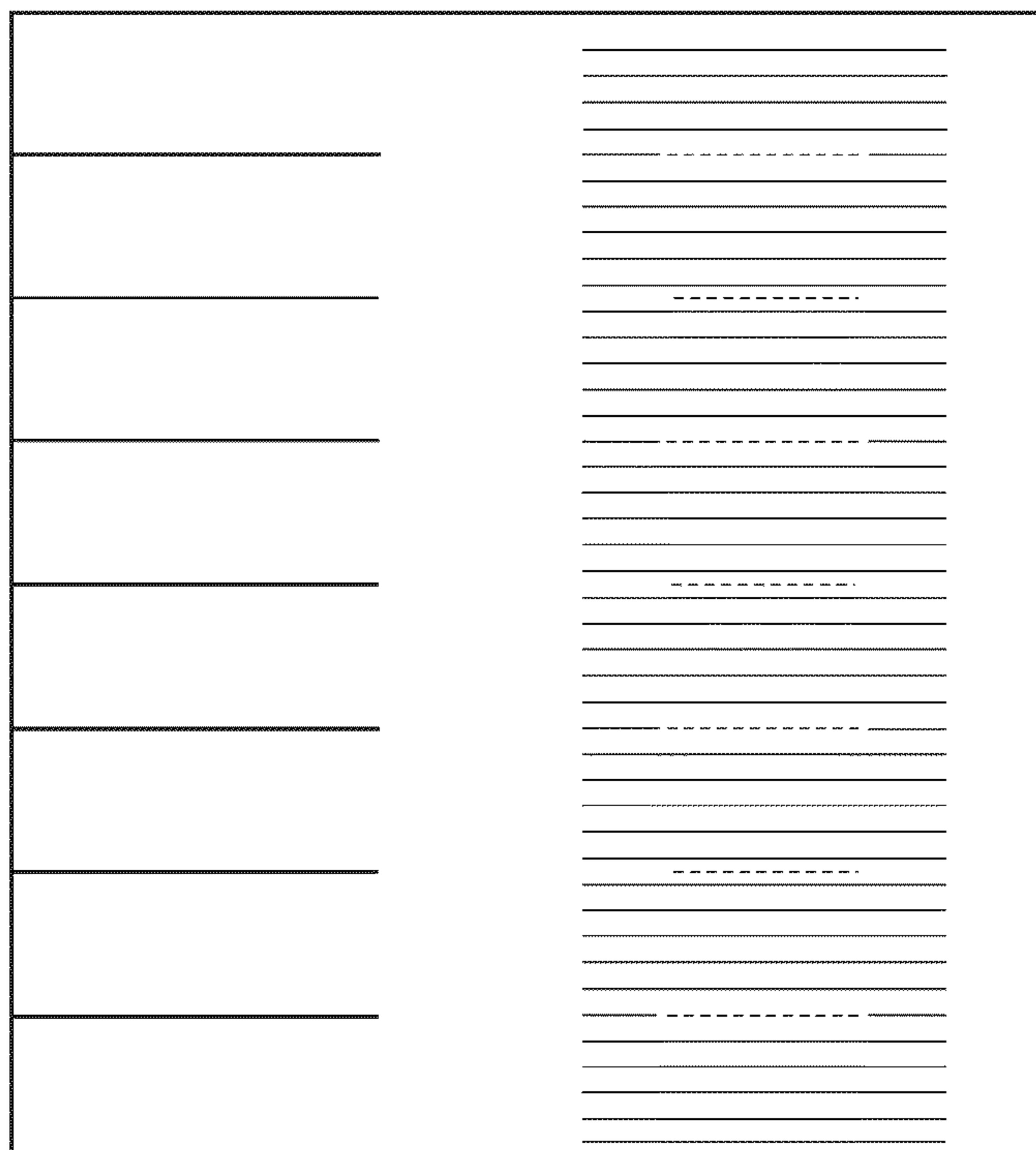

(57) **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for a ruled notebook paper, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of the ruled notebook paper showing my new design; and,  
FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof.  
The ruled notebook paper is a thin and flat sheet: therefore only front and rear views are shown. It is understood that the claimed article is of no appreciable thickness.  
The broken line showing of portions of the ruled notebook paper in FIG. 1 is included for the purpose of separating sections of the solid lines and is shown for illustrating environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design.

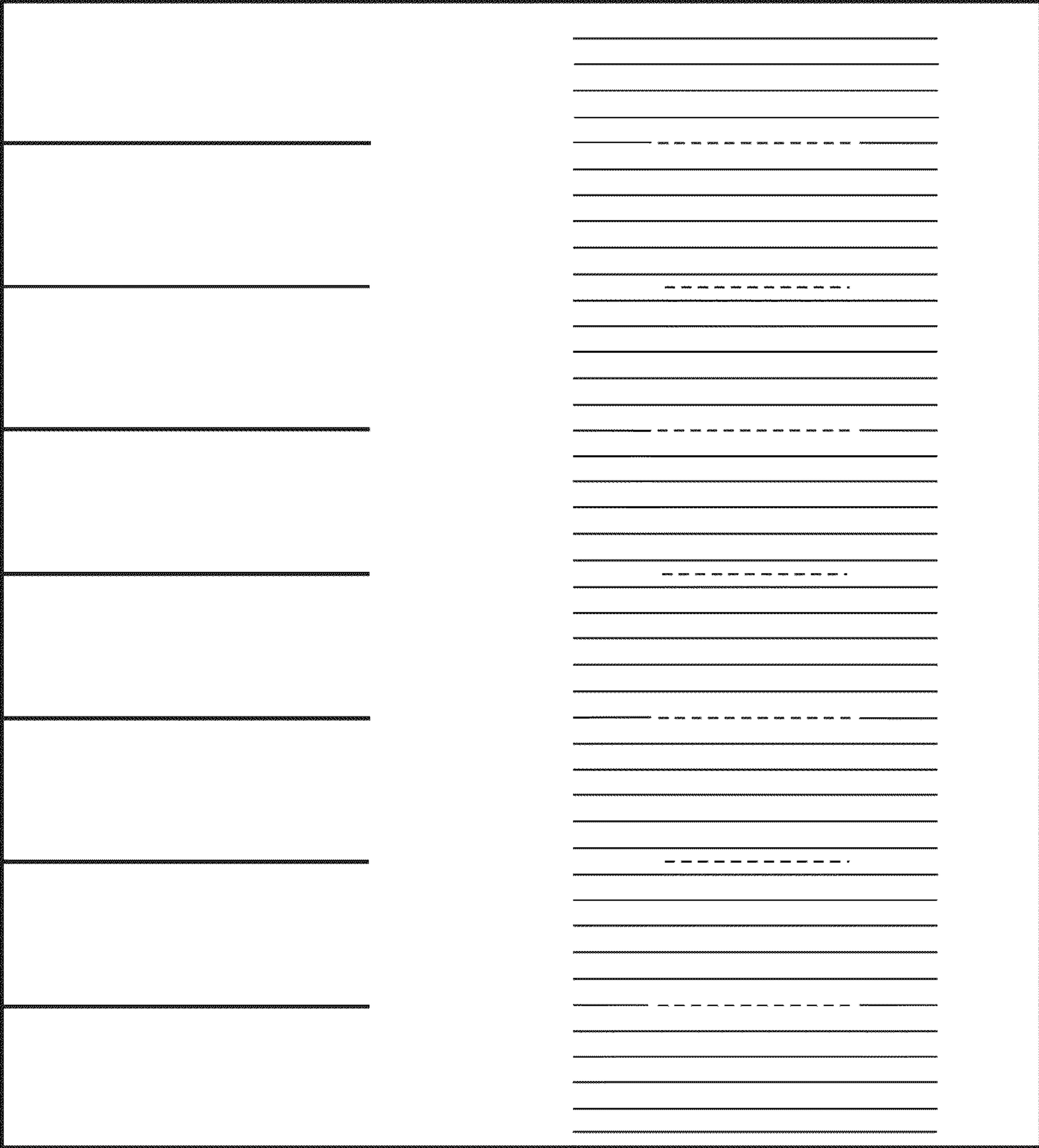

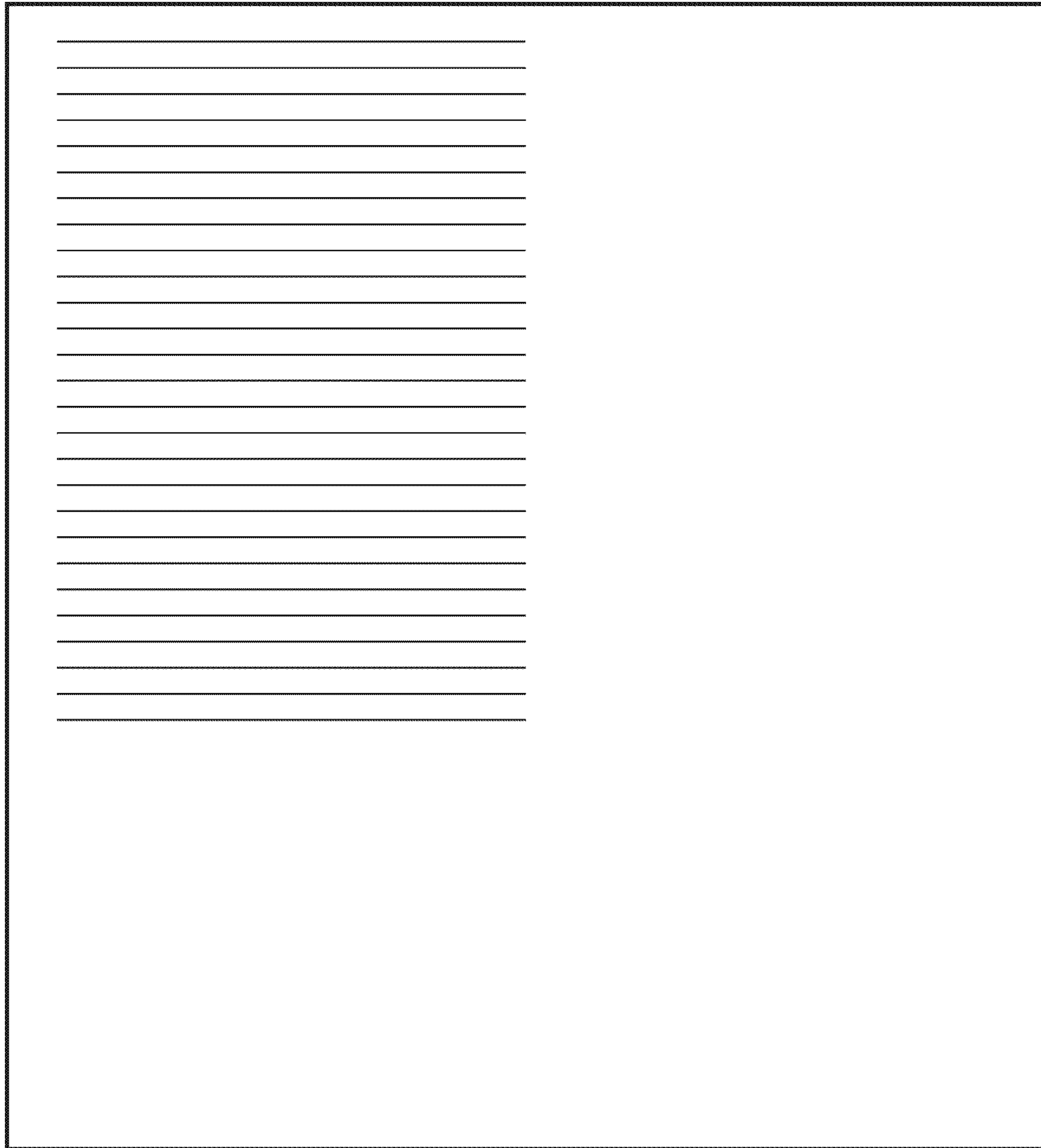
