(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a transparent bottle
showing my design, the rear view being the same;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side
elevational view being the same; and

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a transparent bottle
showing my design in accordance with a second embodiment,
the rear view being the same;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side
elevational view being the same; and

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of an opaque bottle showing
my new design in accordance with a third embodiment, the
contours of the outside sidewall surfaces being the same as
those shown in Embodiment 1 (FIGS. 1-4);

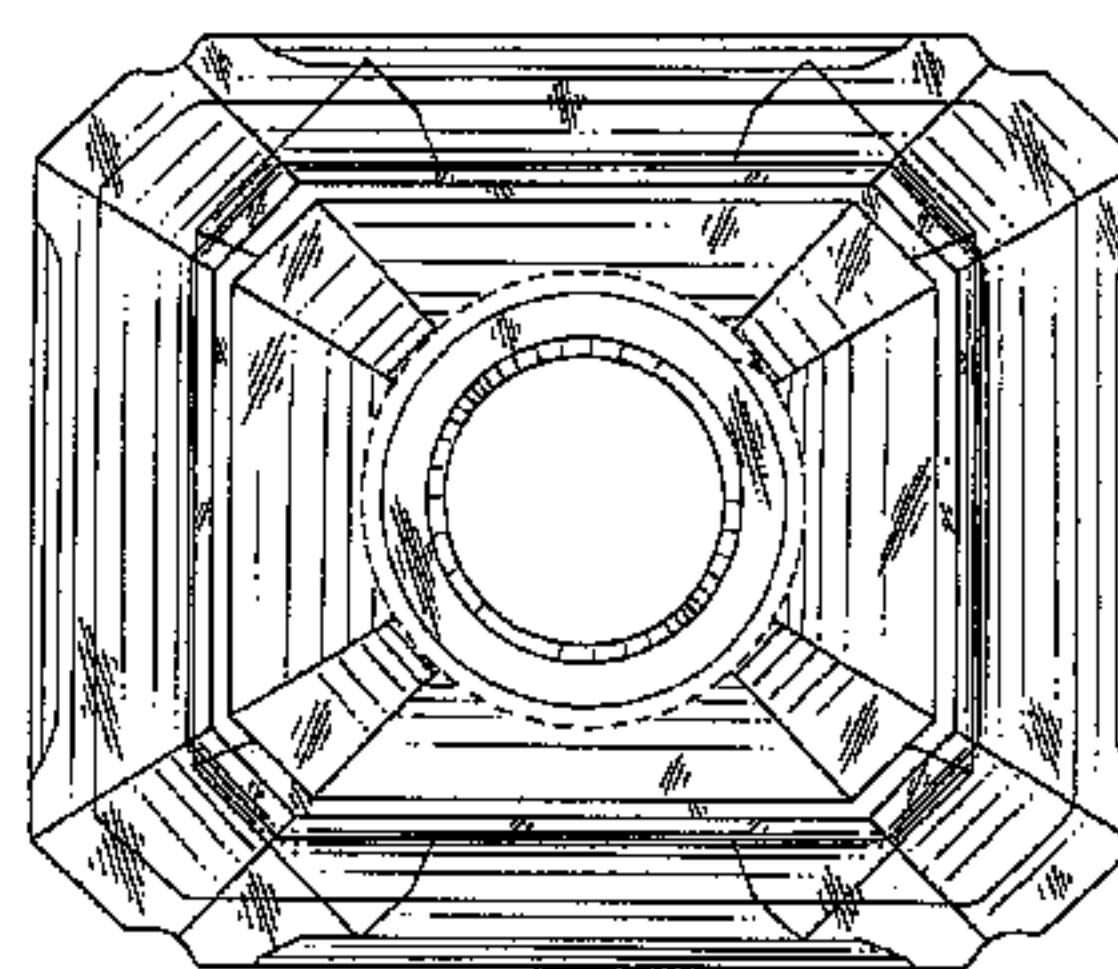
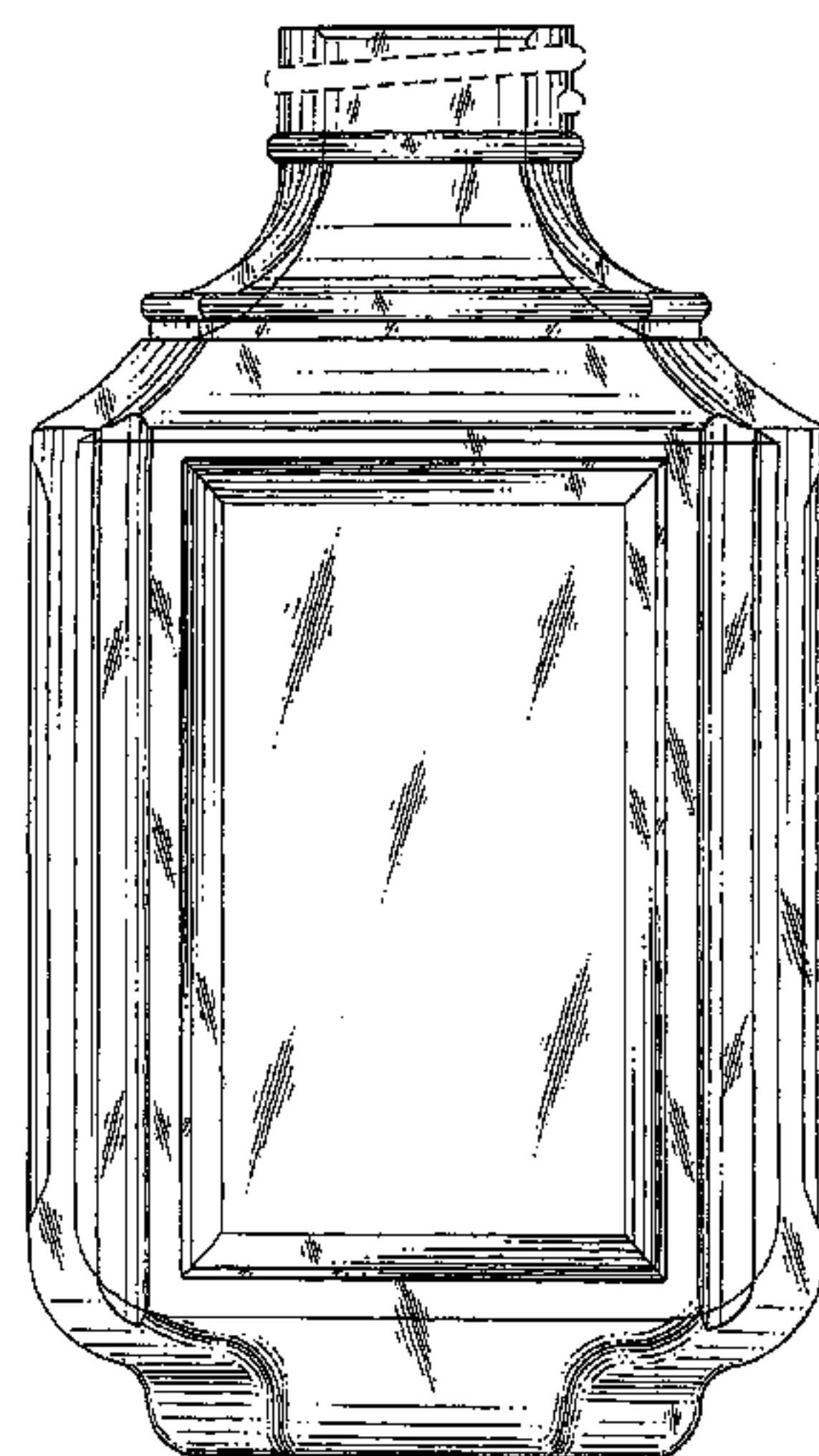
FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;

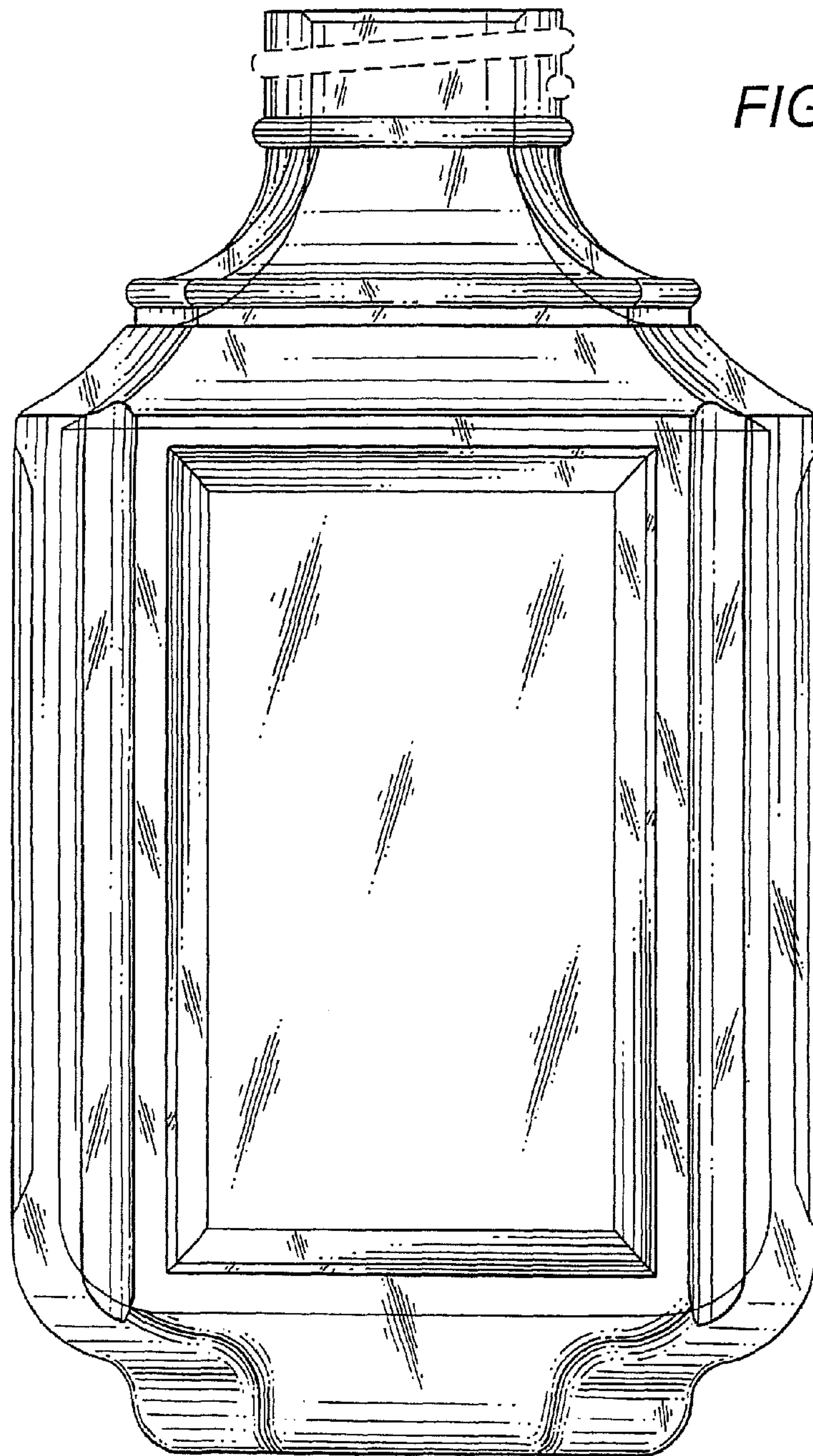

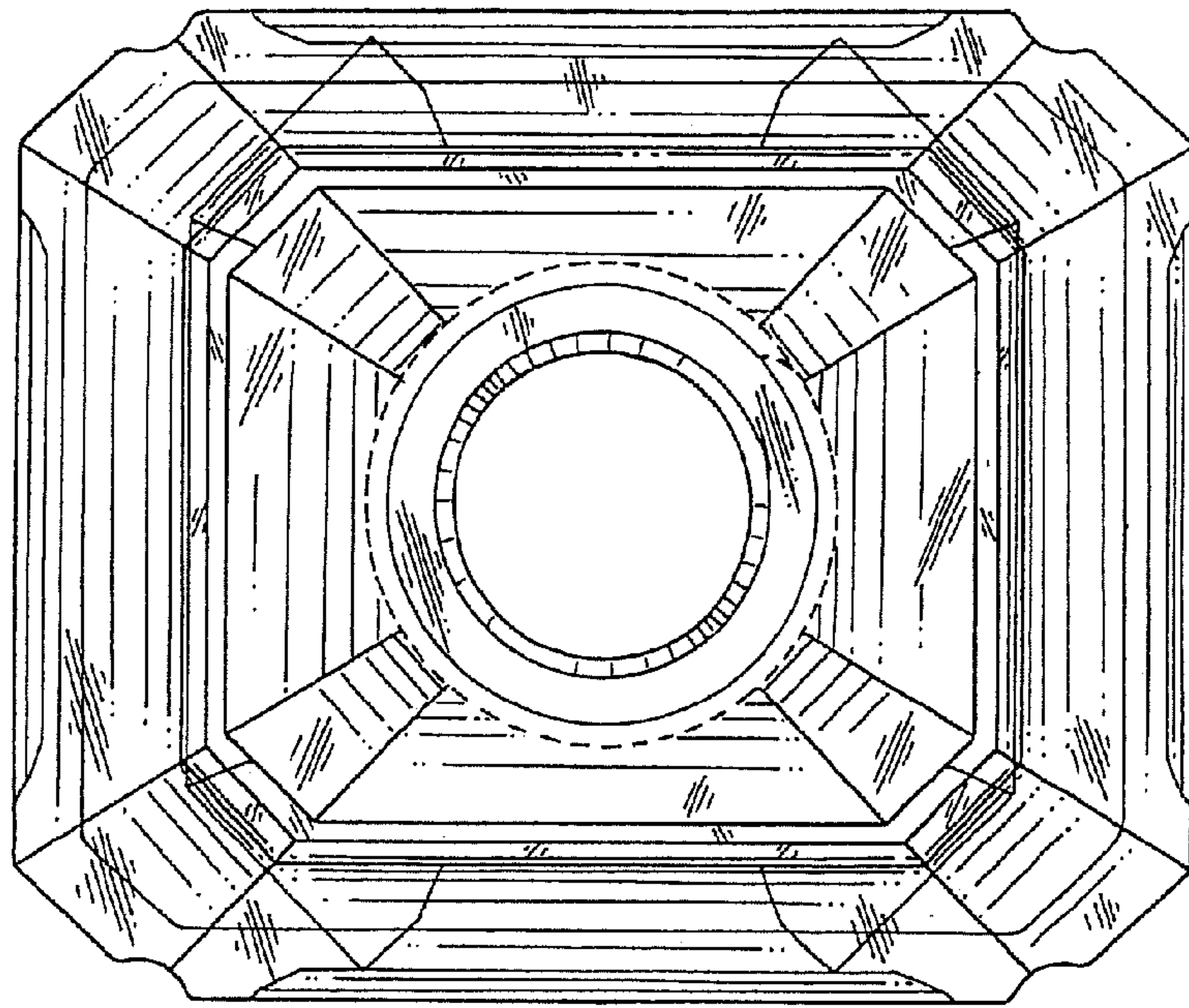
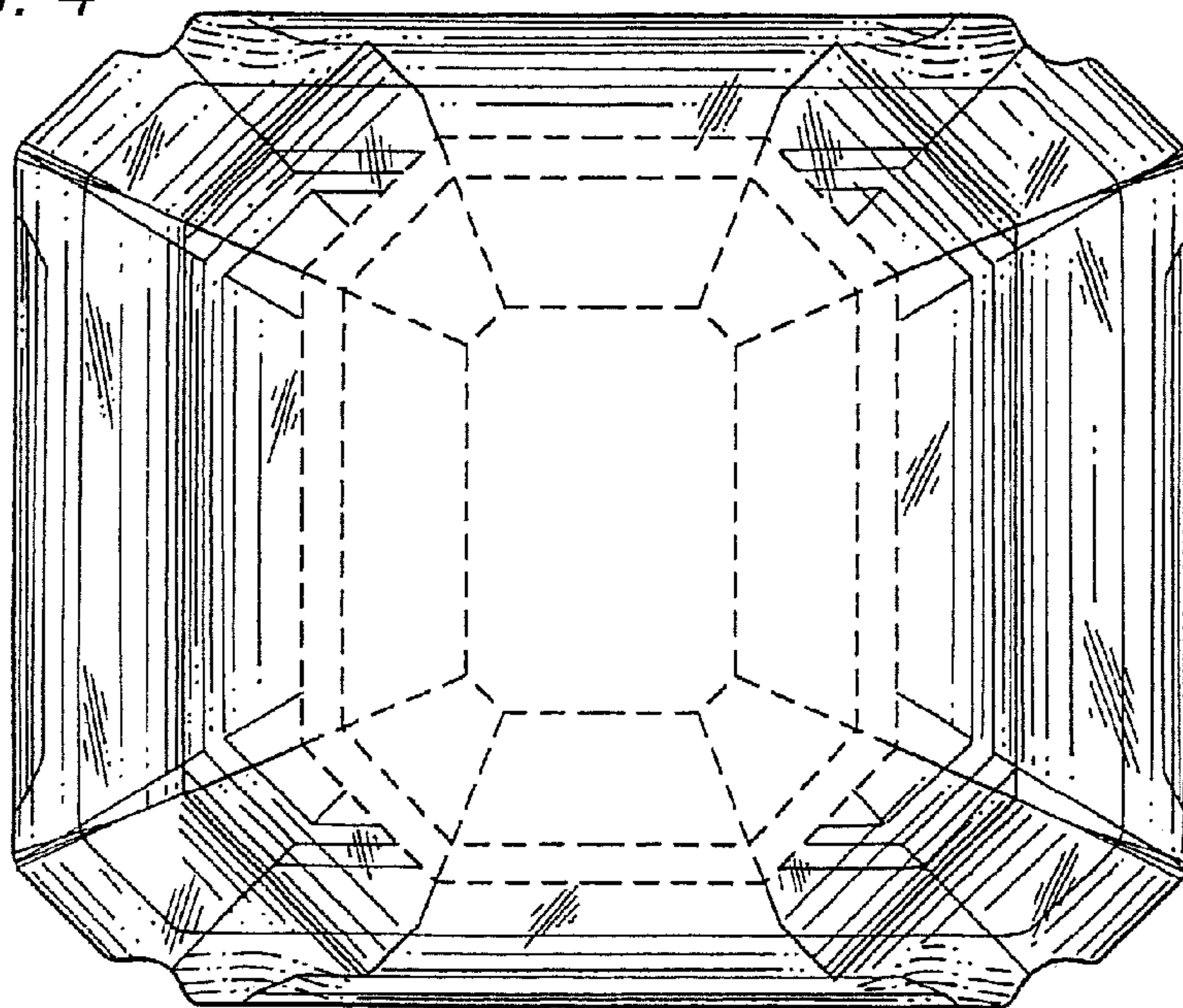

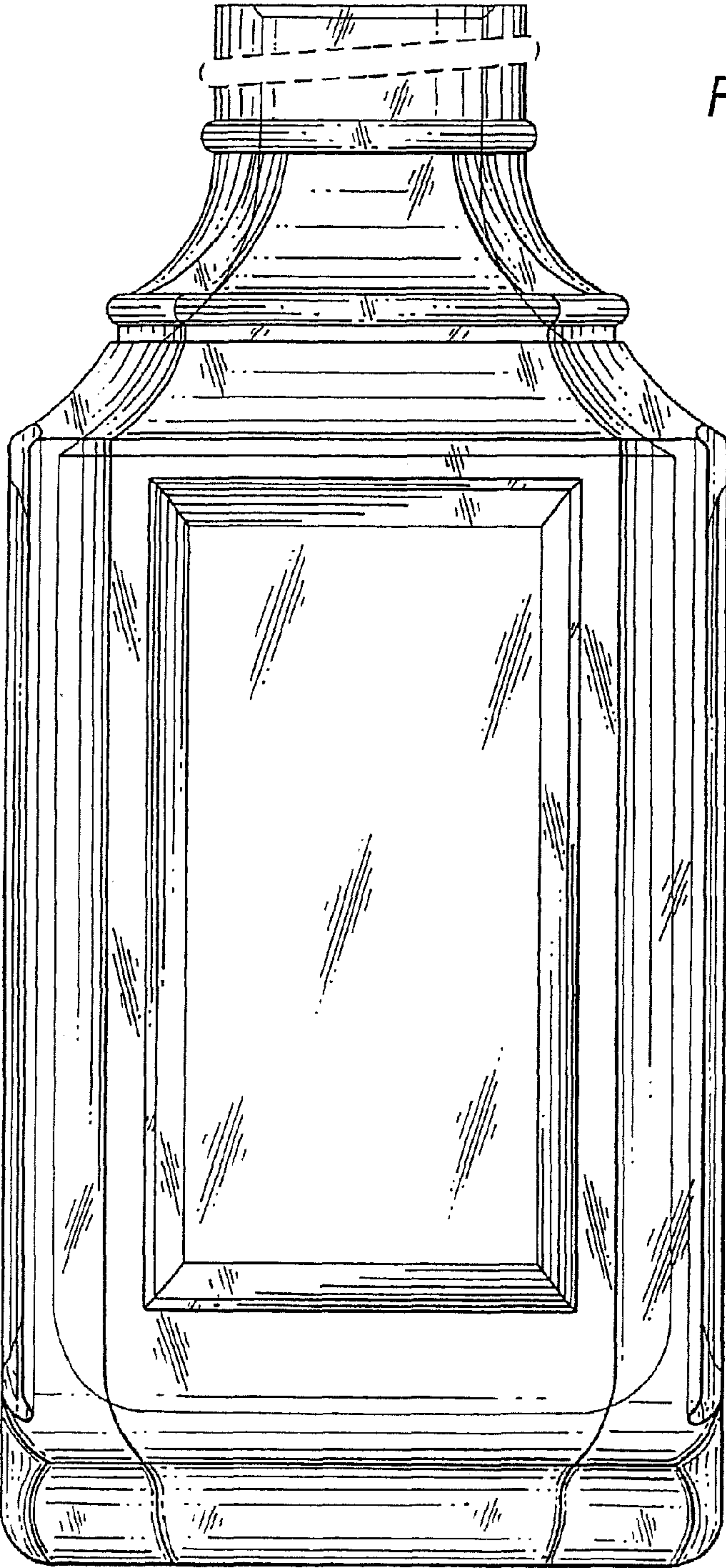

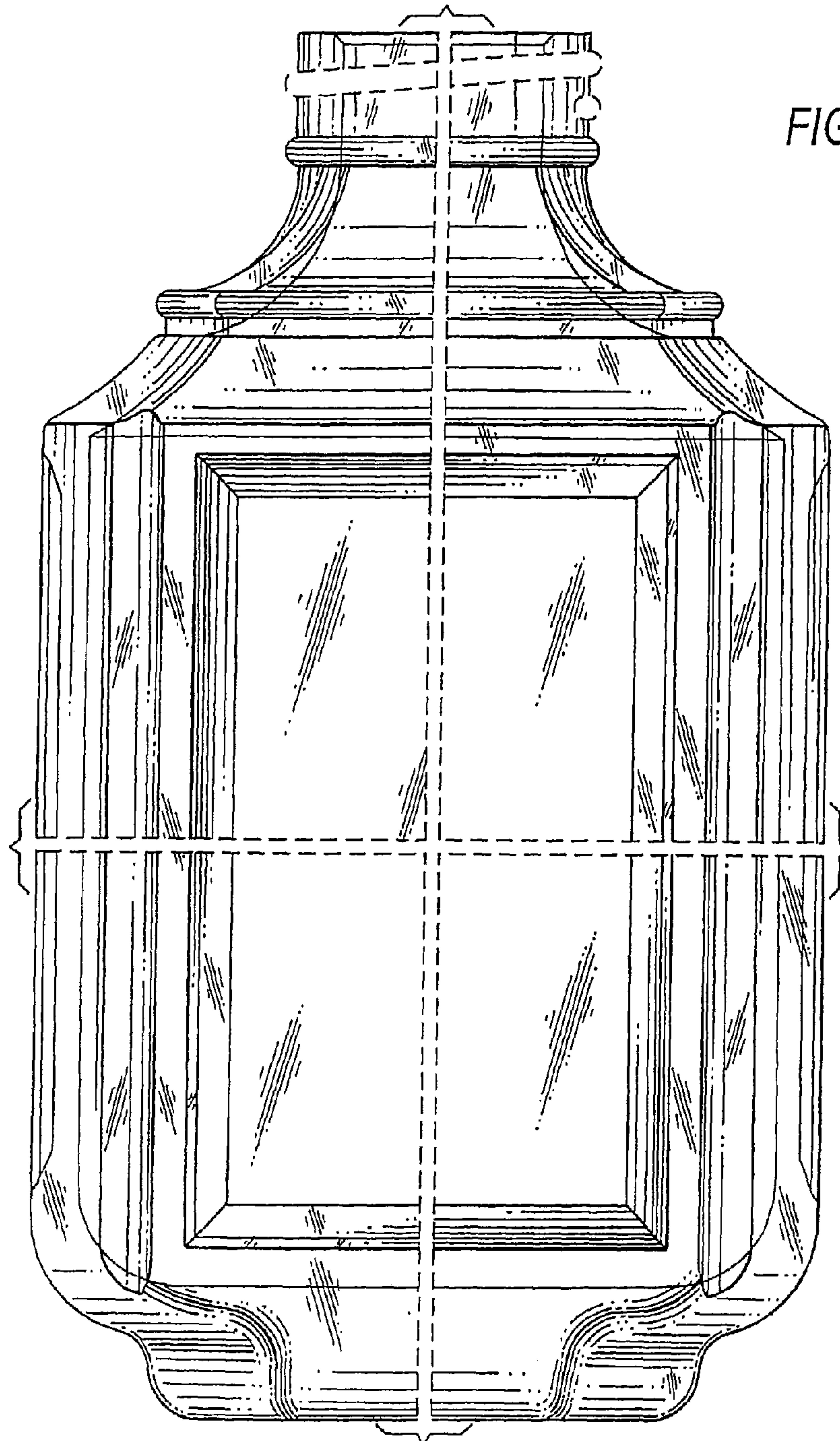

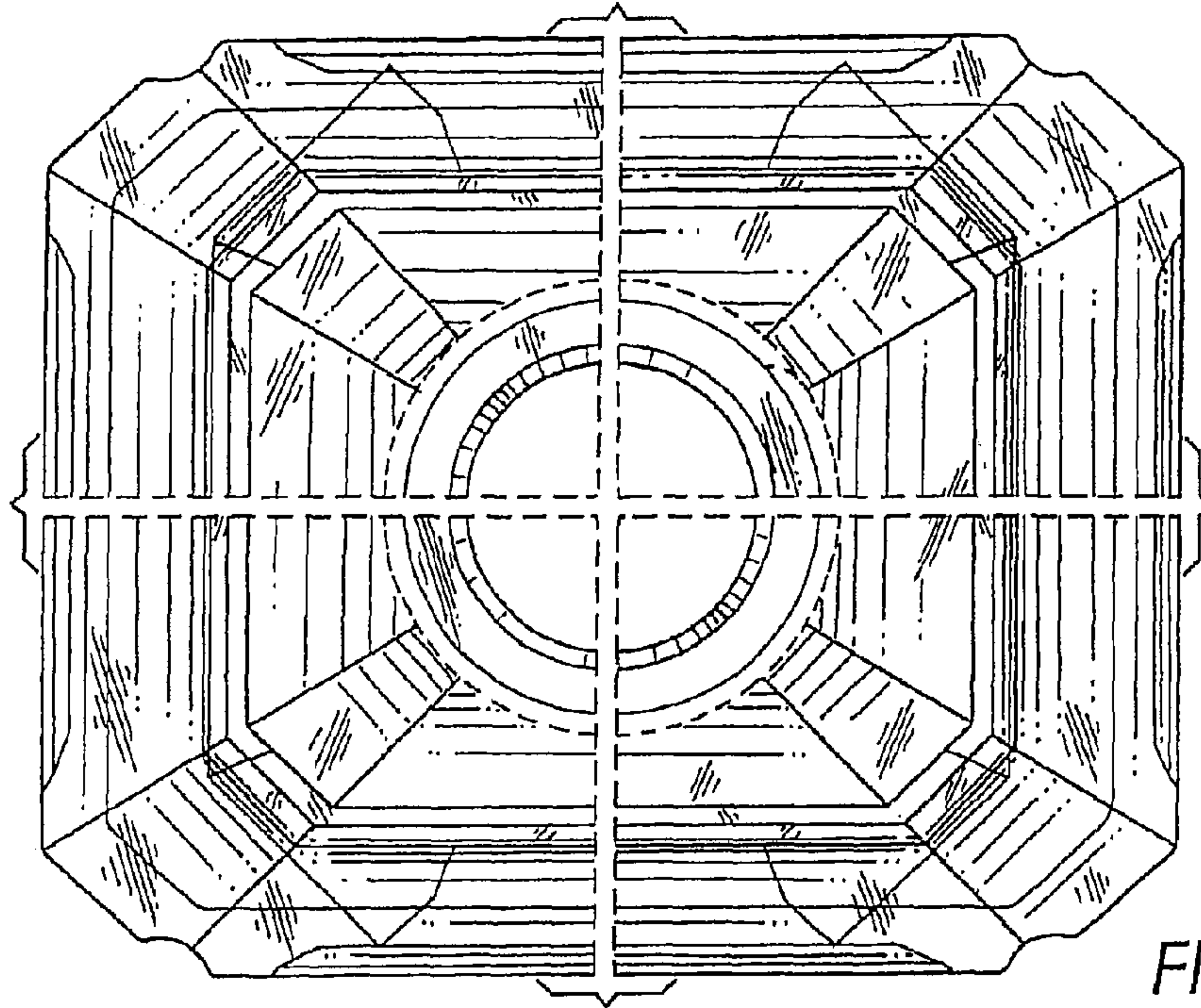
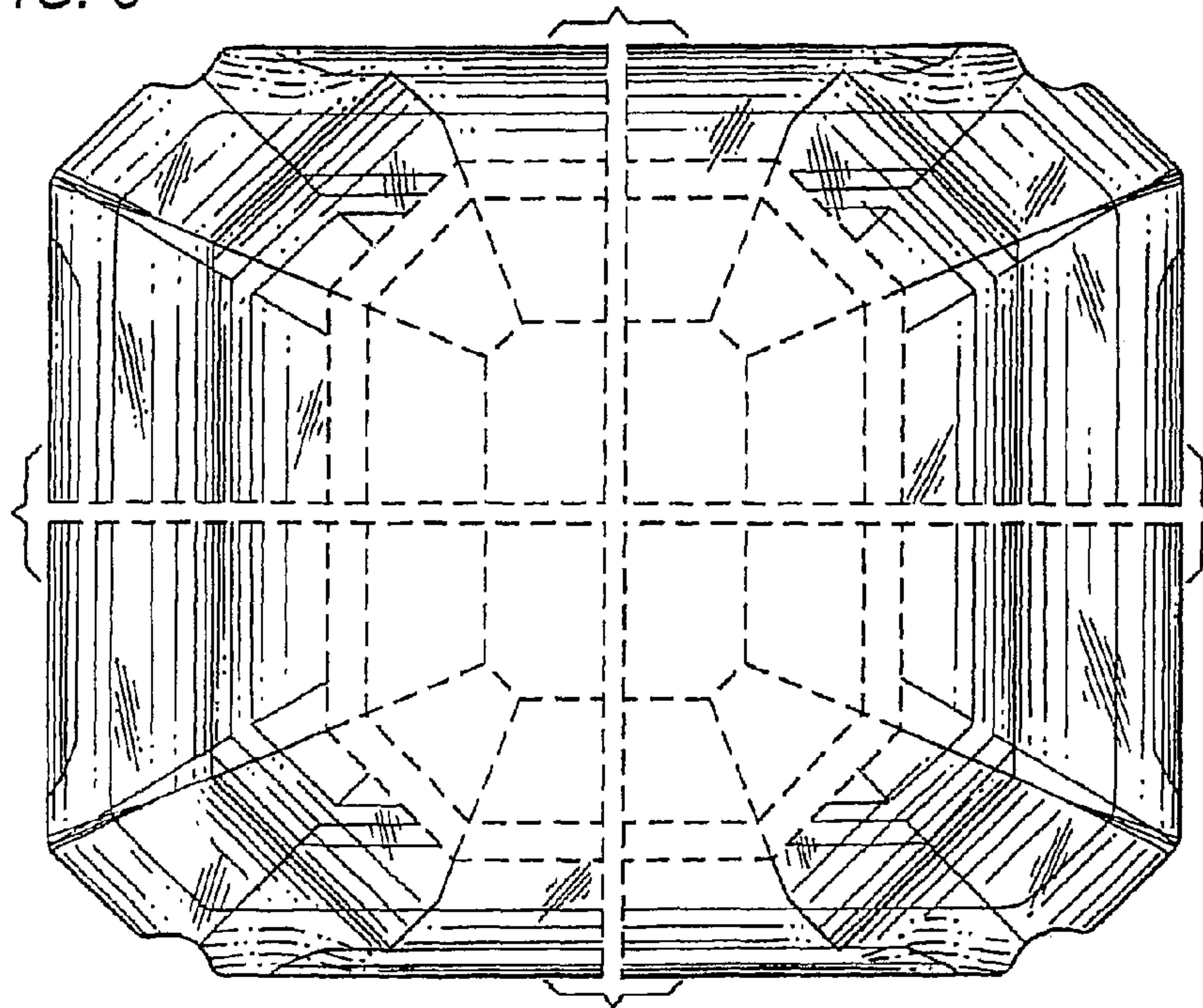

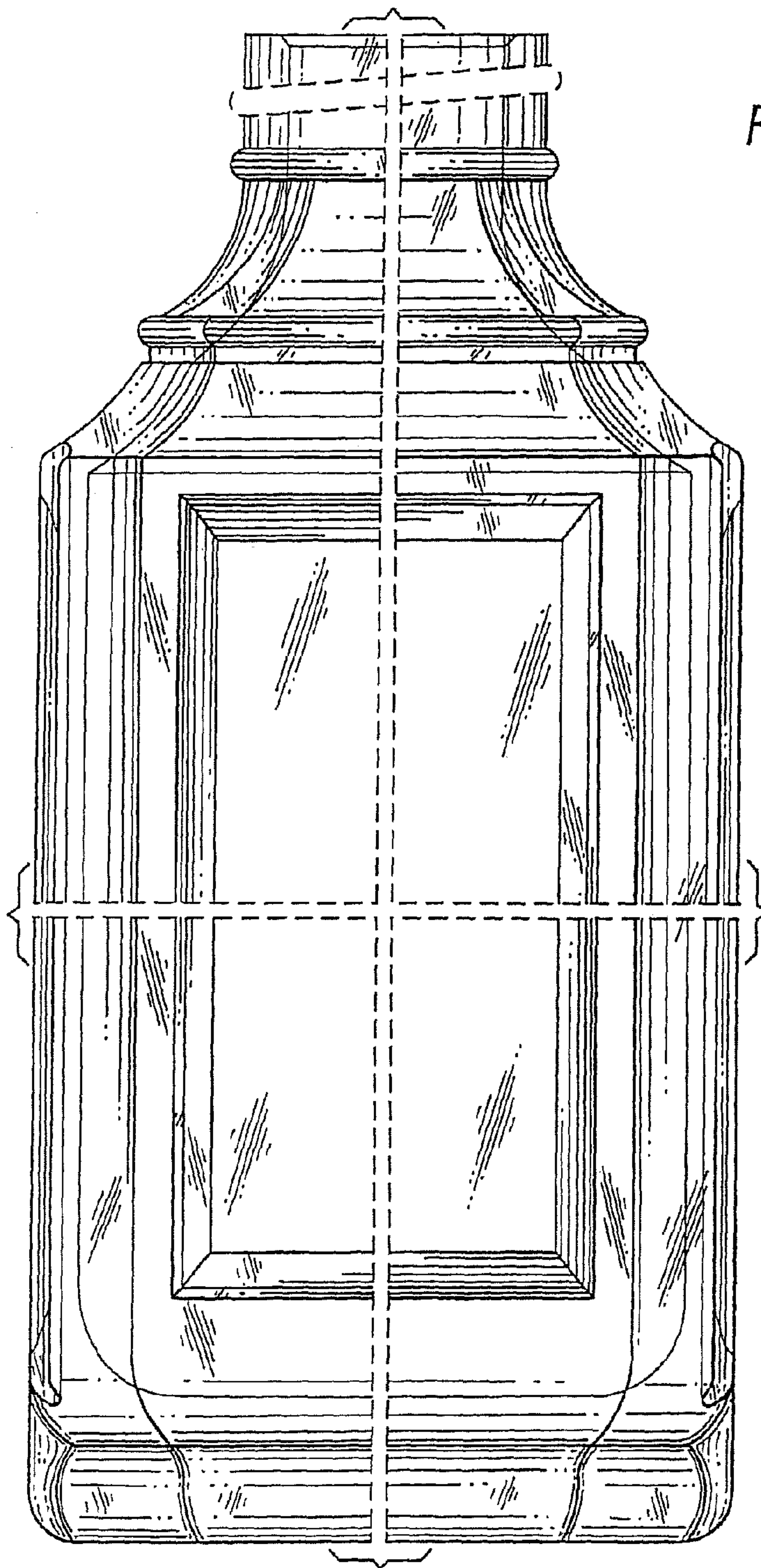

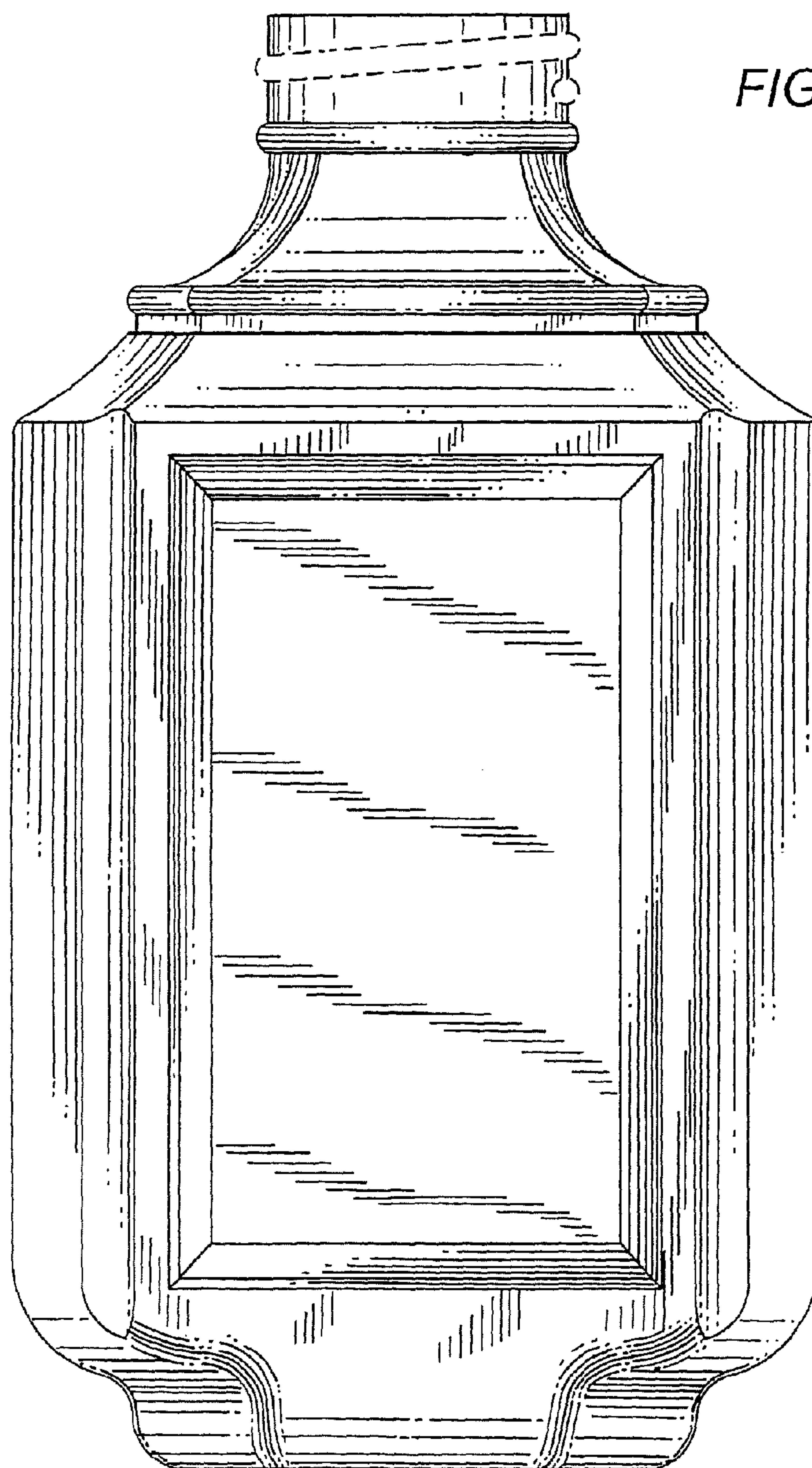

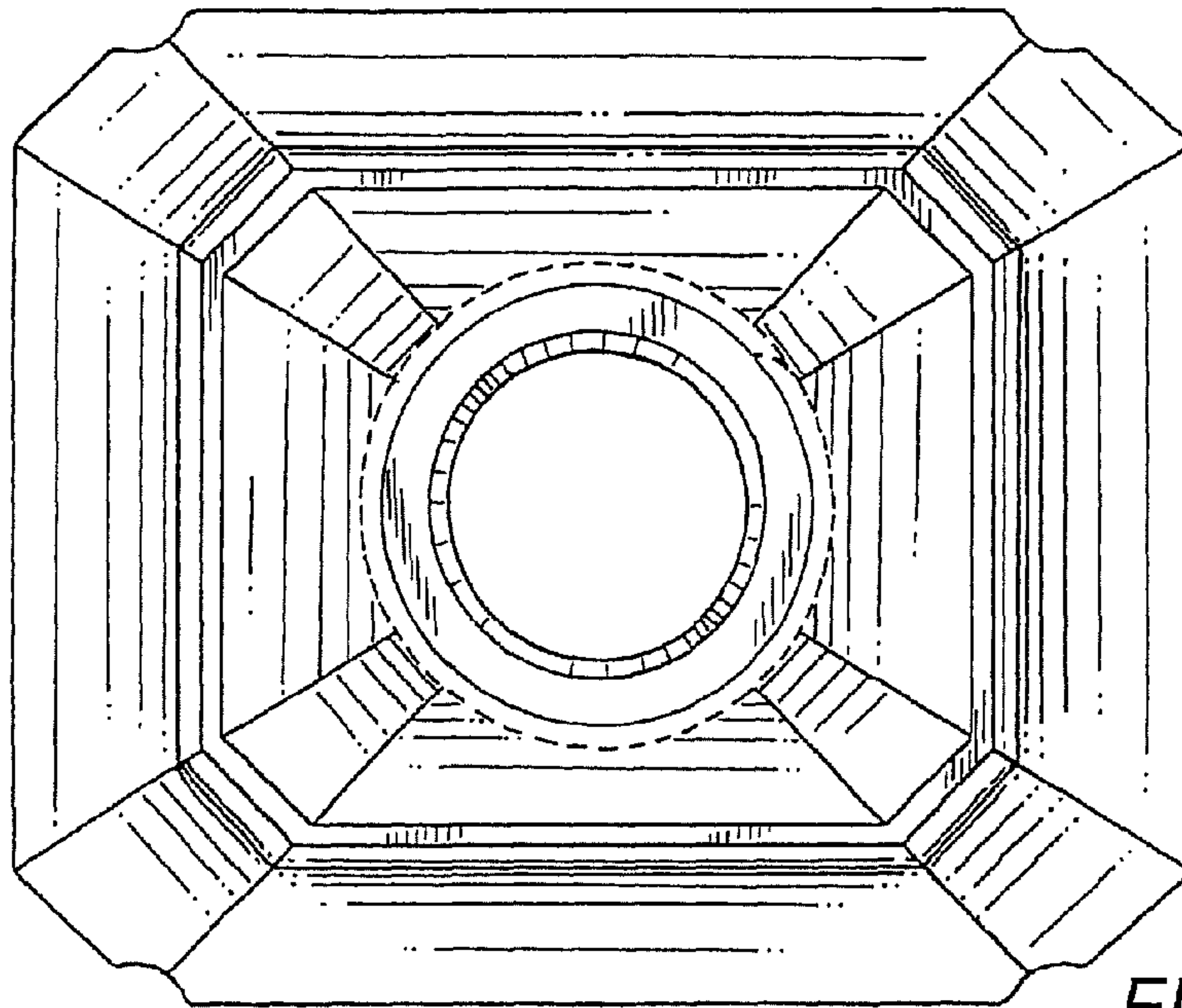

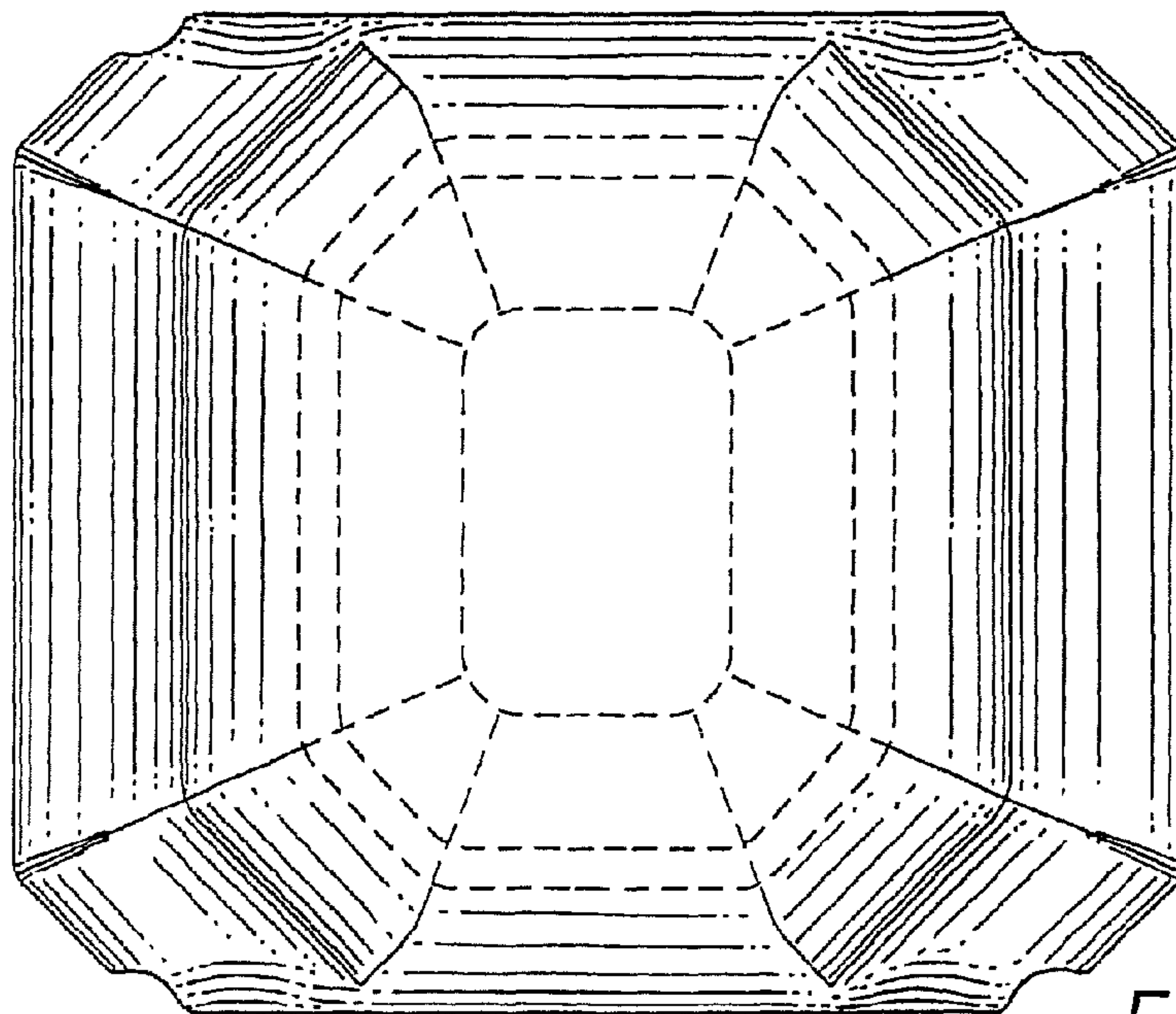

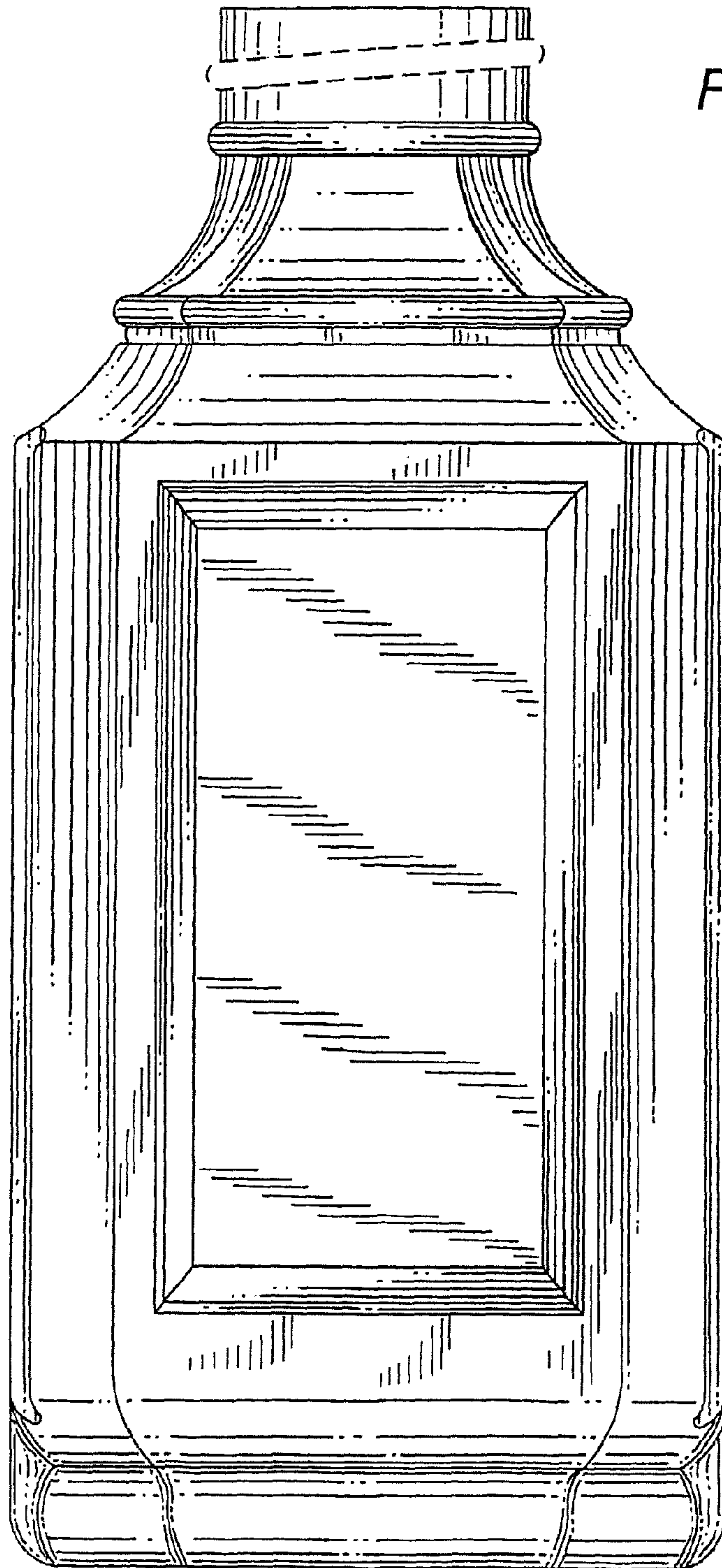
