DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom, and side perspective view of a personal accessory holder in a first position embodying our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a side view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a front, bottom, and side perspective view of the personal accessory holder in a second position.

FIG. 8 is a front view thereof.

FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof.

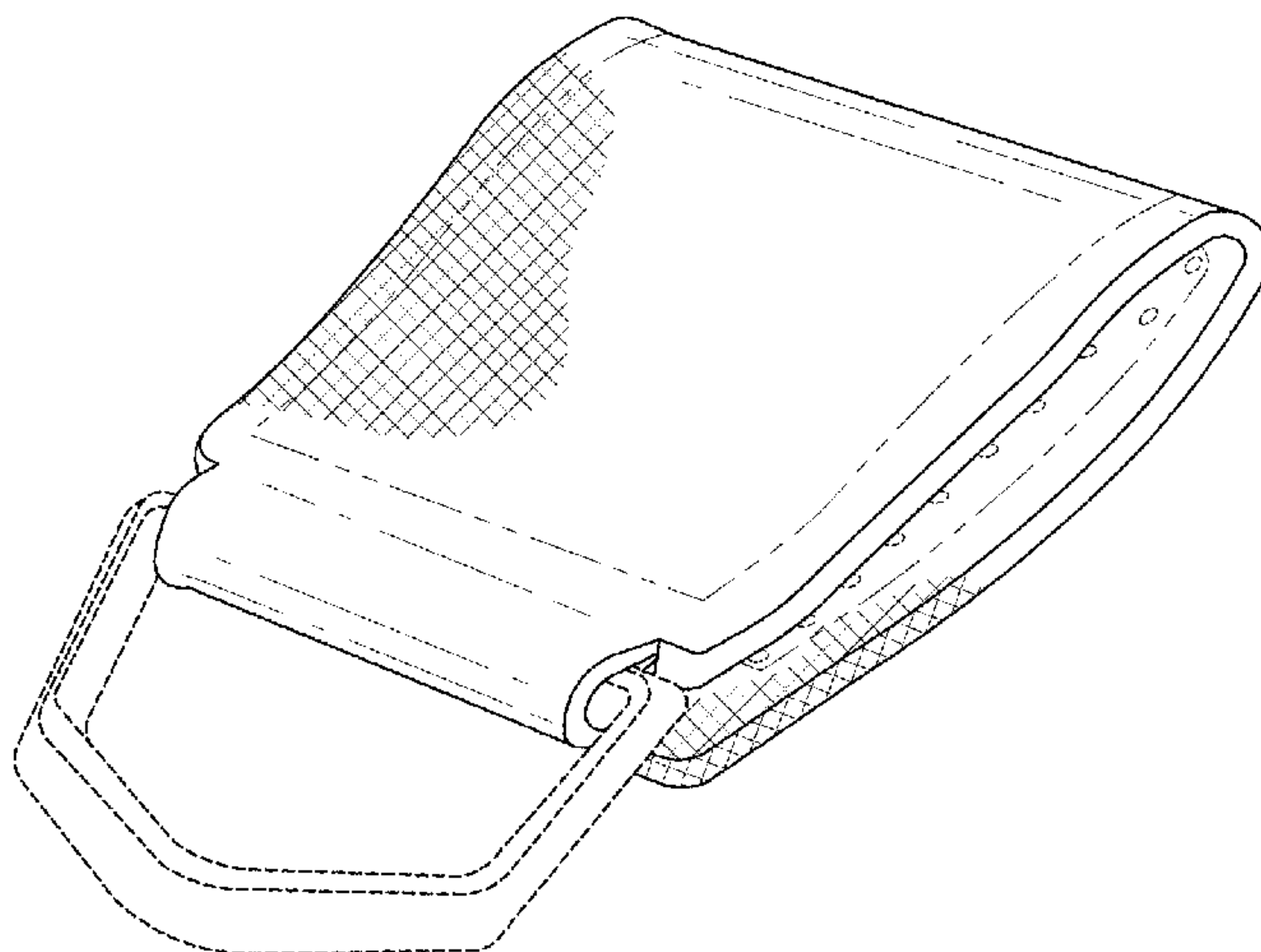
FIG. 10 is a side view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

Broken lines are used to illustrate features of the personal accessory holder which form no part of the claimed design. Cross hatching lines are used to illustrate representative surface shading. Dash dot dot lines illustrate stitching on the main body which forms no part of the claimed design. The personal accessory hanger is shown in broken lines which form no part of the claimed design. Features on the back of the main body in the second position, including a magnetic clasp, are shown in broken lines which form no part of the claimed design of the second embodiment. The first position illustrates a typical in use orientation.

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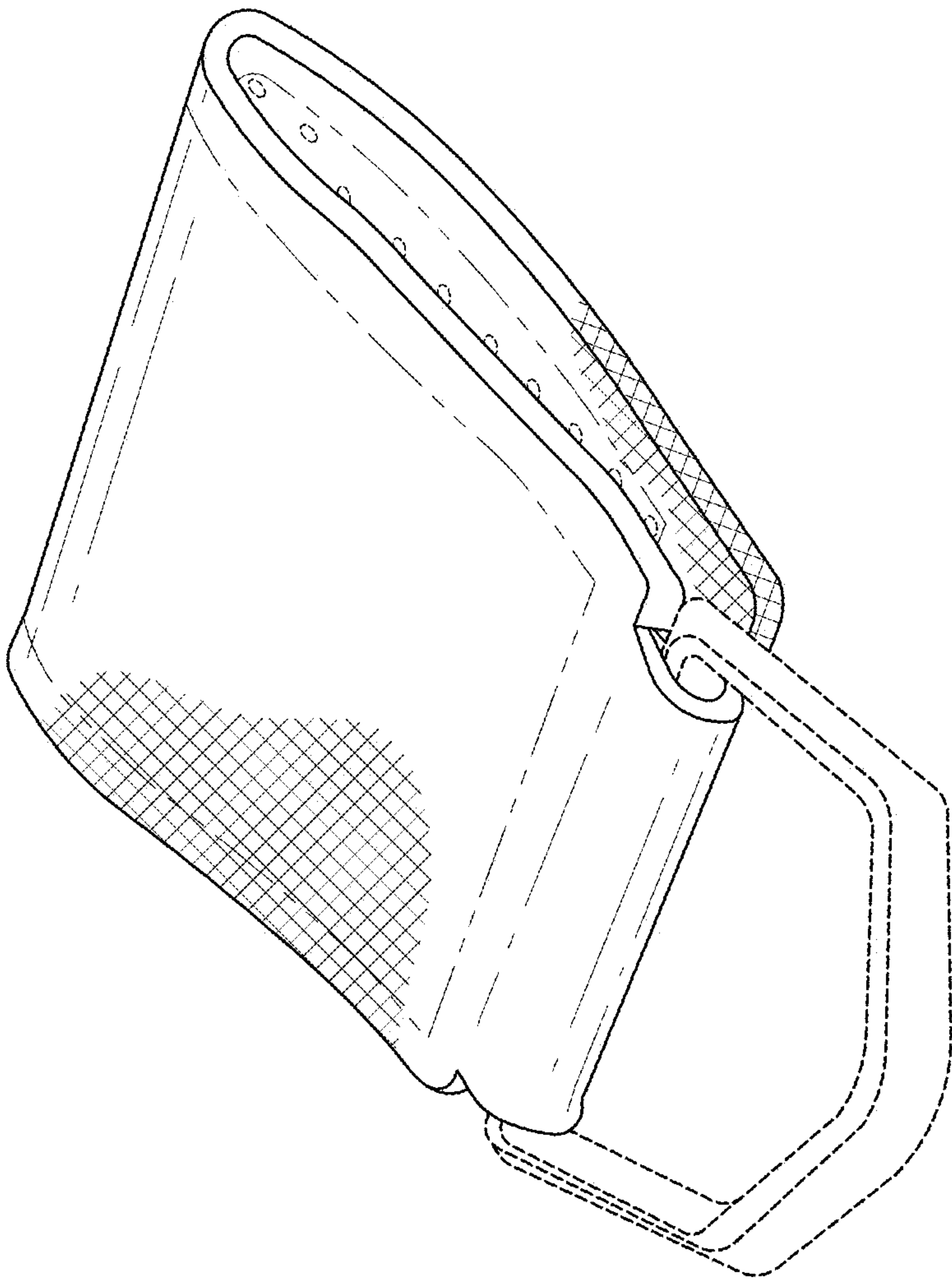

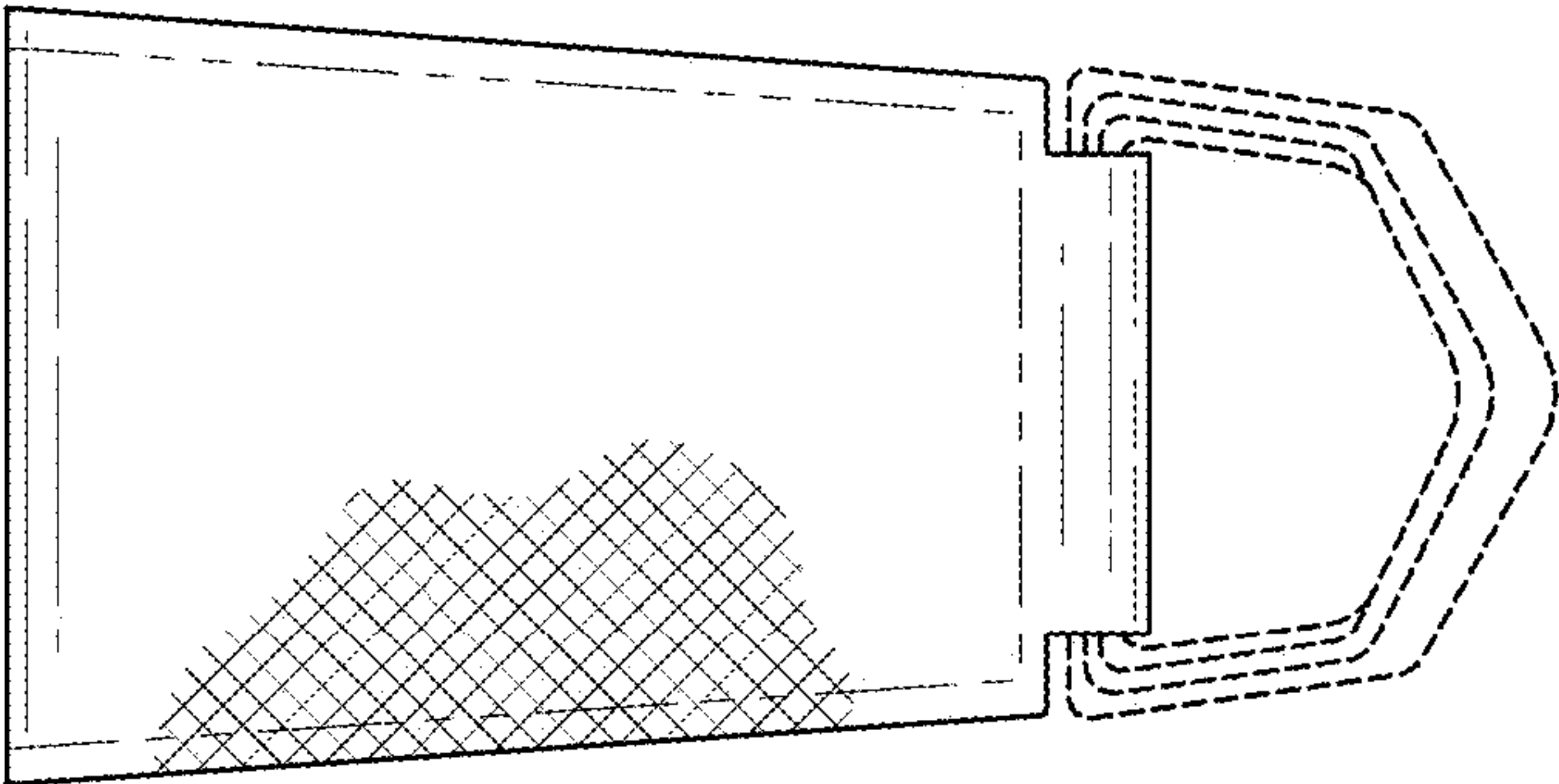

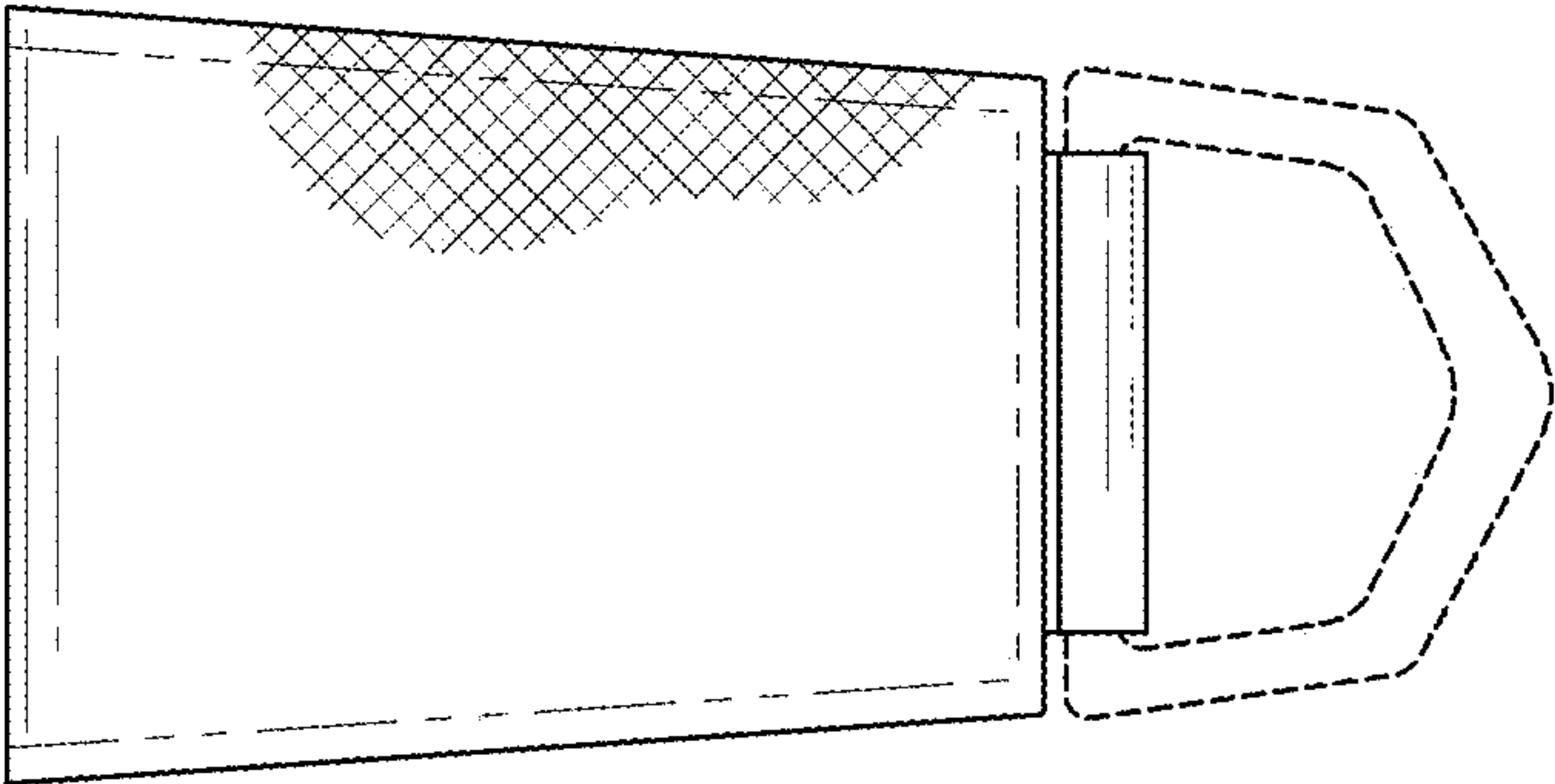

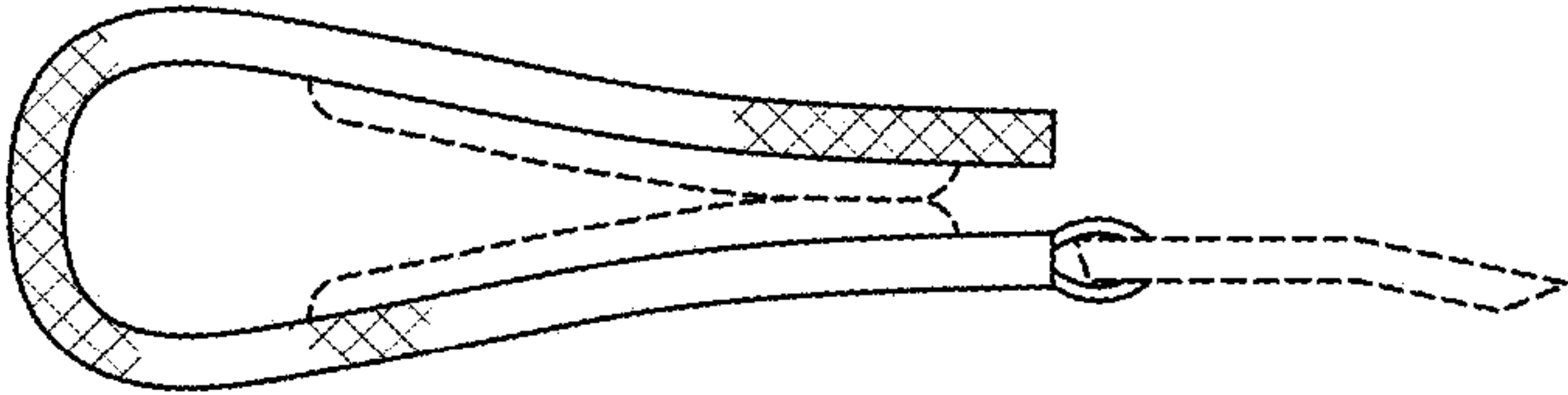

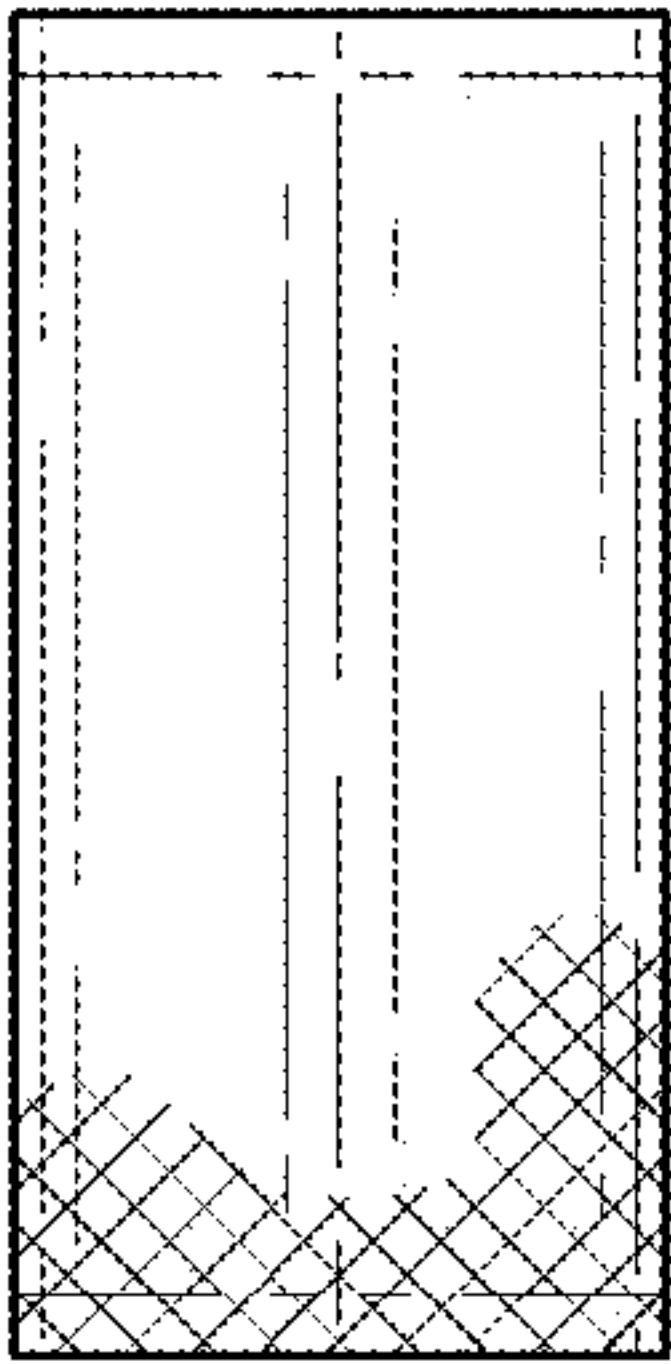

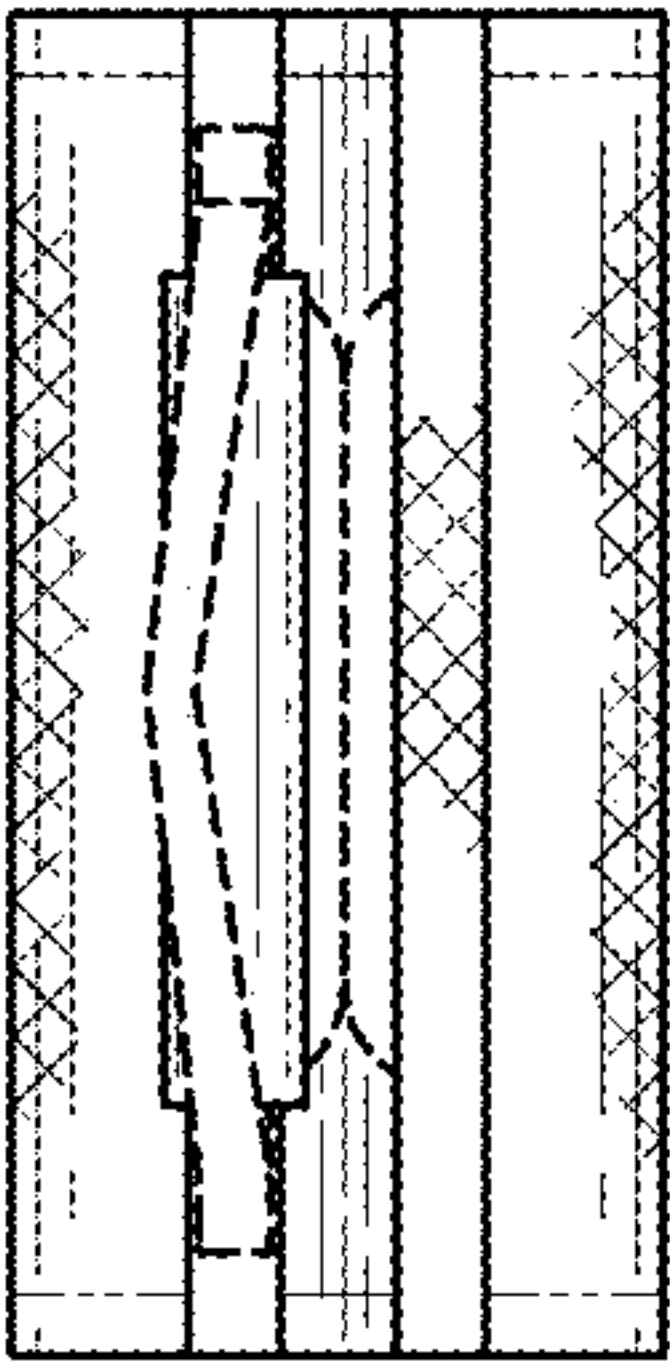

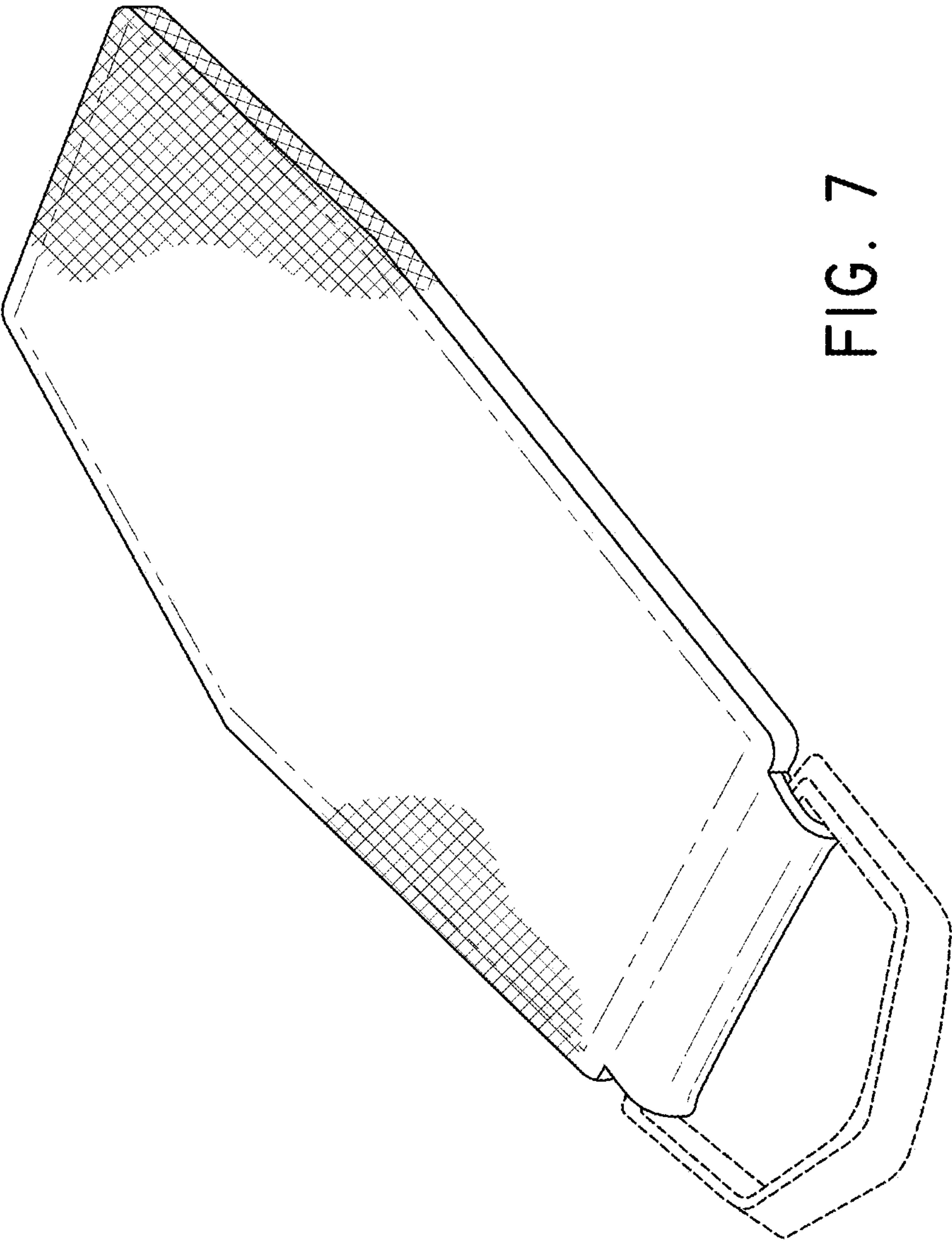

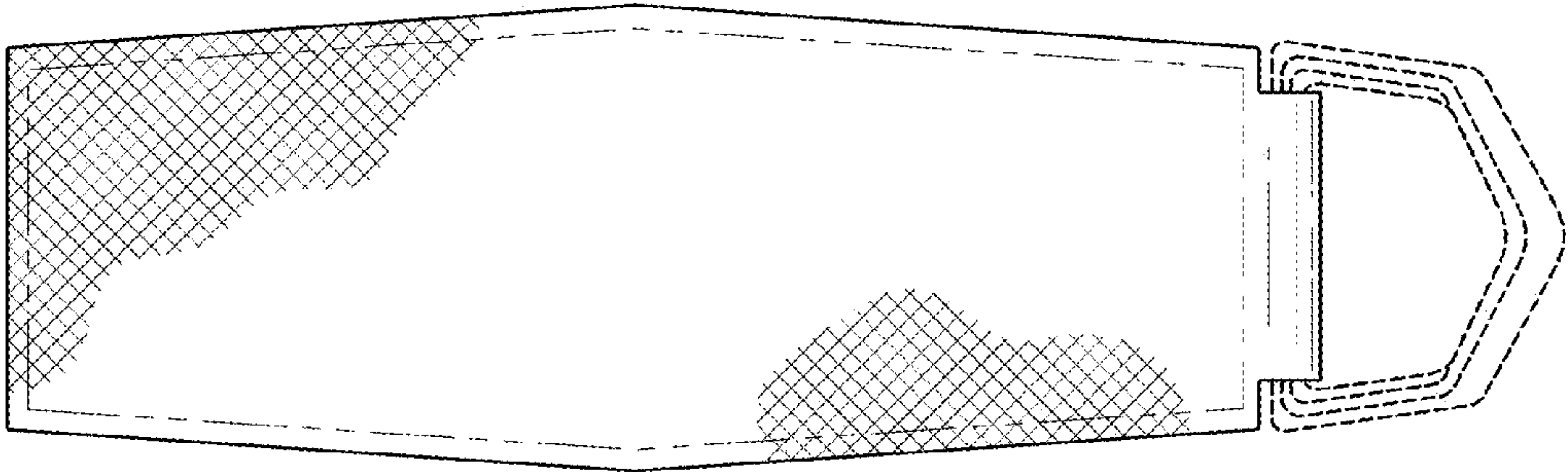

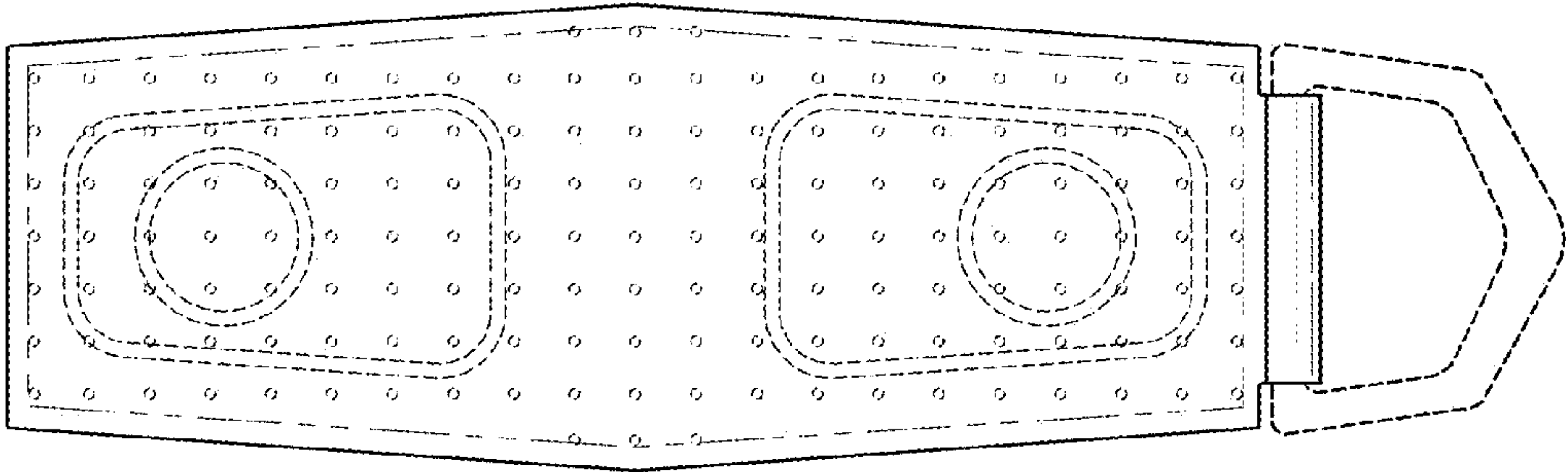

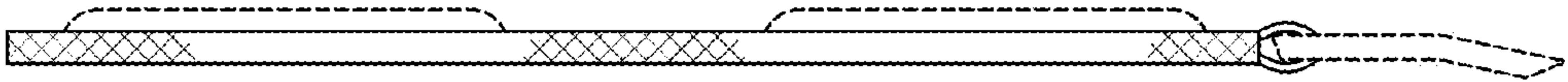
