The ornamental design for a wire decorative holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wire decorative holder showing my new design in a used condition with a tree shown in broken lines;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

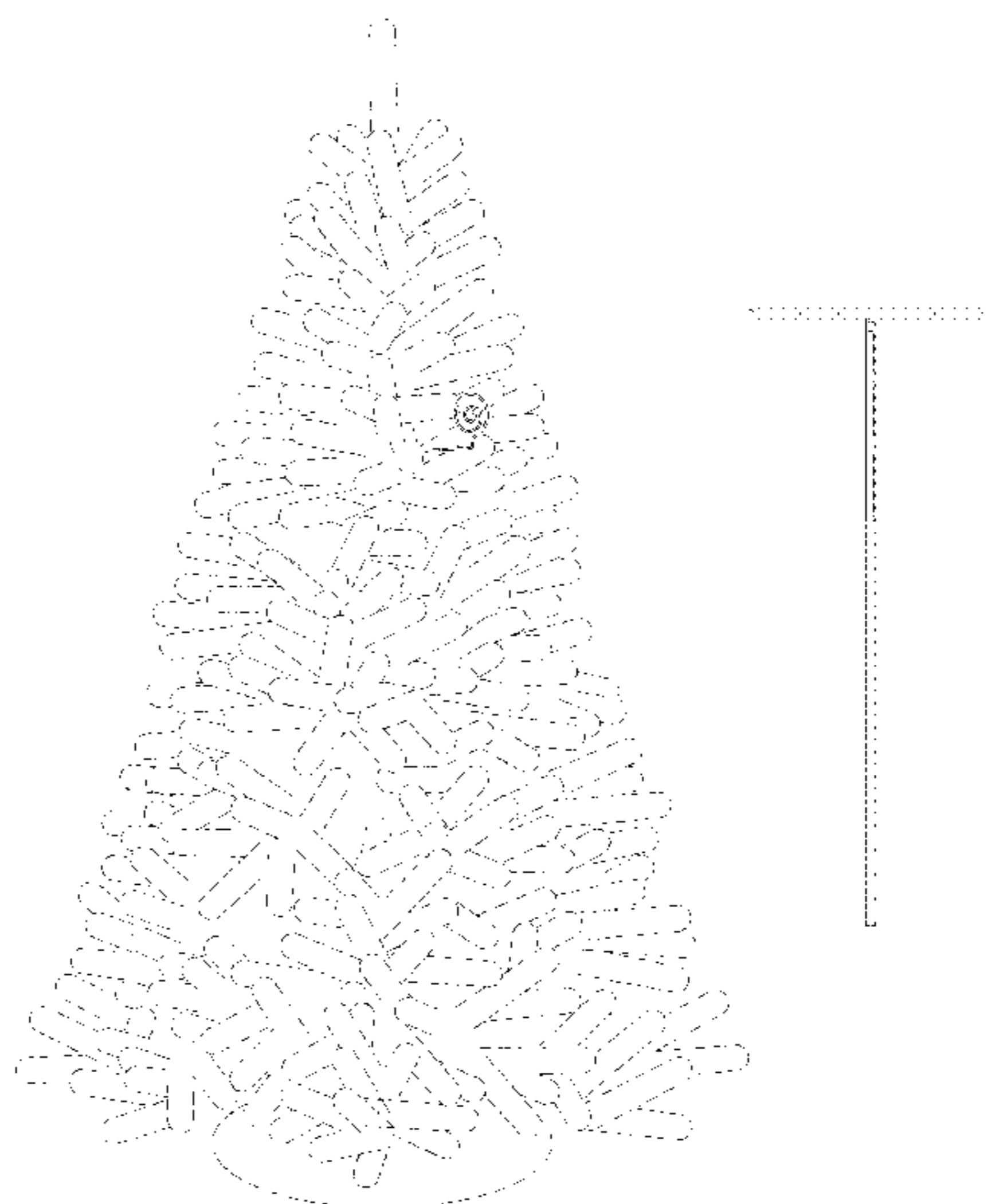
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

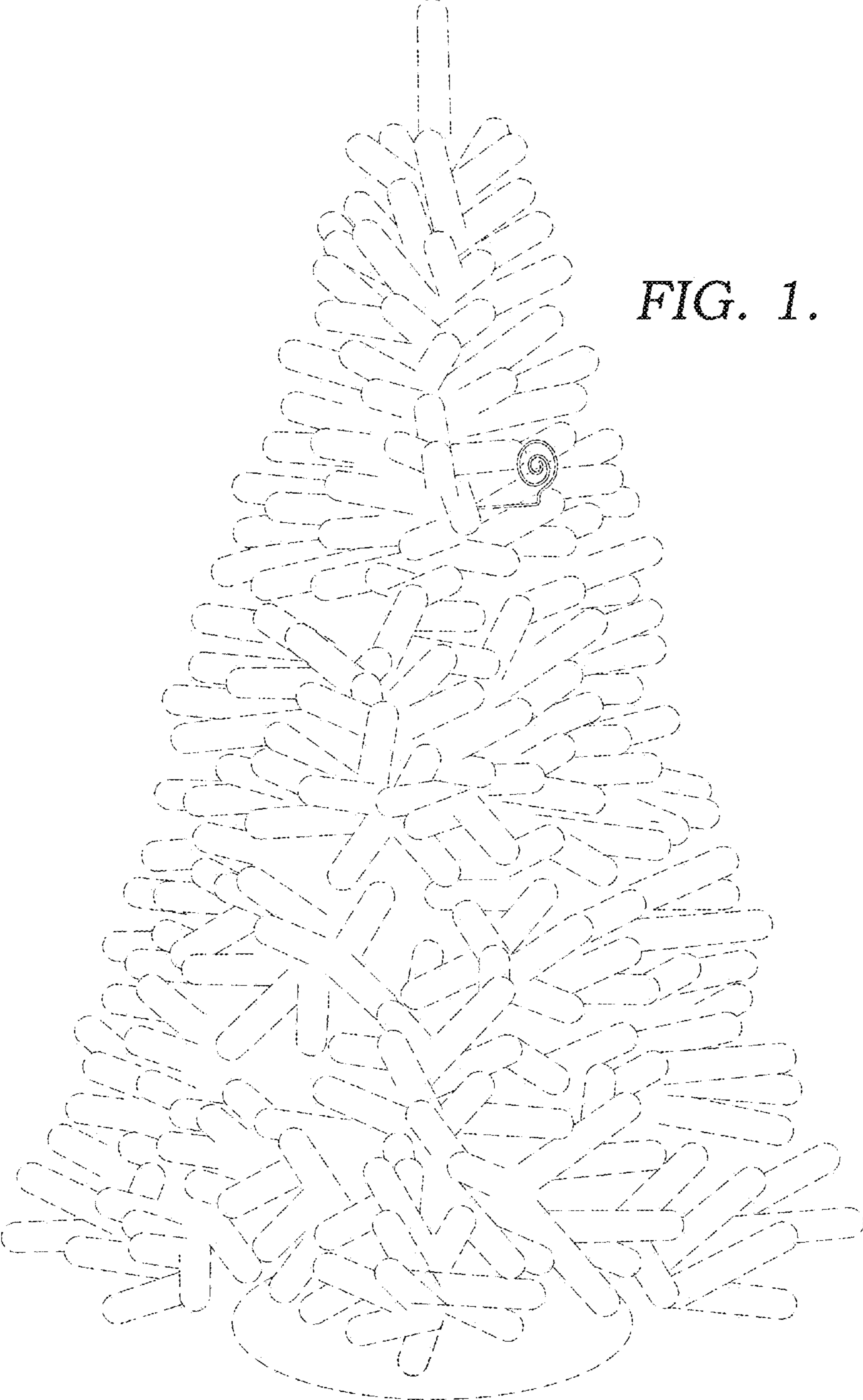

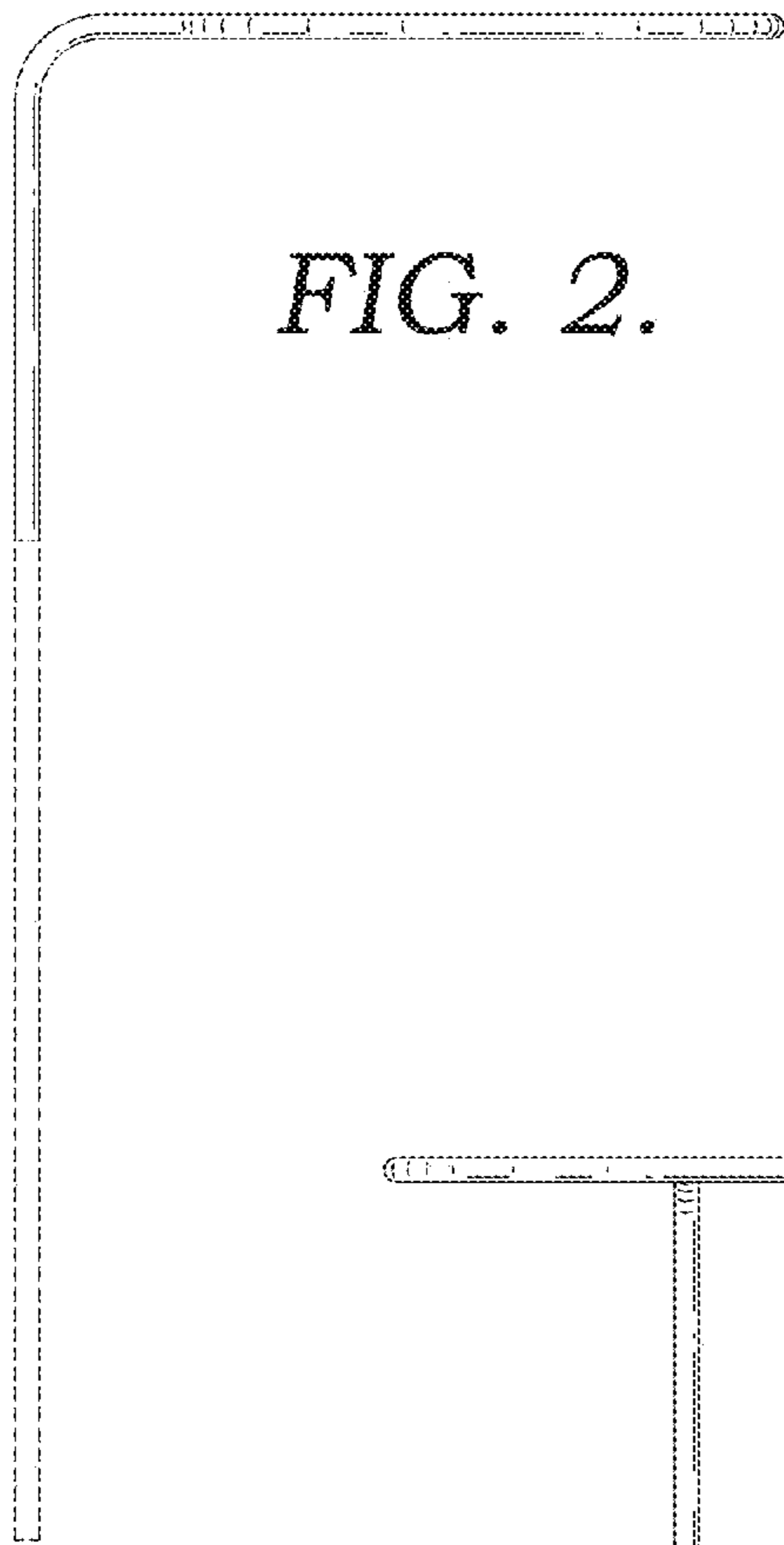

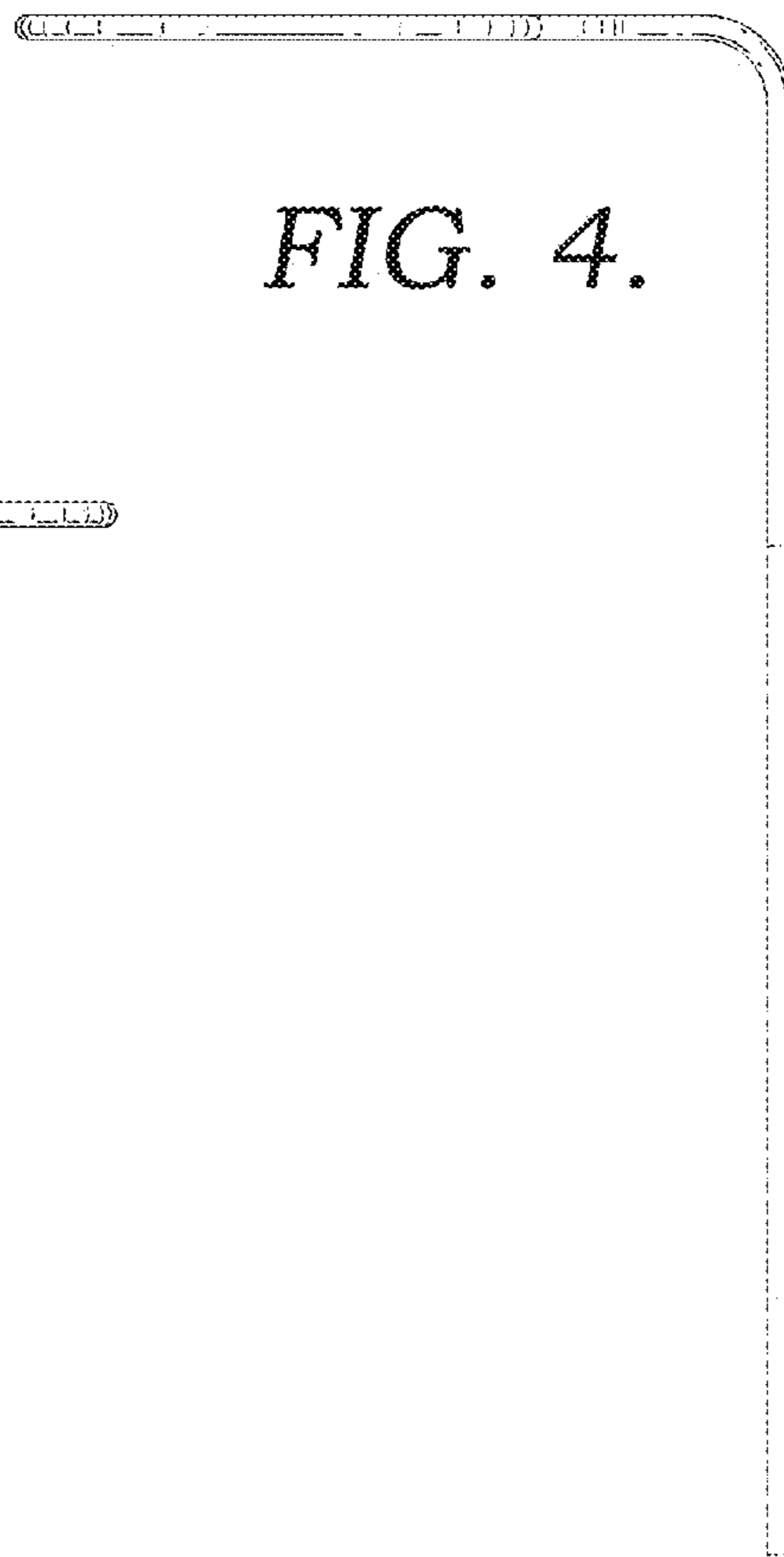

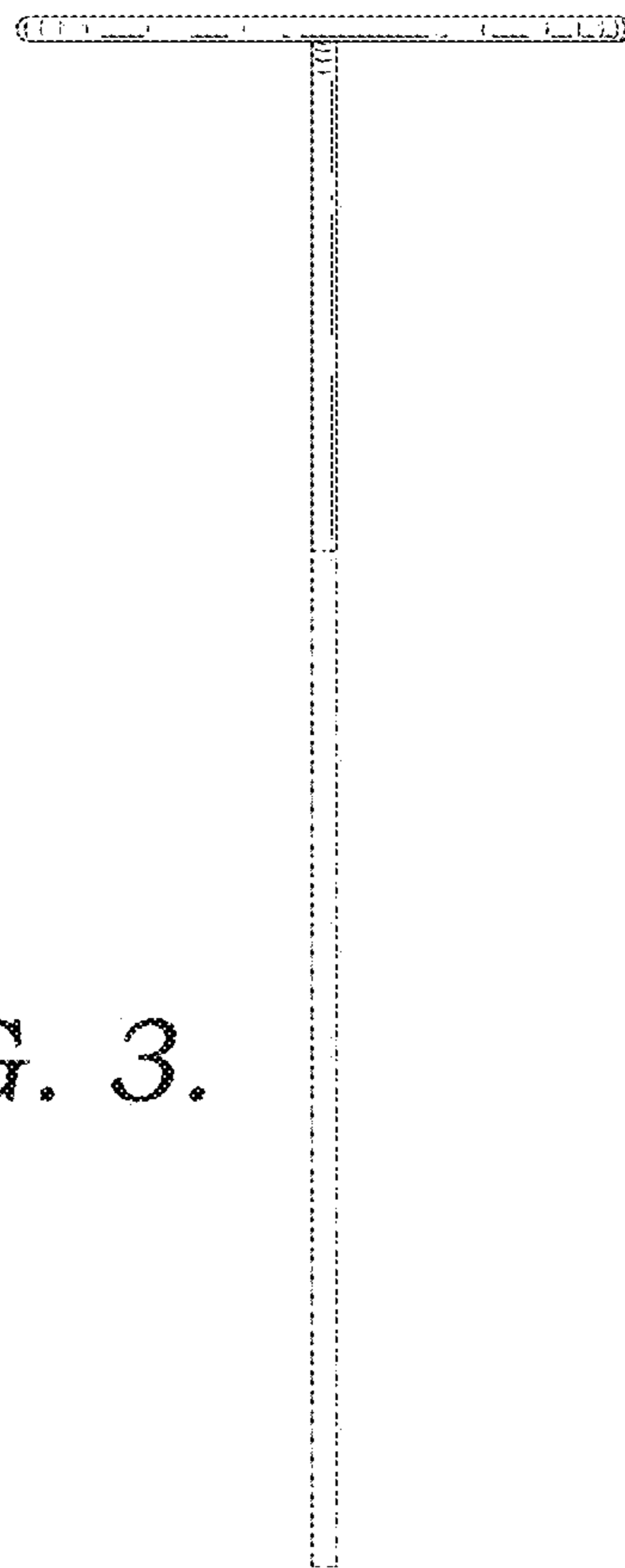

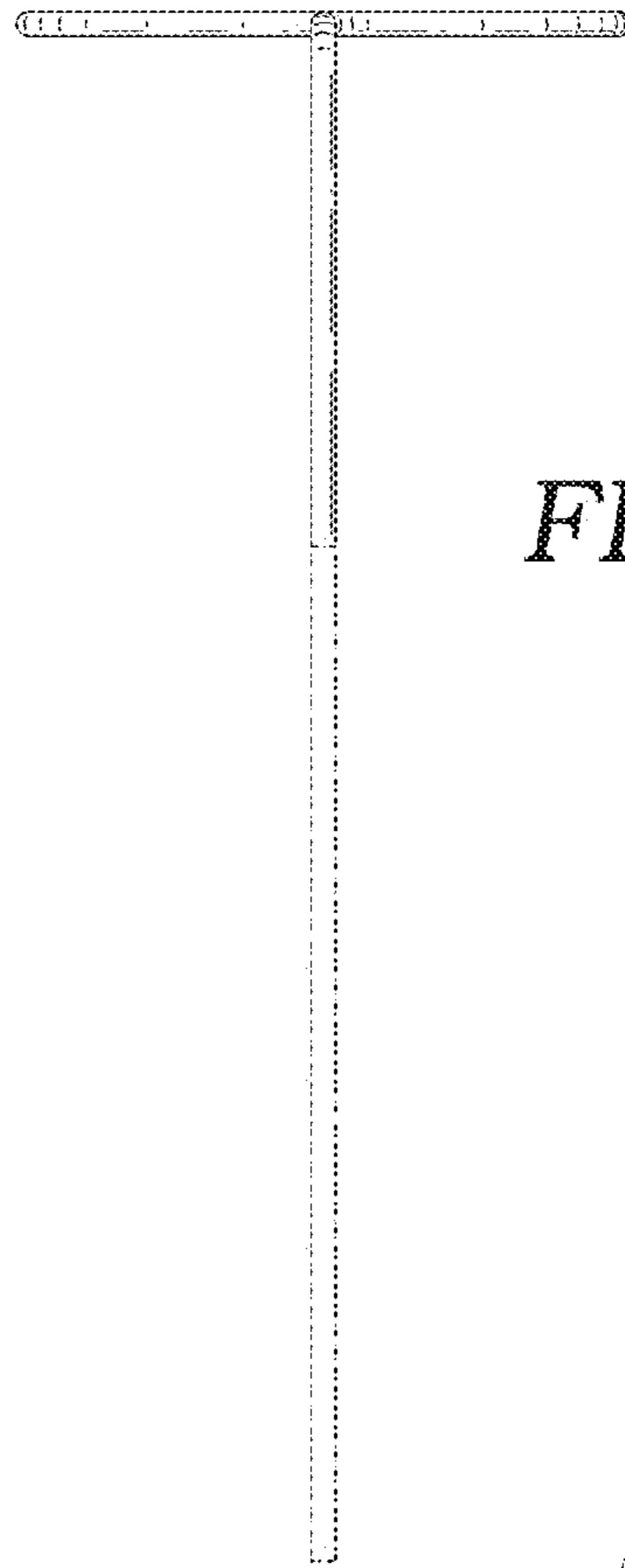

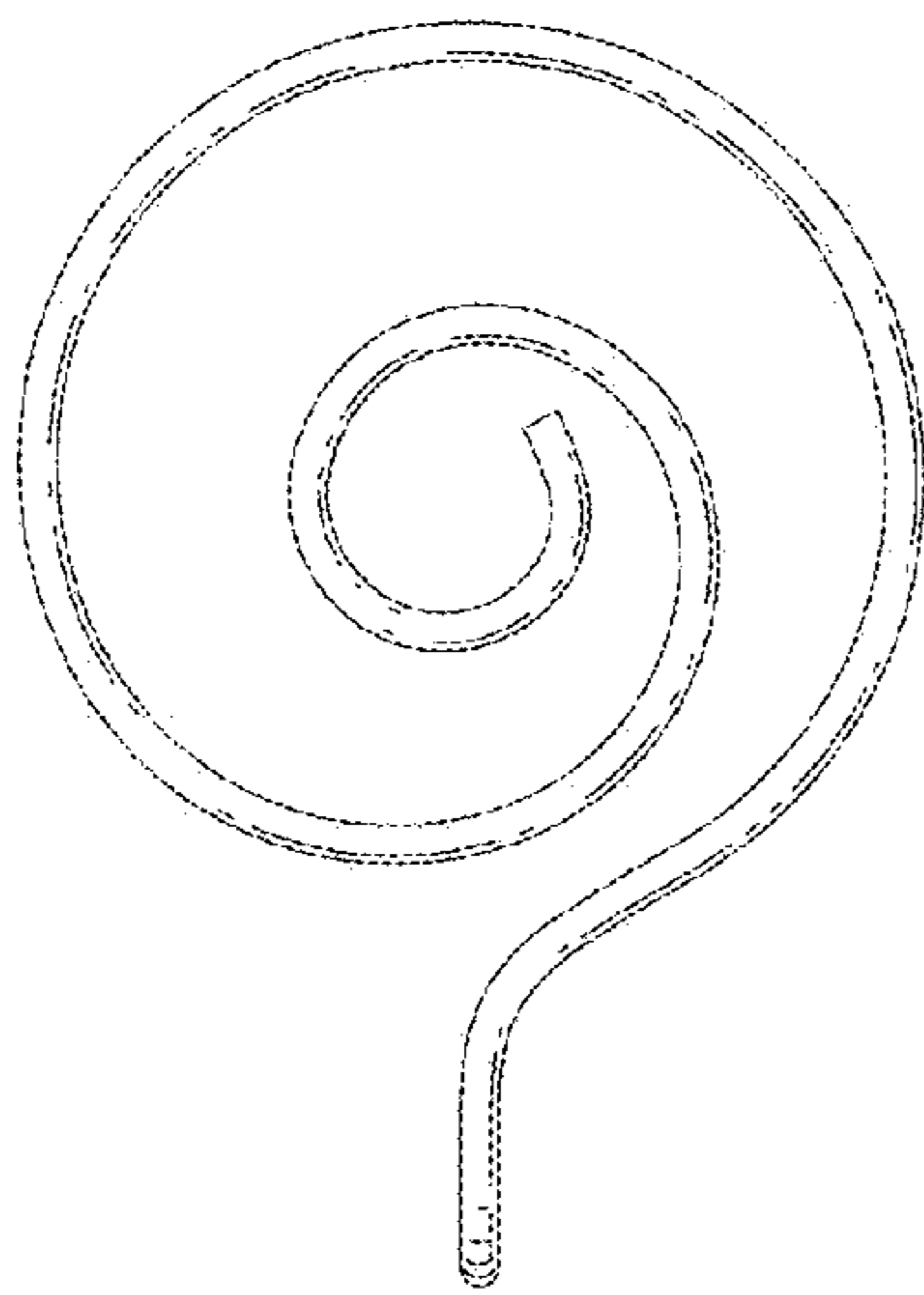

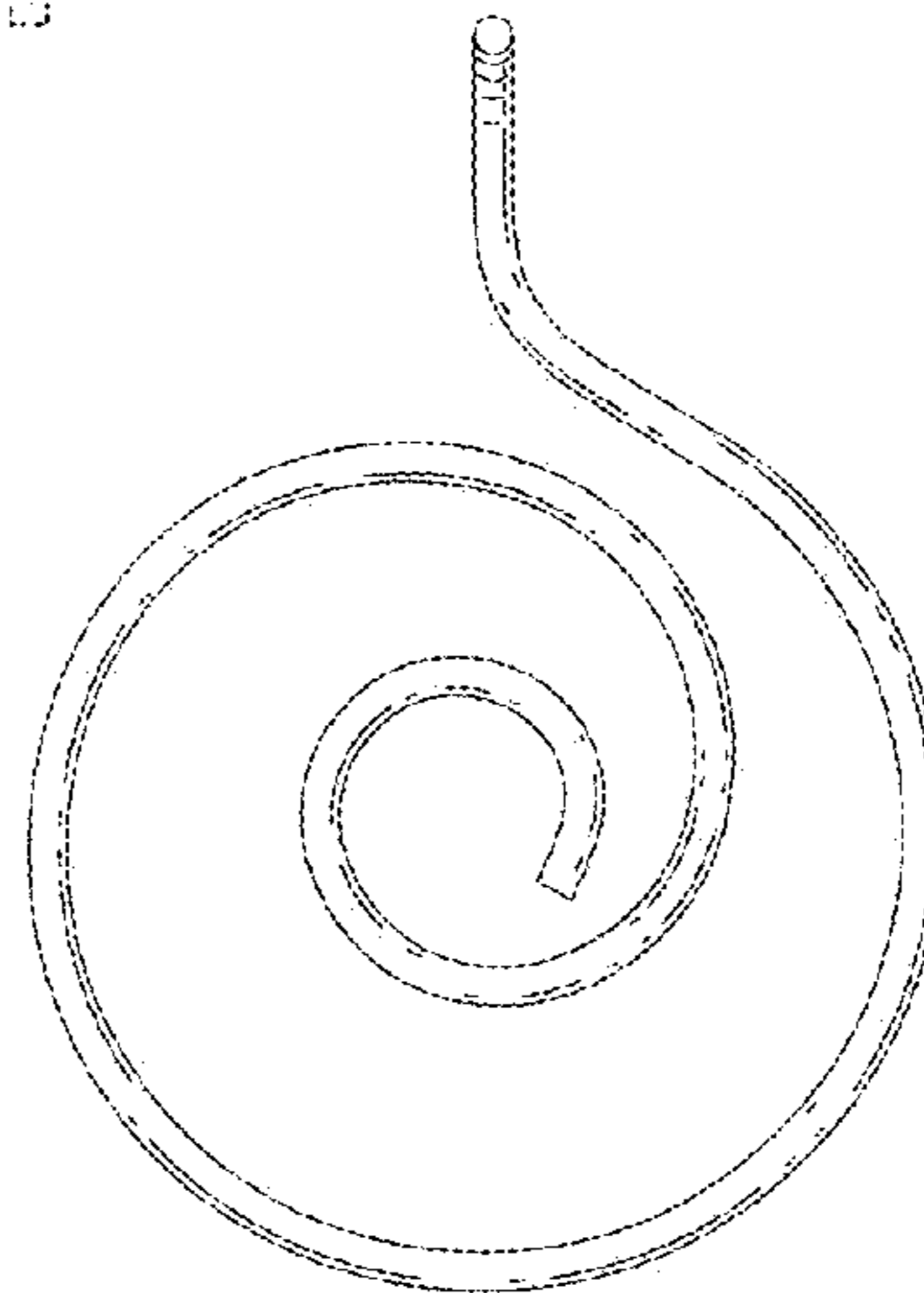
