## (57) CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a handbag with drink pouch, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handbag with drink pouch showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof.

FIG. **5** is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a top planform view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a bottom planform view thereof.

FIG. 8 is a top planform view thereof with the handbag open showing three separate compartments, one of which having a flap in its closed position.

FIG. 9 is a top planform view thereof similar to FIG. 8 showing the flap in its open position.

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof showing the side zipper, open and showing access to two compartments.

FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view thereof similar to FIG. 10 showing the positioning of a drinking bag spout

10 showing the positioning of a drinking bag spout.


FIG. 12 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 12-12 of FIG. 6 showing one of the three compartments of FIGS. 8 and 9 with the flap in its closed position.

FIG. 13 is a cross-sectional view thereof similar to FIG. 12 showing the flap in its open position; and,

FIG. 14 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 14-14 of FIG. 6 showing another one of the three compartments of FIGS. 8 and 9.

The broken lines showing a portion of a strap are for the purpose of illustrating environment and form no part of the claimed design.
