(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a slotted head spoon with silicone end, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the spoon with slotted head with silicone end showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the spoon with slotted head with silicone end of our new design;


FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the spoon with slotted head with silicone end of our new design;










