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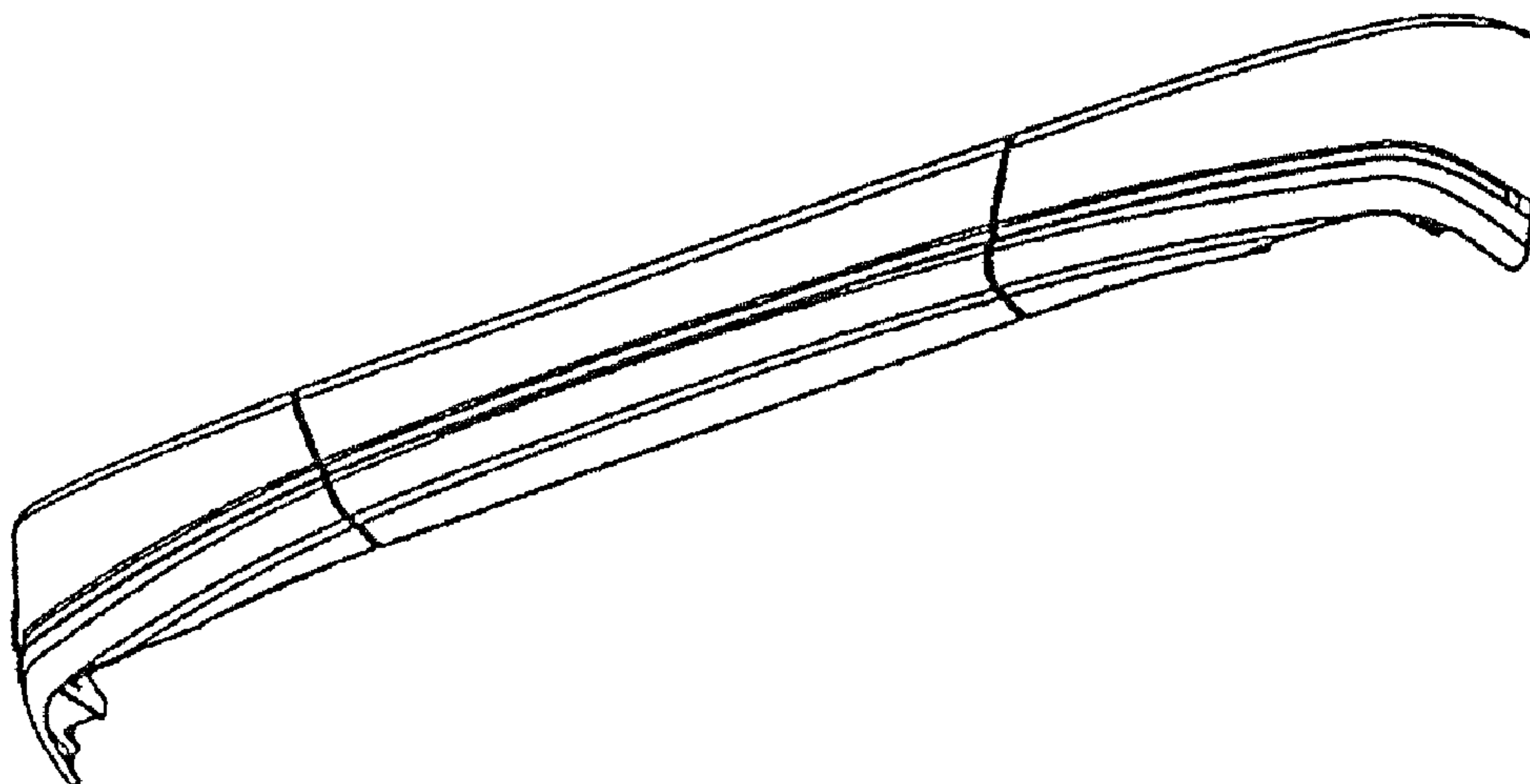
(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a bumper for a passenger bus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom, front and left side perspective view of a bumper for a passenger bus showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;

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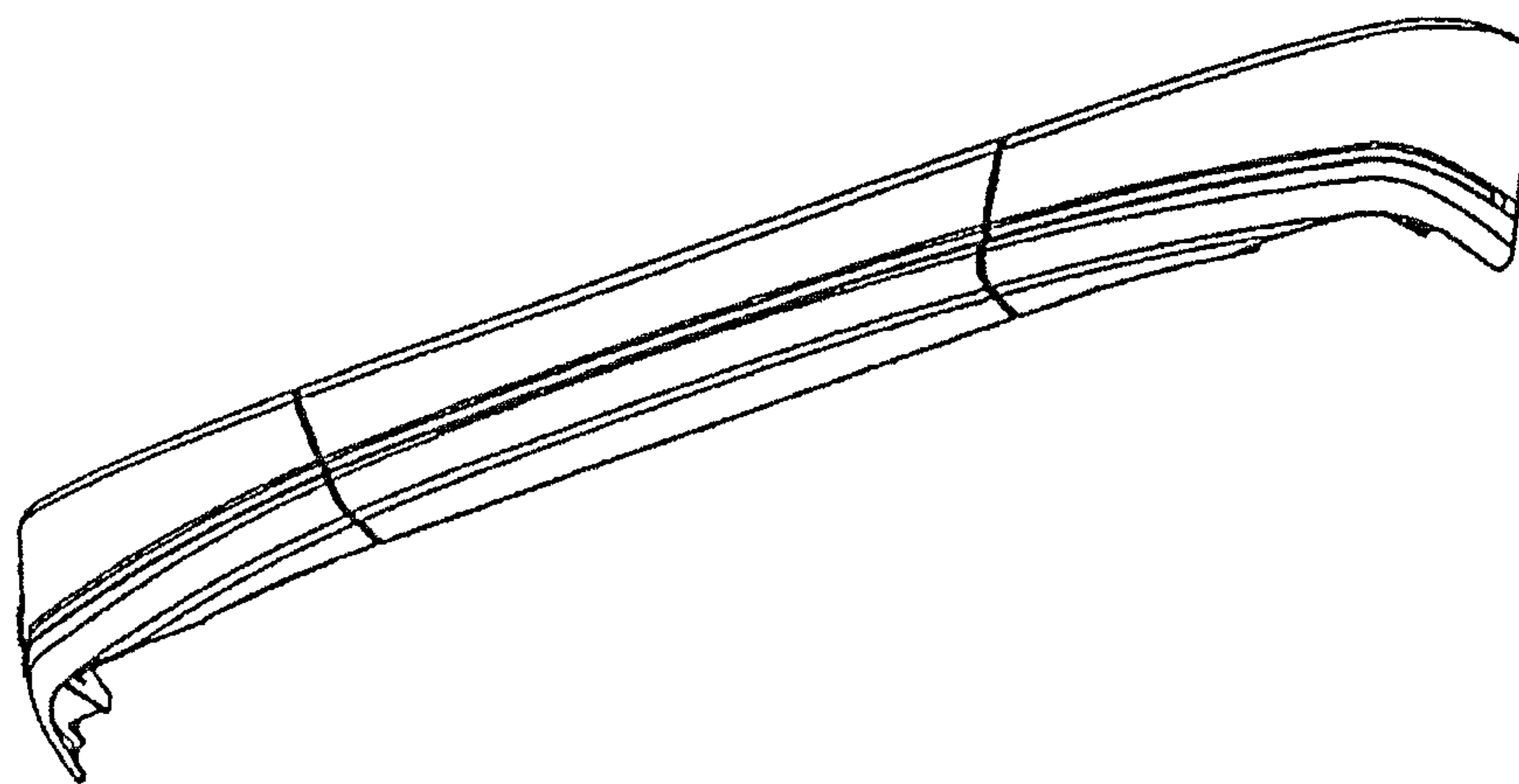

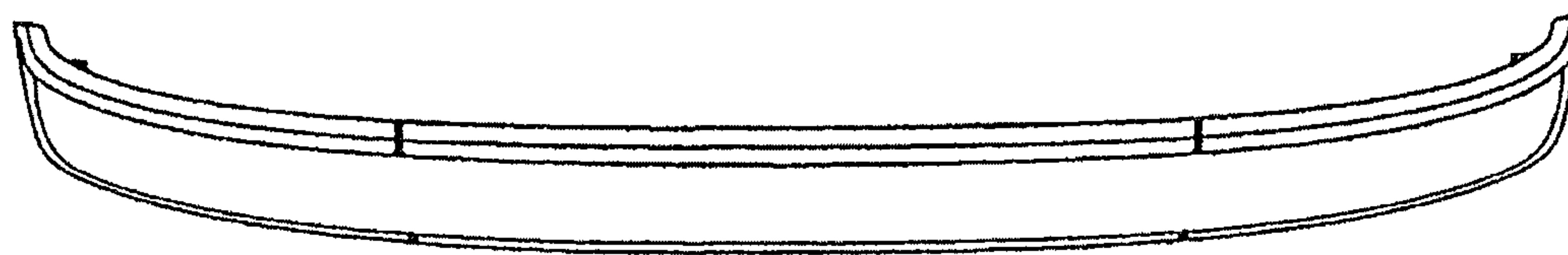

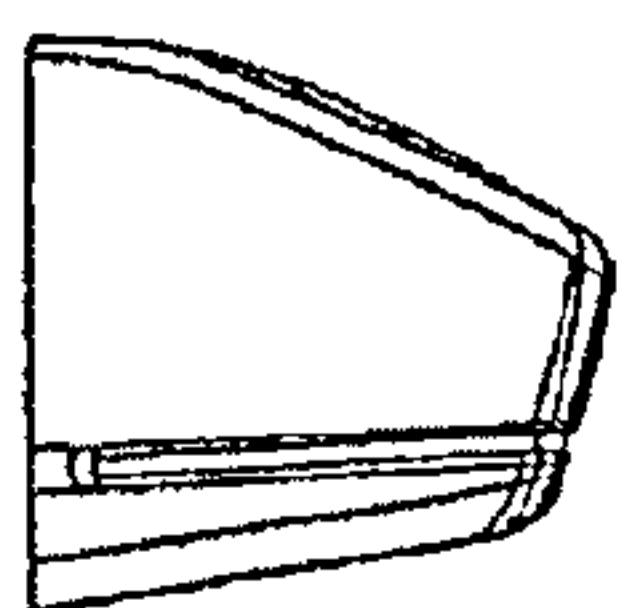

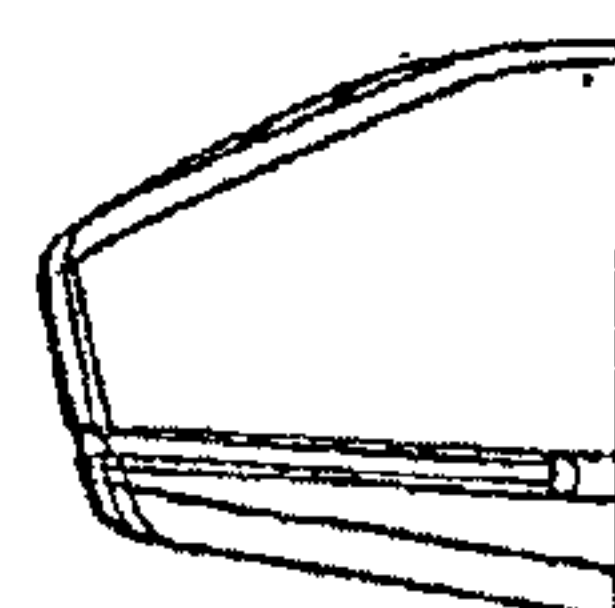

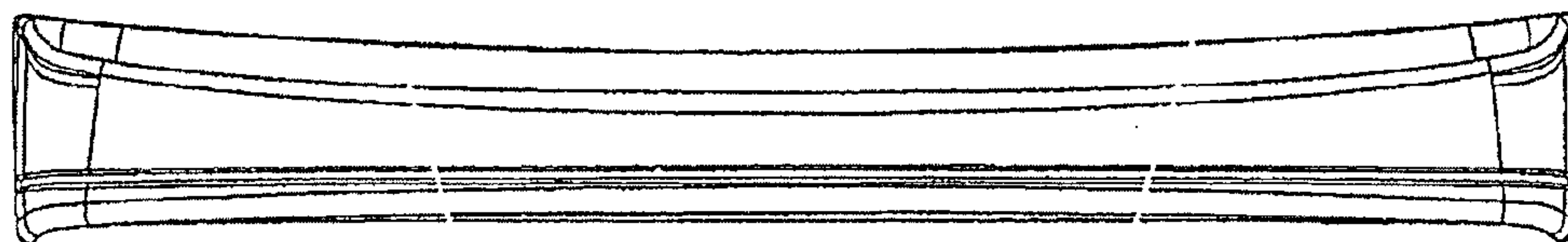

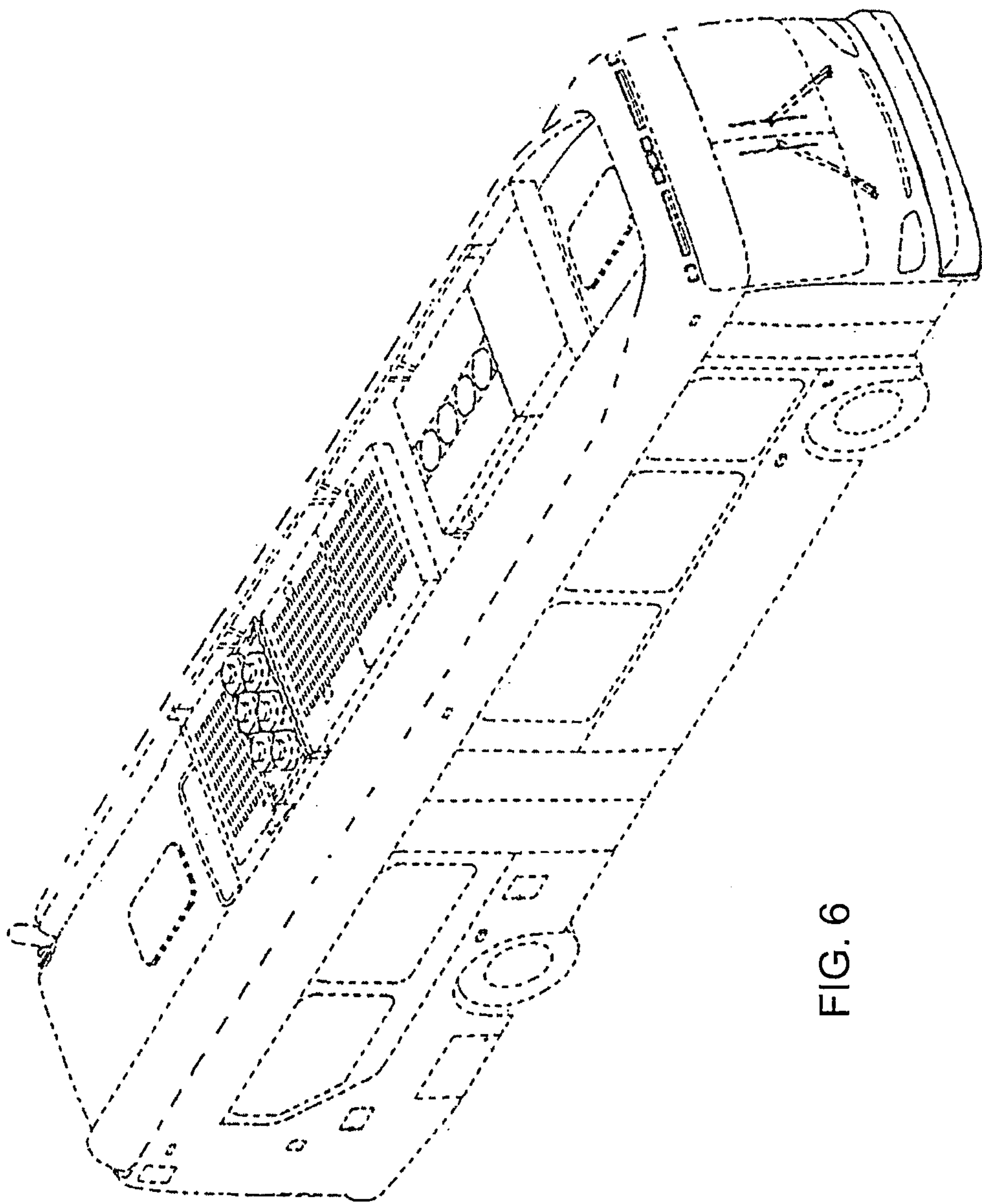

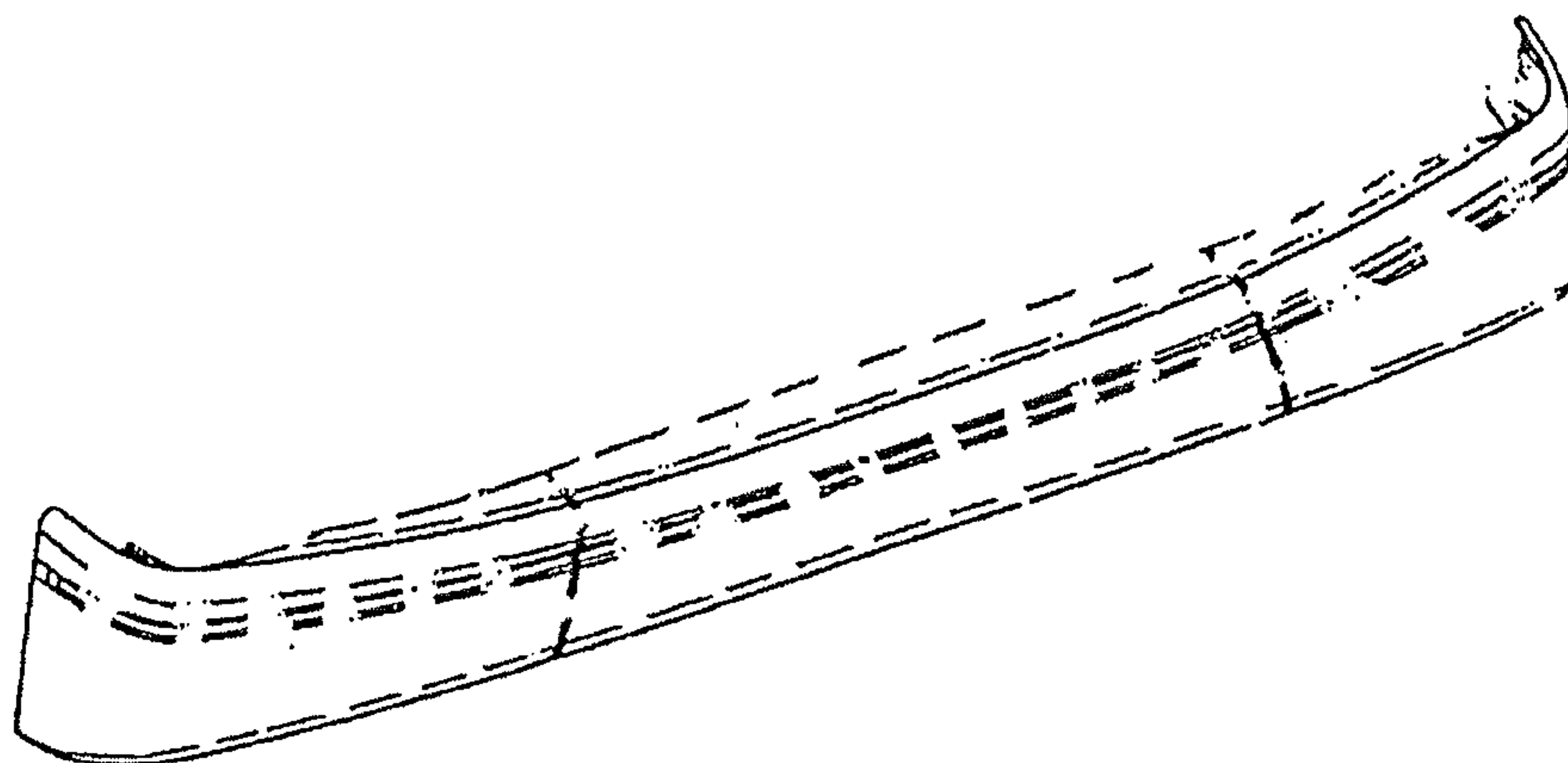

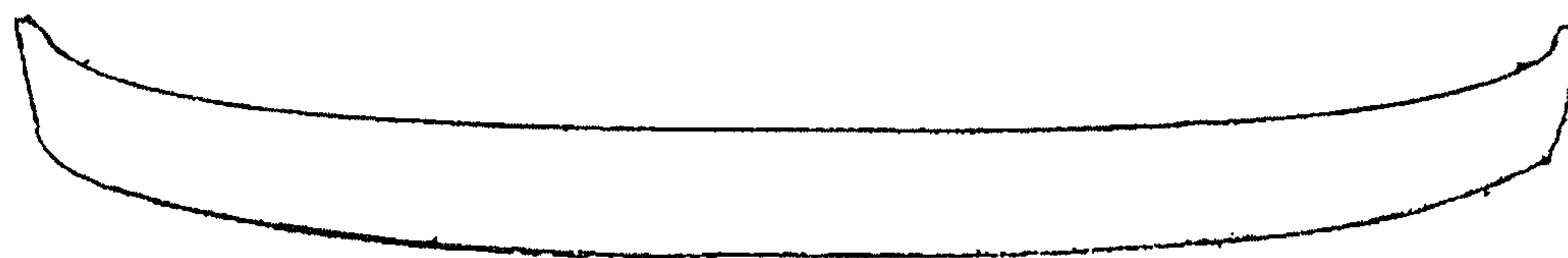

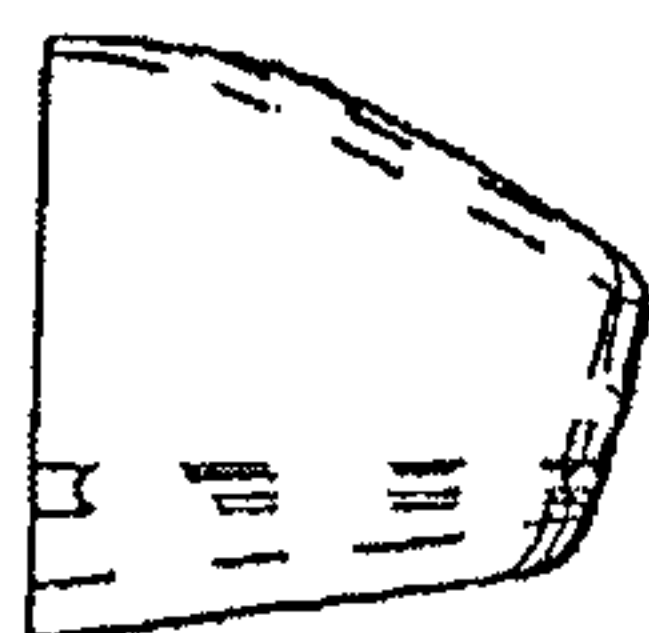

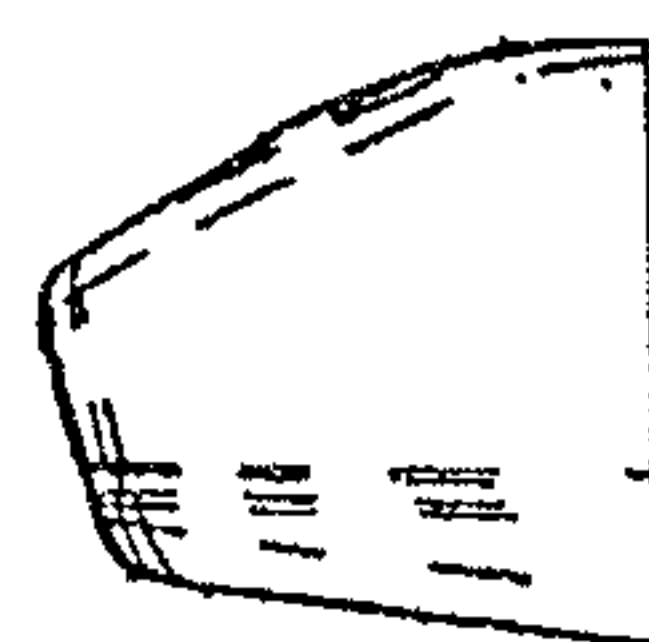

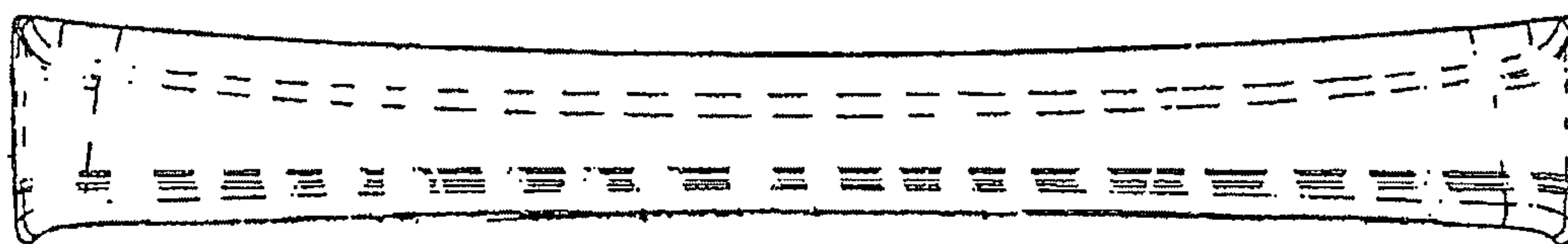
