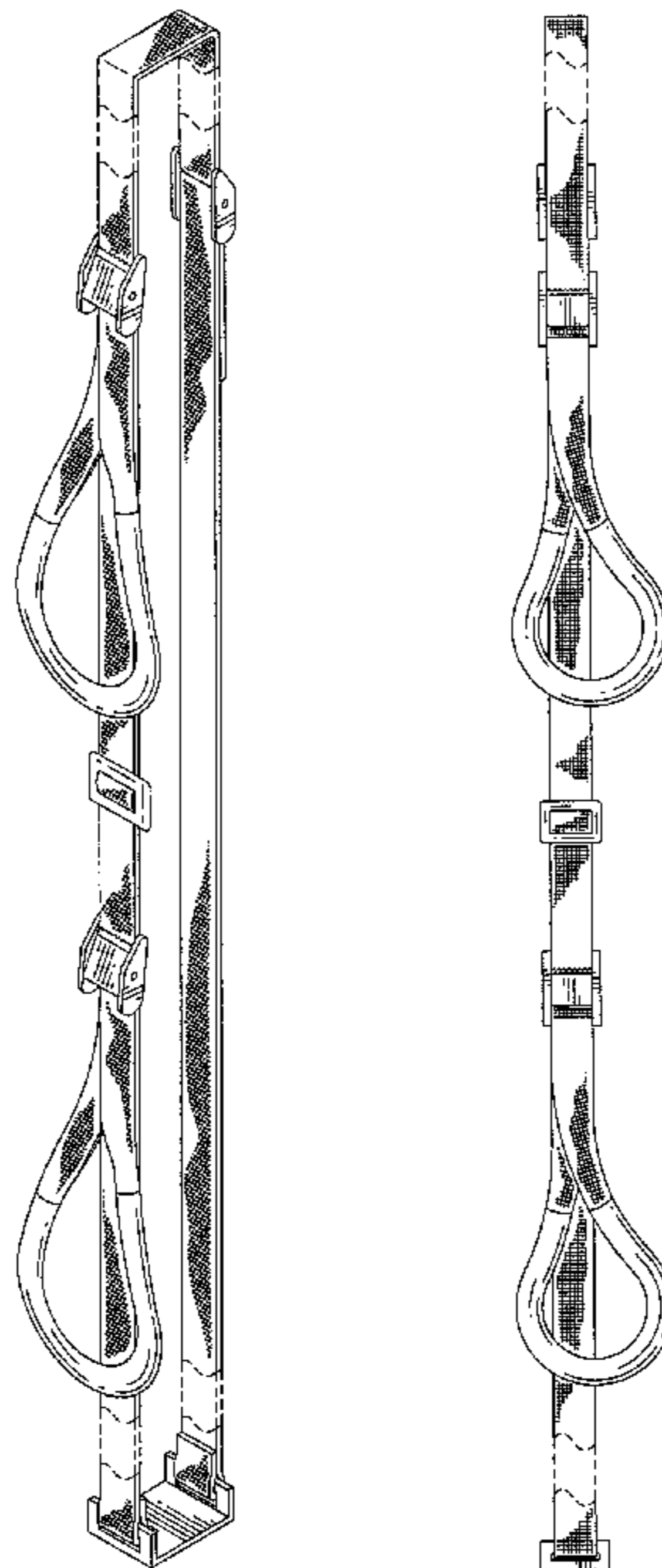
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of an exercise device.
FIG. 2 is a front plan view of the exercise device.

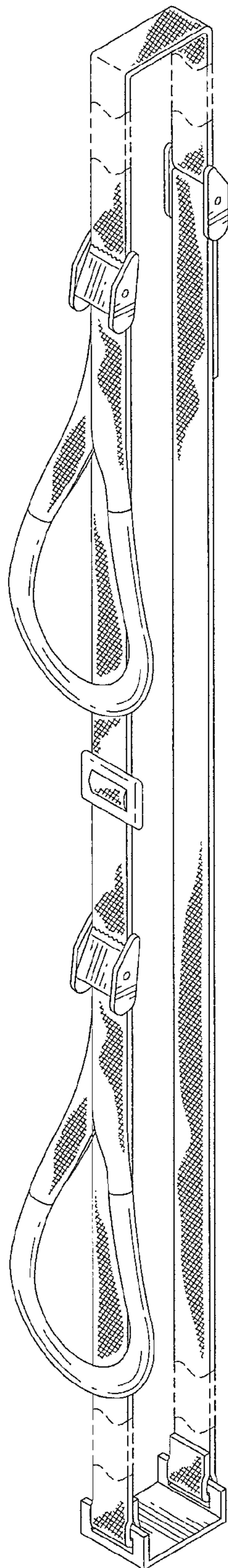

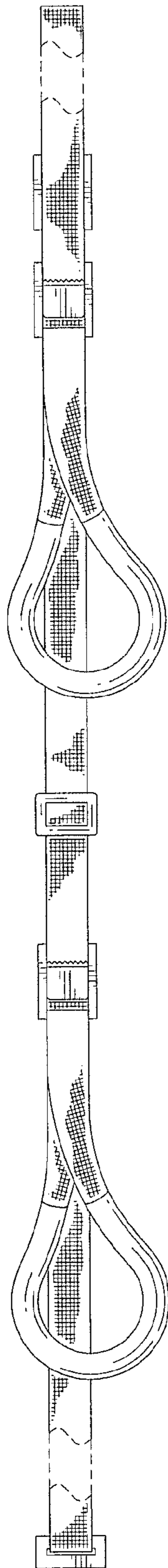

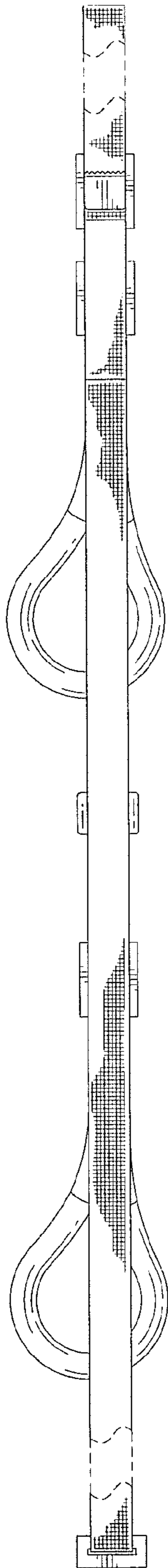

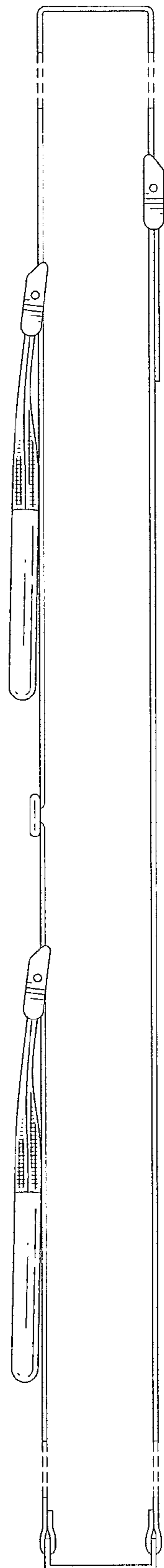

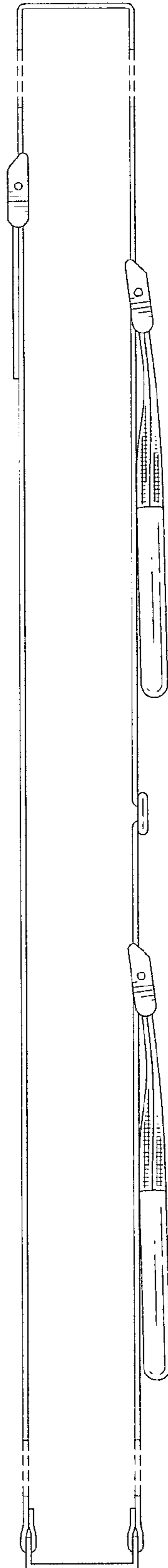

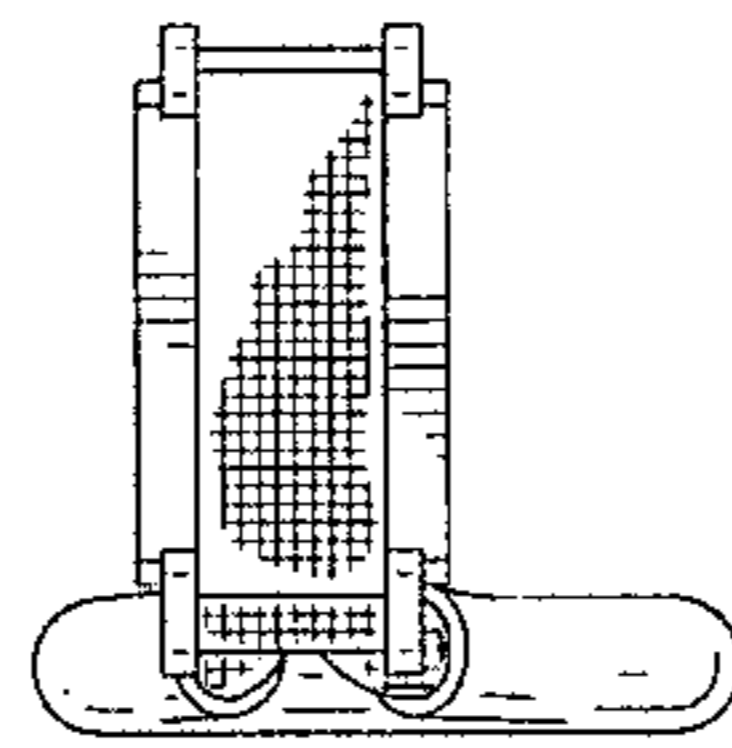

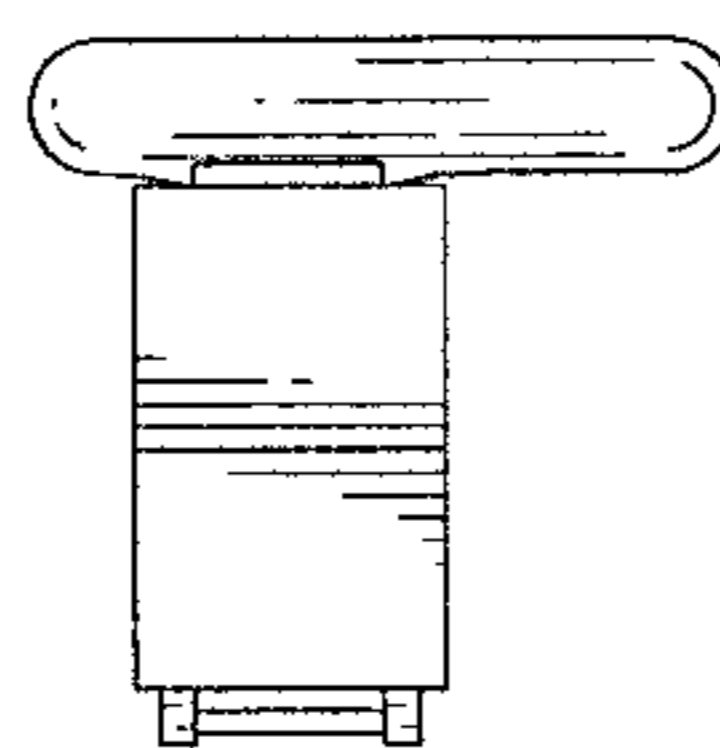

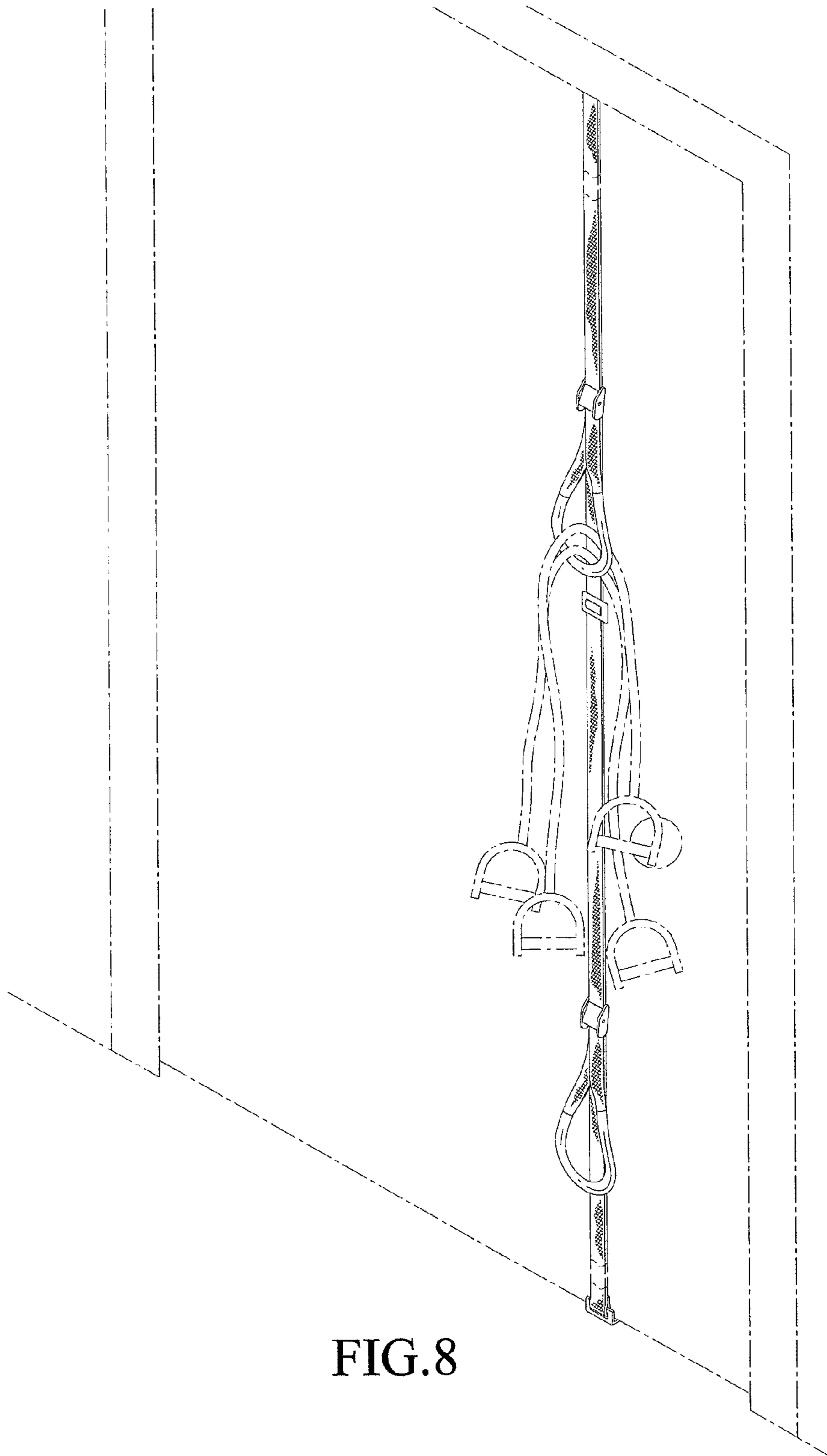
