The ornamental design for a stalk holder and wire spacer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a stalk holder and wire spacer. FIG. 2 is a top plan view, from the side opposite to the view of FIG. 1, of a stalk holder and wire spacer.

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the stalk holder and wire spacer of FIG. 1 or FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is an end elevation view of the stalk holder and wire spacer of FIG. 1 viewing from the closed end of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is an end elevation view of the stalk holder and wire spacer of FIG. 2 viewing from the open end of FIG. 2.

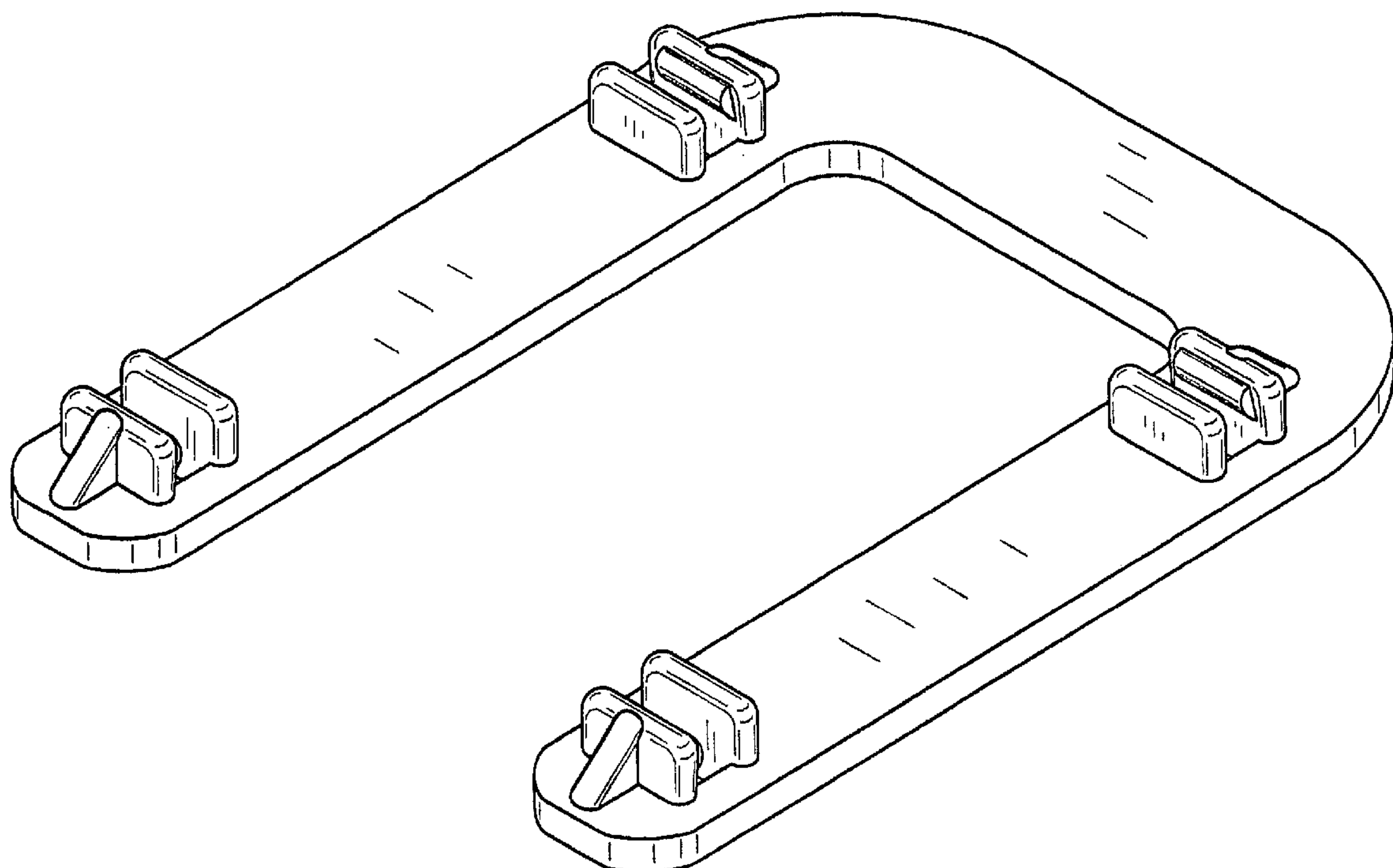
FIG. 6 is an isometric view from its bottom of the stalk holder and wire spacer as shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is an isometric view from its top of the stalk holder and wire spacer as shown in FIG. 2; and,

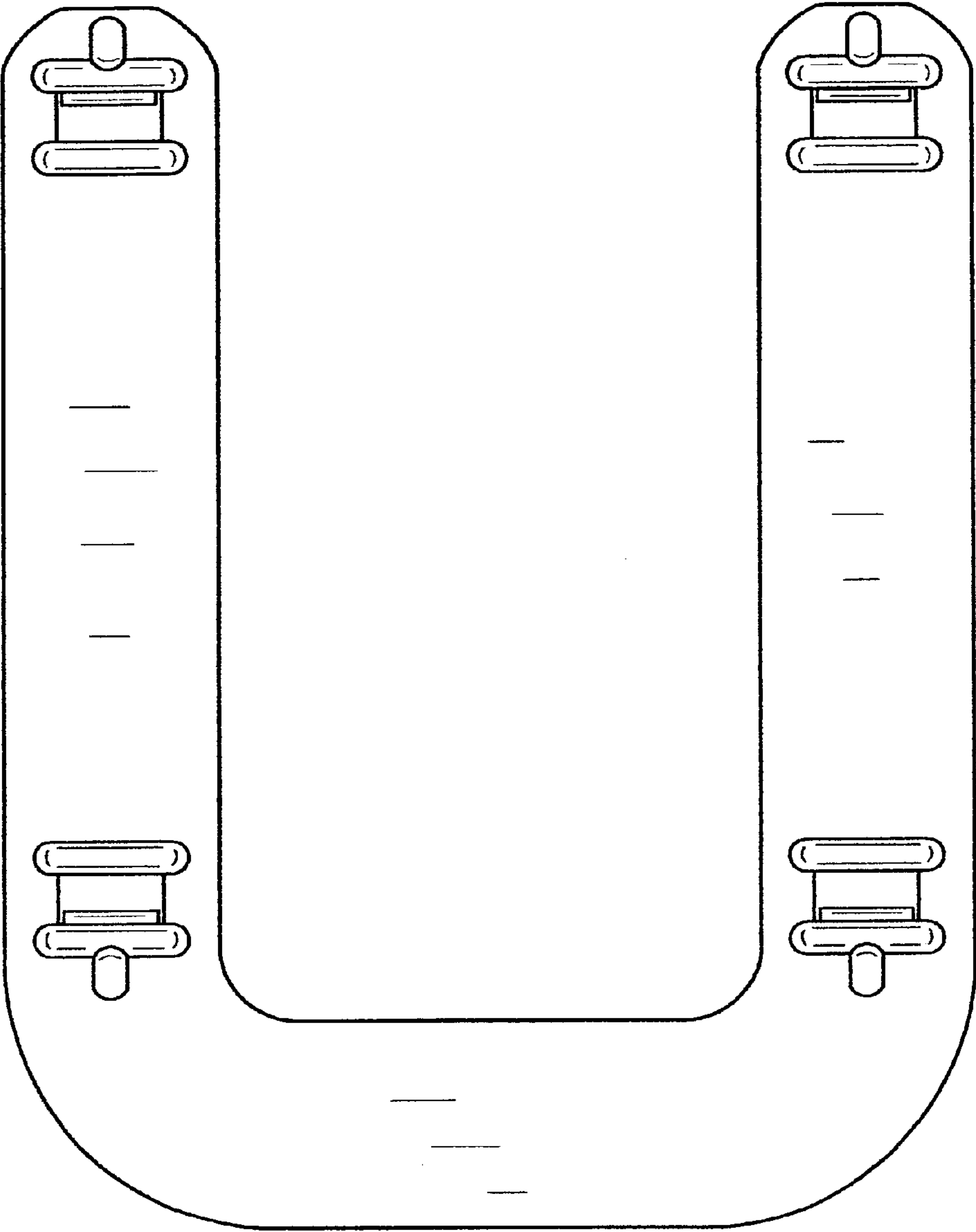

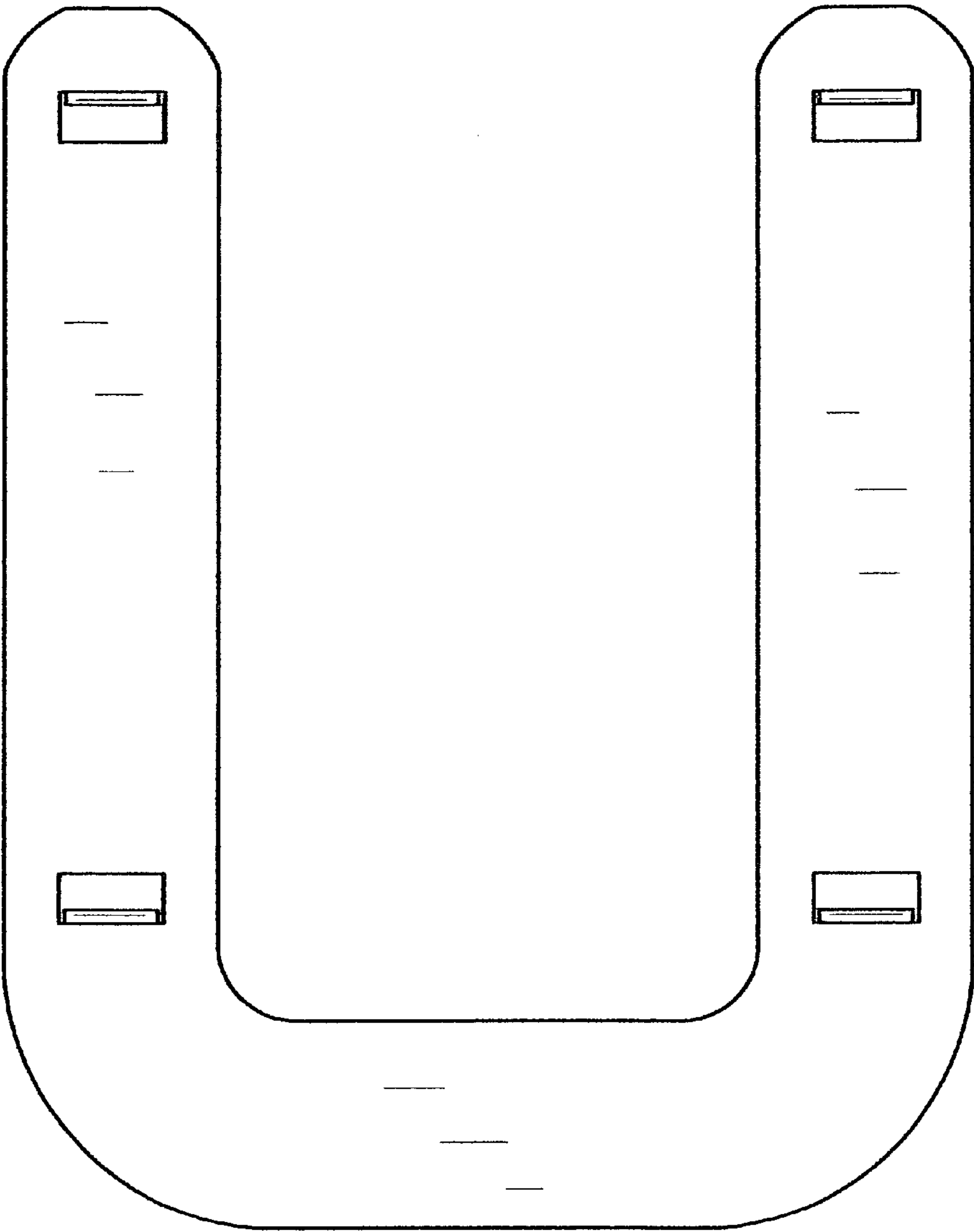

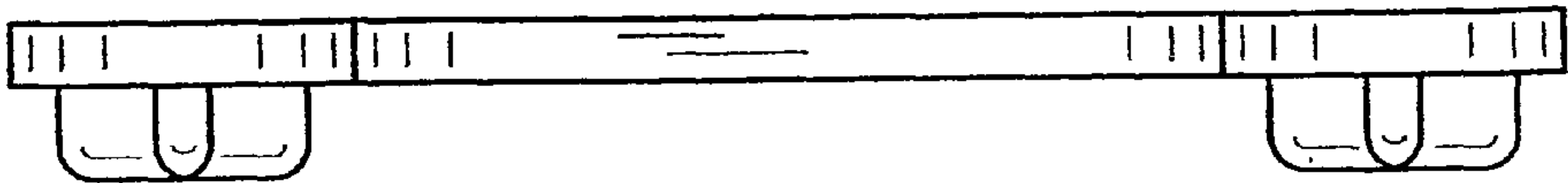

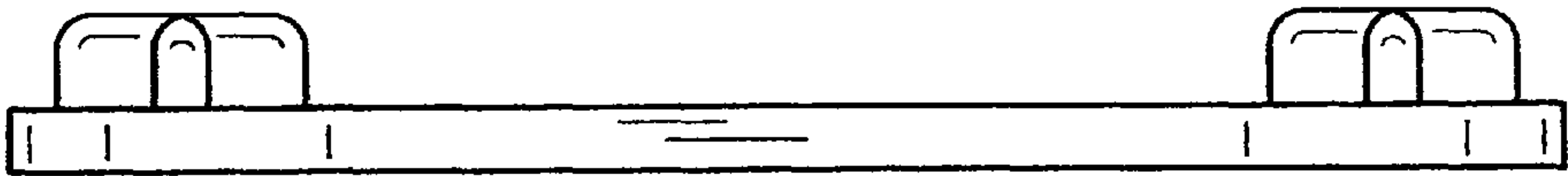

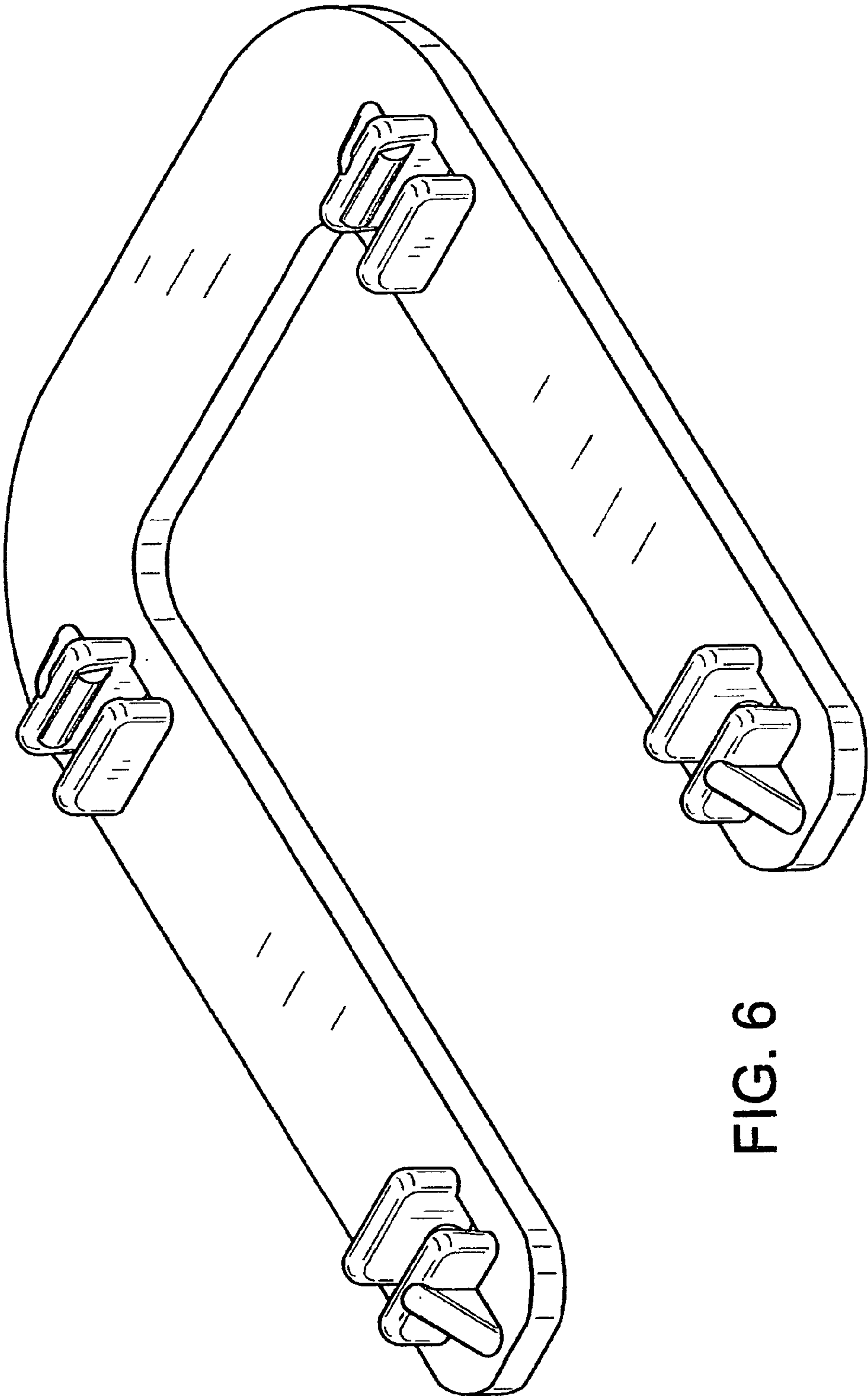

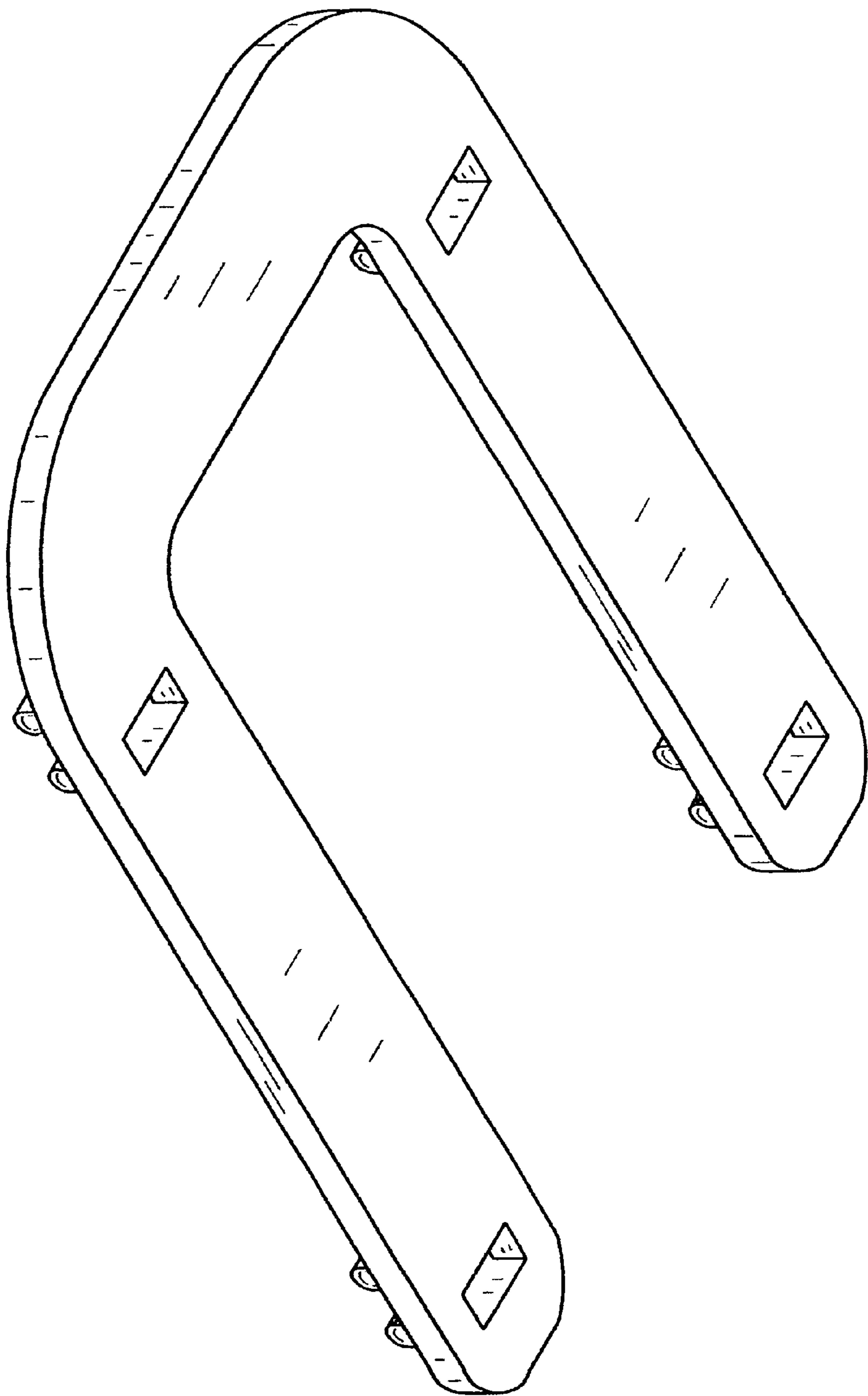
