a firearm of FIG. 1;

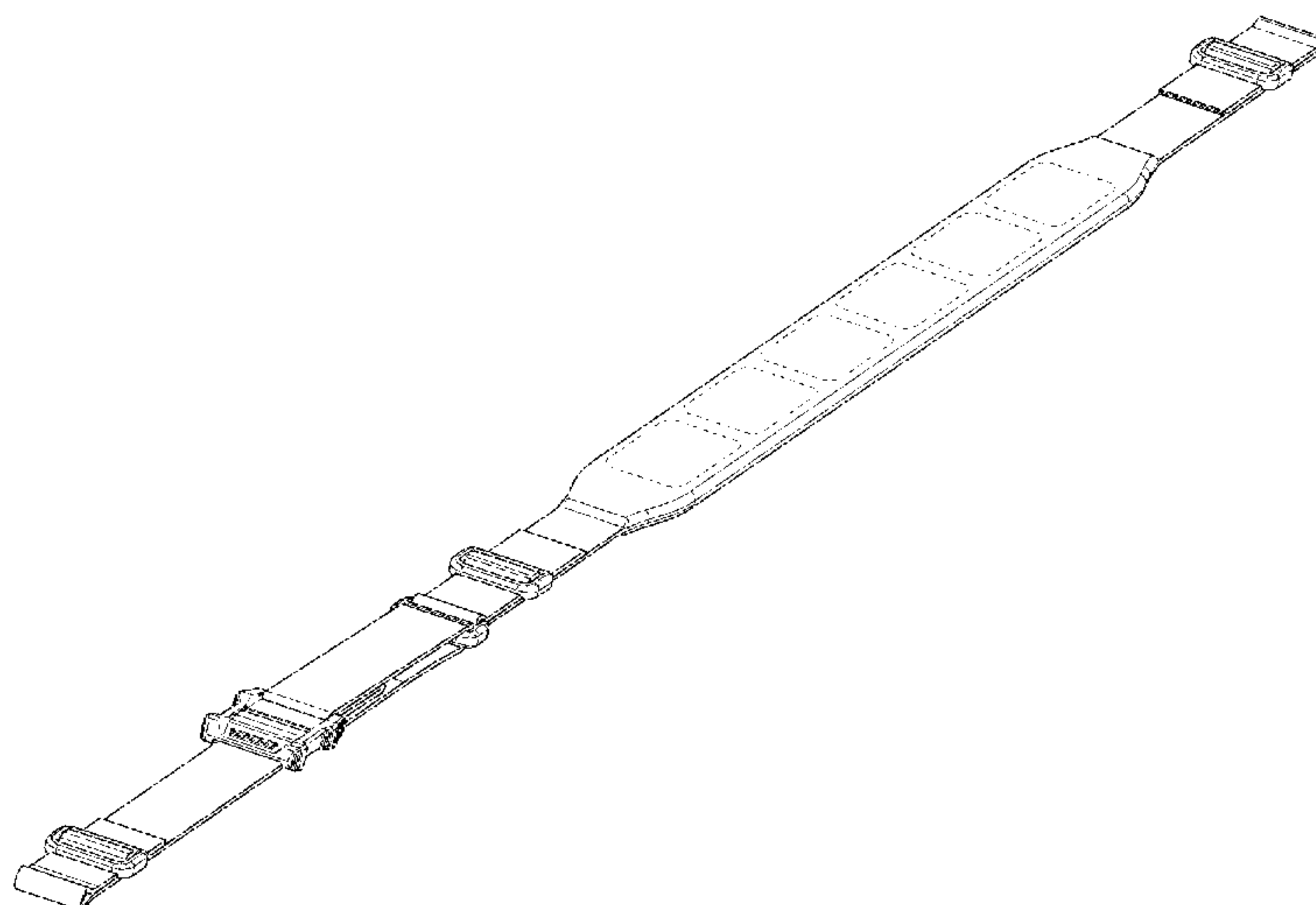
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the sling for a firearm of FIG. 1;

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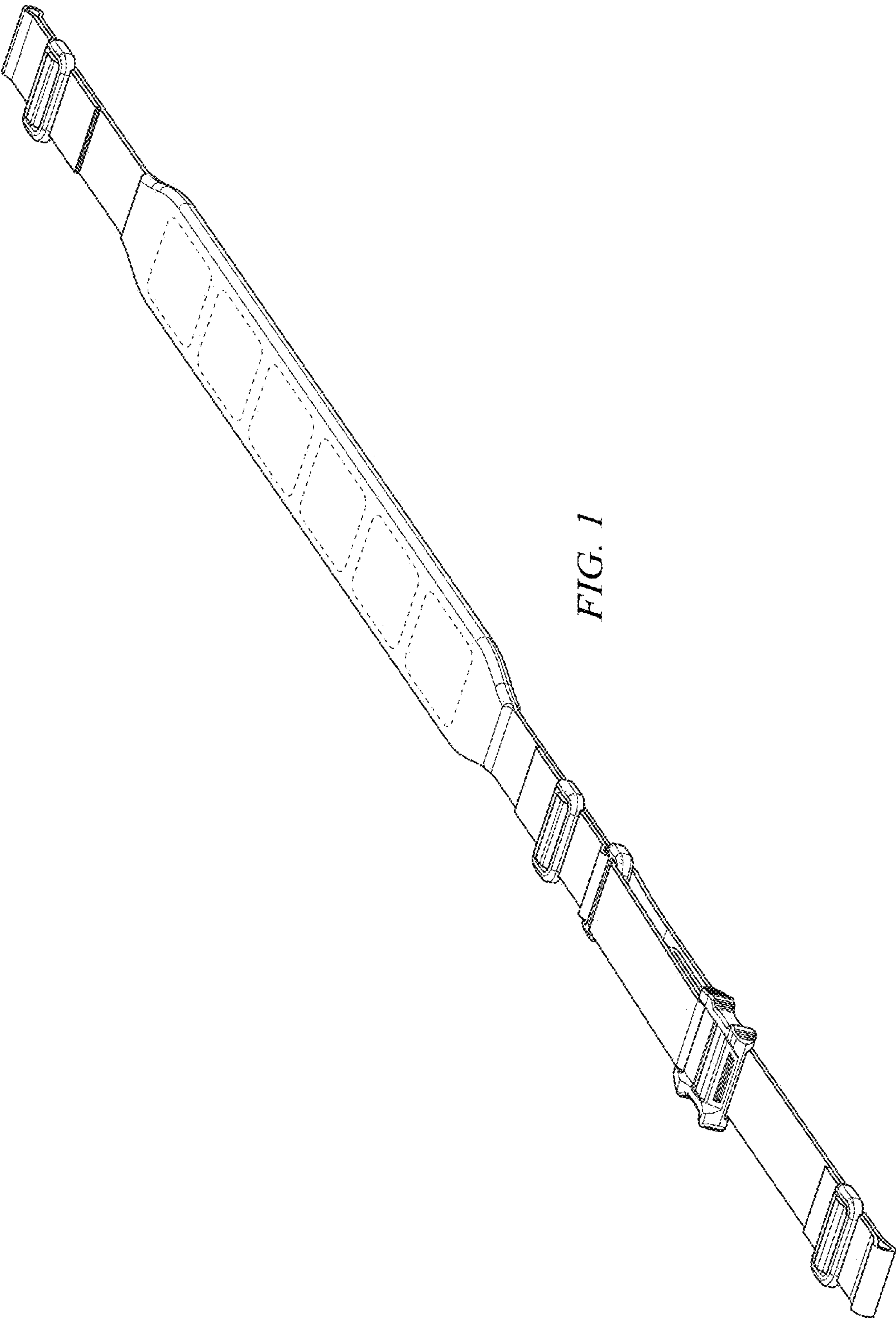
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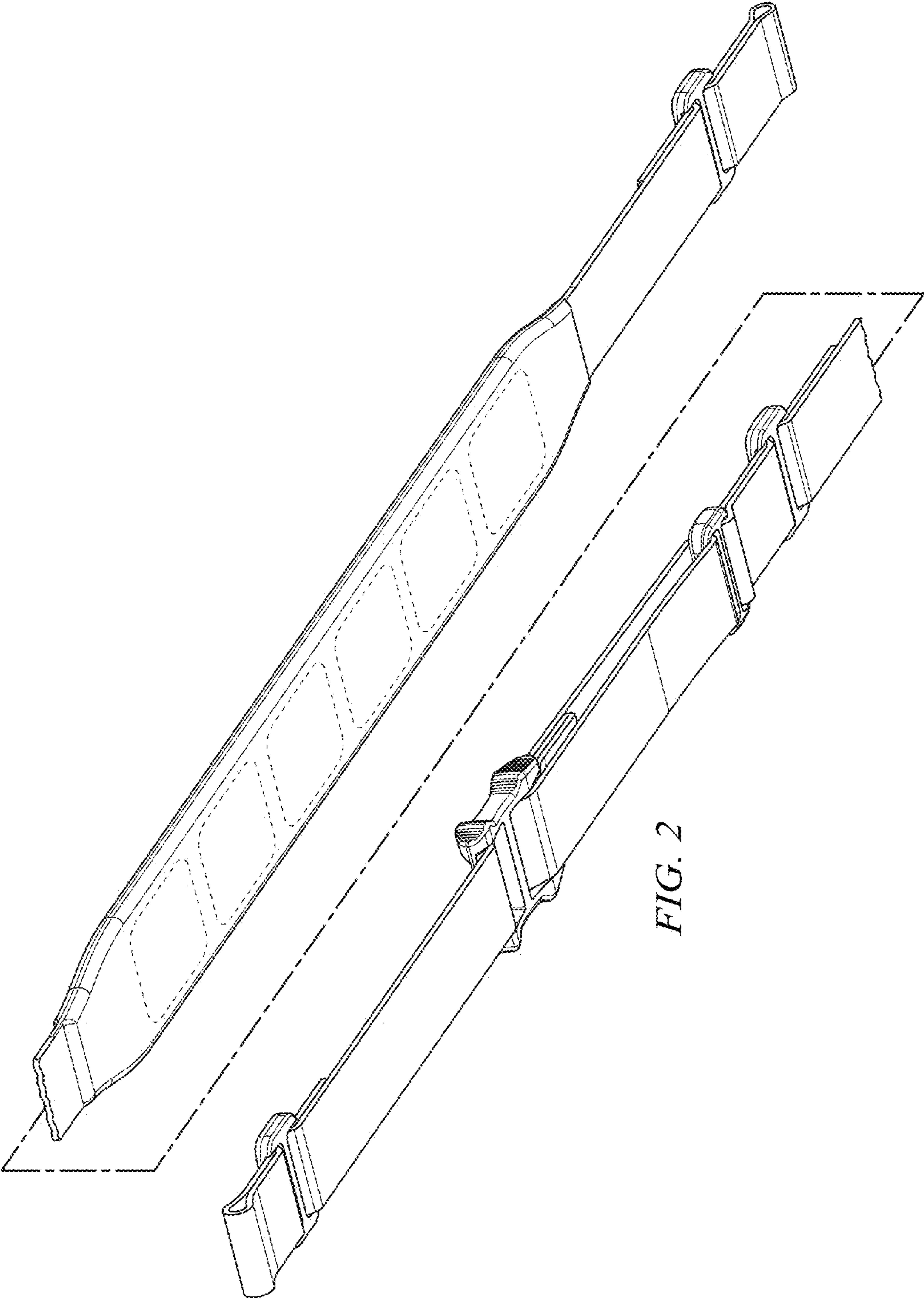
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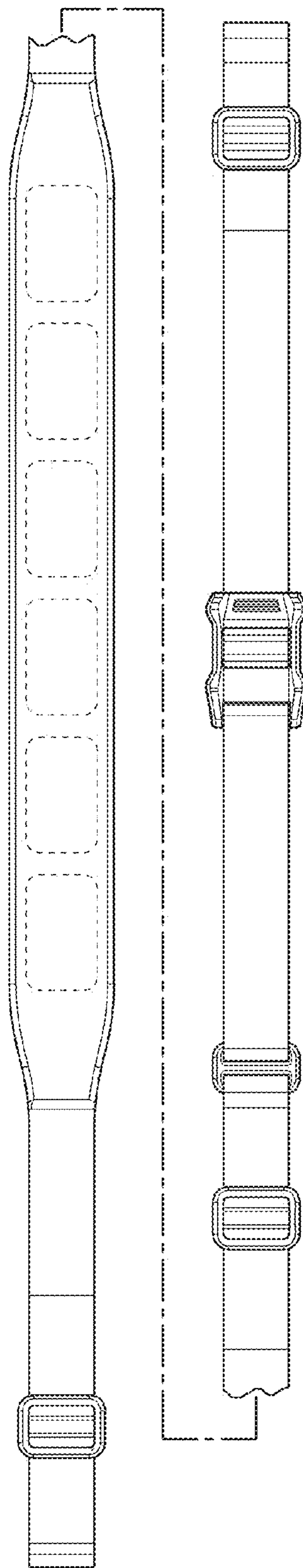

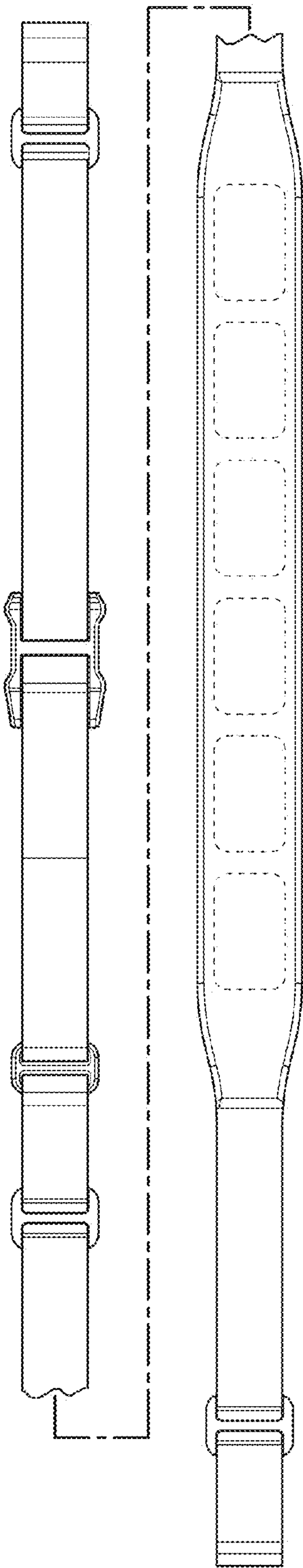

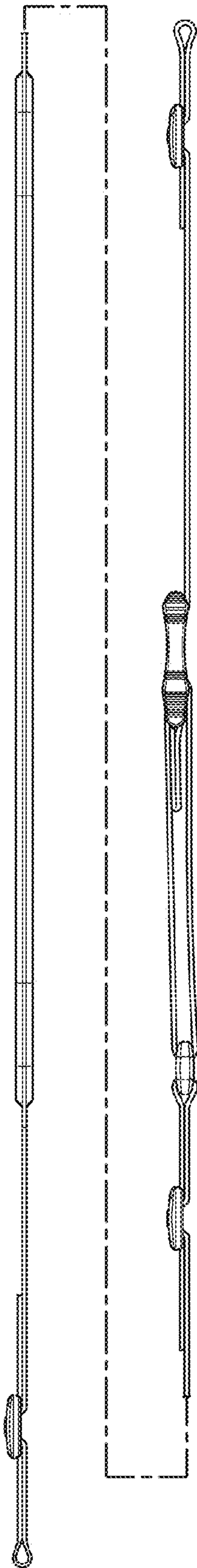

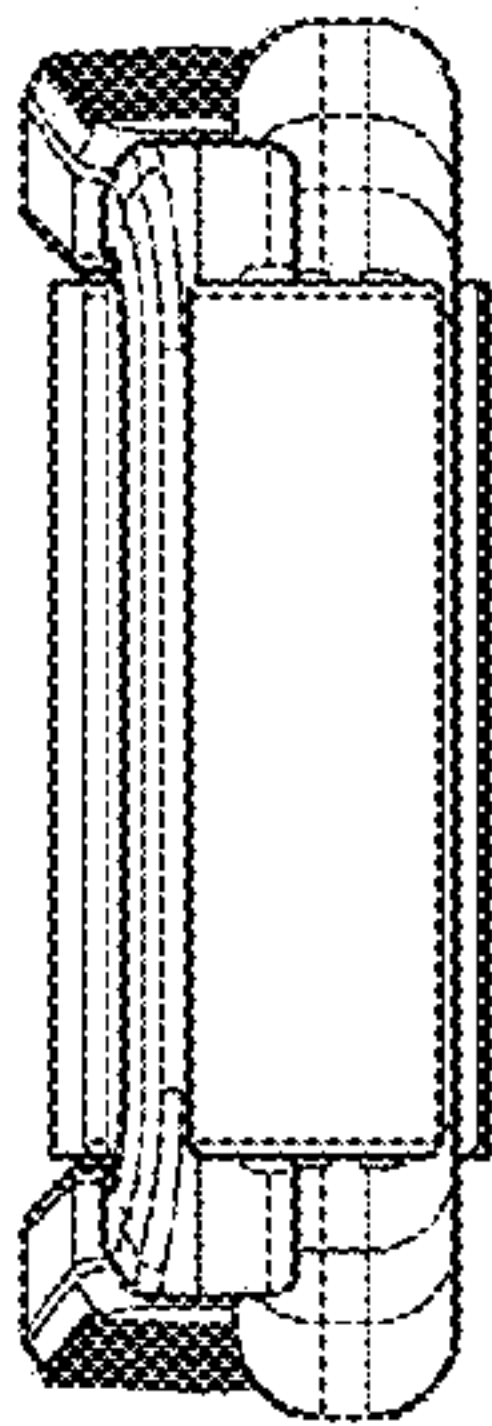

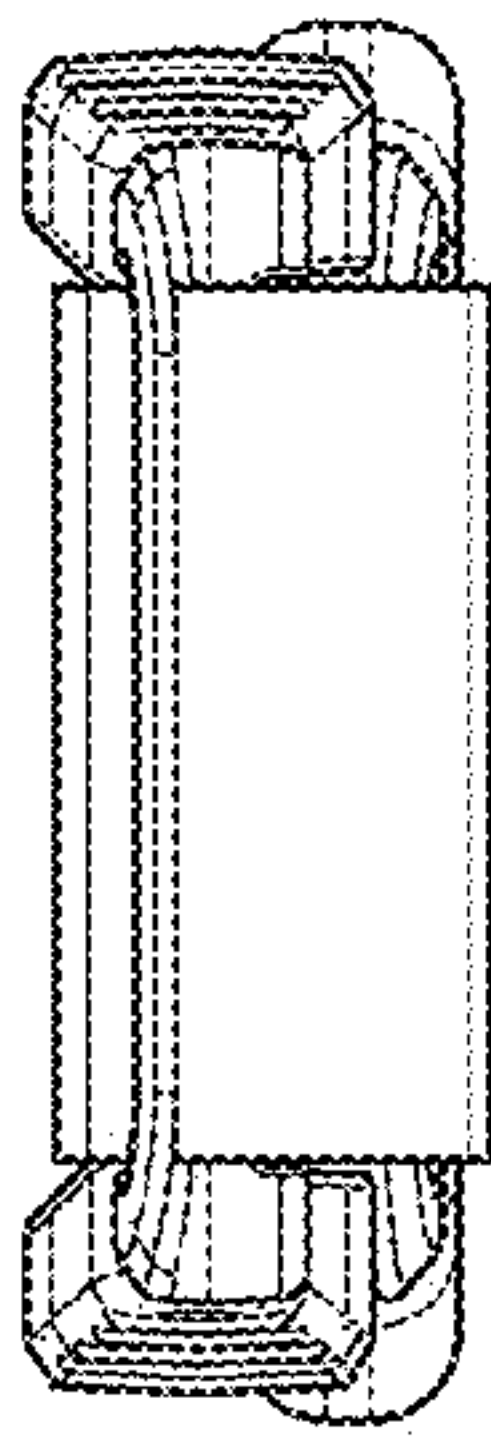
