DESCRIPTION

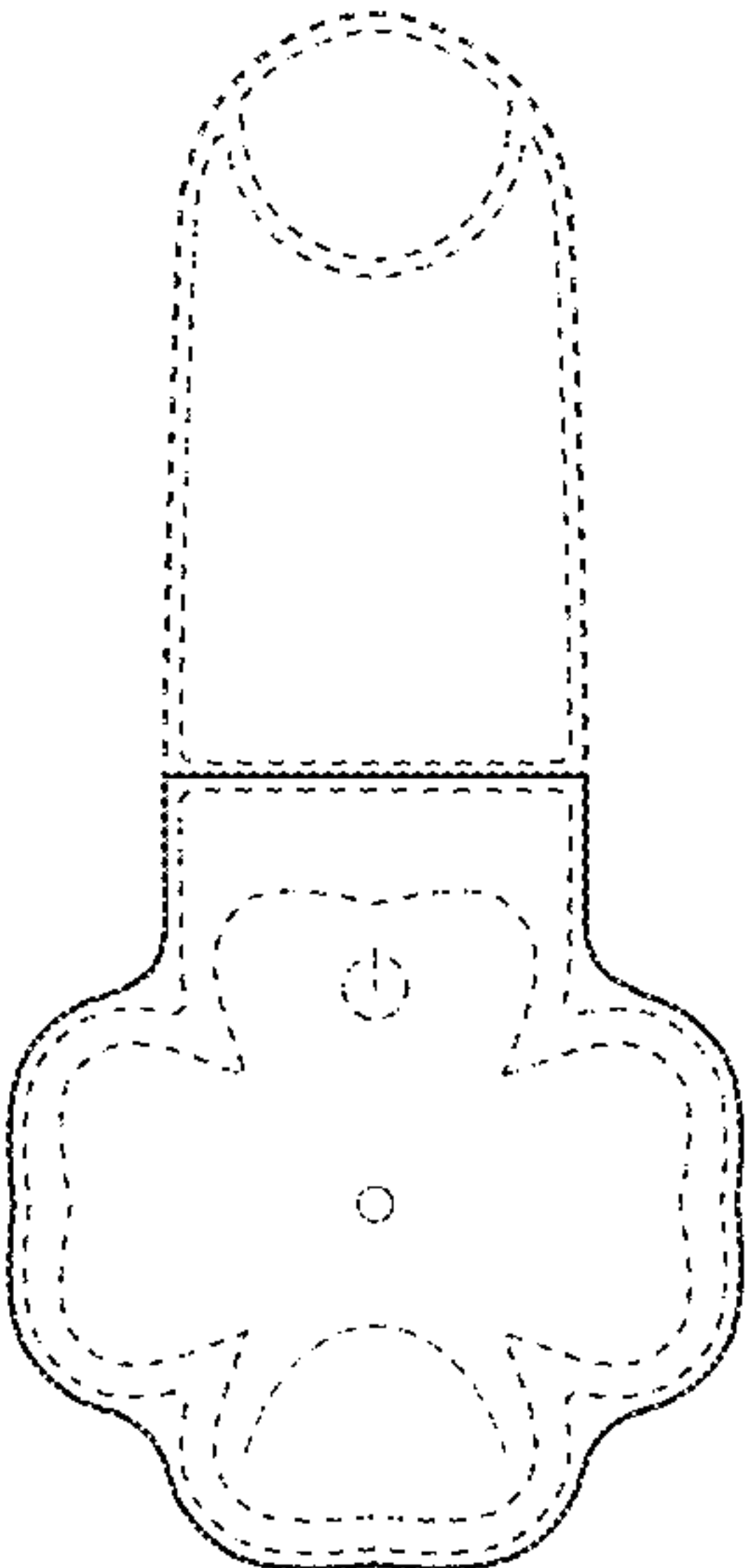
FIG. 1 is a front view of the reflective strip.

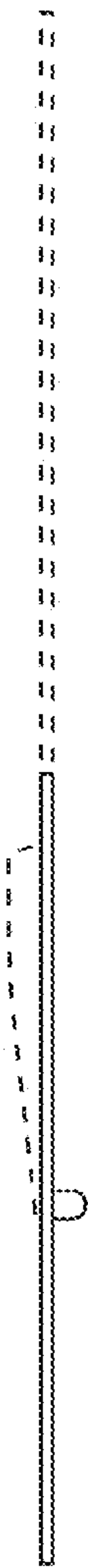

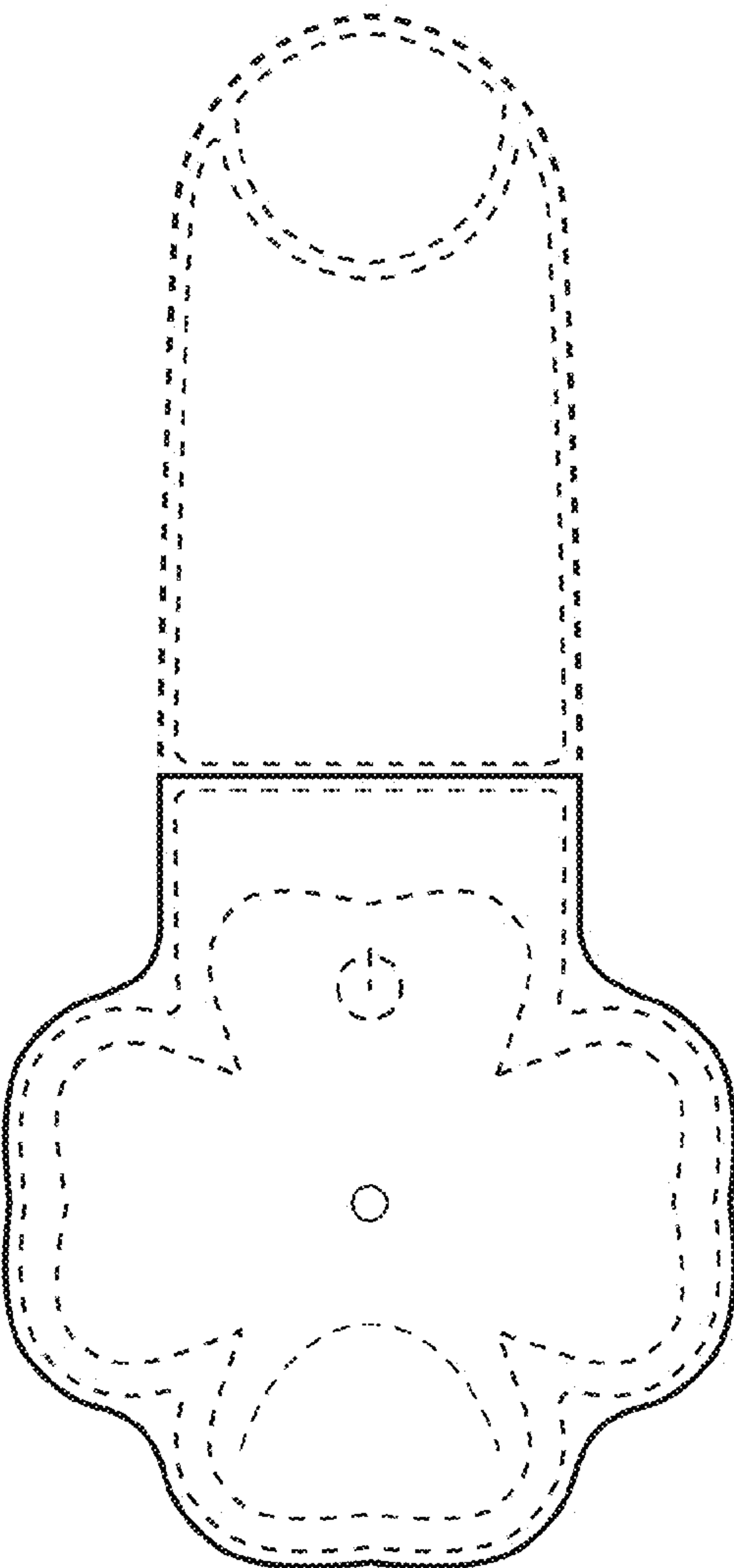

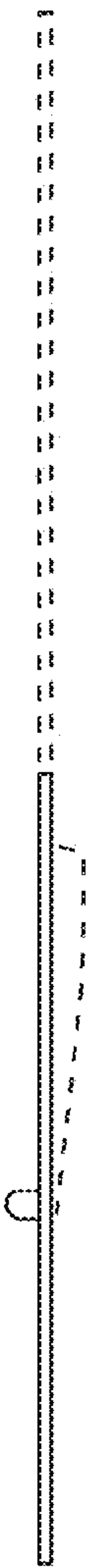

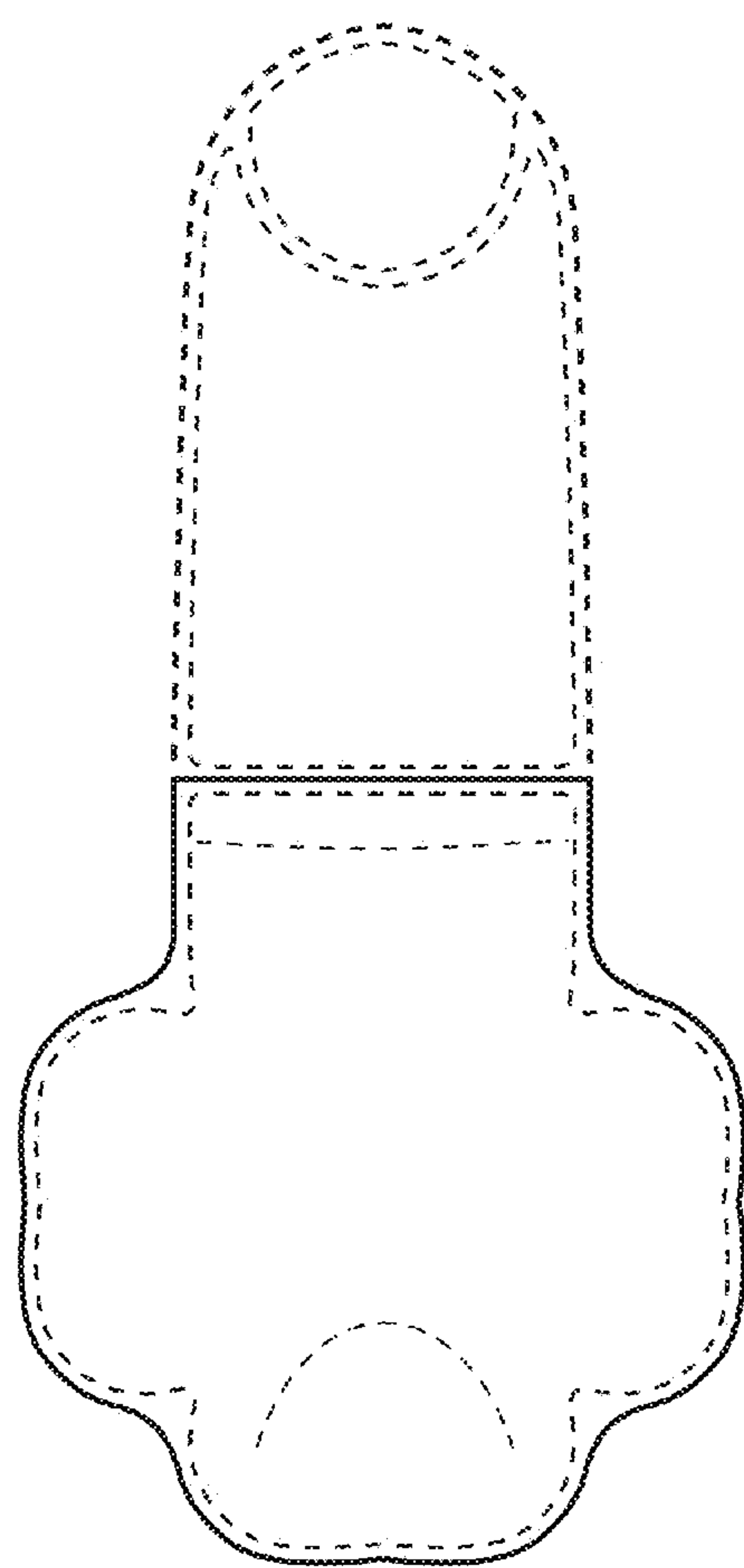

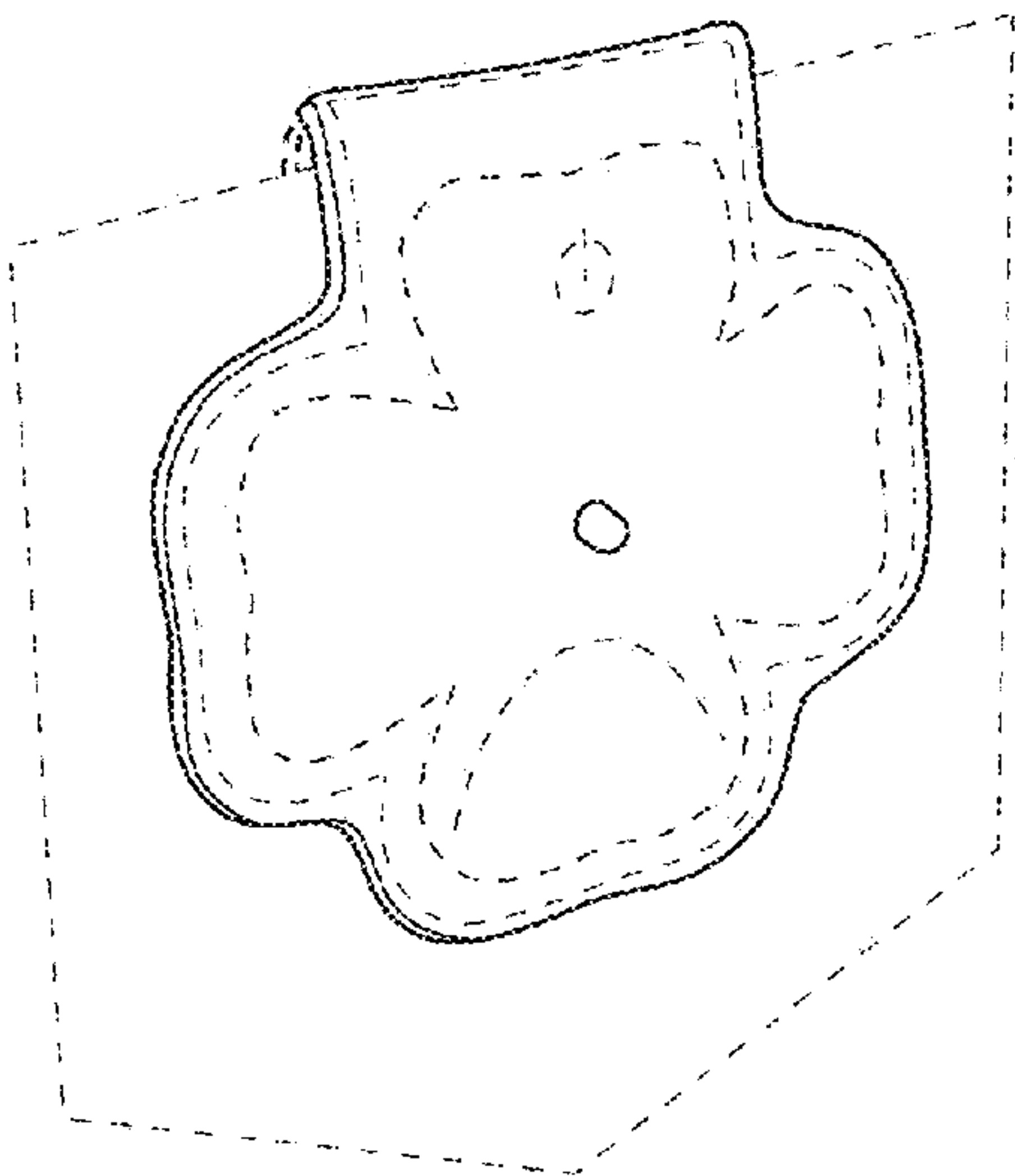
