(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a container cover or trivet, as  
shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the container cover or trivet  
according to one embodiment of the present invention;  
FIG. 2 is a first end elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a second end elevational view thereof, opposite from  
the first end elevational view;  
FIG. 4 is a third side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, wherein the bottom is flat  
and devoid of ornamentation;  
FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of the container cover or trivet  
according to a second embodiment of the present invention;  
FIG. 7 is a first side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a second side elevational view thereof, opposite  
from the first side elevational view;  
FIG. 9 is a third side elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof, wherein the bottom is flat  
and devoid of ornamentation.

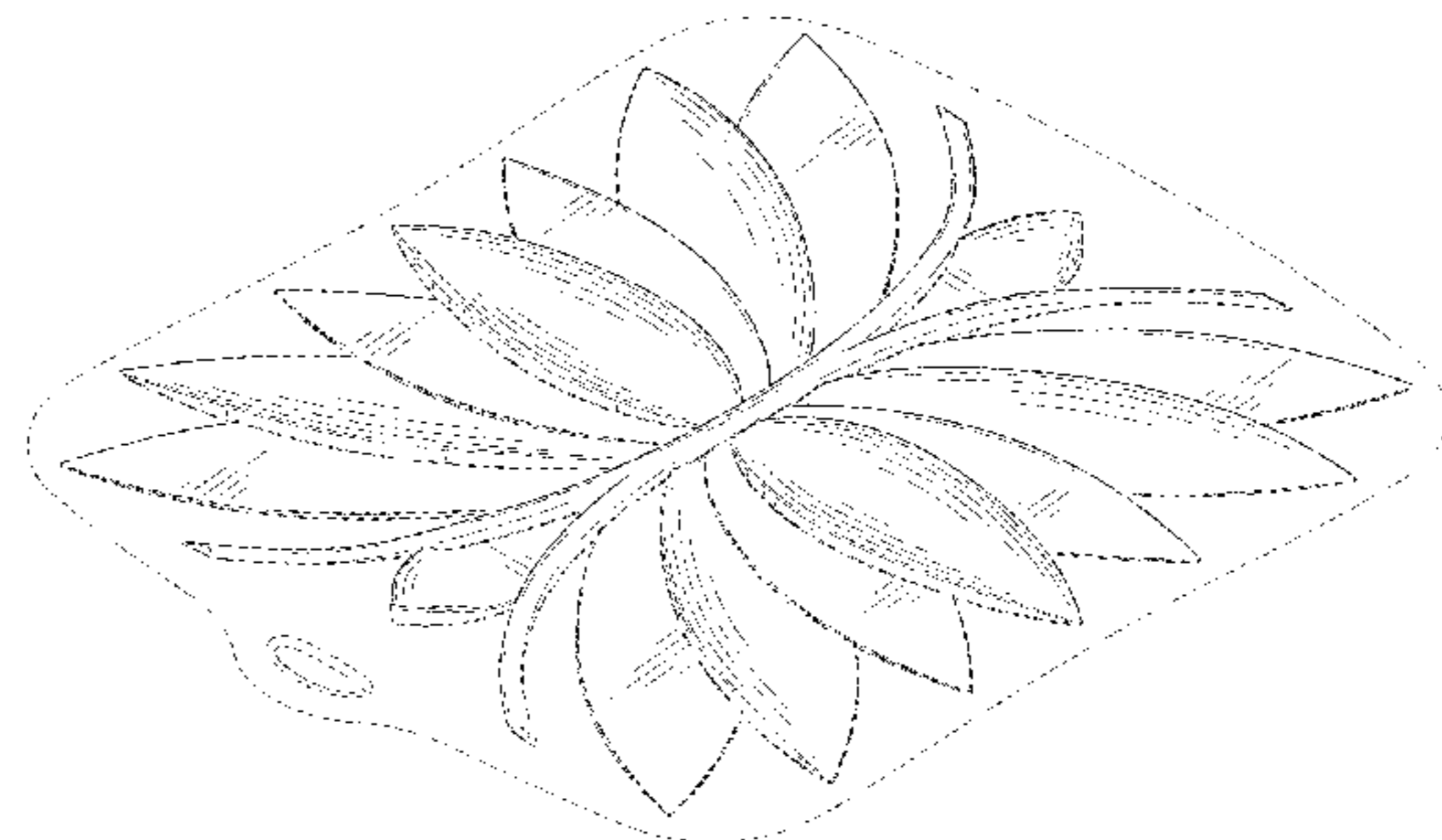
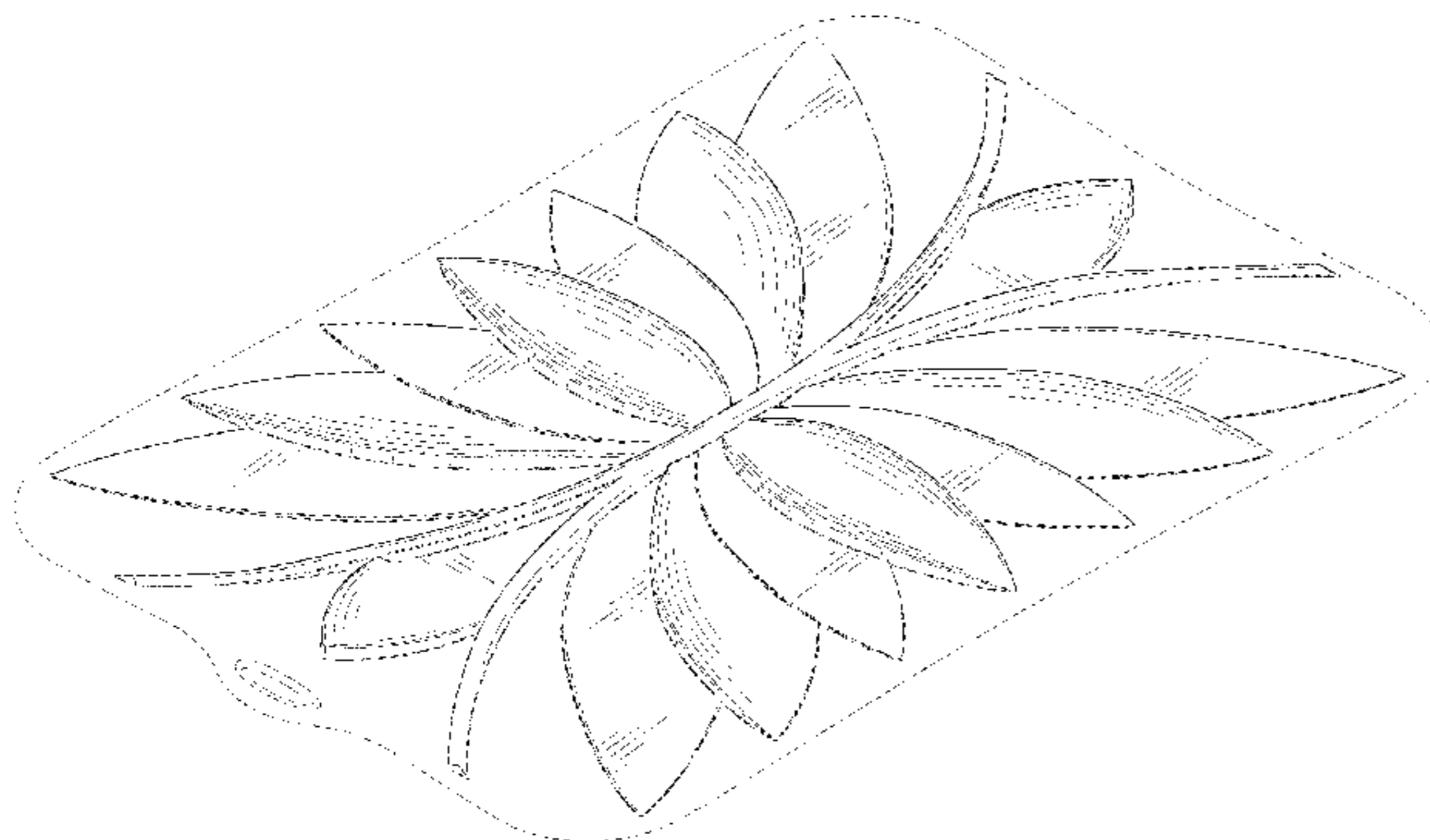

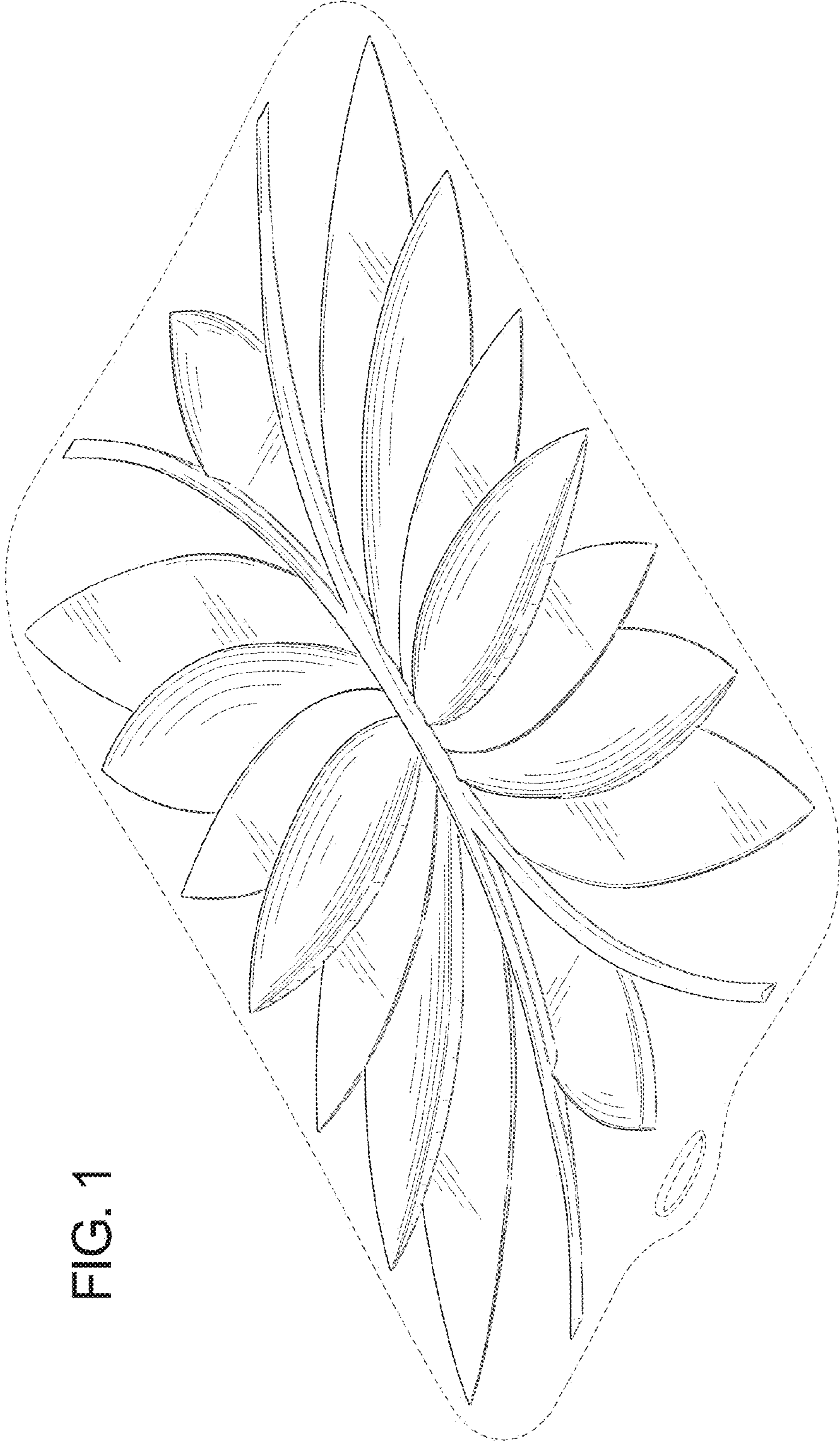

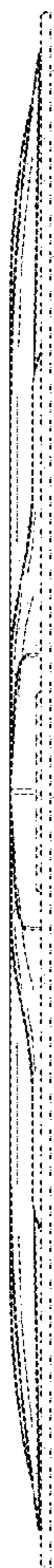

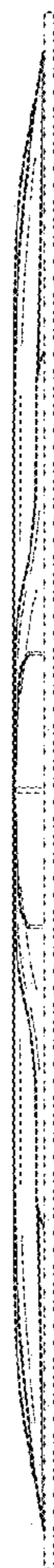
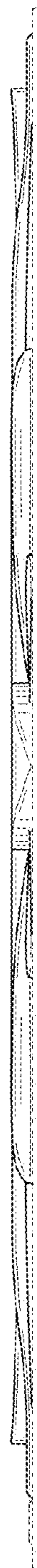

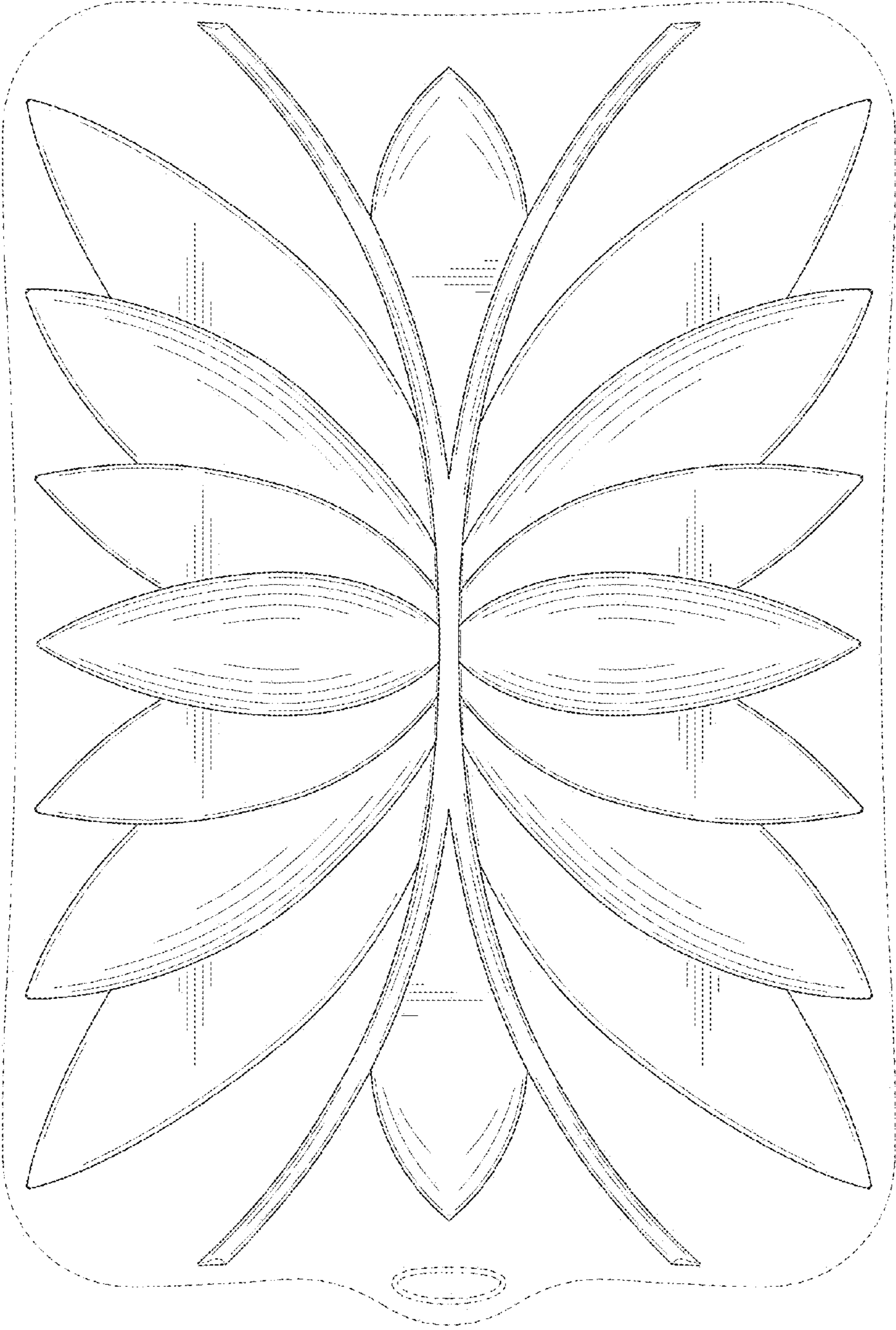

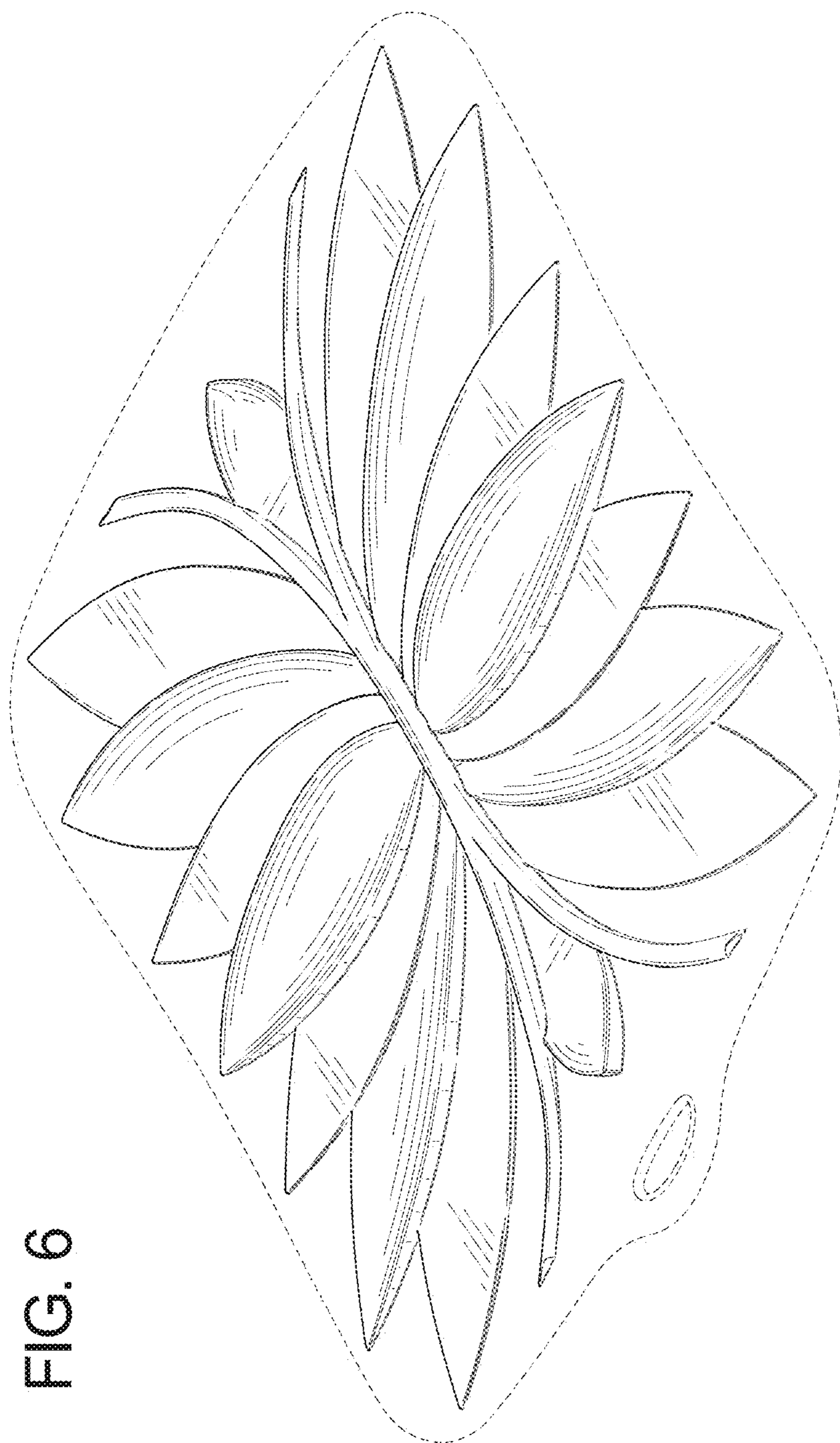

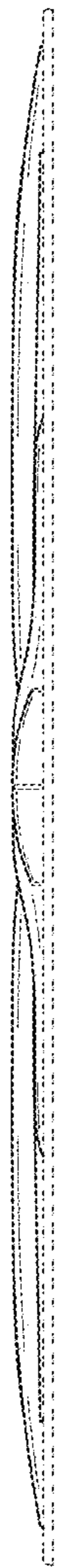
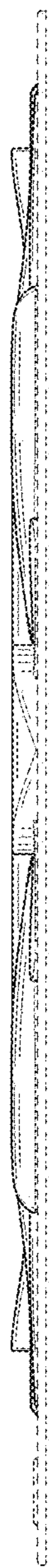

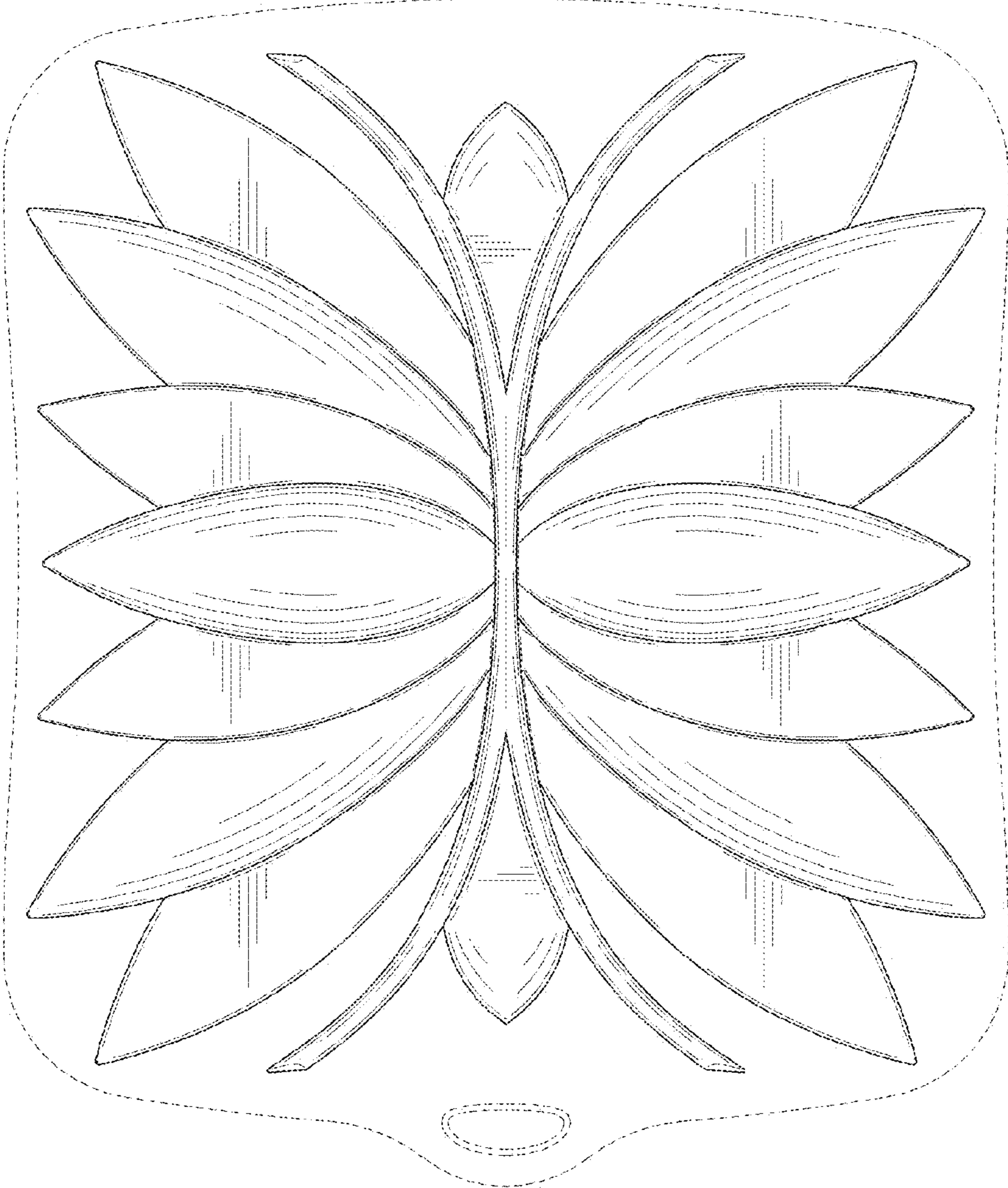
