(57) **CLAIM**

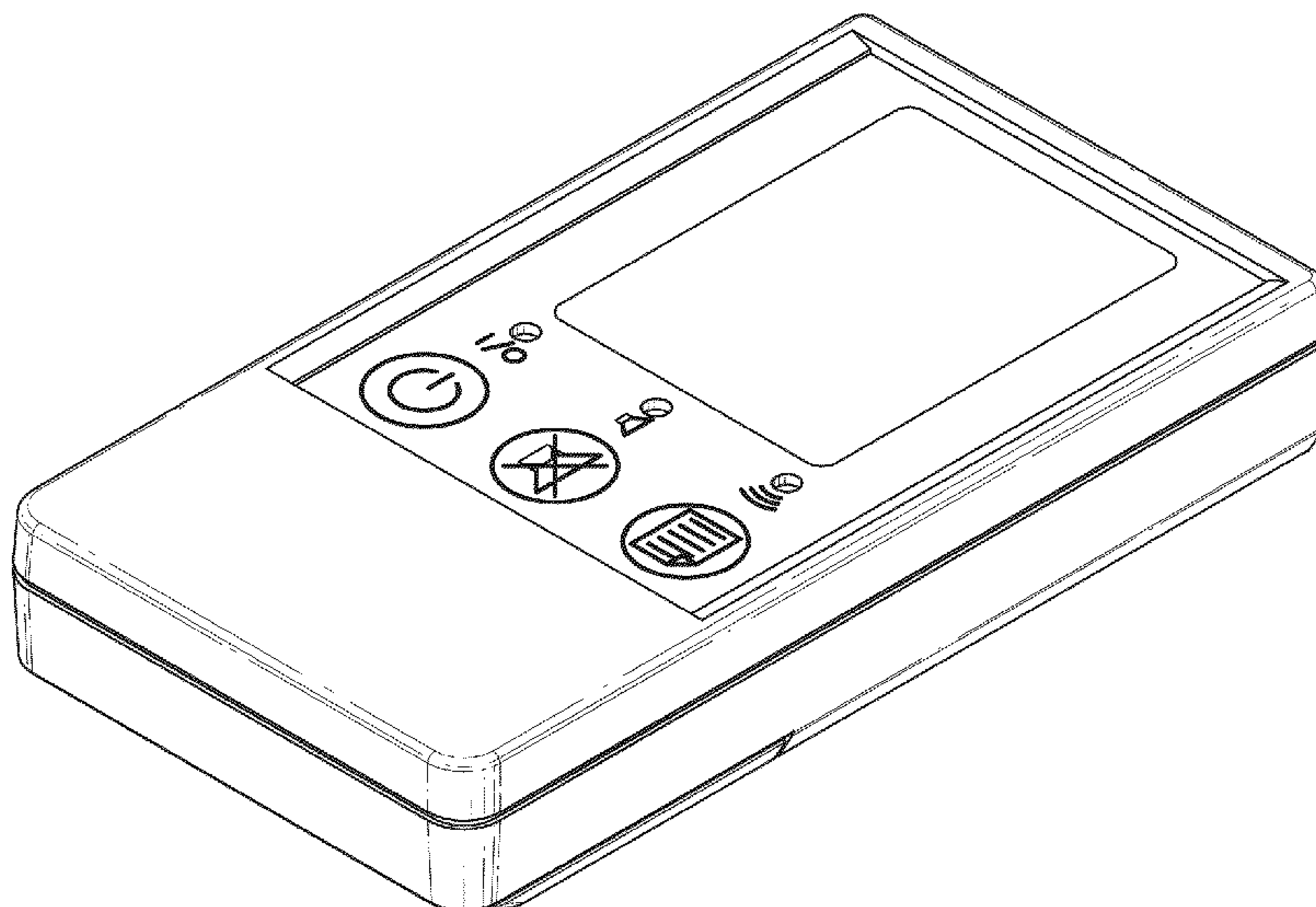
We claim the ornamental design for a wireless patient monitor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 shows a perspective view of a wireless patient monitor; FIG. 2 shows a front view thereof; FIG. 3 shows a right side view thereof; FIG. 4 shows a left side view thereof; FIG. 5 shows a top view thereof; FIG. 6 shows a bottom view thereof; and, FIG. 7 shows a back view thereof.

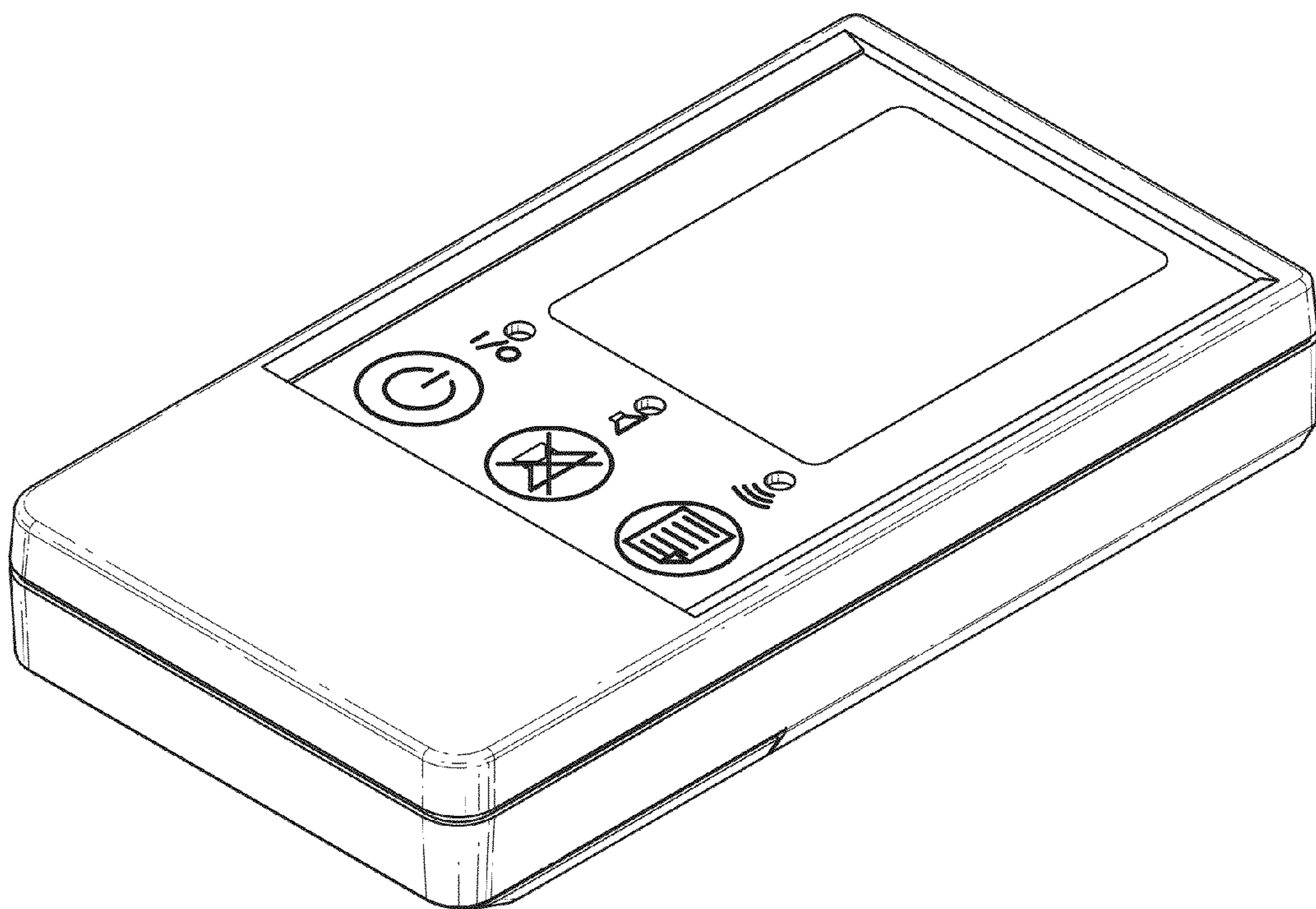

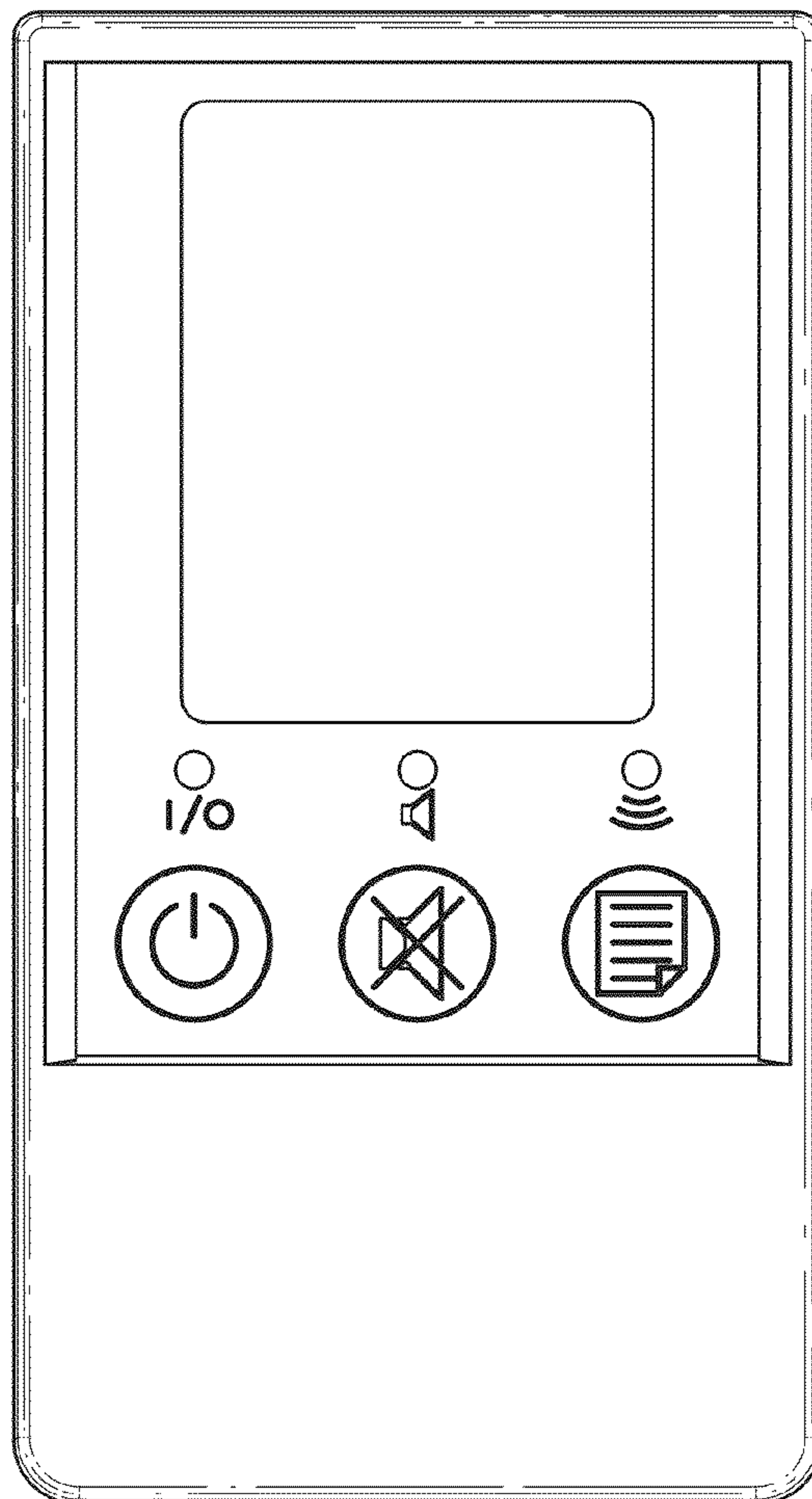

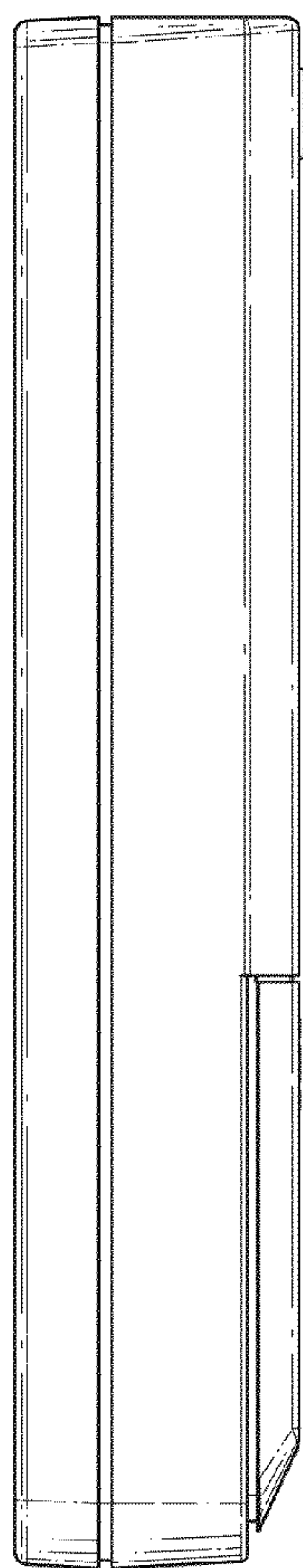

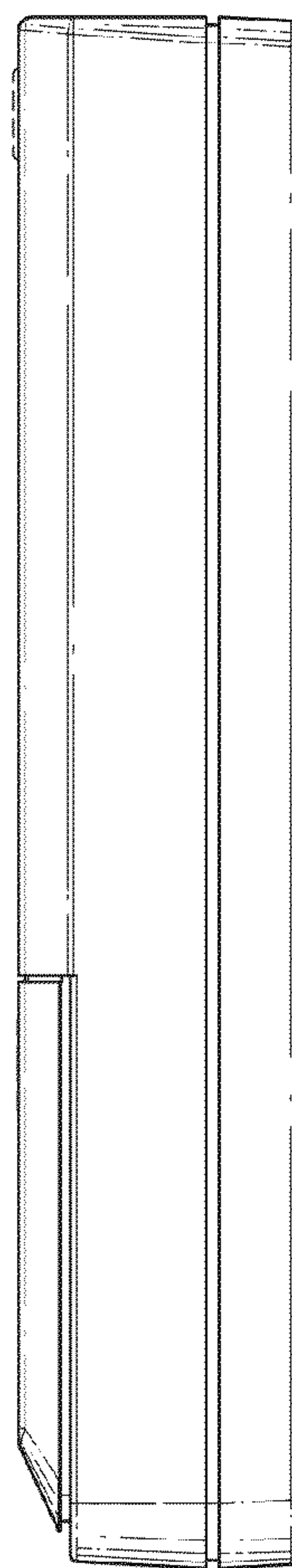

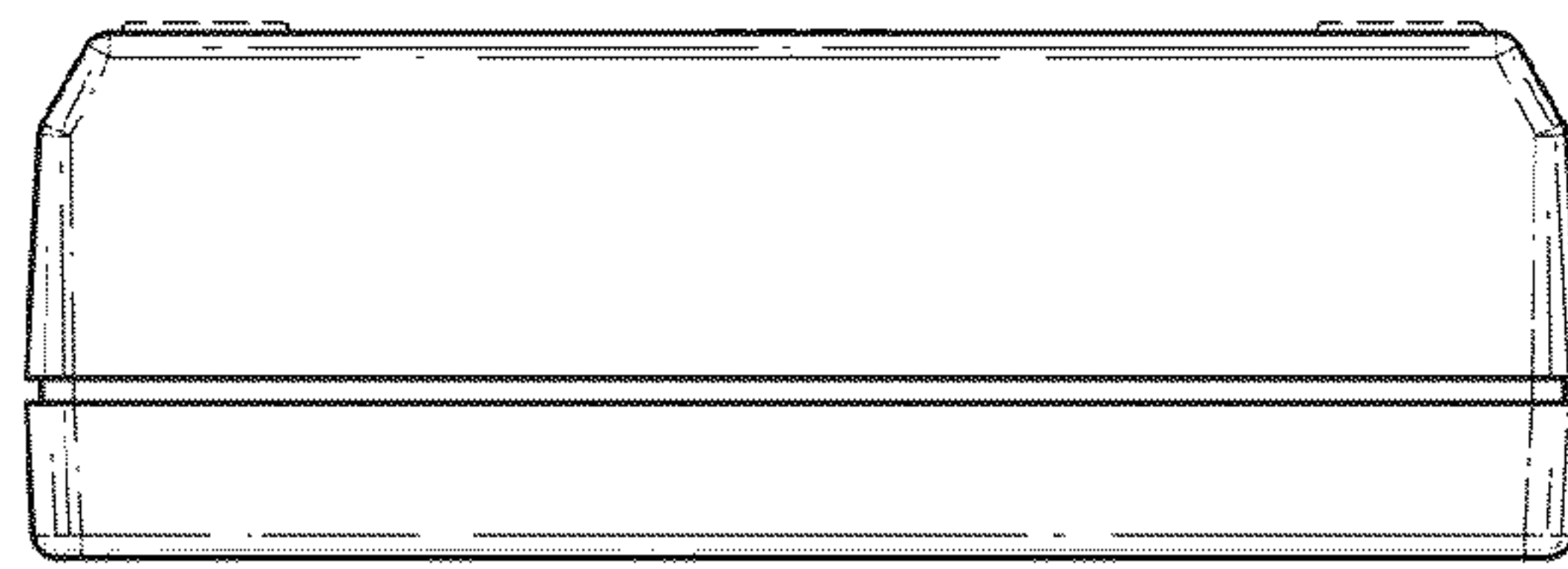

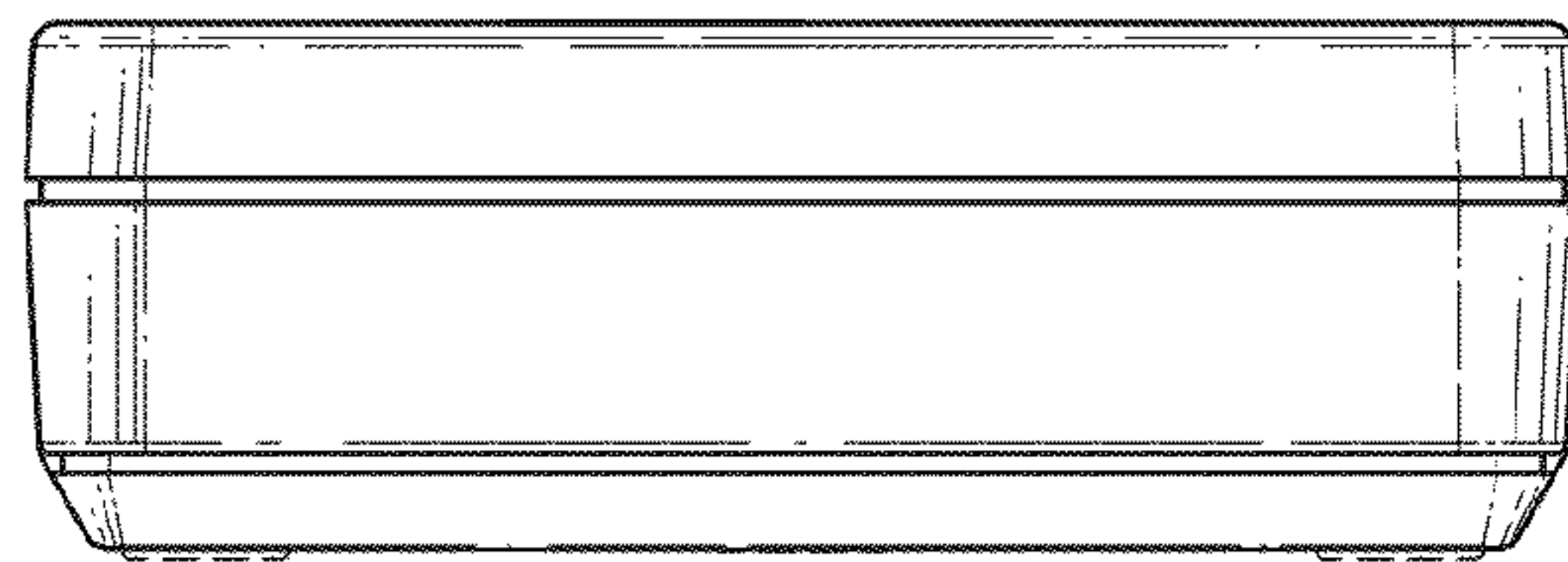

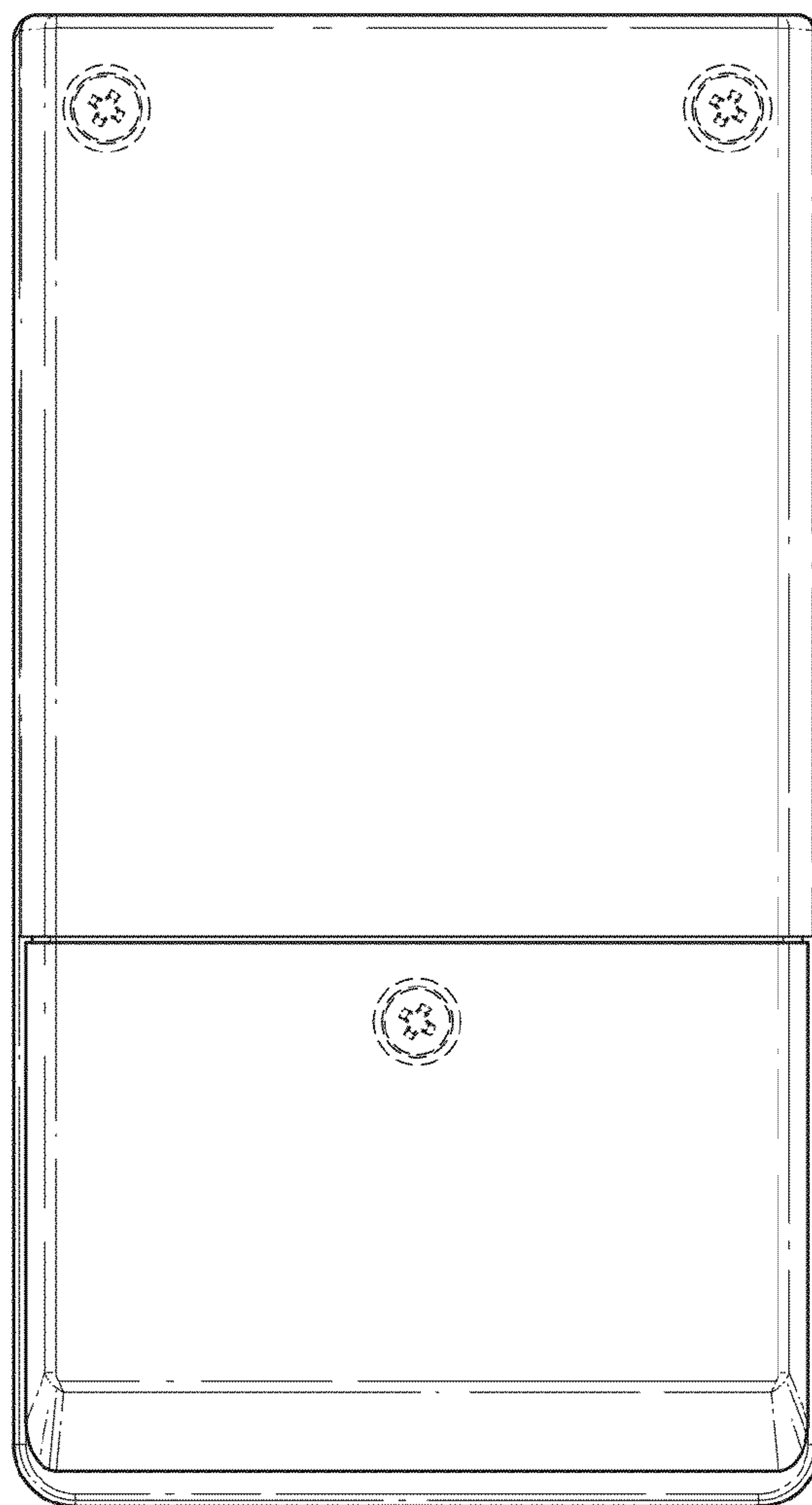
