FIG. 6 is a right-side elevation view thereof;

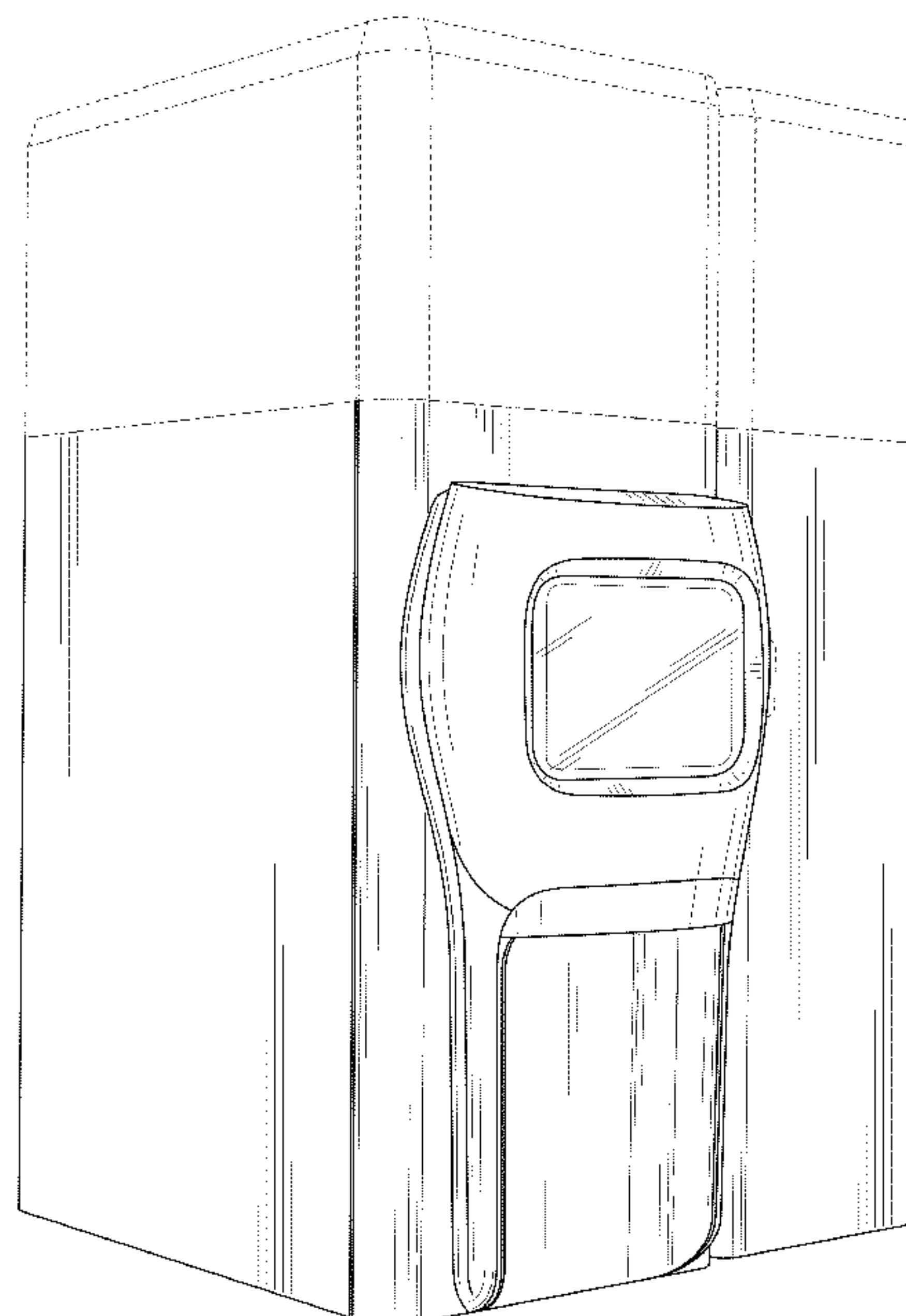
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and,

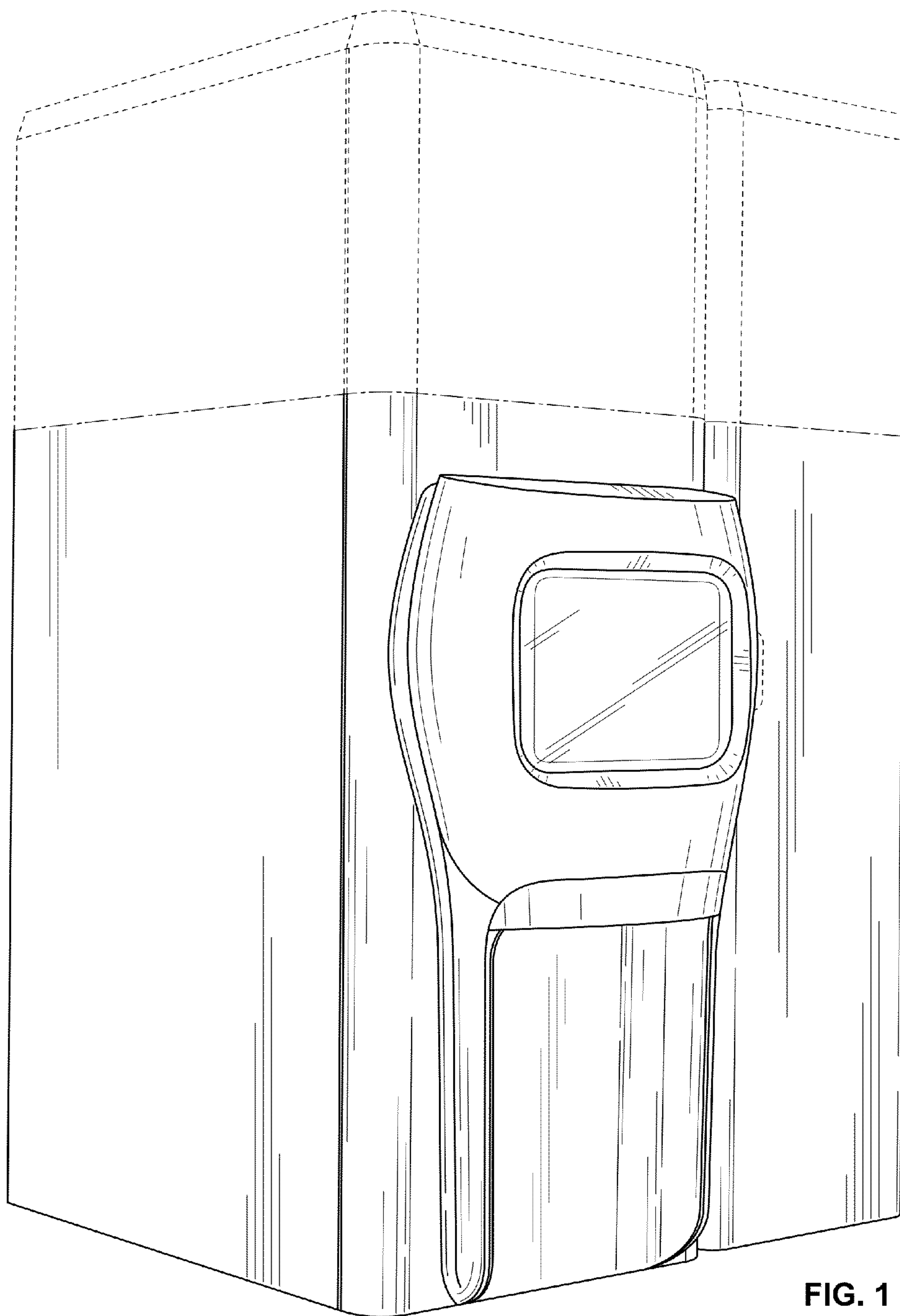

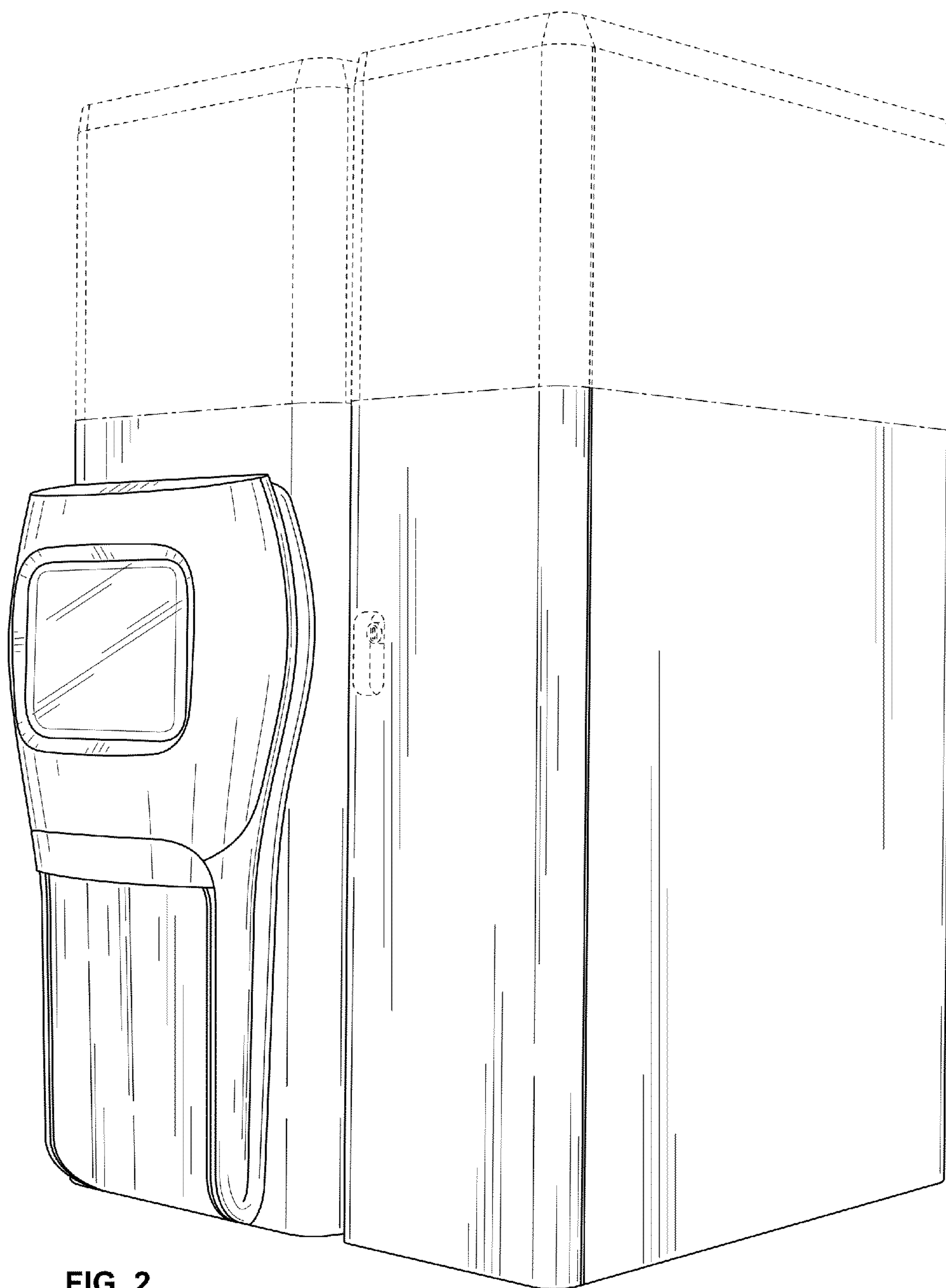

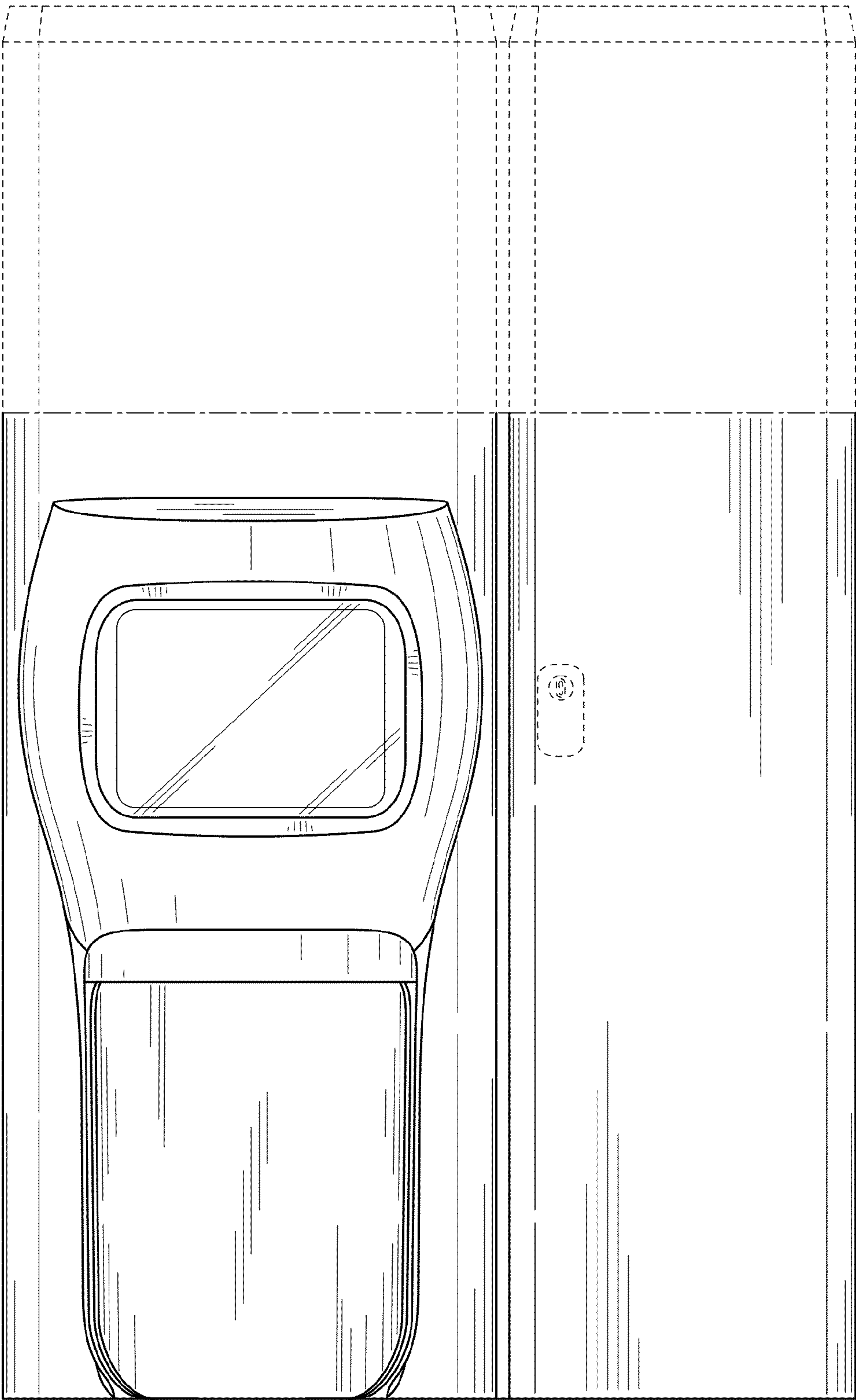

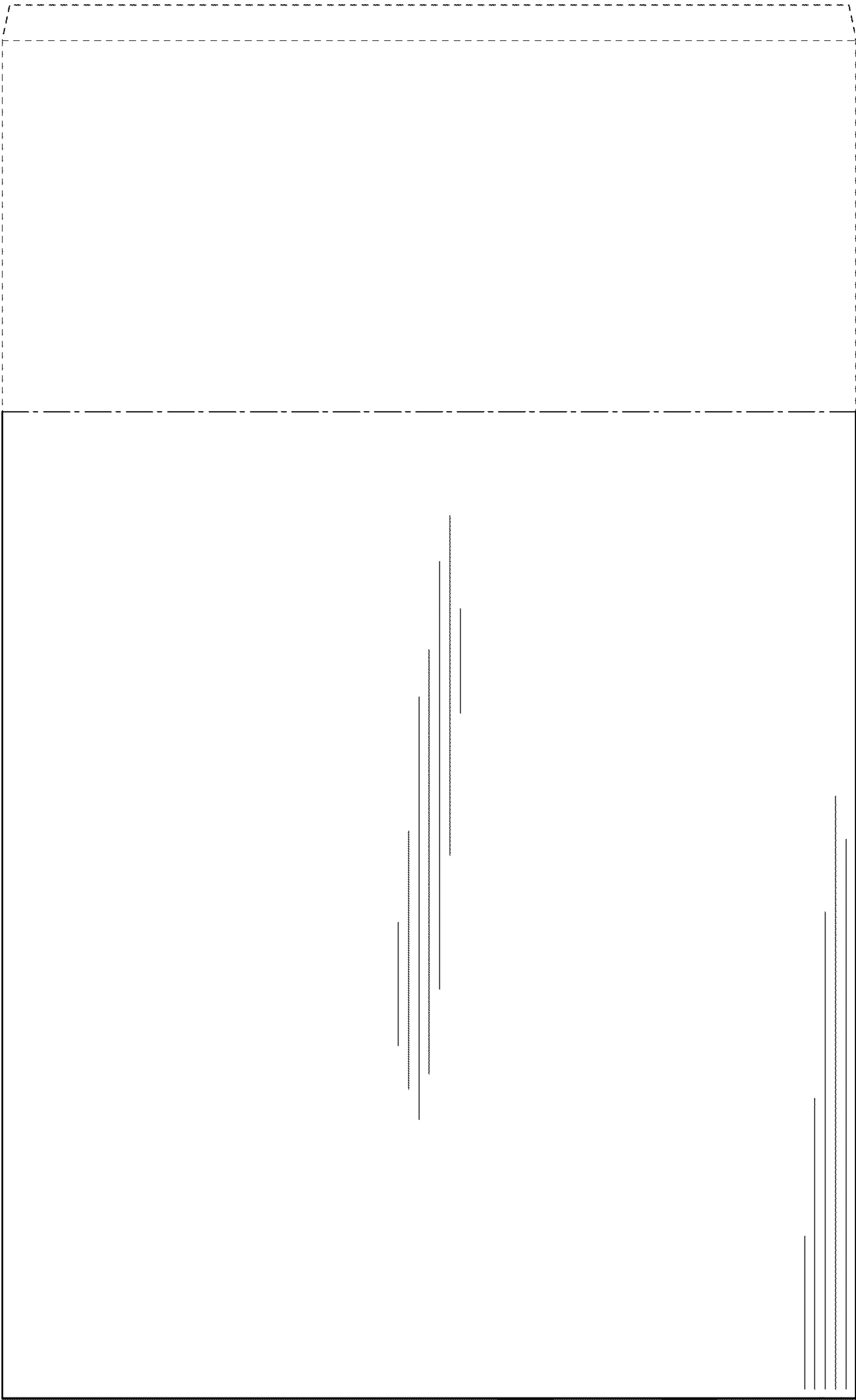

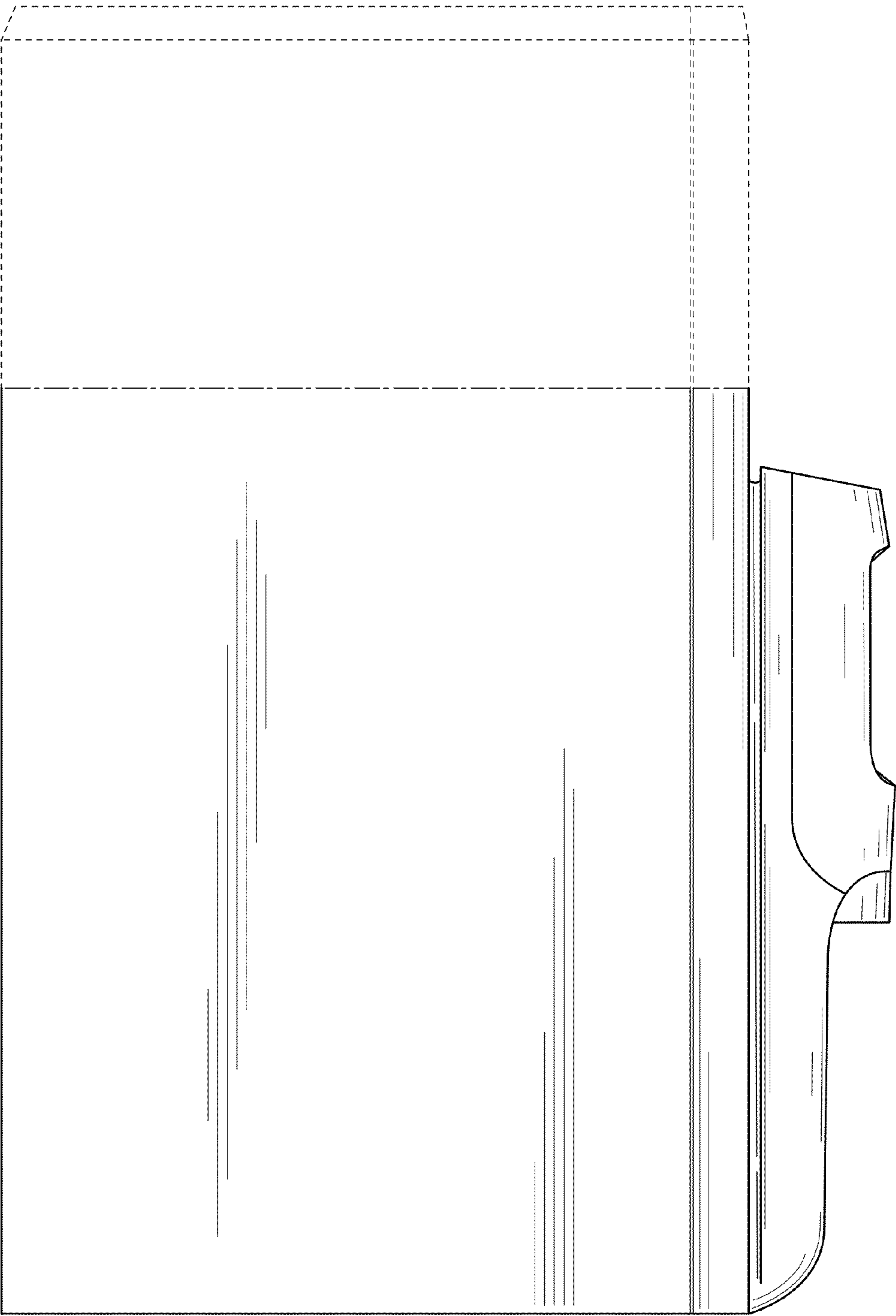

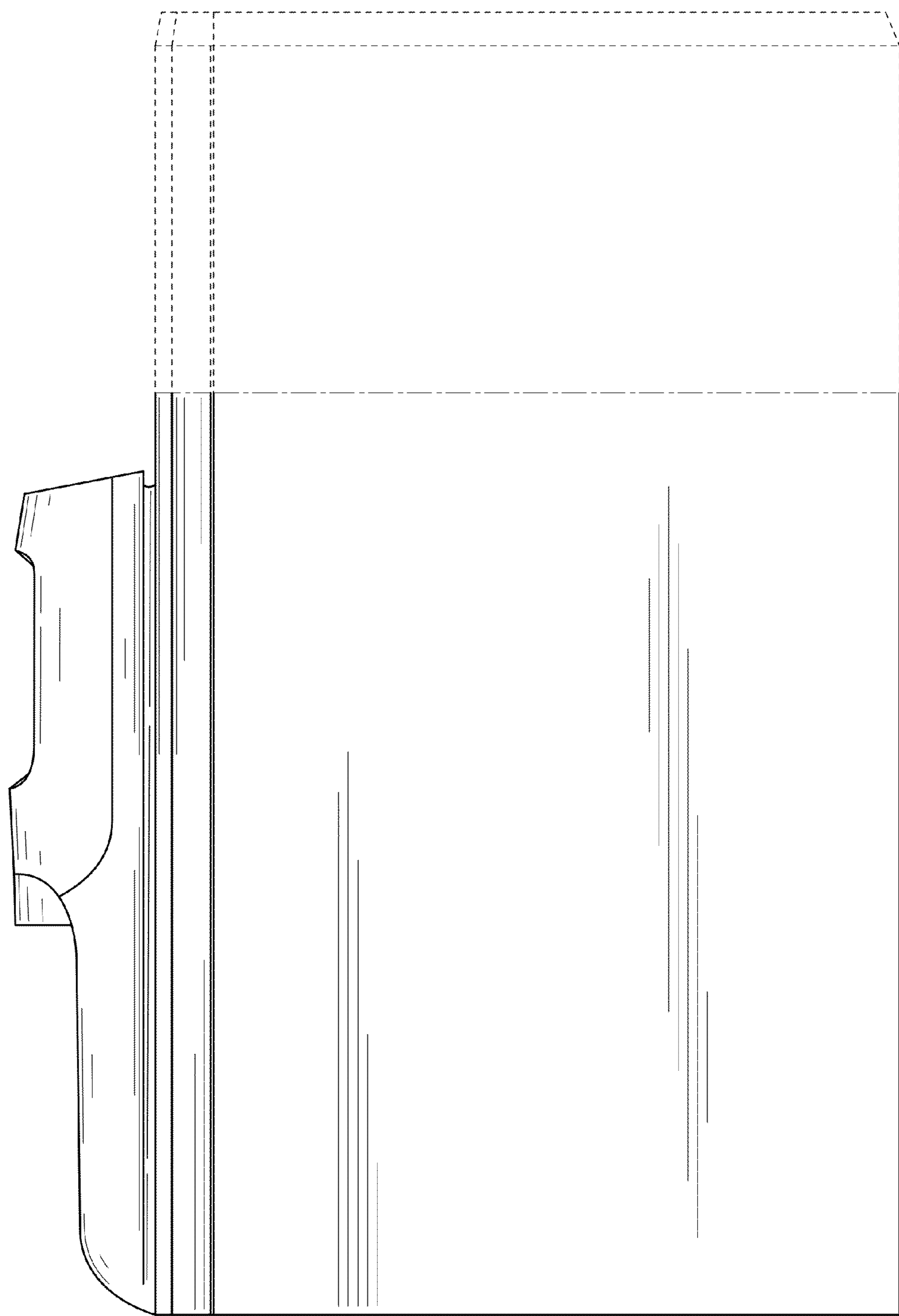

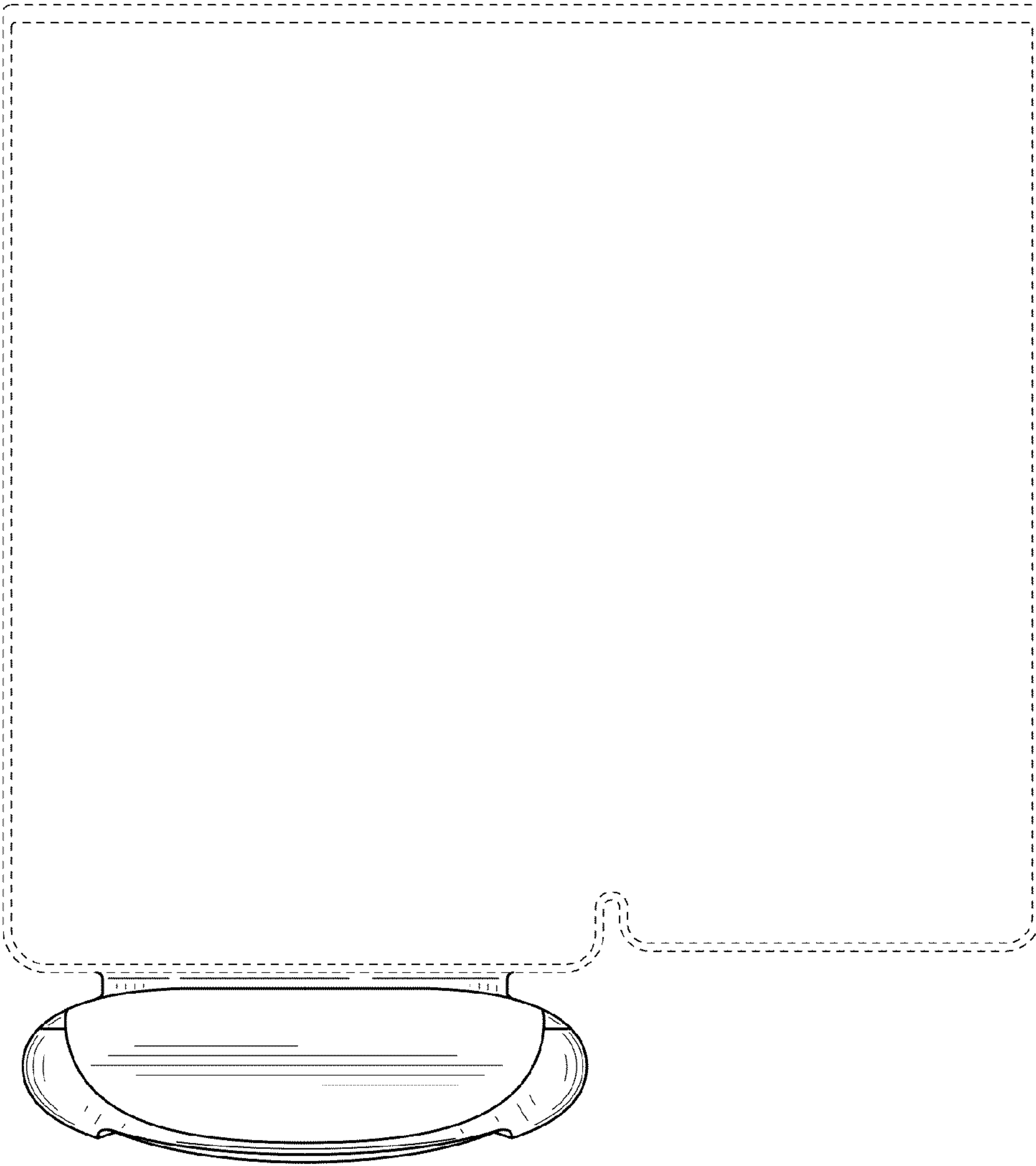

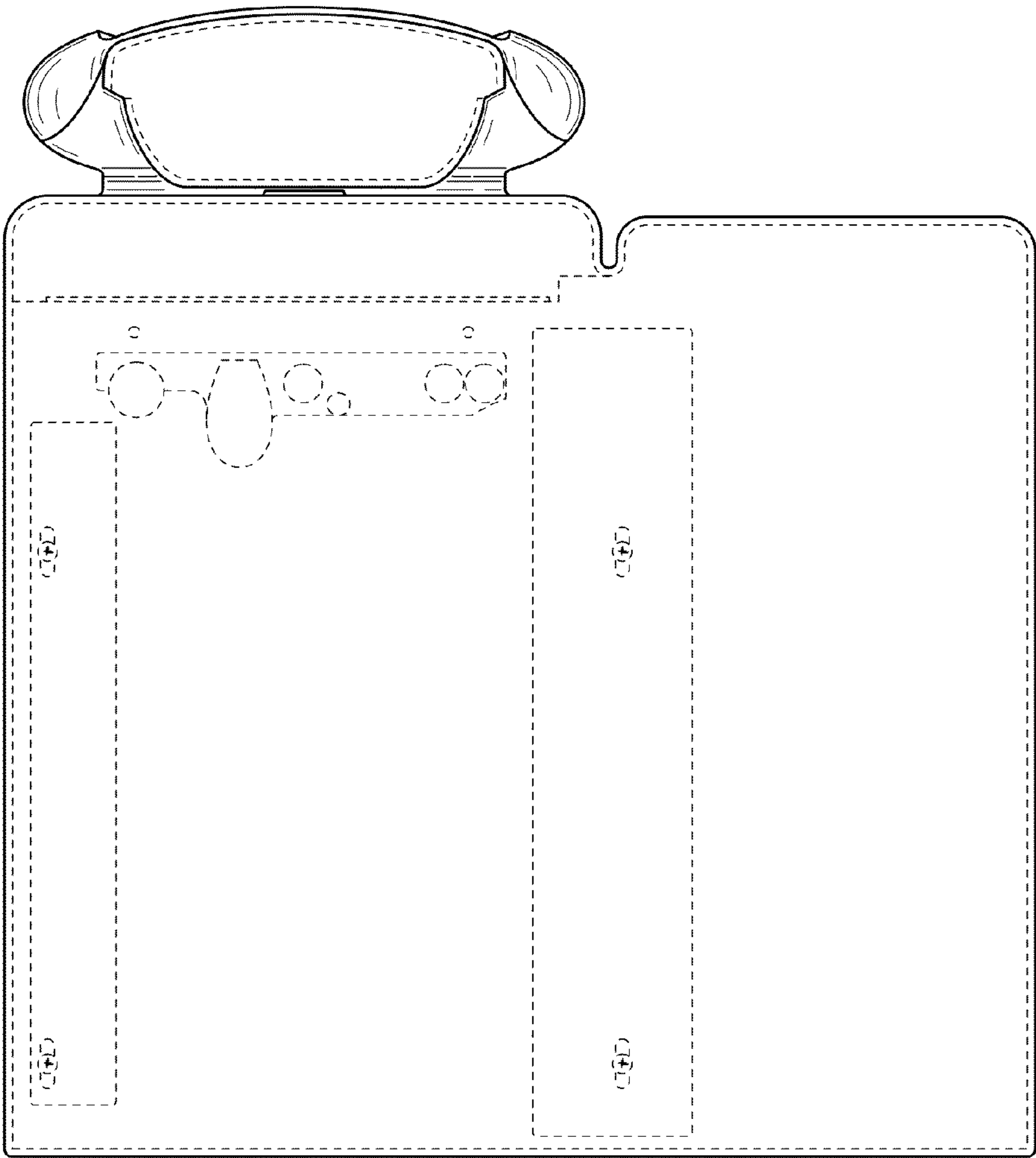
