(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the head bandage, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a head bandage showing the design.

FIG. 2 is an opposite perspective view of the embodiment of the invention shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1 showing the inner absorbent layer and outer protective layer.

FIG. 4 is a top front view of the embodiment showing in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a side view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is the opposite side view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 5.

FIG. 7 is the top back view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, showing the head bandage in an alternate environment of use.

FIG. 9 is an opposite front perspective view of FIG. 8.

FIG. 10 is a front perspective view of FIG. 8.

FIG. 11 is a top view of FIG. 8.

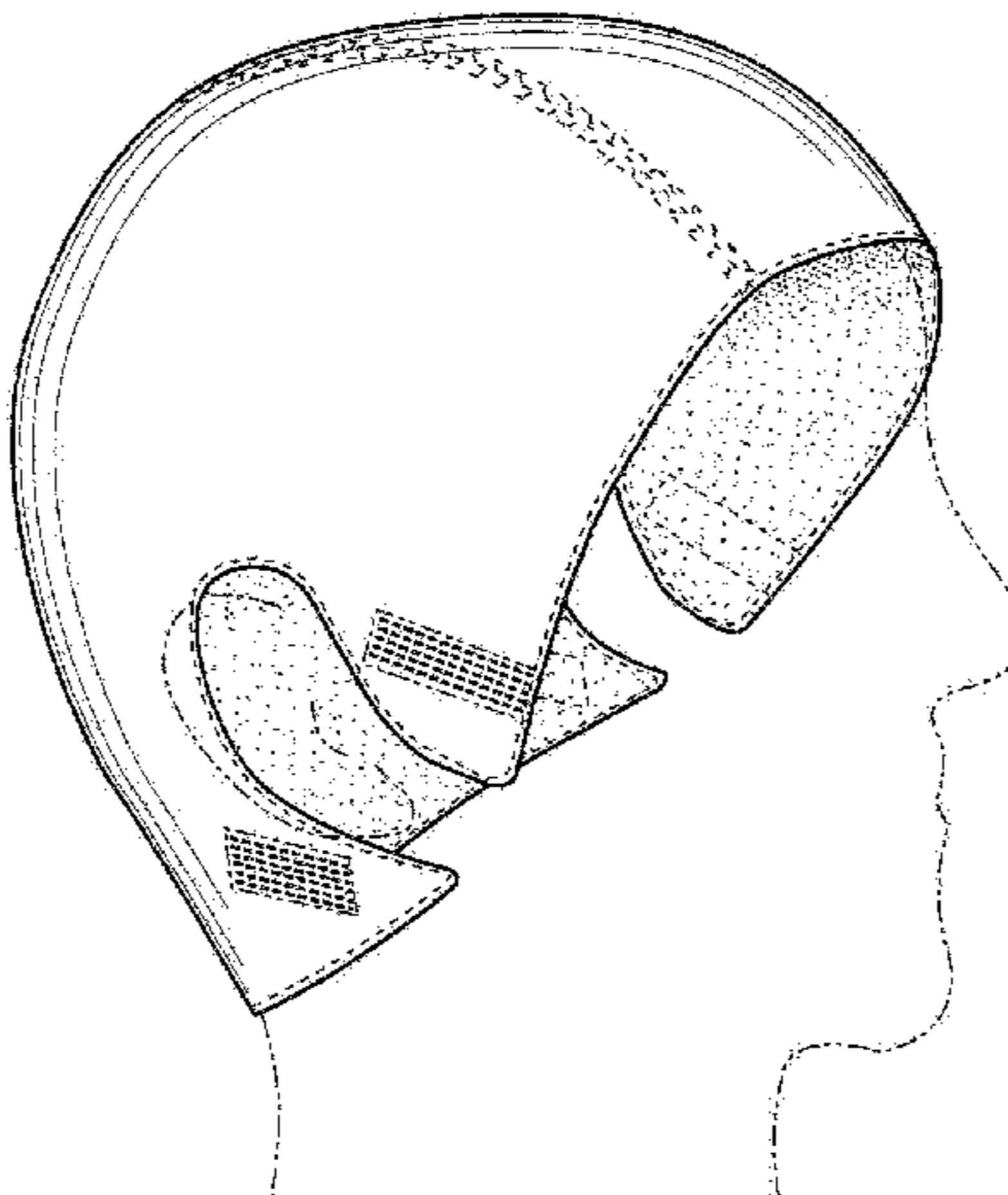
FIG. 12 is a side view of FIG. 8.

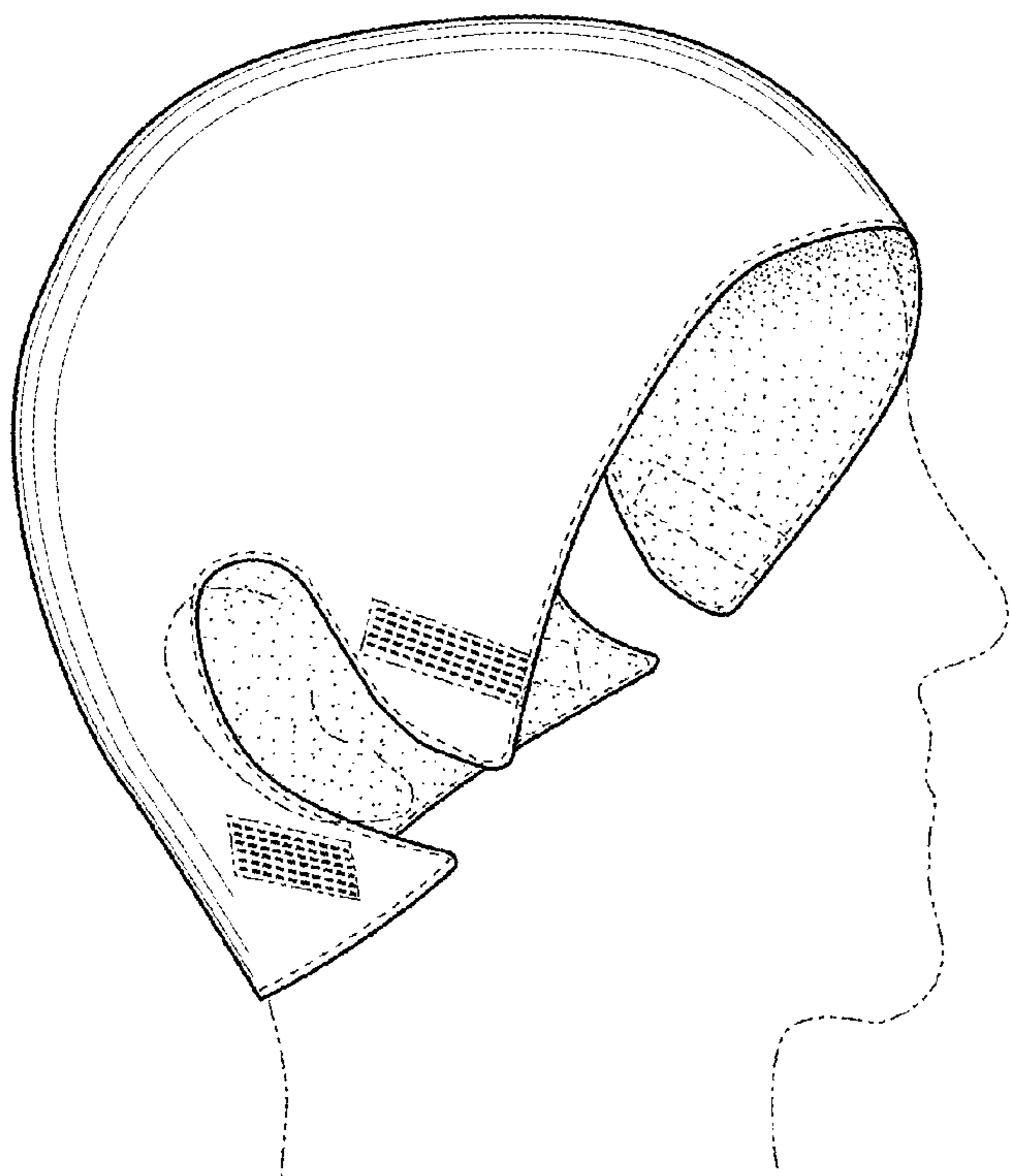

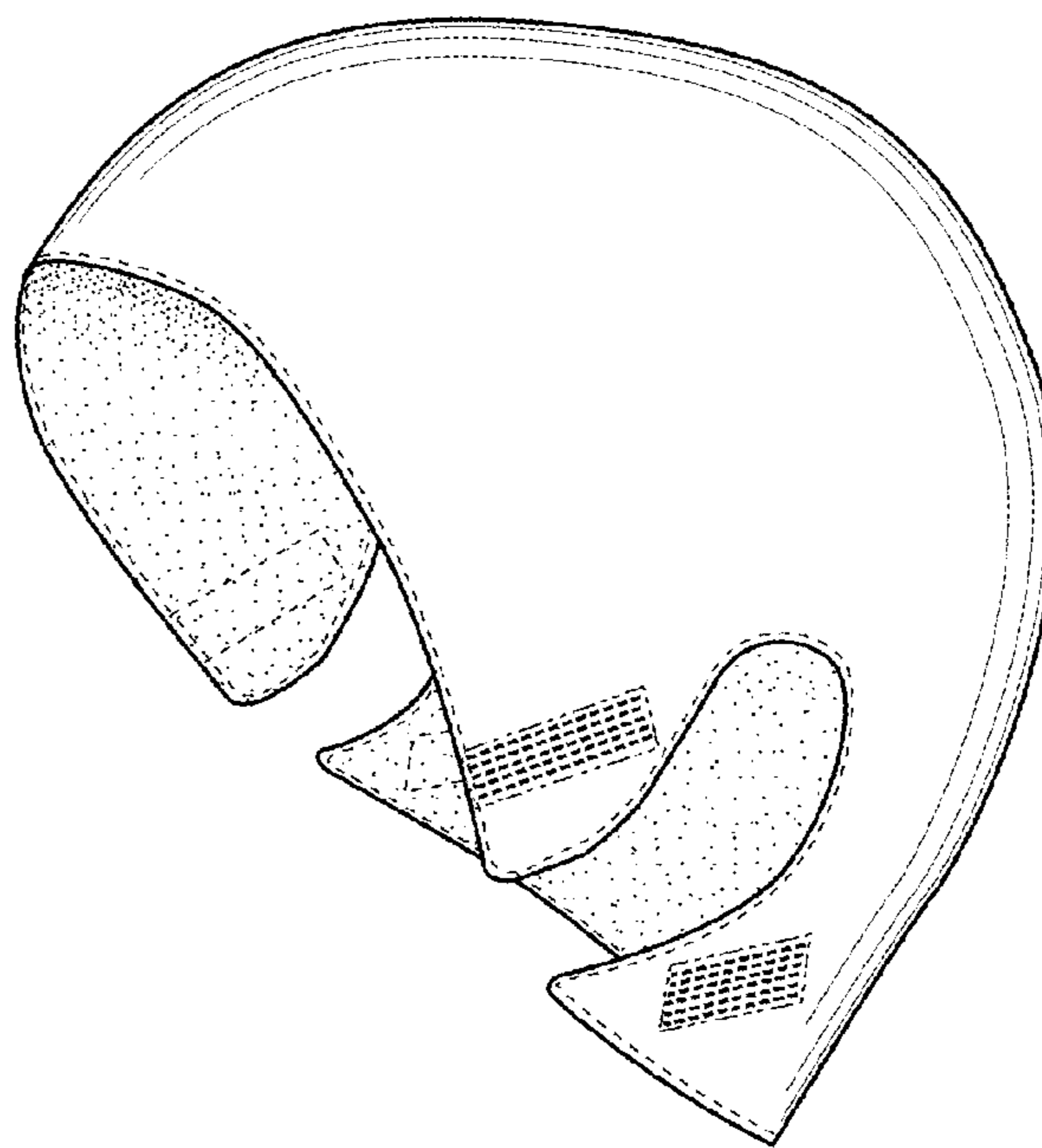

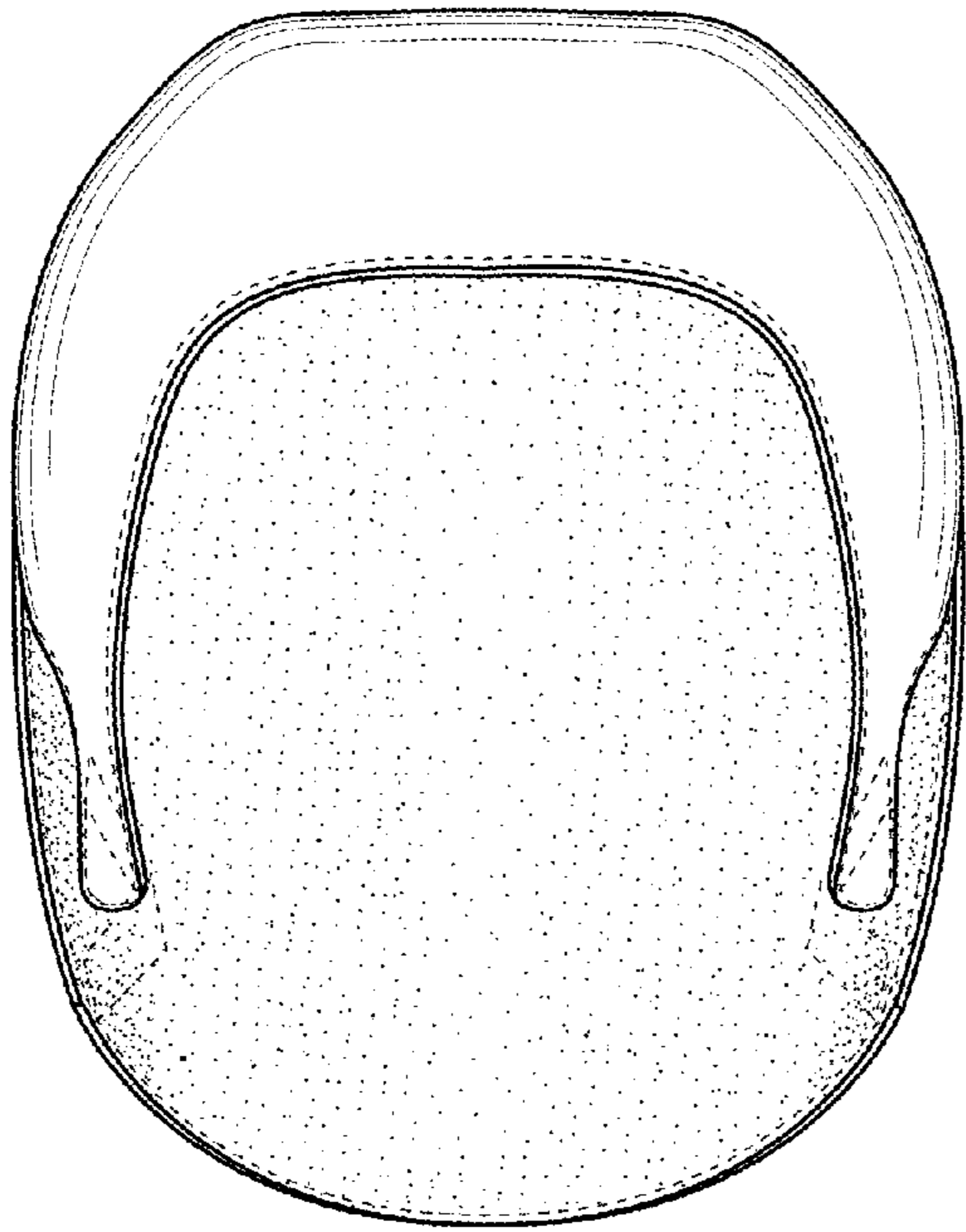

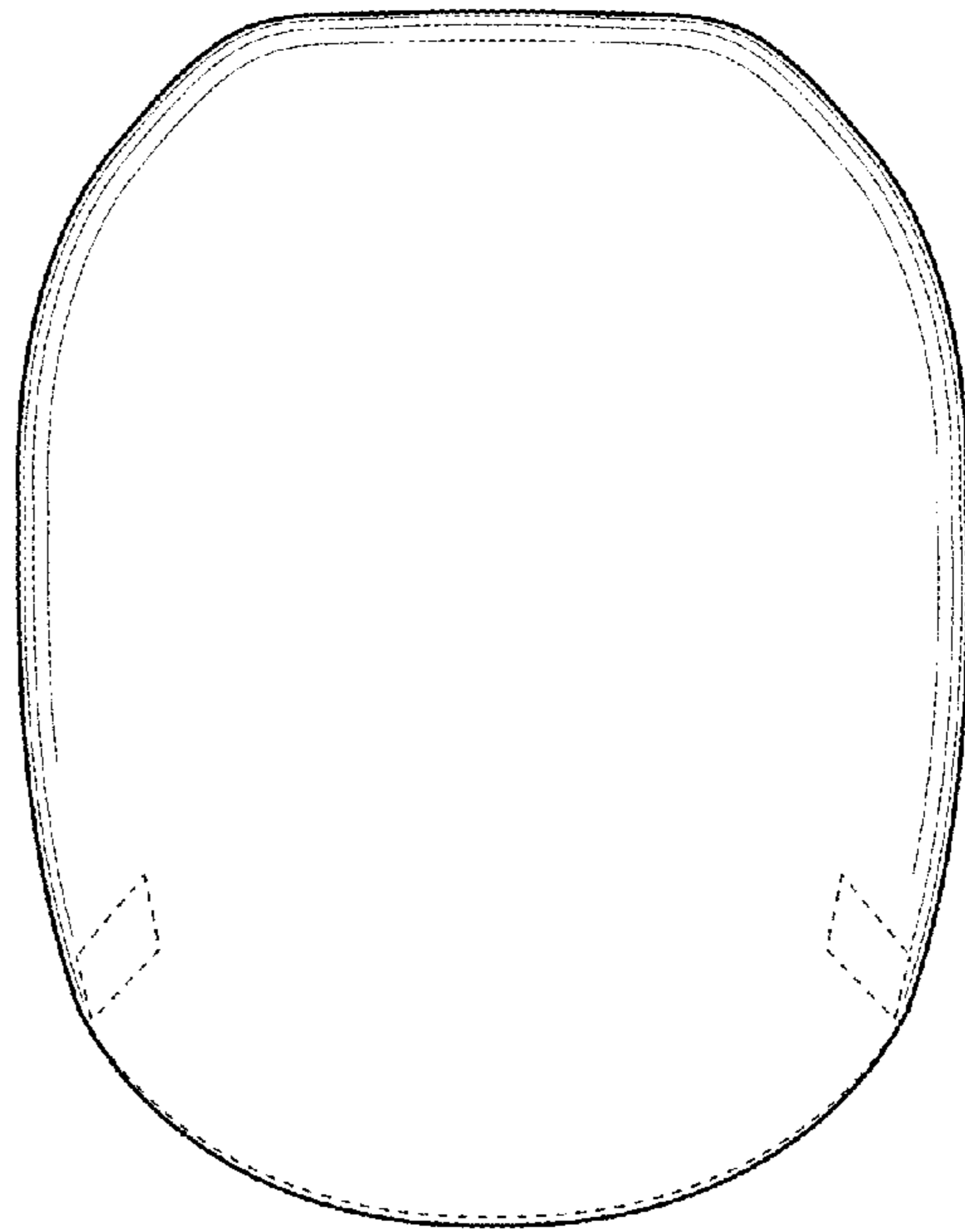

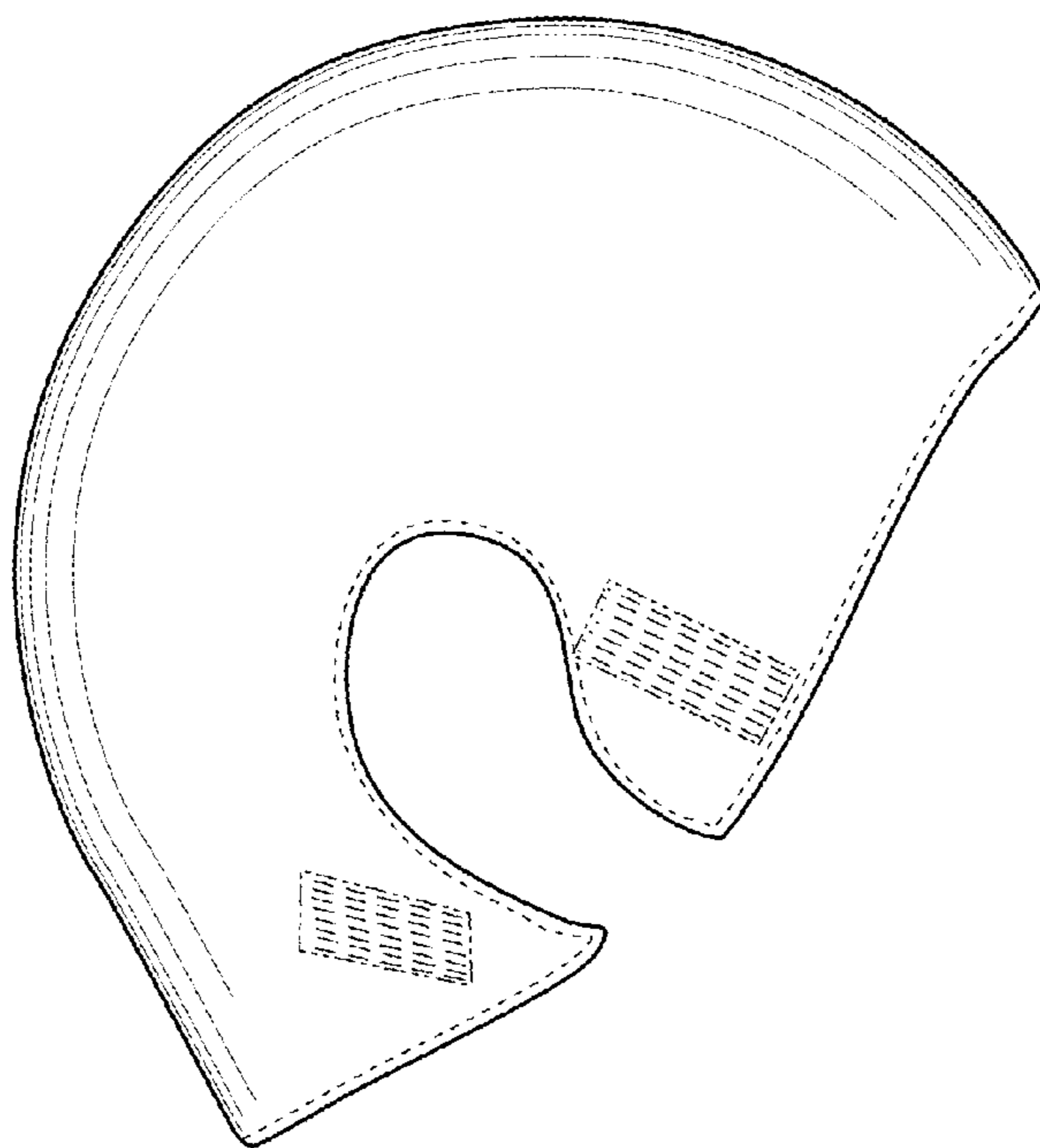

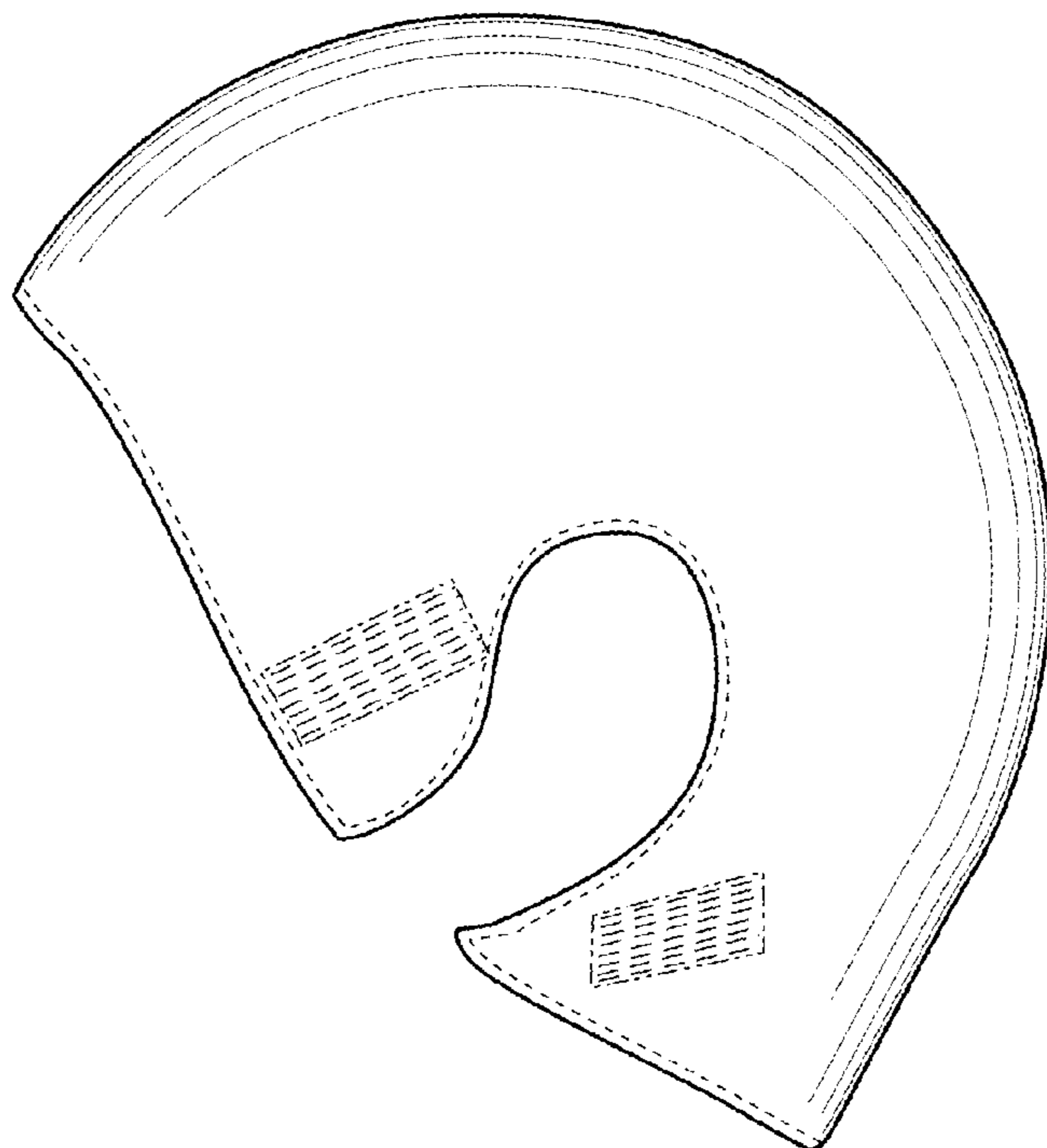

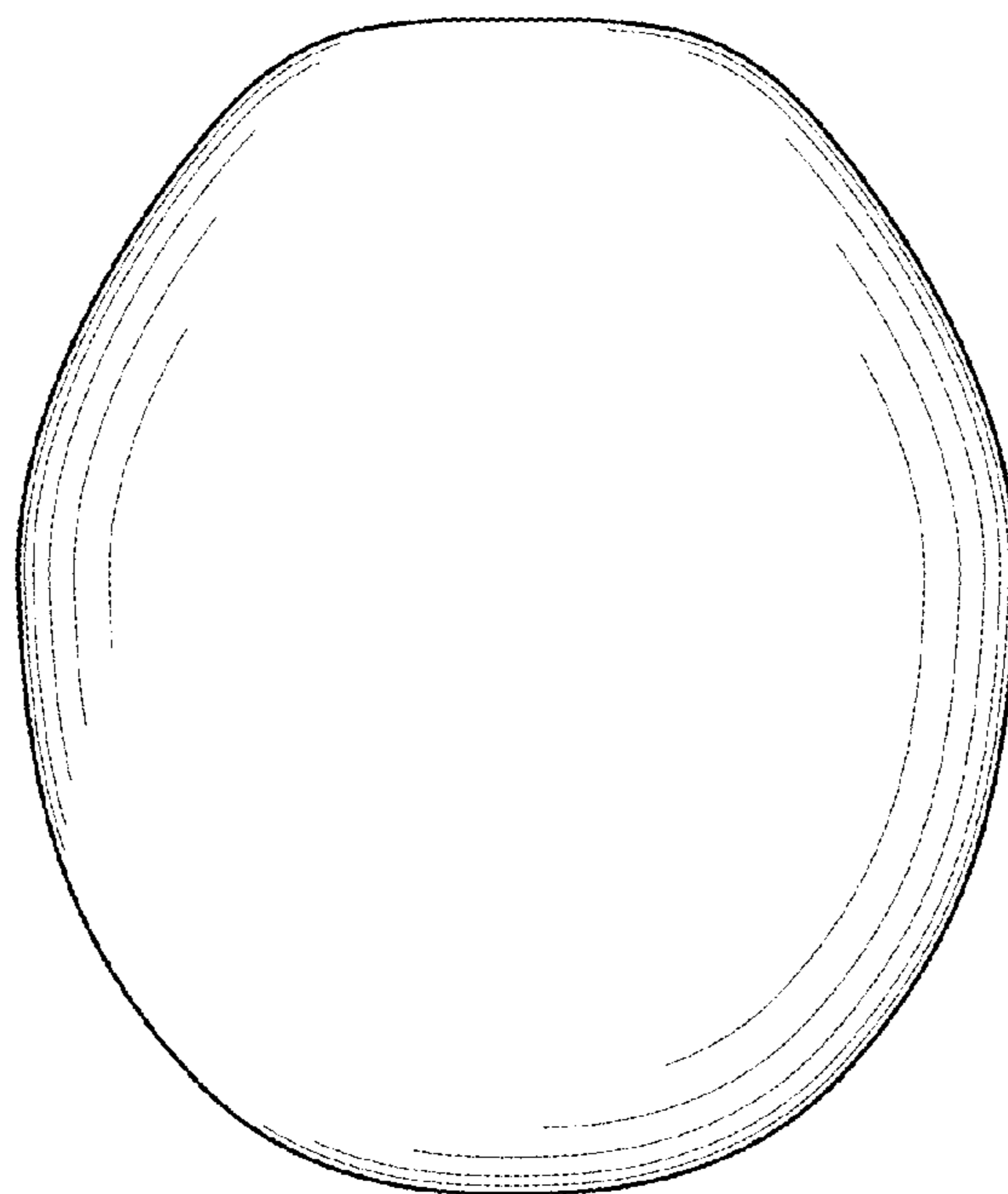

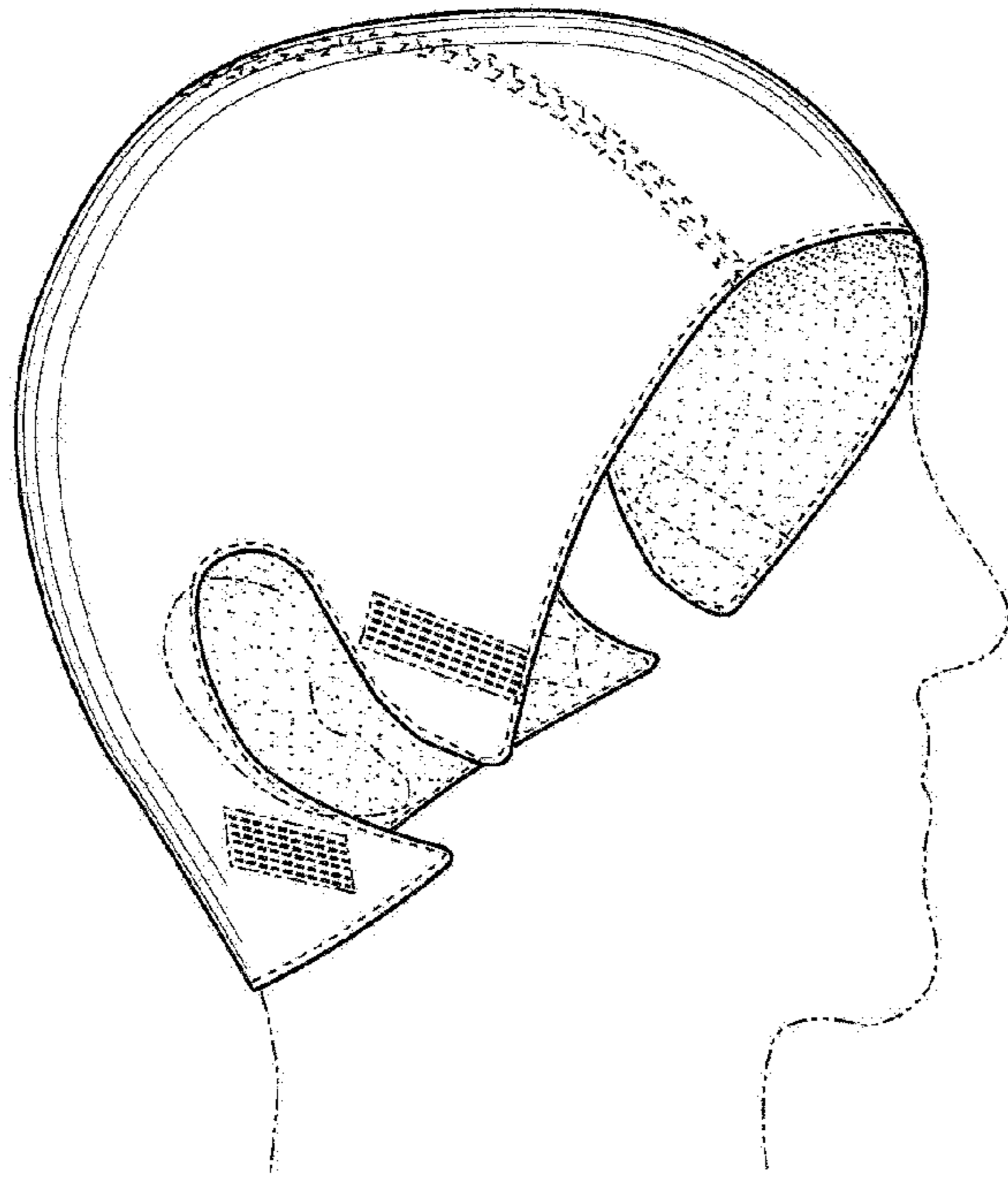

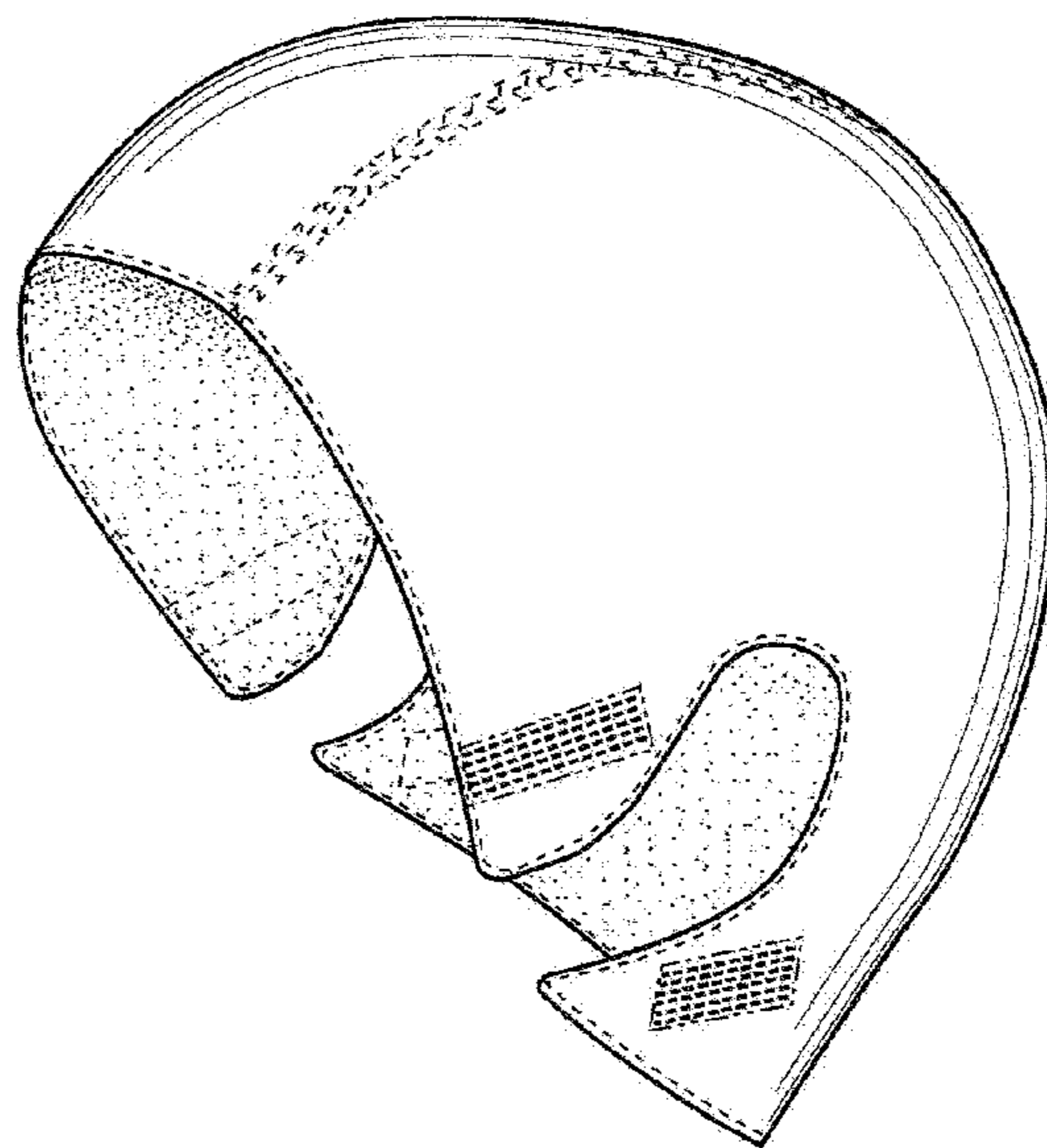

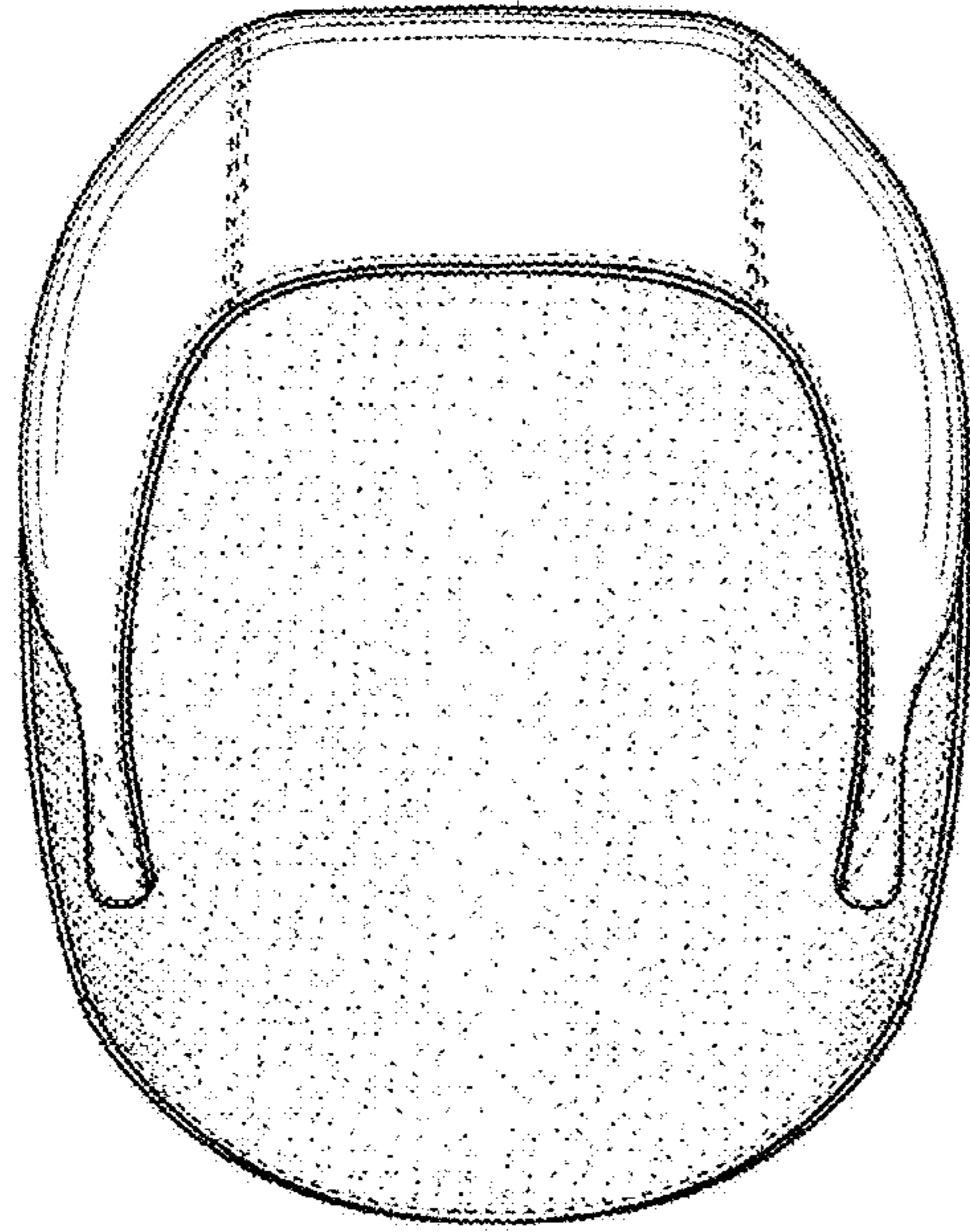

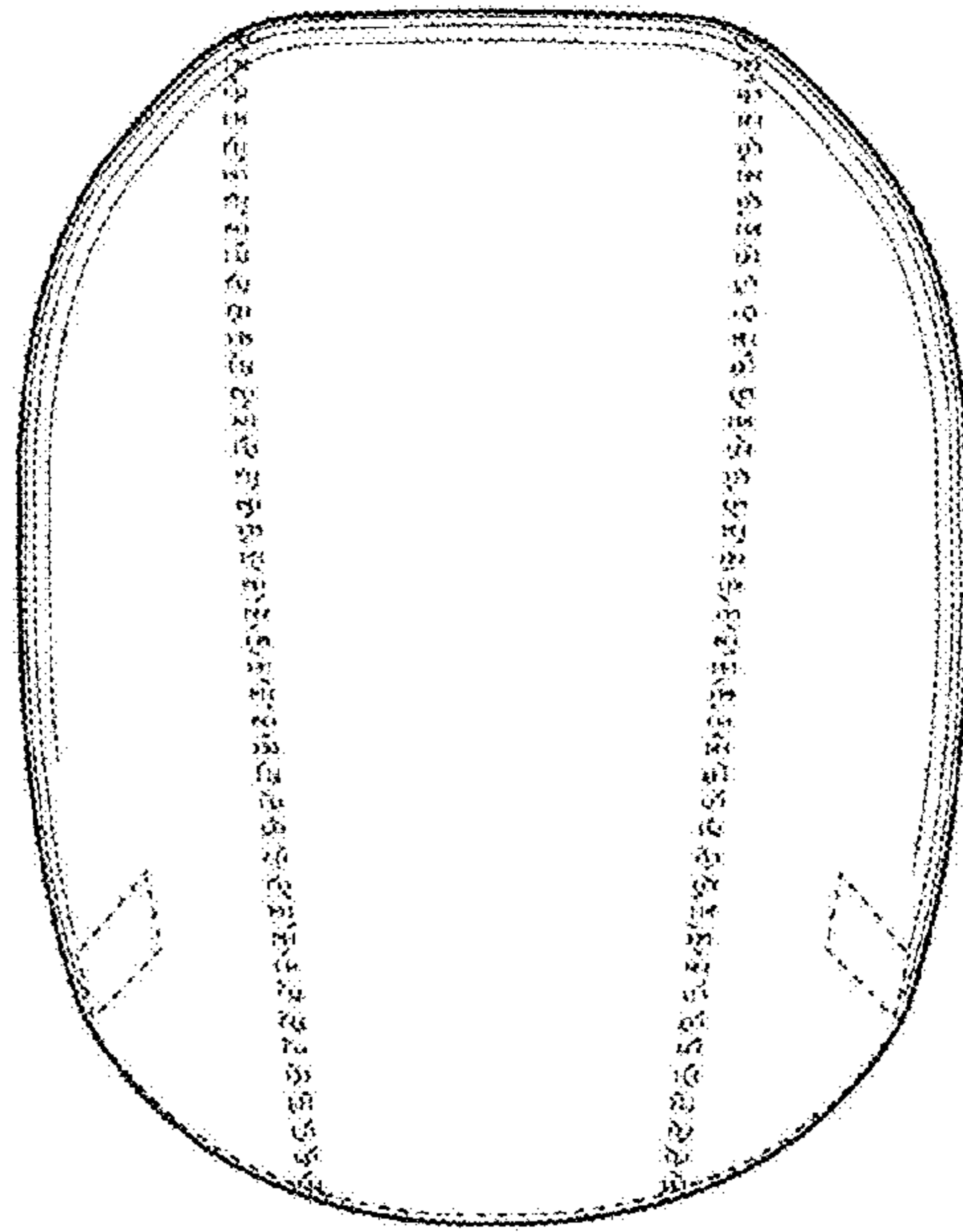

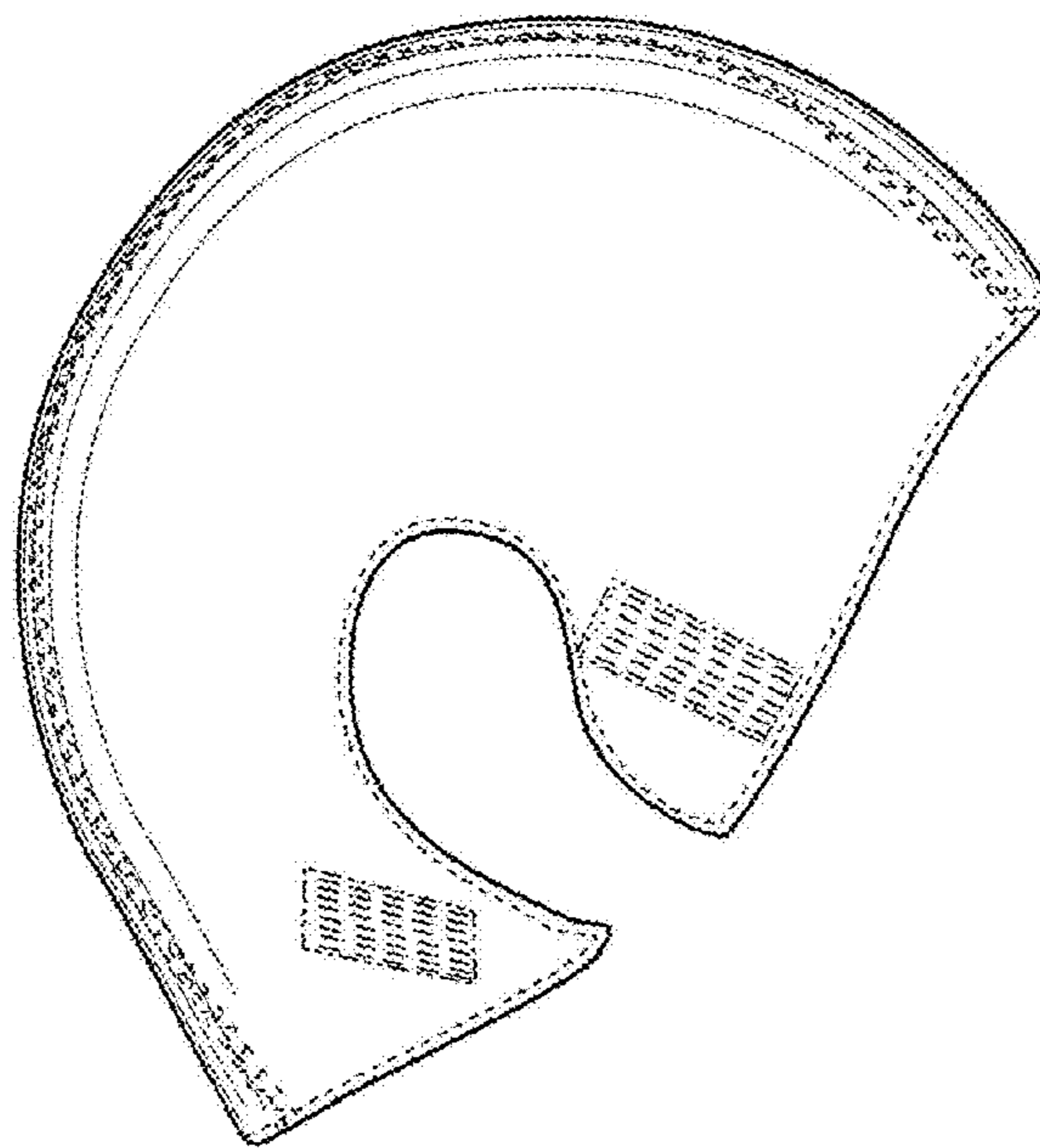

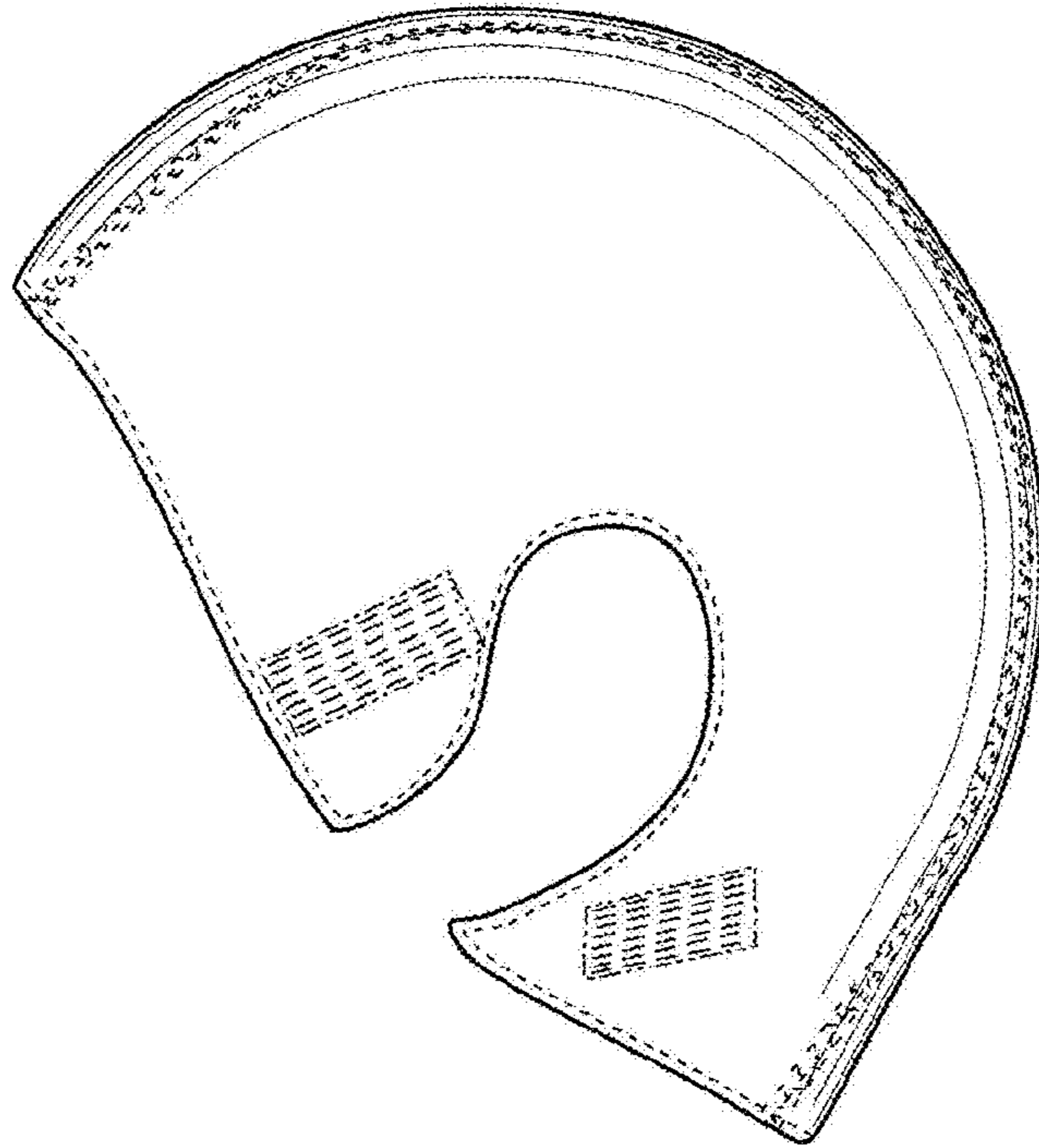

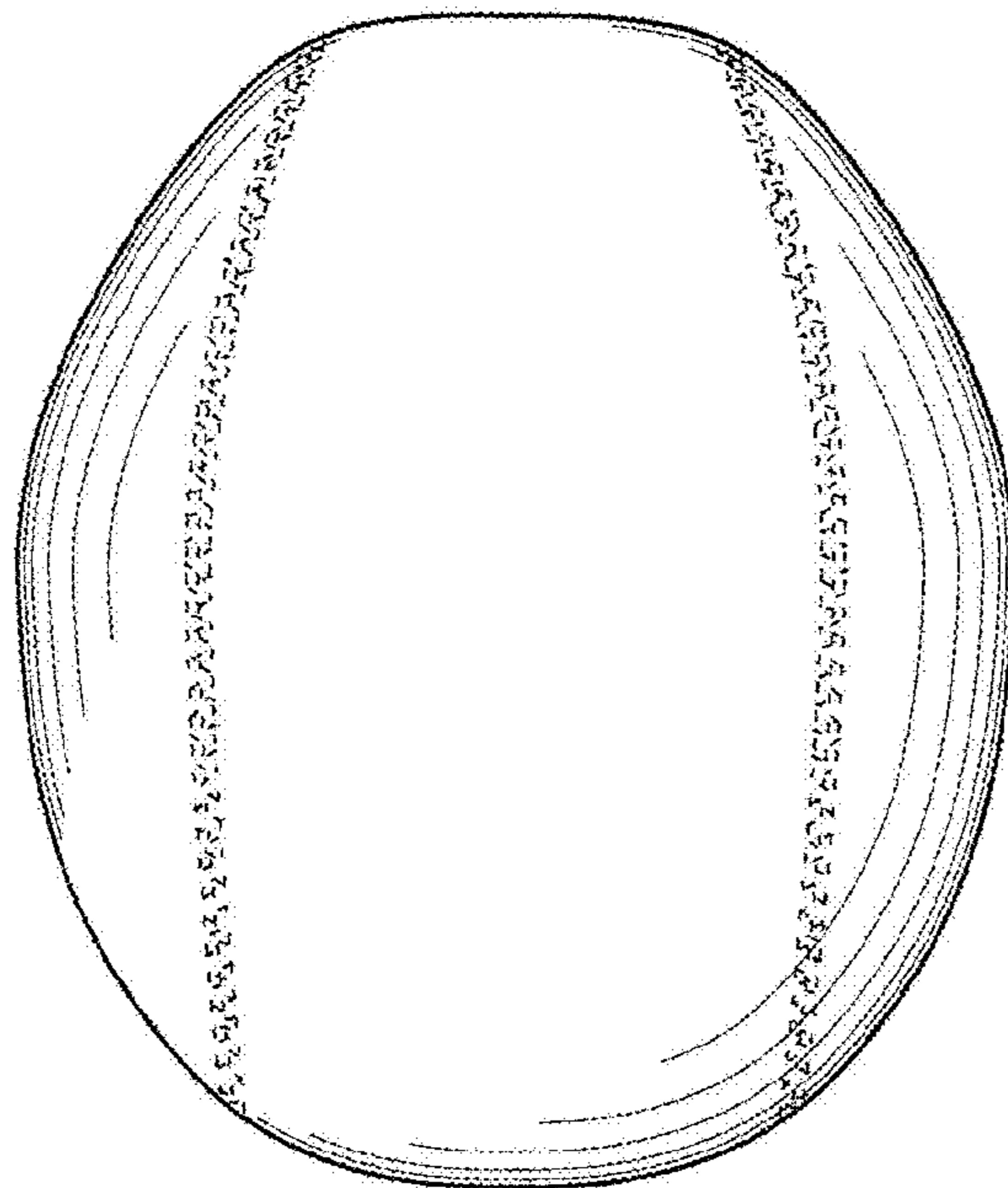
