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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a coin roll opener, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a coin roll opener, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

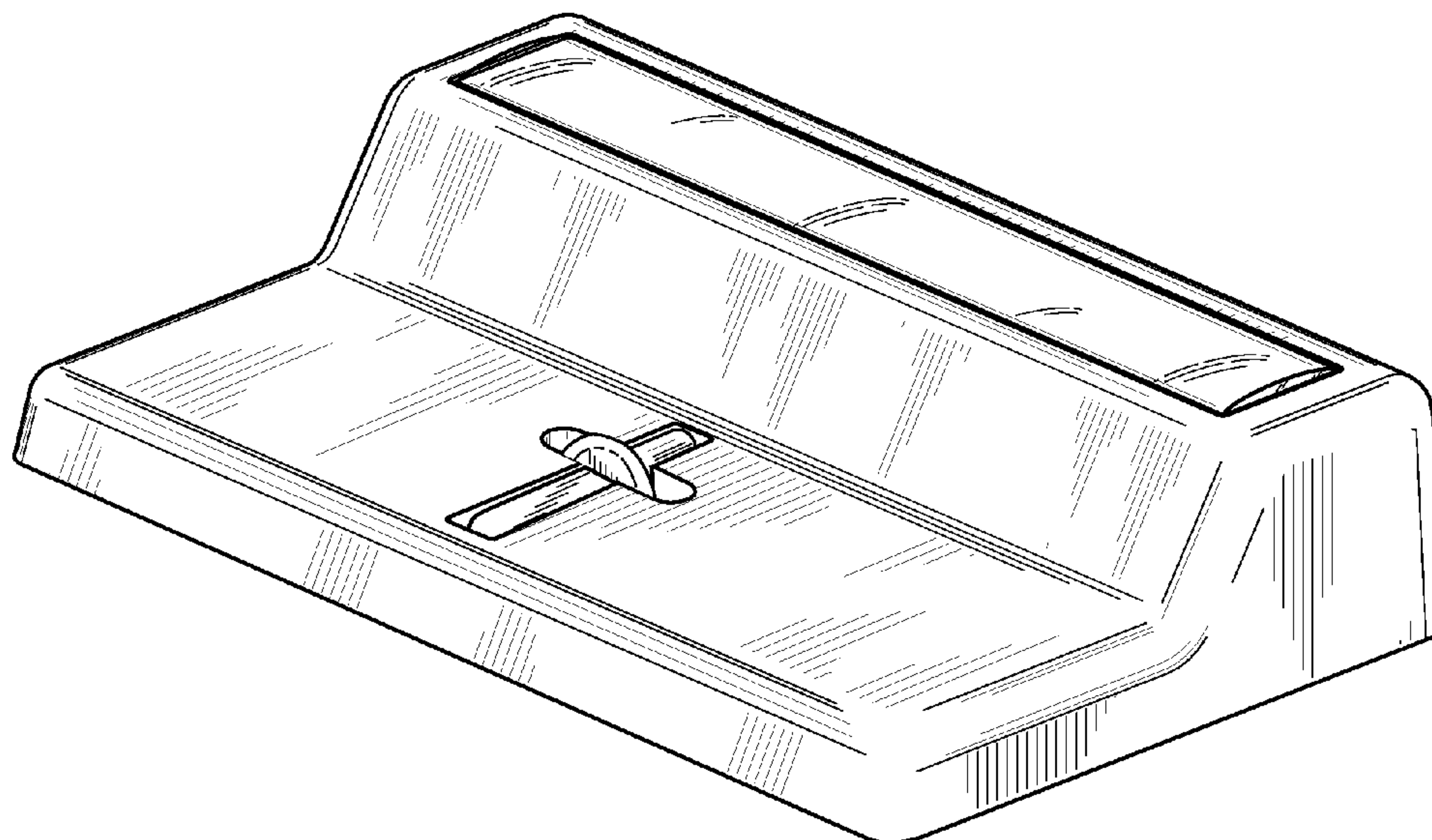
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

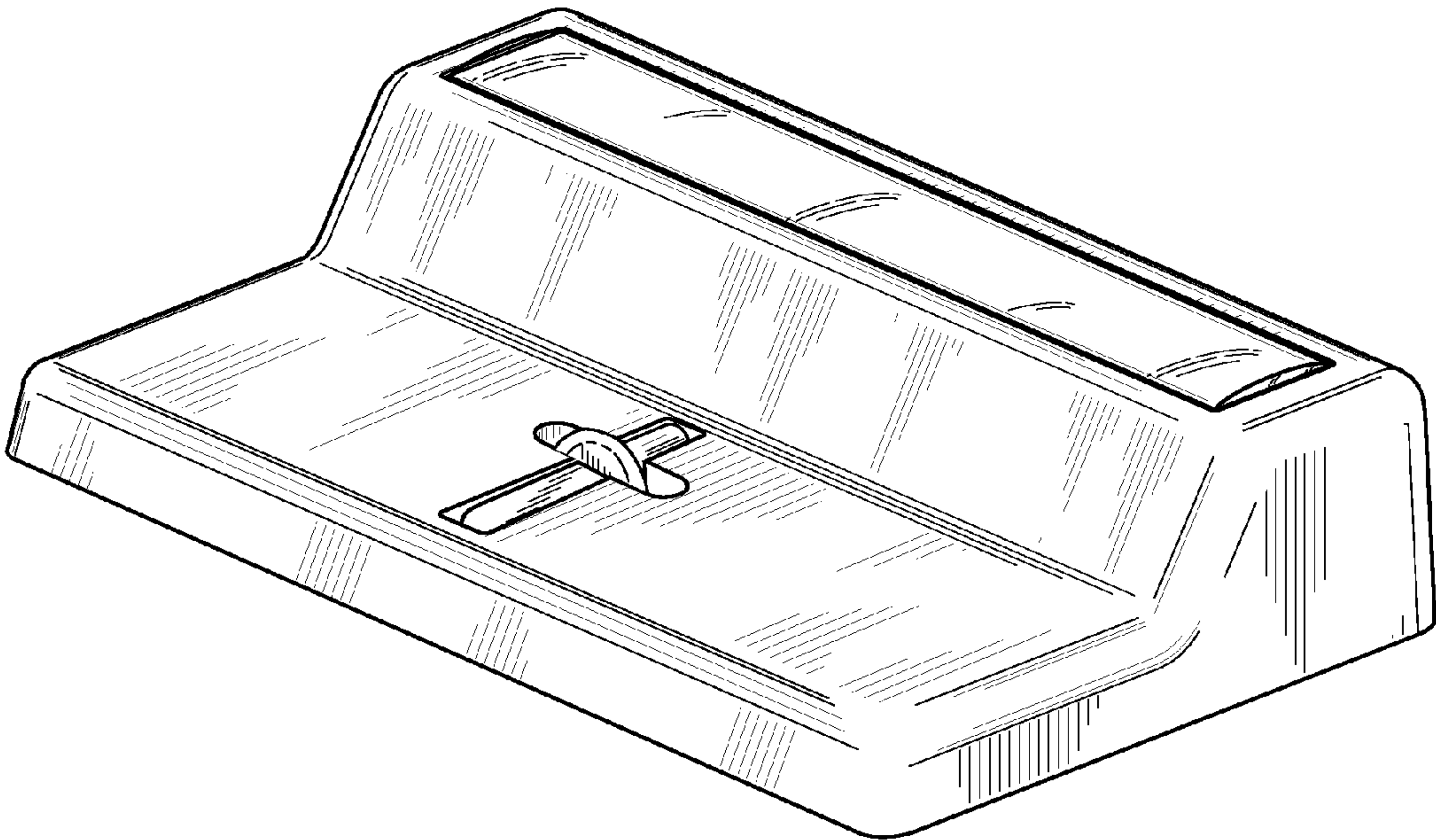

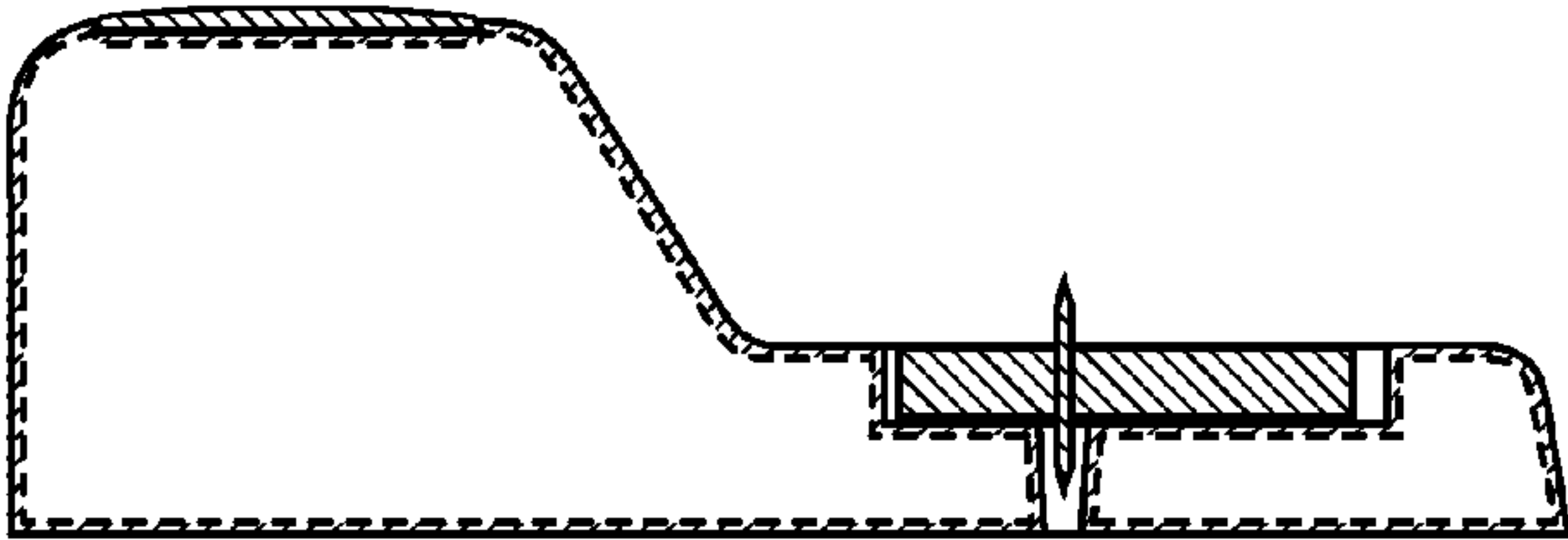

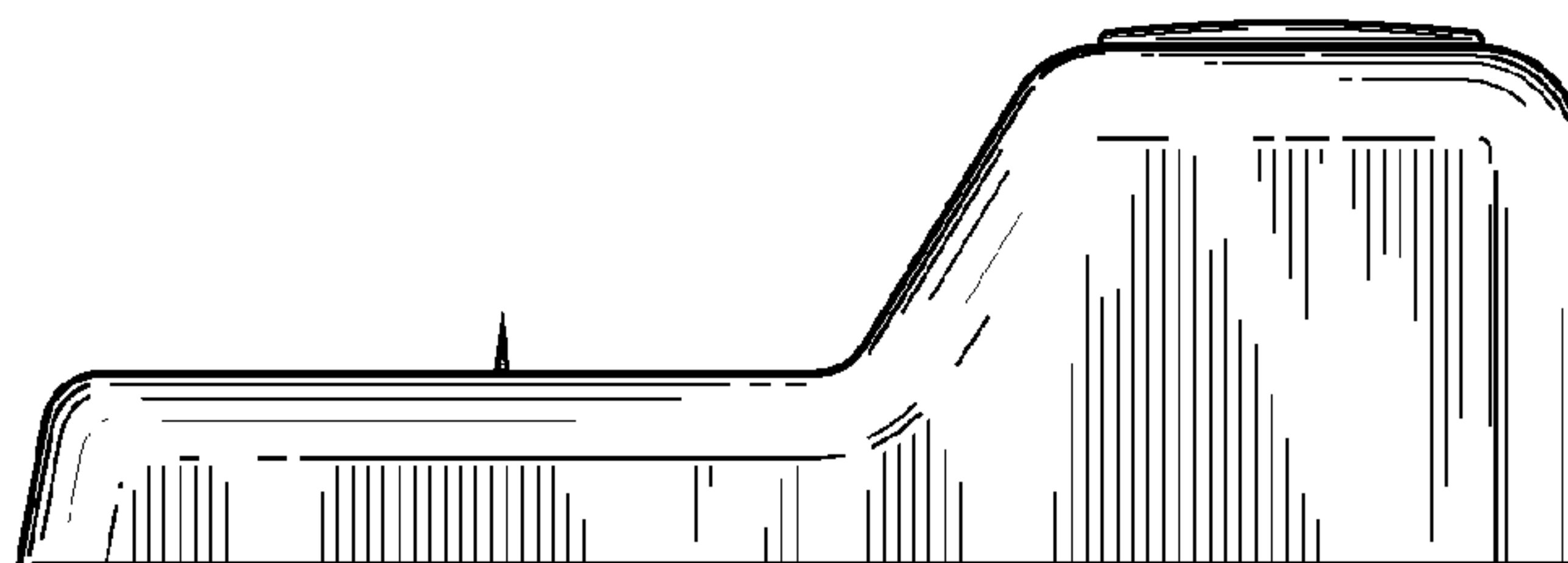

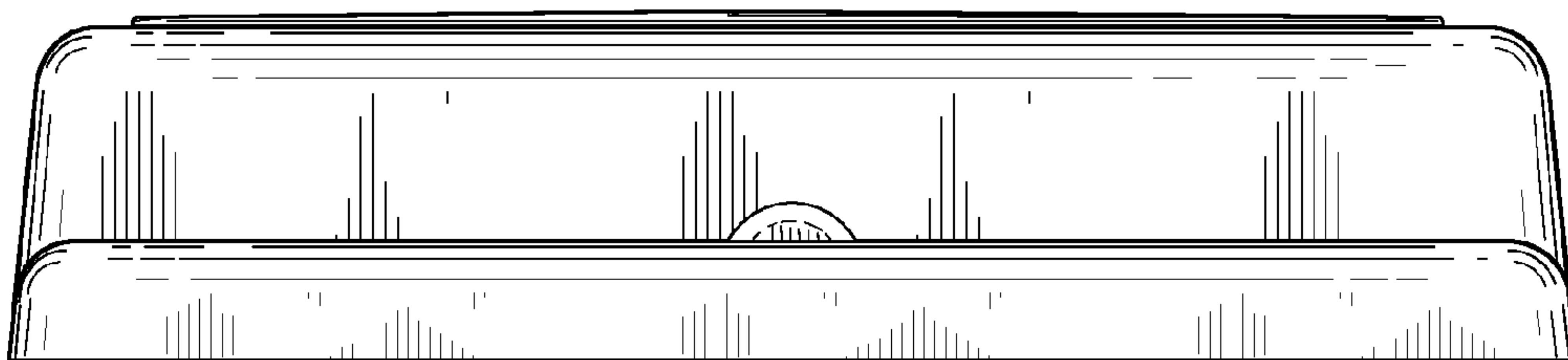

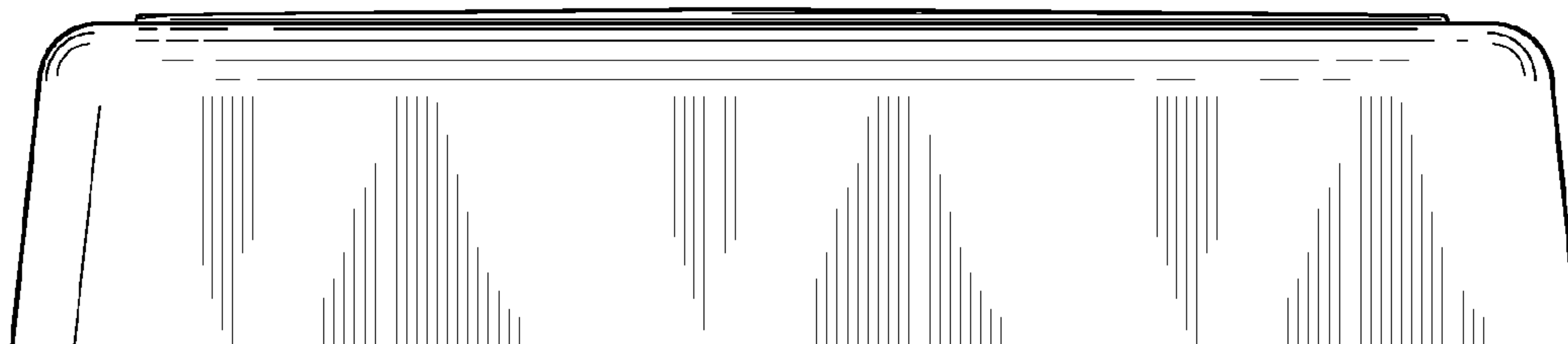

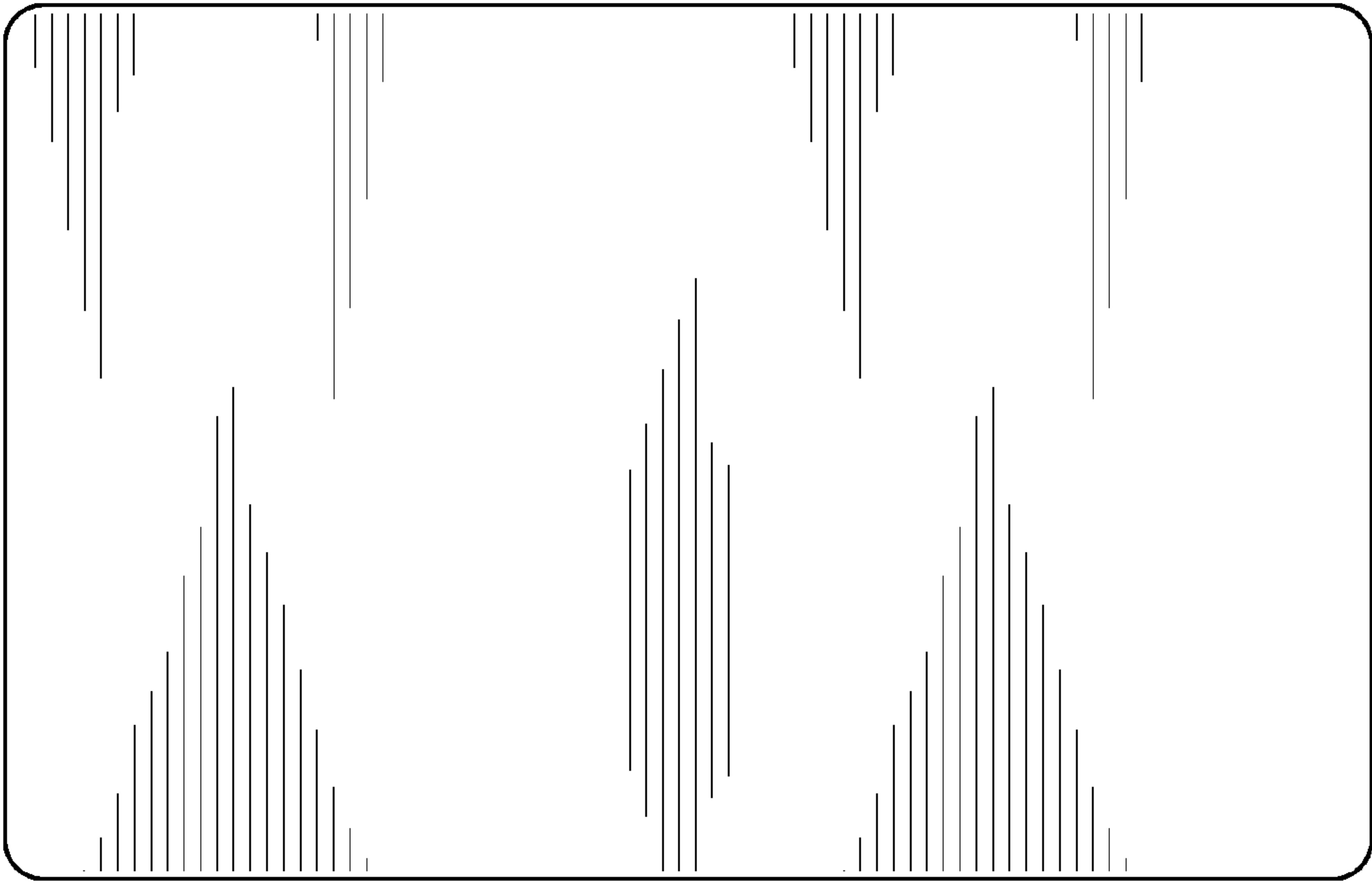
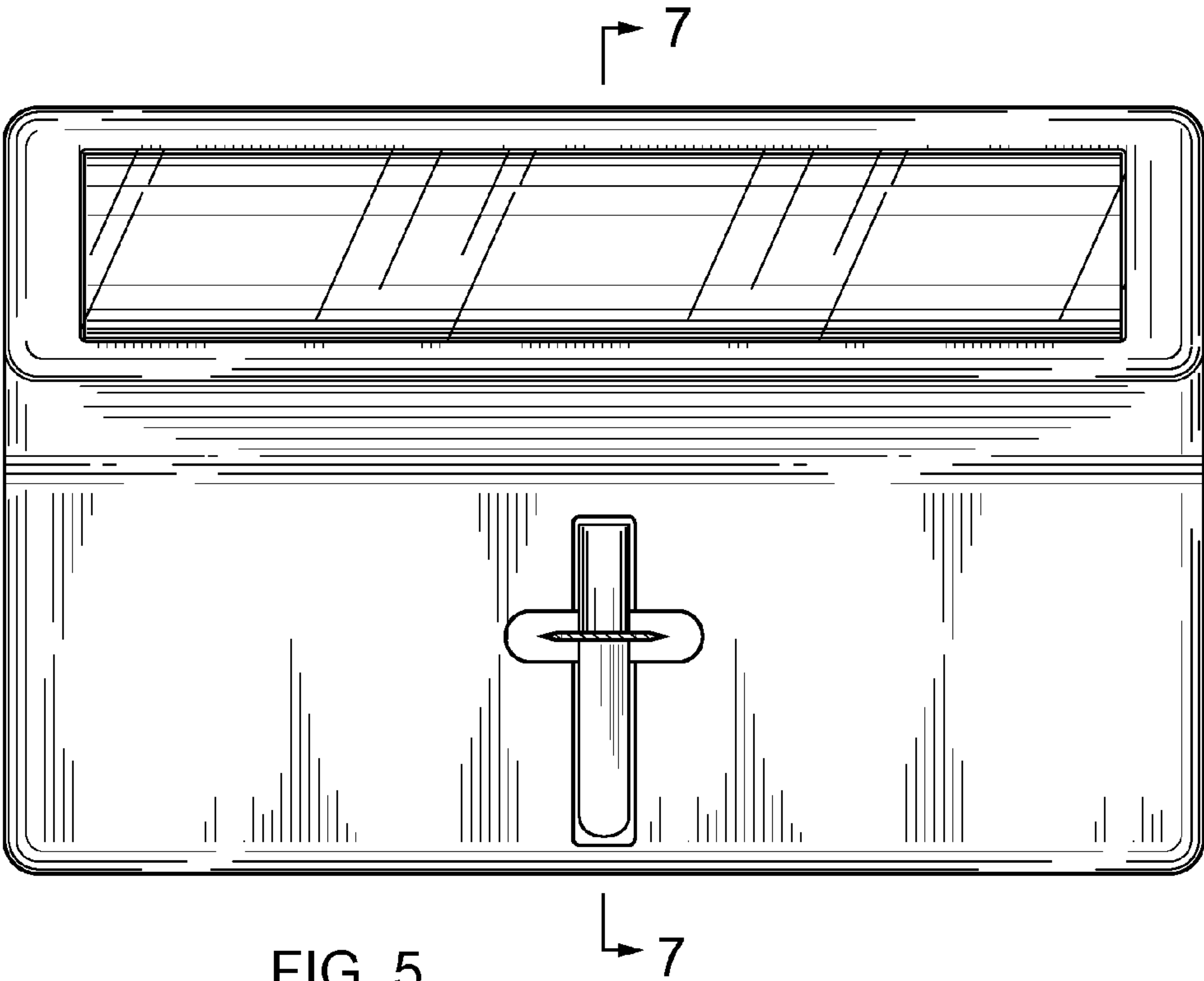
