The ornamental design for a telescoping pole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a telescoping pole, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

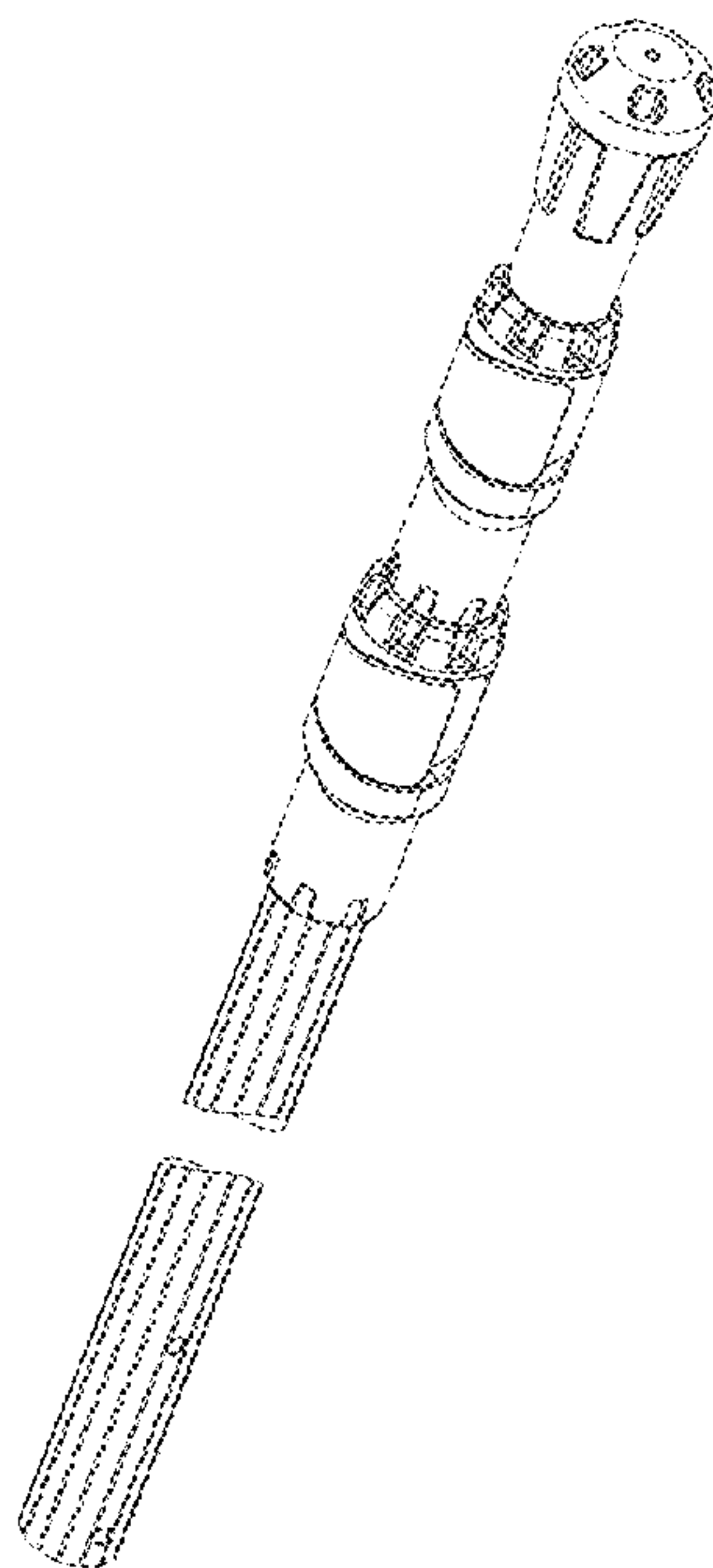
The telescoping pole is shown with a symbolic break. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

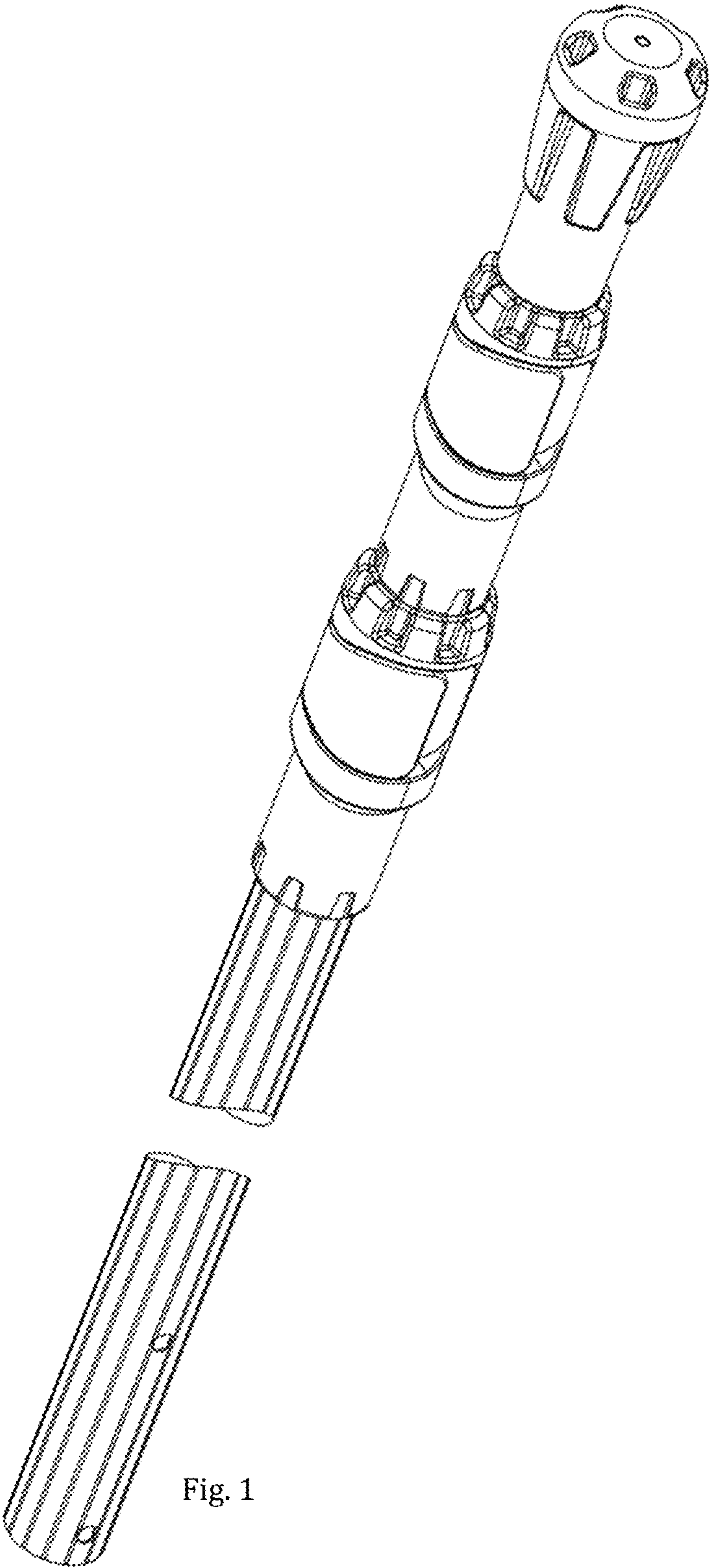

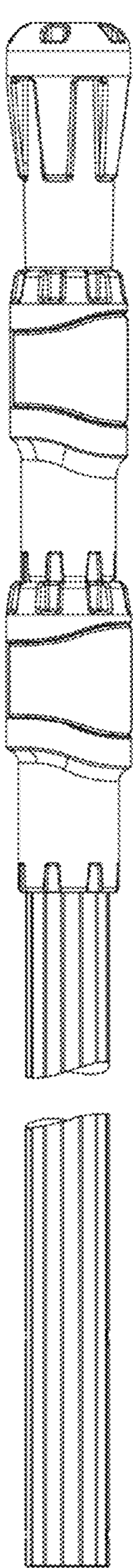

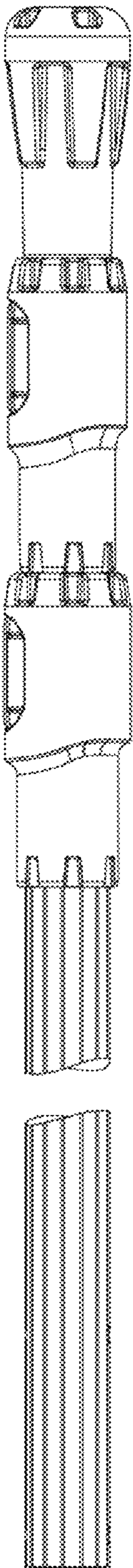

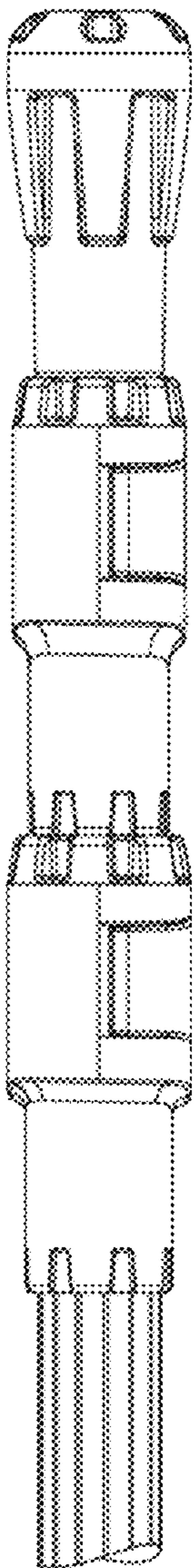

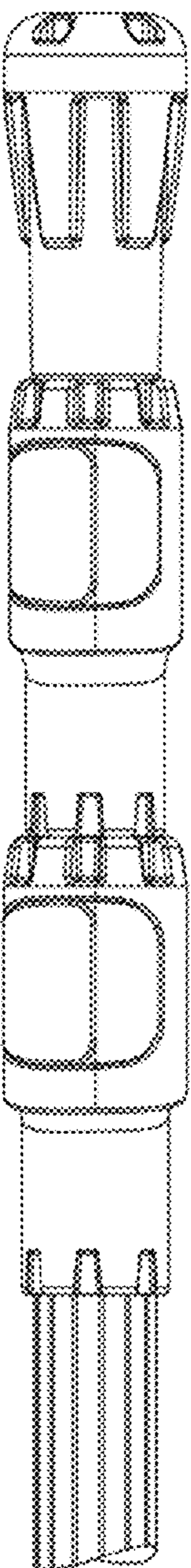
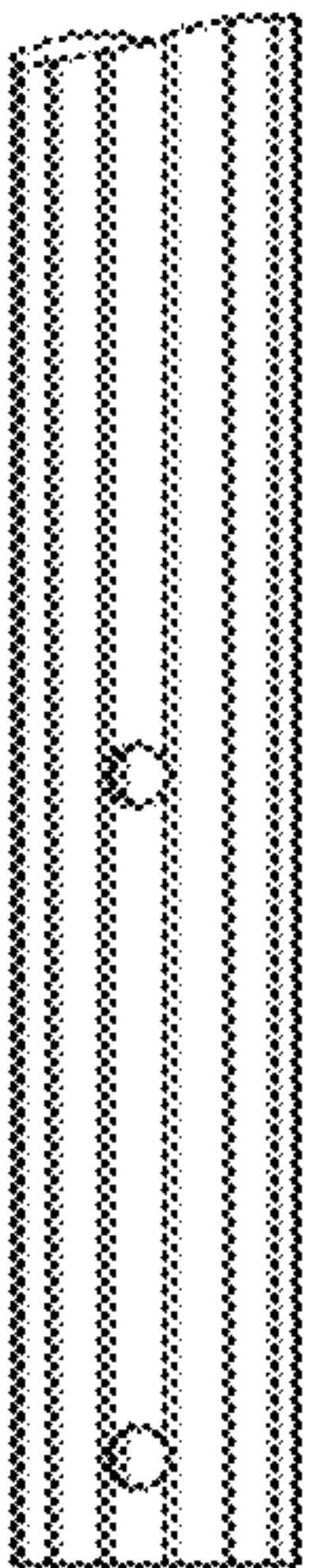
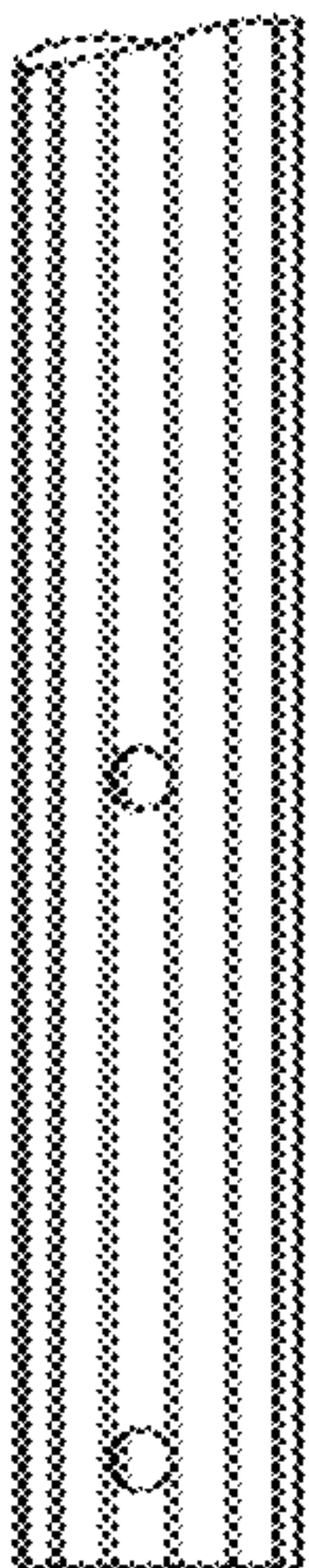

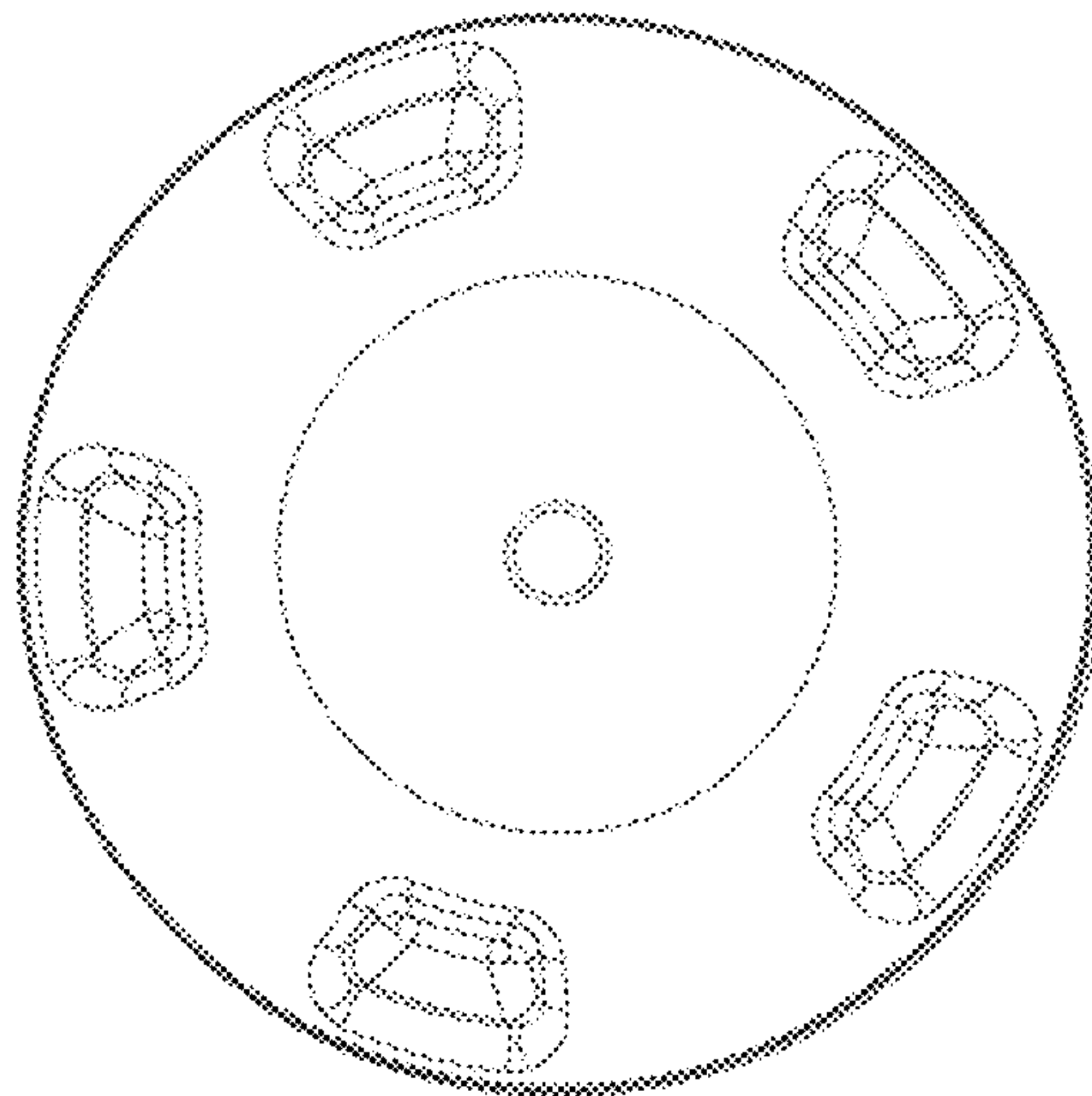
