DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of an ornamental design for a
fitness training device, showing sectional lines 2-2, 3-3, and
4-4;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view thereof taken along the sectional
line 2-2 shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view thereof taken along the sectional
line 3-3 shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken along the sectional
line 4-4 shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom elevation view thereof;

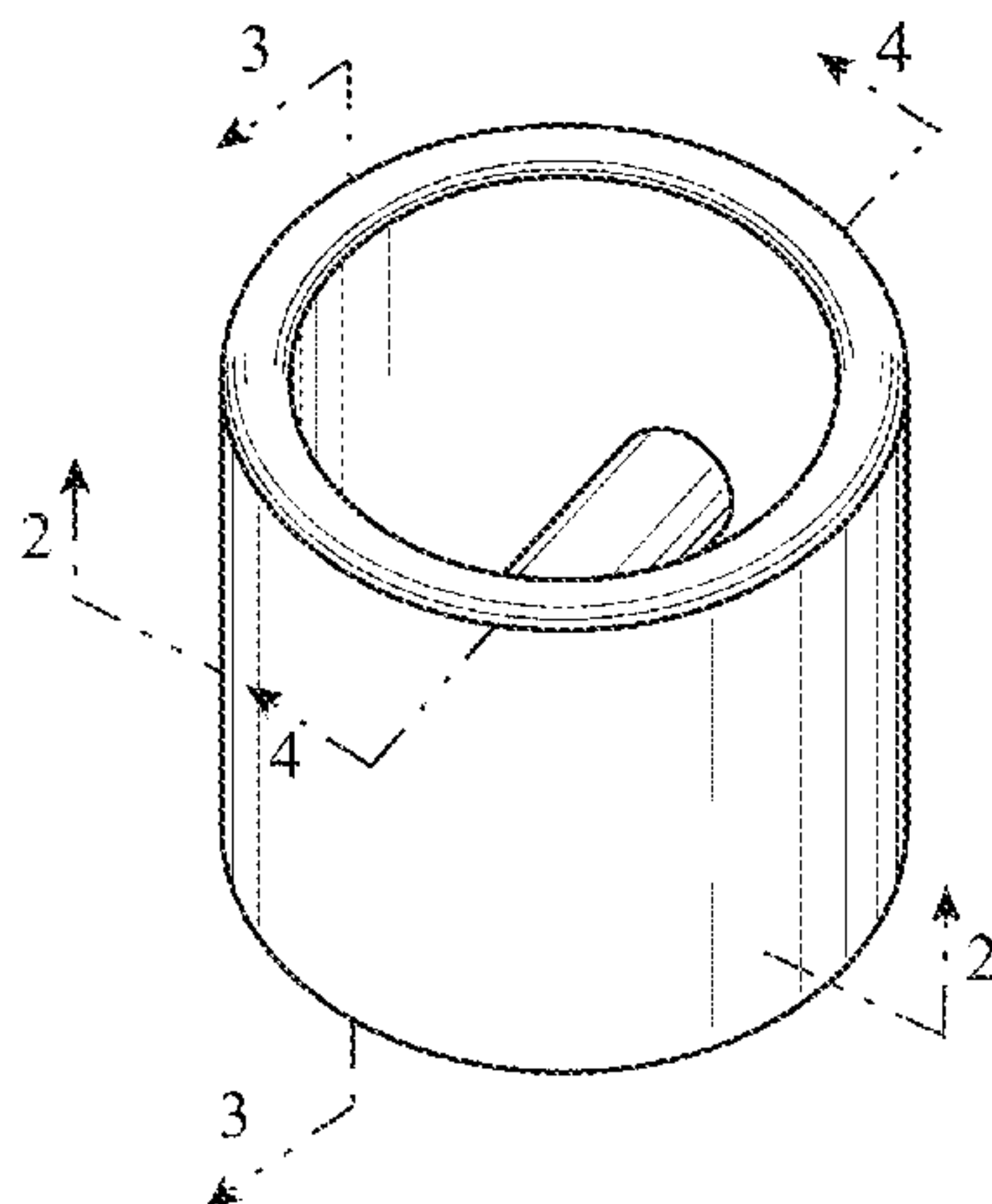
FIG. 9 is a right side elevation view thereof;

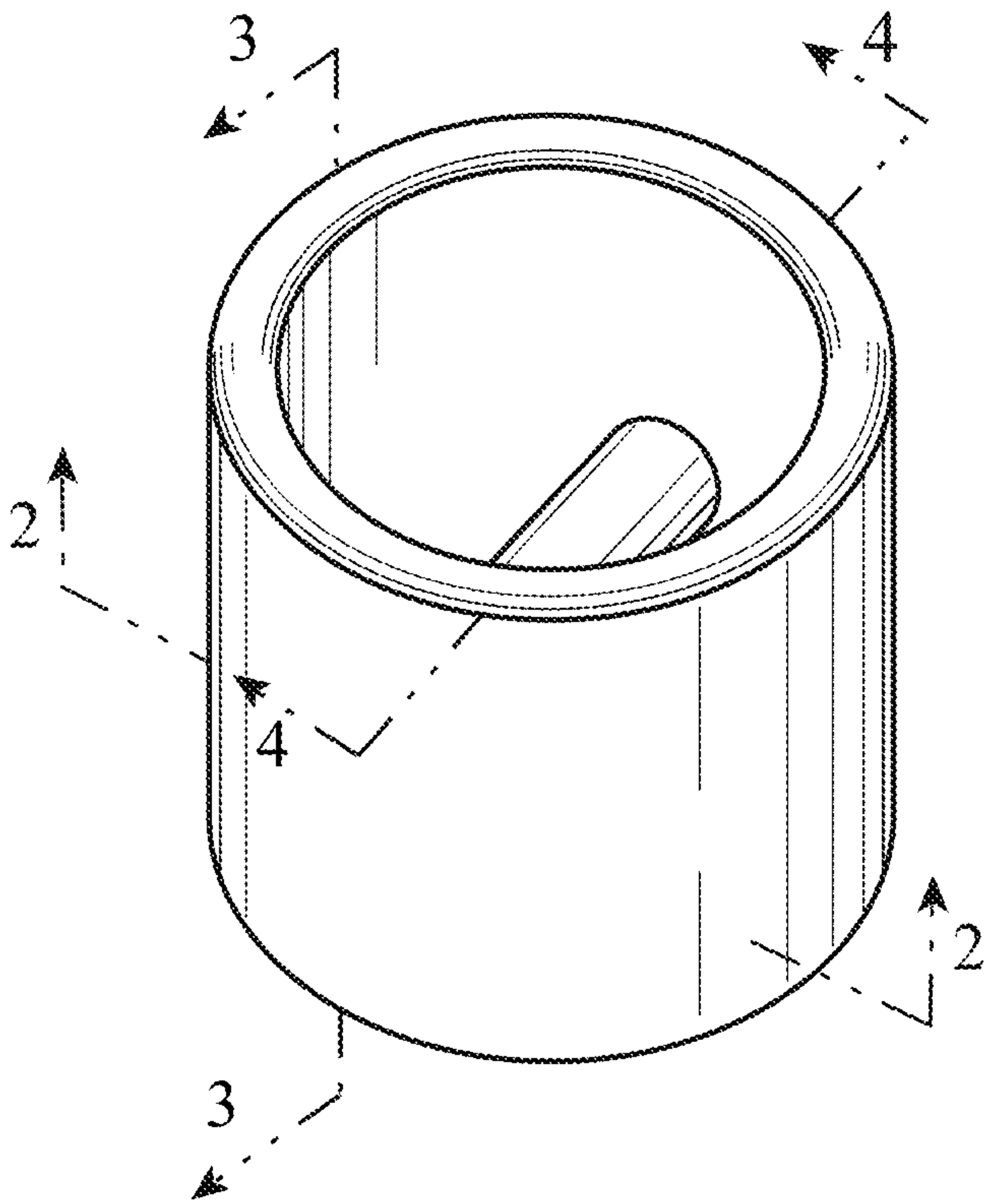

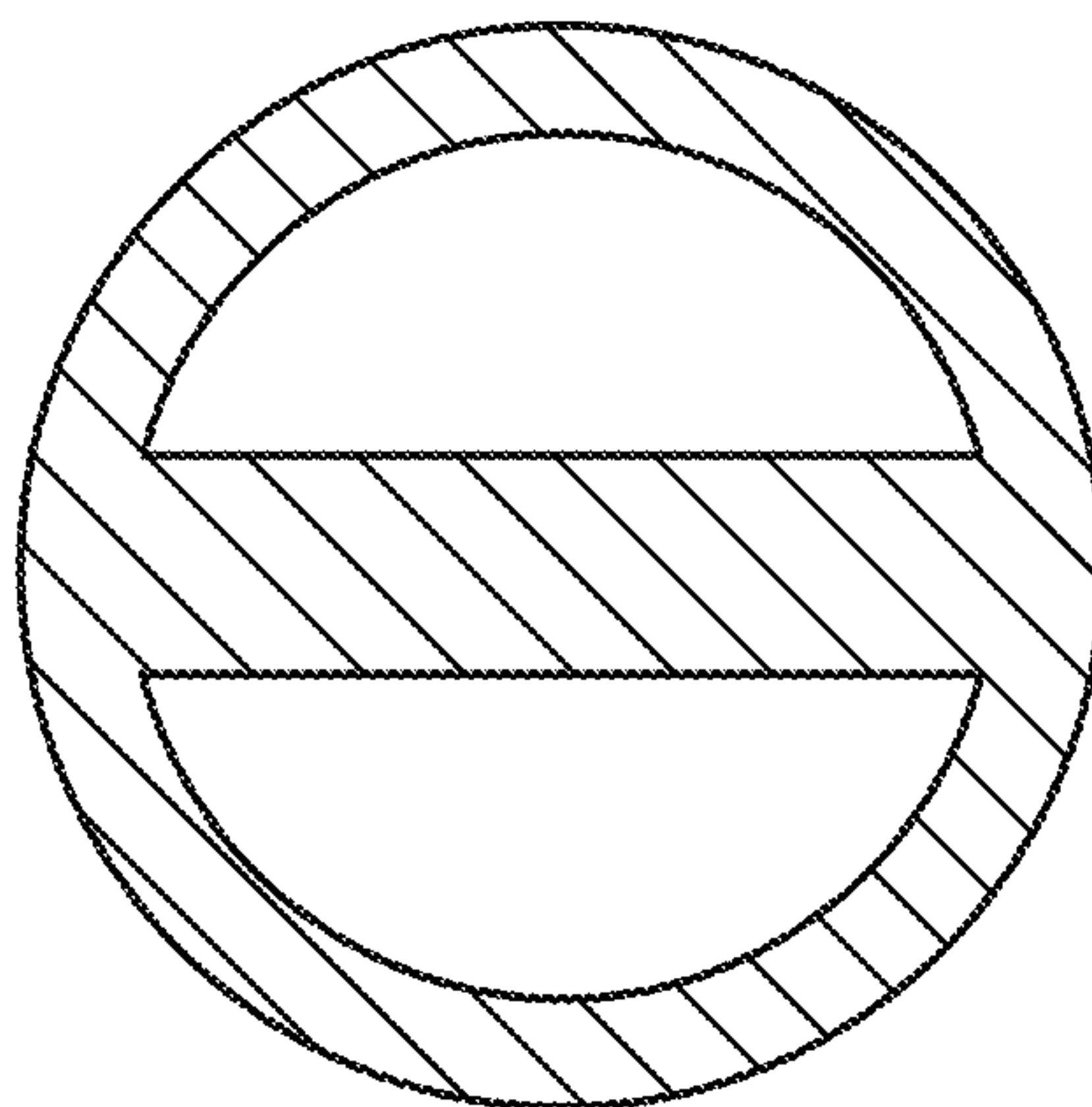

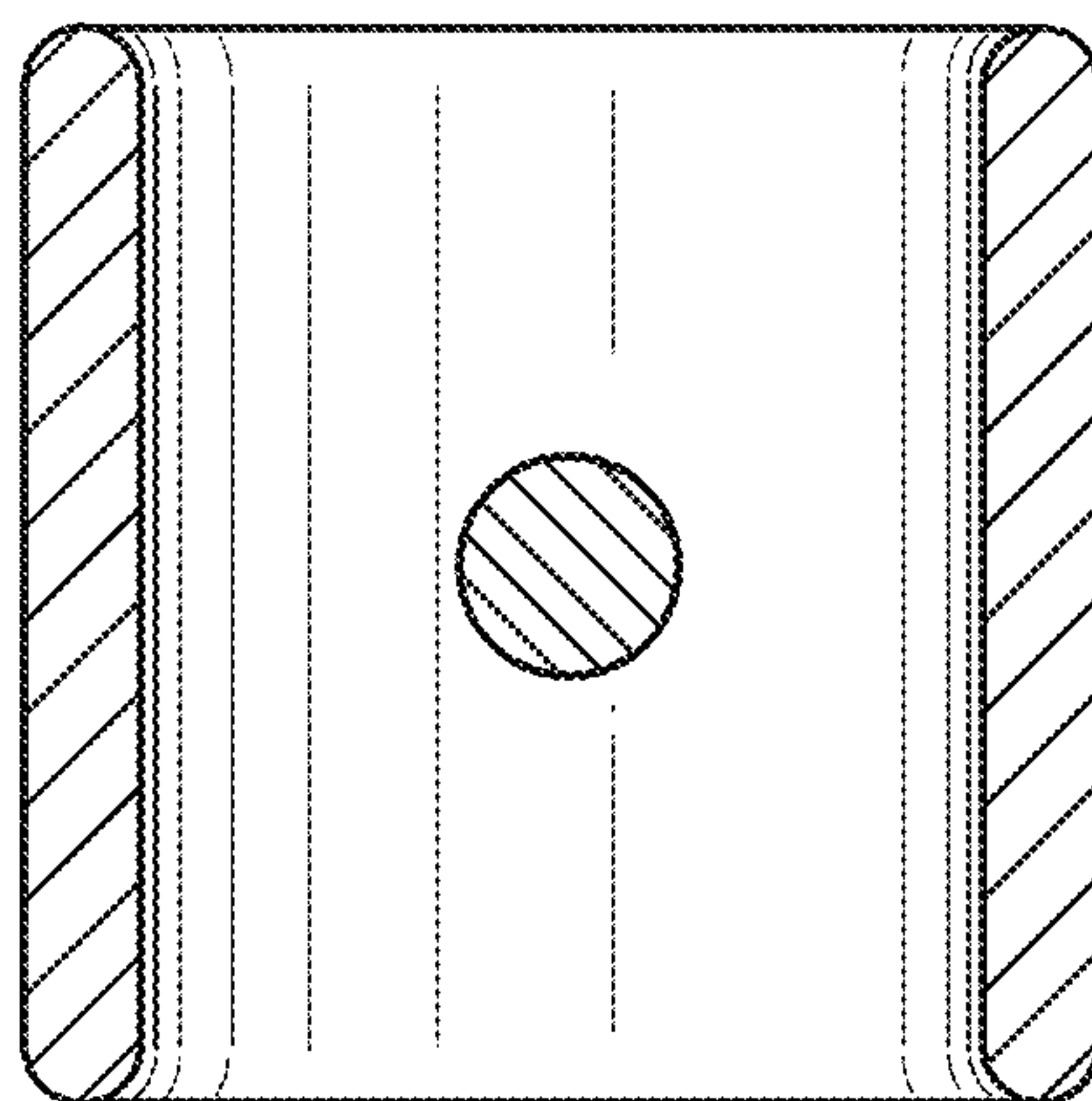

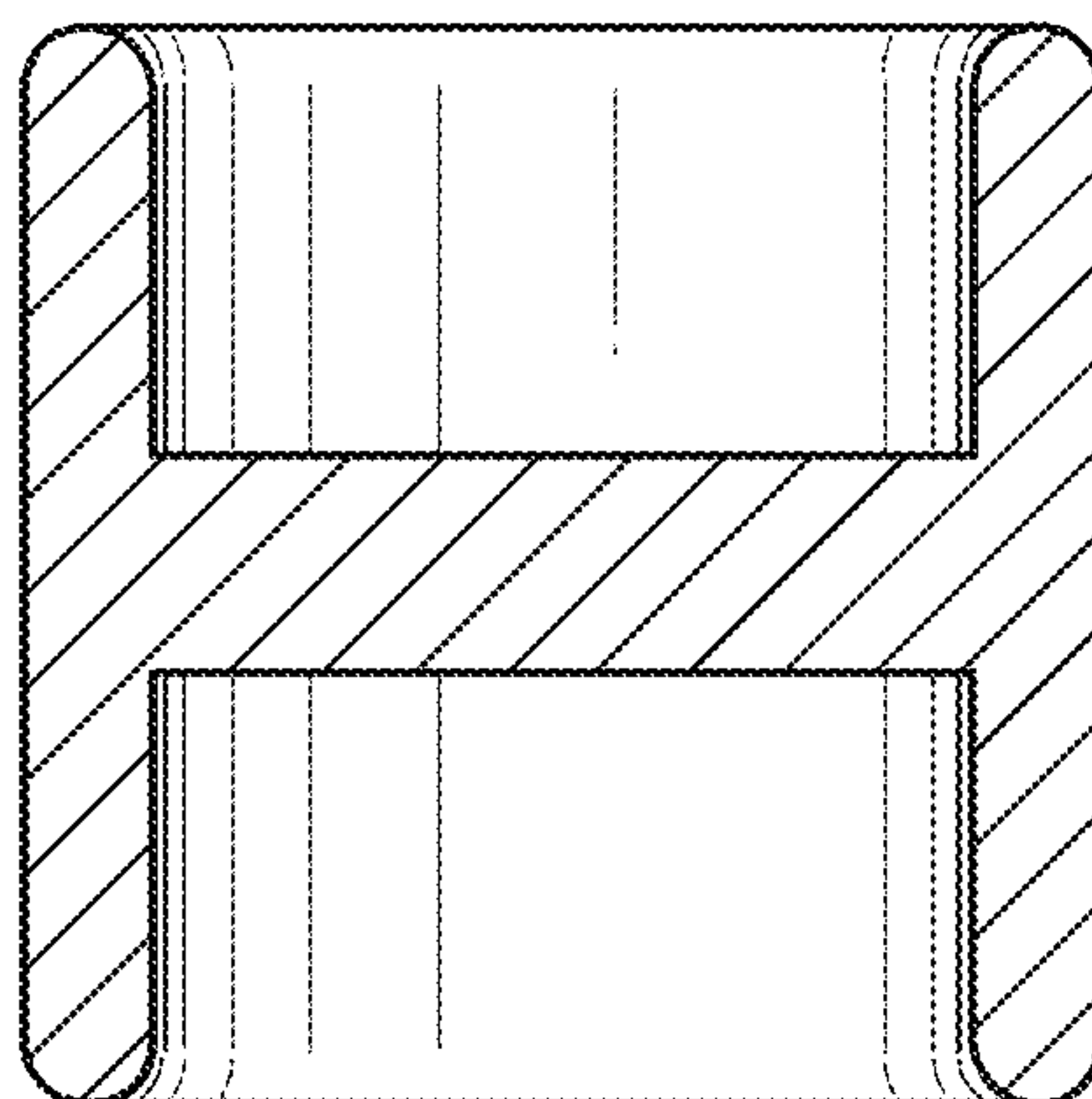

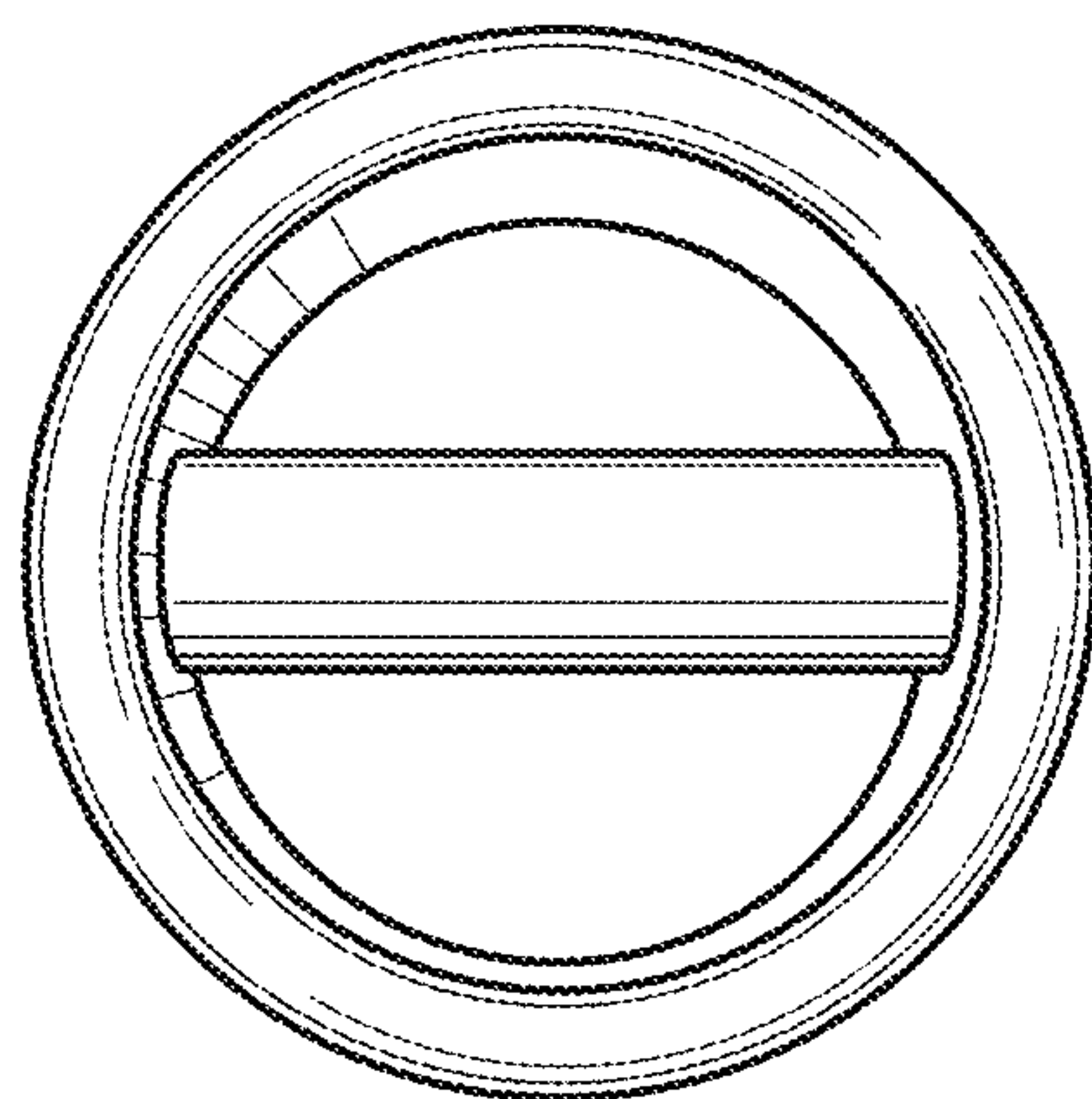

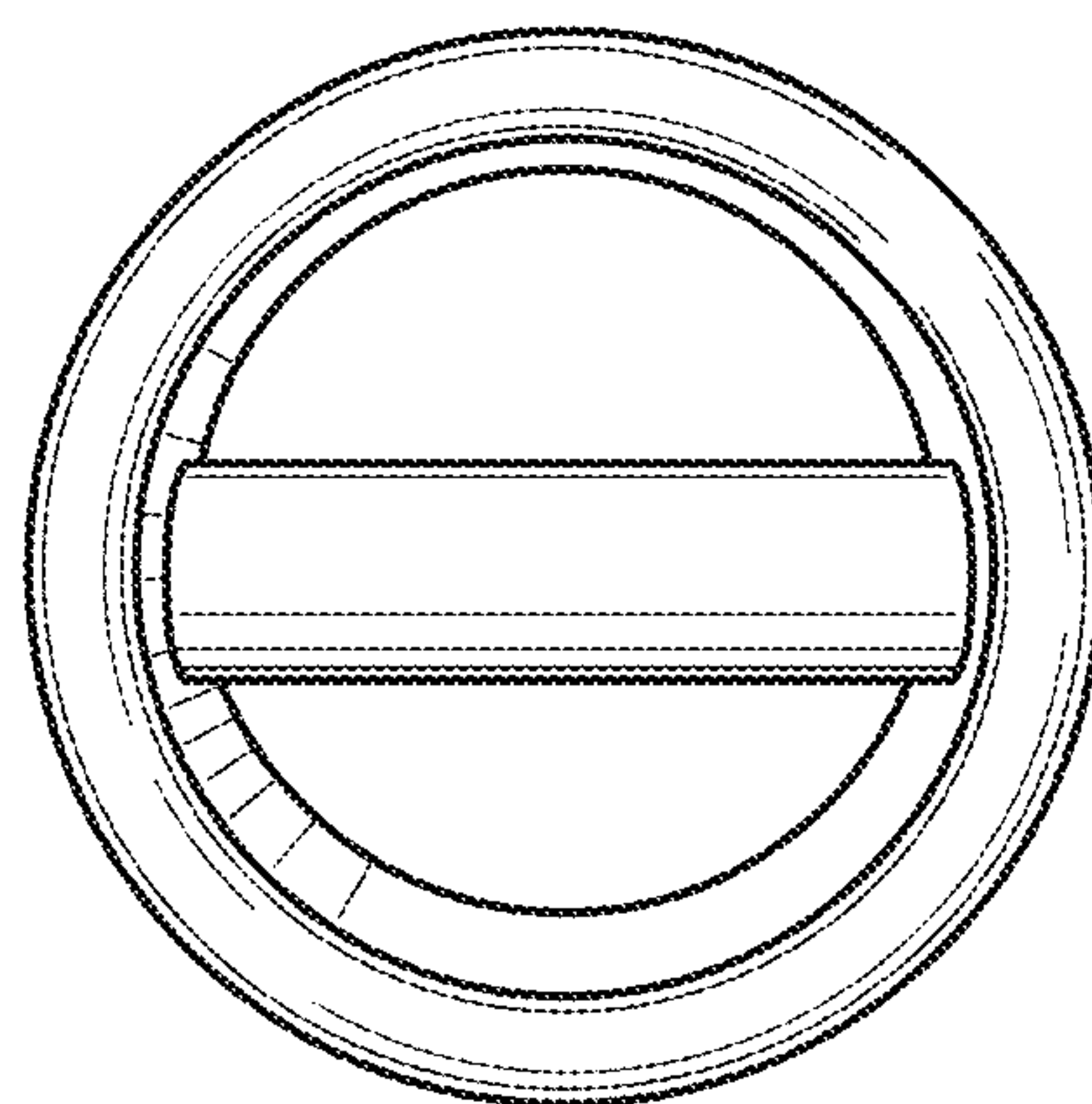

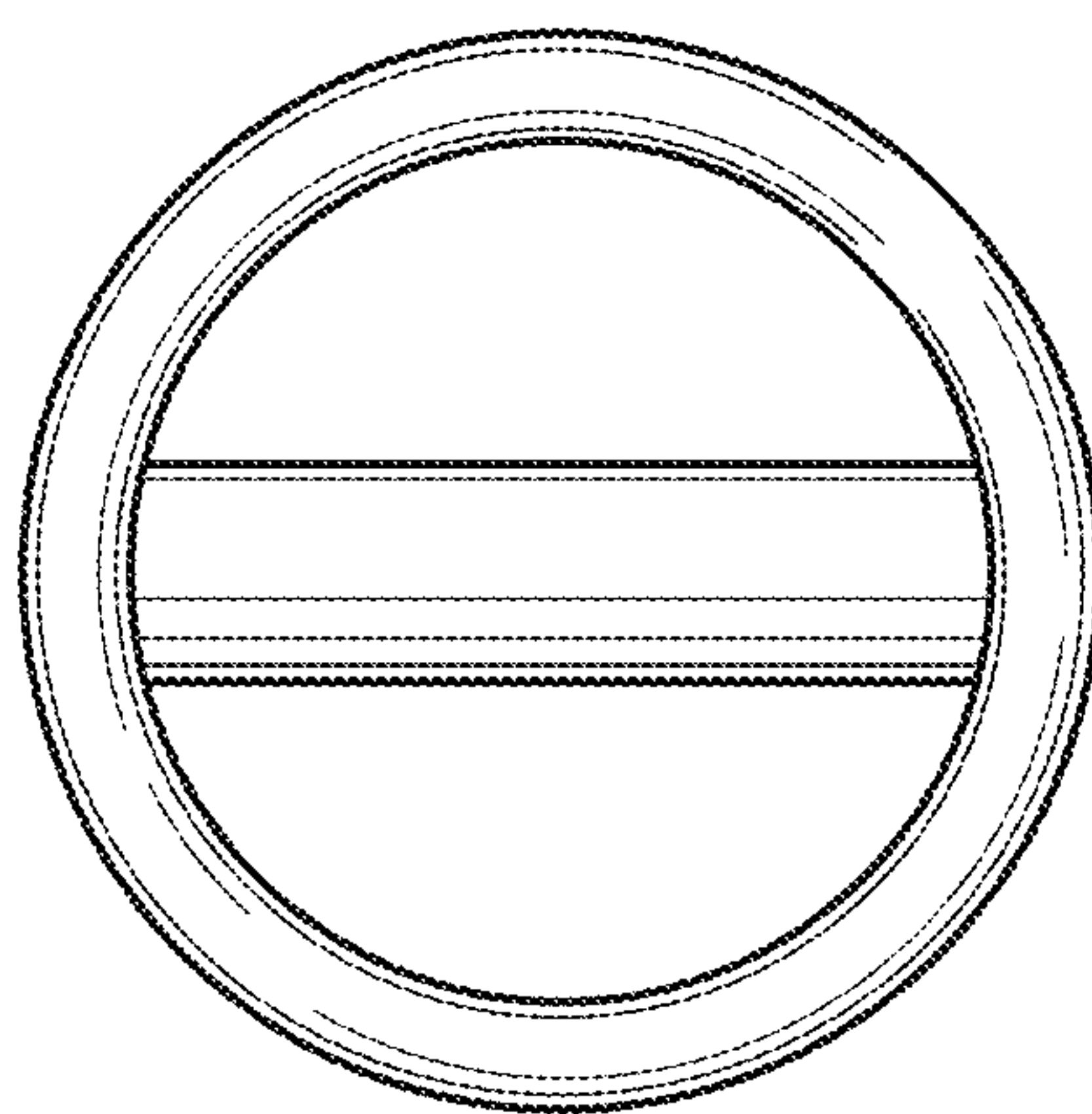

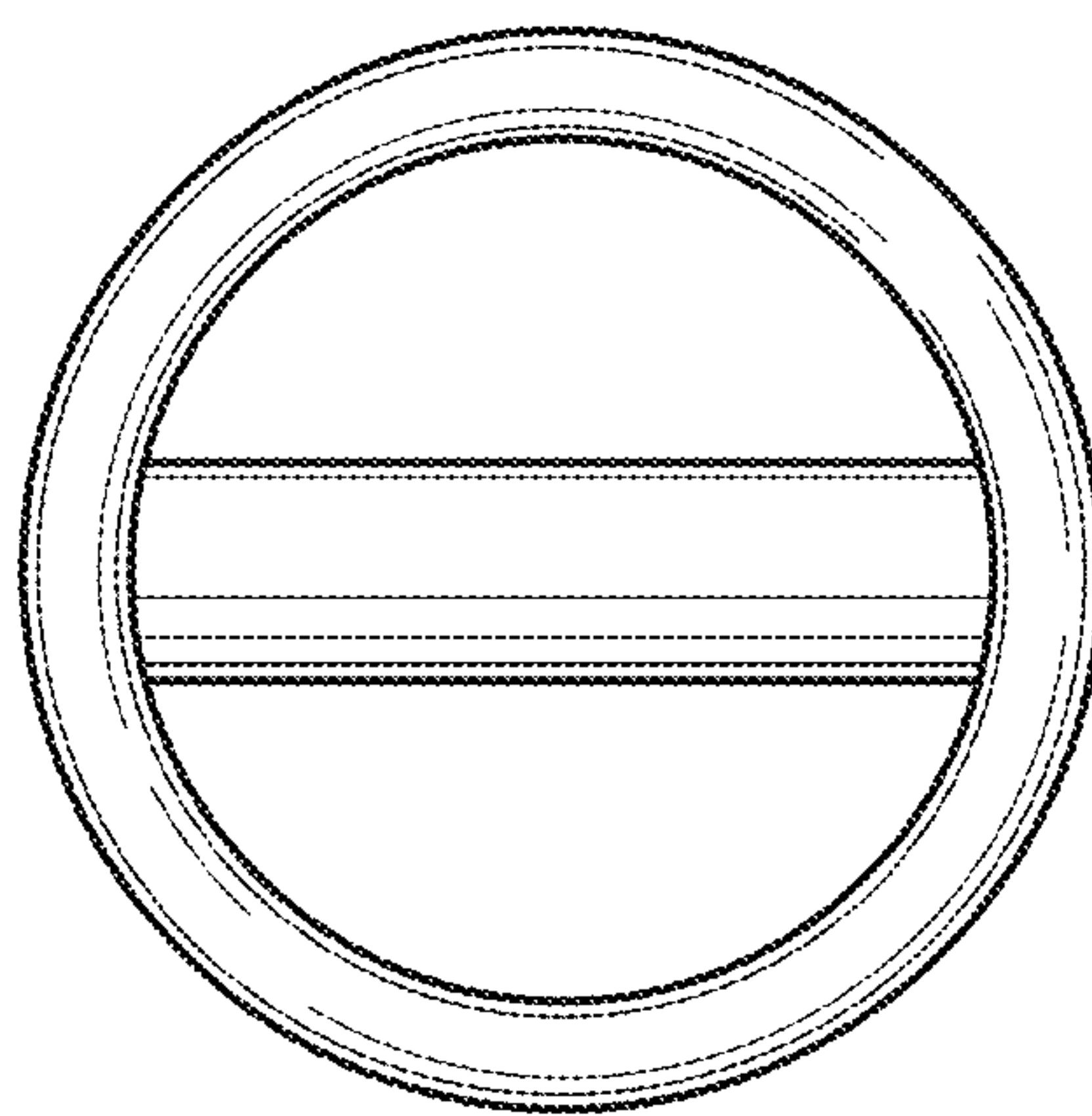

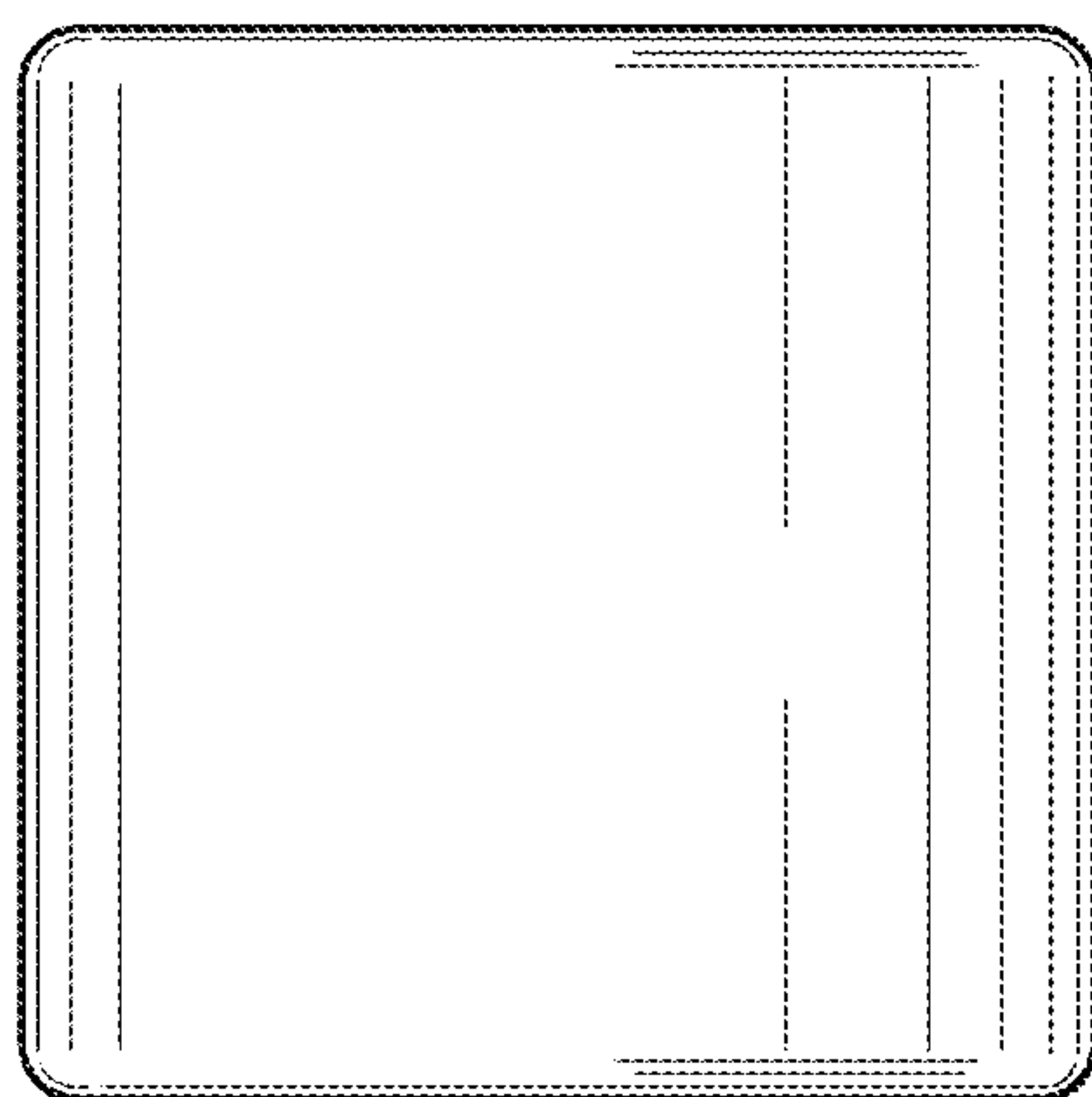

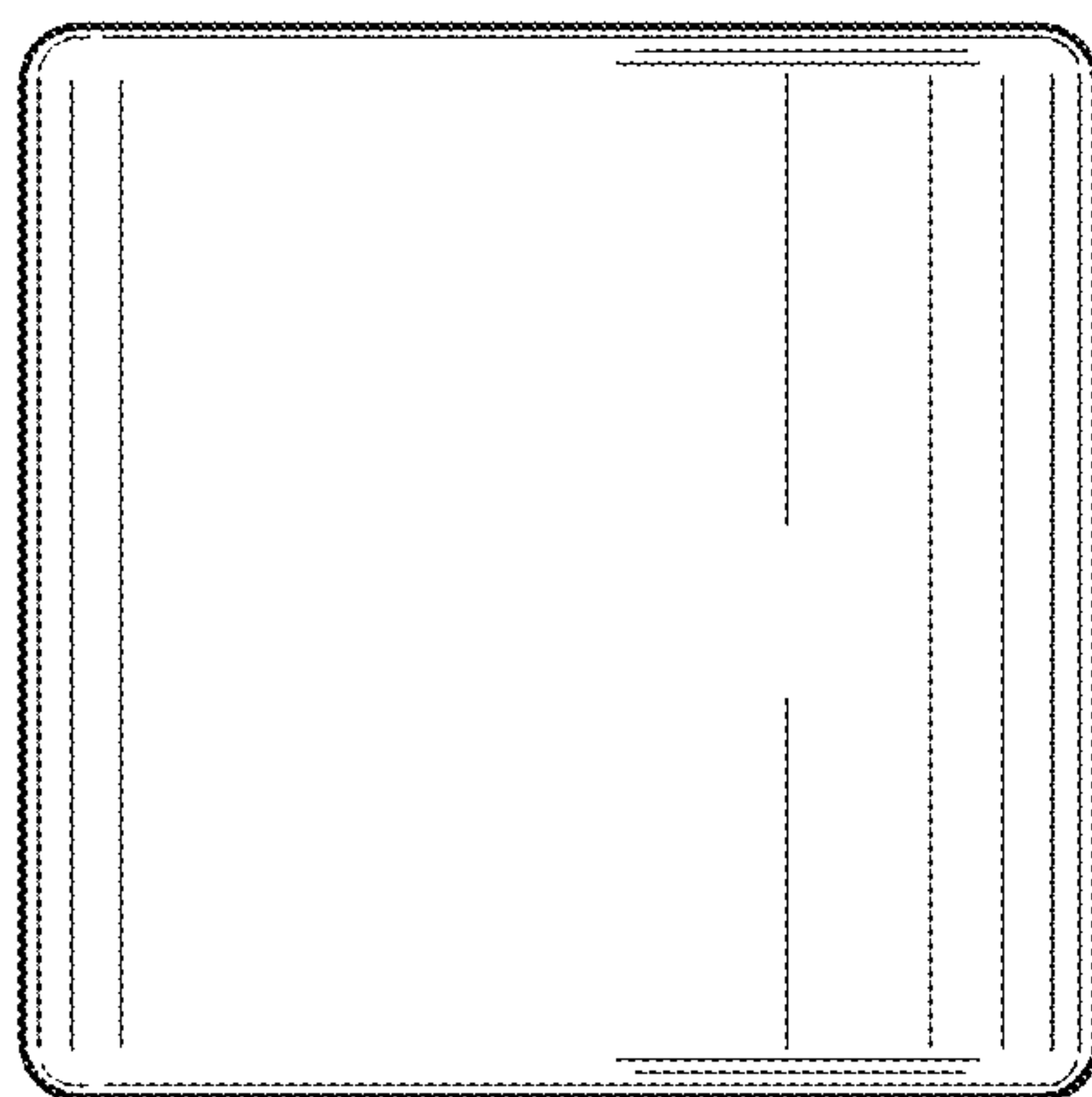

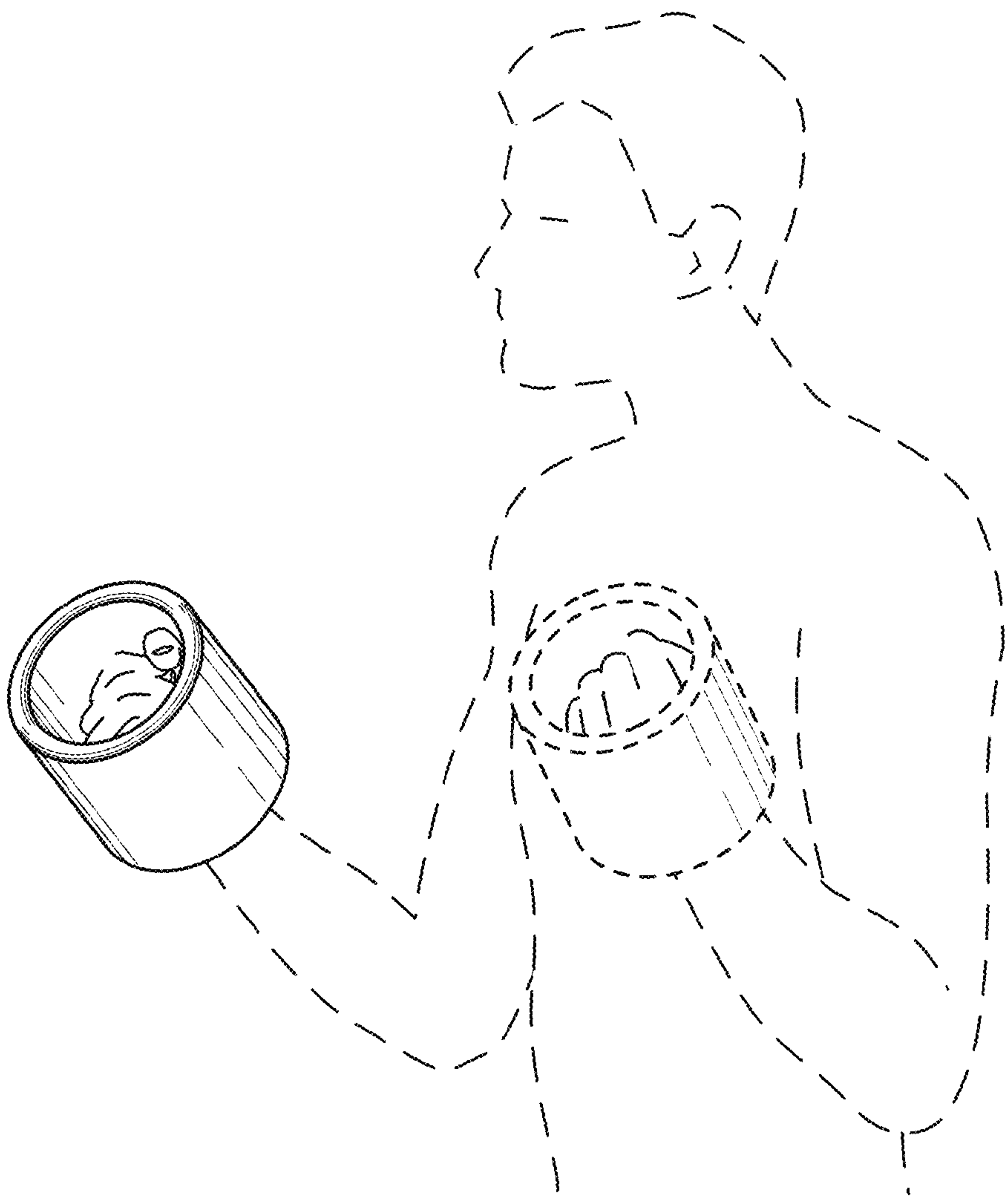
