I claim the ornamental design for a glove with a pad for painting, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a glove with a pad for painting, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

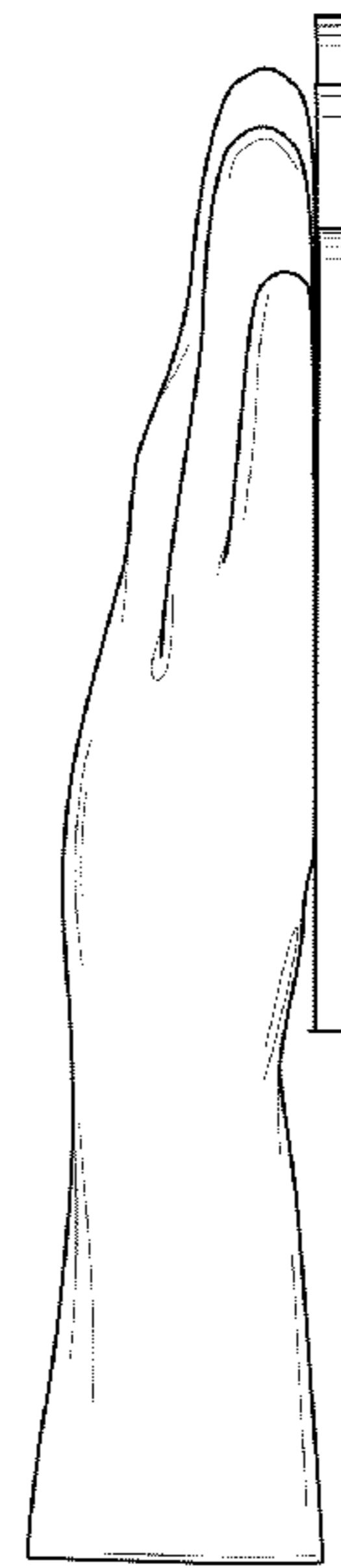
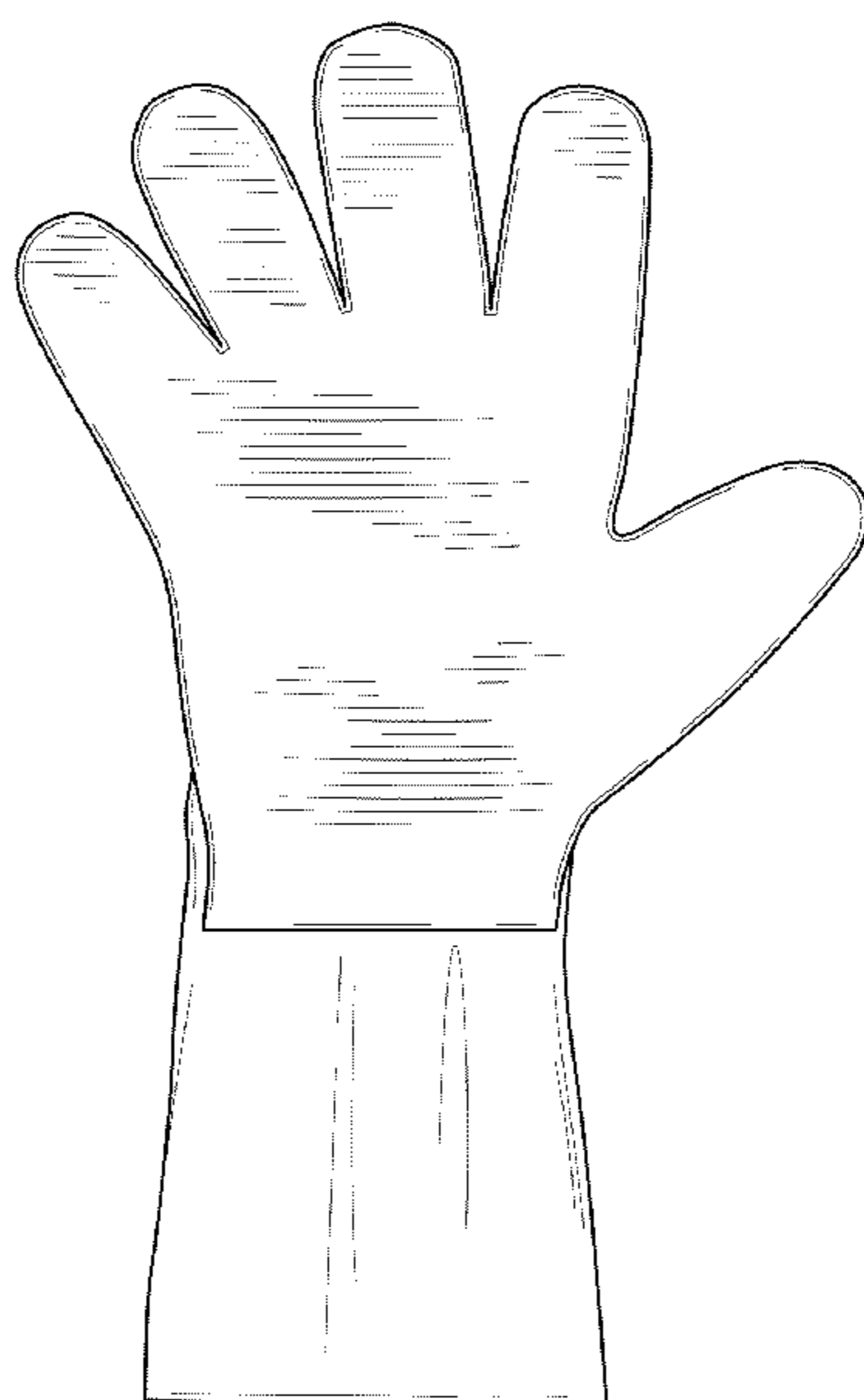
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

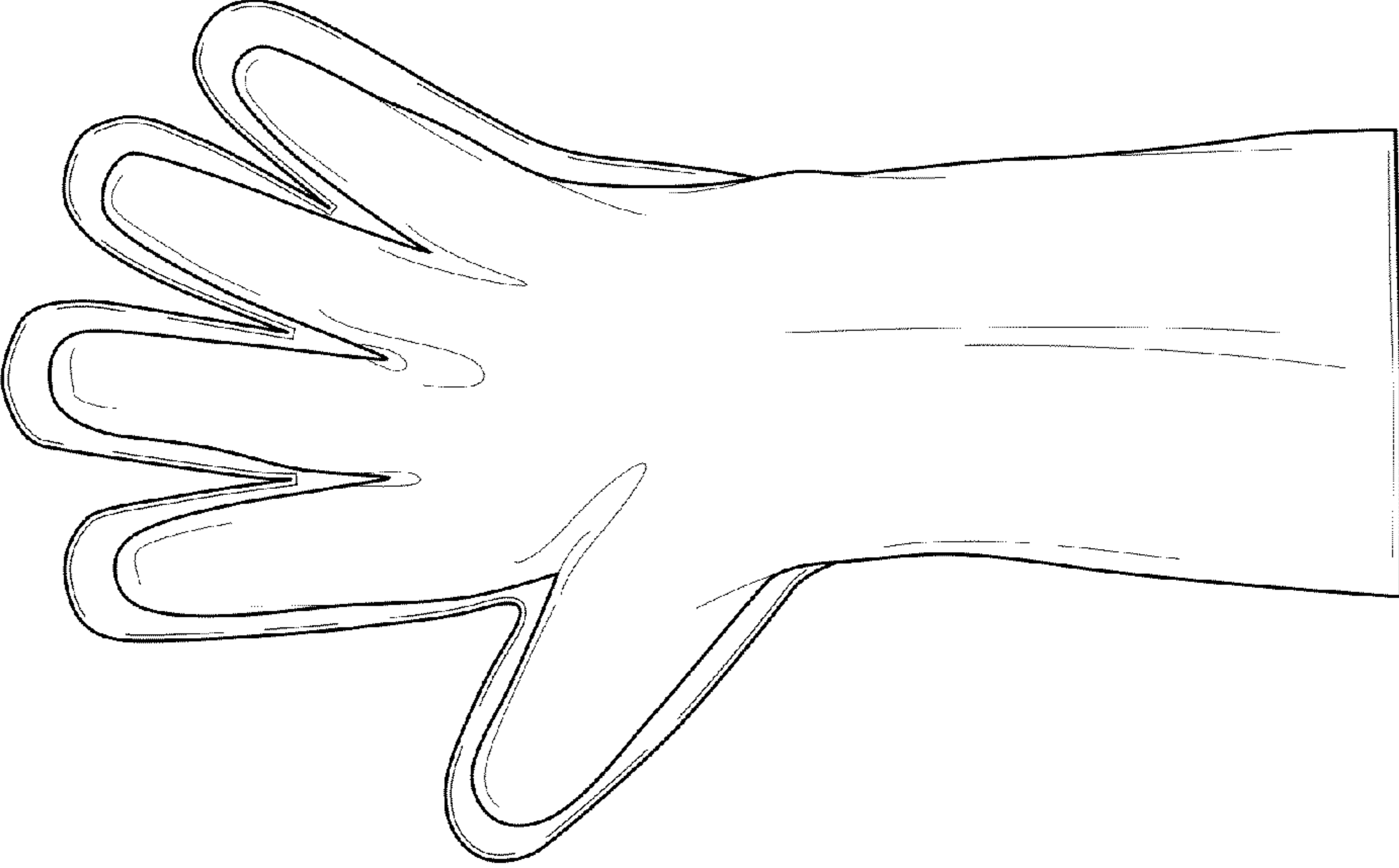

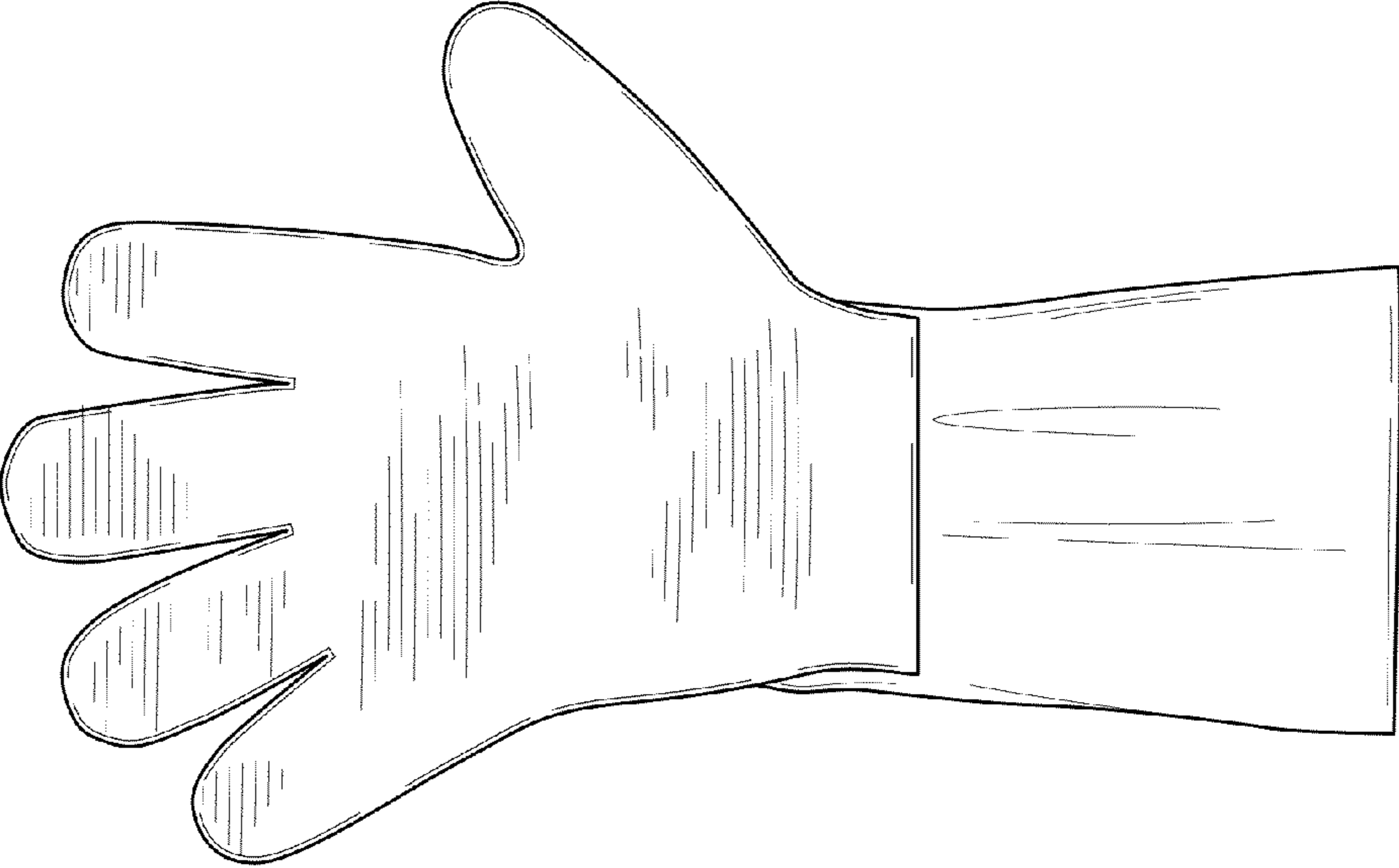

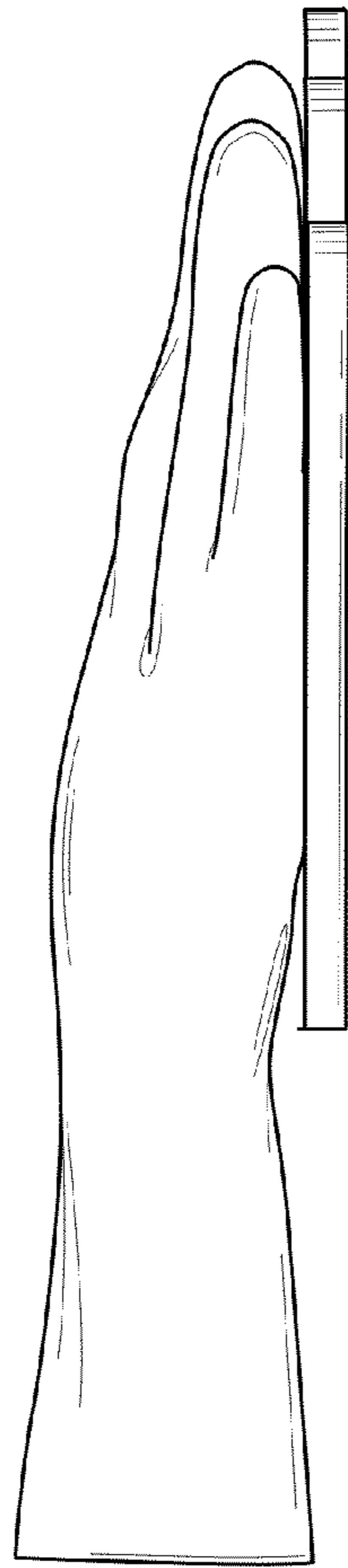

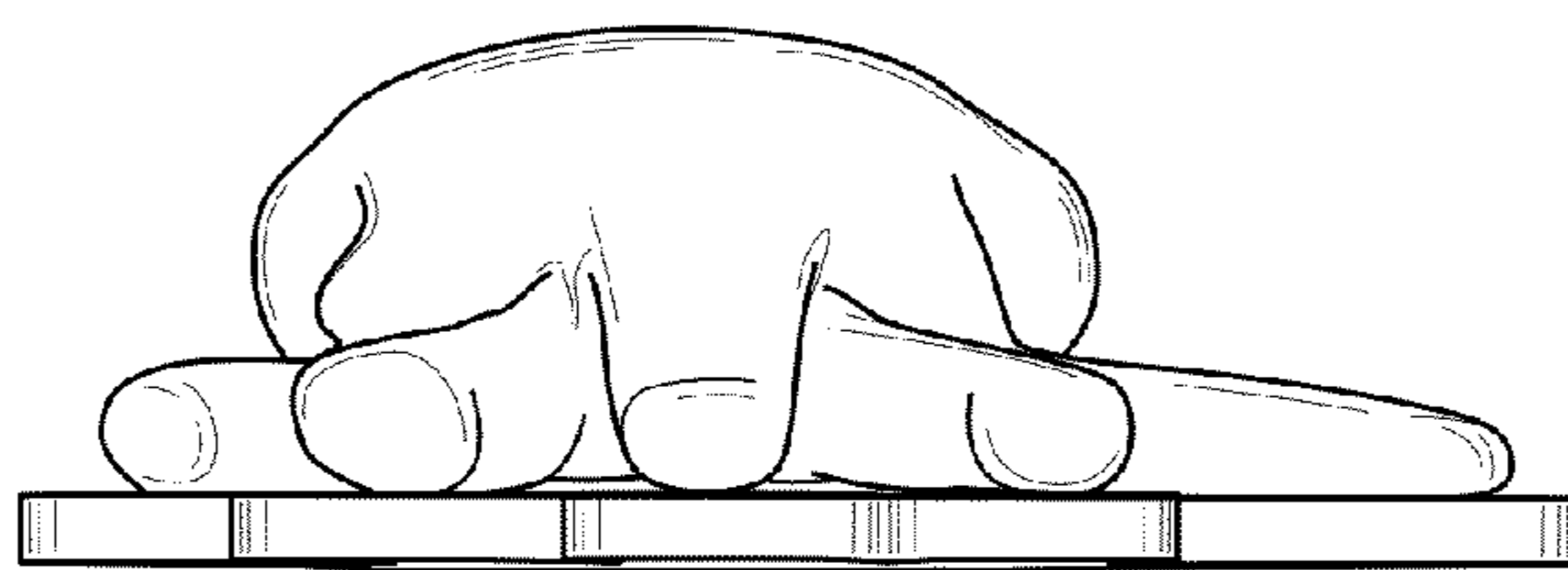
