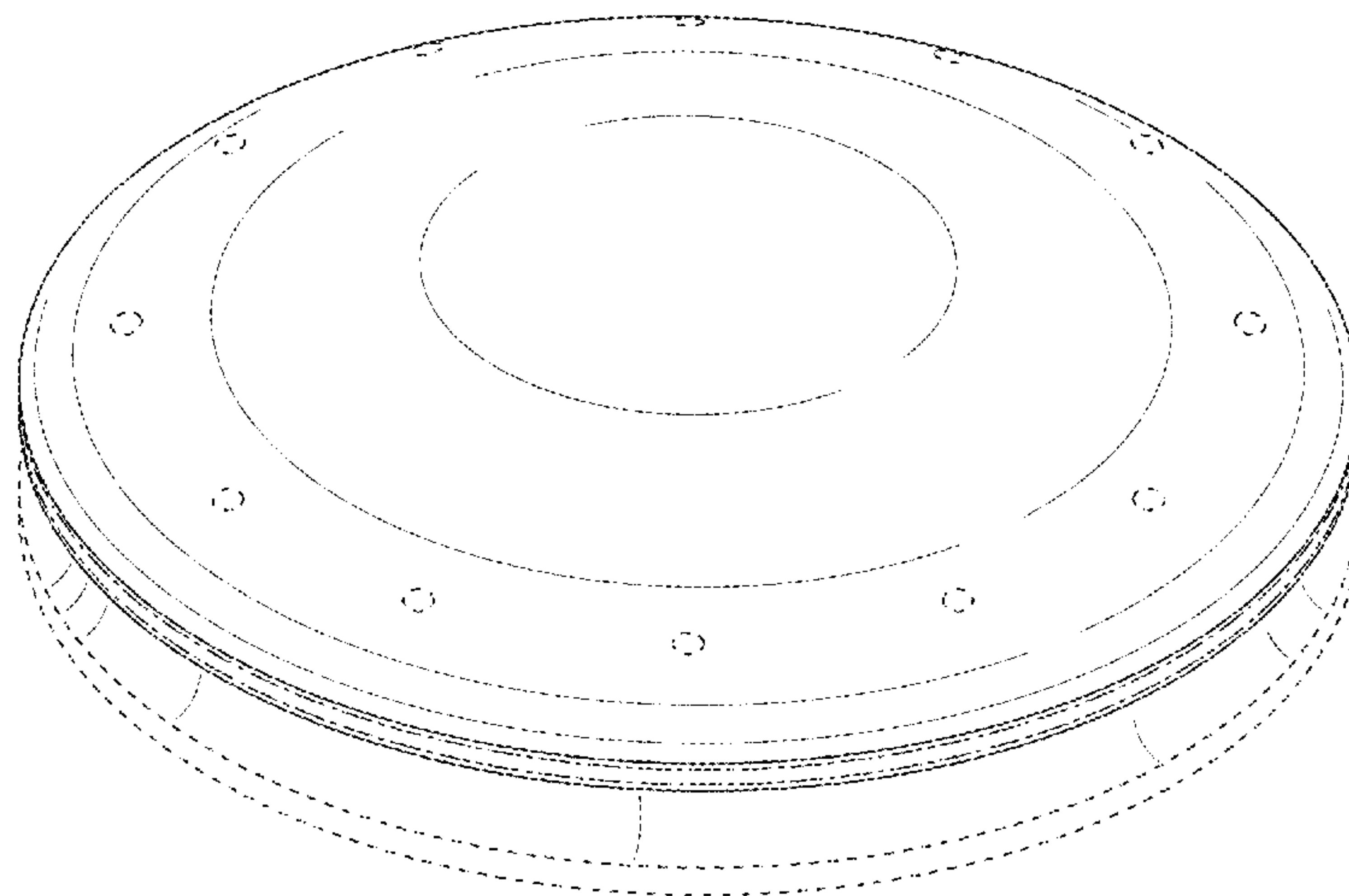
The ornamental design for an activity monitoring device, as shown and described.

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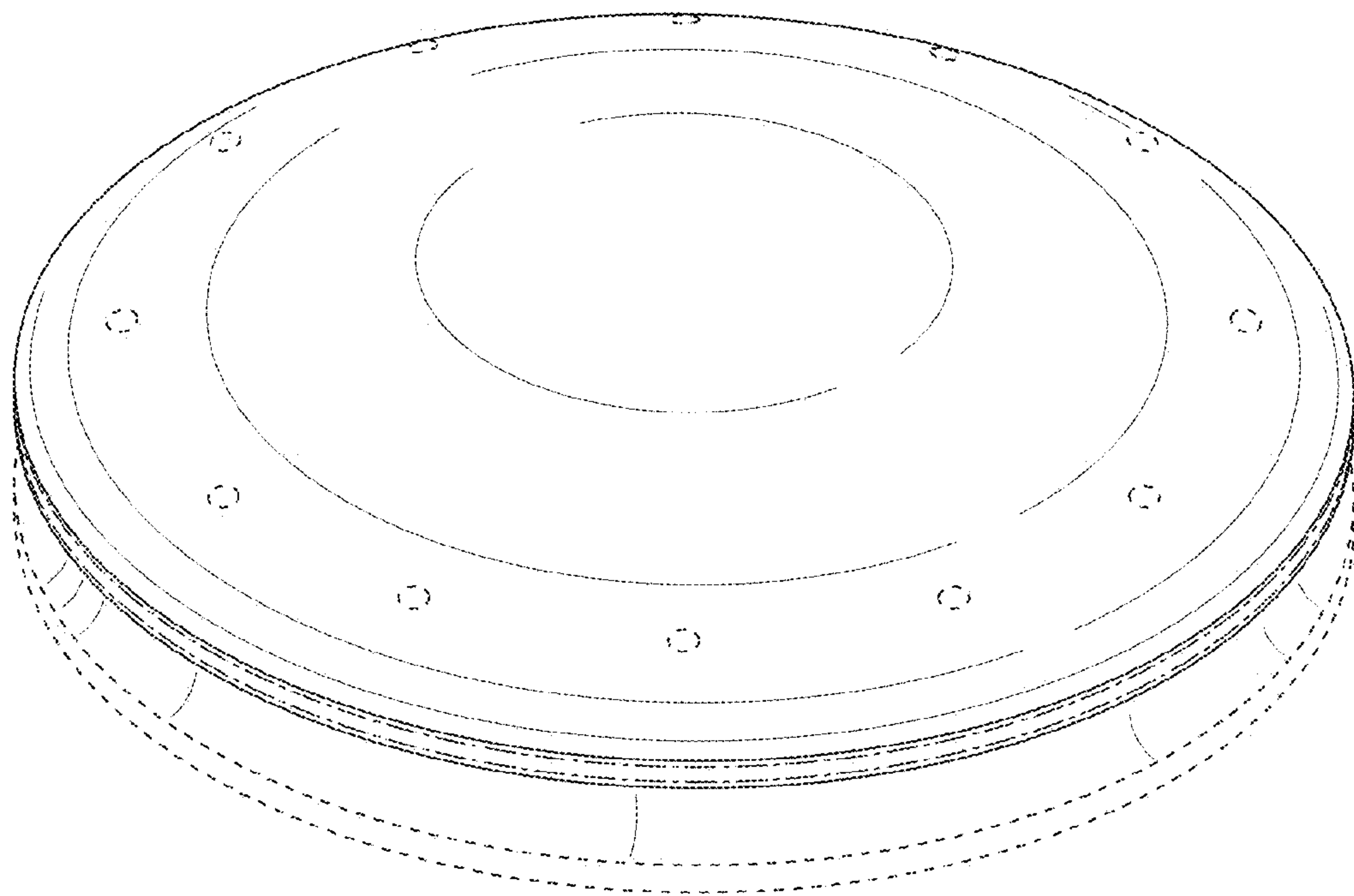

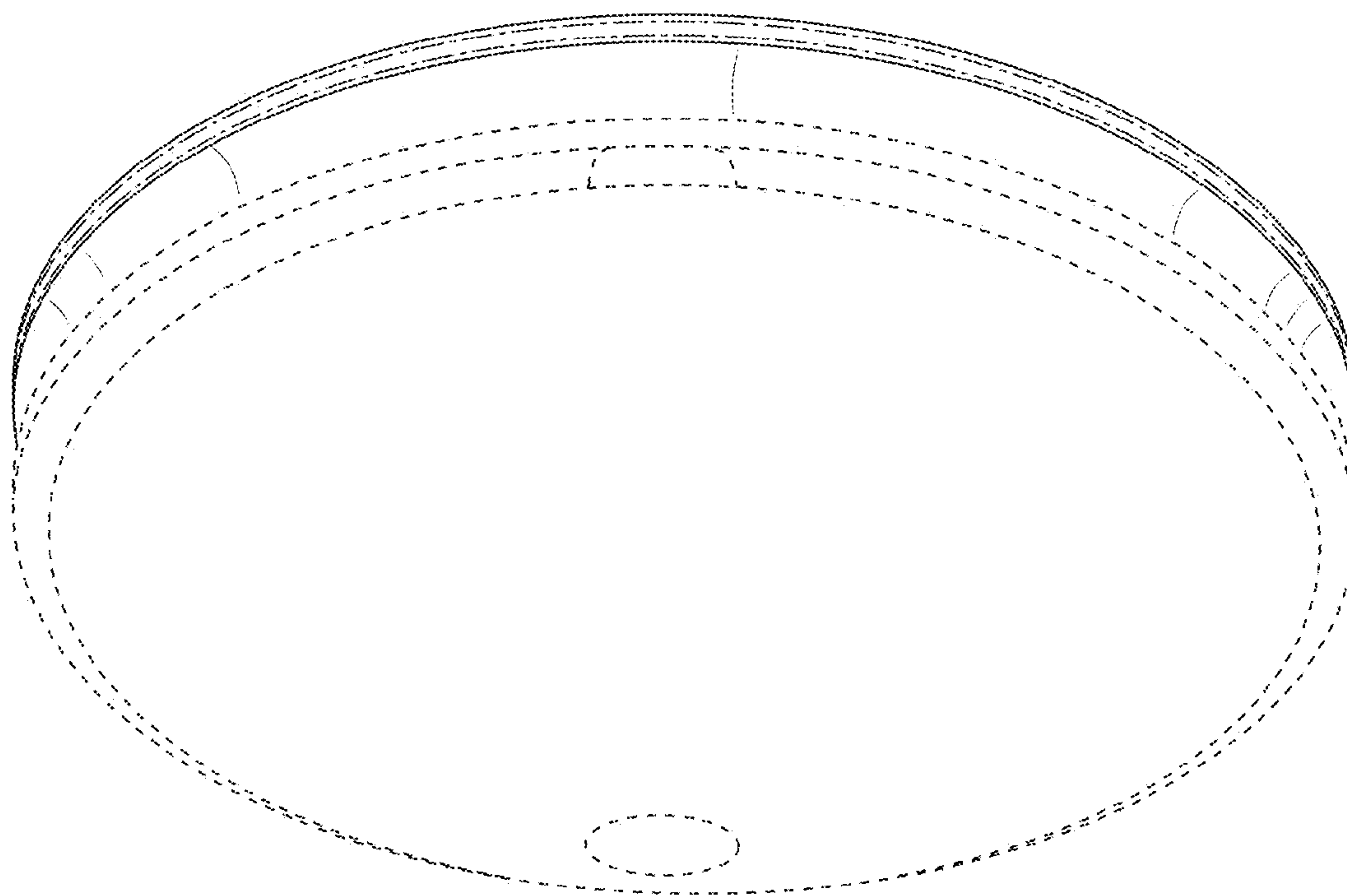

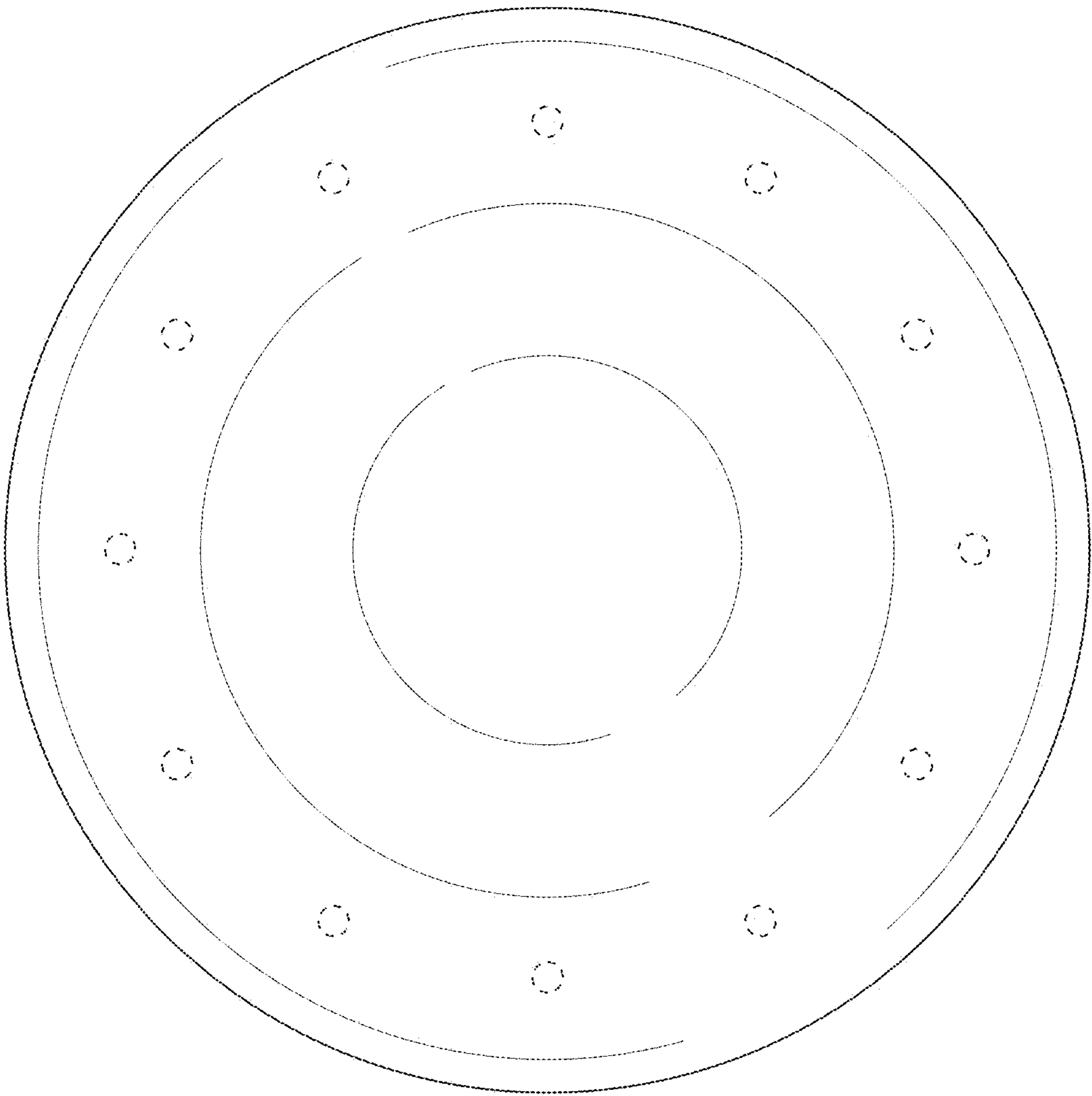

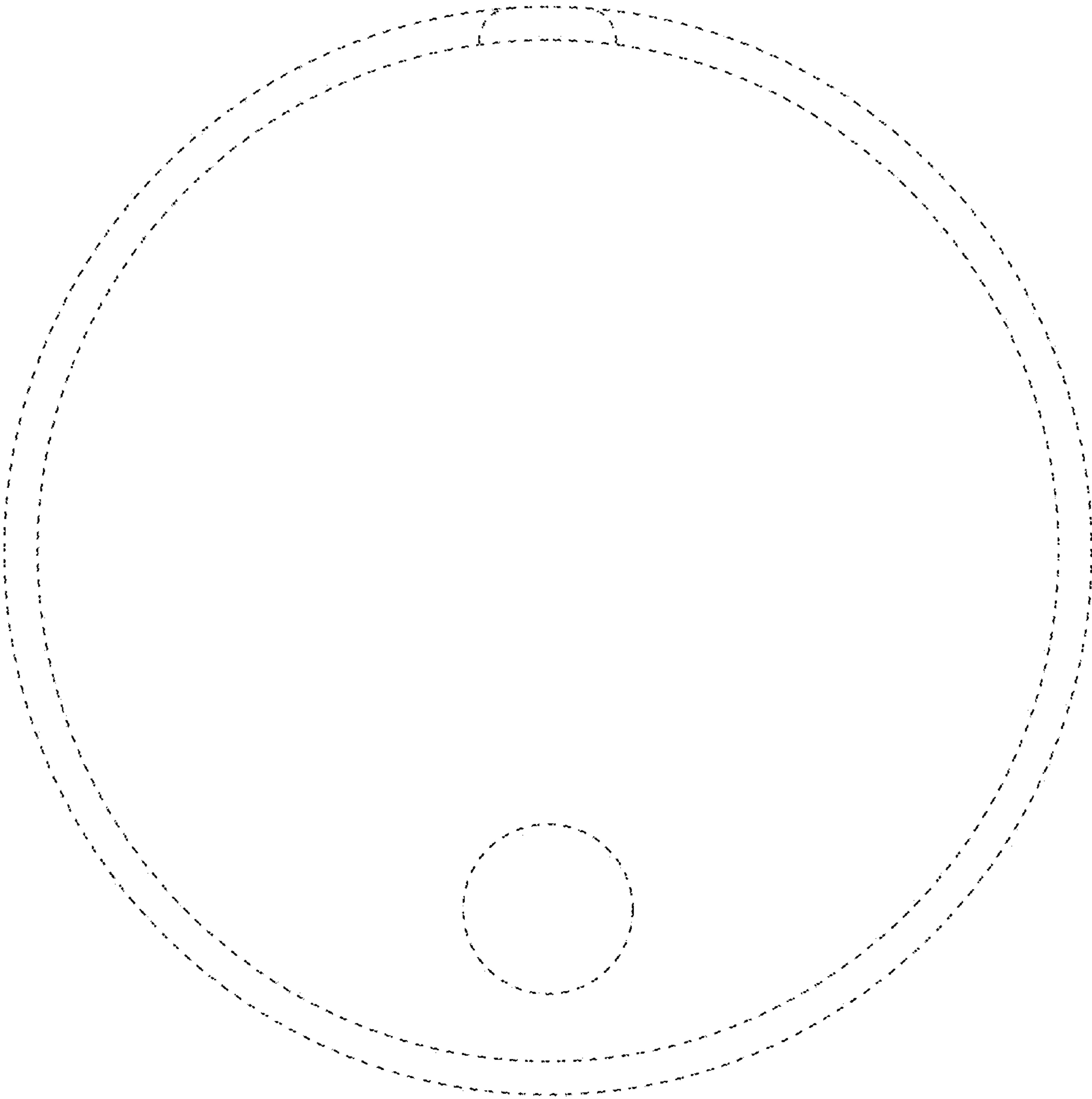

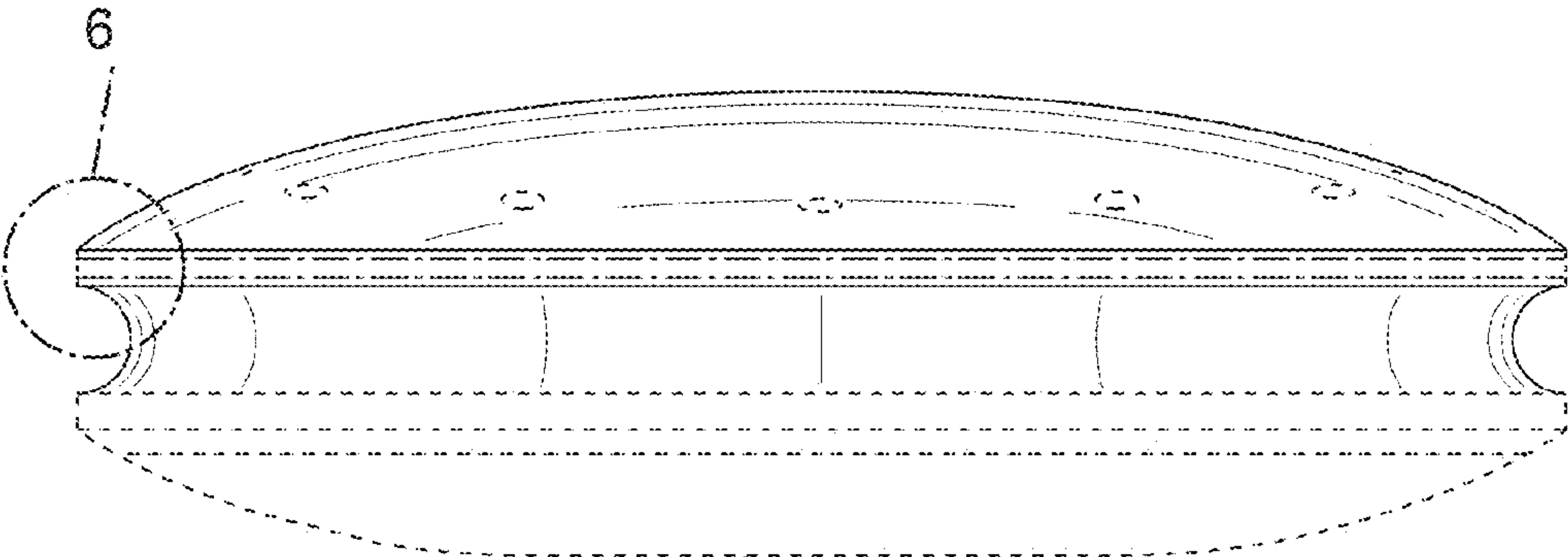

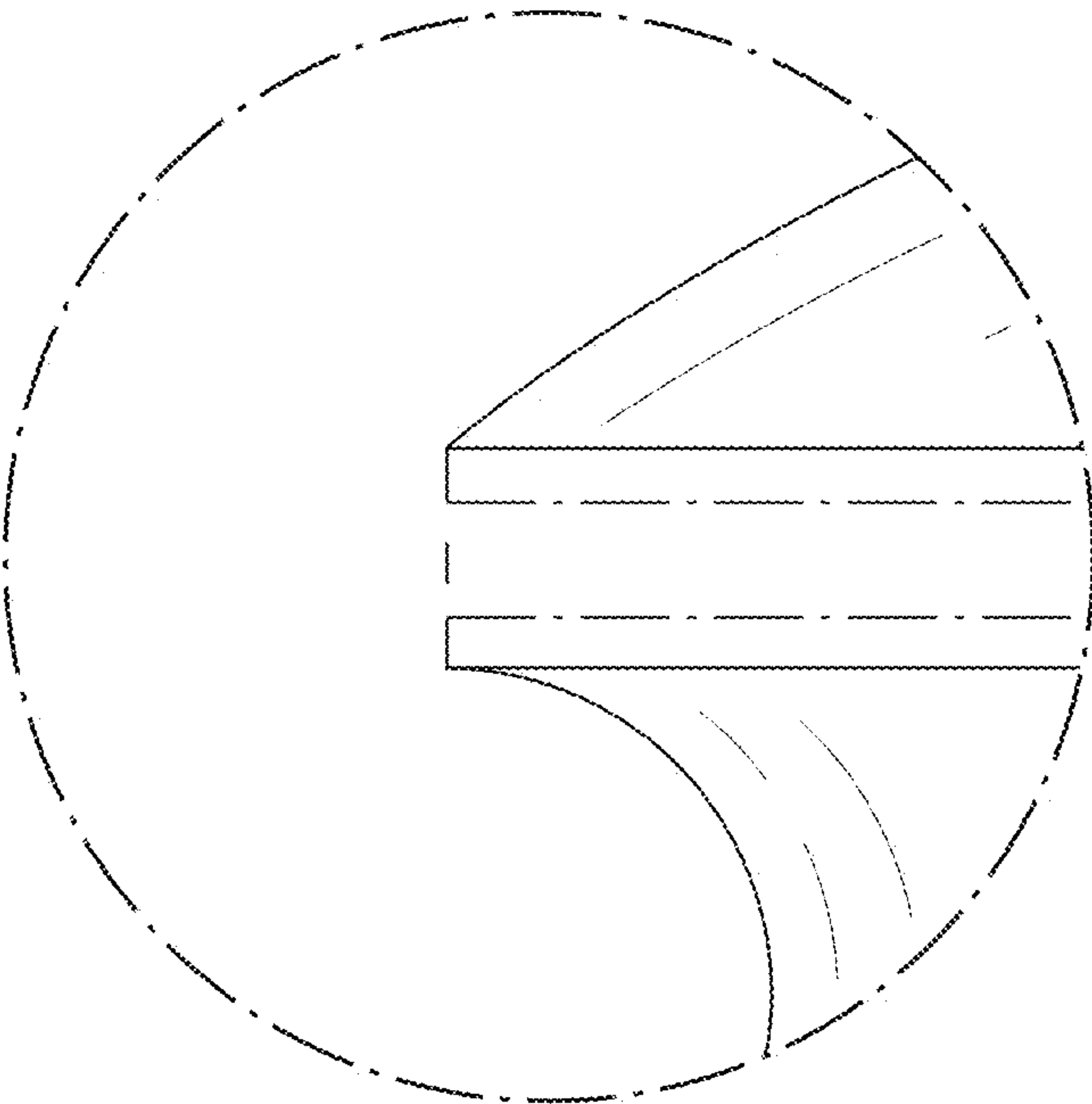

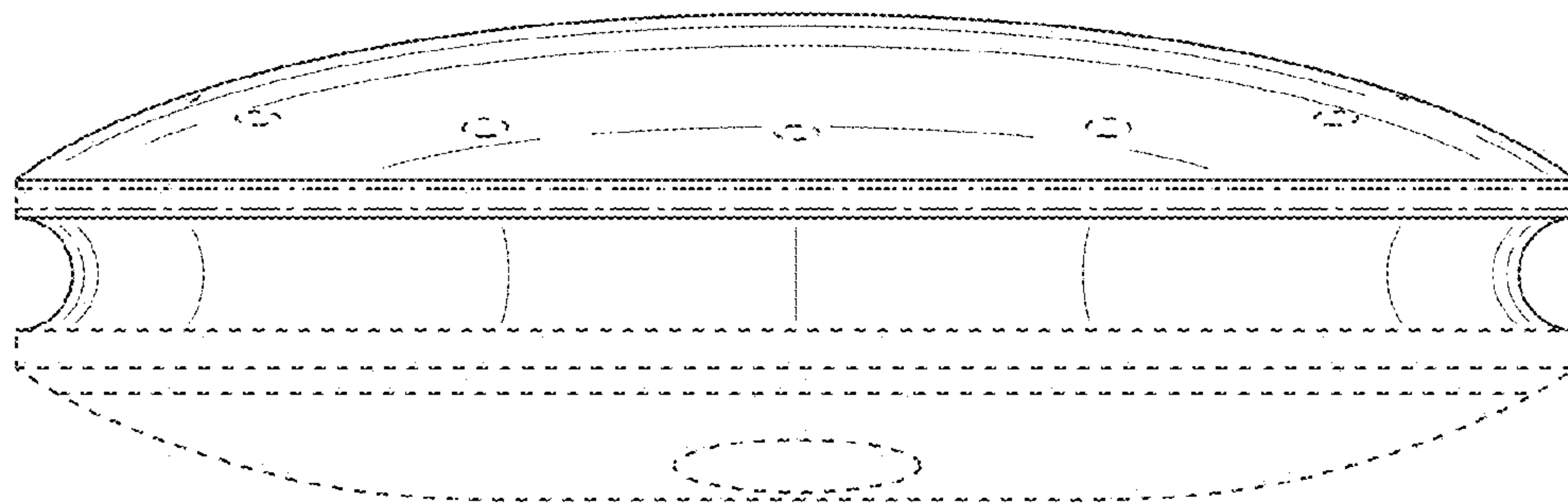

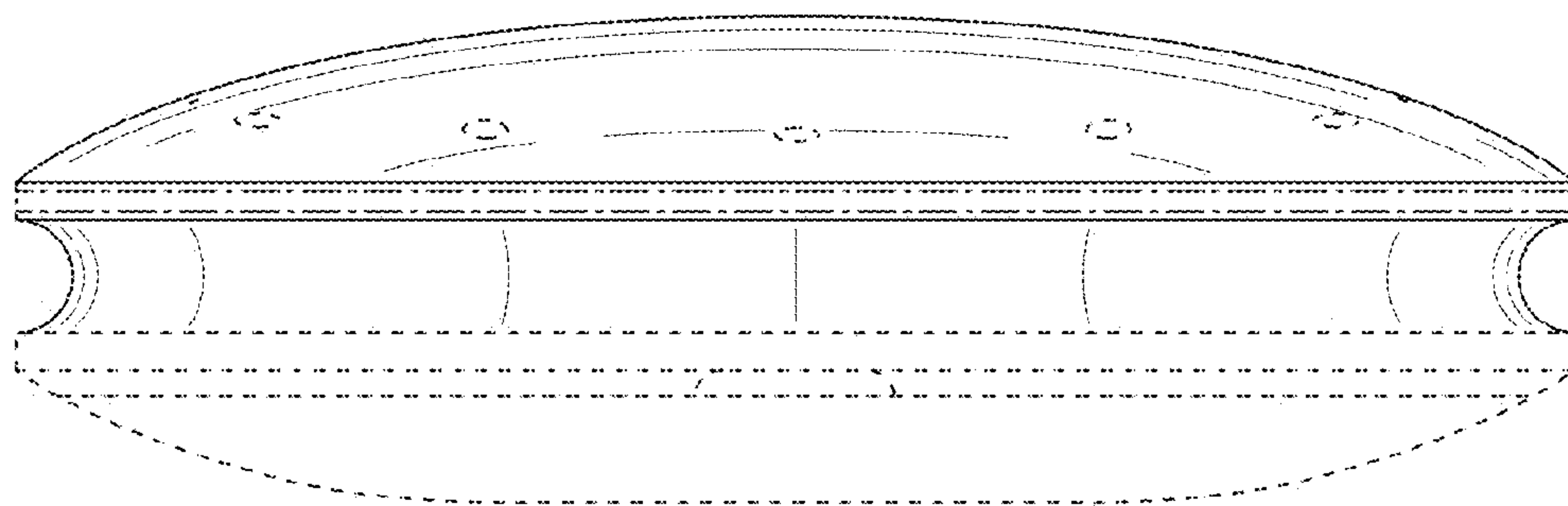
