(57) **CLAIM**

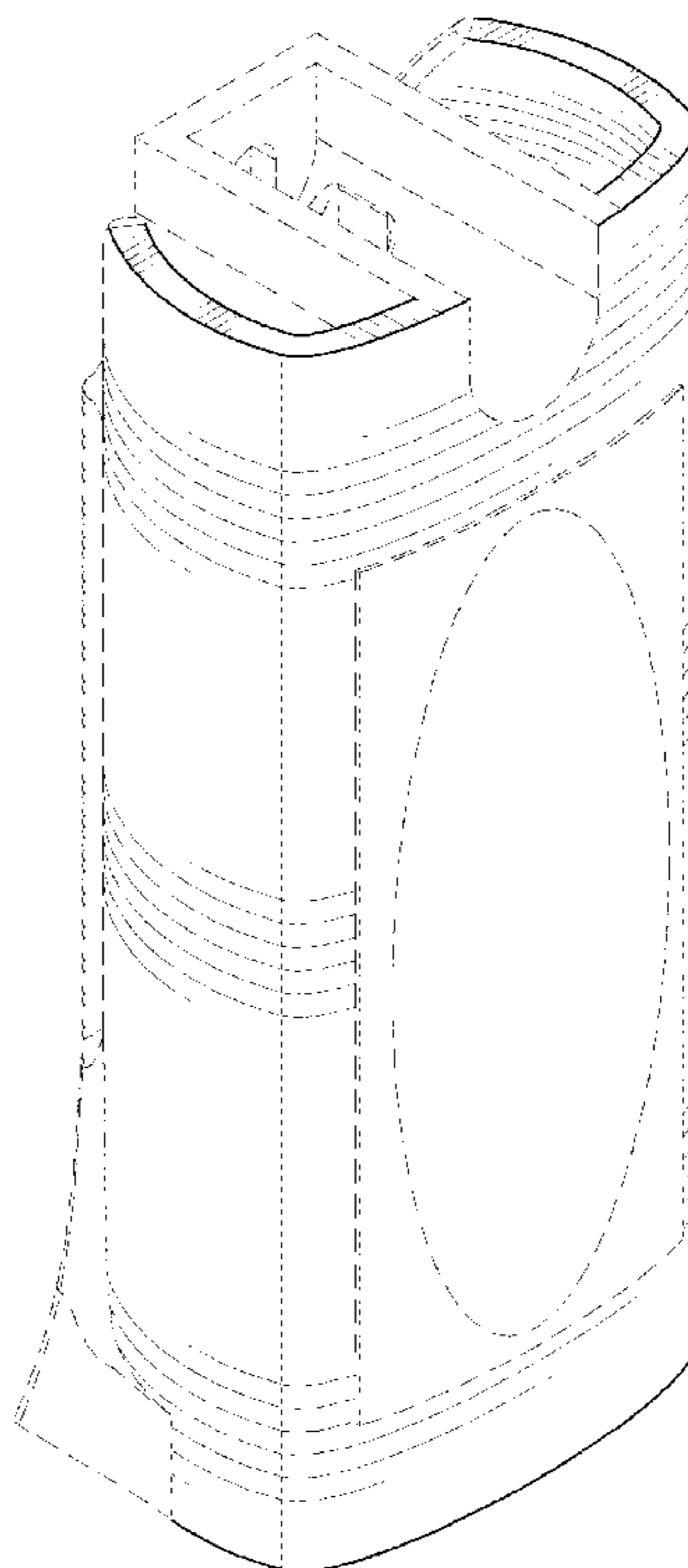
The ornamental design for a push button cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a push button cover showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a second perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a back side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 9 is a view of the push button cover covering a door bell push button.

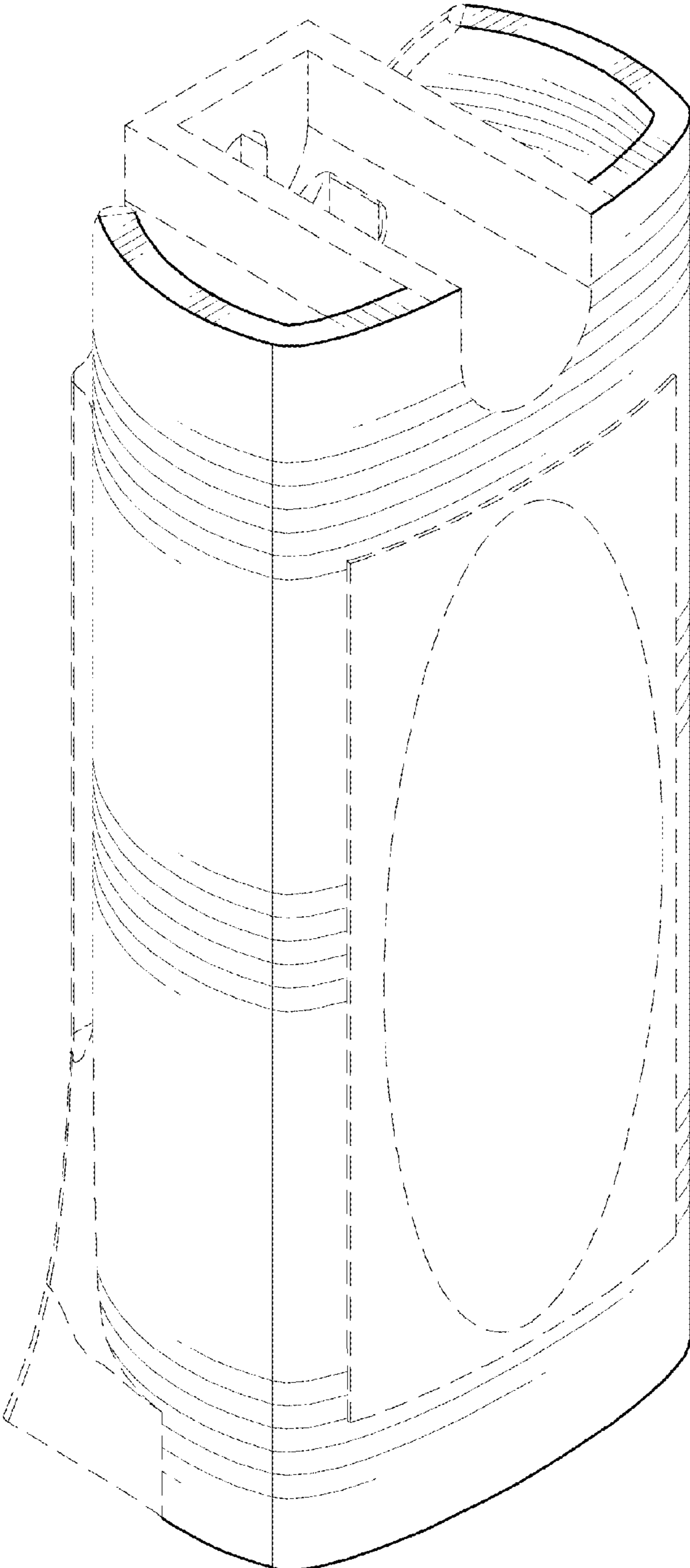

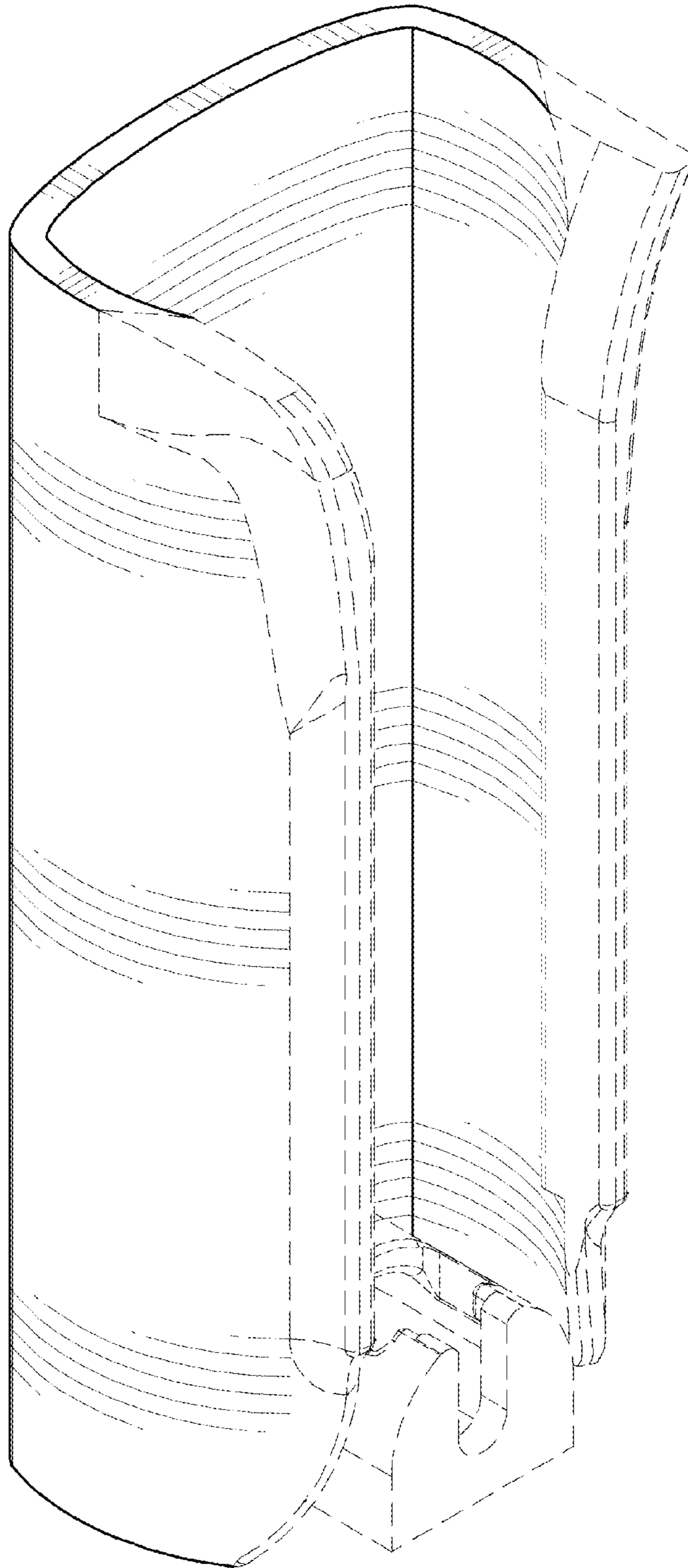

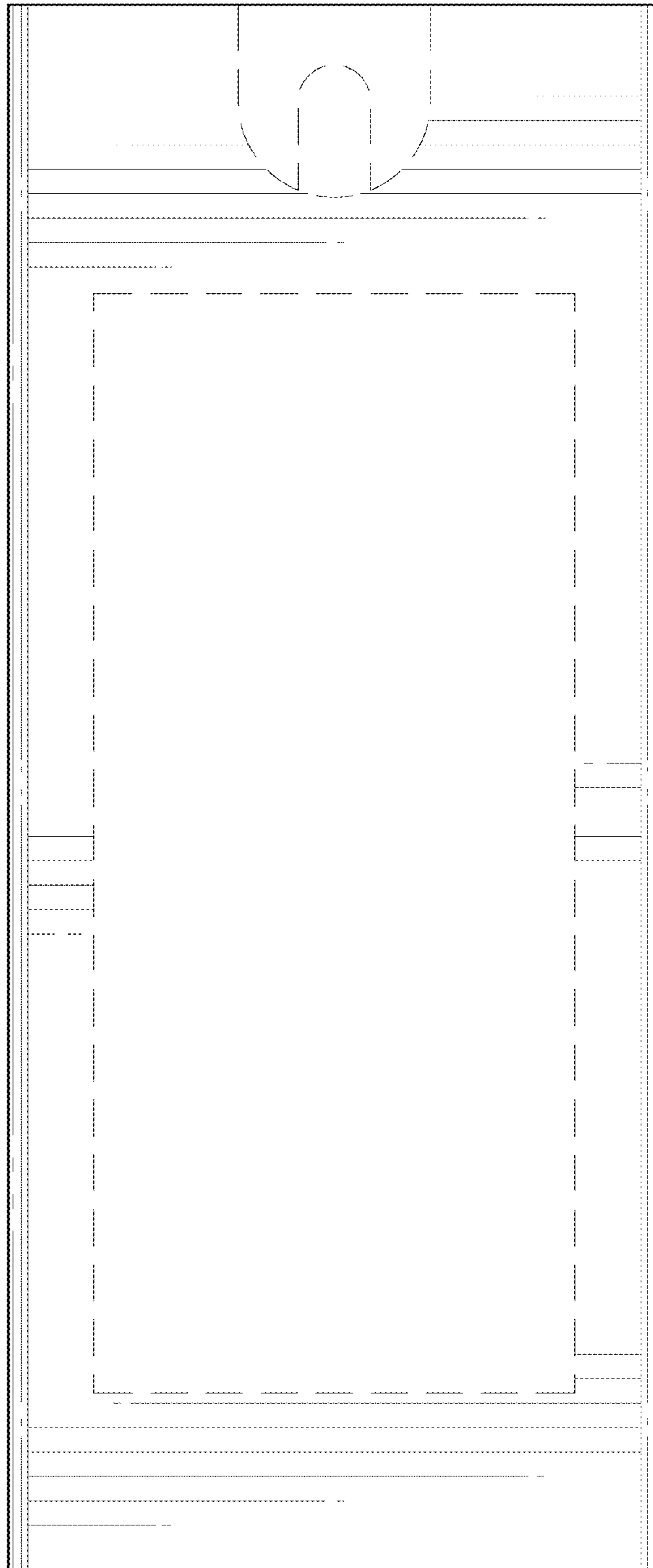

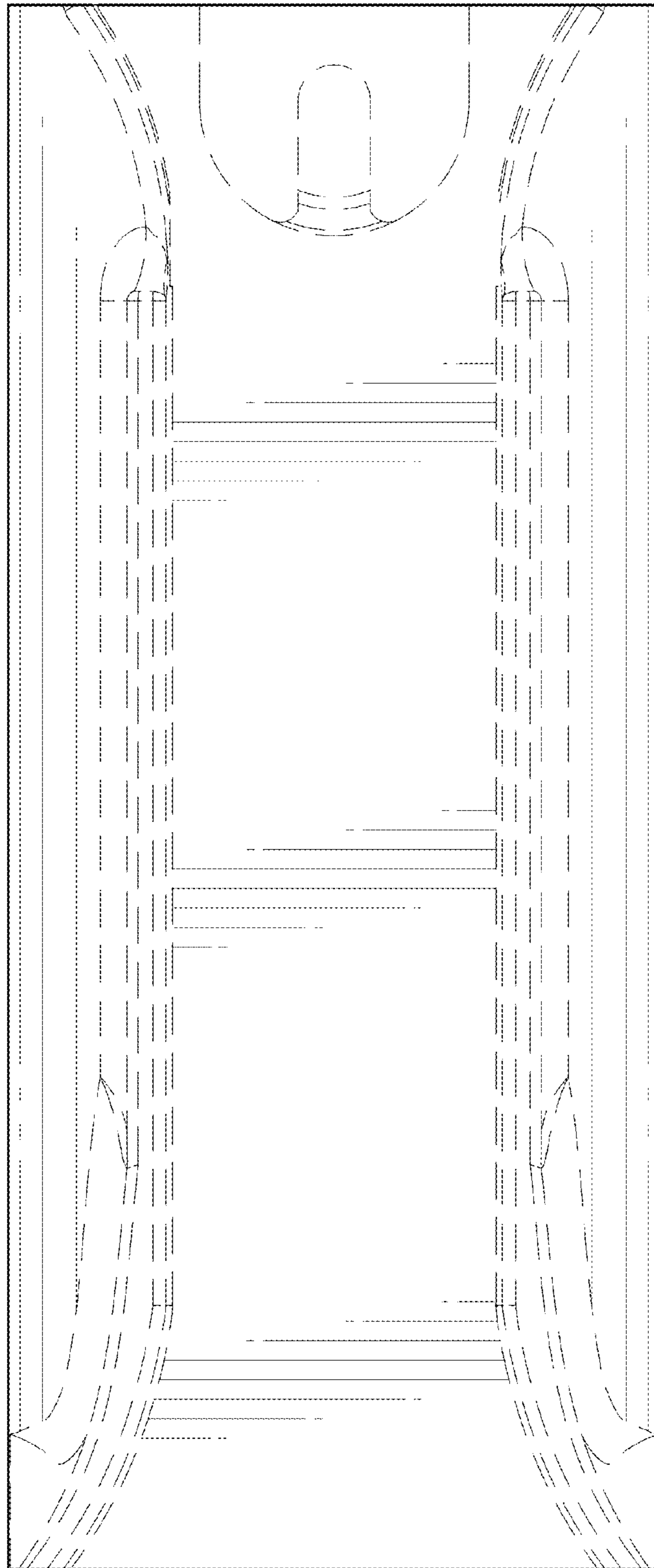

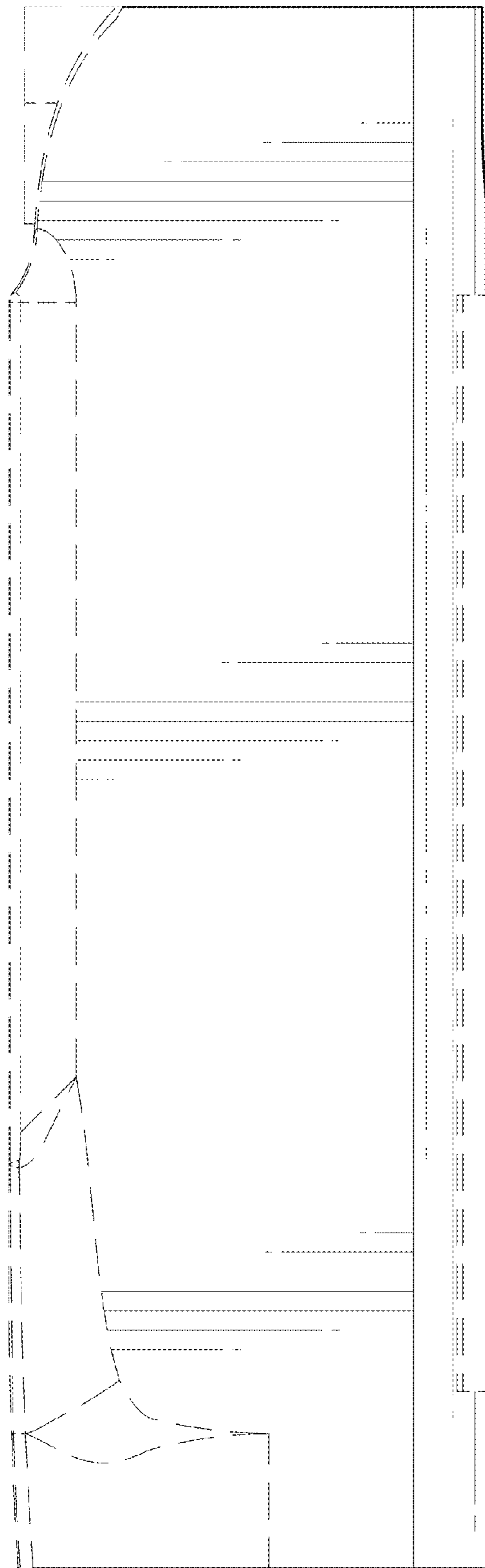

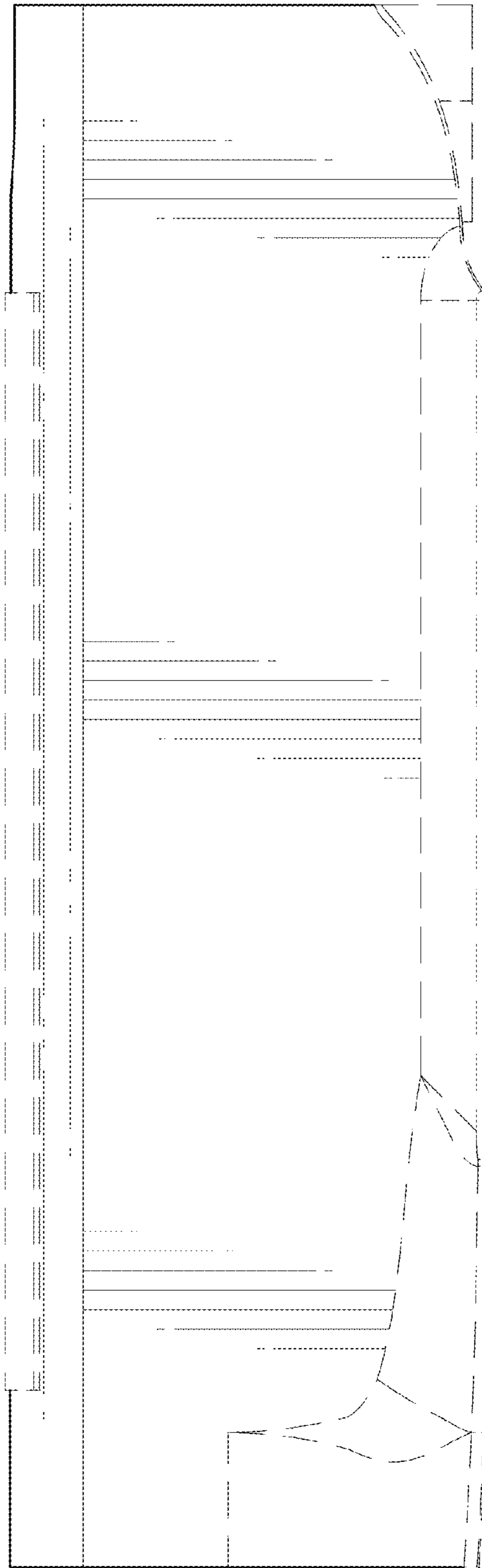

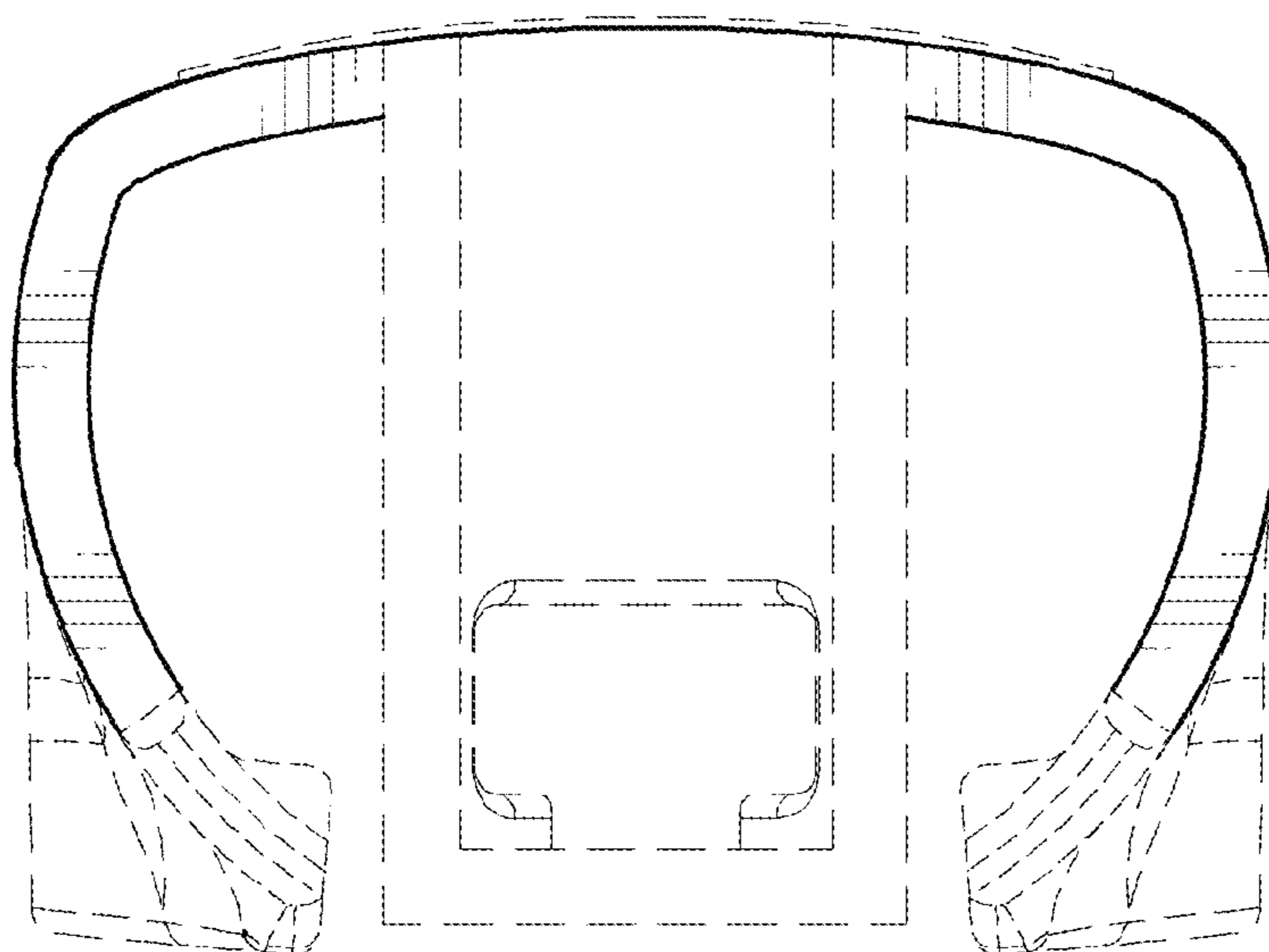

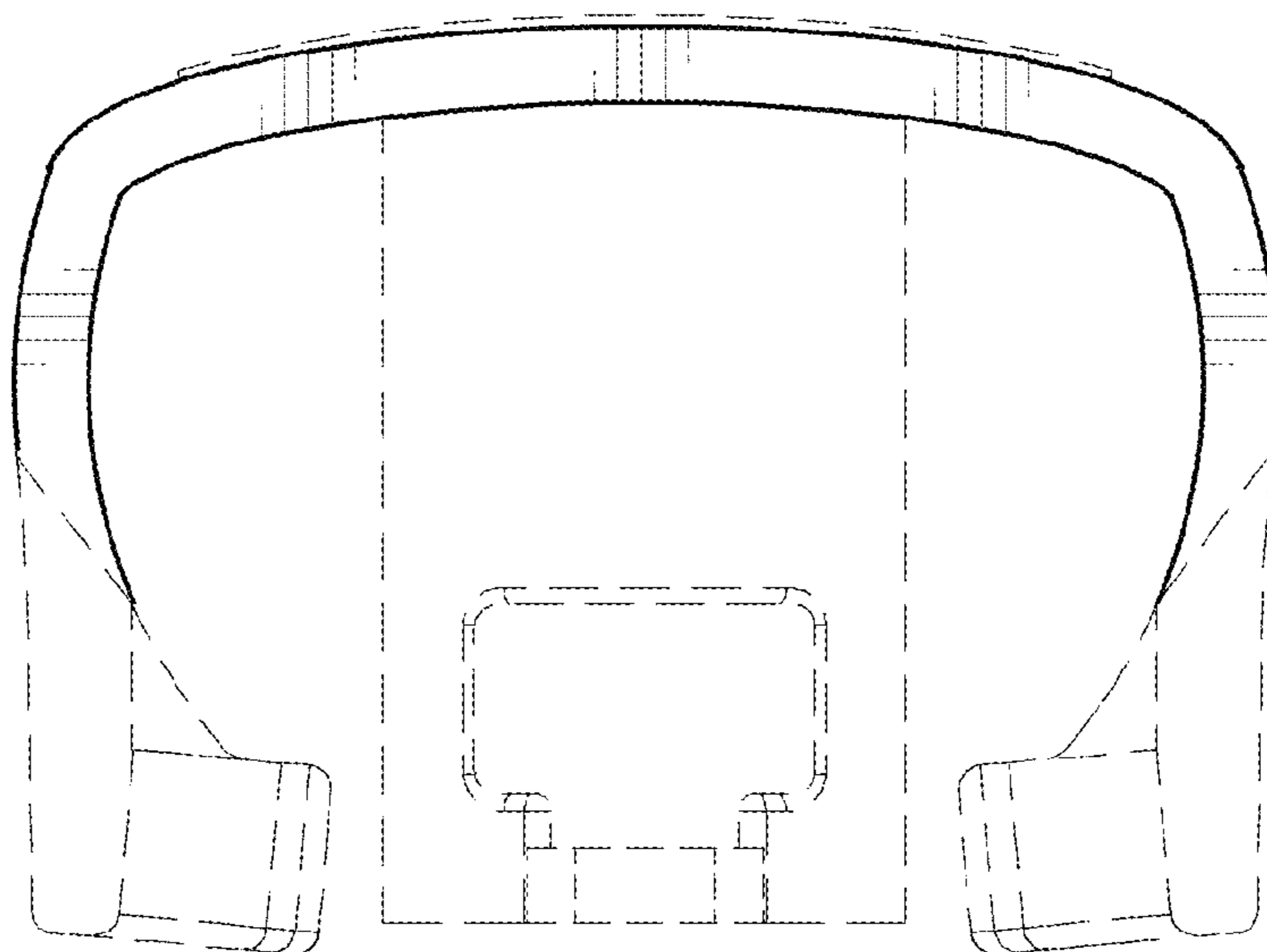

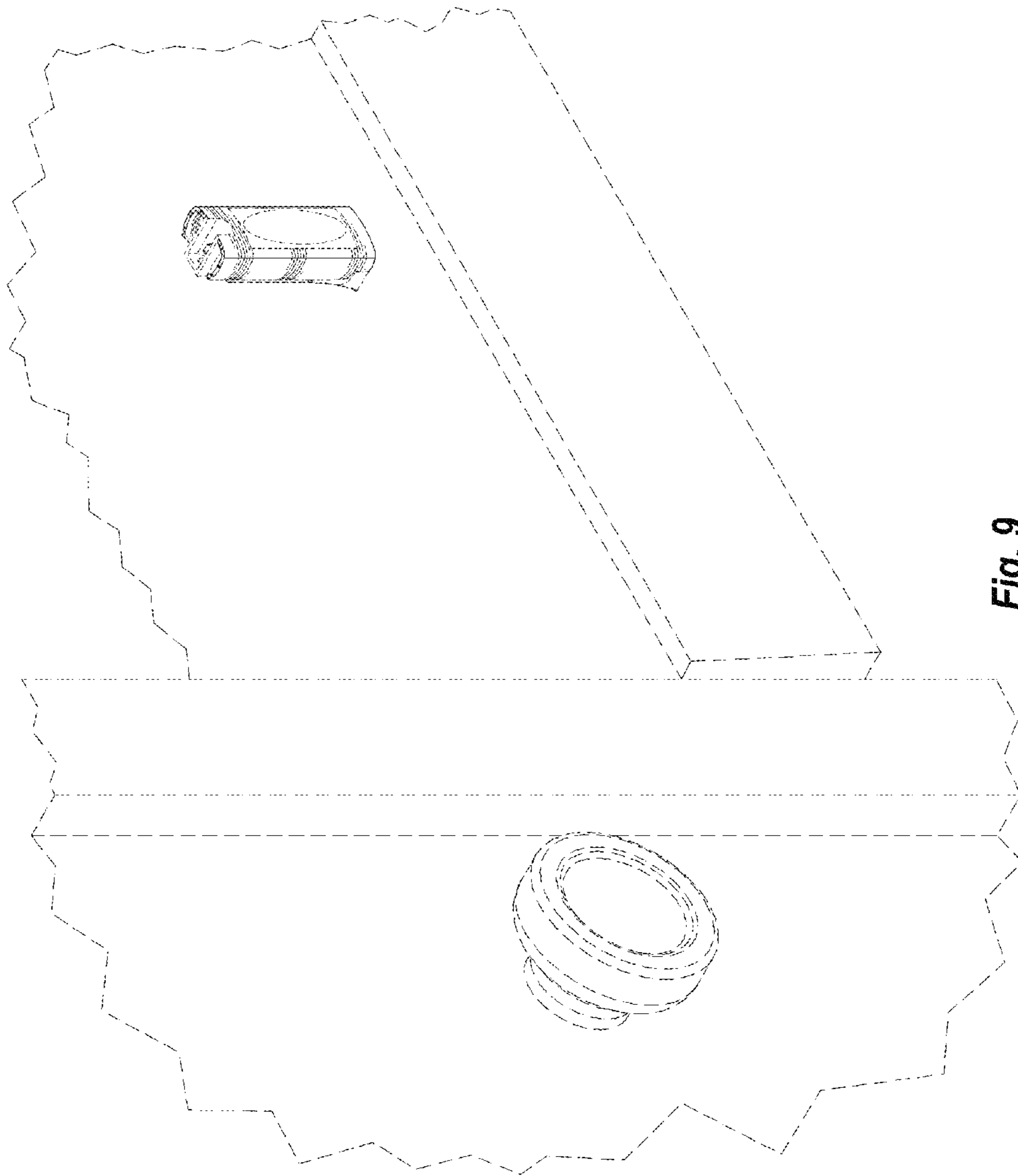
