The appearance of the animated images transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-3. The process or period in which one image transitions to another forms no part of the claimed design.

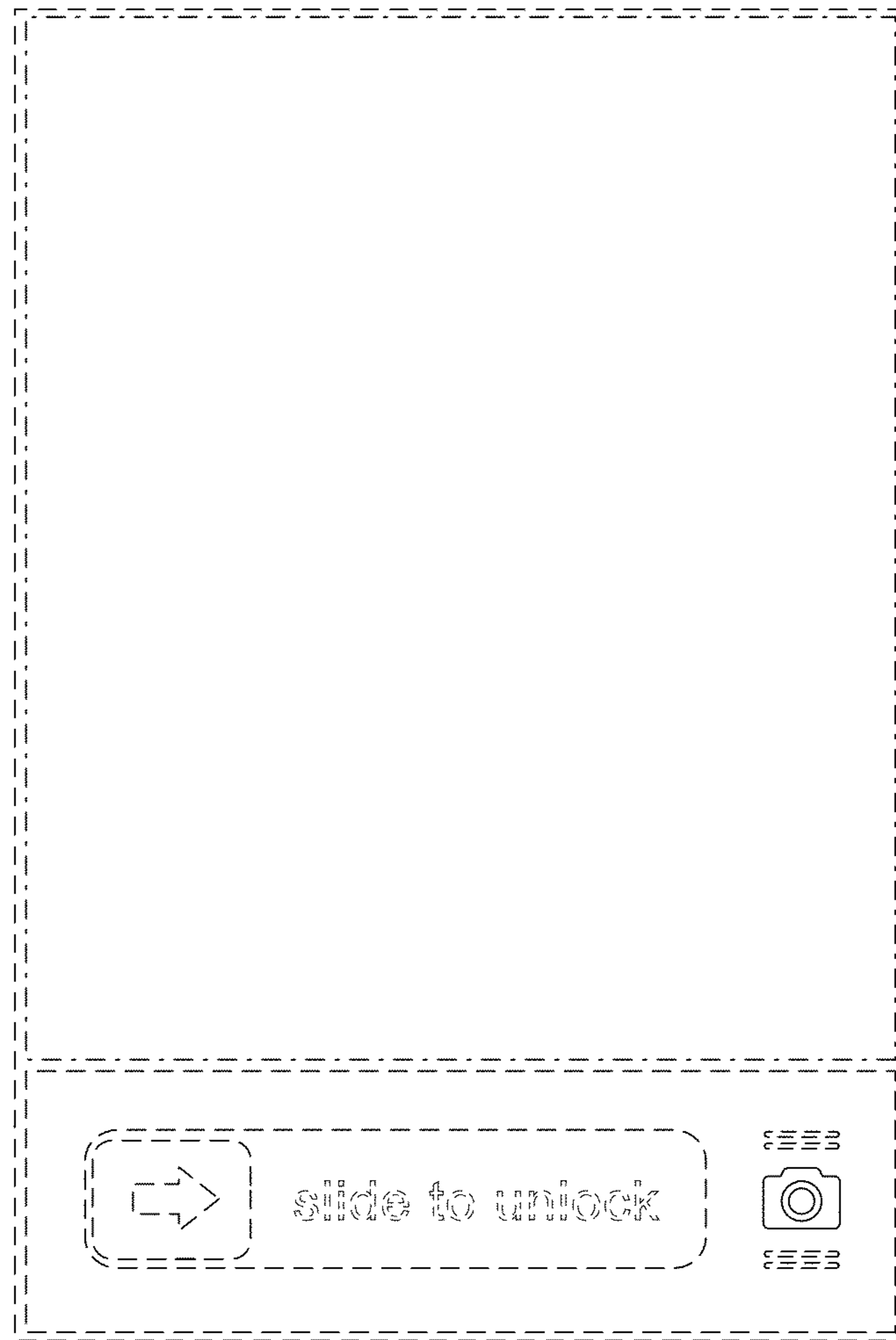
