FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;

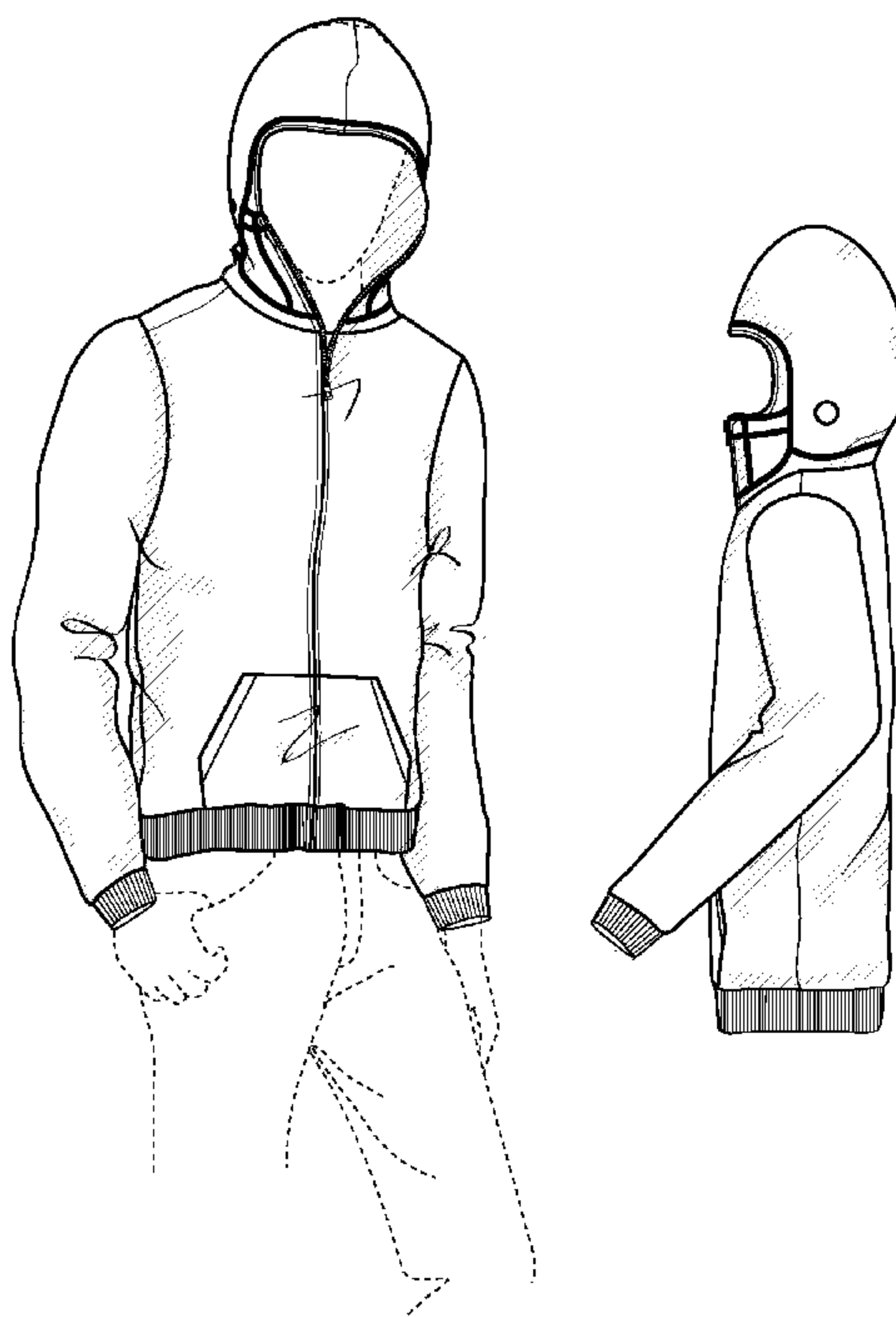
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof; the left side being a mirror image thereto;

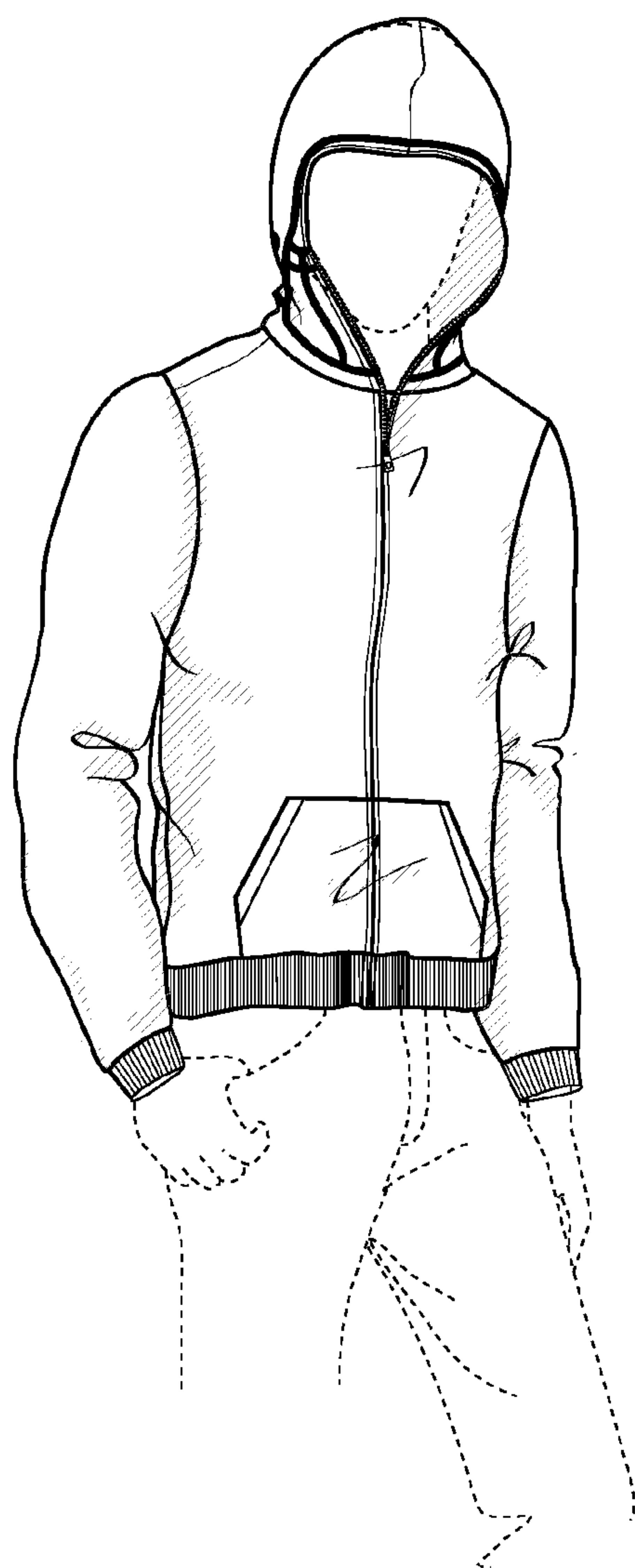

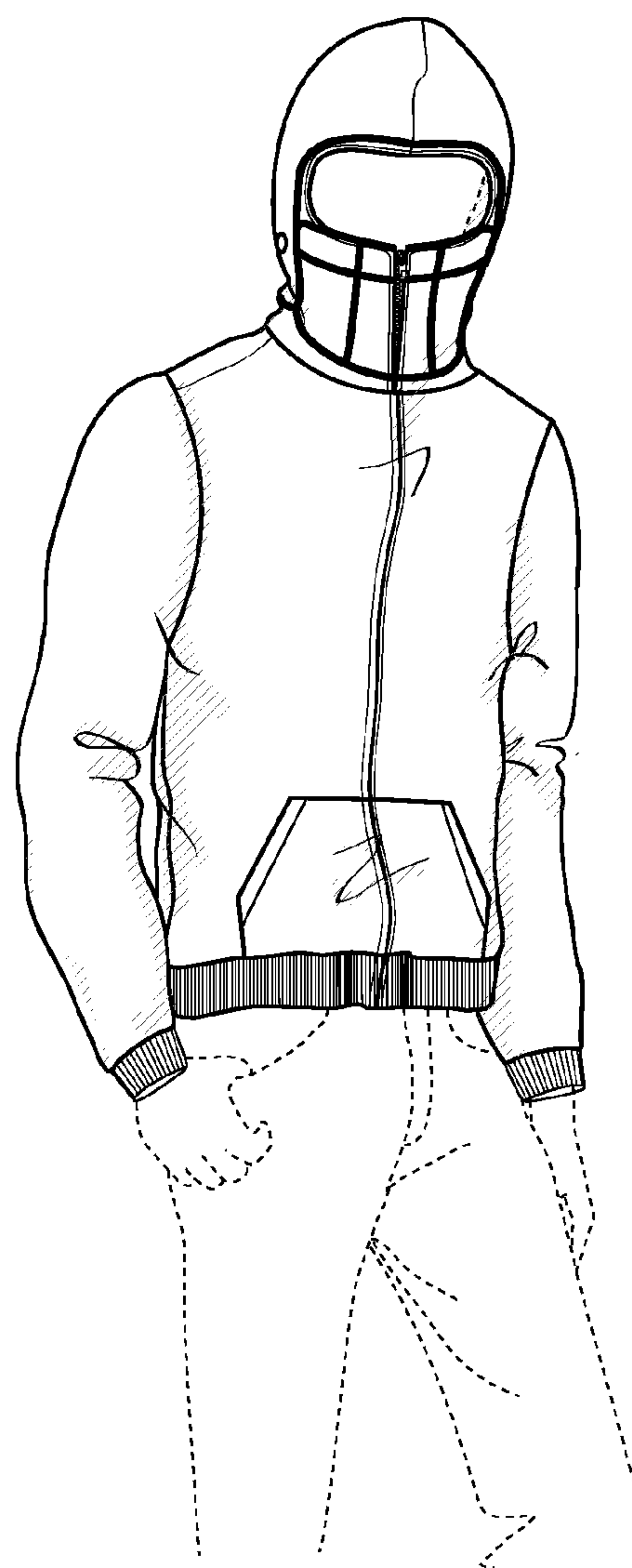

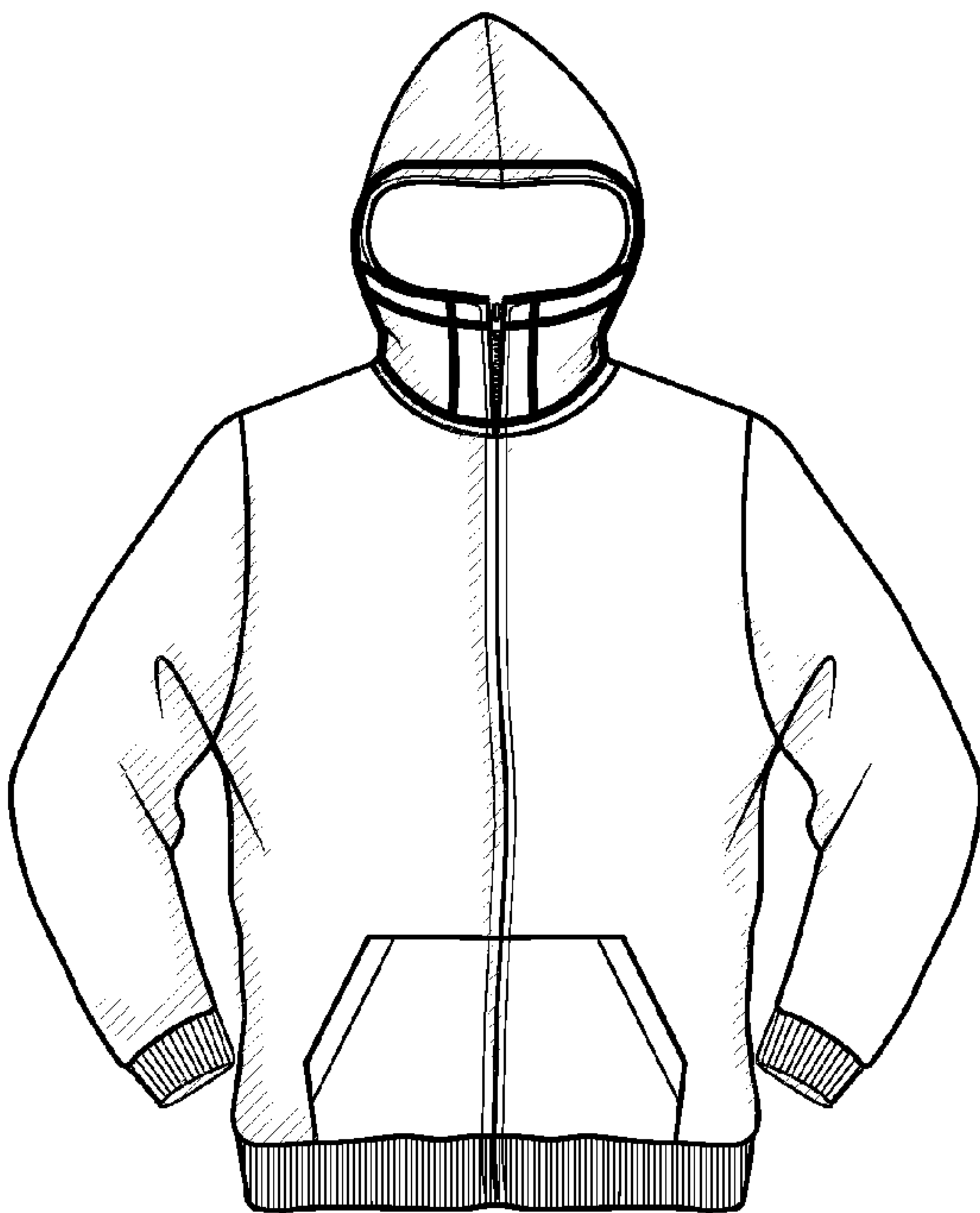

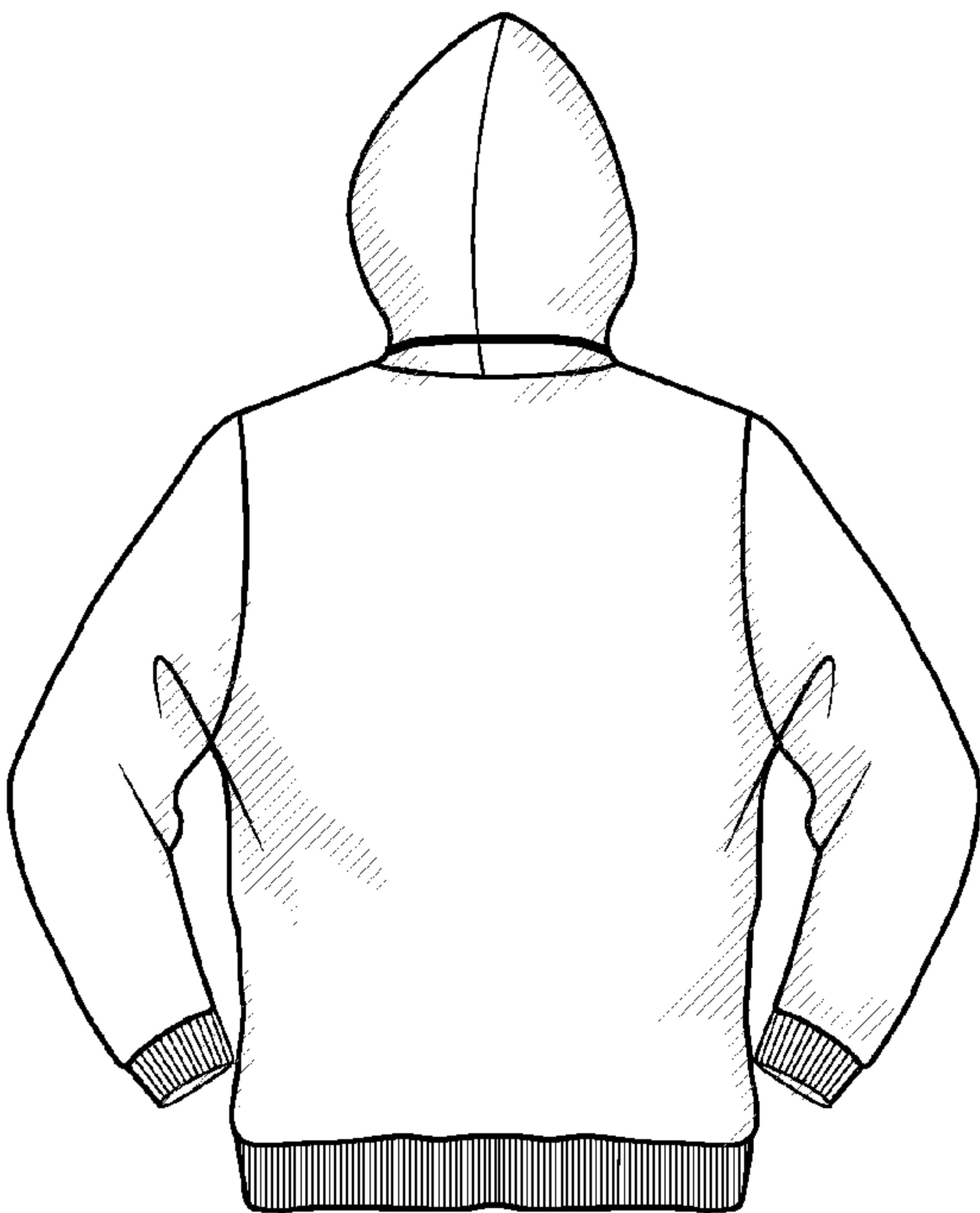

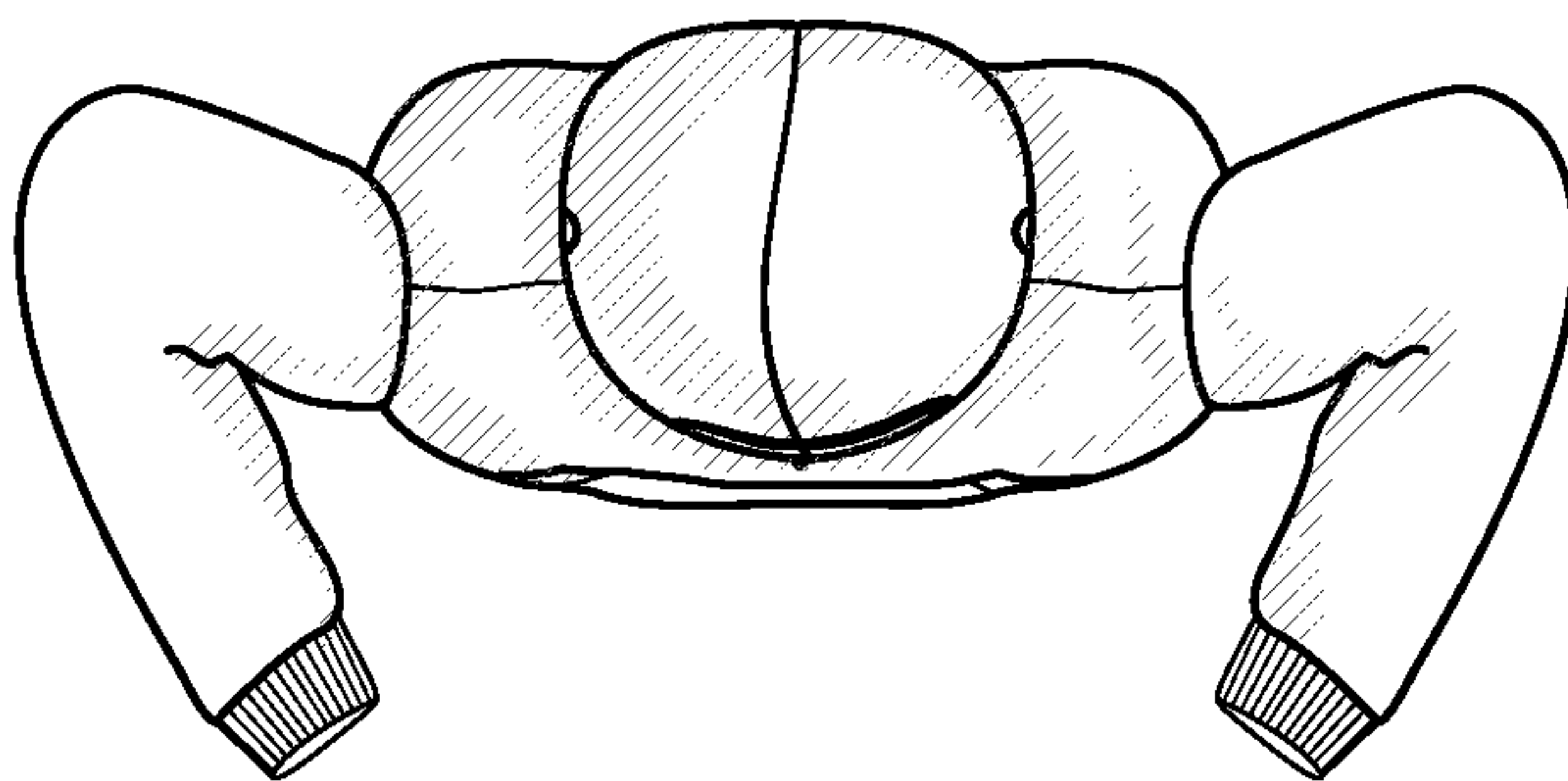

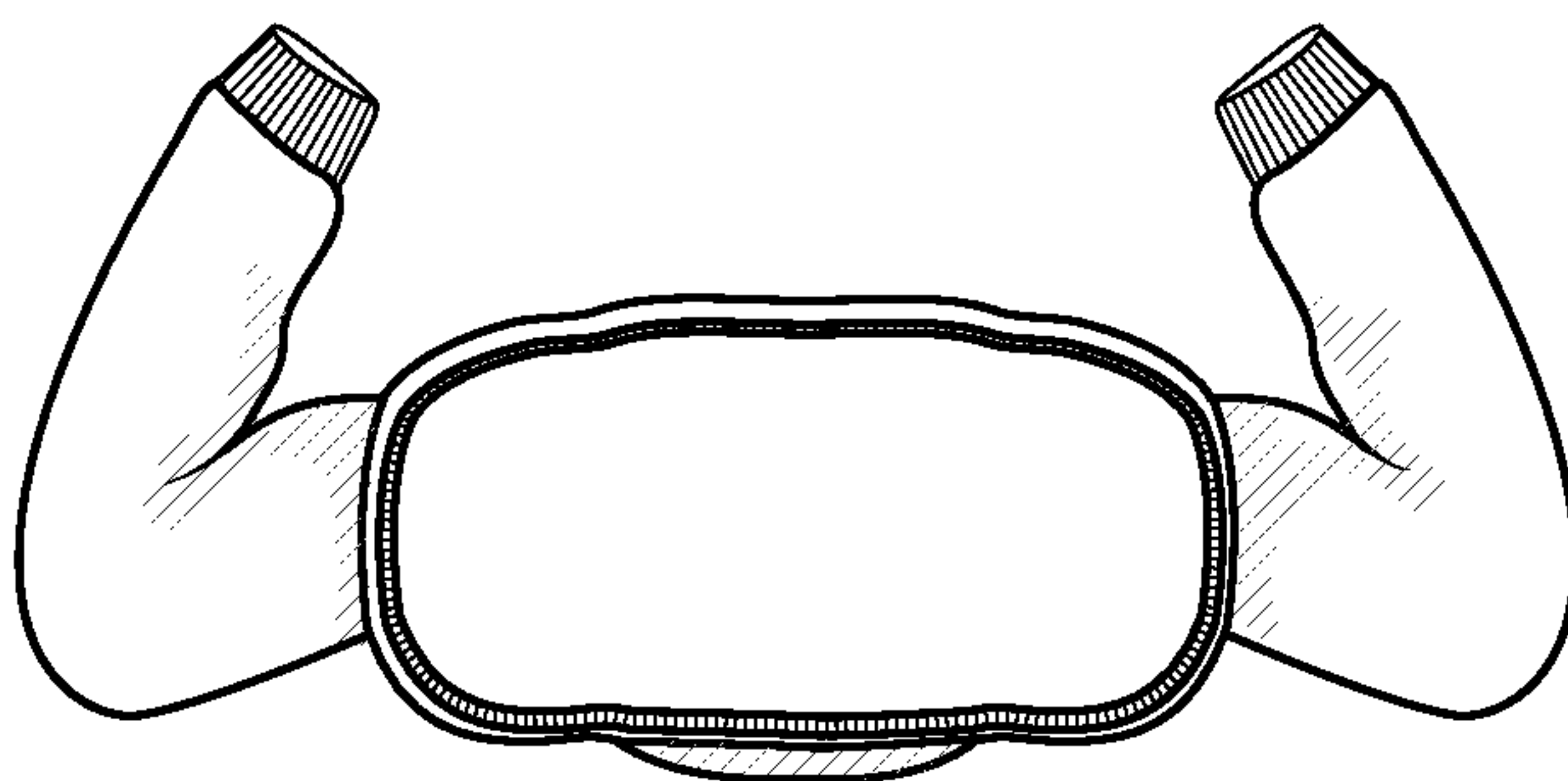
