(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a modular bag, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the modular bag including a large bag and small bag whereby the large bag and small bag are used in combination;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the large bag in use independent of the small bag;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the large bag in use independent of the small bag;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the large bag in use independent of the small bag;

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the large bag in use independent of the small bag;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the large bag in use independent of the small bag;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the large bag in use independent of the small bag;

FIG. 8 is a front view of the small bag in use independent of the large bag;

FIG. 9 is a rear view of the small bag in use independent of the large bag;

FIG. 10 is a right side view of the small bag in use independent of the large bag;

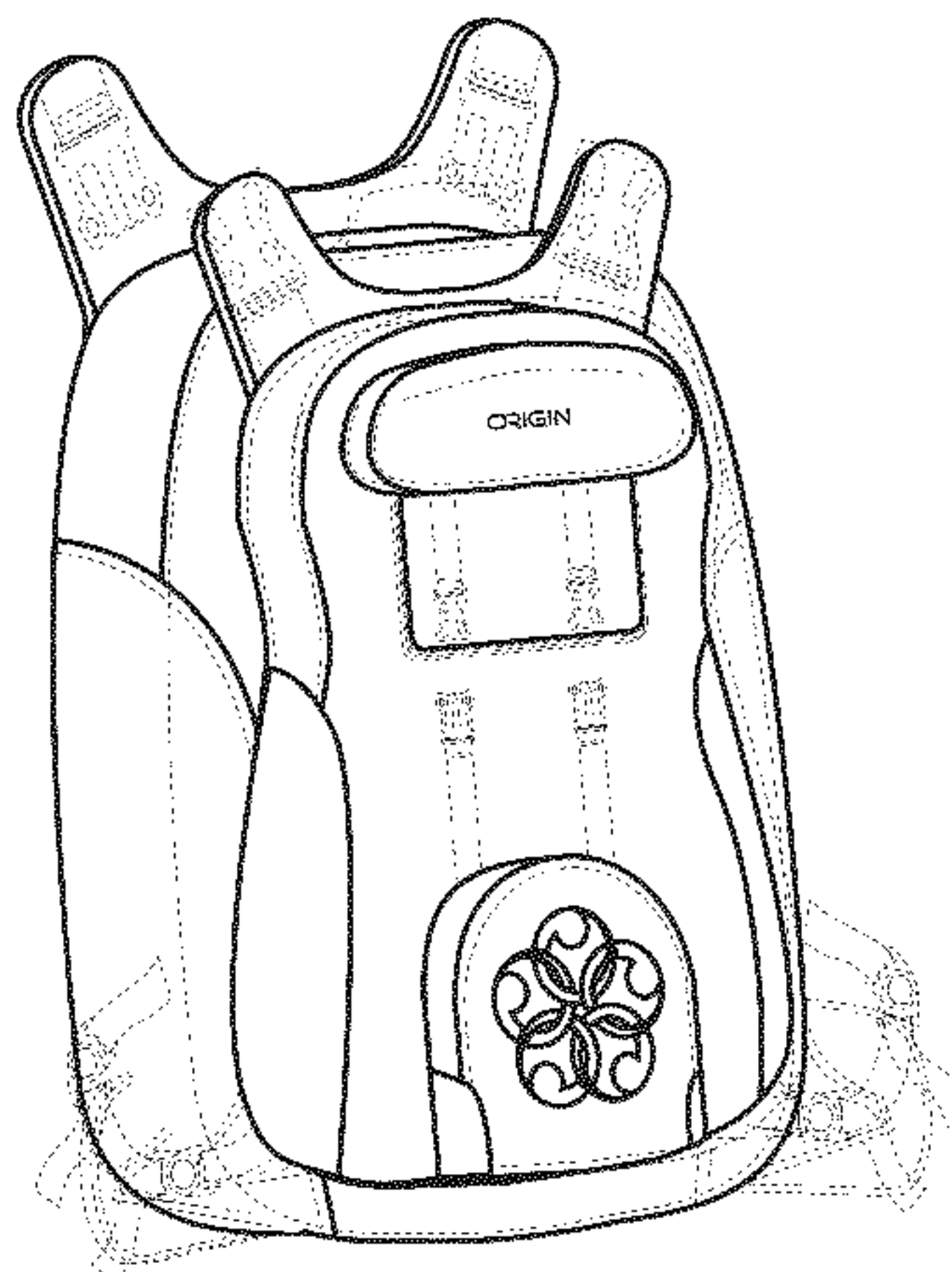
FIG. 11 is a left side view of the small bag in use independent of the large bag;

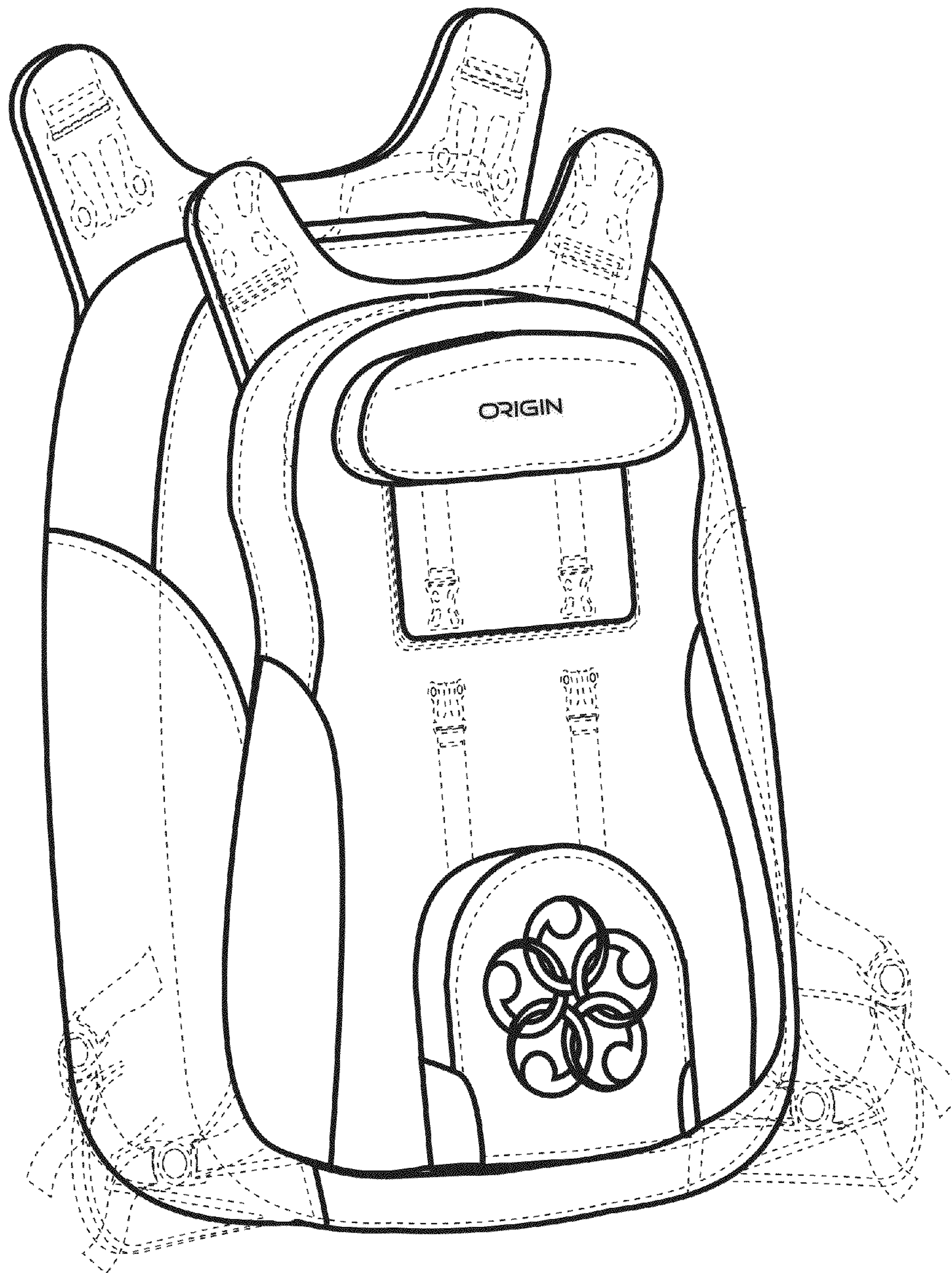

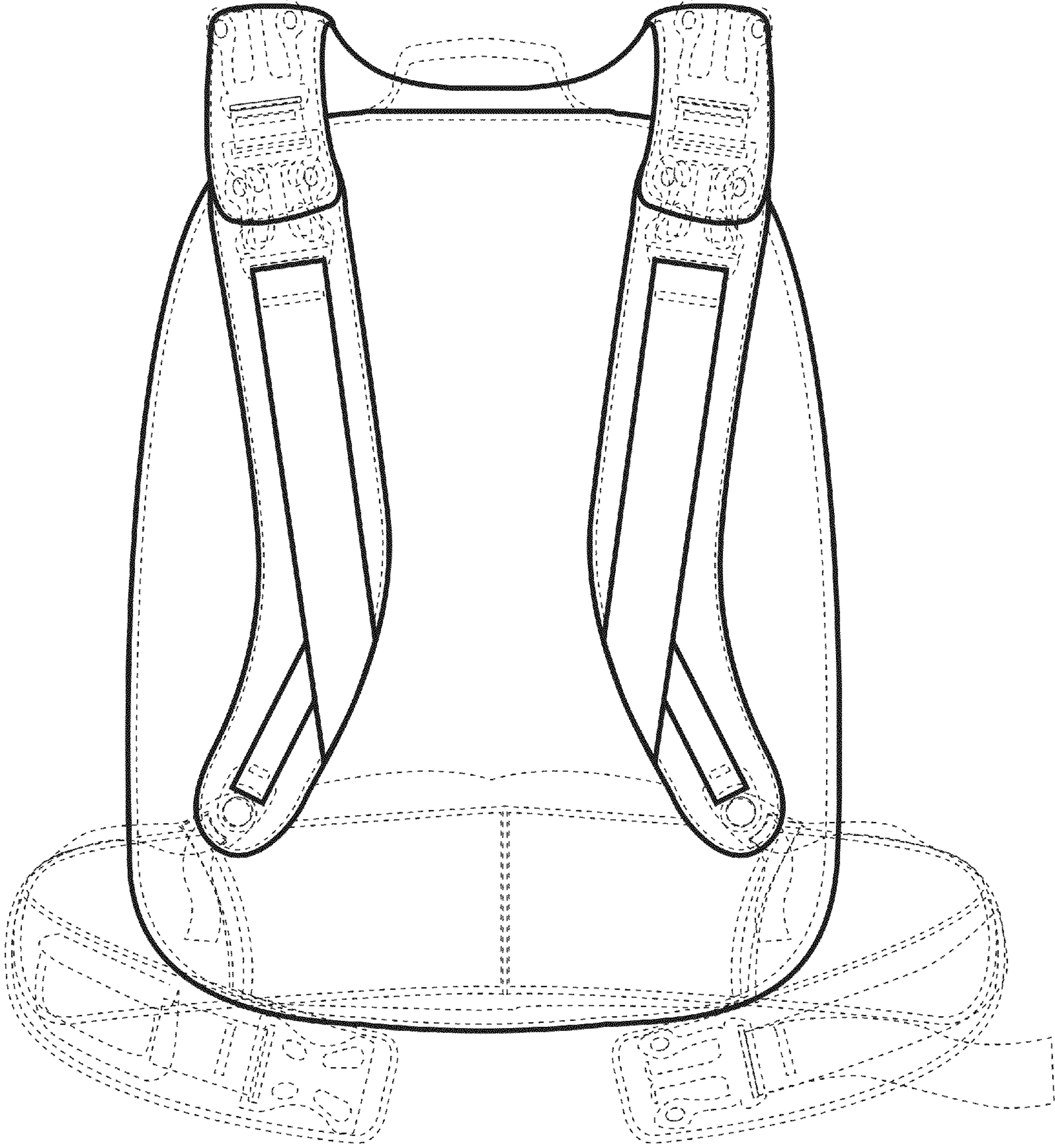

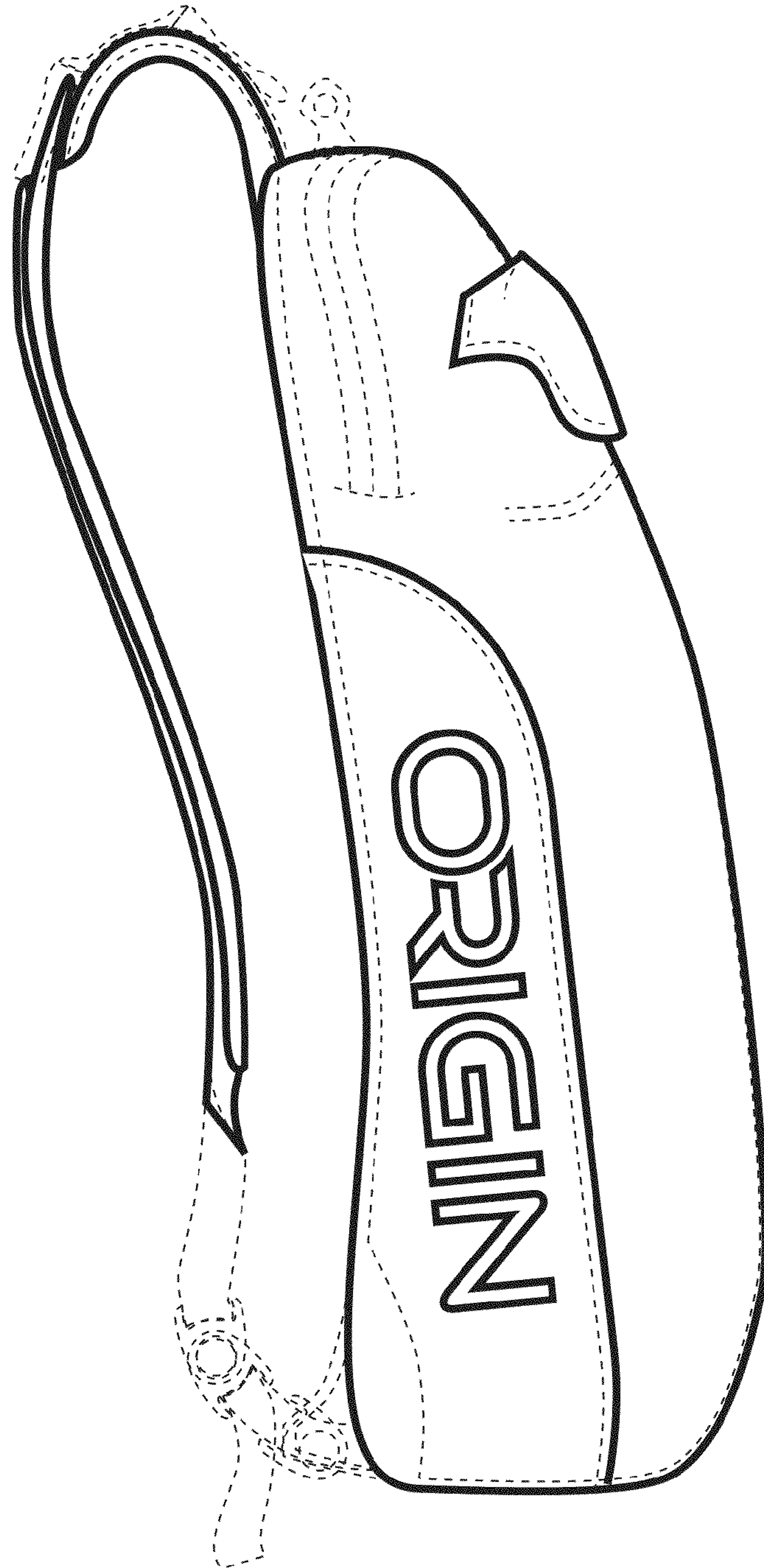

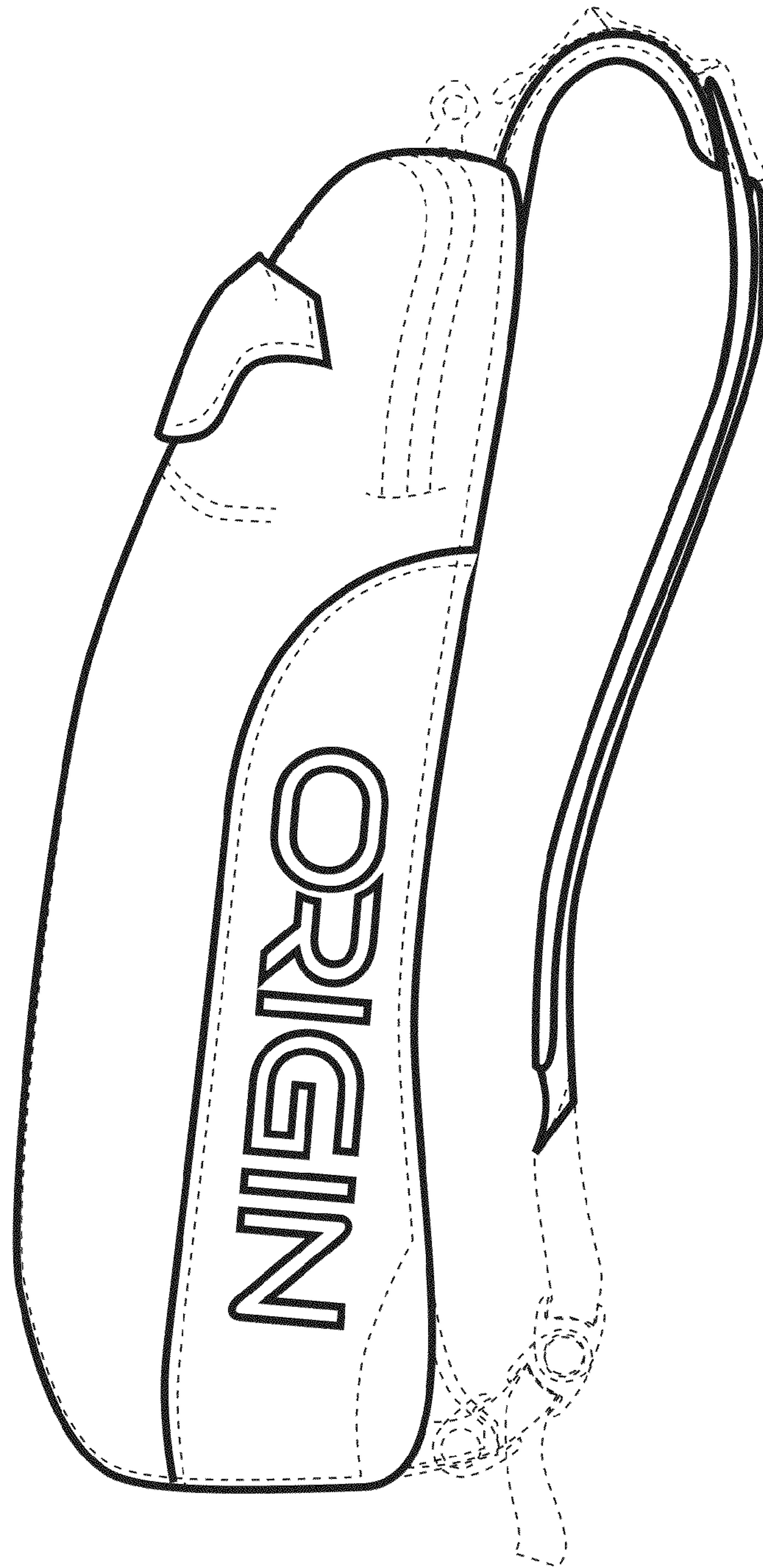

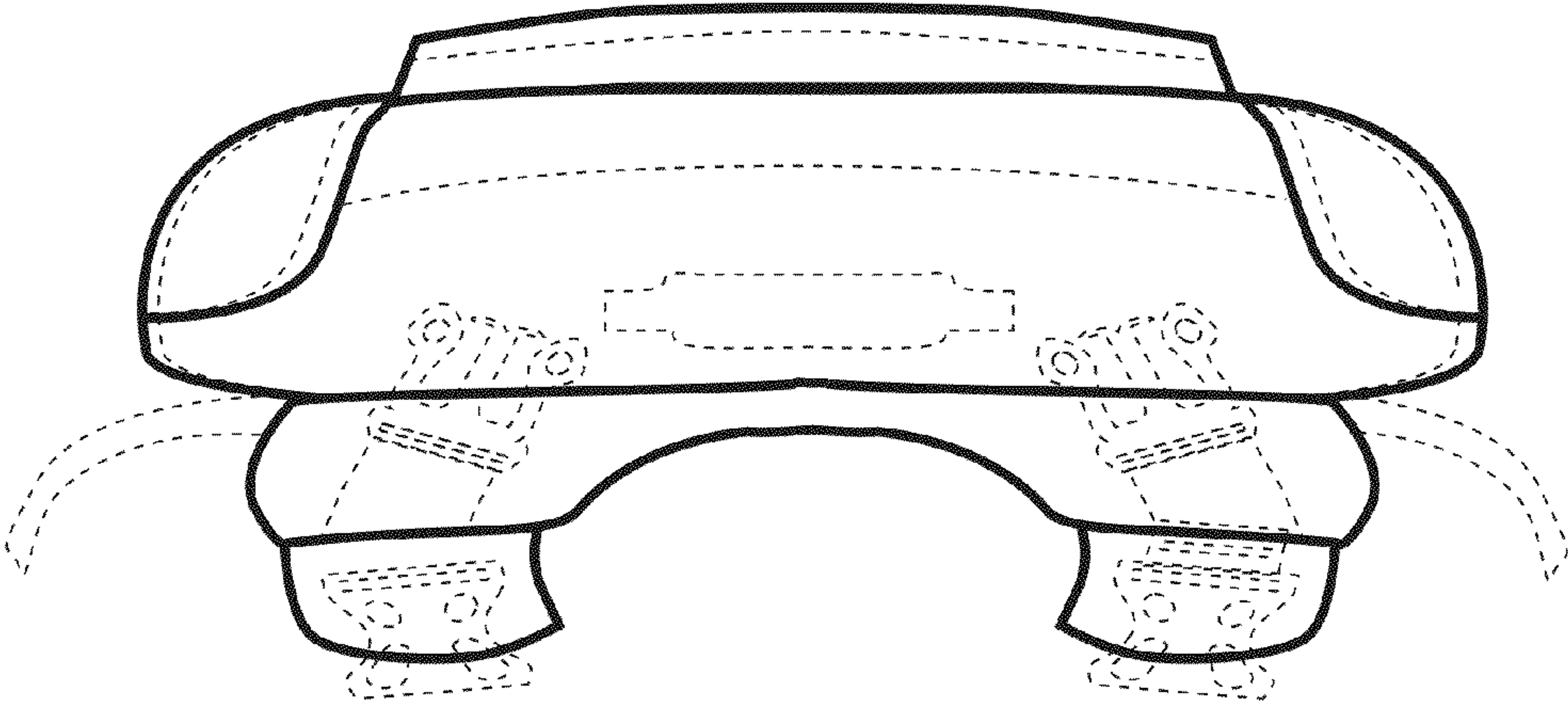

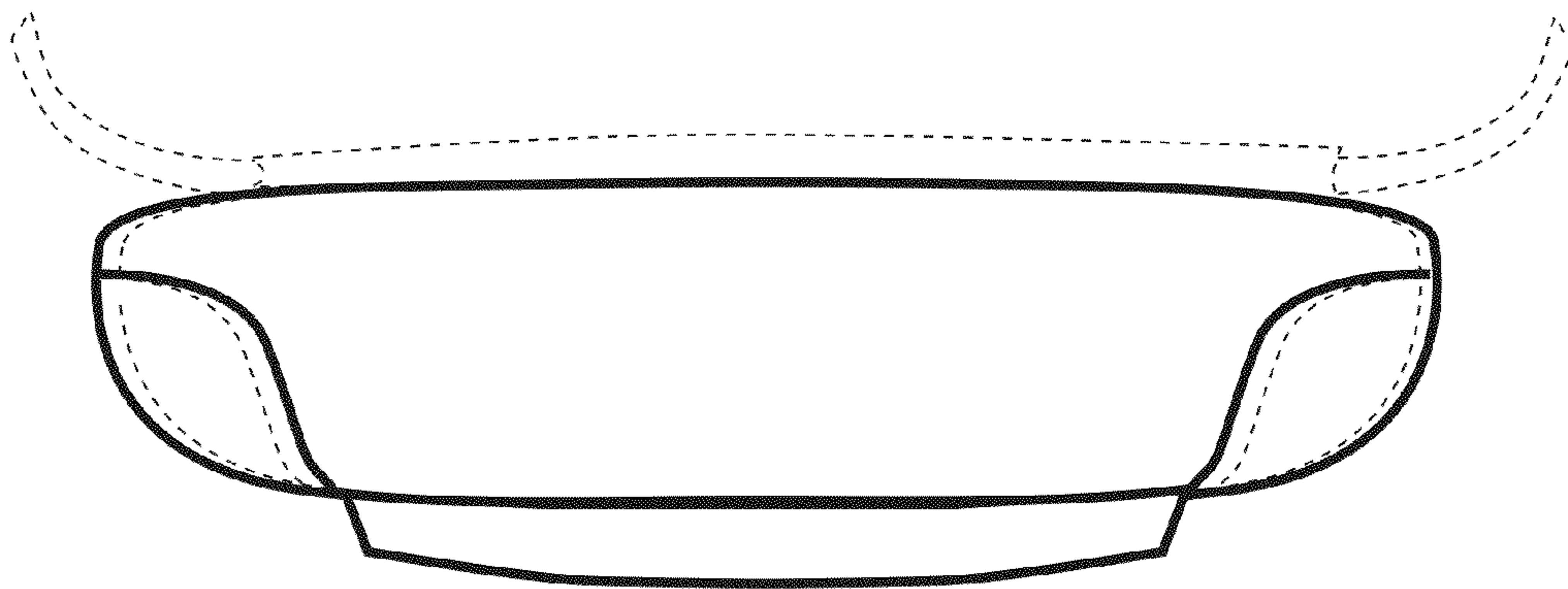

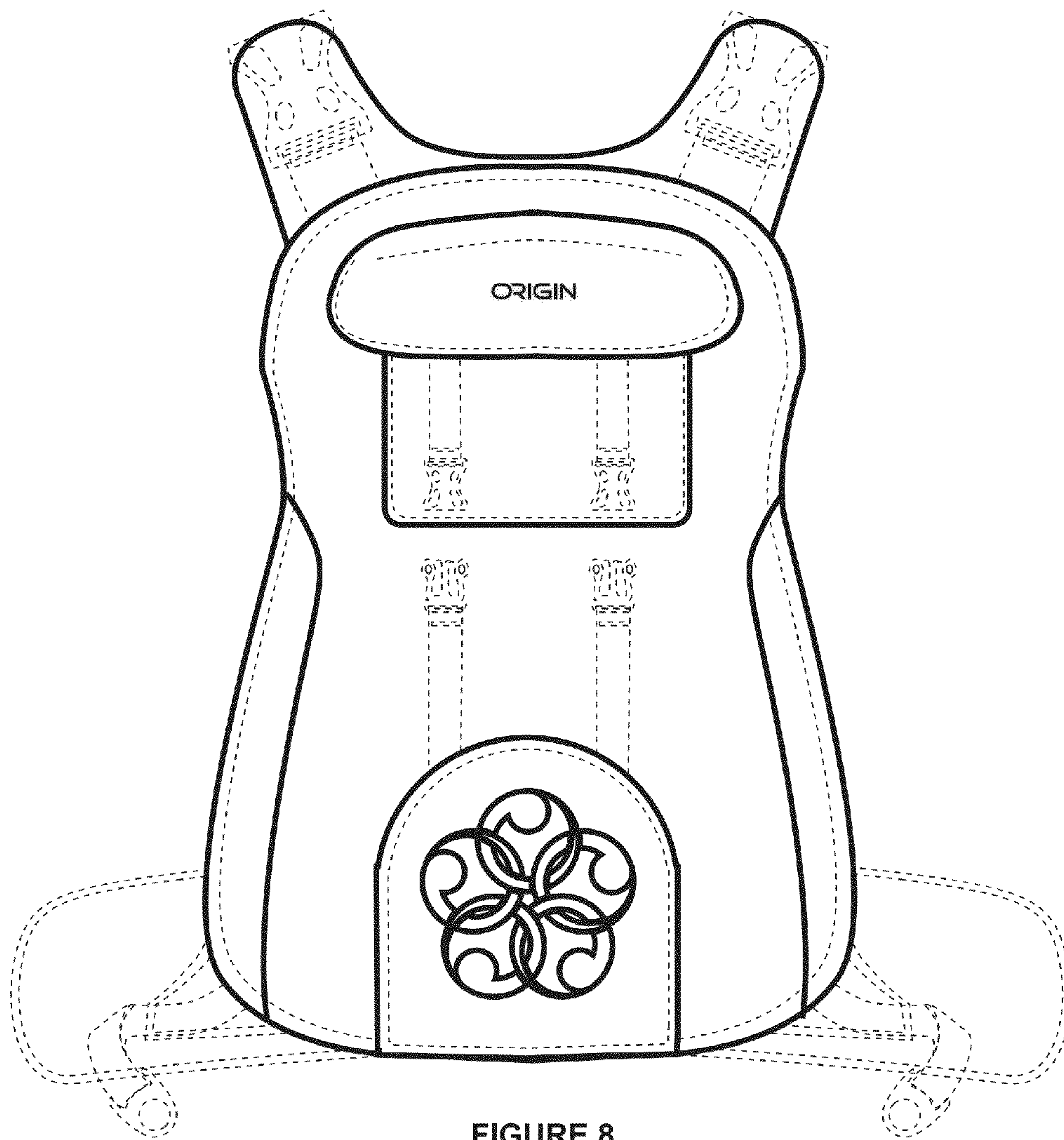

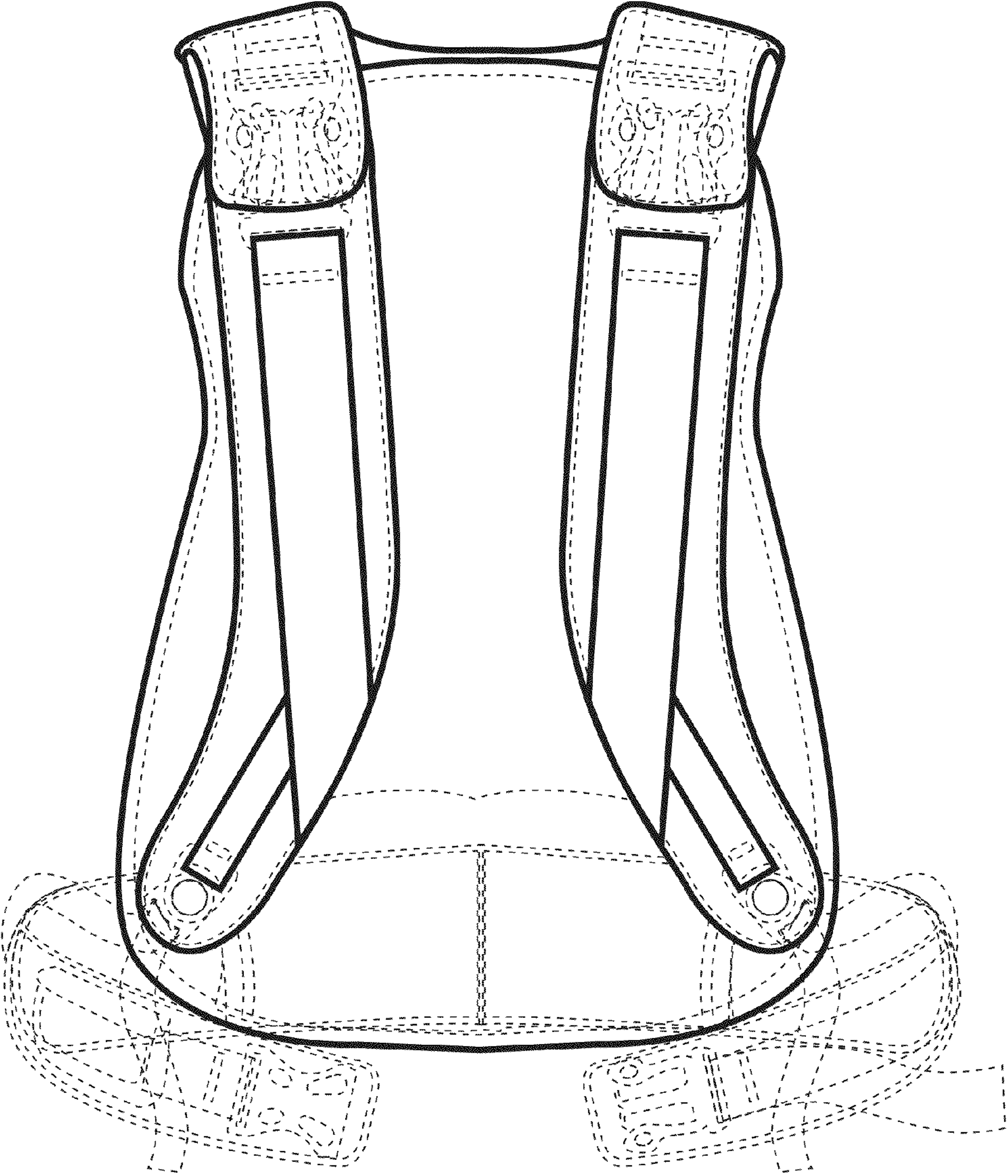

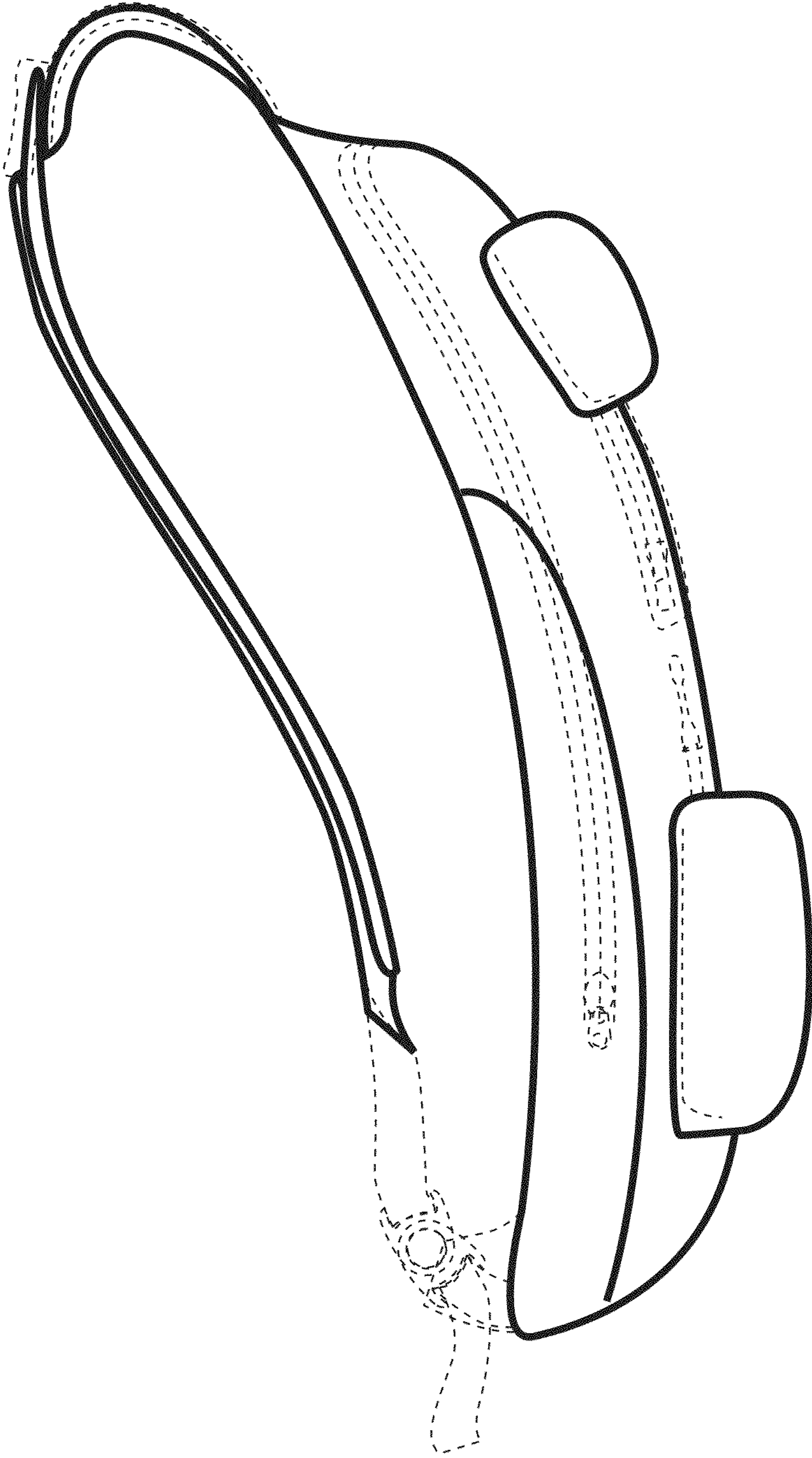

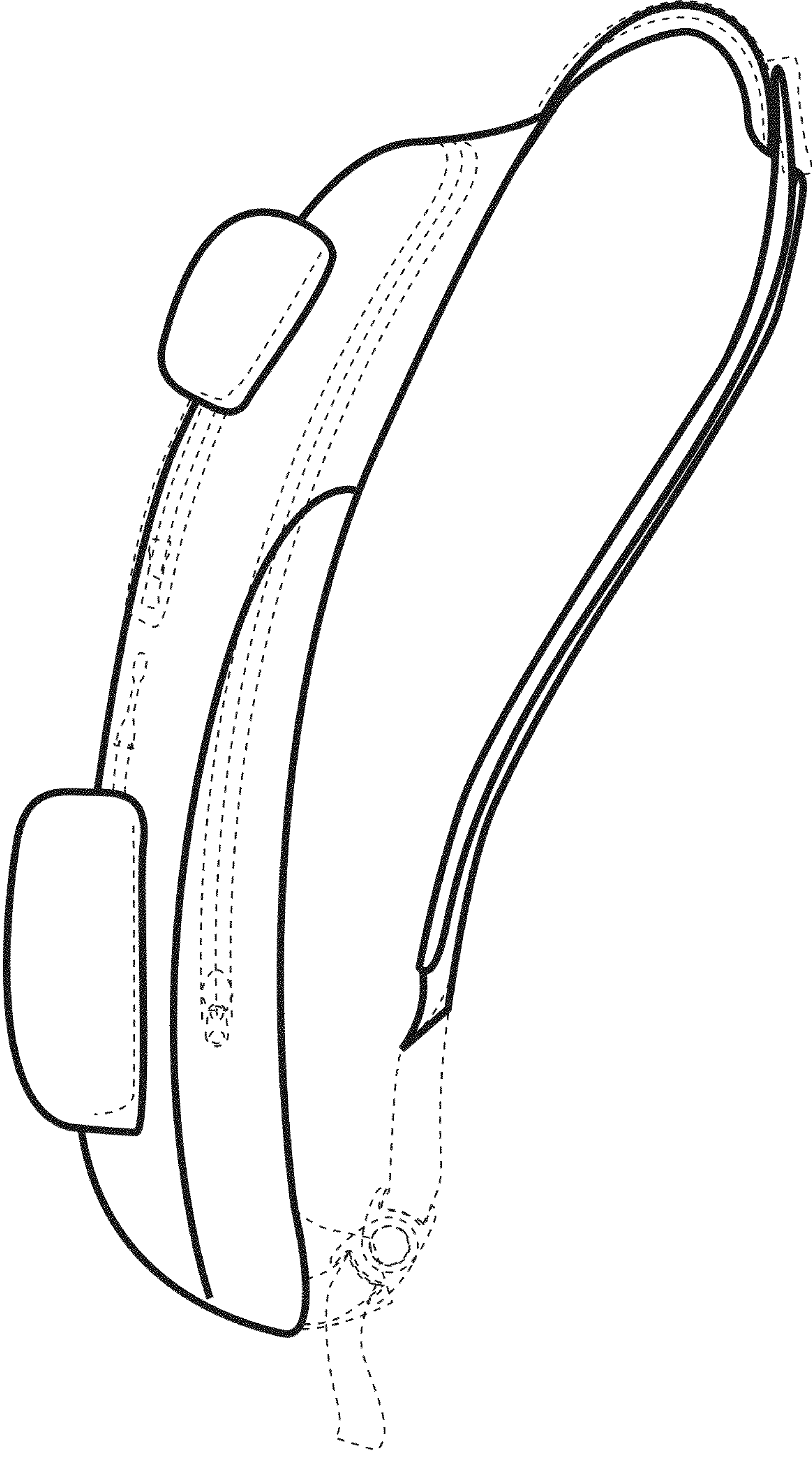

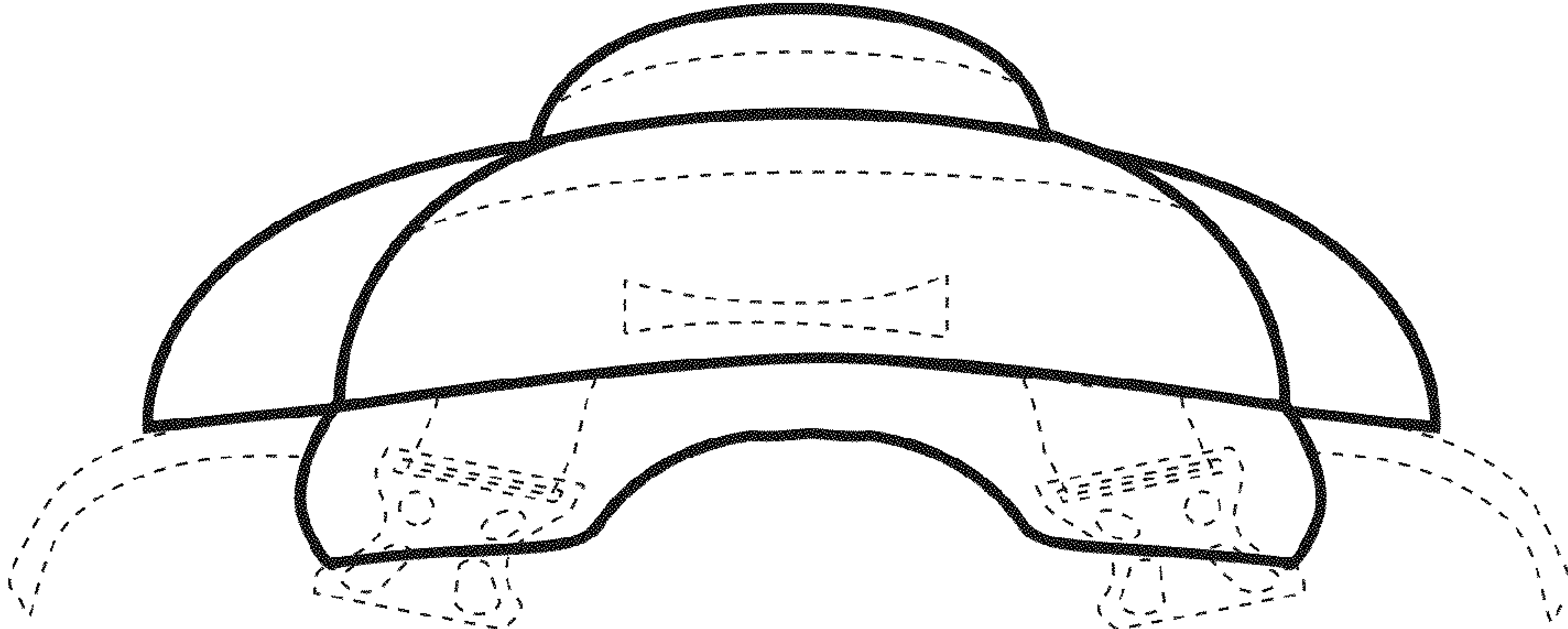

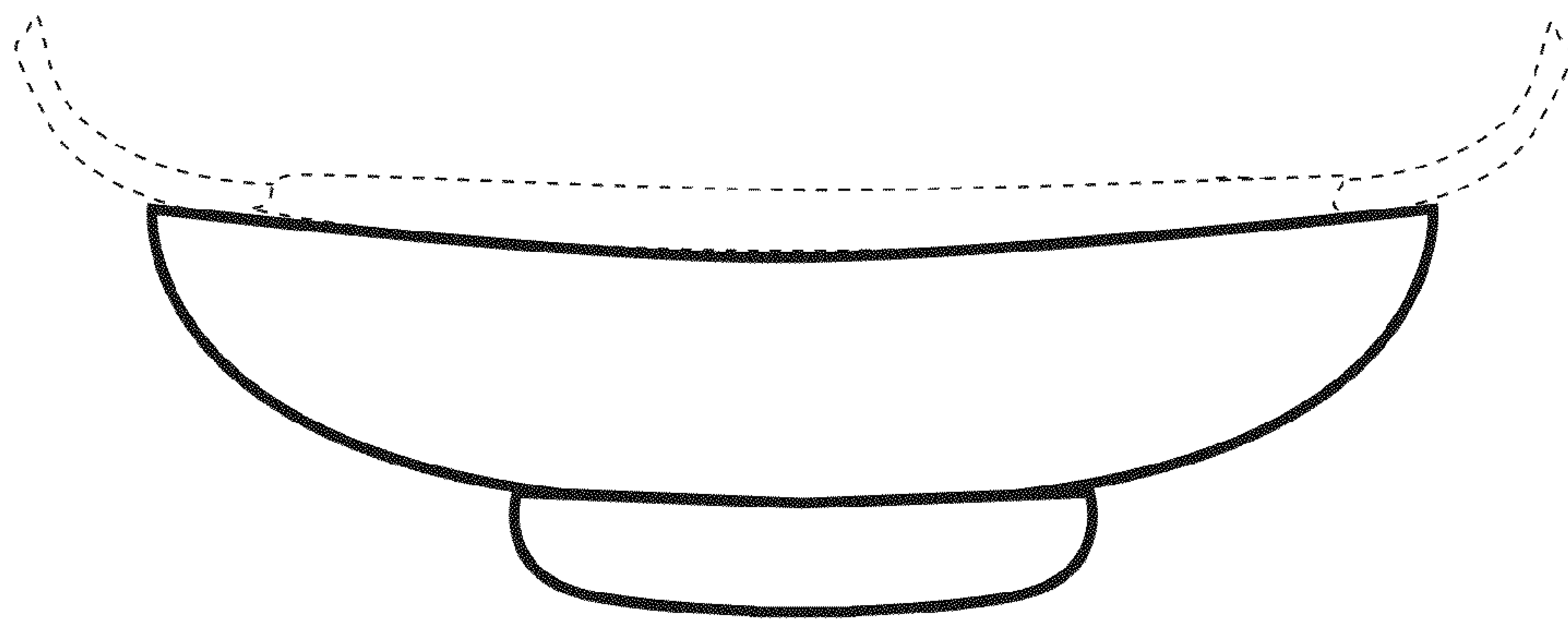
