The ornamental design for a climbing apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left-side perspective view of the climbing apparatus;

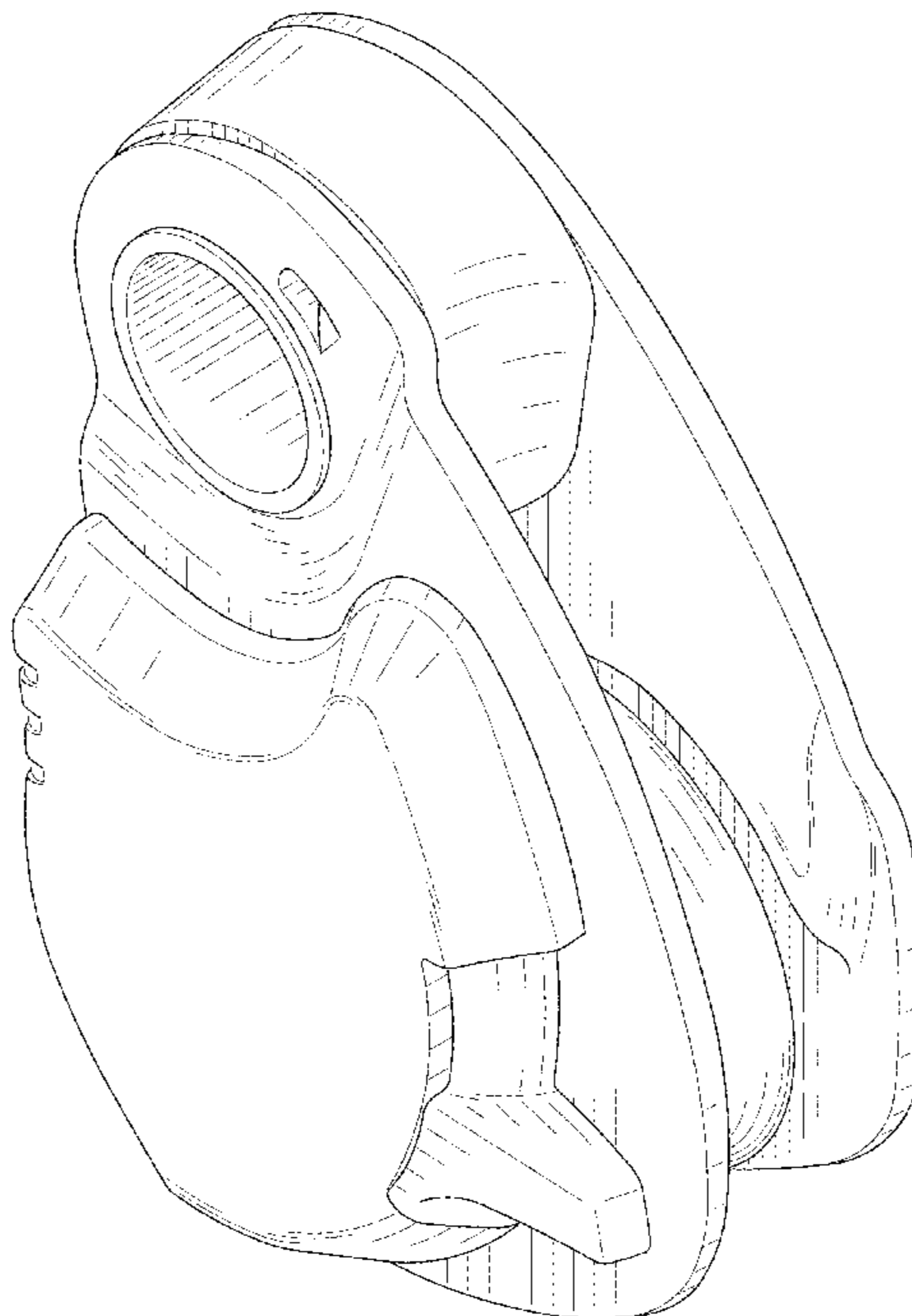

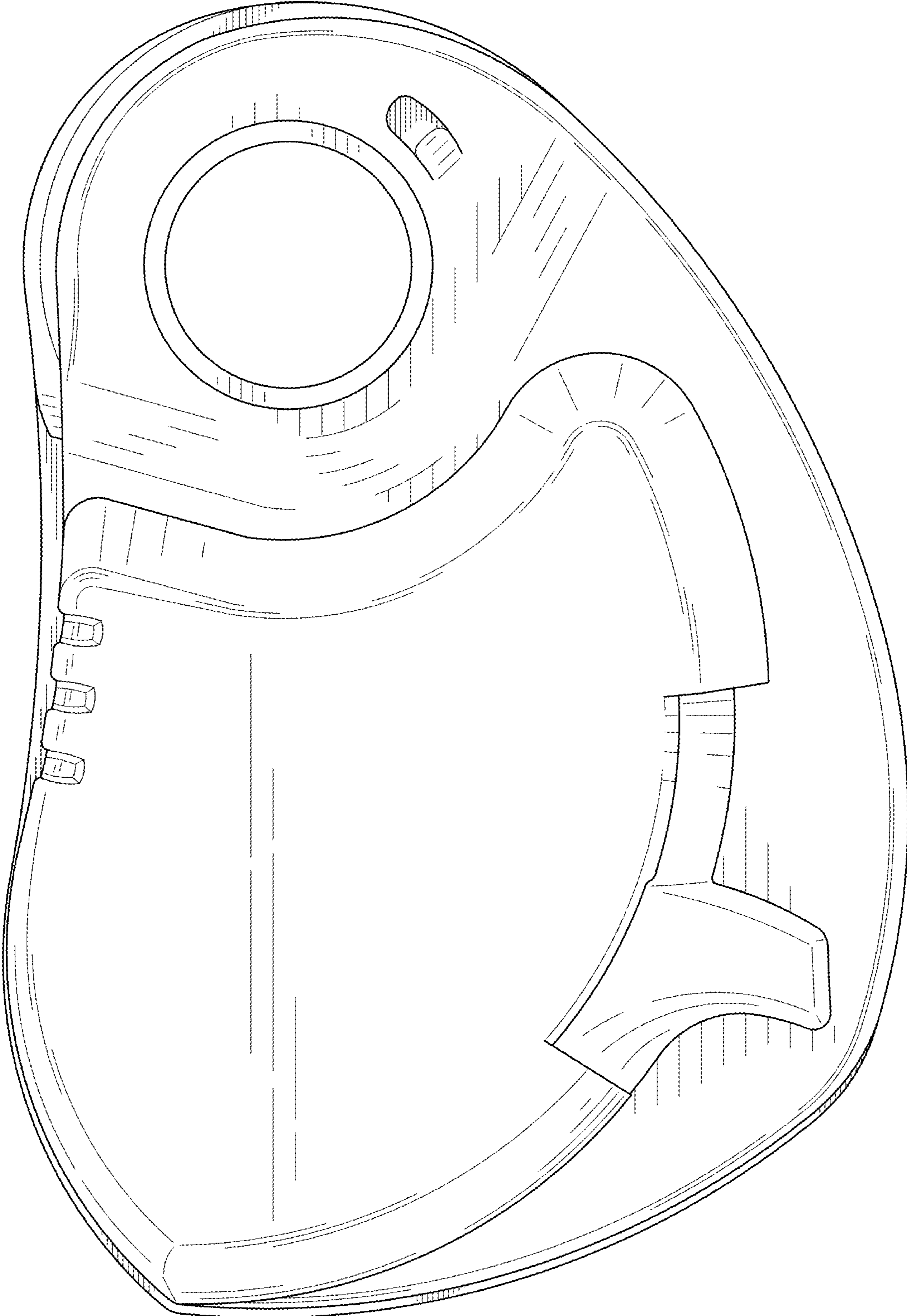

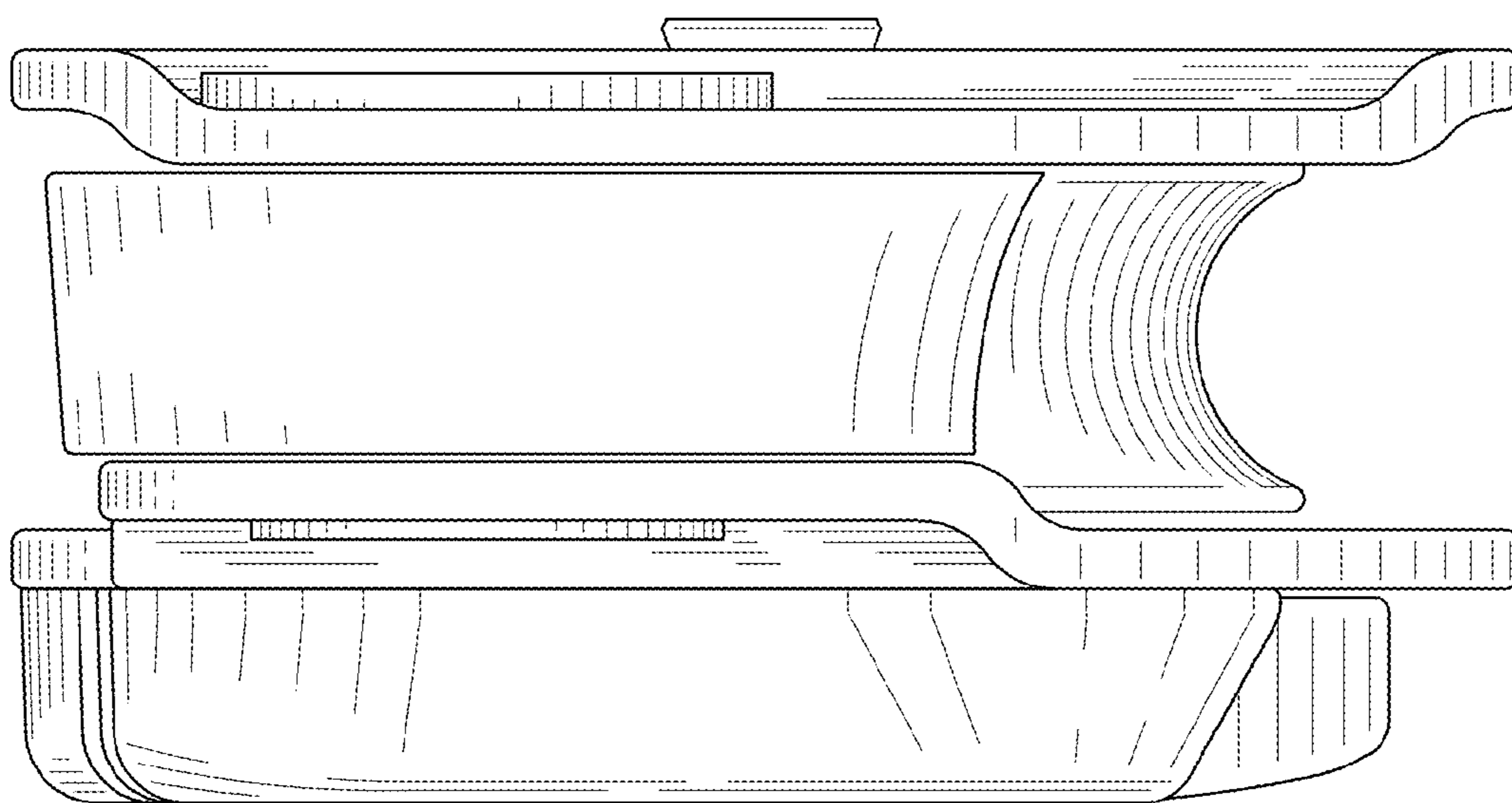

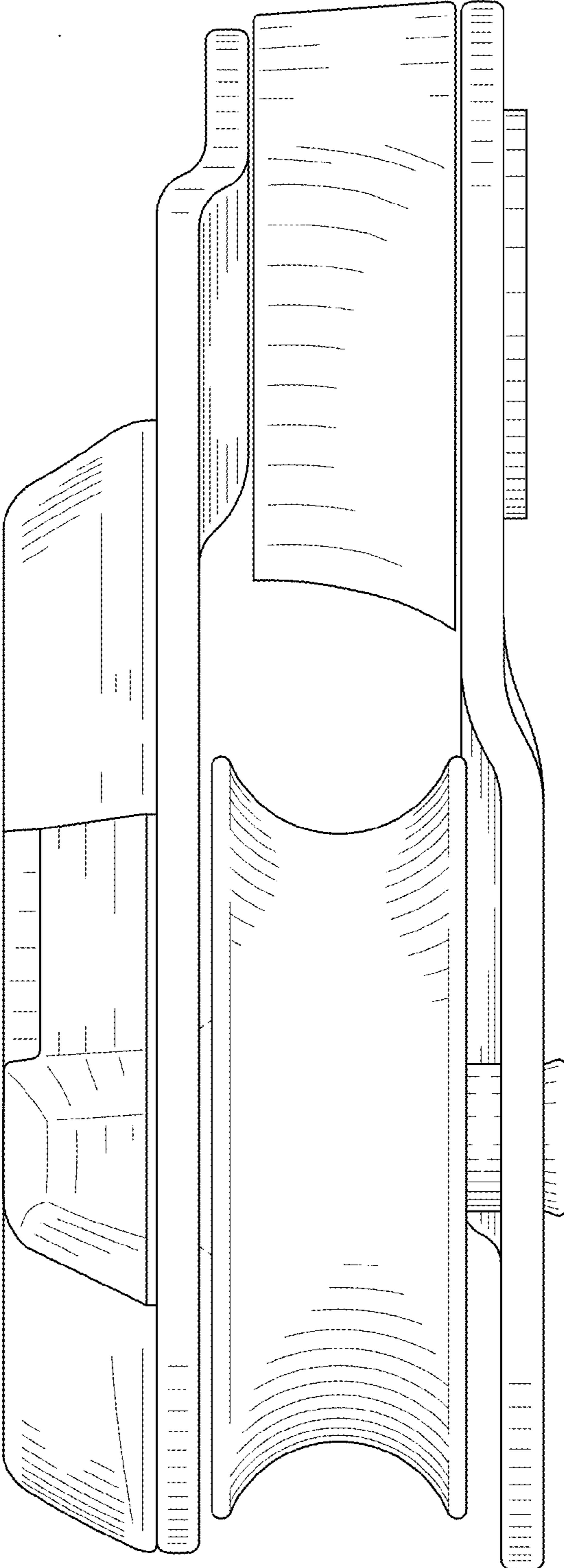

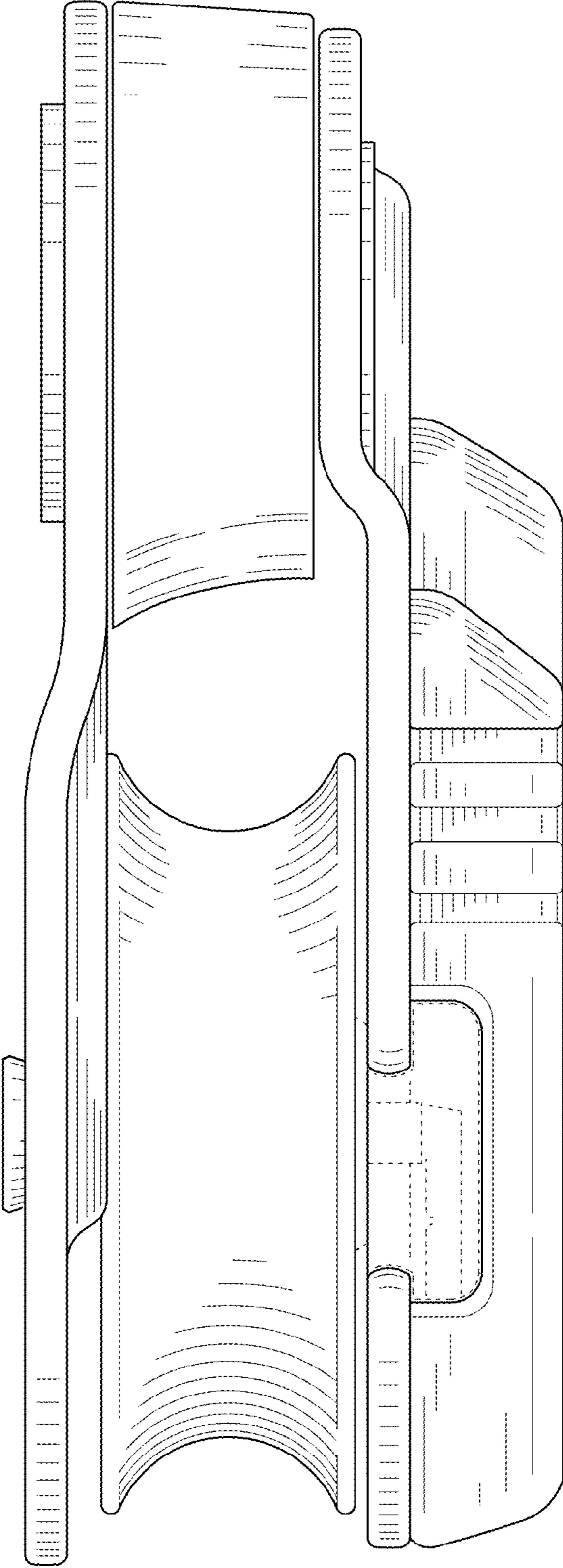

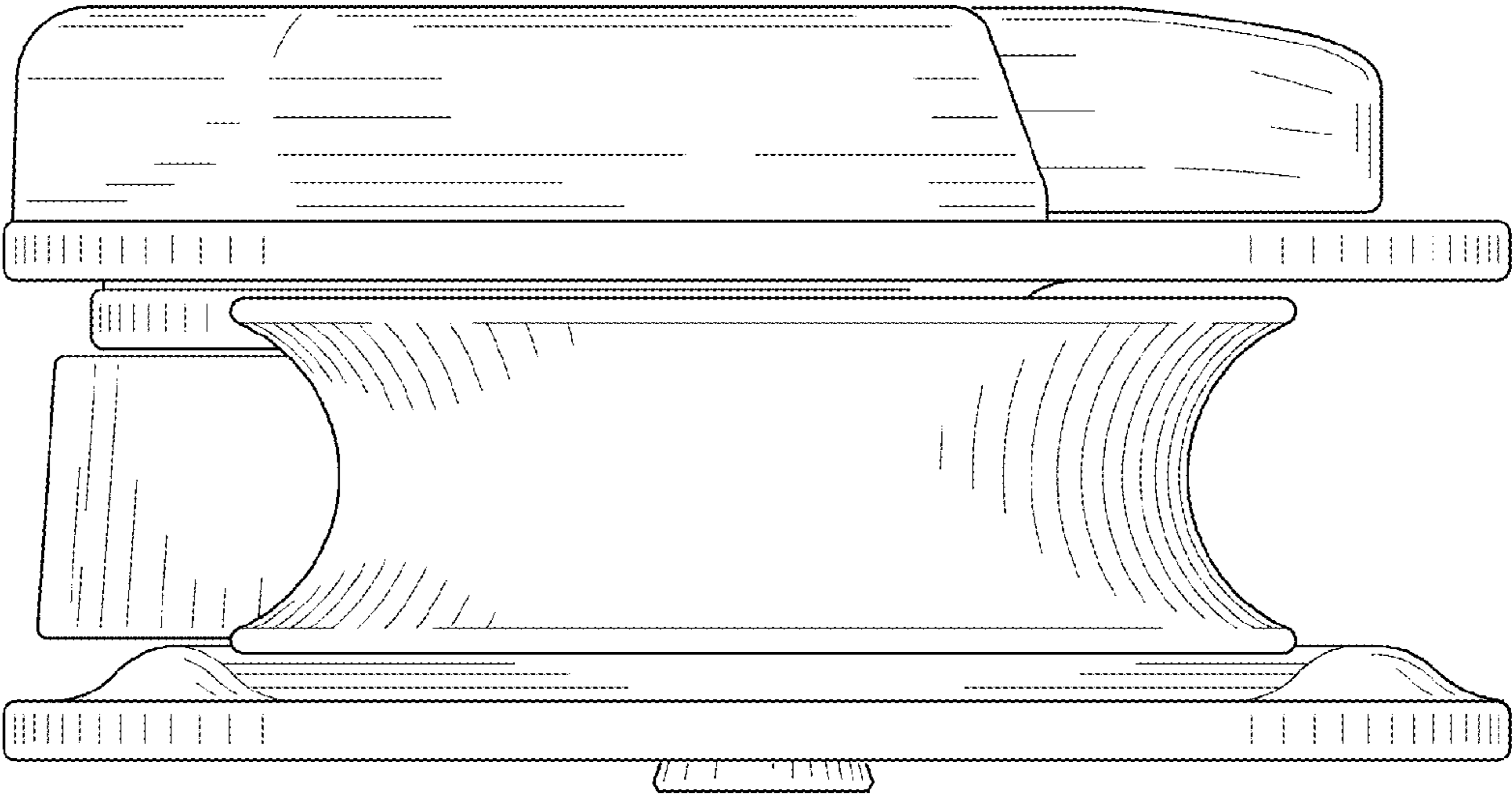

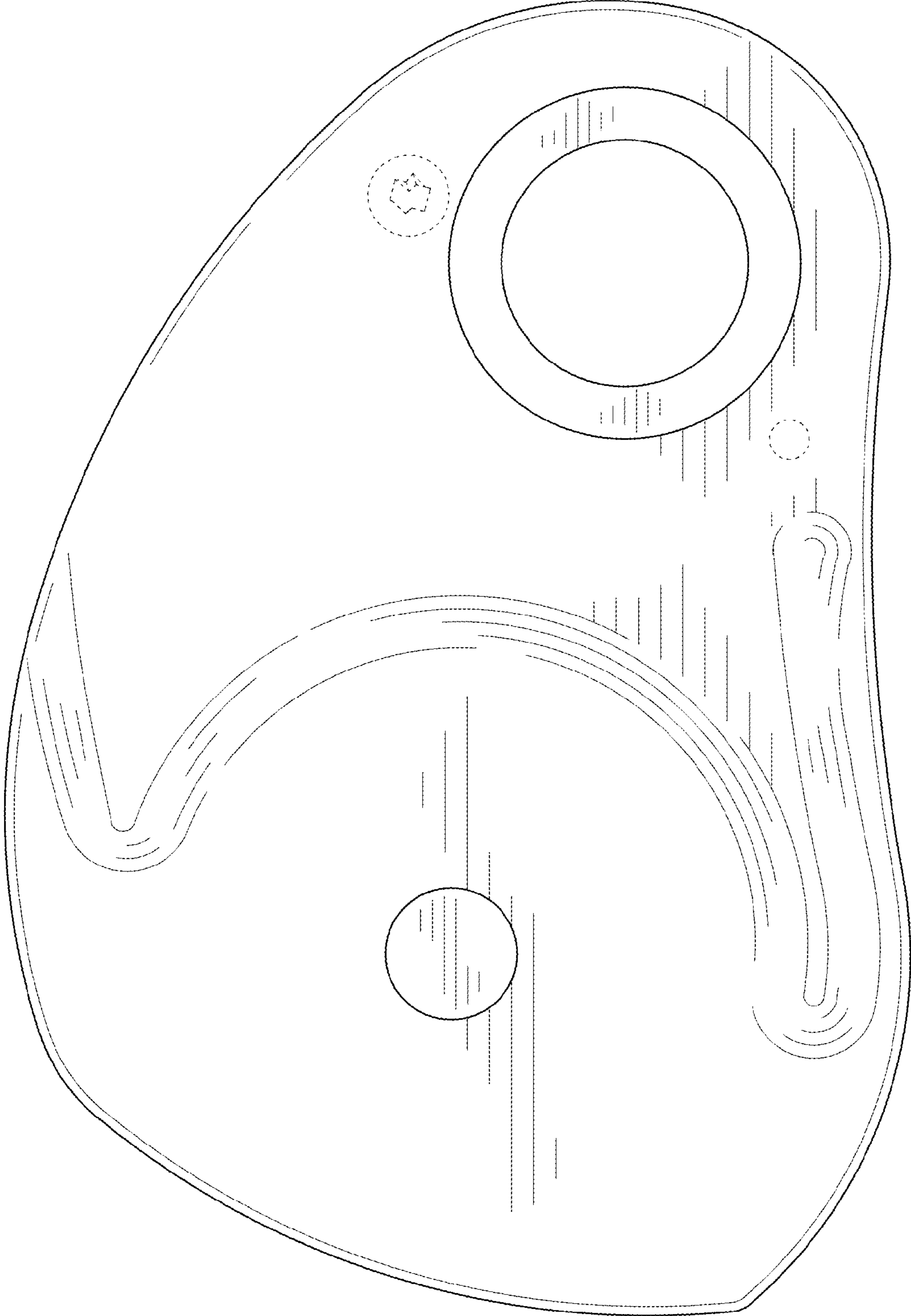

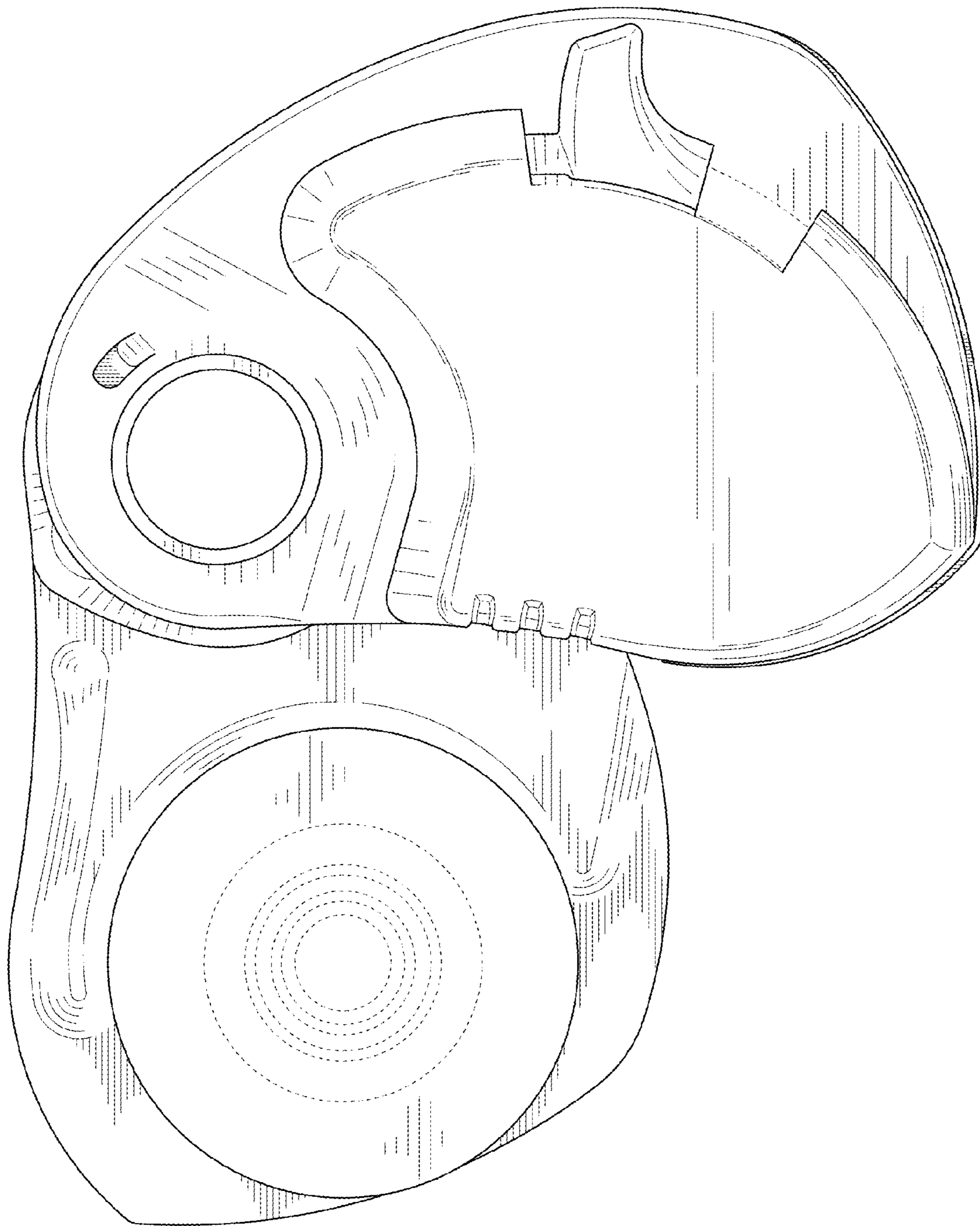
