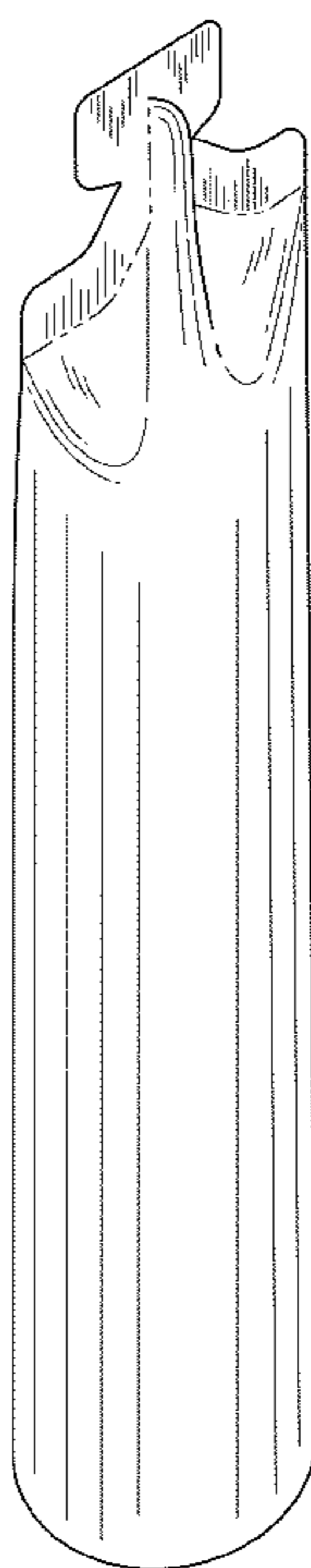
(57) **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for a flexible pouch, as shown and described.

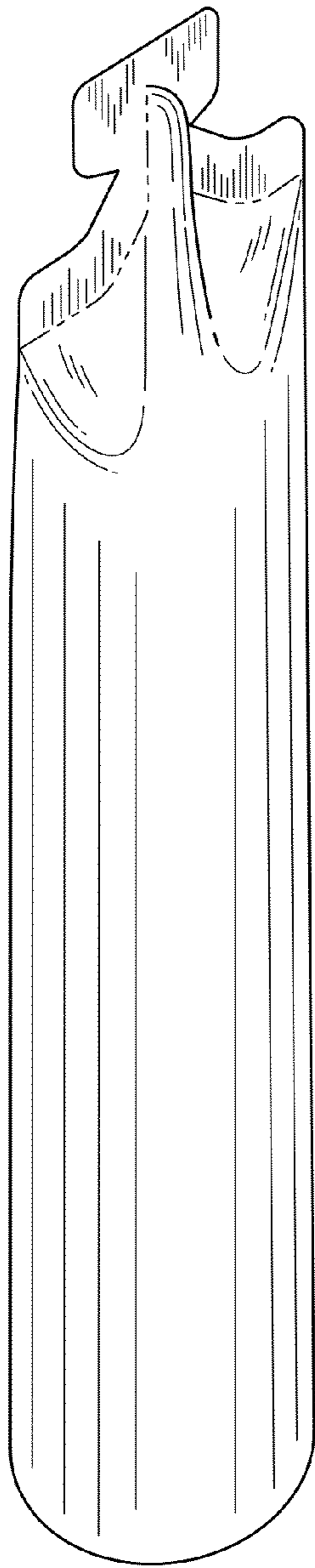
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front of a flexible pouch;

It should be appreciated that the broken lines are merely illustrative of the environment of the design, and not part of the claimed design.

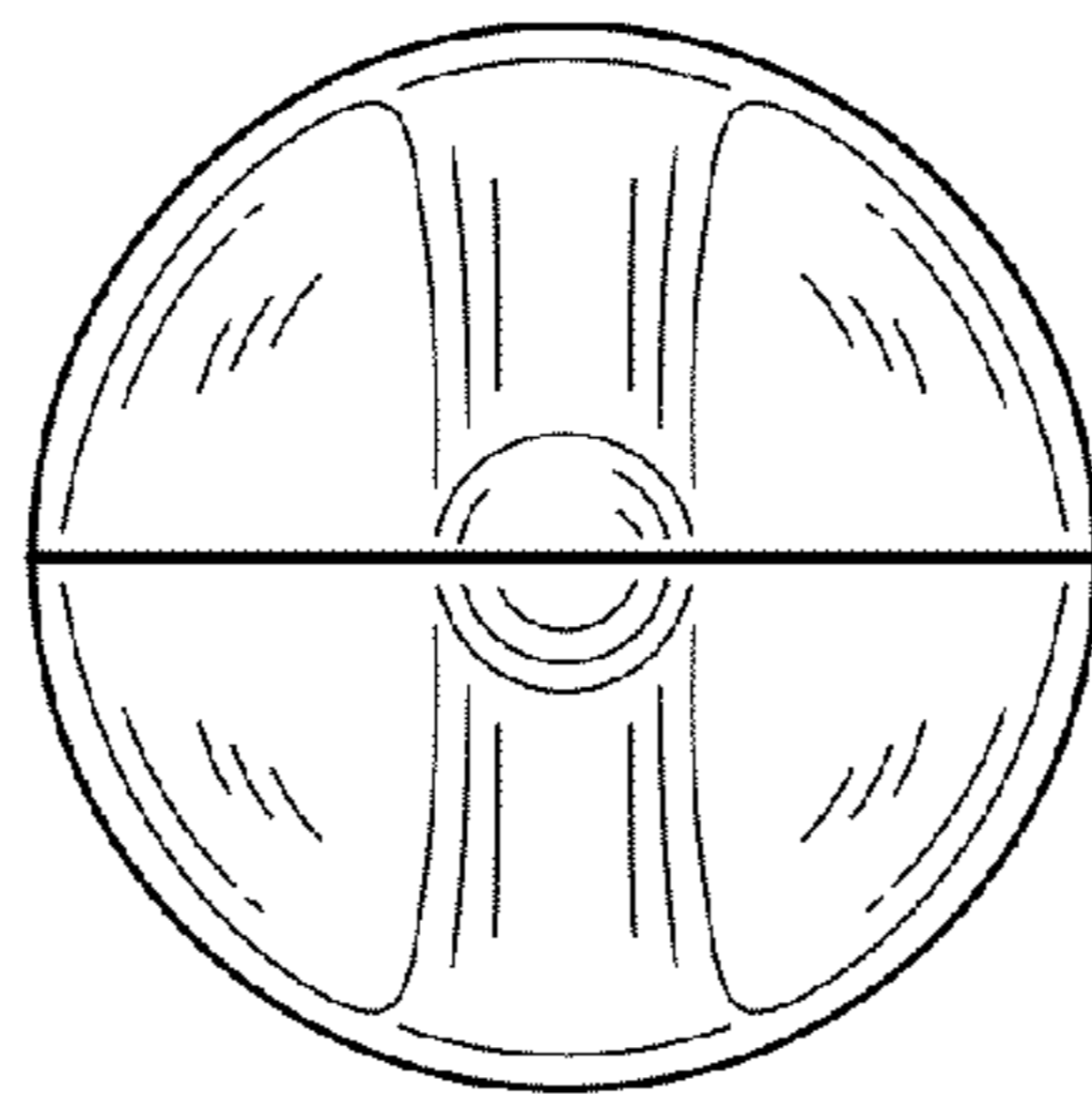

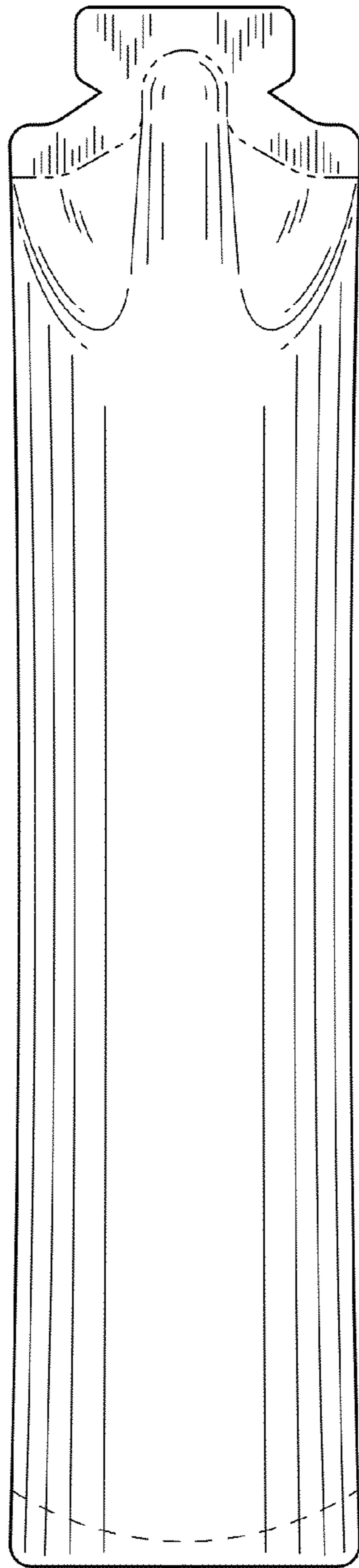




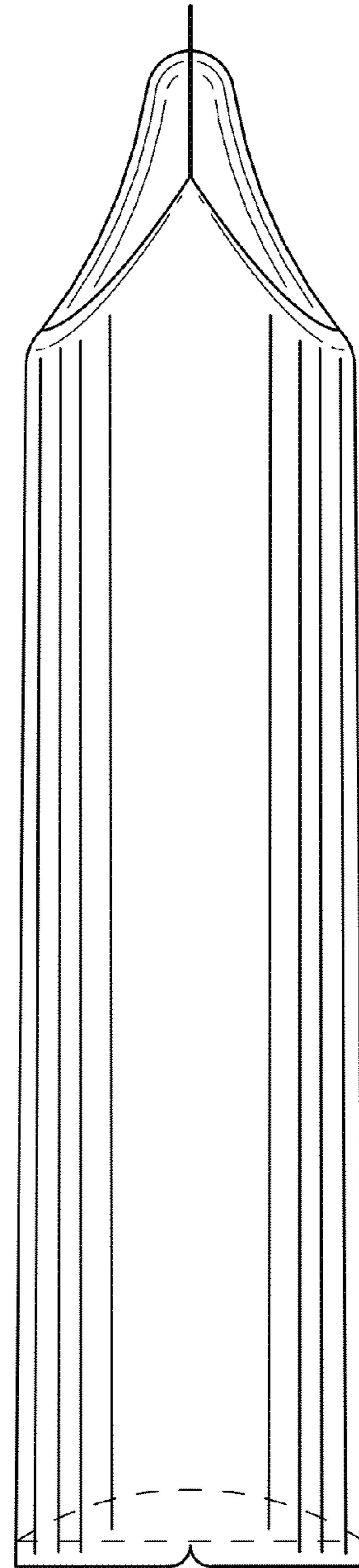

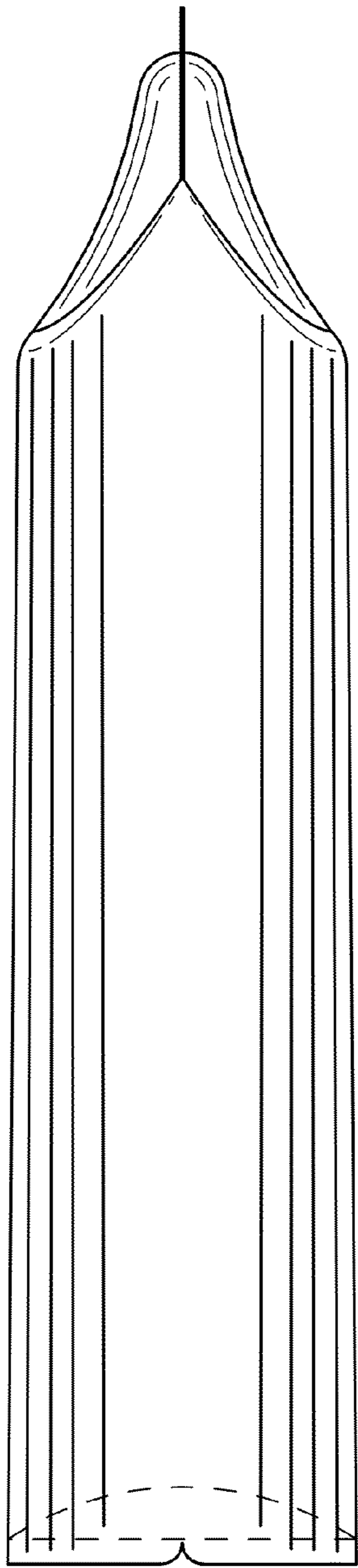

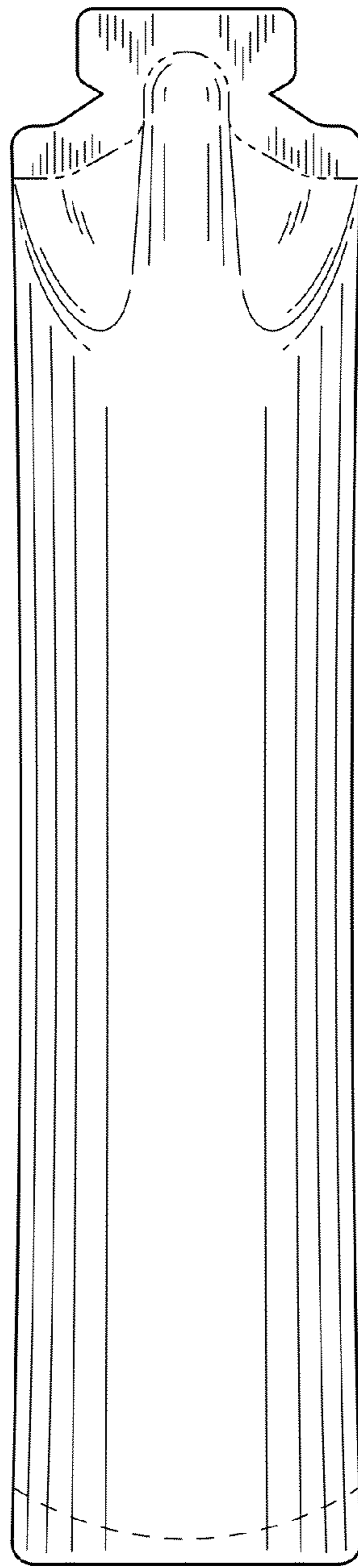

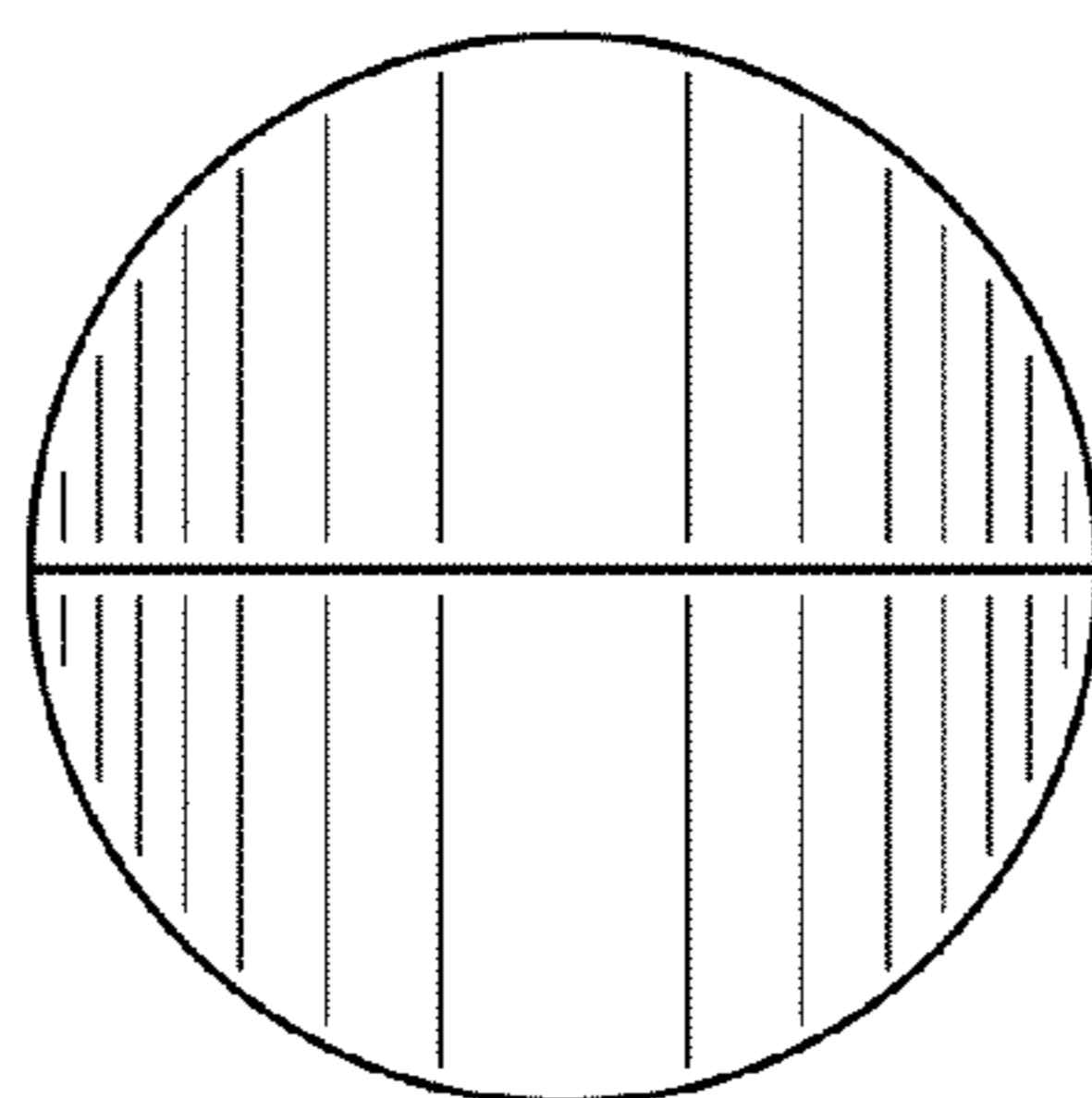
