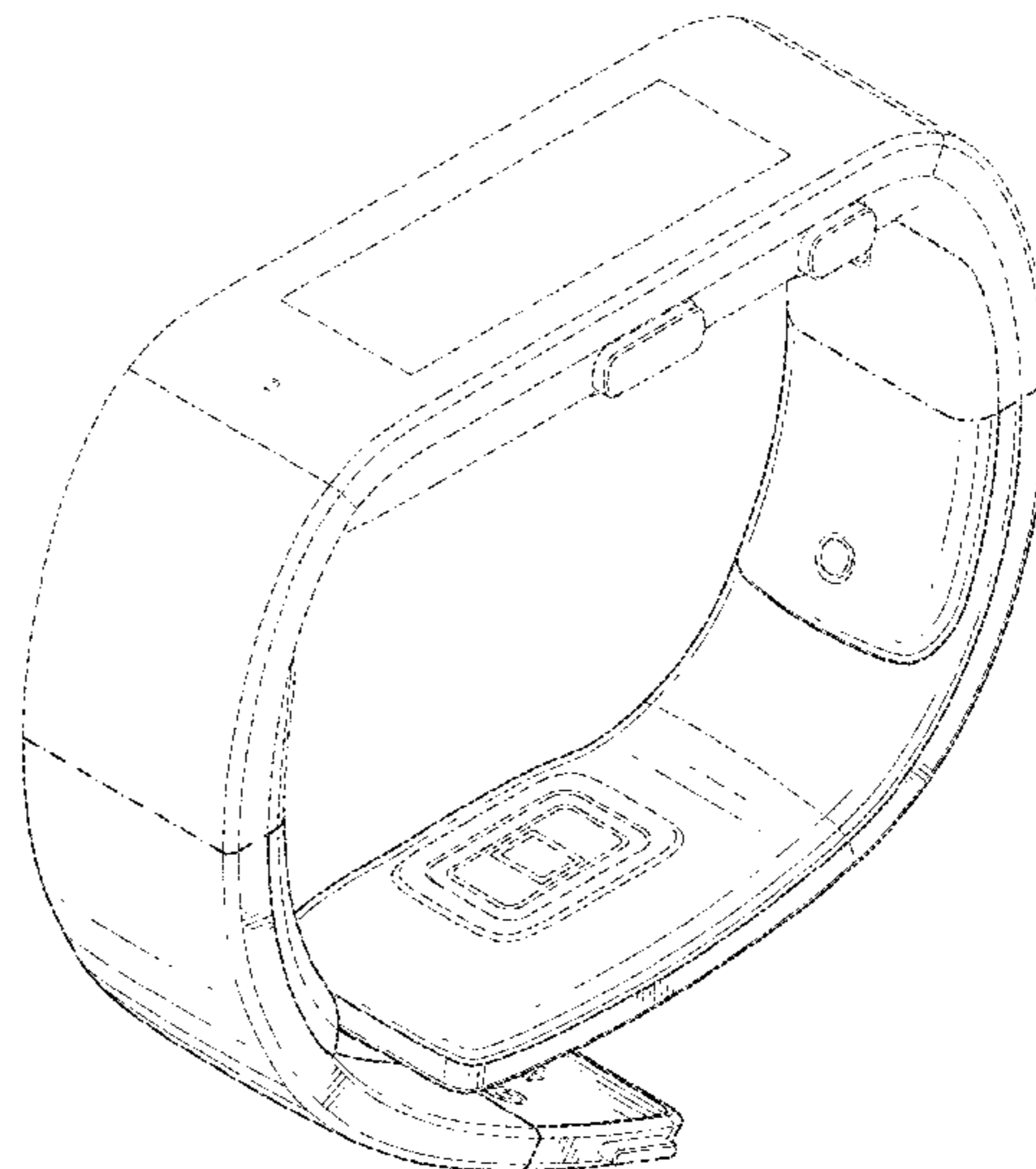
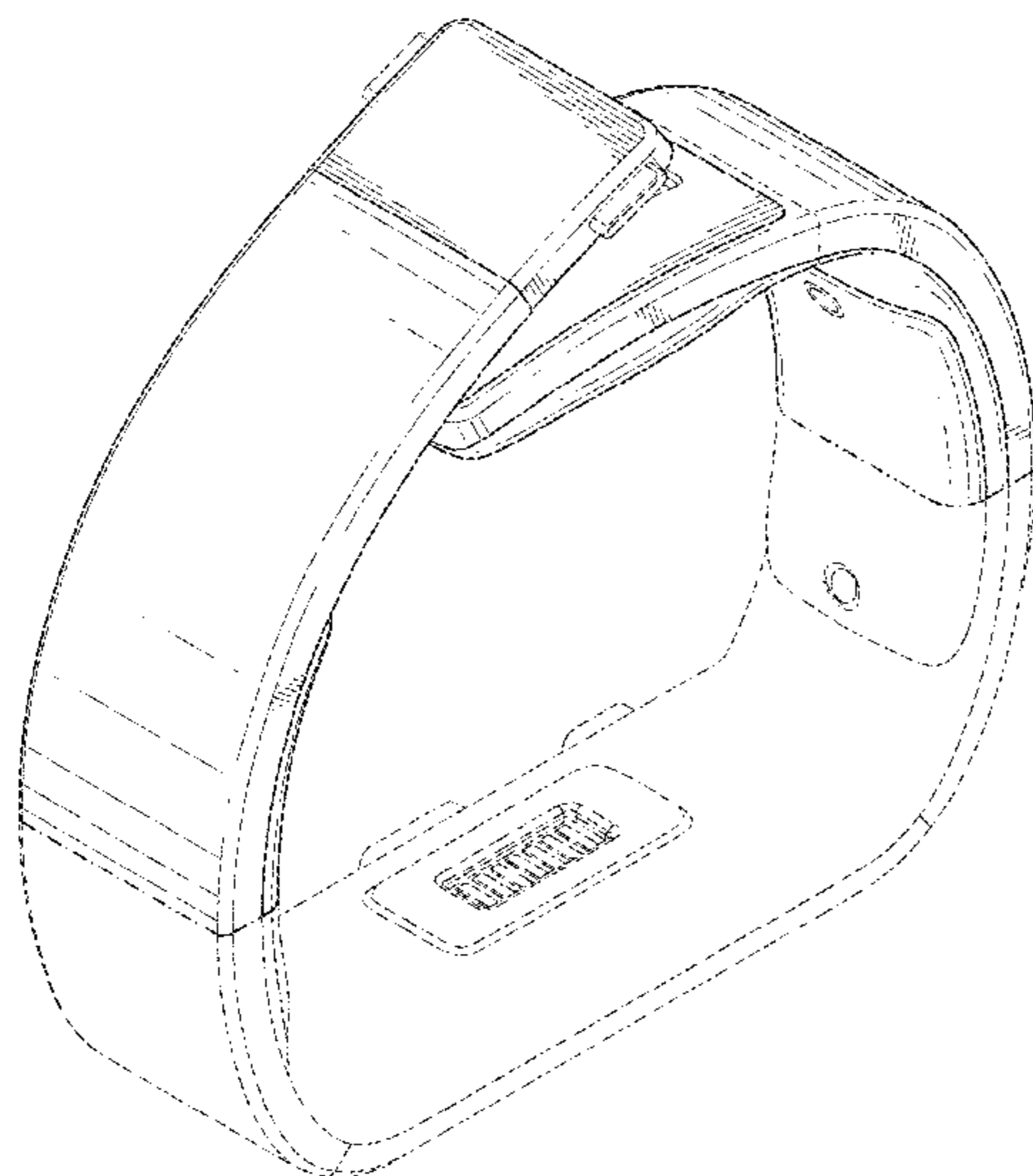
The ornamental design for a portion of a wearable electronic band, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front top perspective view of a portion of a wearable electronic band showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front bottom perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a back view thereof.

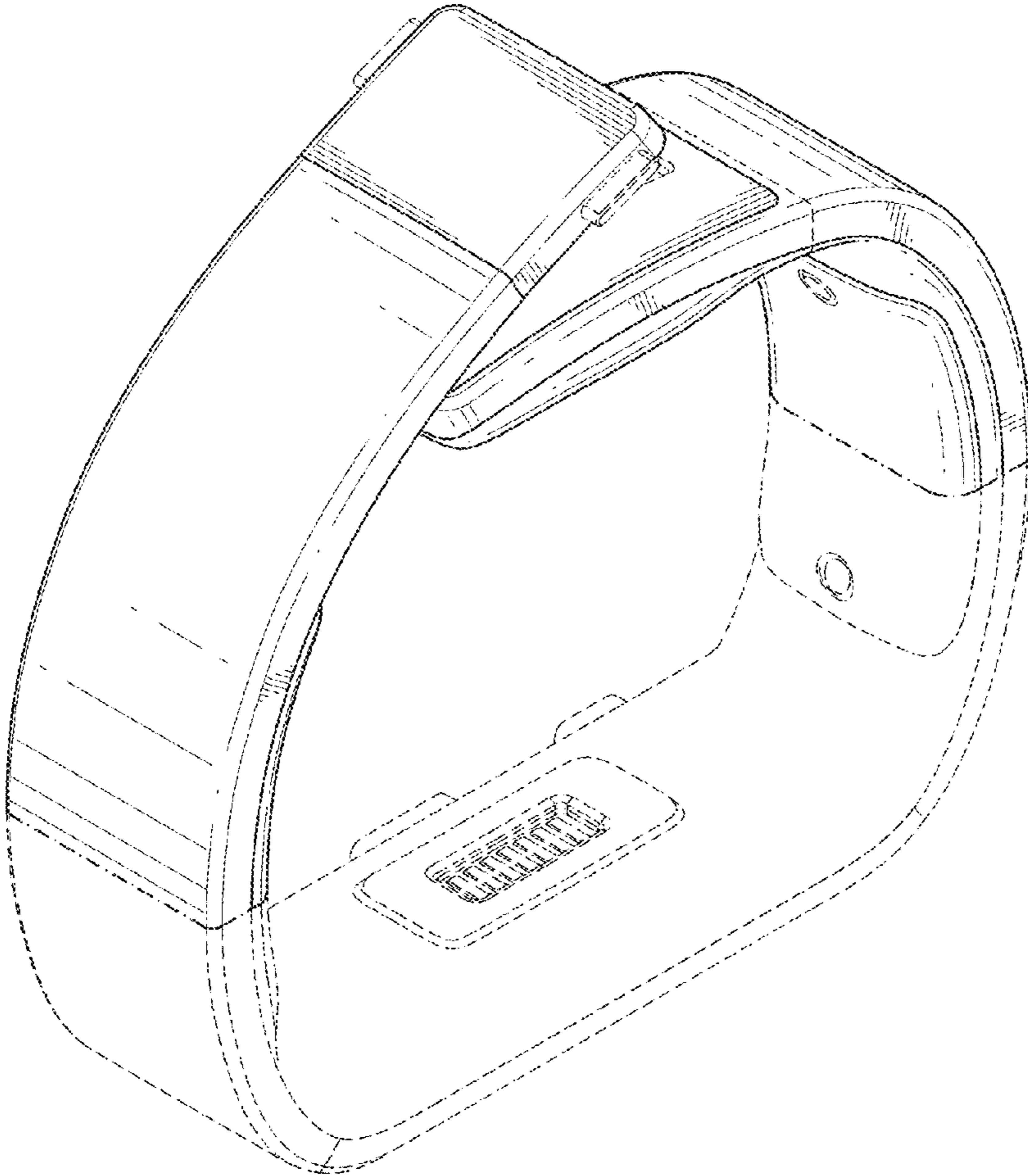

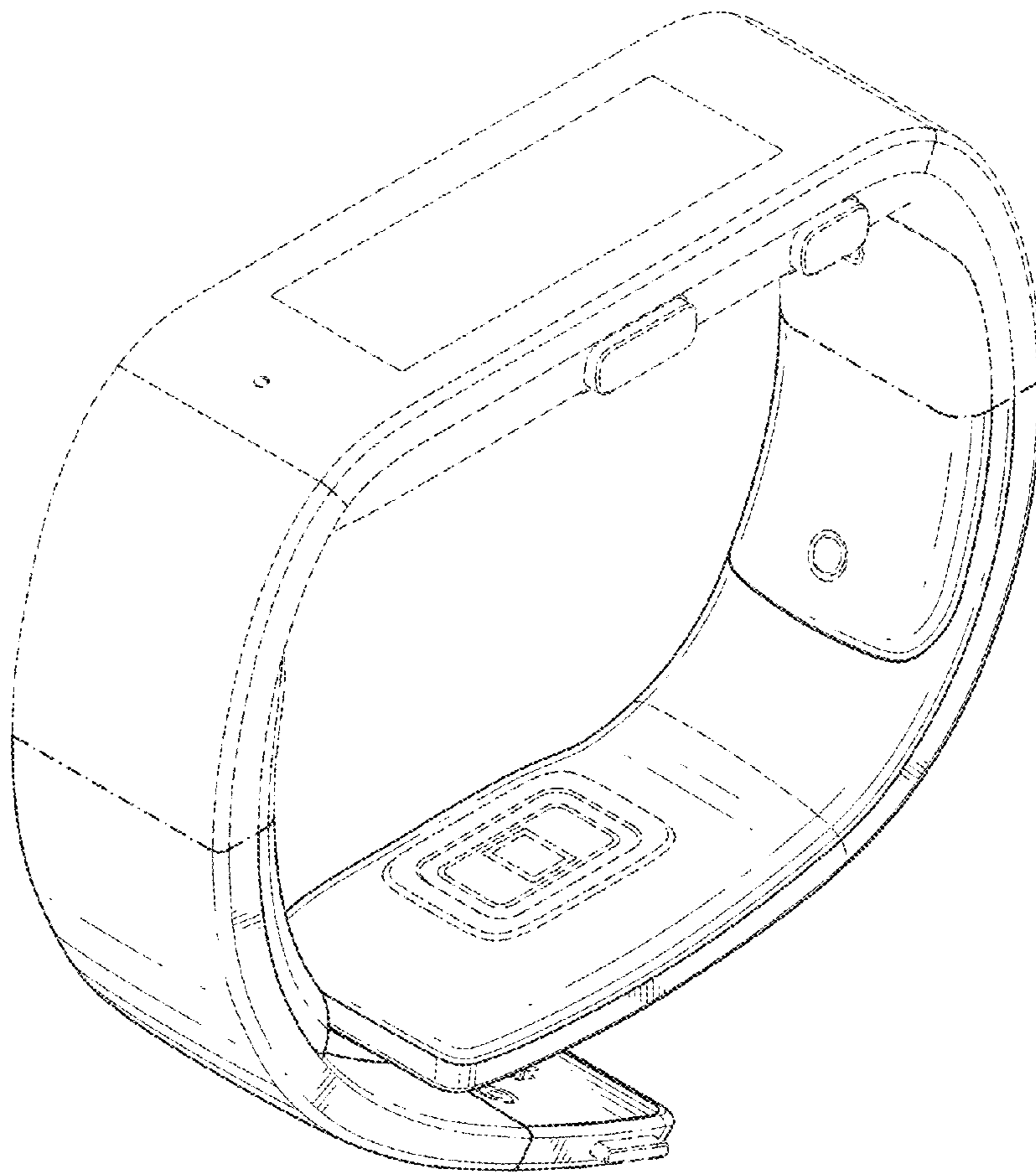

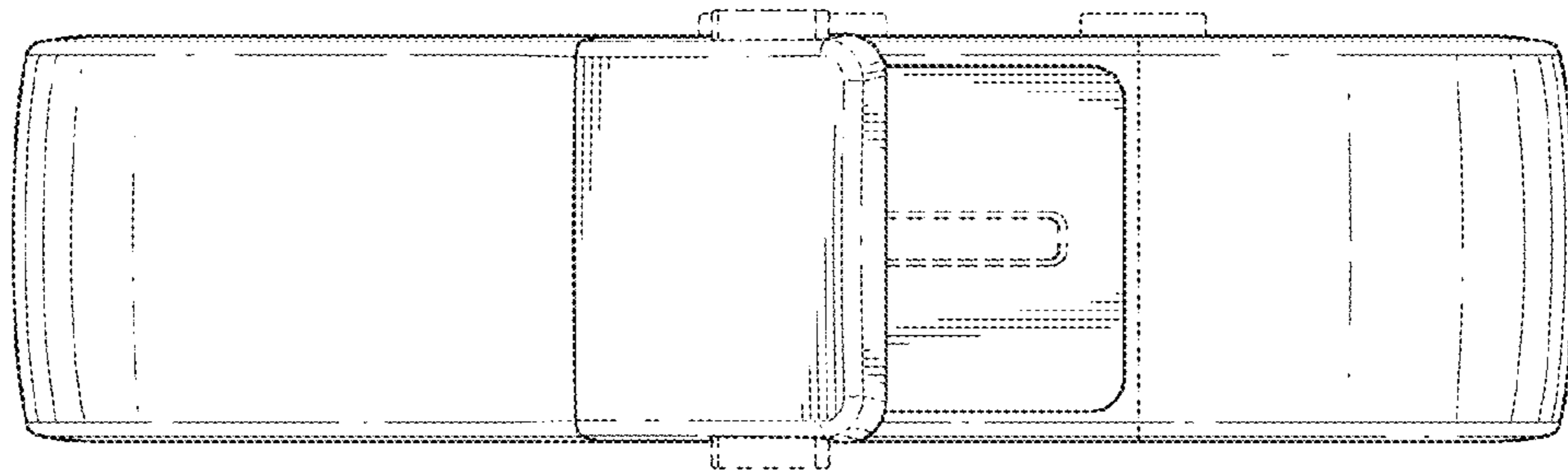

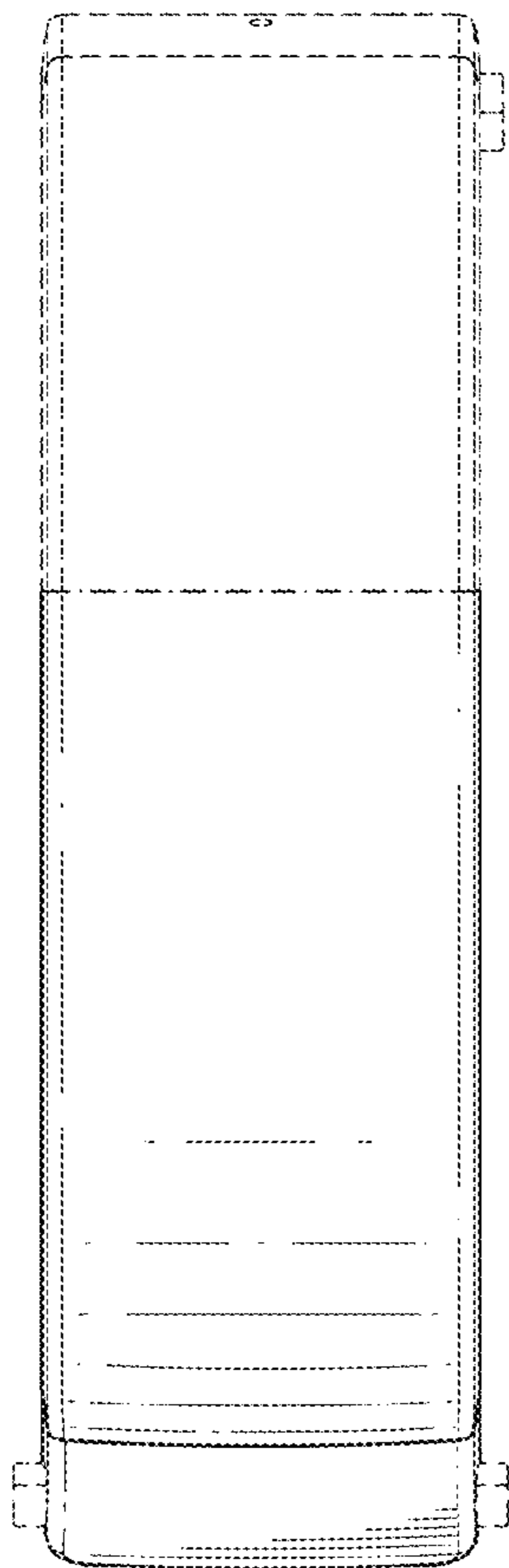

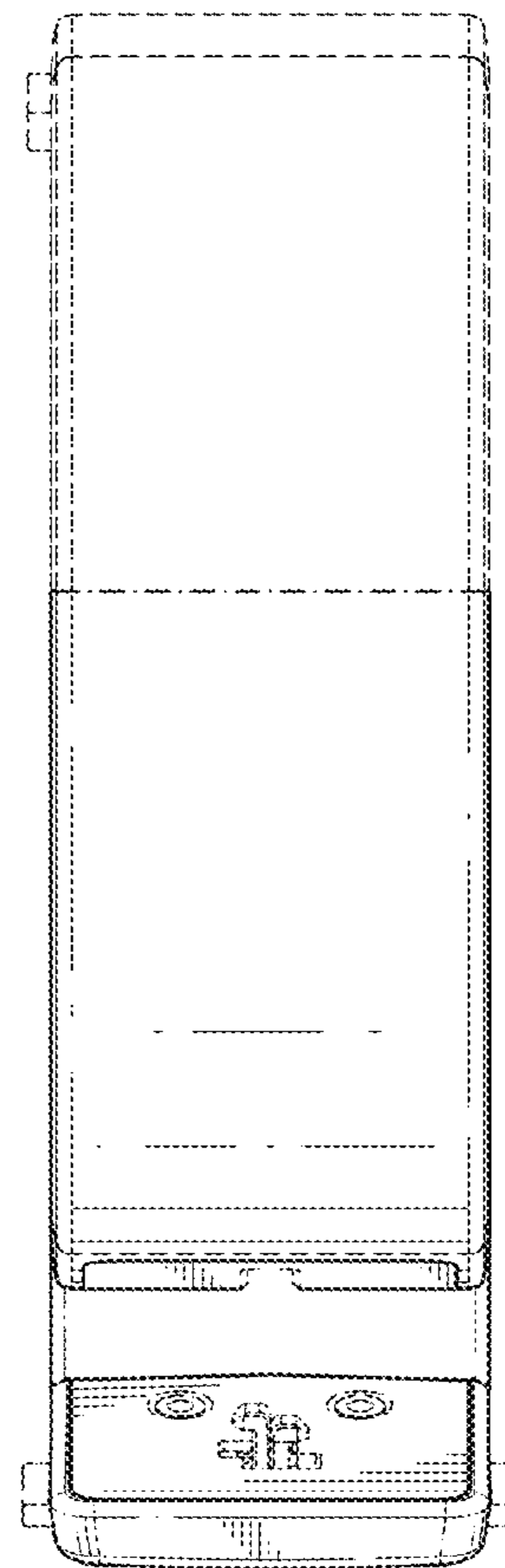

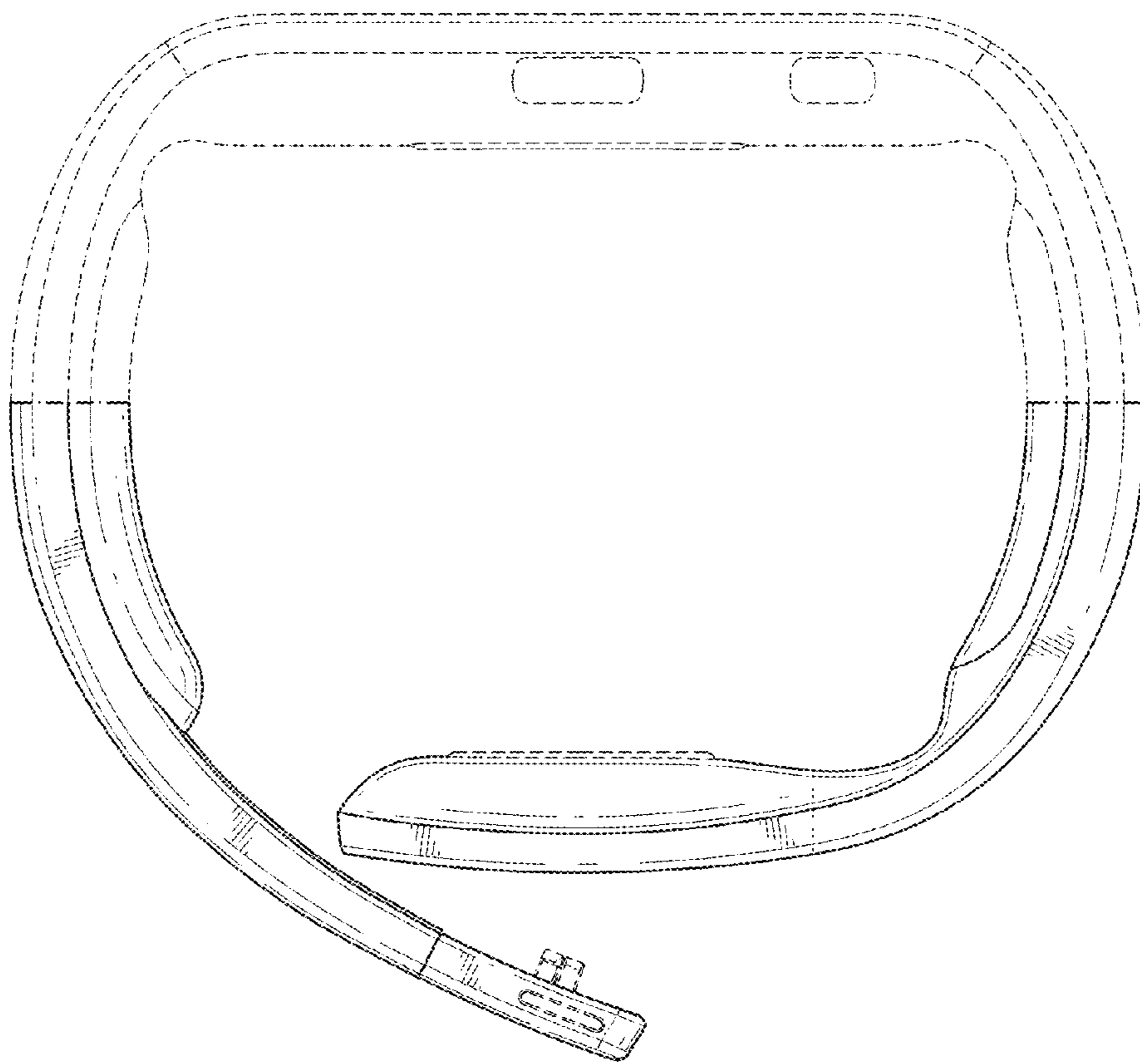

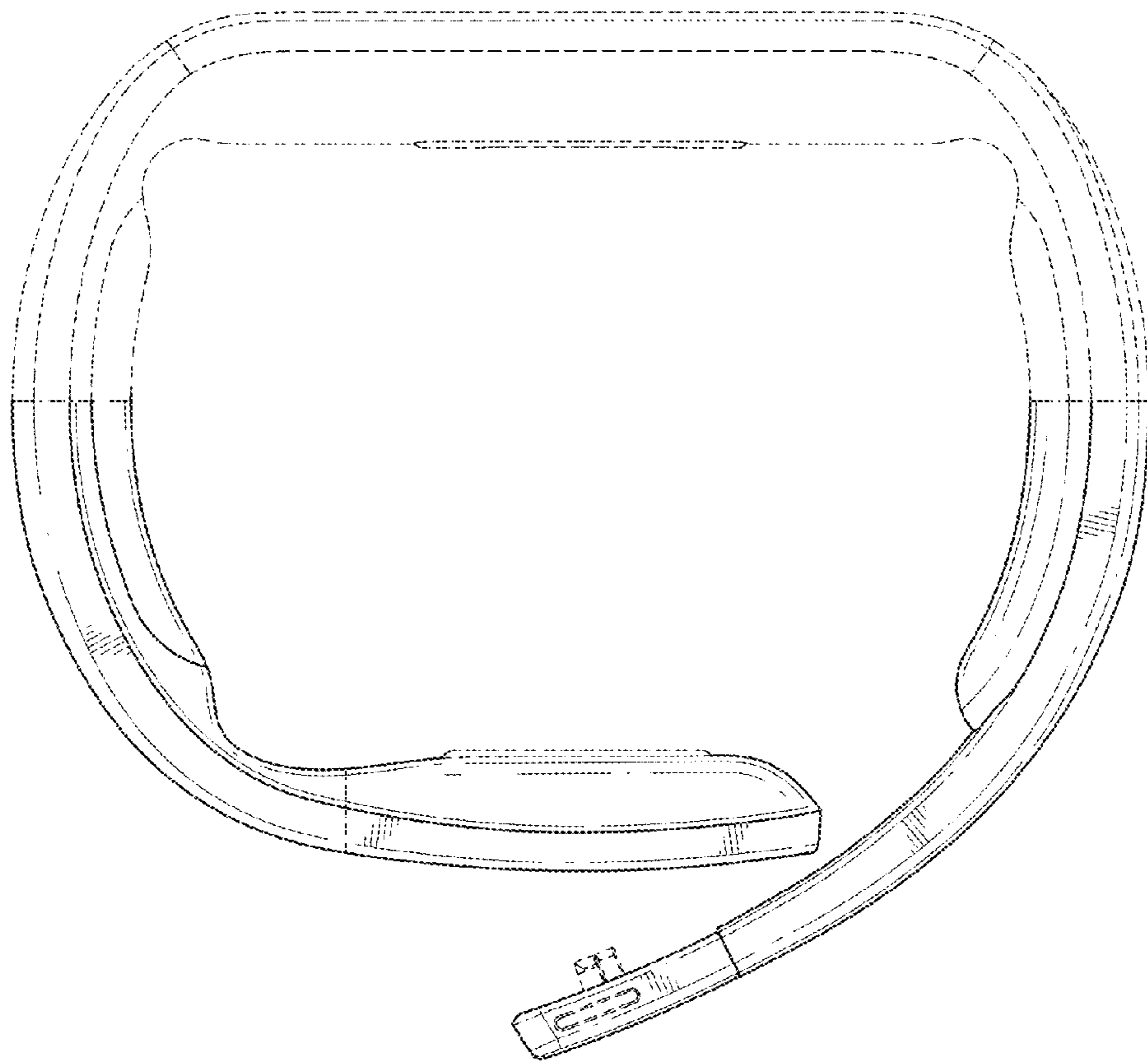
