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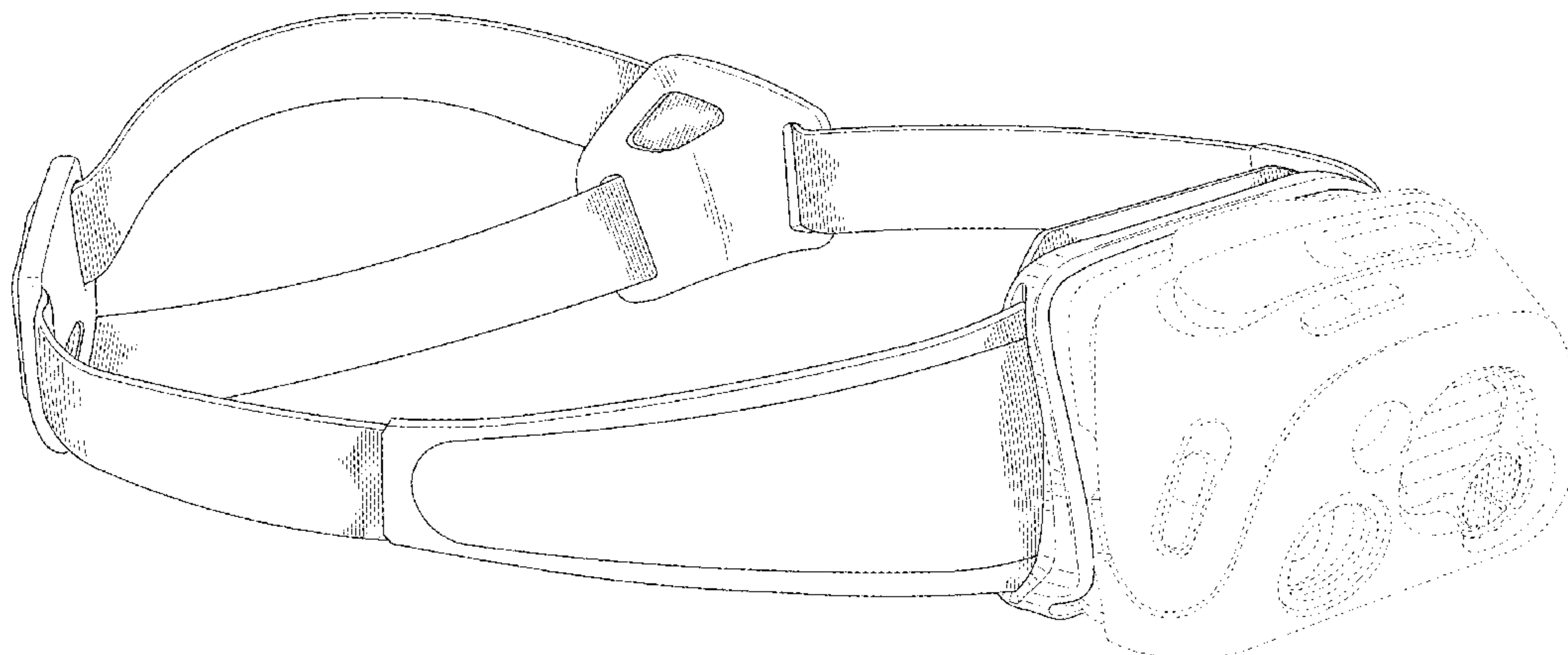
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable headband, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a headlamp mounted on an adjustable headband showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof, with a central portion of the strap member removed for ease of illustration;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the adjustable headband;
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a partial top view of the rear portion thereof;
FIG. 6 is a partial top view of the front portion thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right side view thereof, with a central portion of the strap member removed for ease of illustration;
FIG. 8 is a left side view thereof, with a central portion of the strap member removed for ease of illustration;
FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a partial bottom view of the rear thereof, with the front portion removed;
FIG. 11 is partial bottom view of the front thereof, with the rear portion removed; and,
FIG. 12 is an enlarged partial rear view thereof; to show details not otherwise discernable from the drawings.

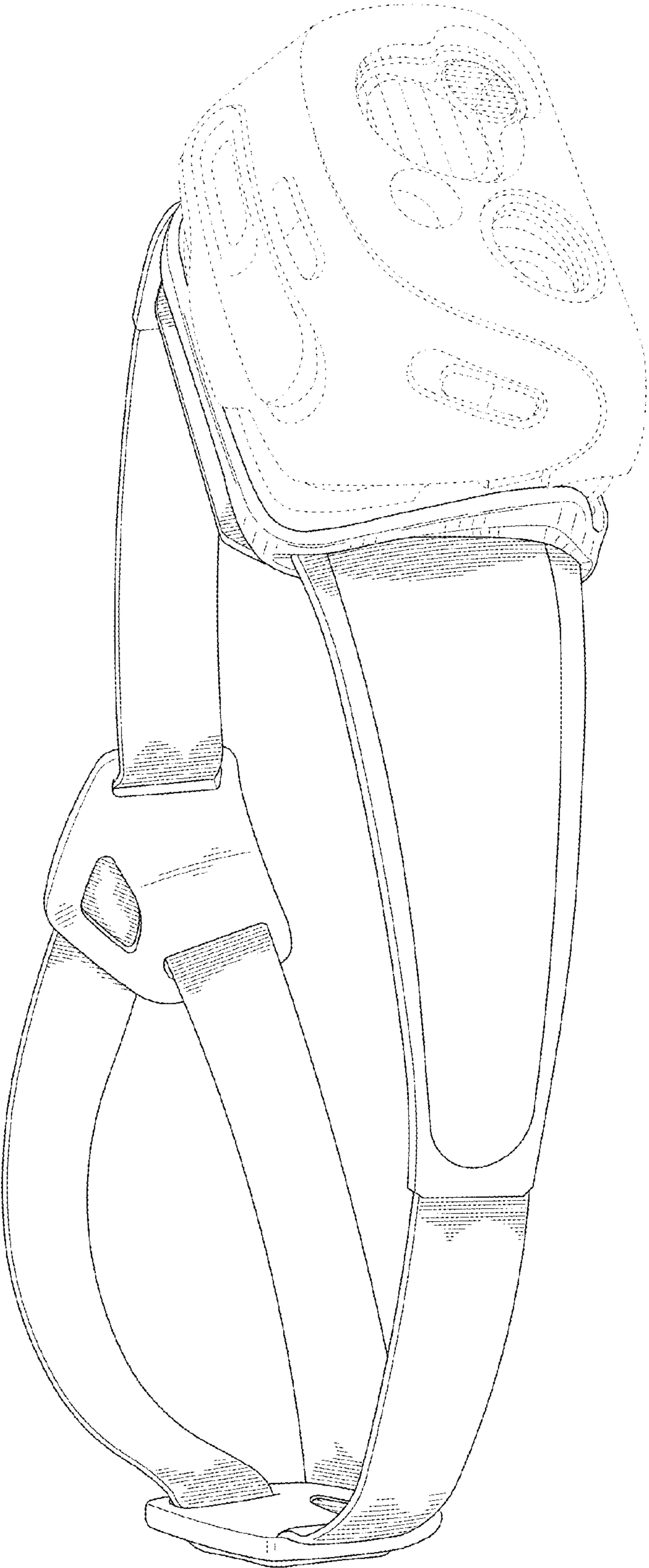

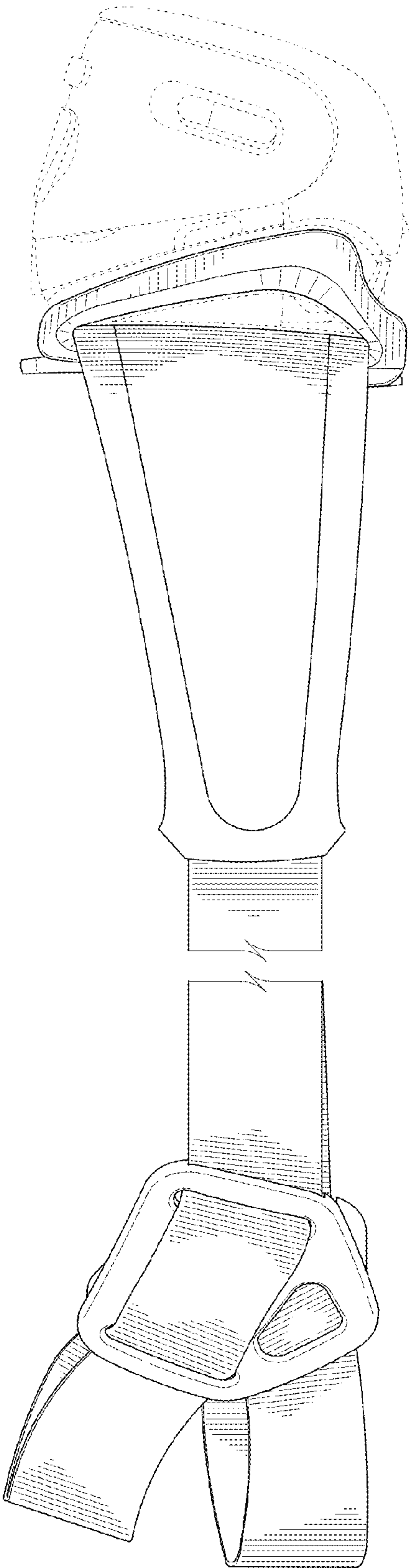

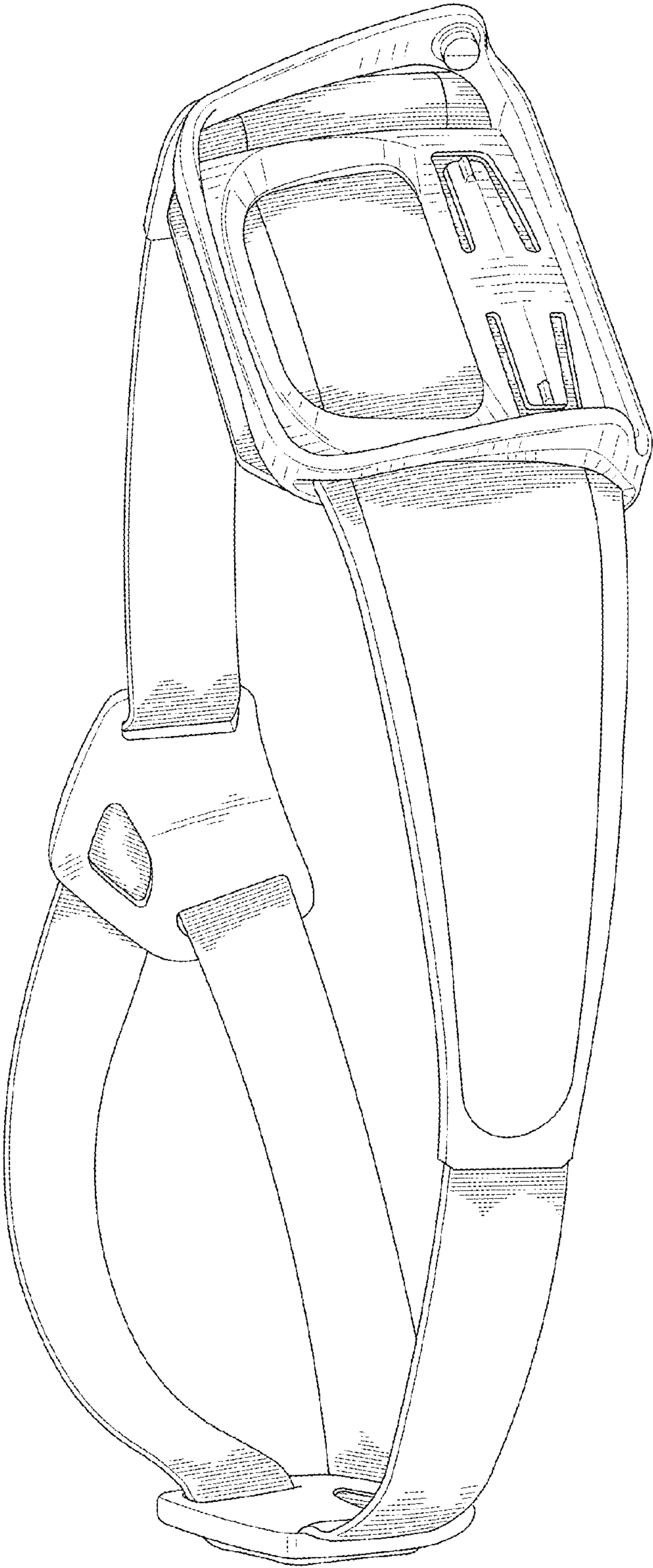

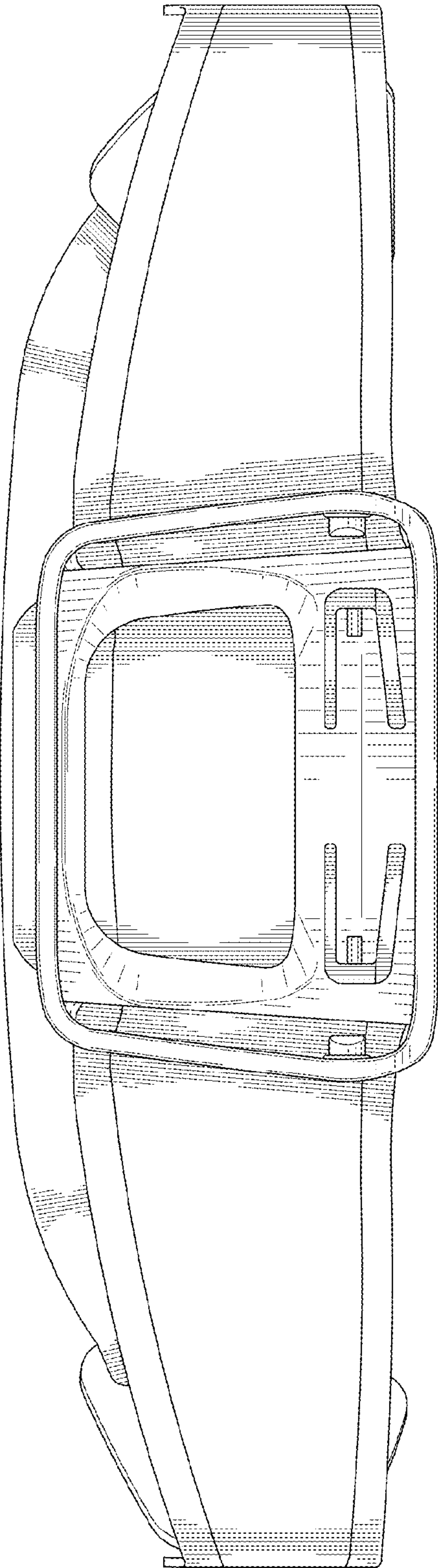

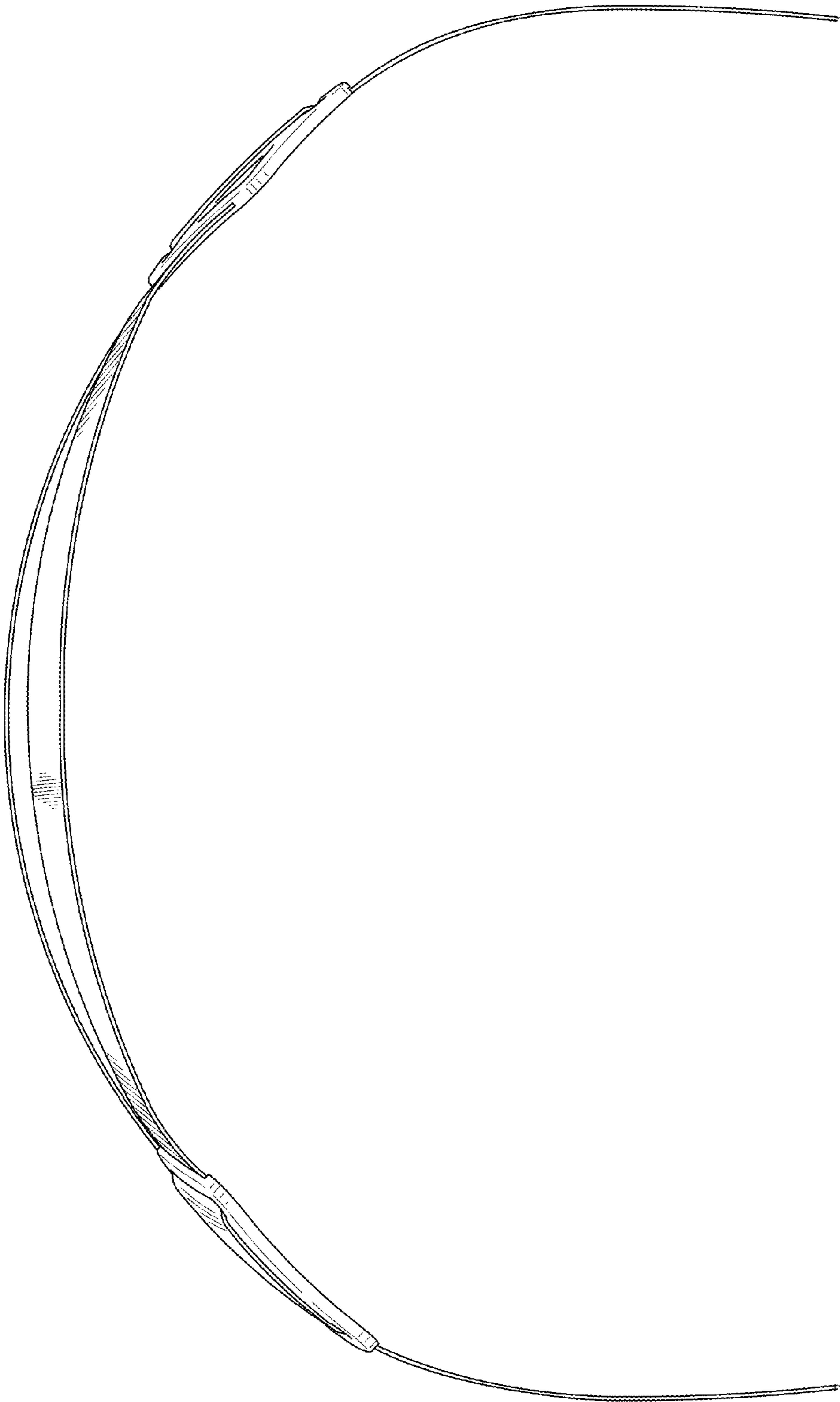

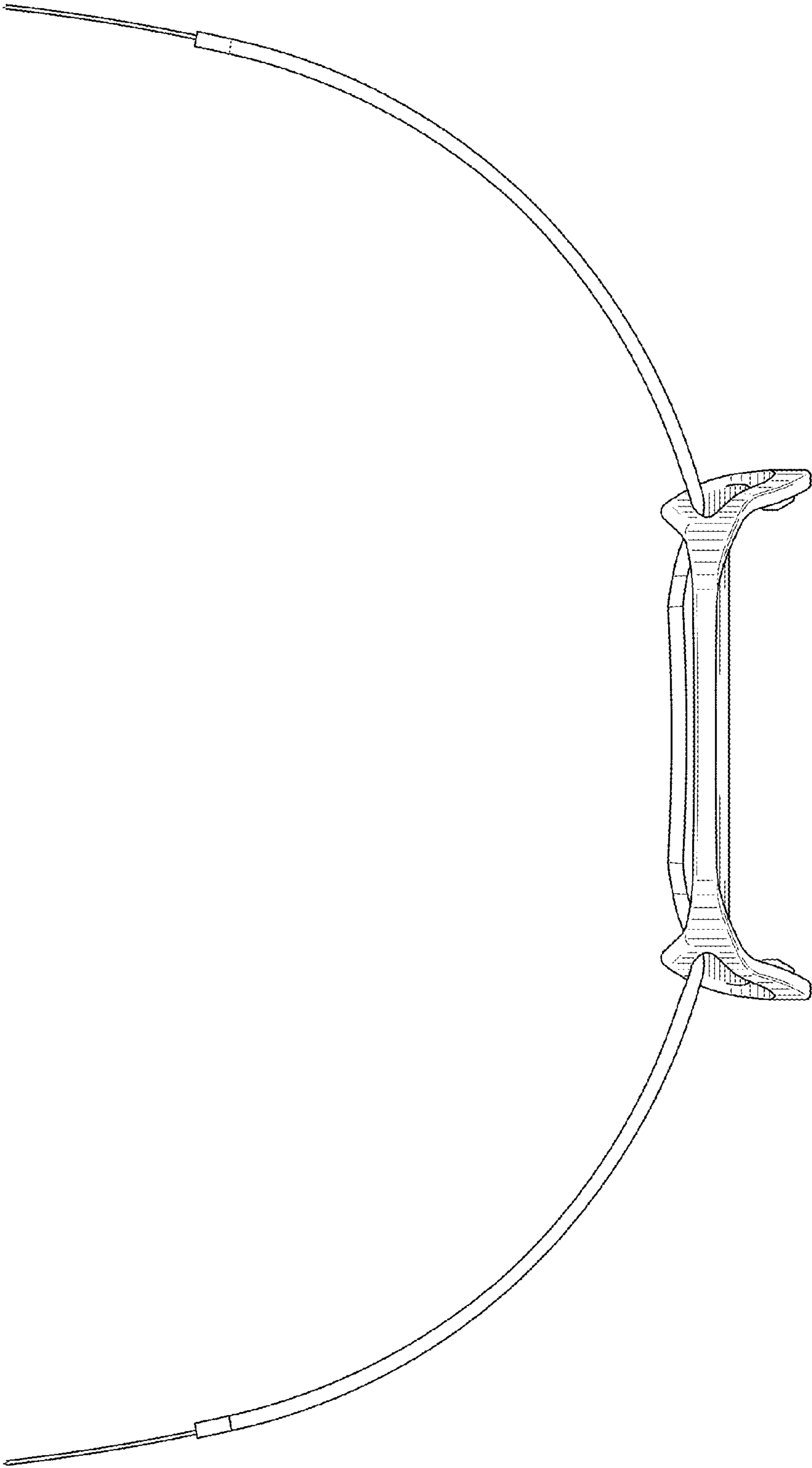

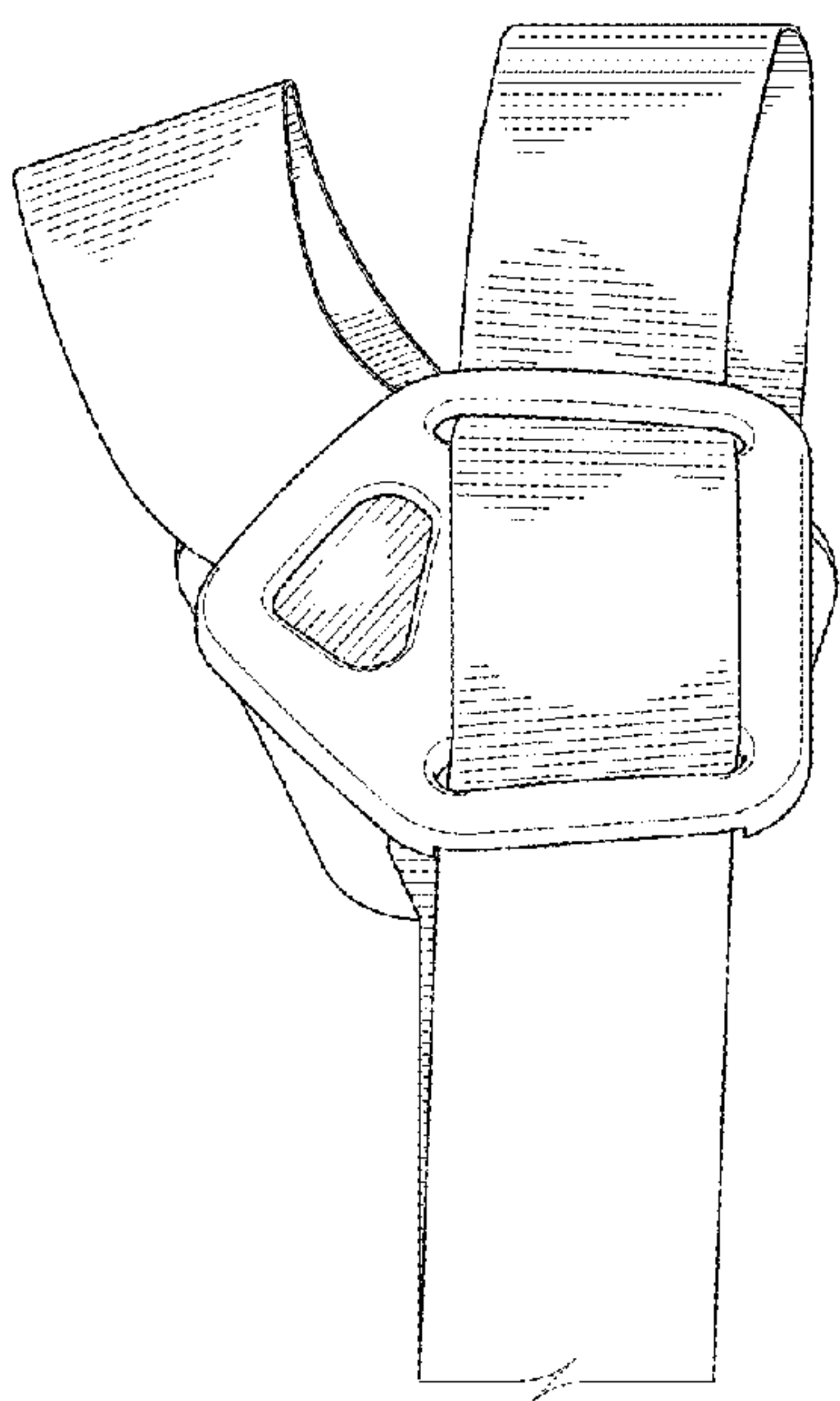

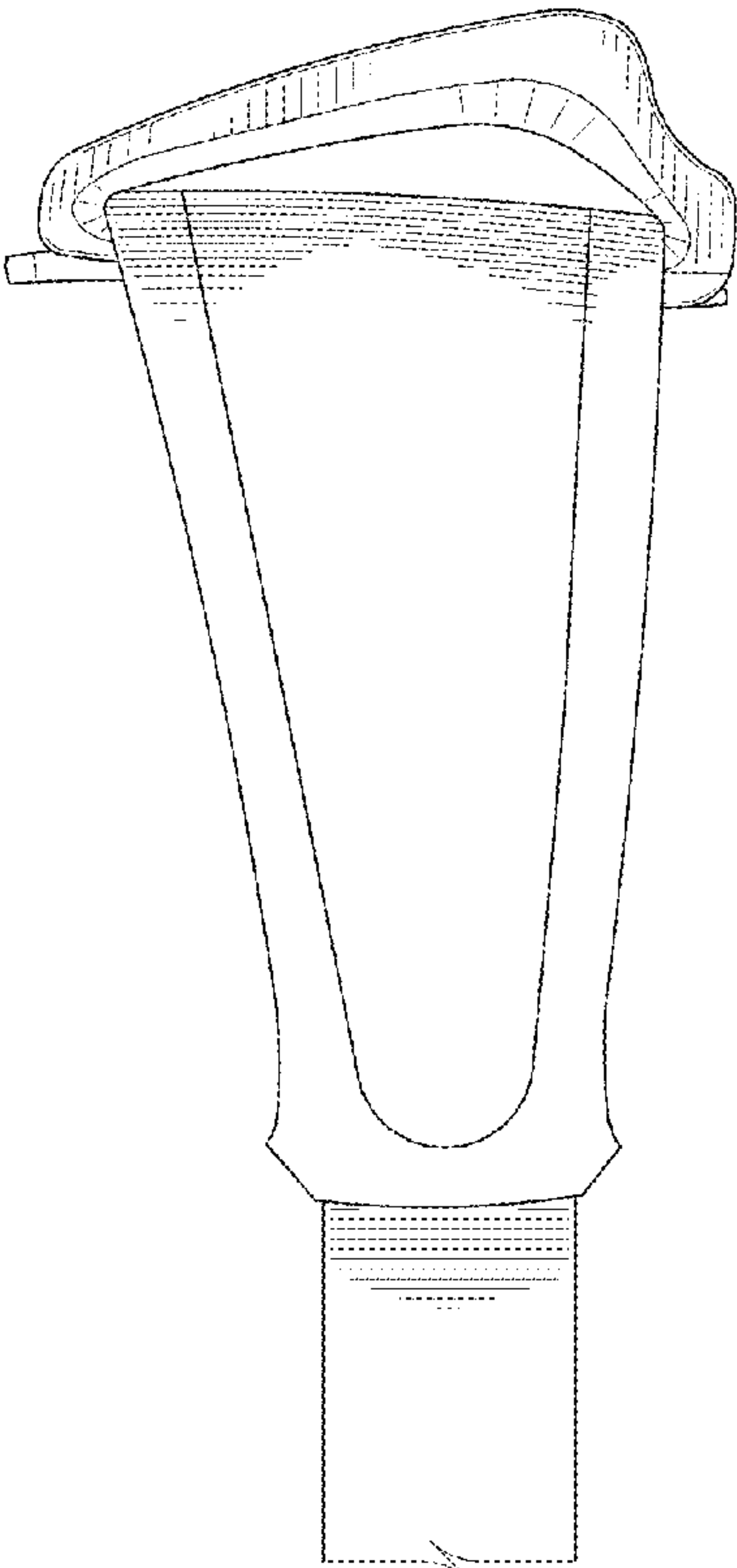
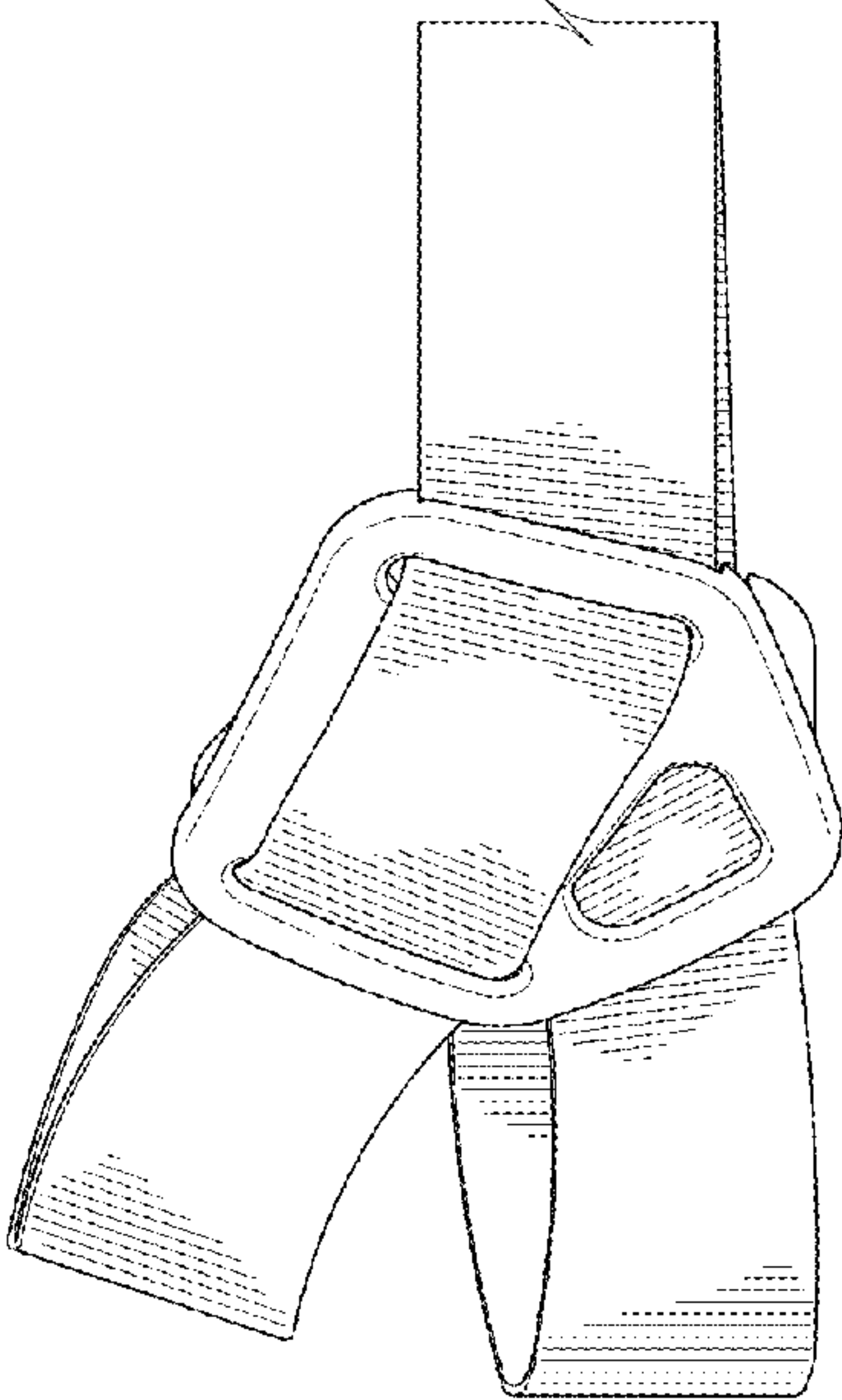
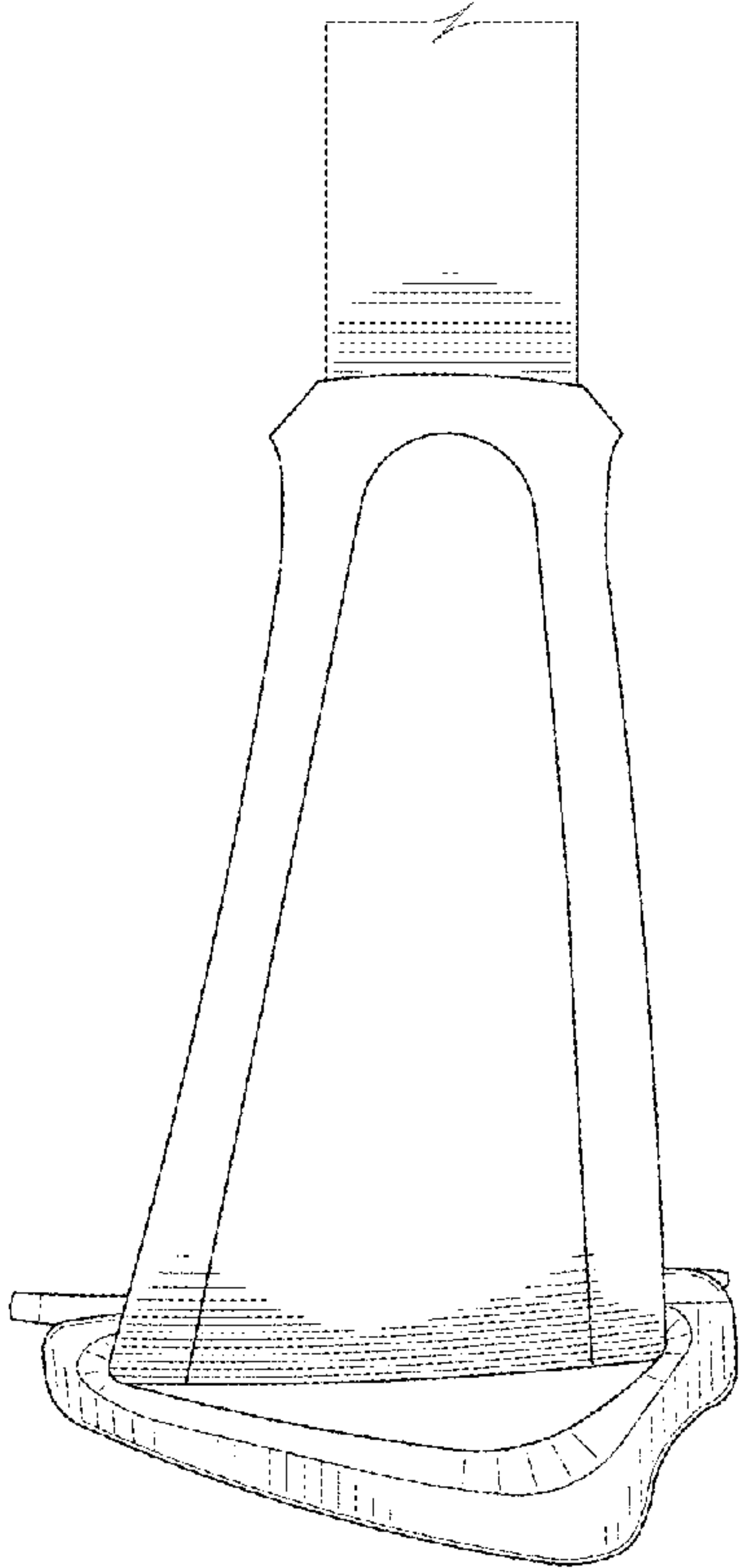

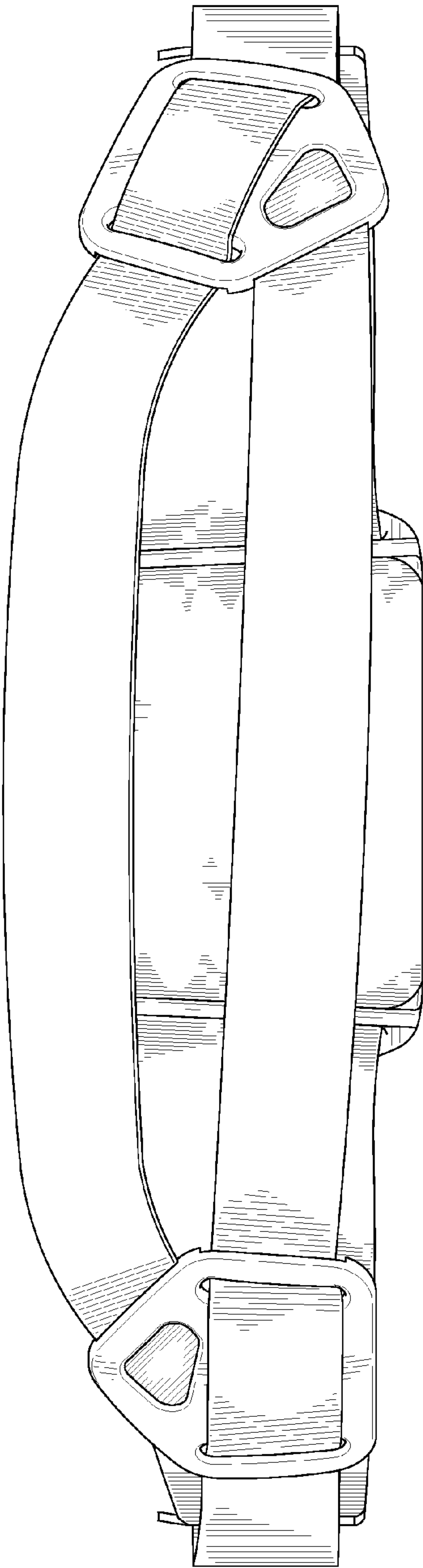

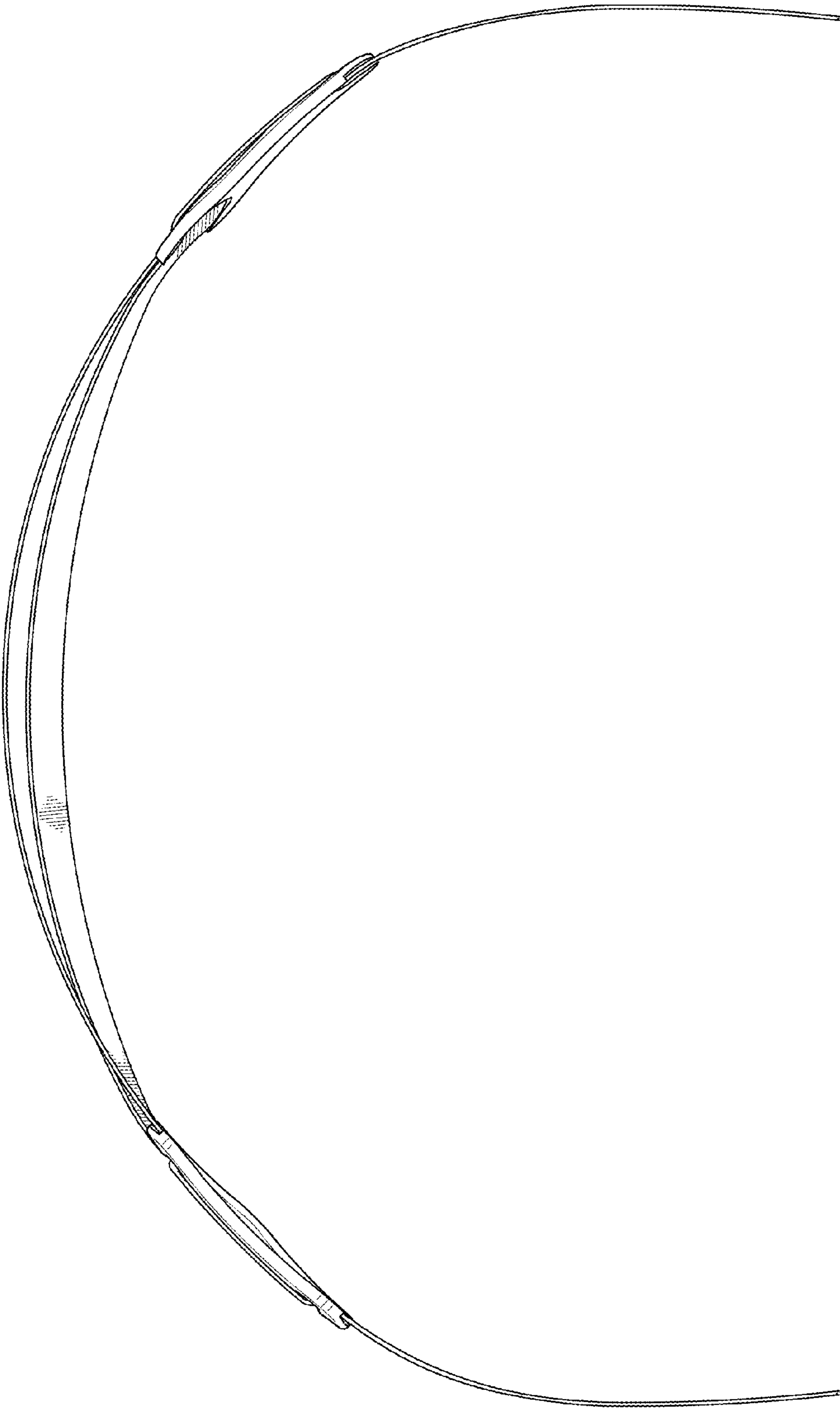

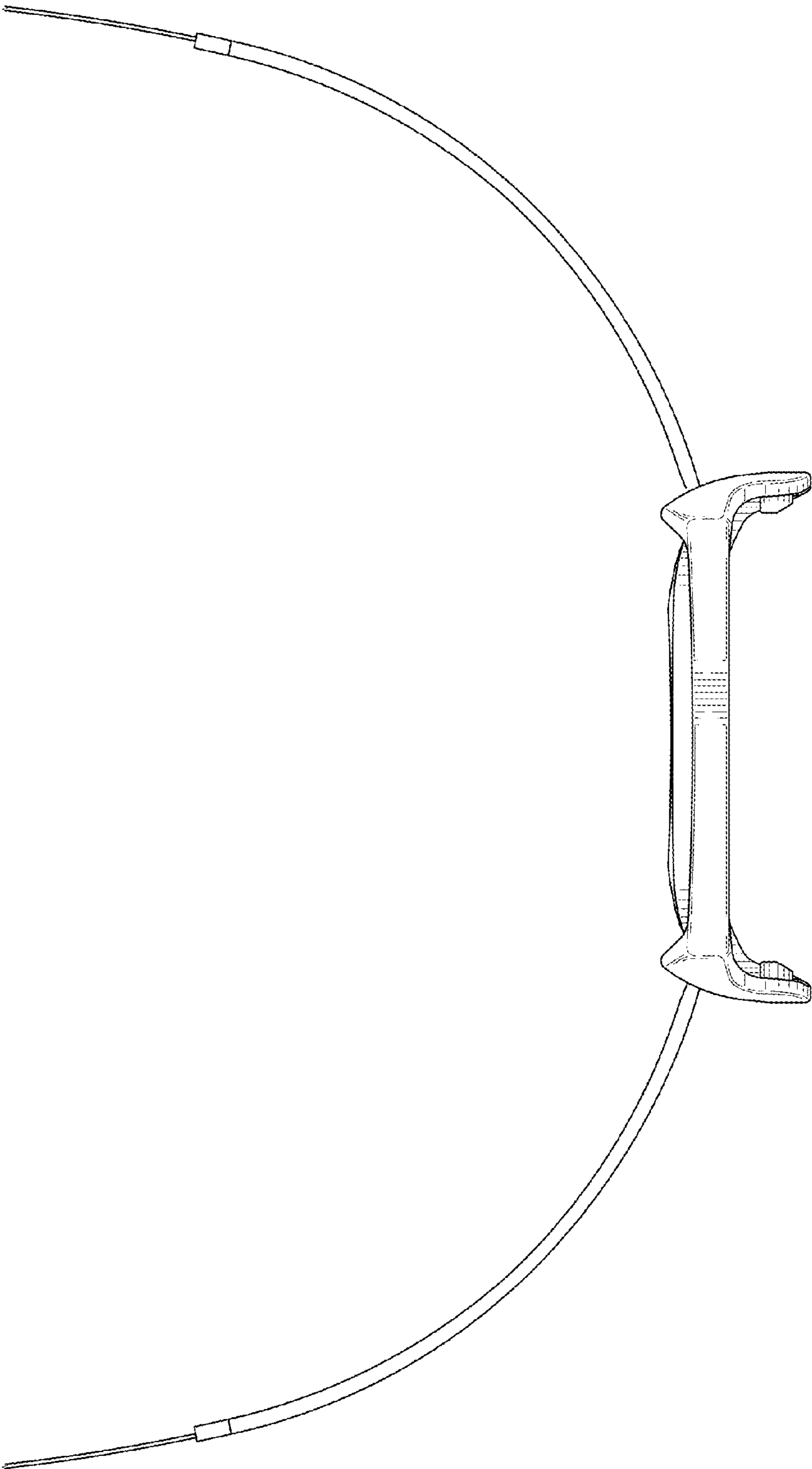

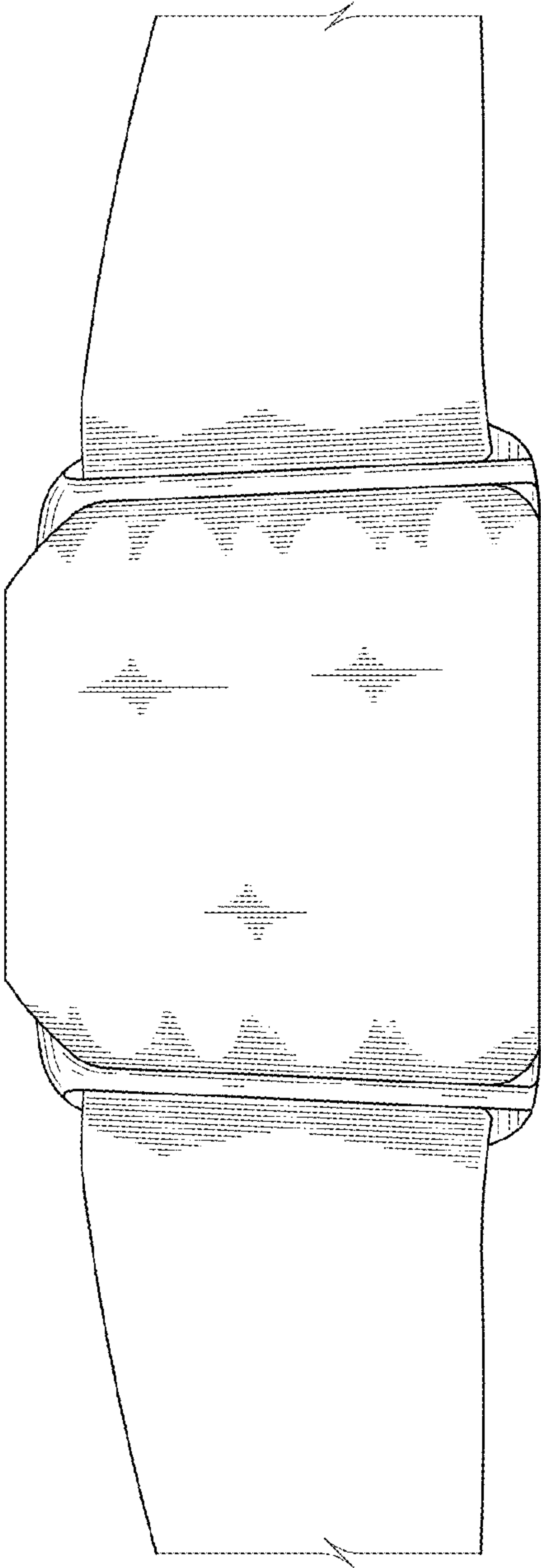
