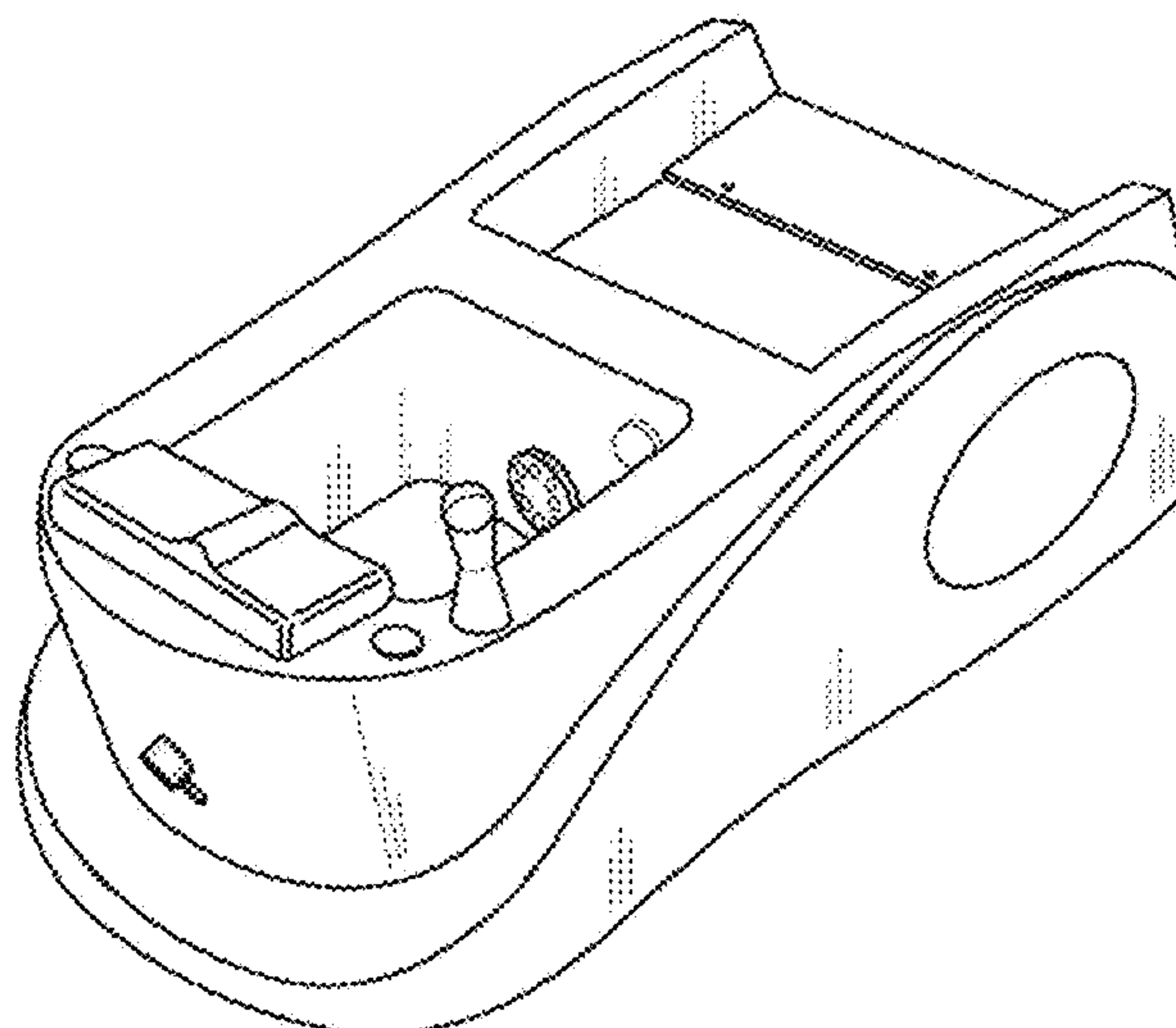
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the pedicure spa according to the present invention.

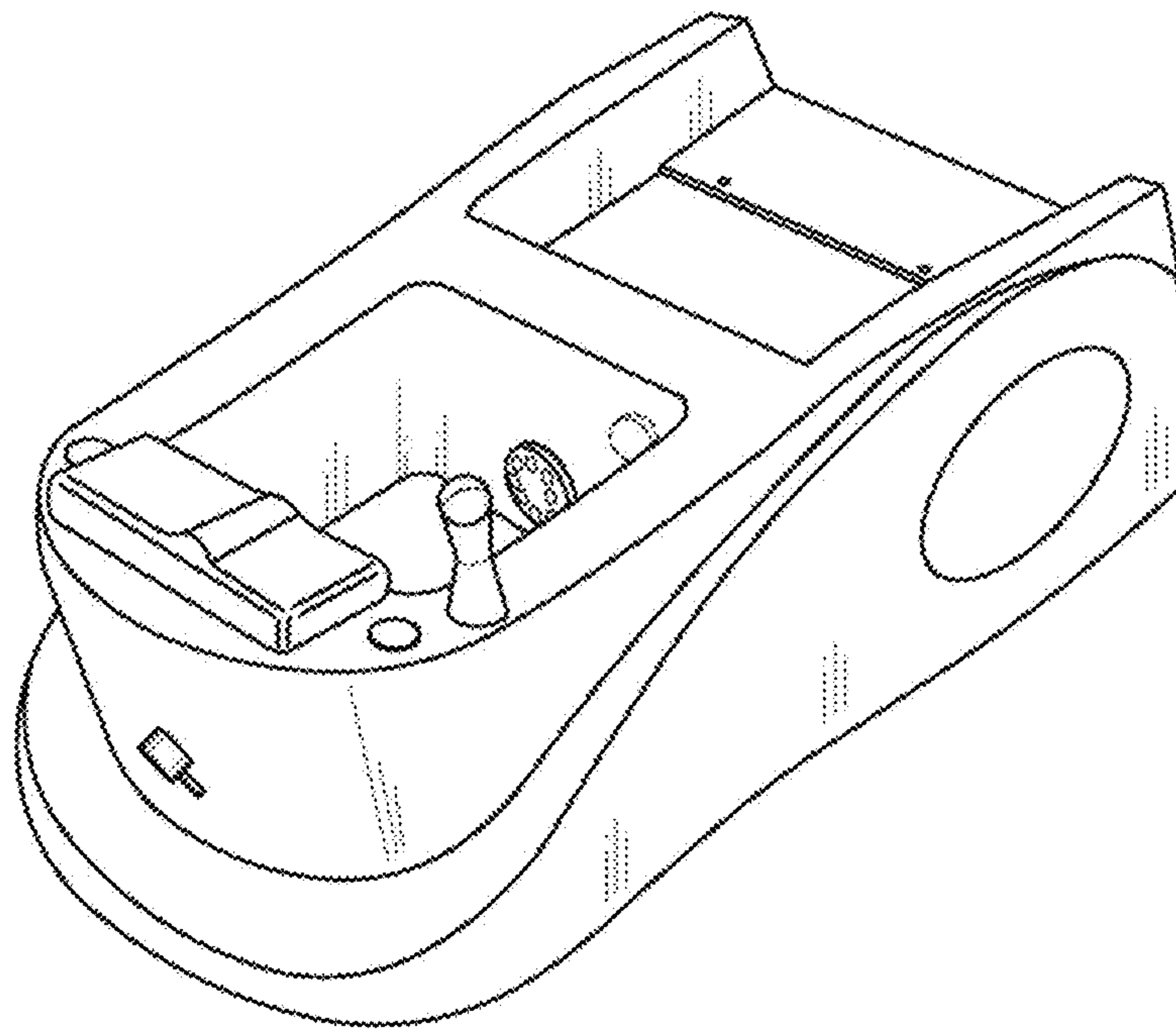

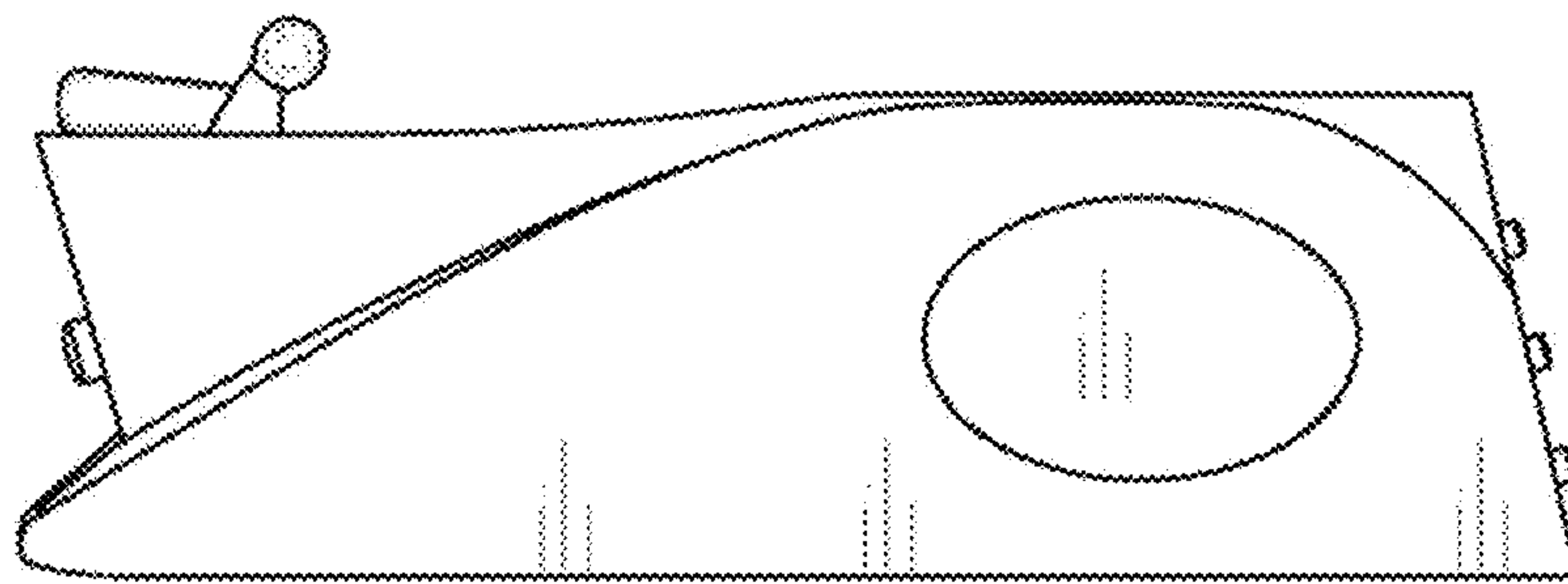

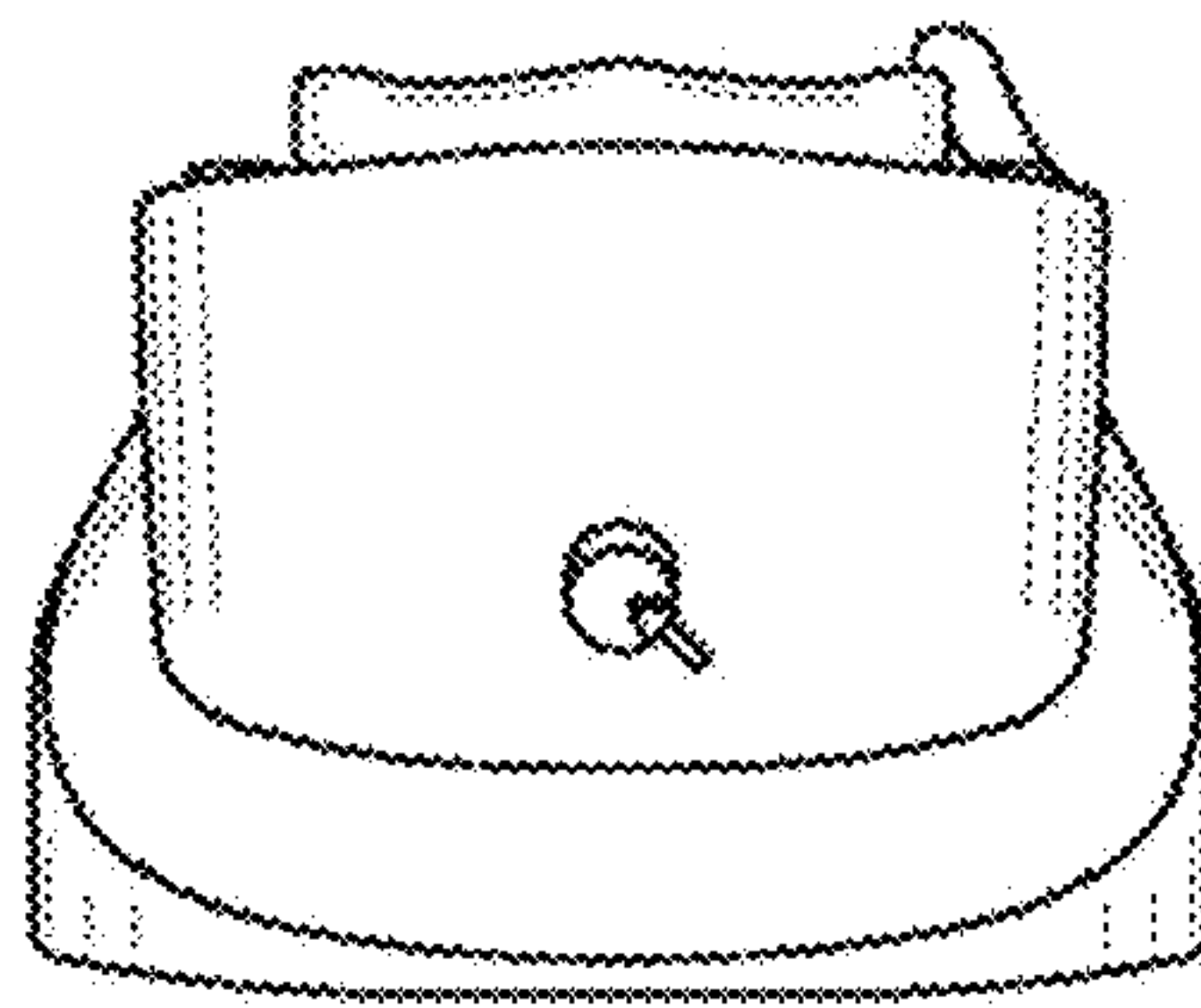

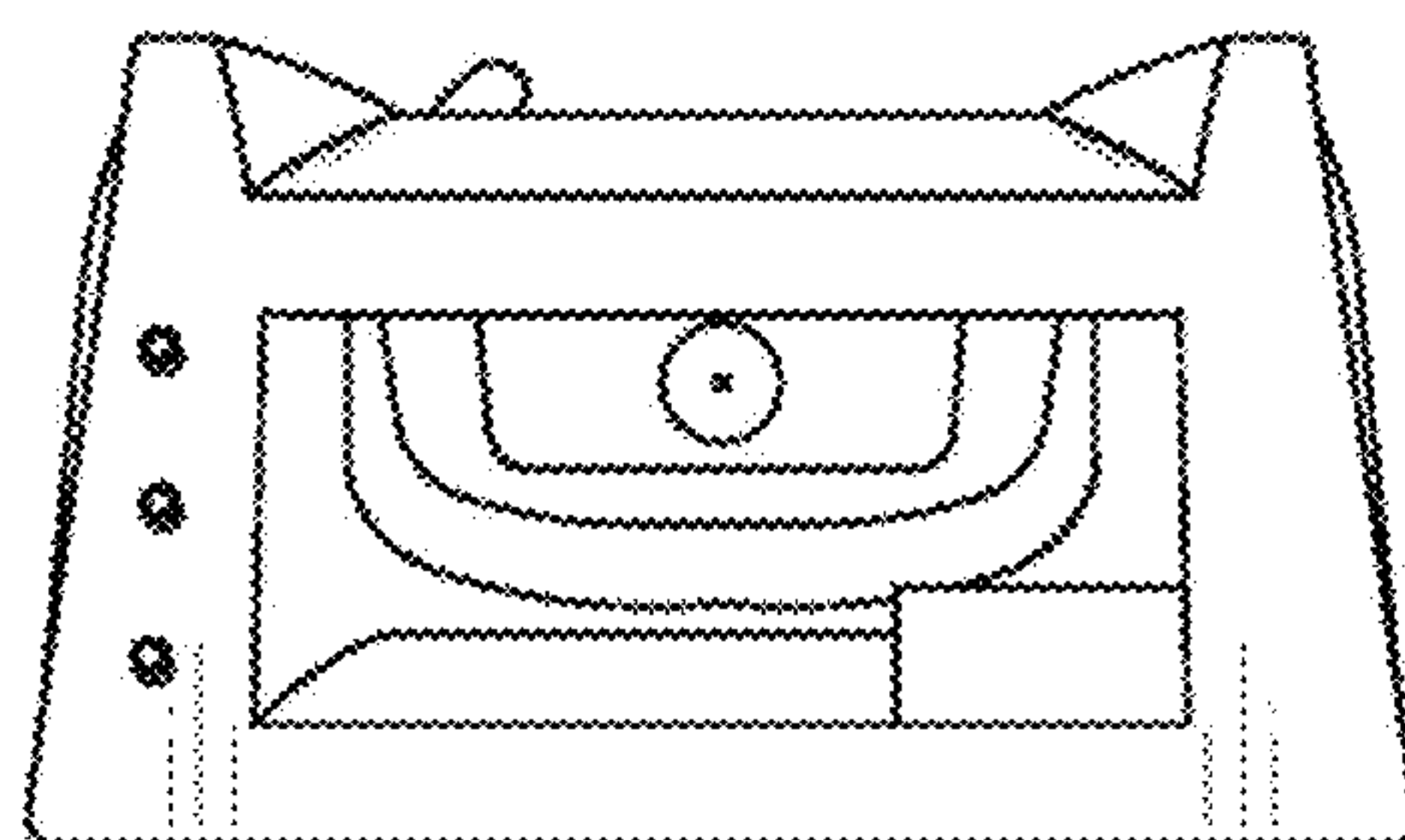

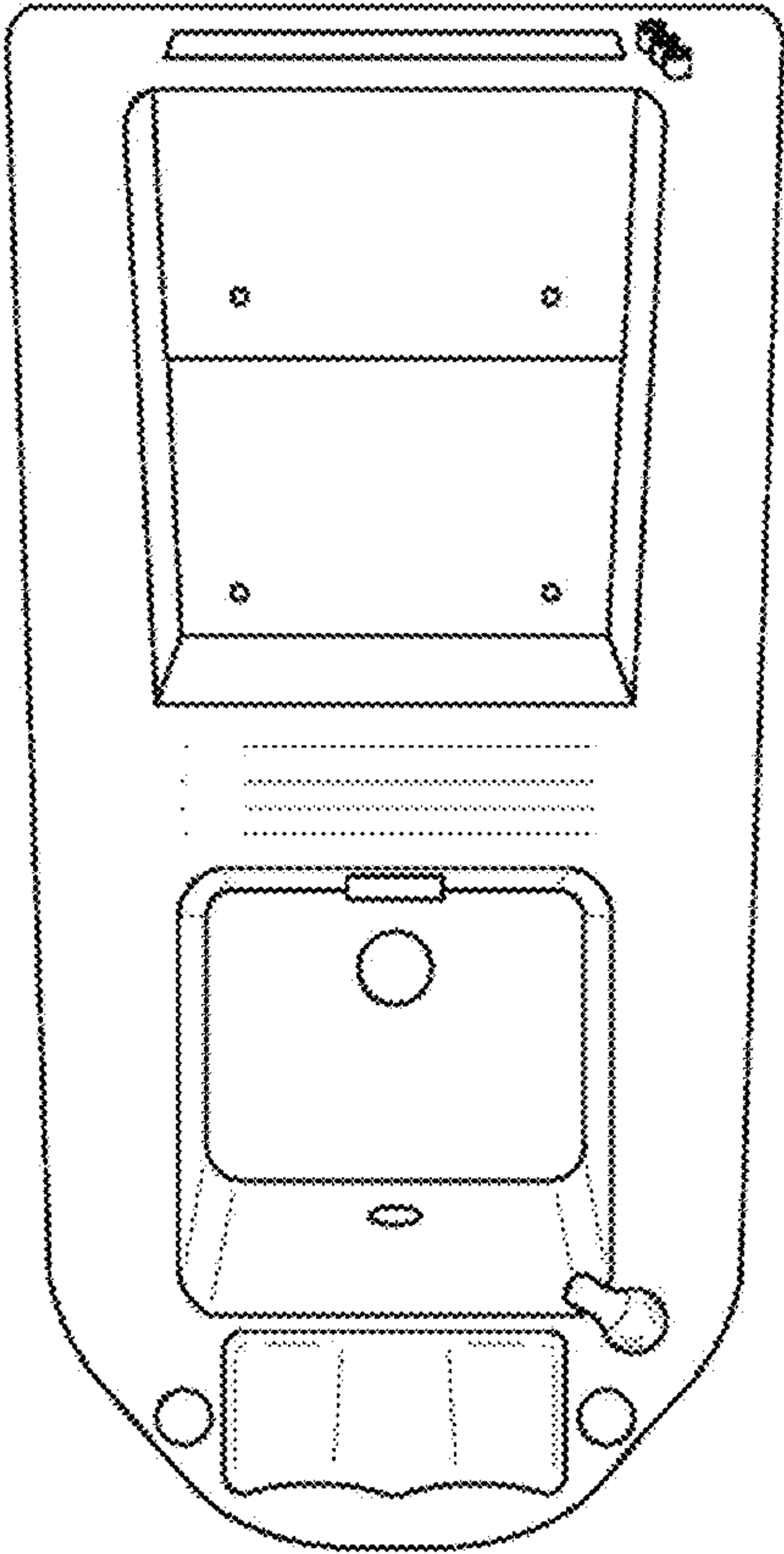

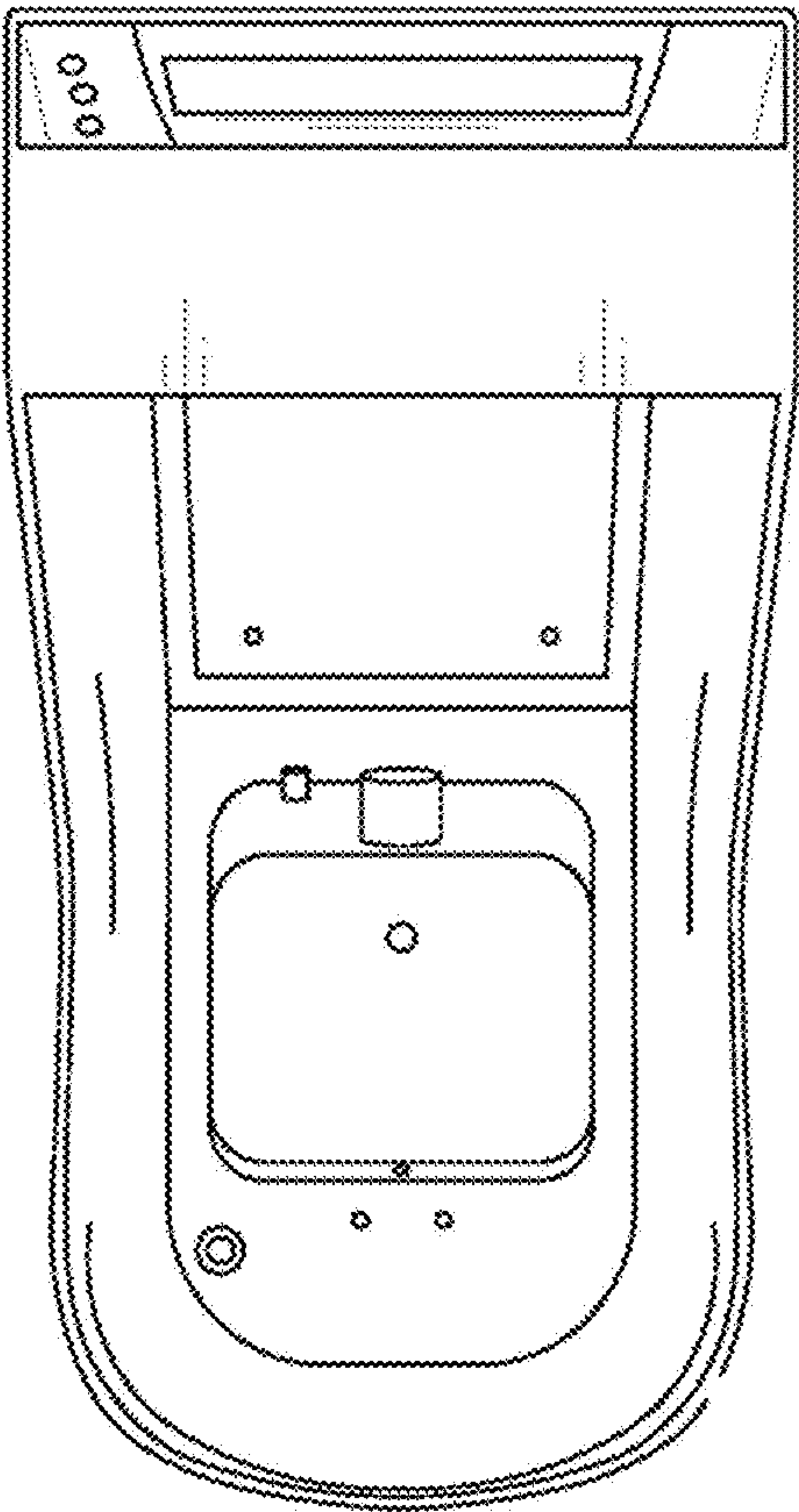
