DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a speaker for television receiver showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof where the right side view is a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof where the bottom plan view is a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a partially enlarged view thereof, taken from the lower middle part of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 6 is a partially enlarged view thereof, taken from the lower left part of FIG. 2.

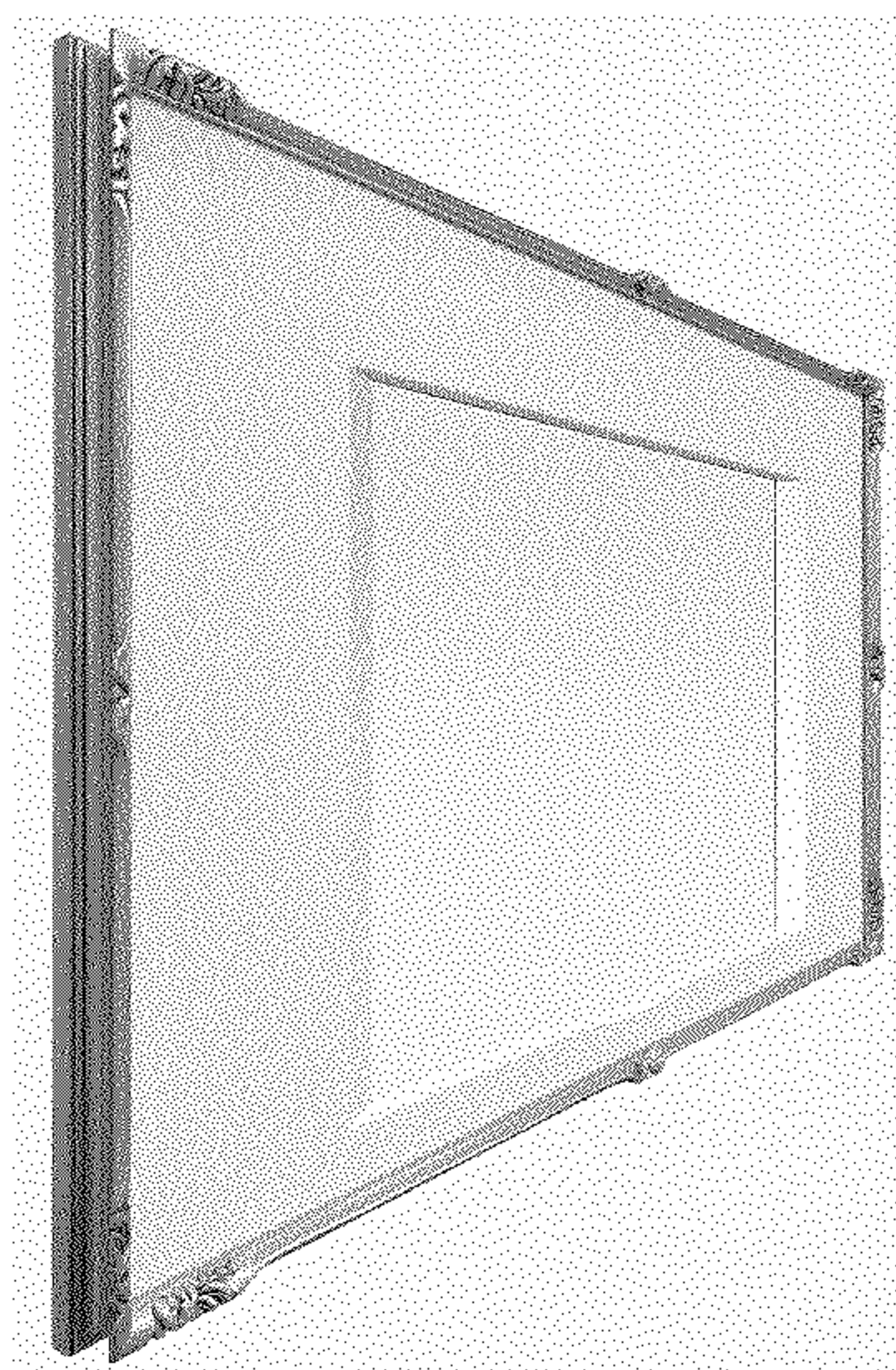

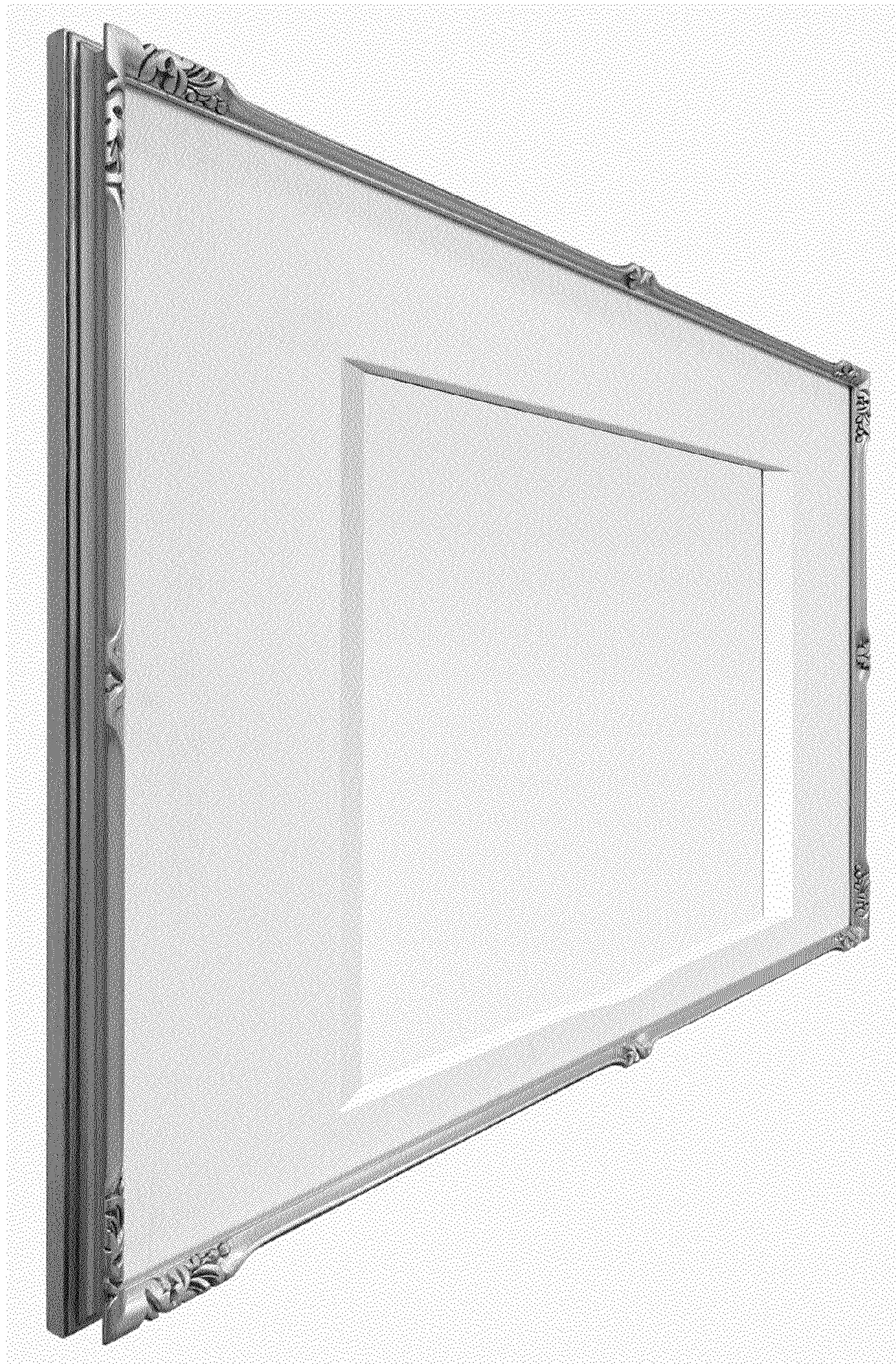
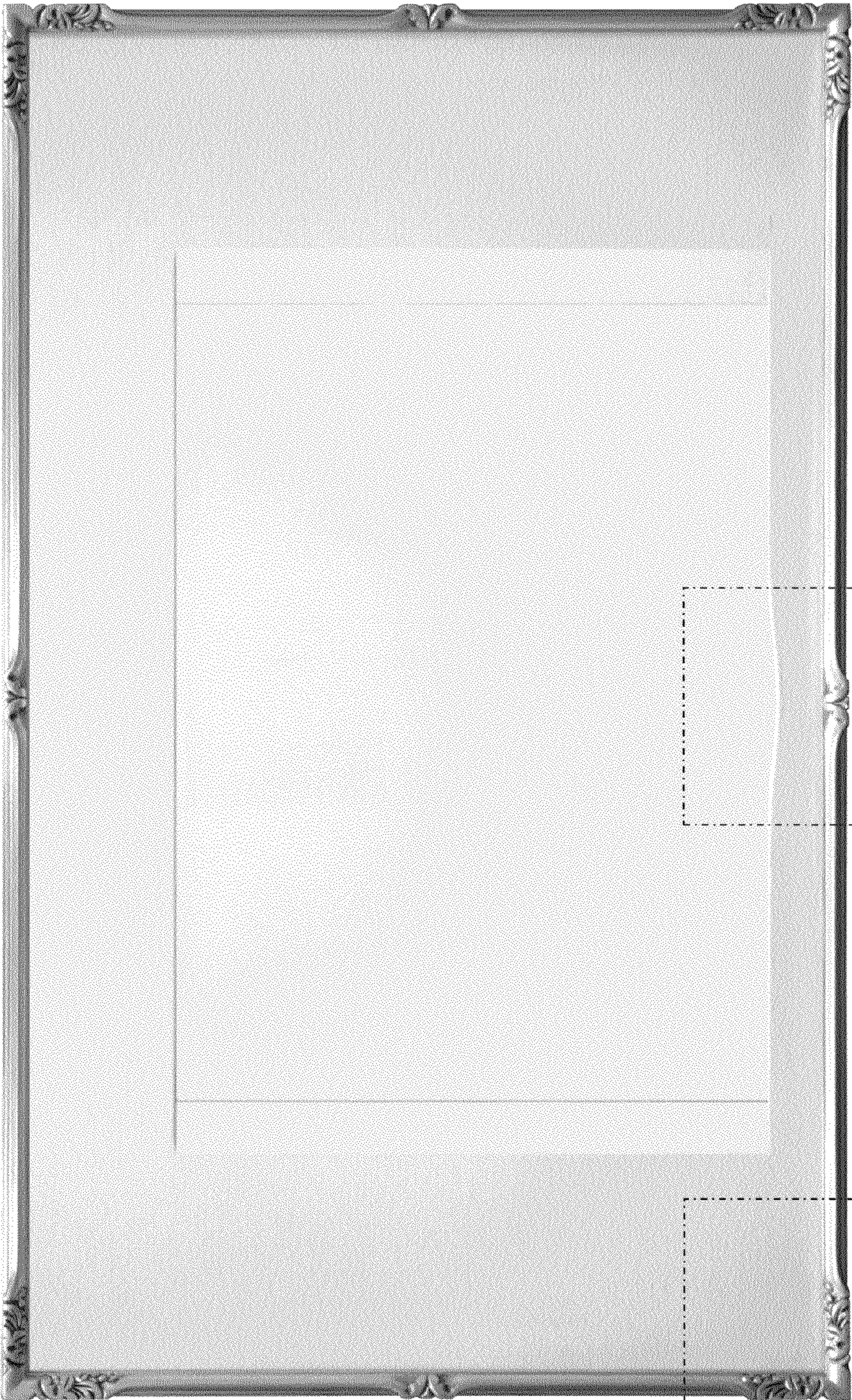

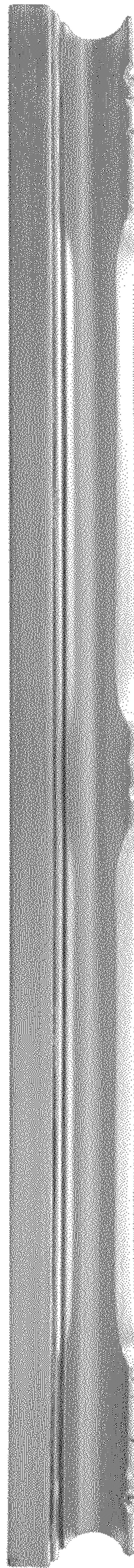

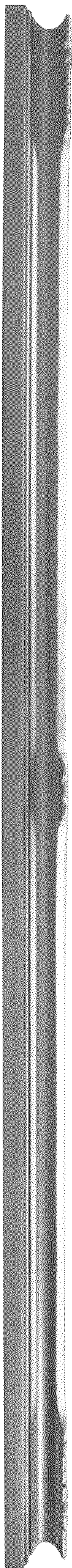

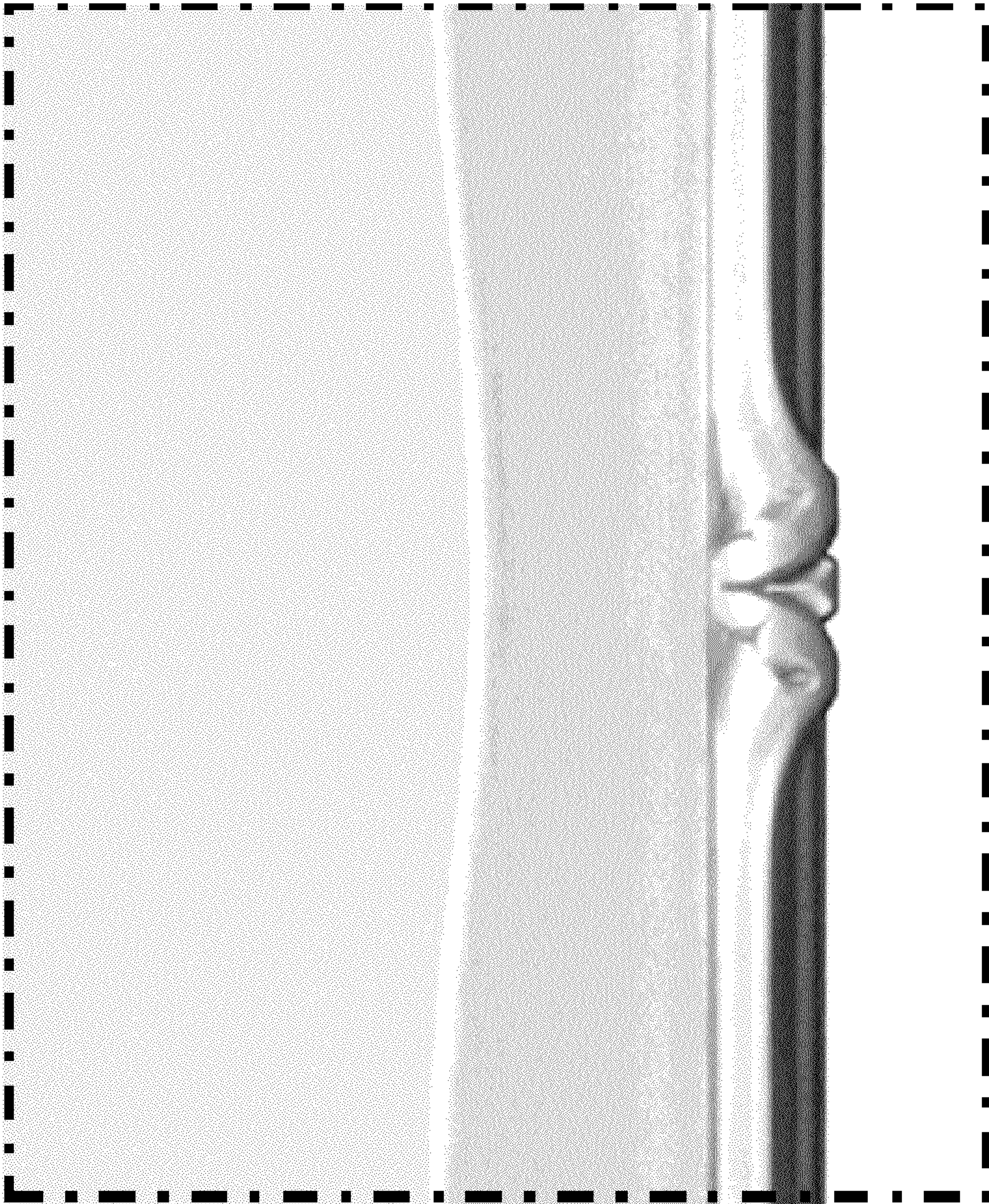
