FIG. 6 is a top view of the skid steer attachment for pulling trees depicted in FIG. 1.

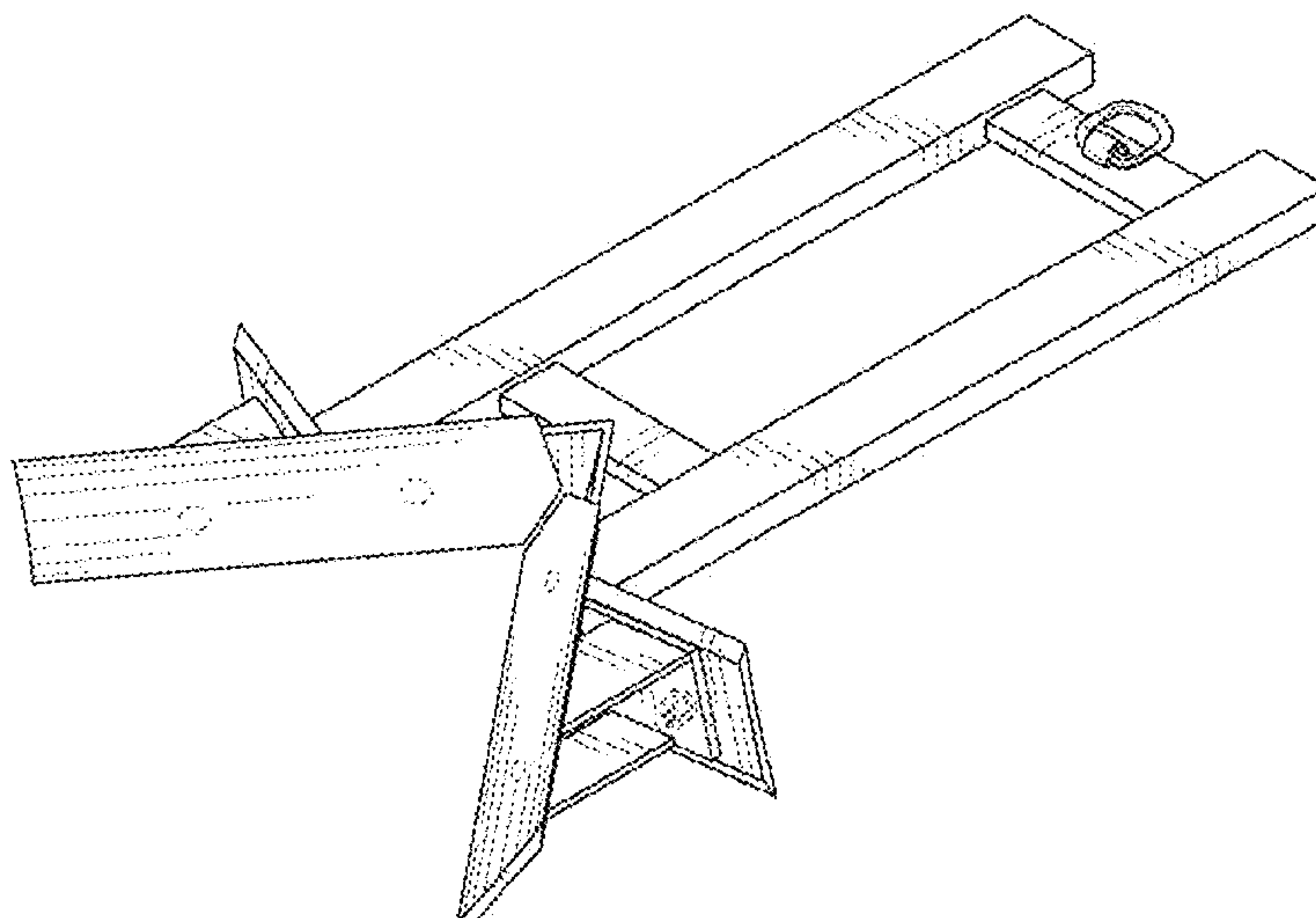
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the skid steer attachment for pulling trees depicted in FIG. 1.

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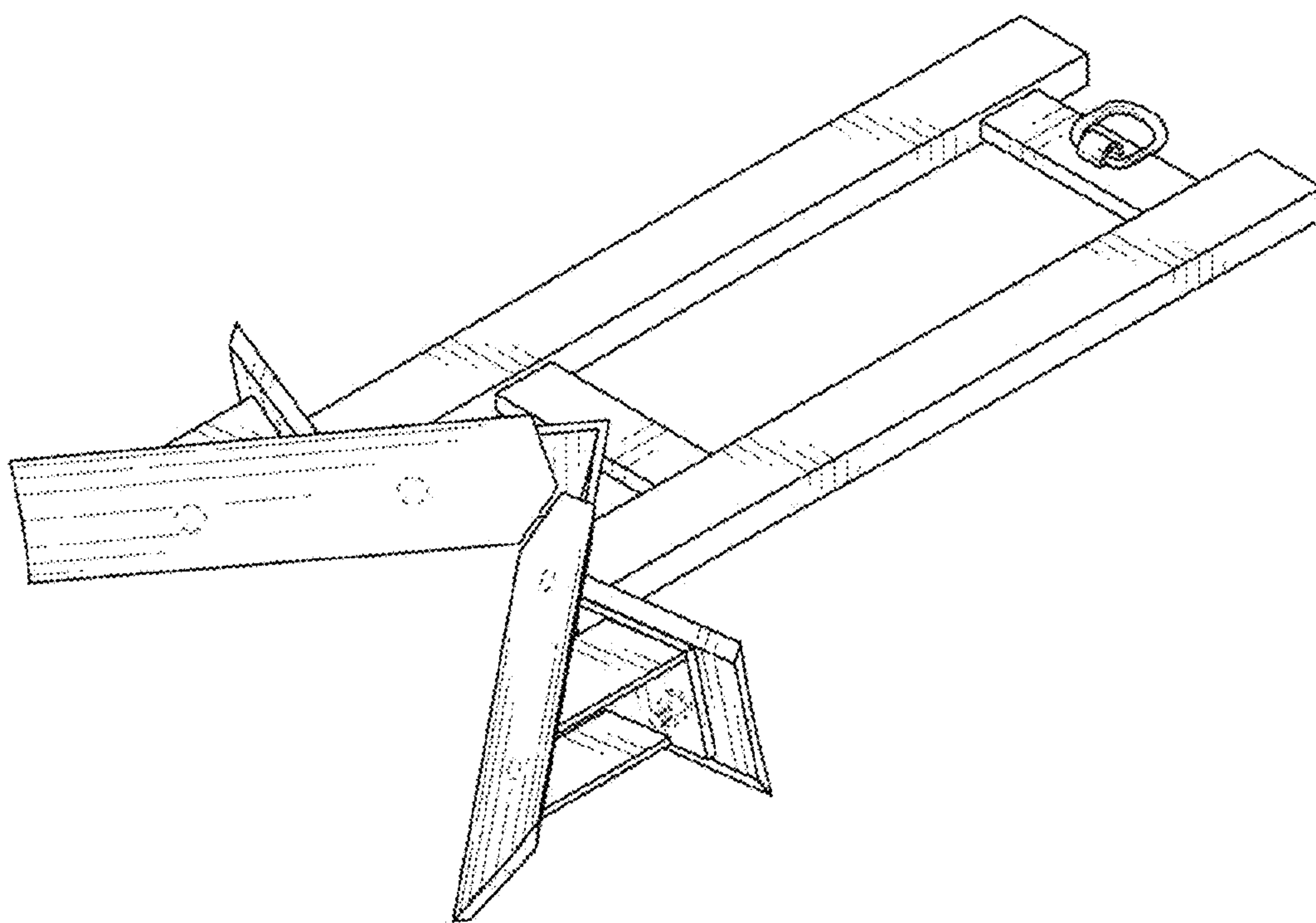

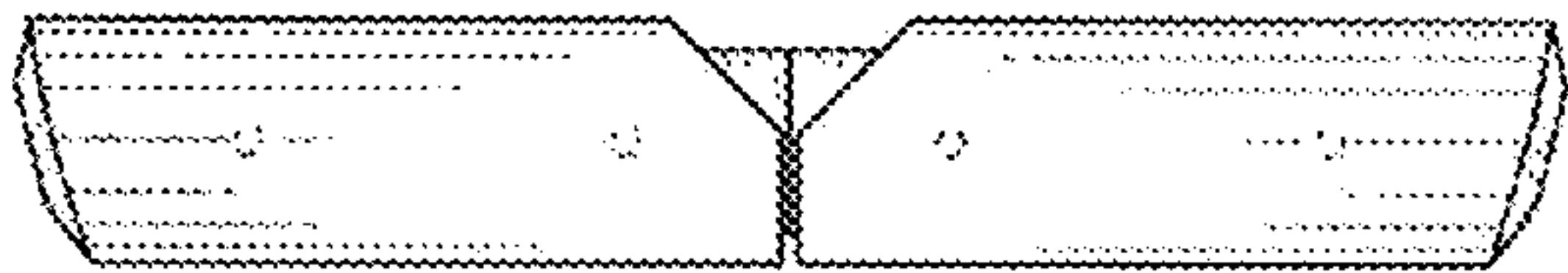

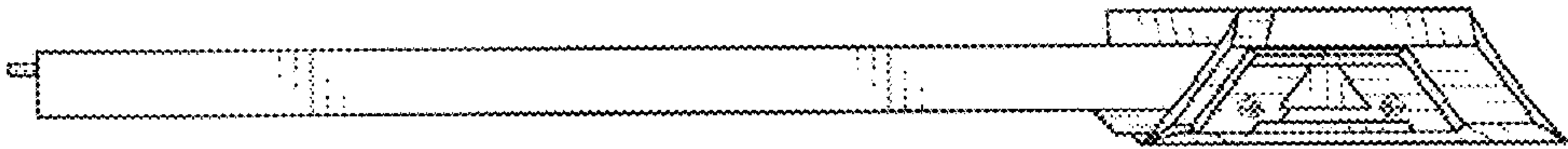

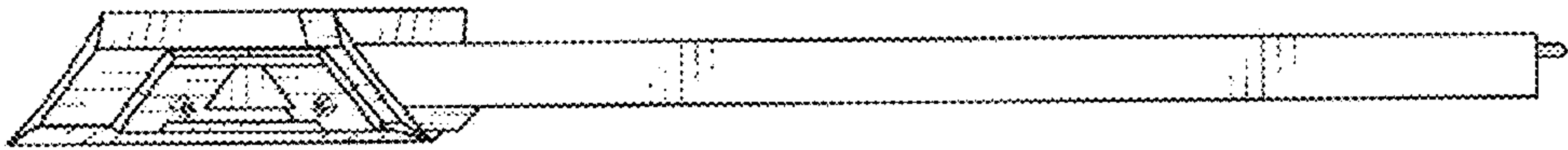

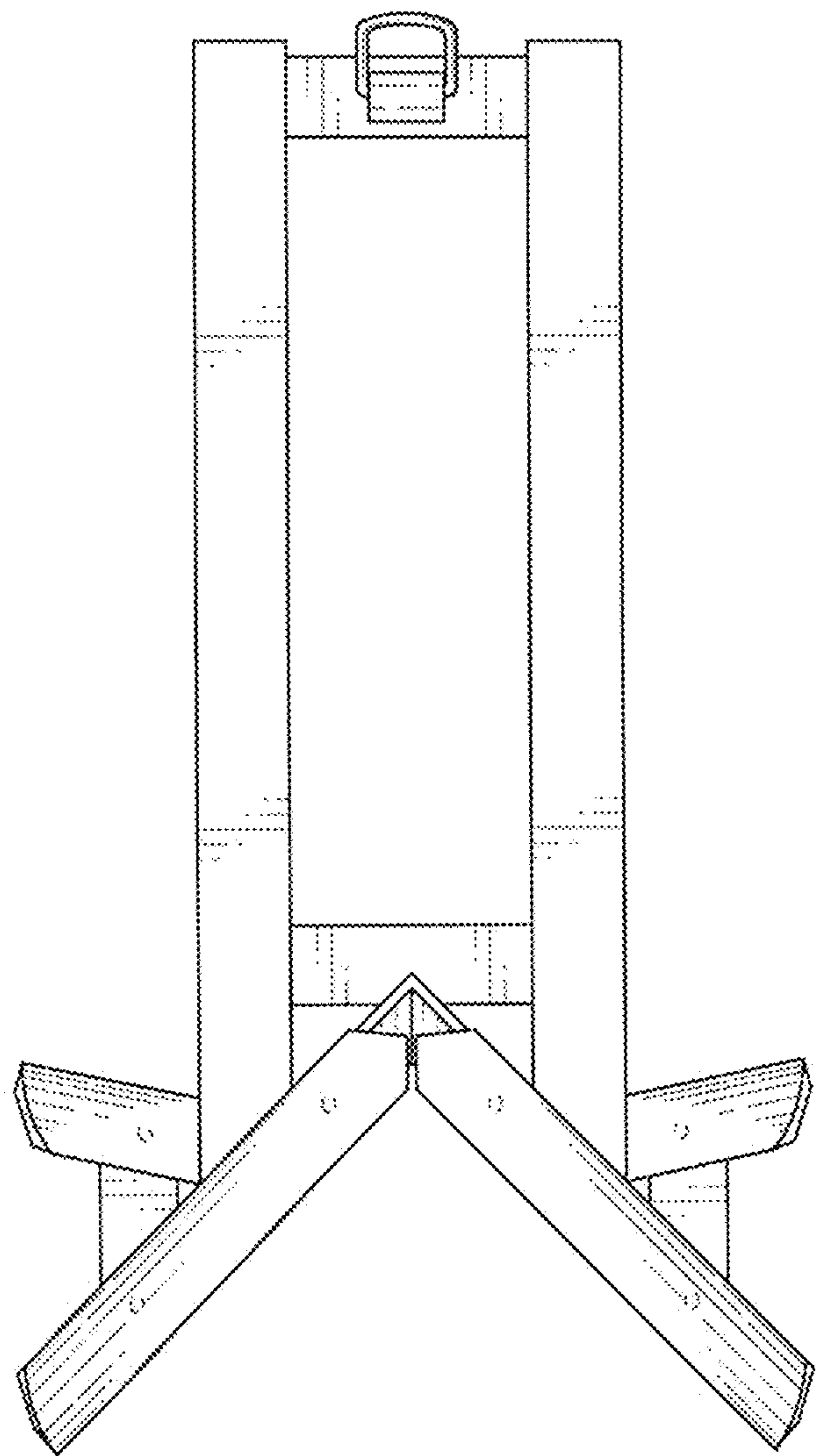

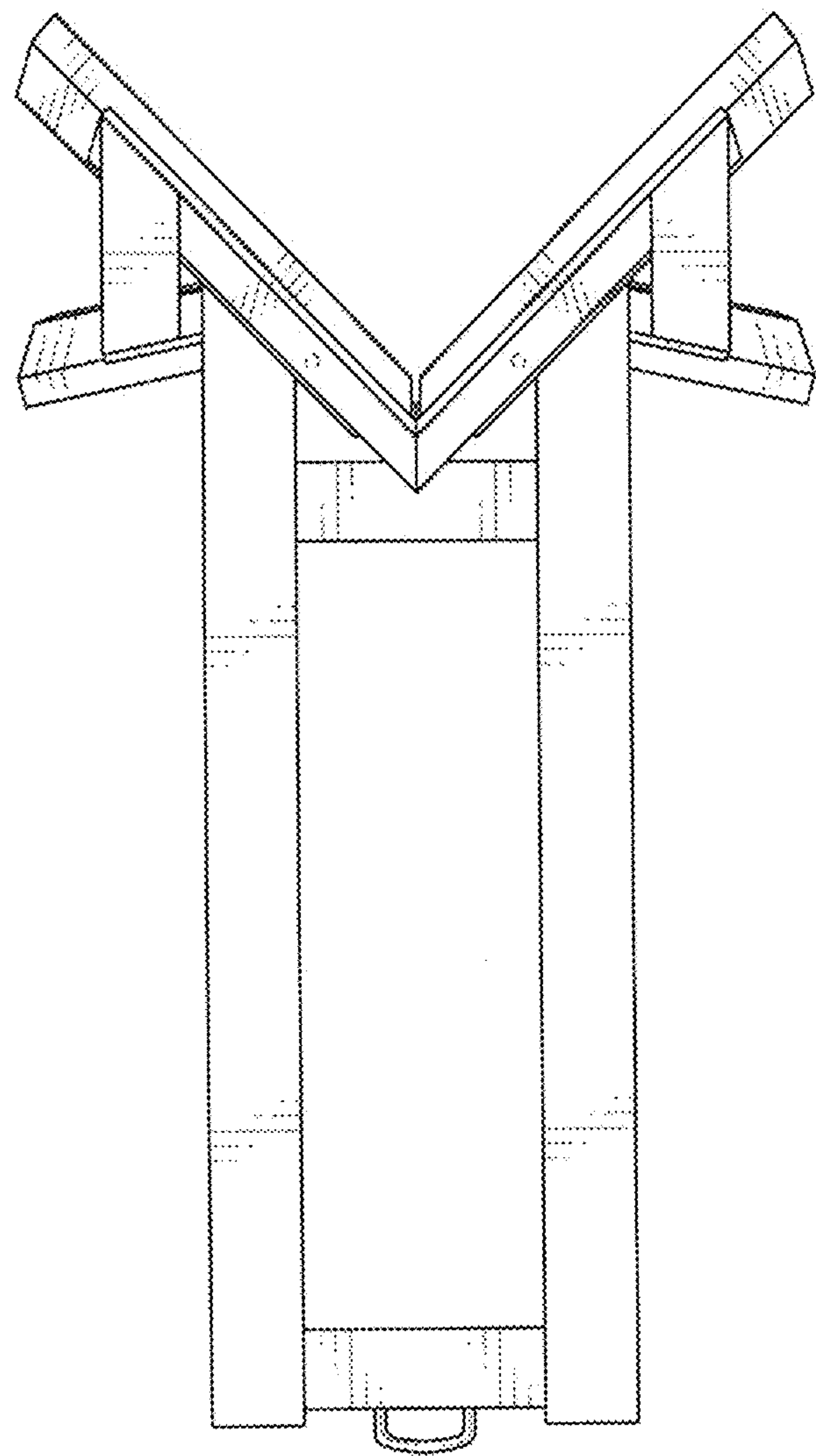

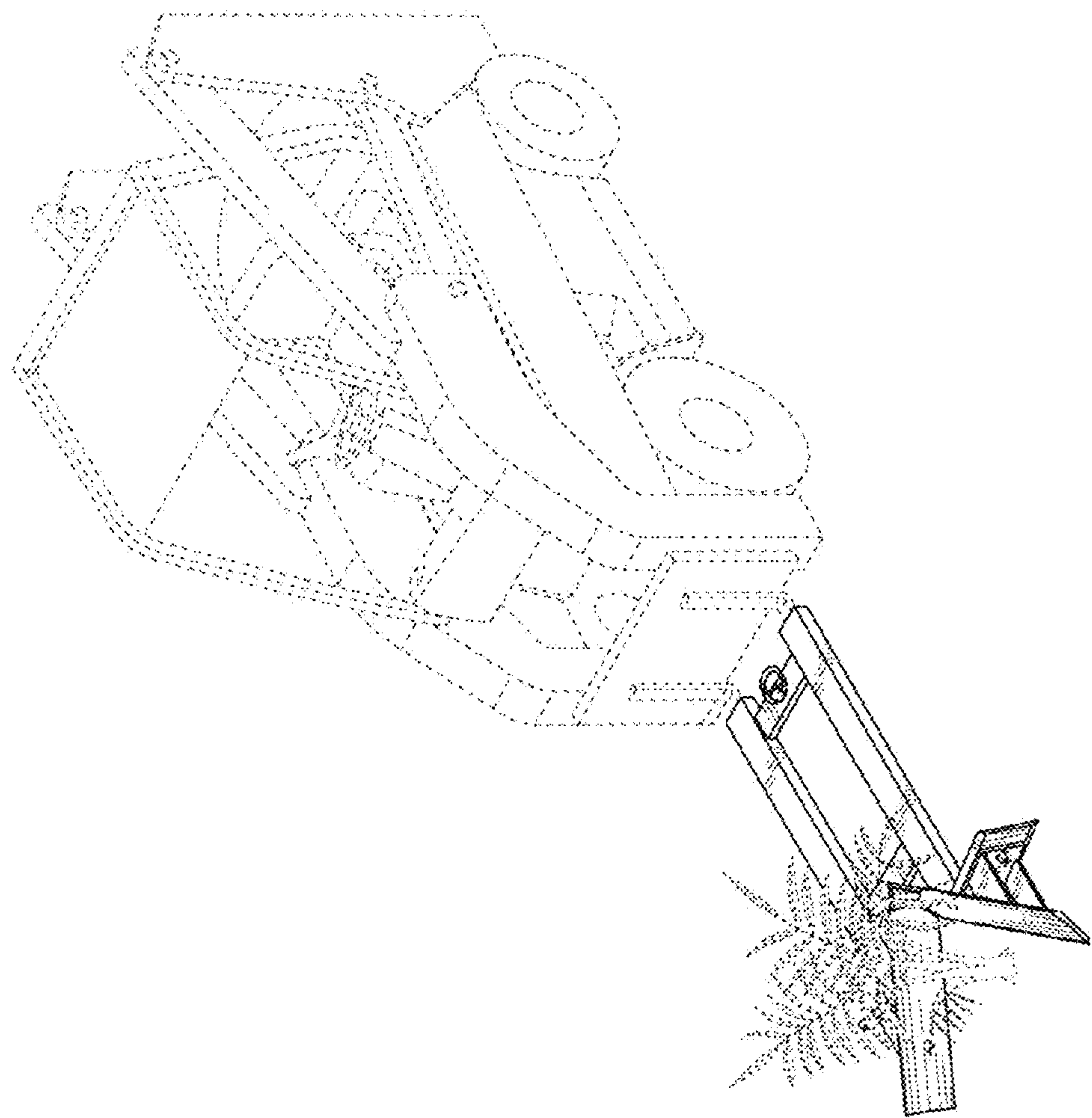

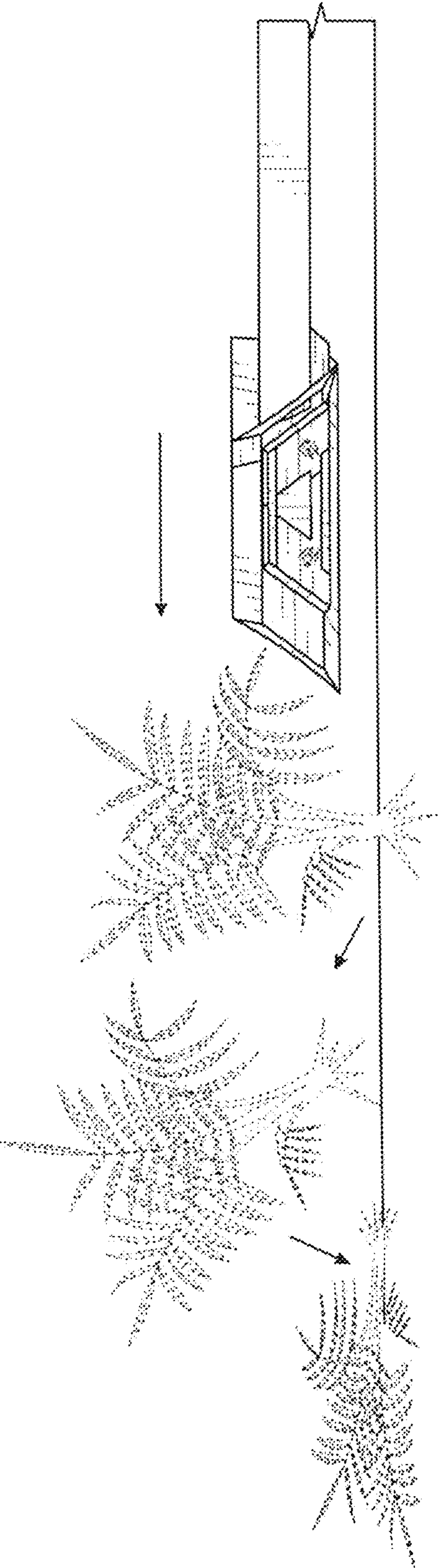
