FIG. 7 is top view of FIG. 6

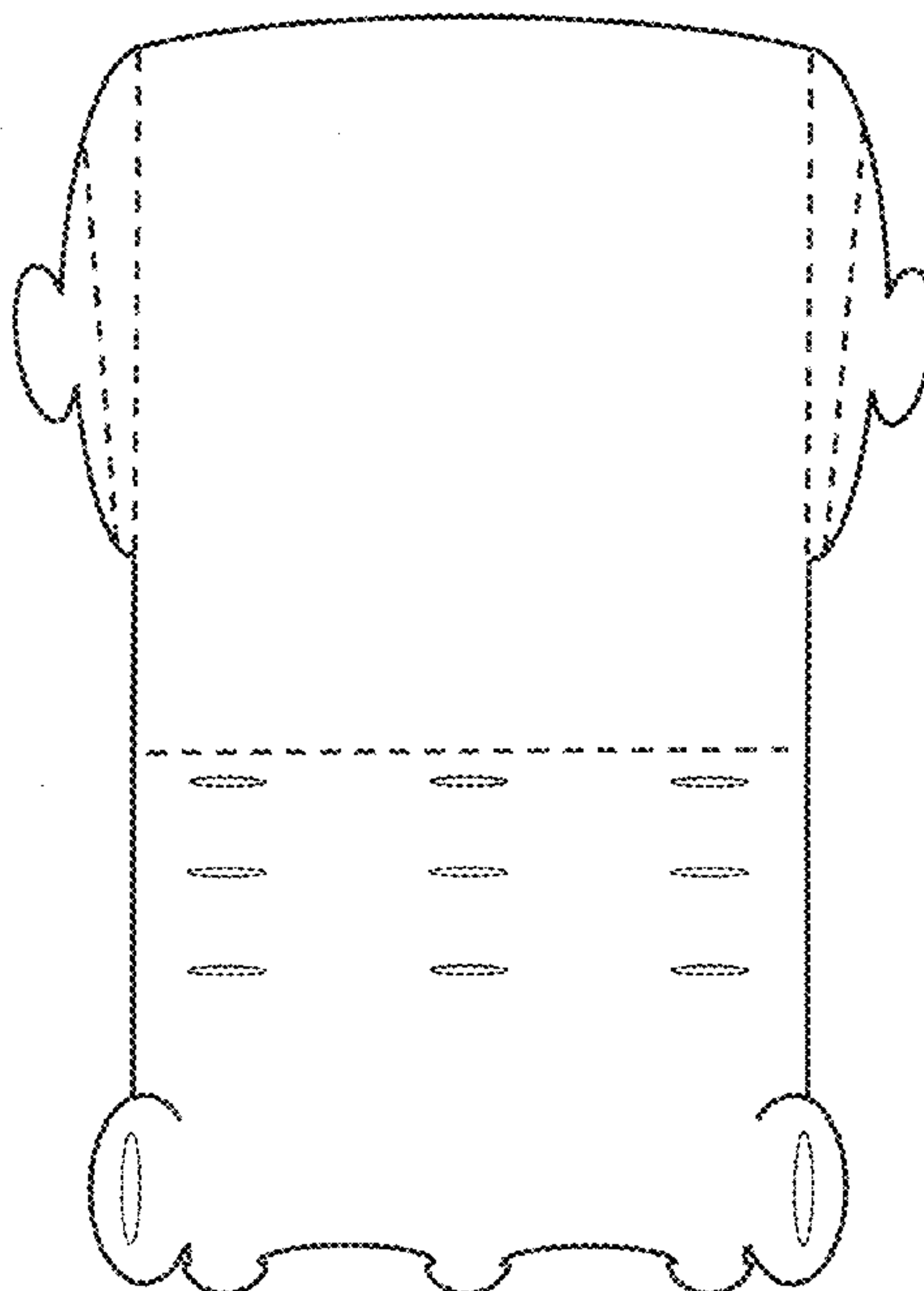
FIG. 8 is bottom view of FIG. 6

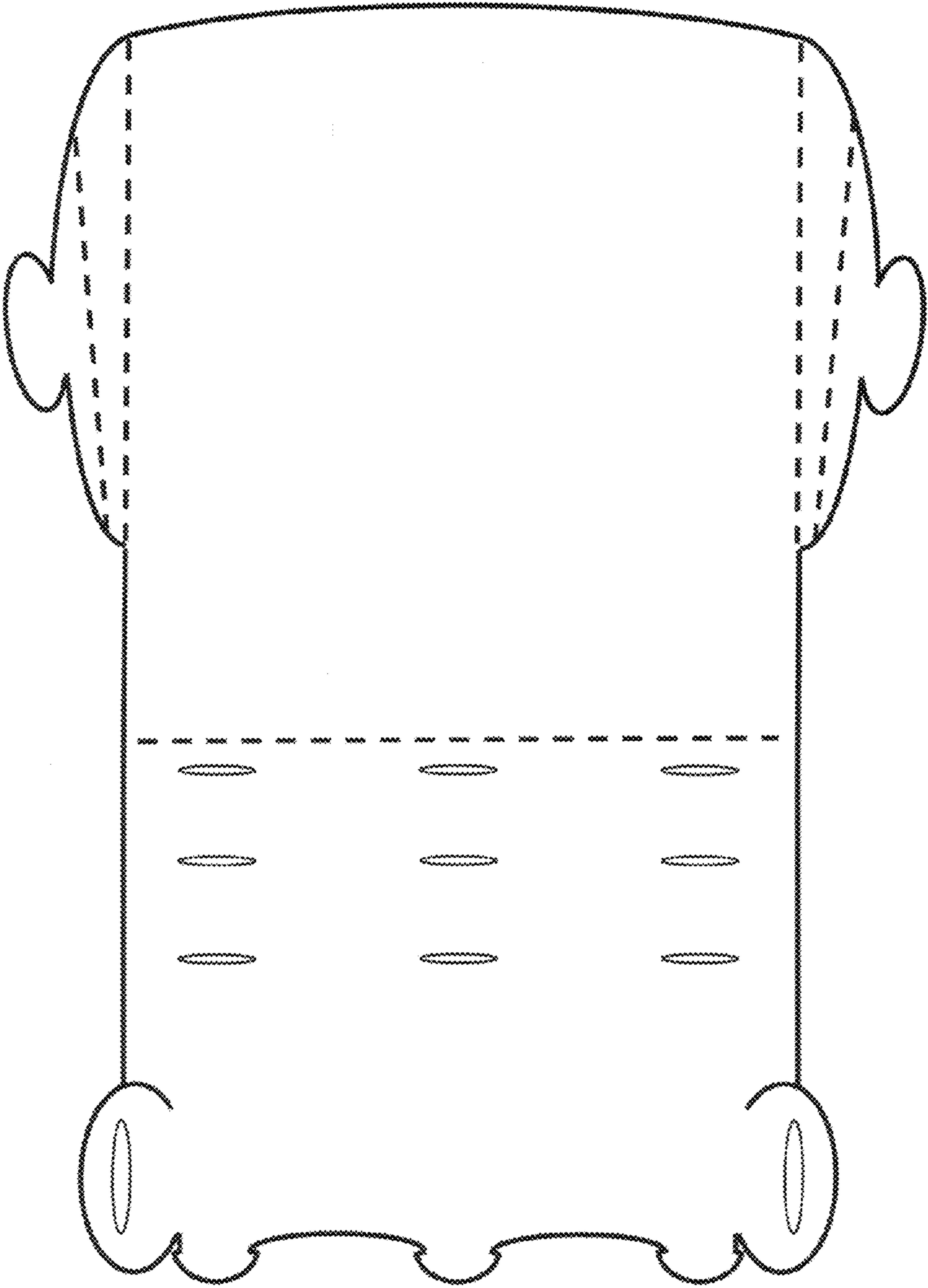

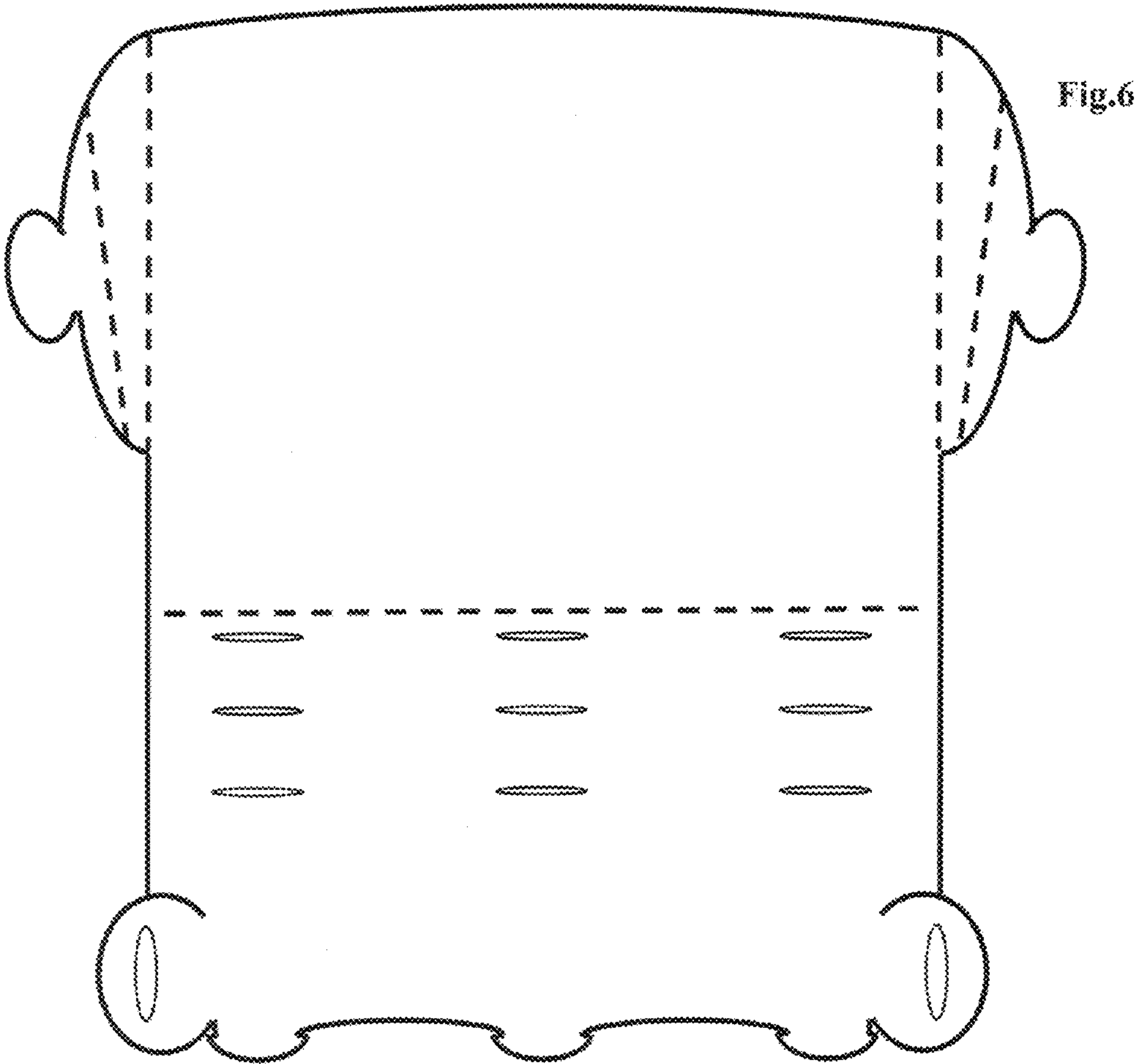
