(57) **CLAIM**

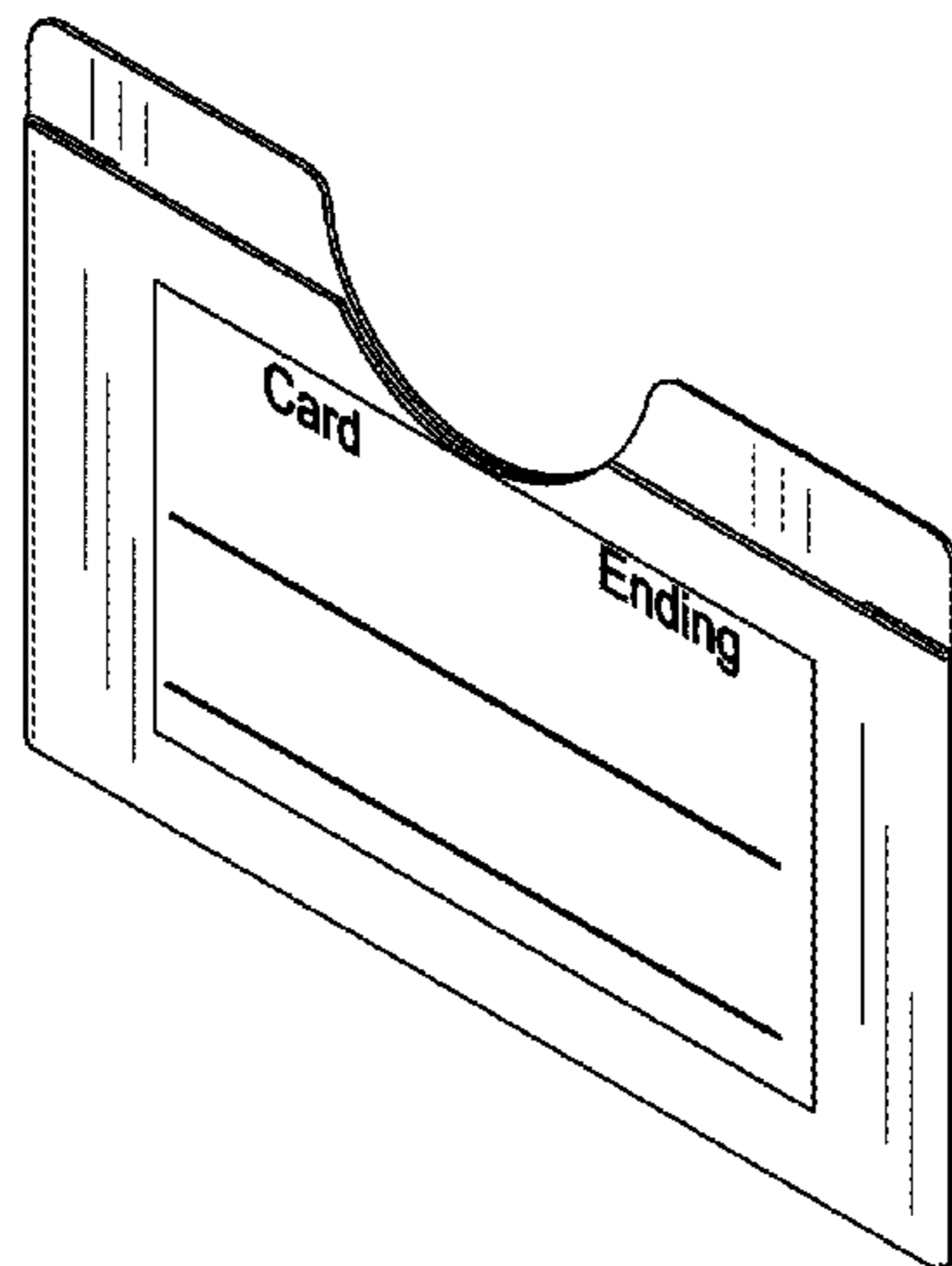
The ornamental design for a transaction card sleeve, as shown and described.

The broken lines showing stitching are for the purposes of illustrating environment and form no part of the claimed design.

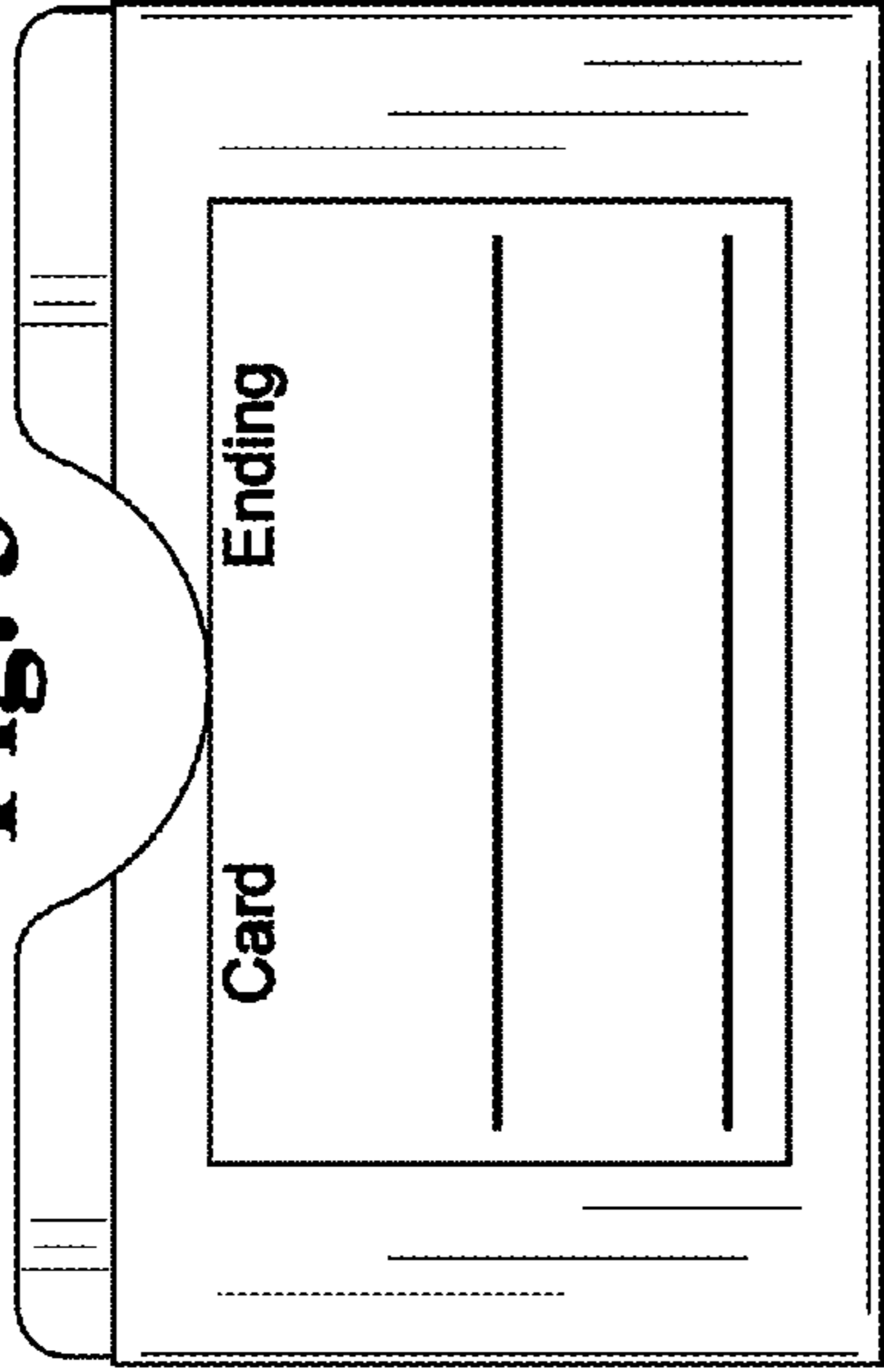

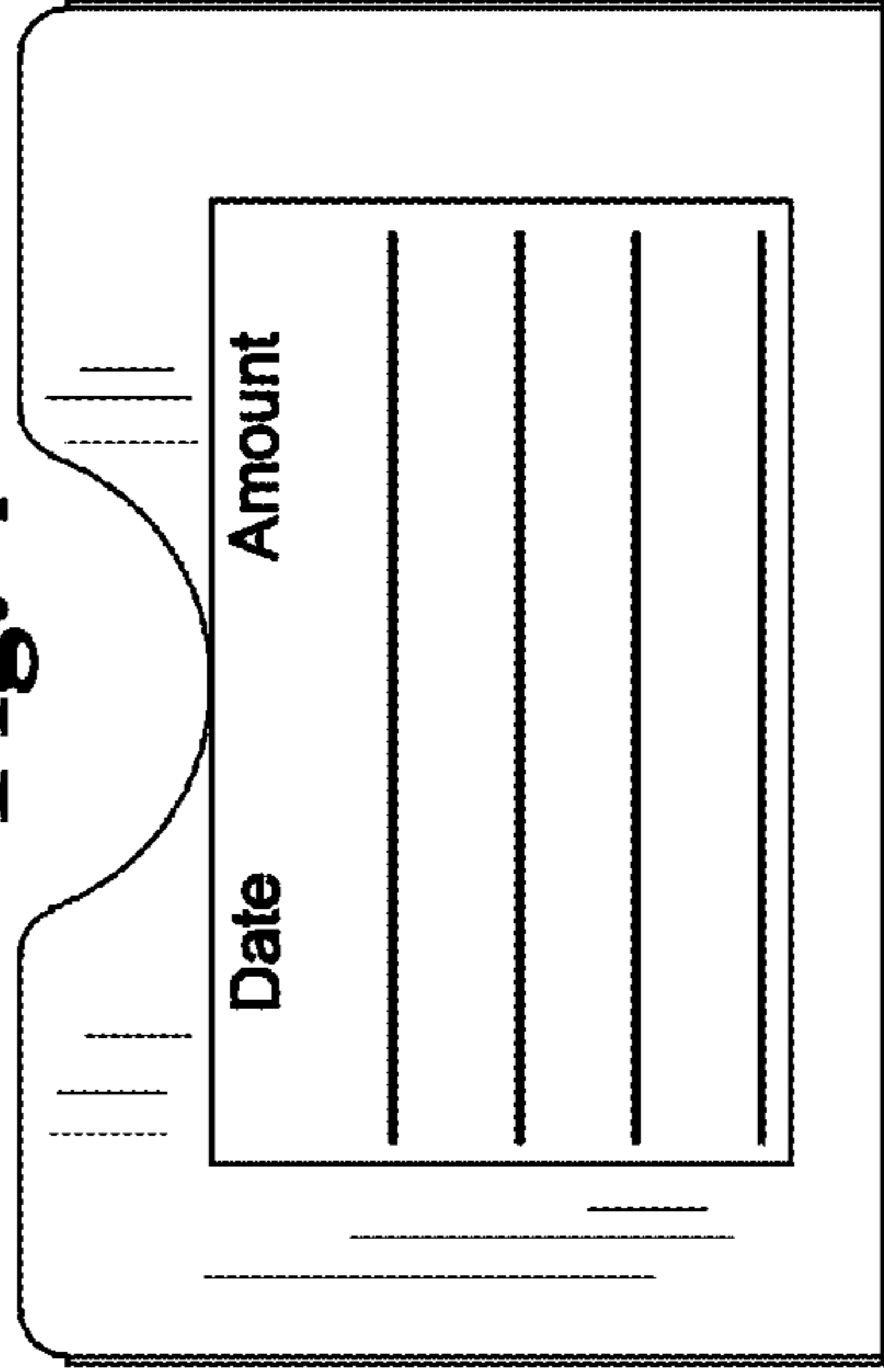

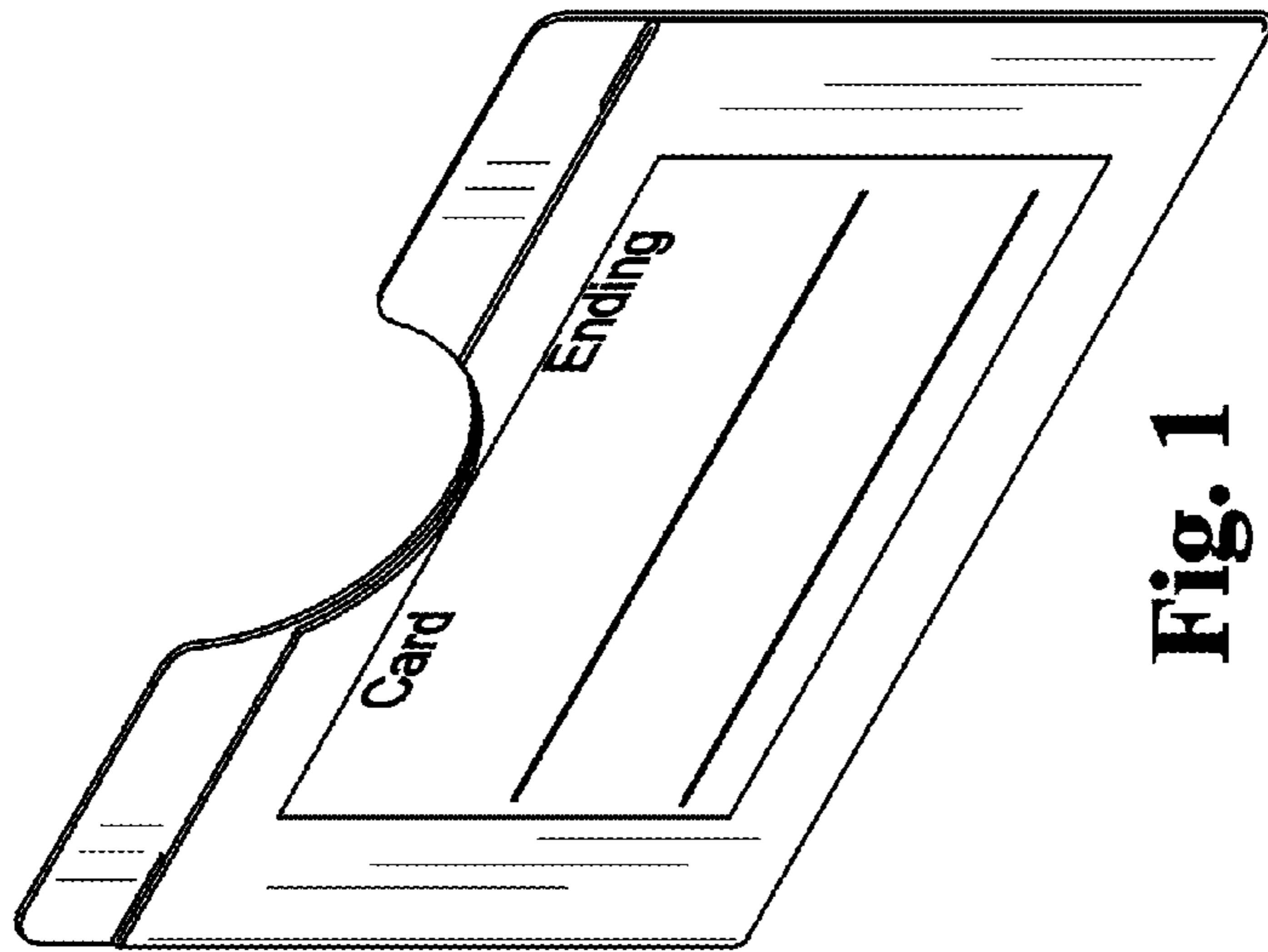
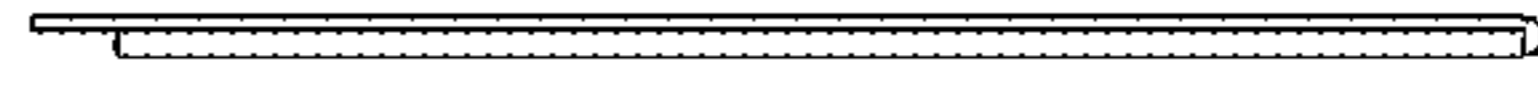

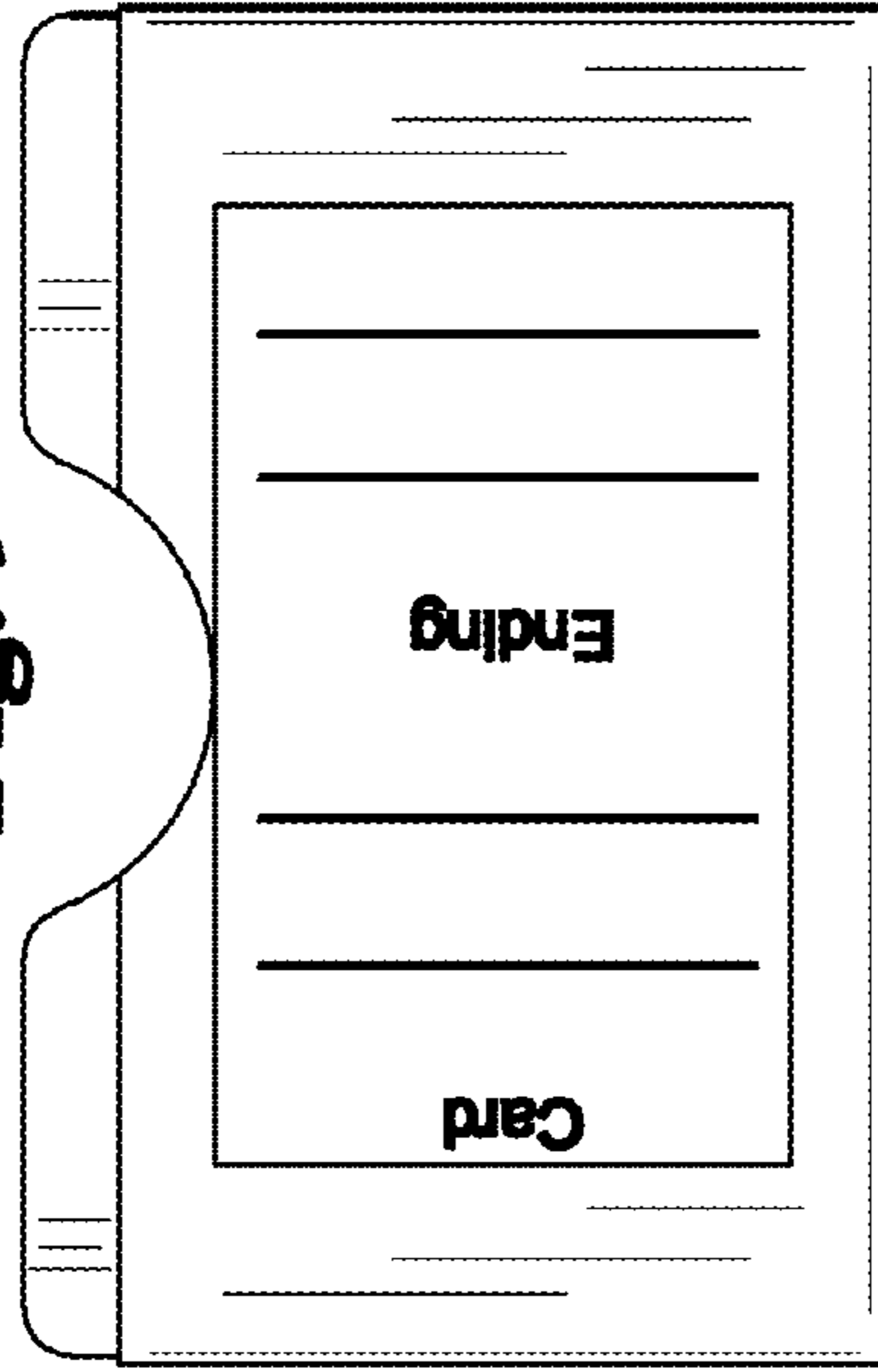

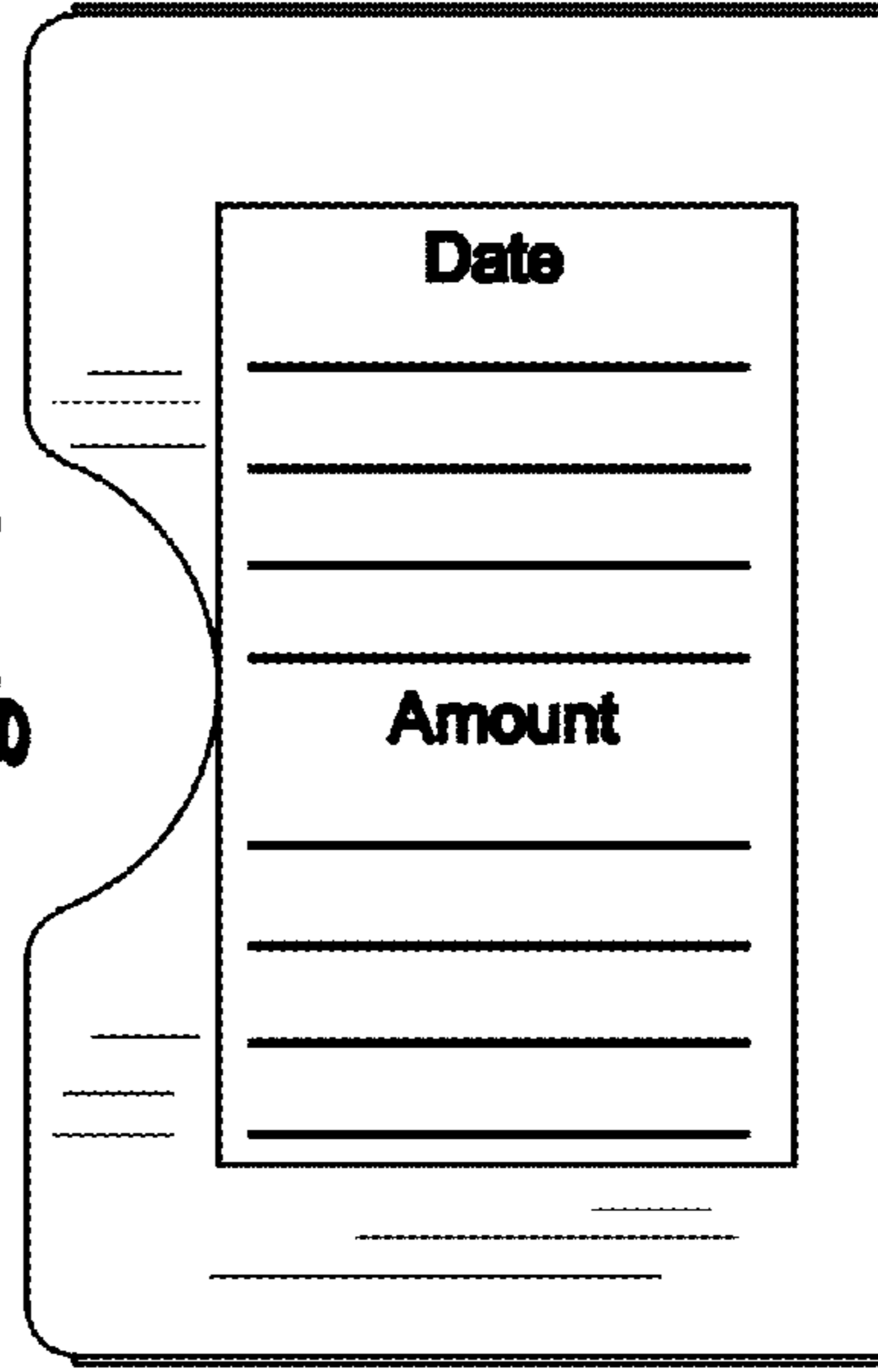

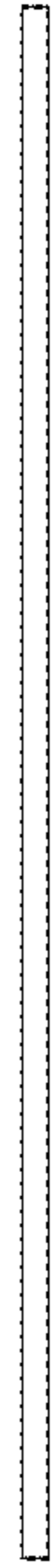

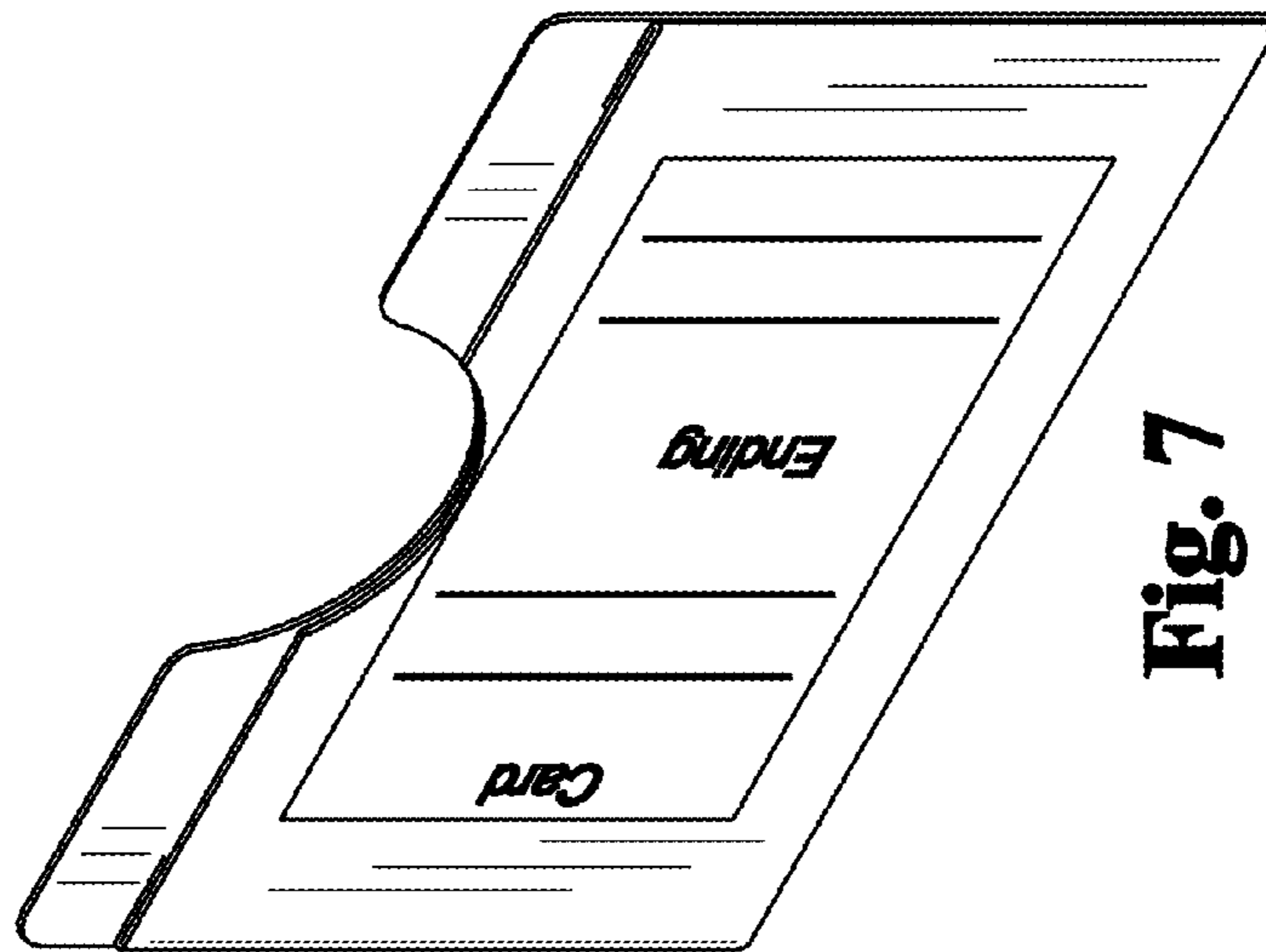
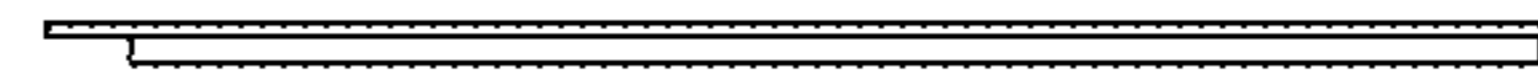

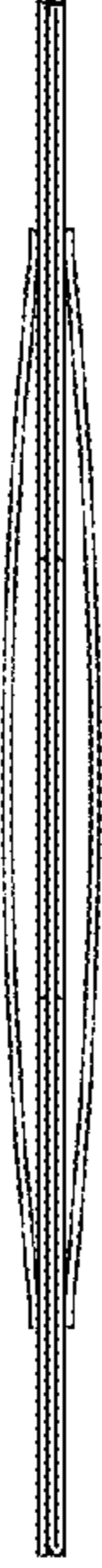

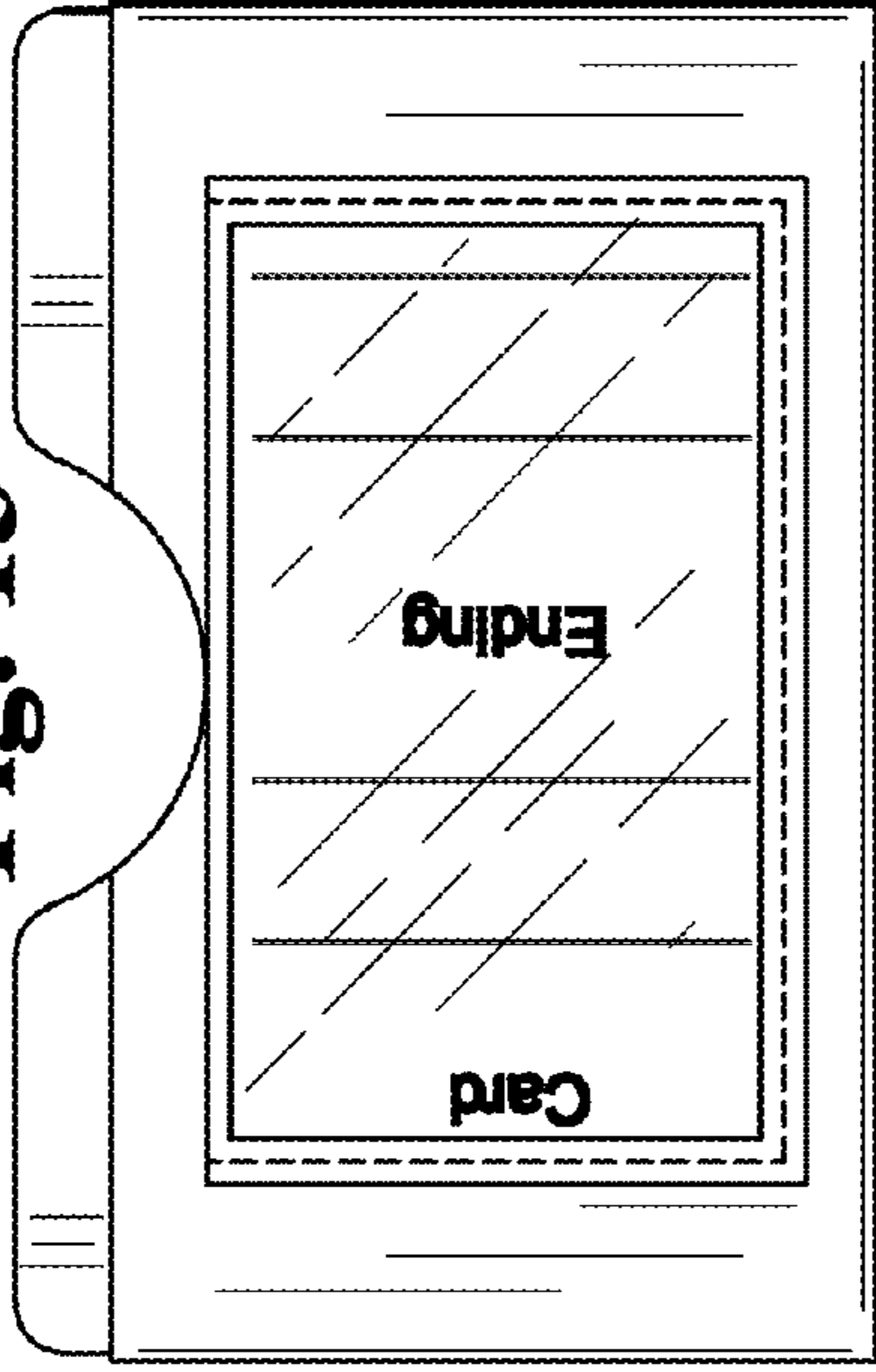

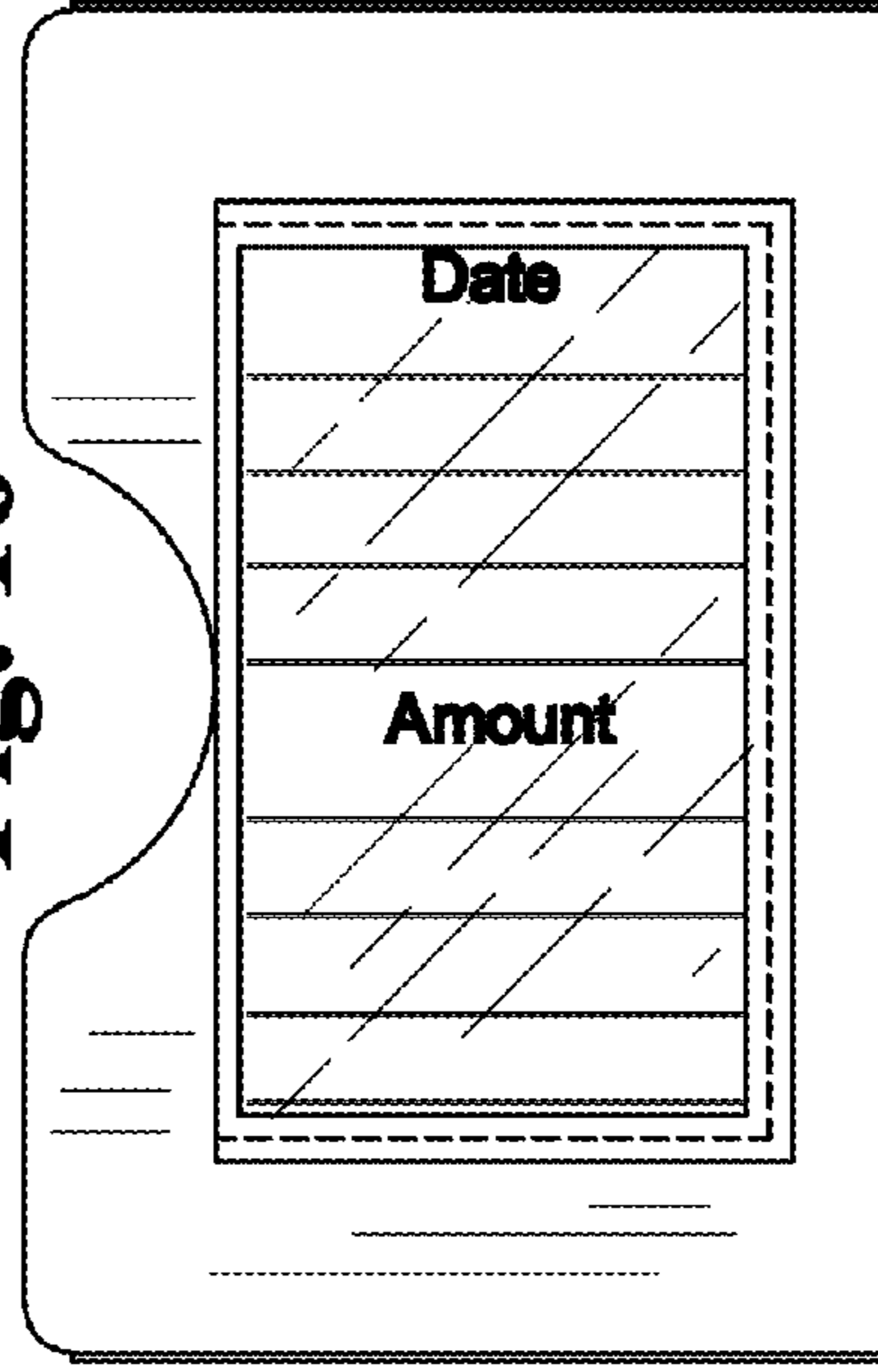

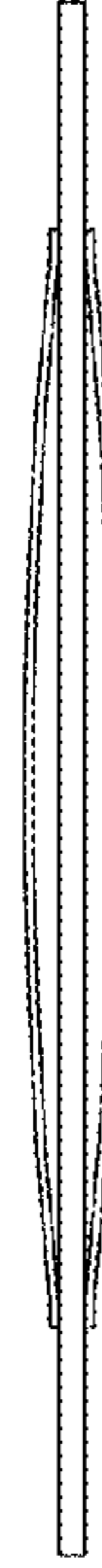

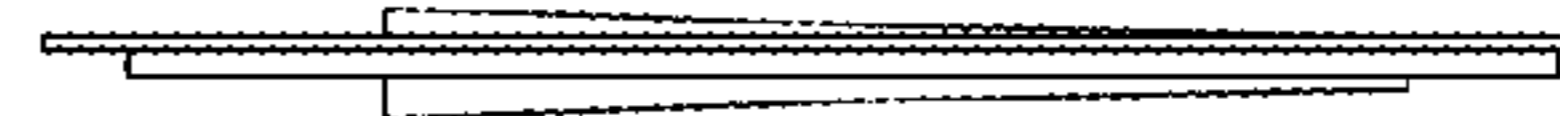
