The ornamental design for a flexible pouch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front of a filled embodiment of the flexible pouch;
FIG. 2 is a plan top view of the filled embodiment of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a plan bottom view of the filled embodiment of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the side of the filled embodiment of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the front of the filled embodiment of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1.

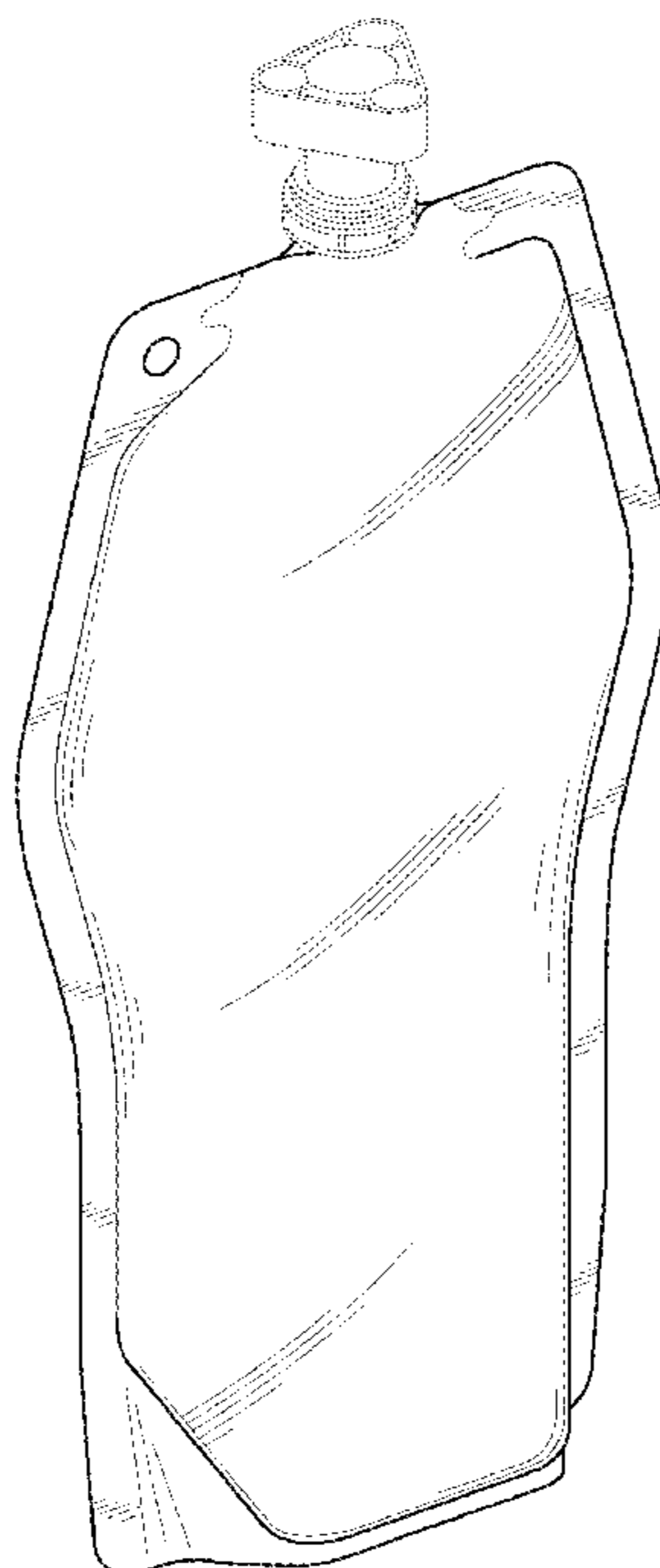

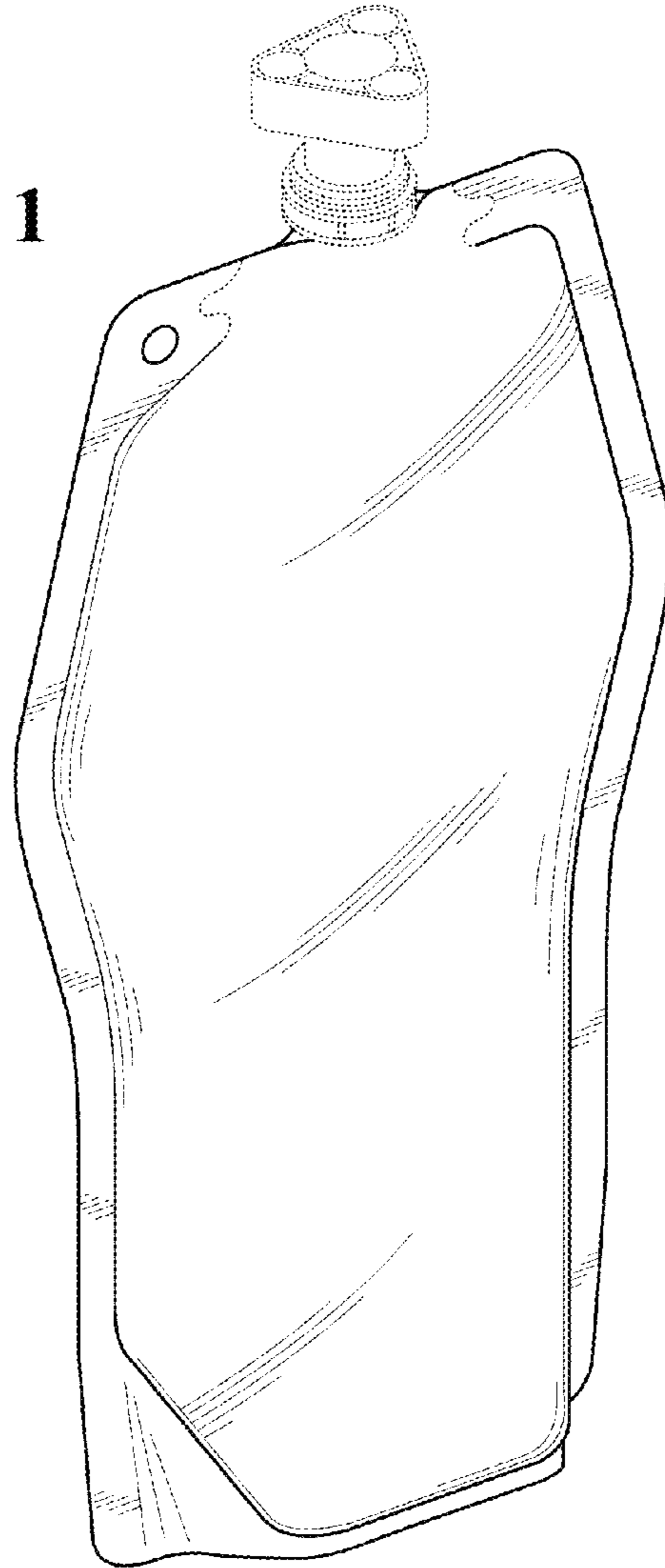

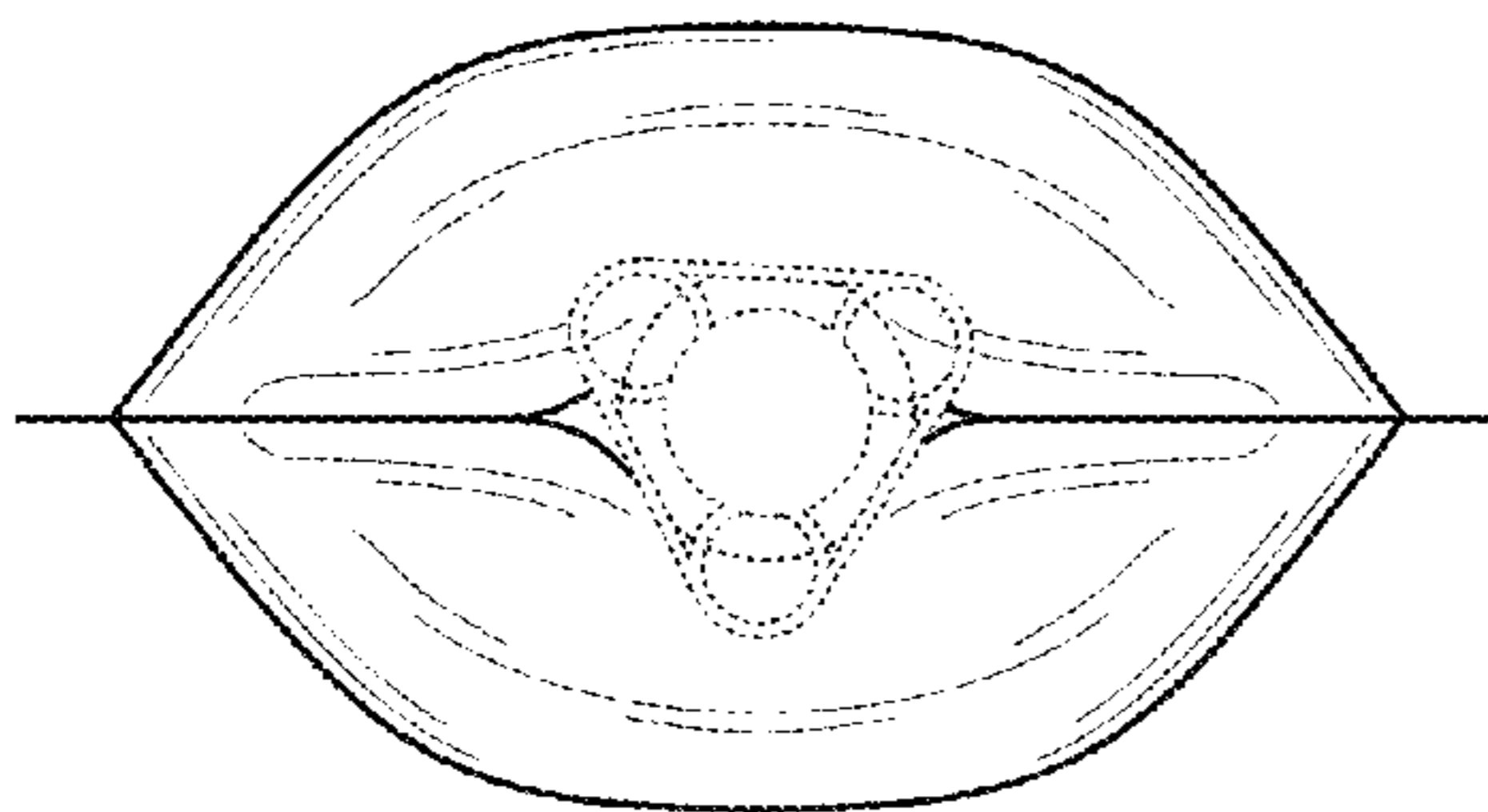
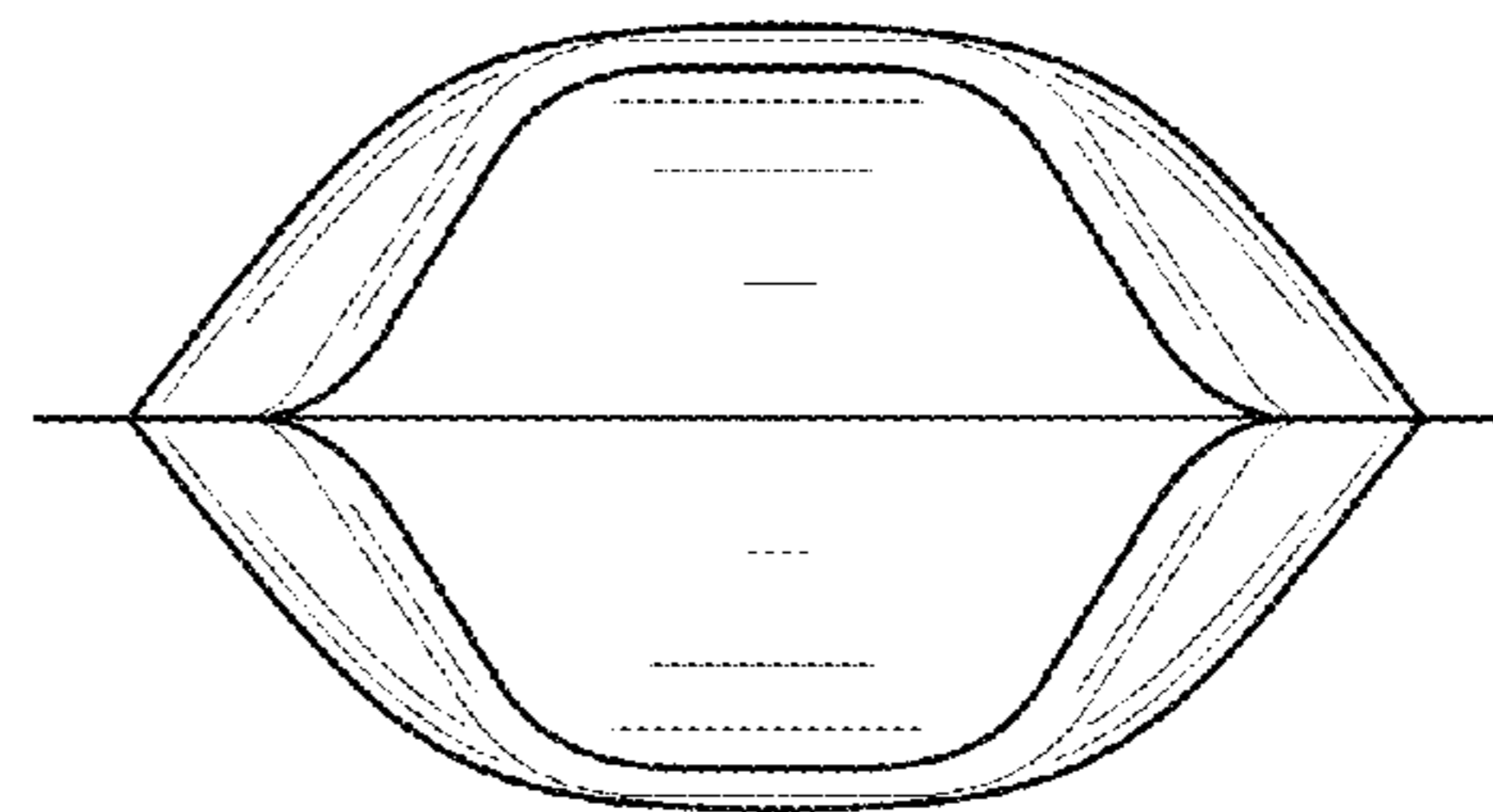

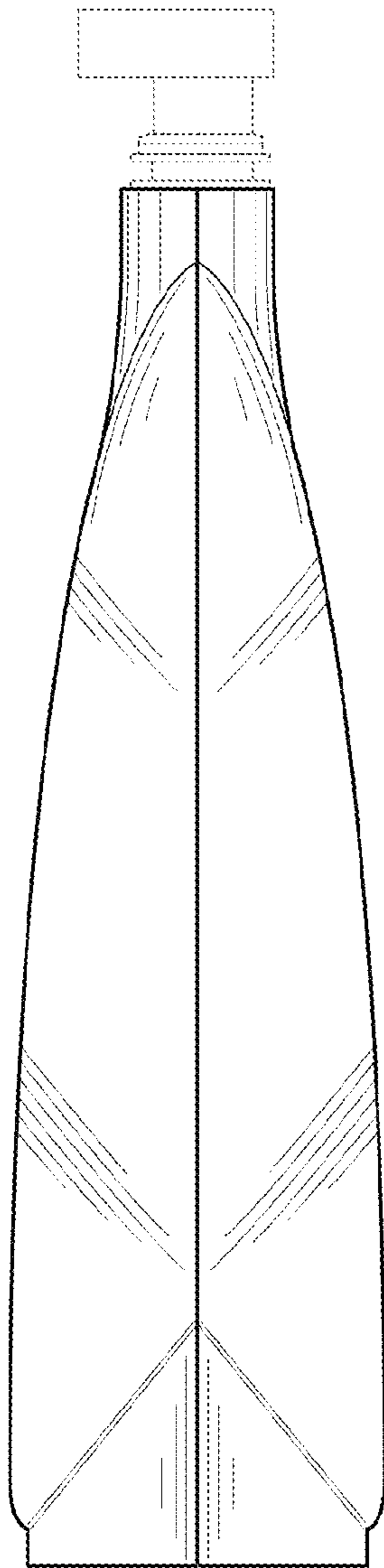

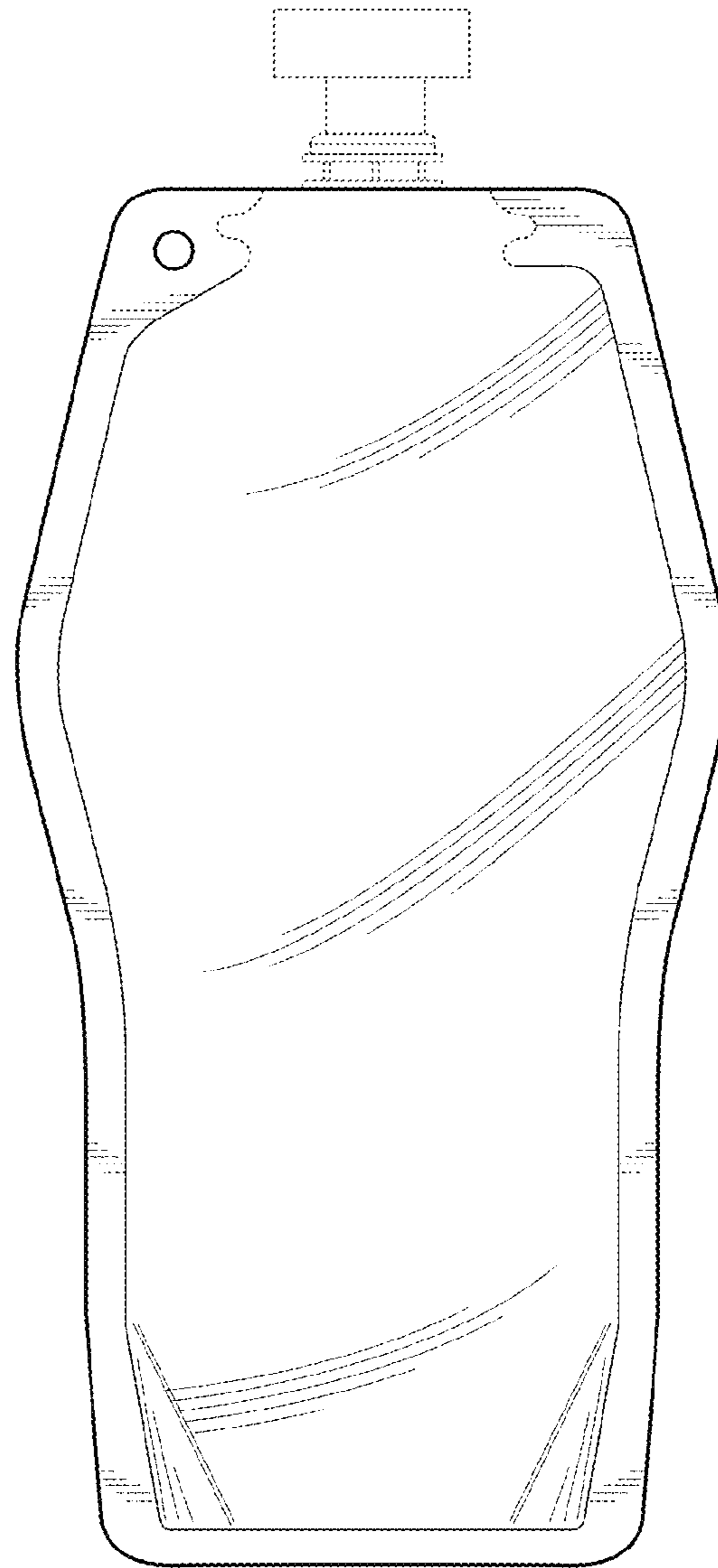
