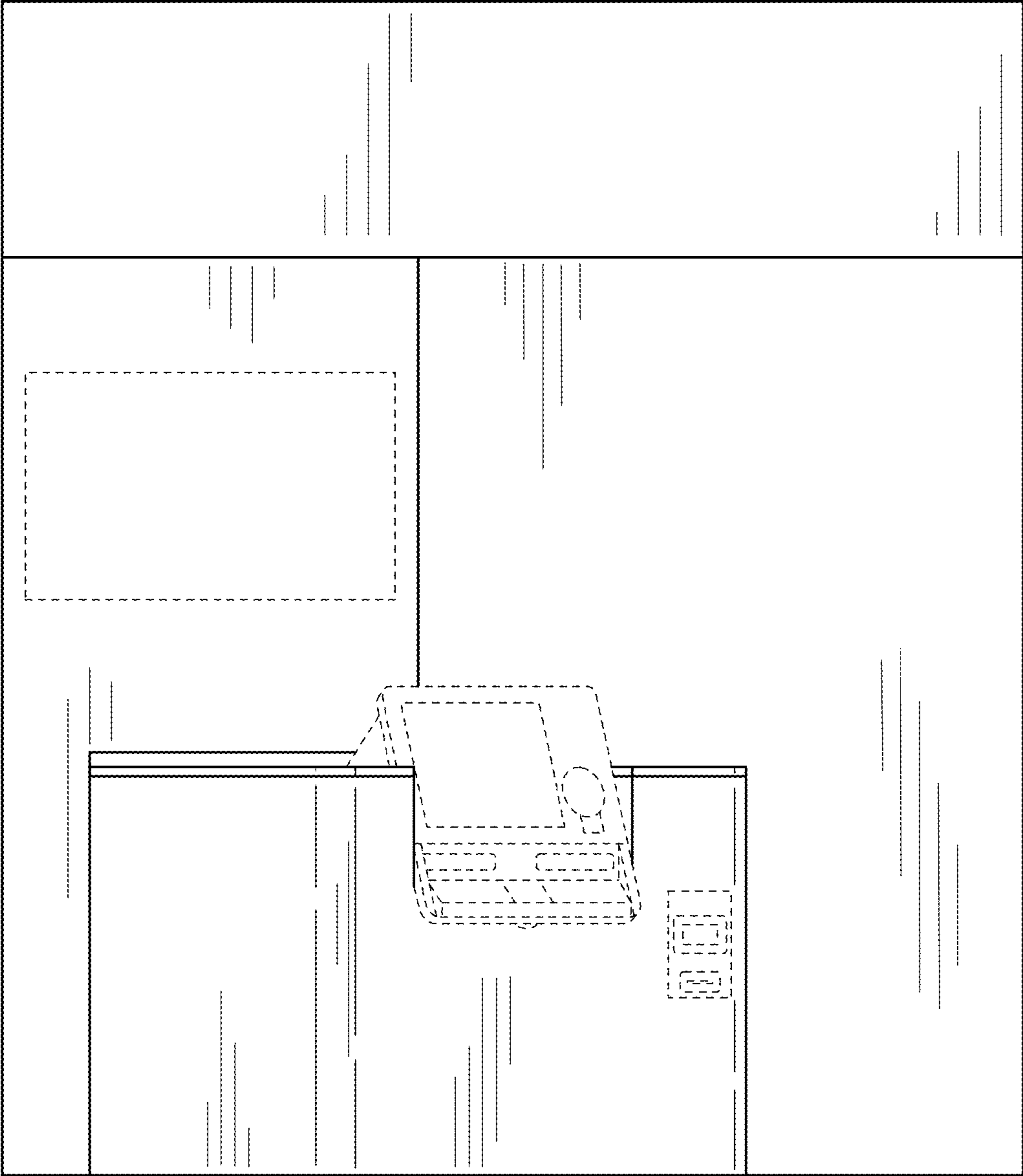
