FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

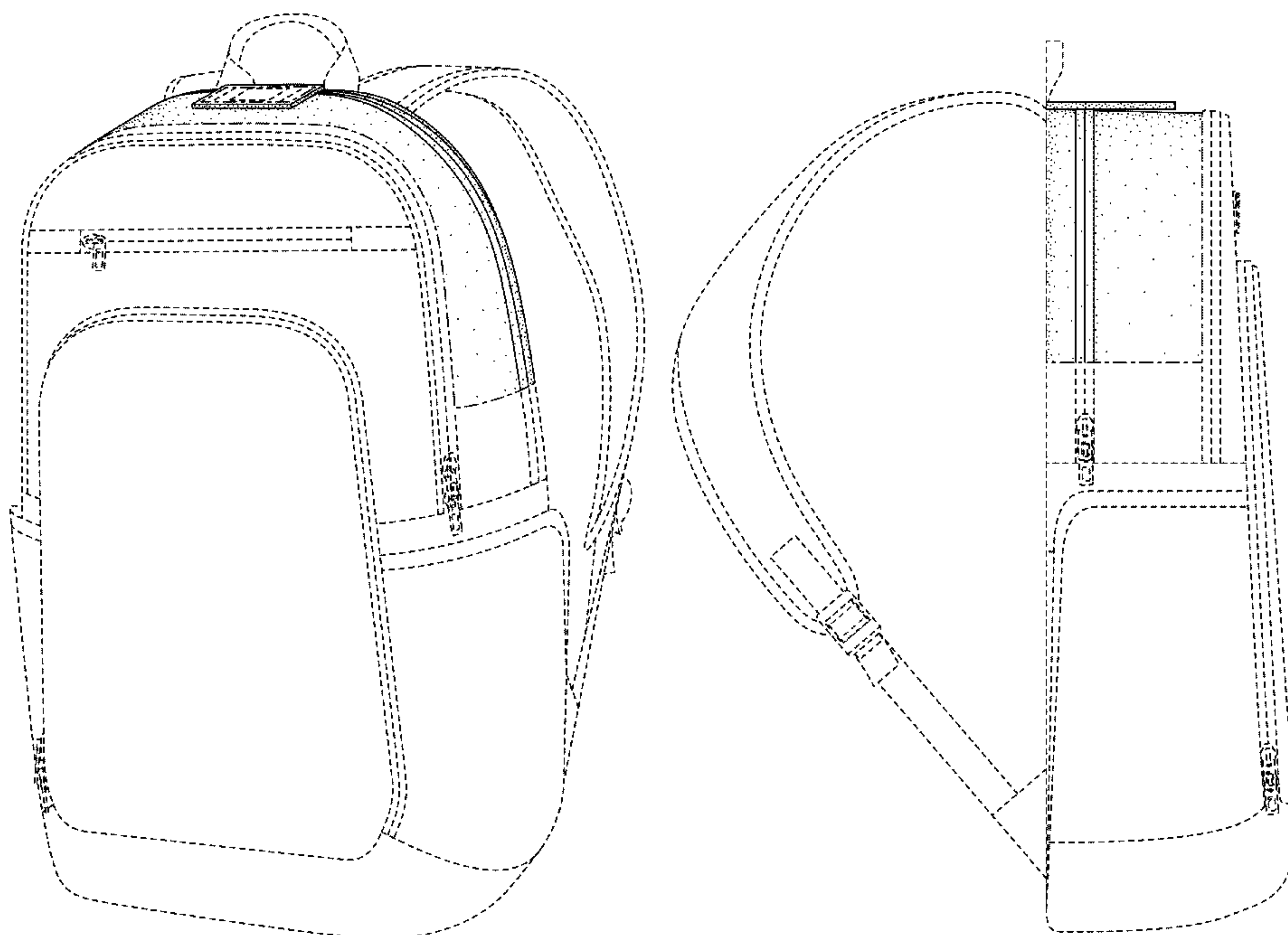
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

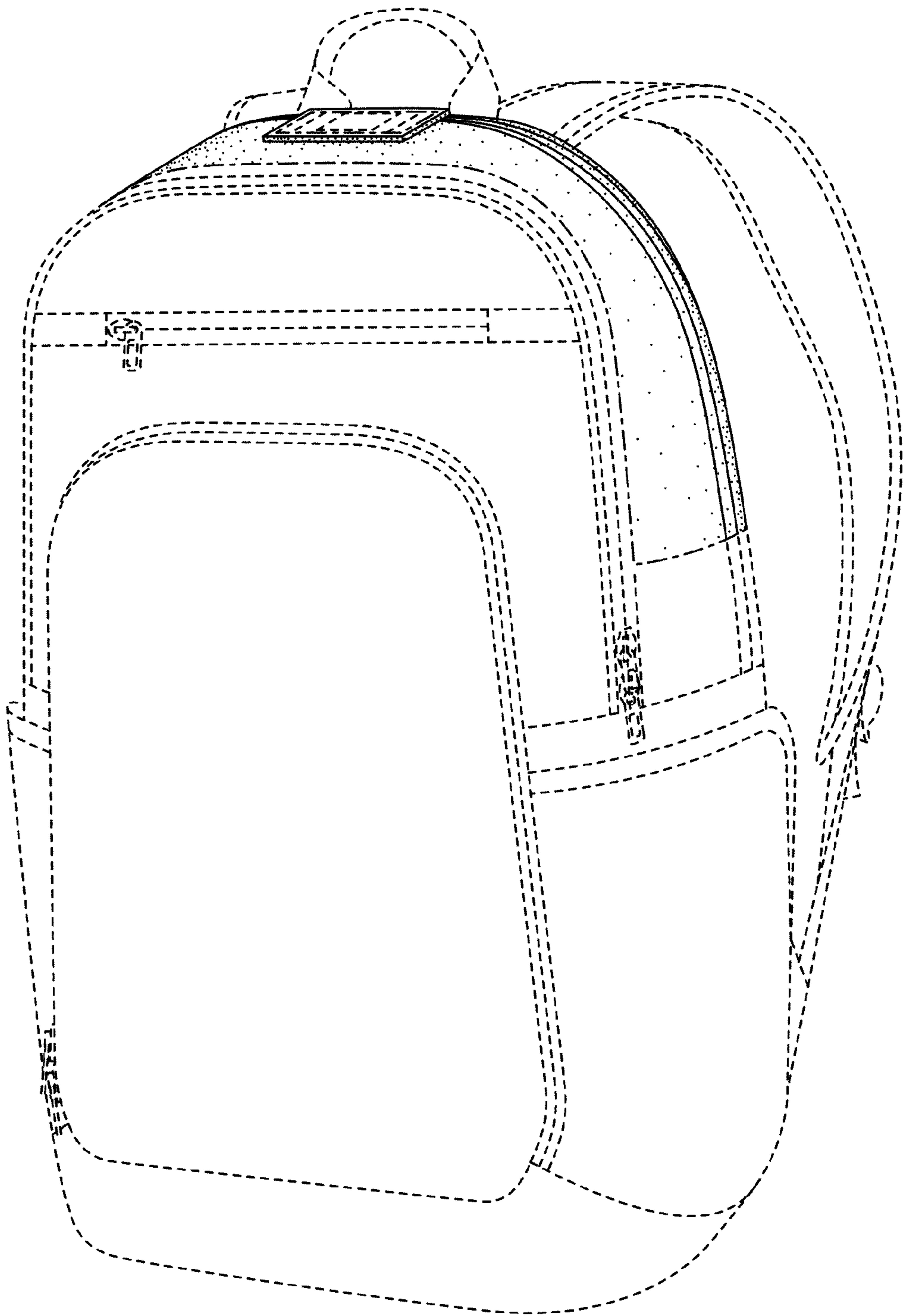

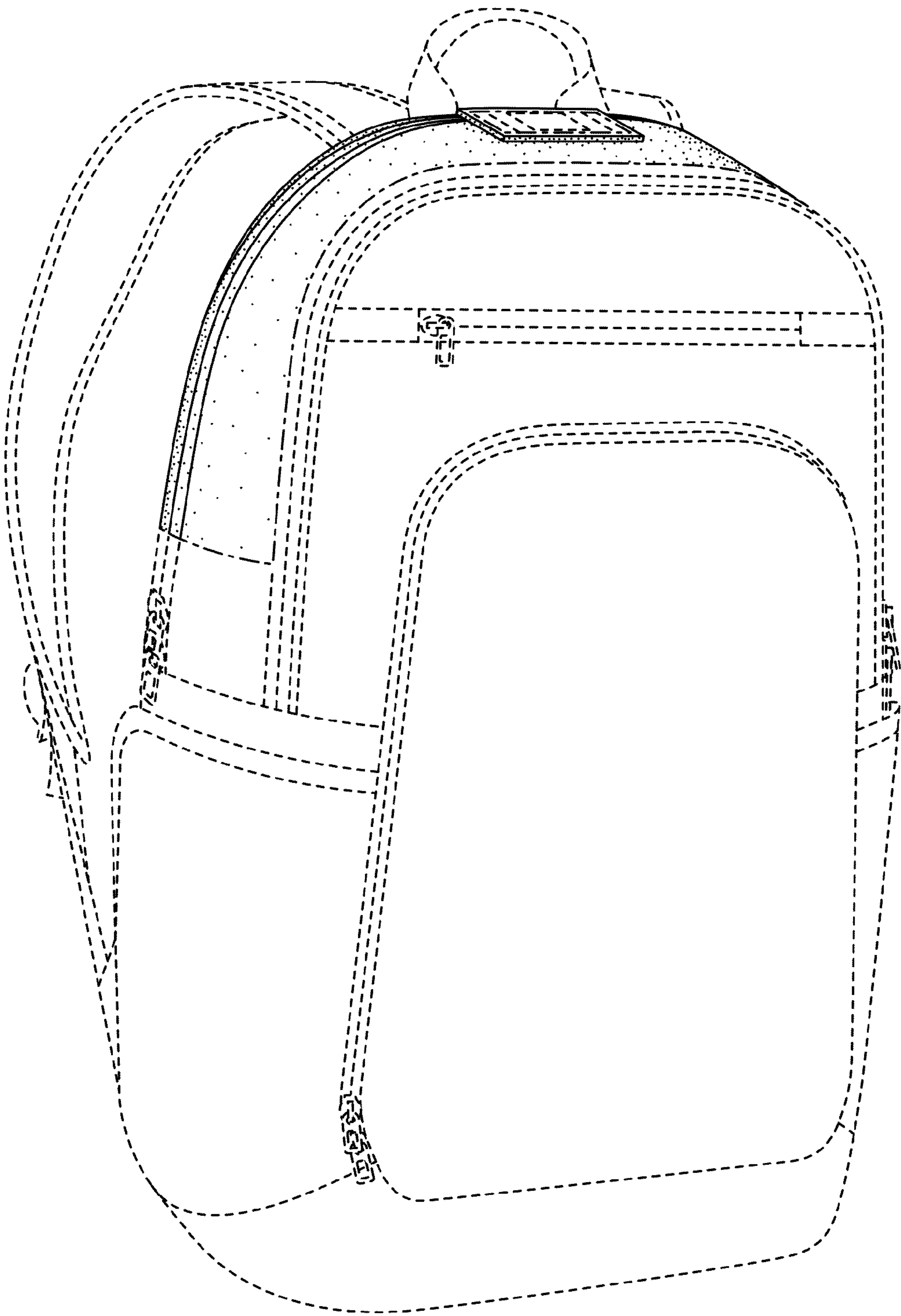

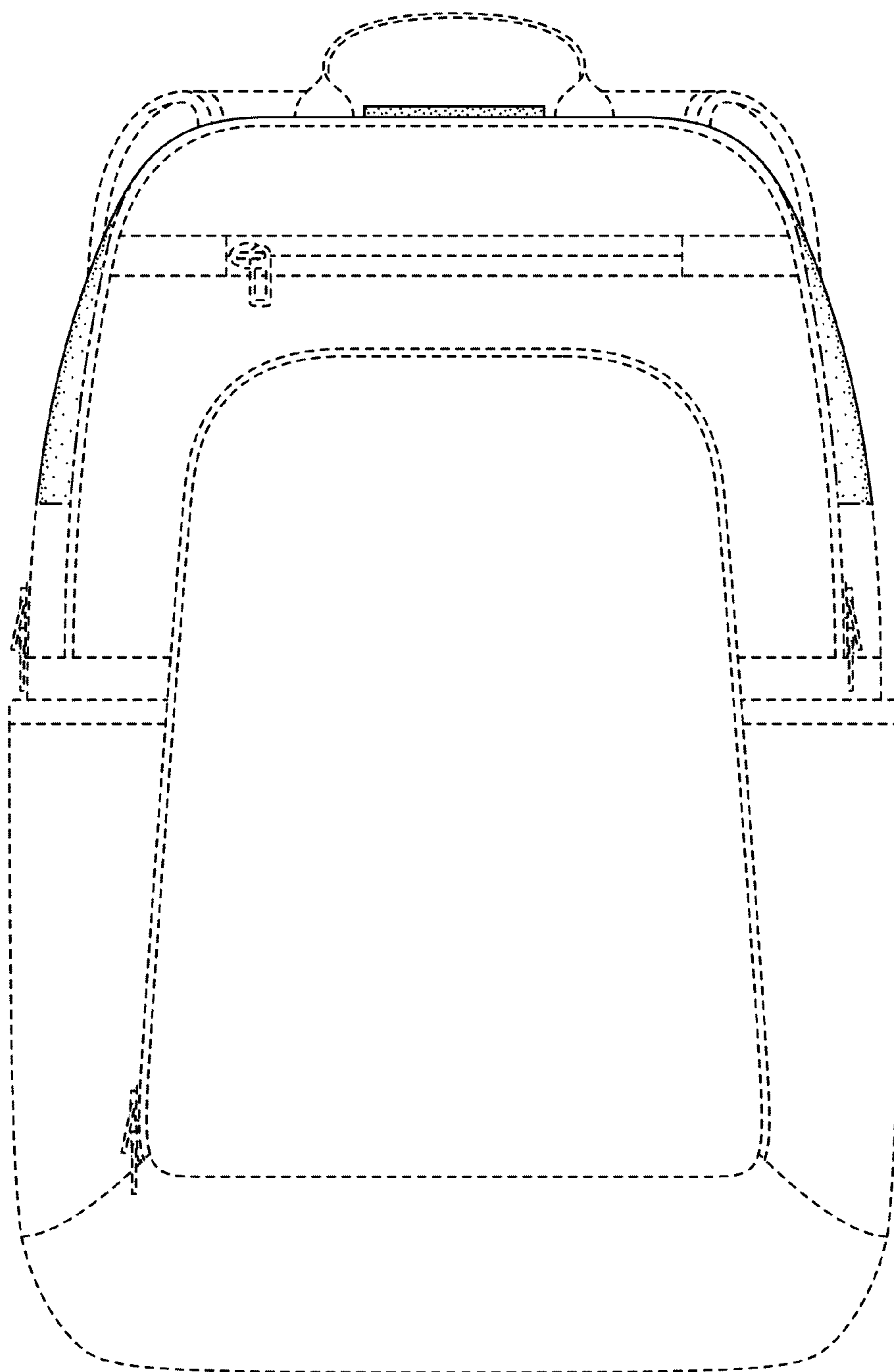

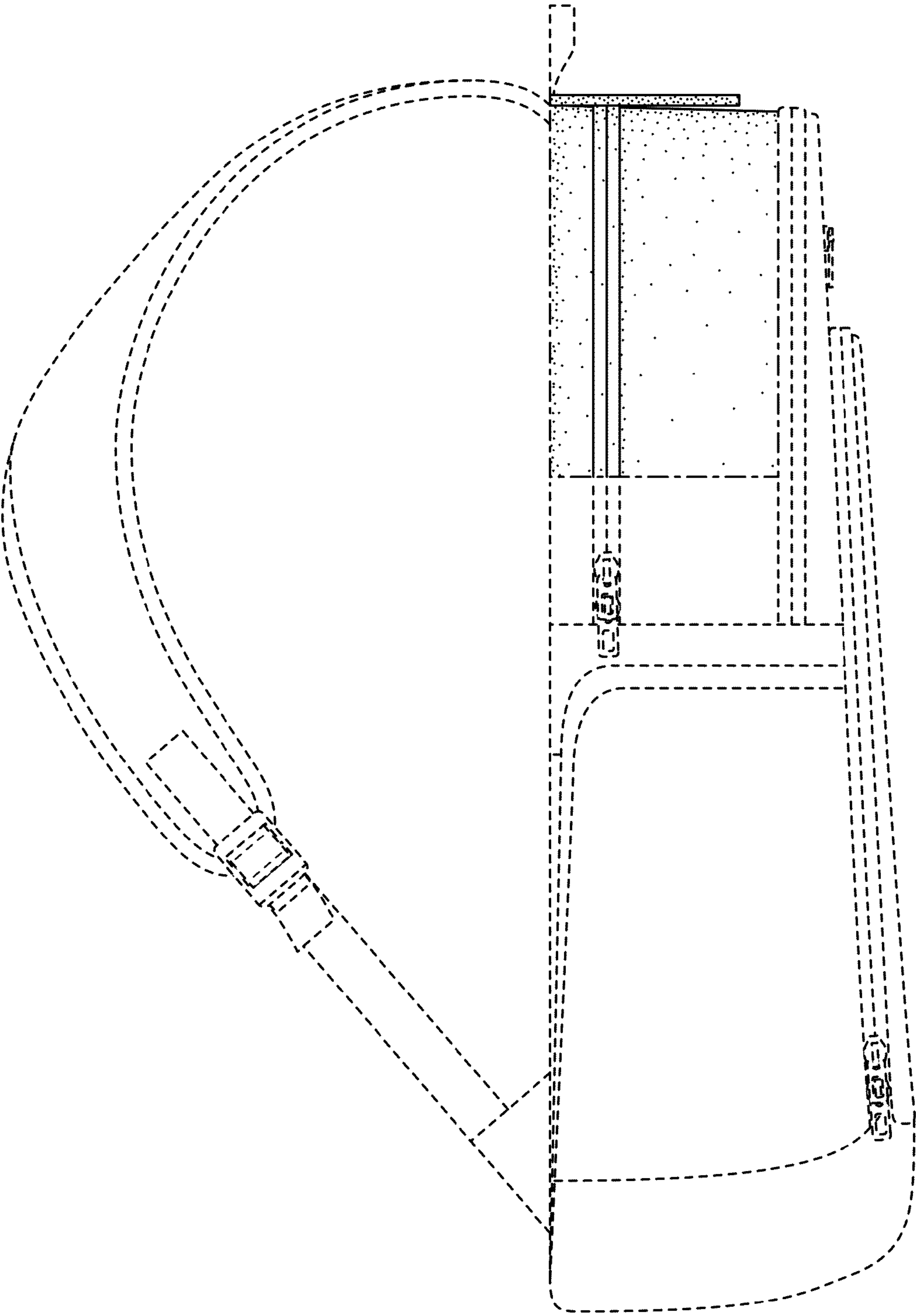

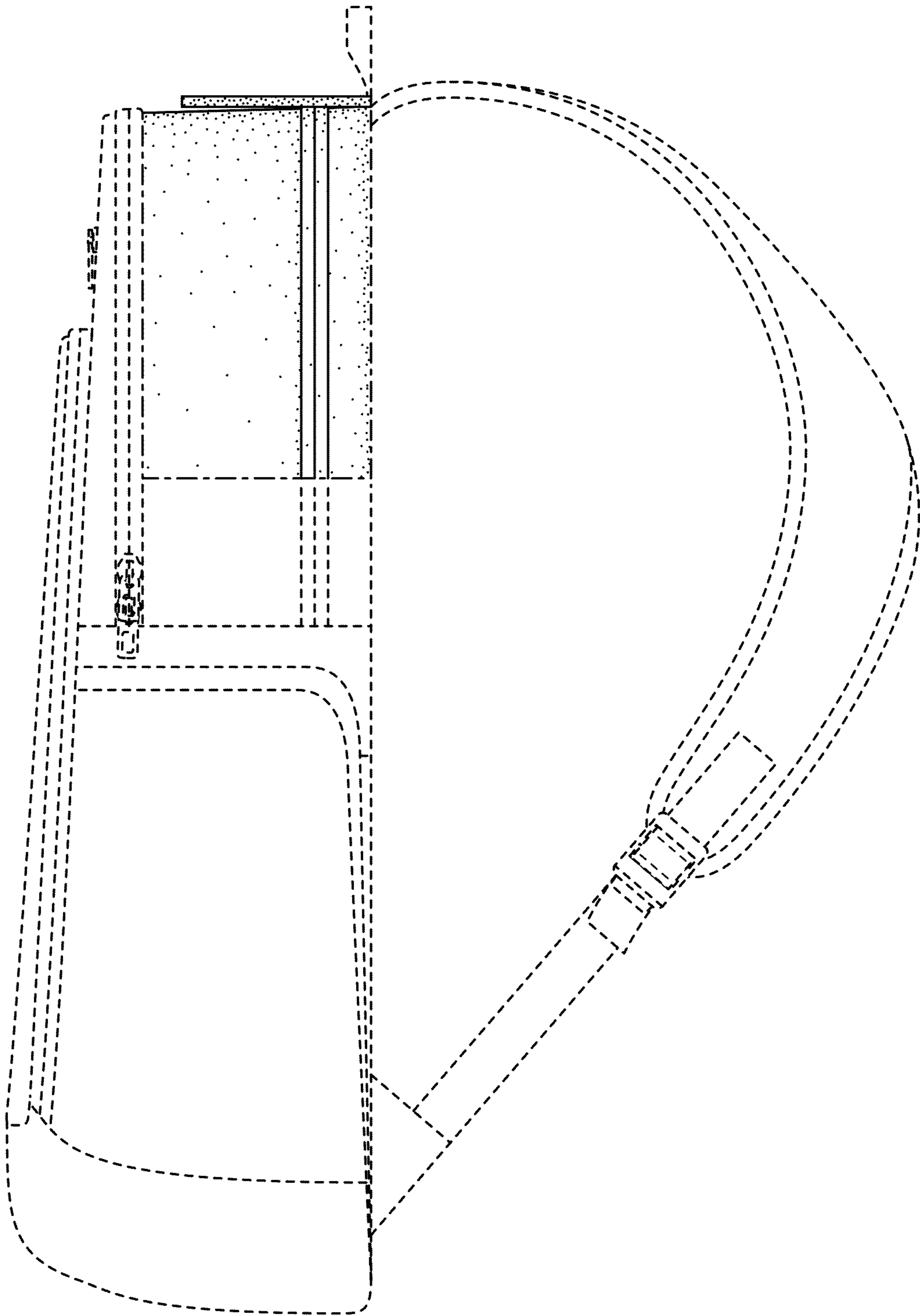

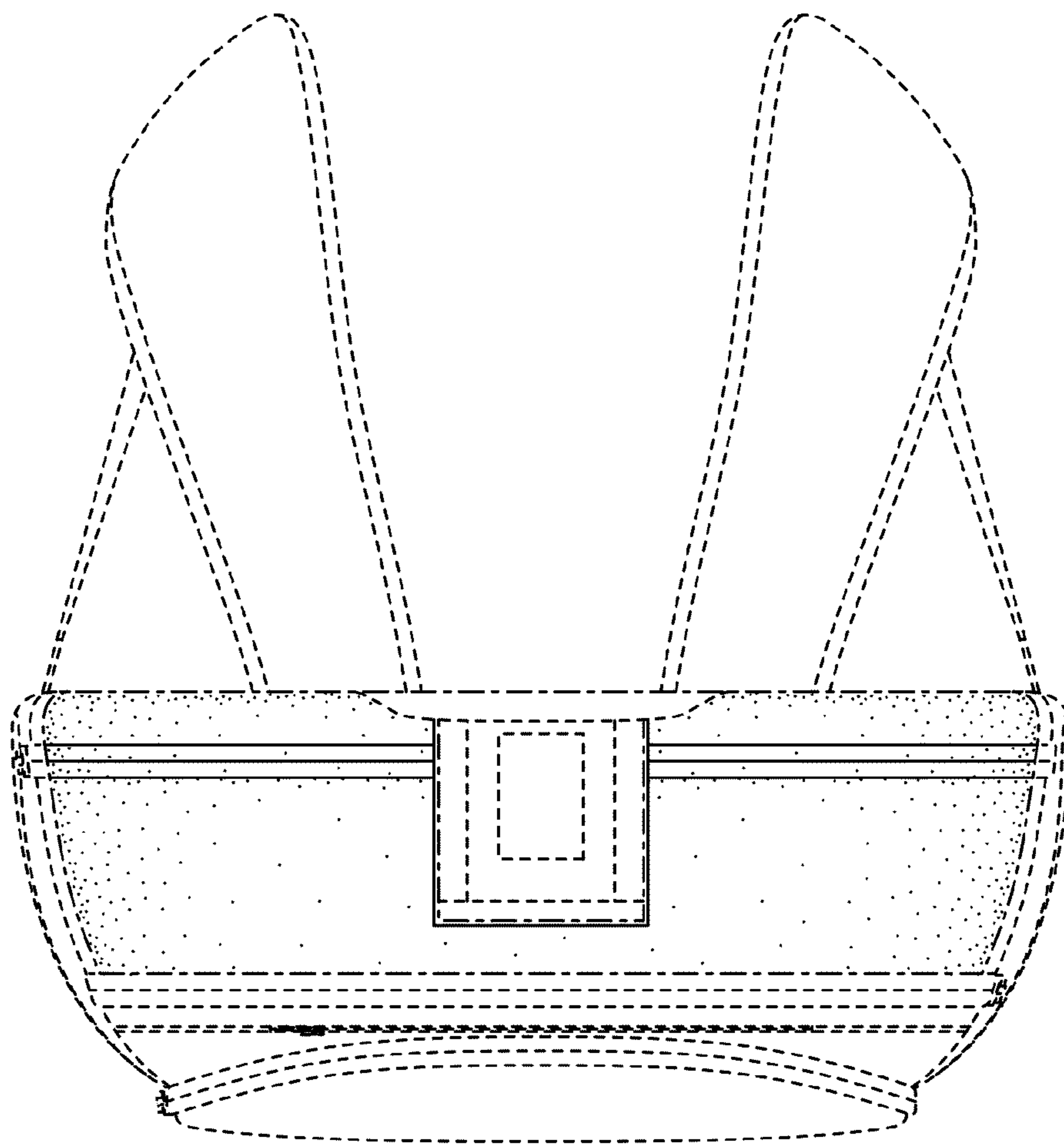
