DESCRIPTION

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the play mat of FIG. 7.

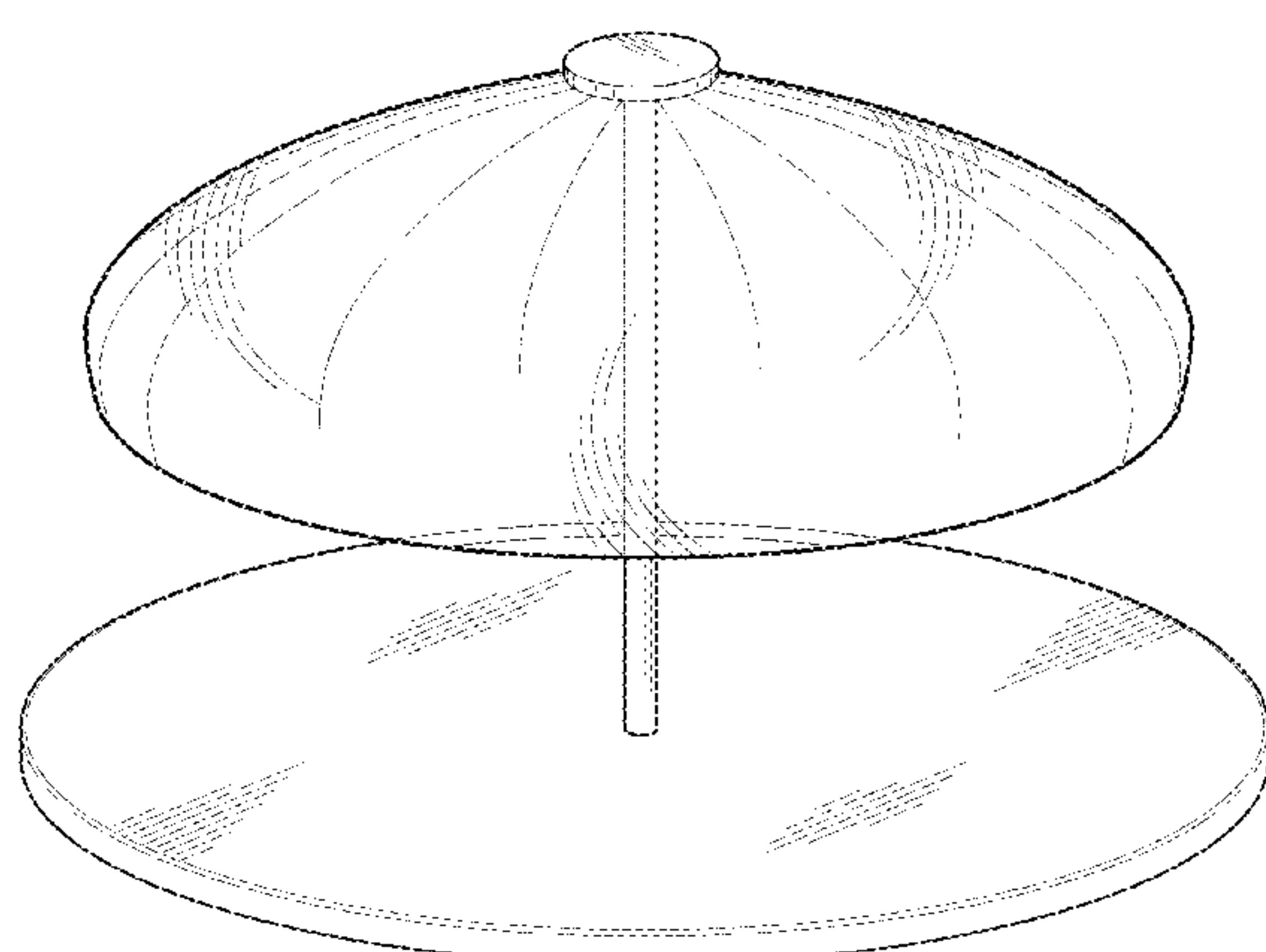
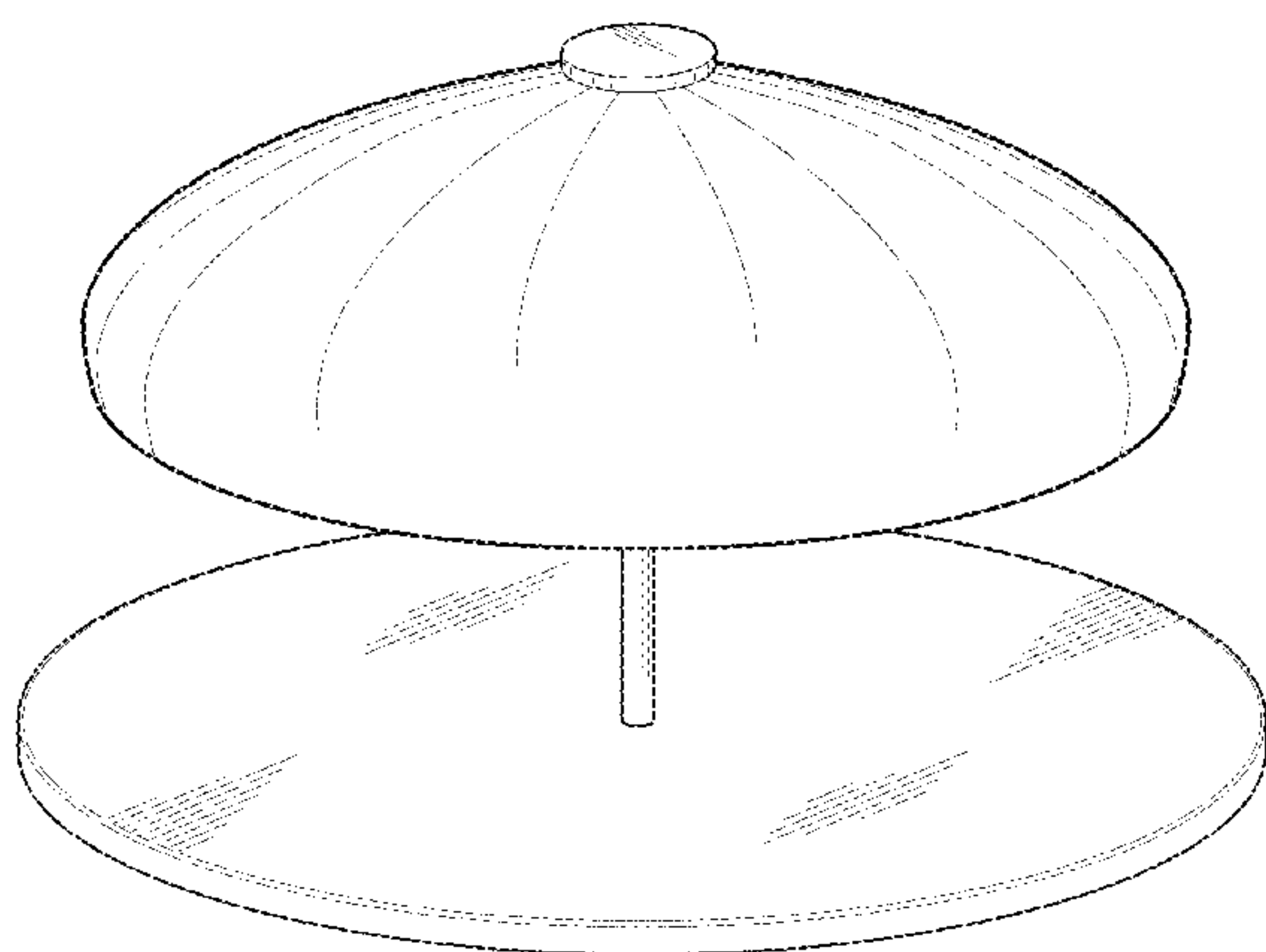
FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the fourth embodiment of a play mat embodying the new design.

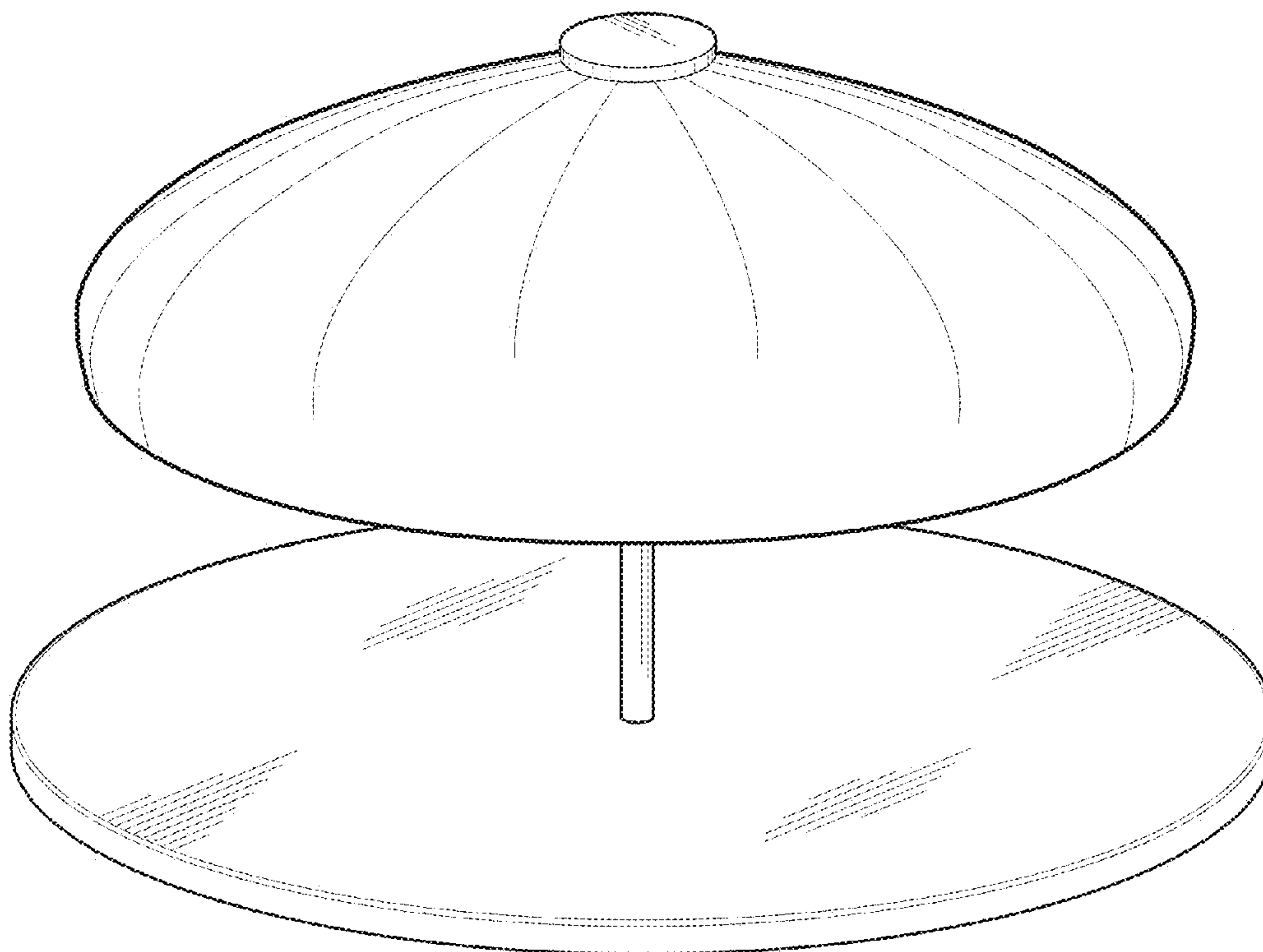
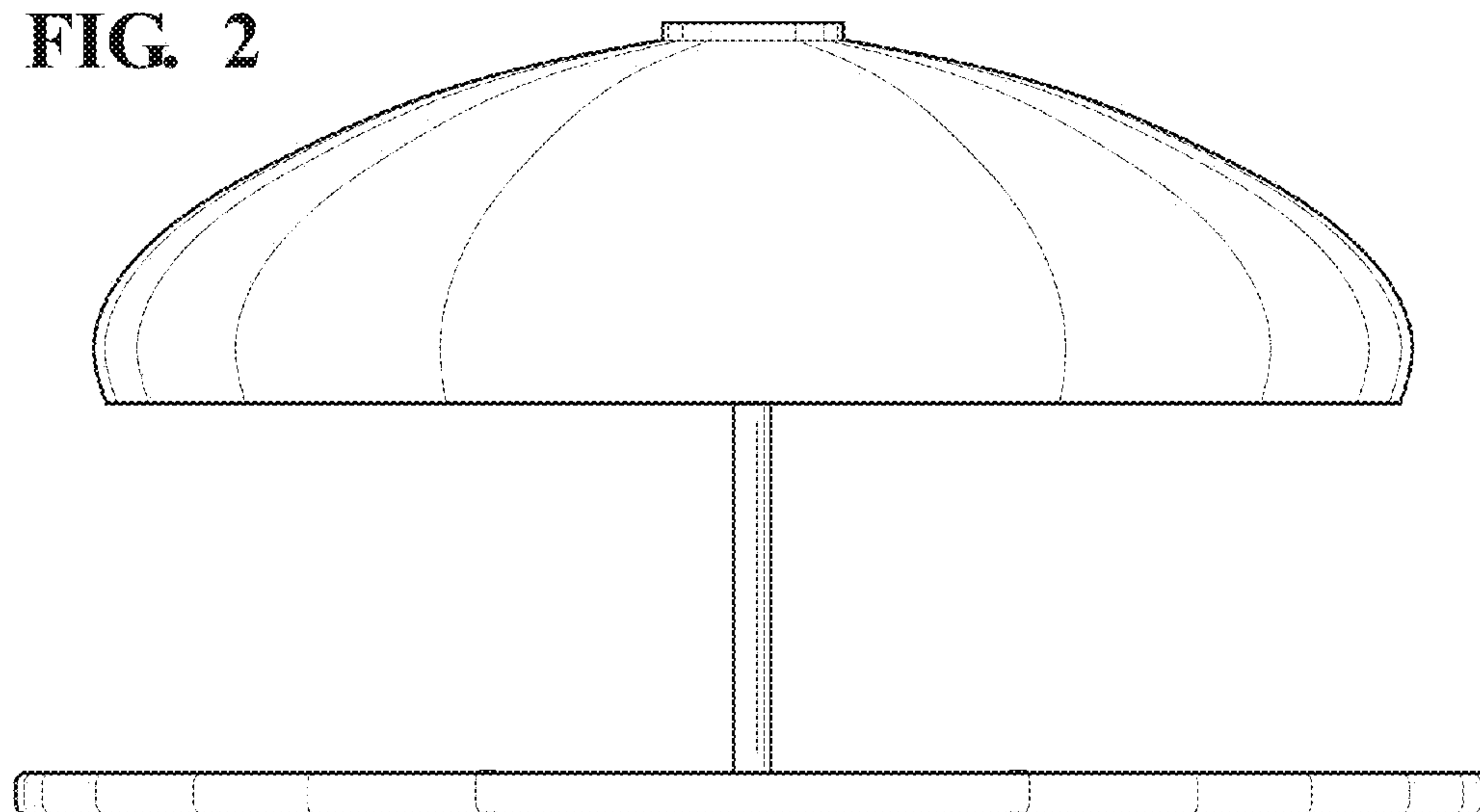

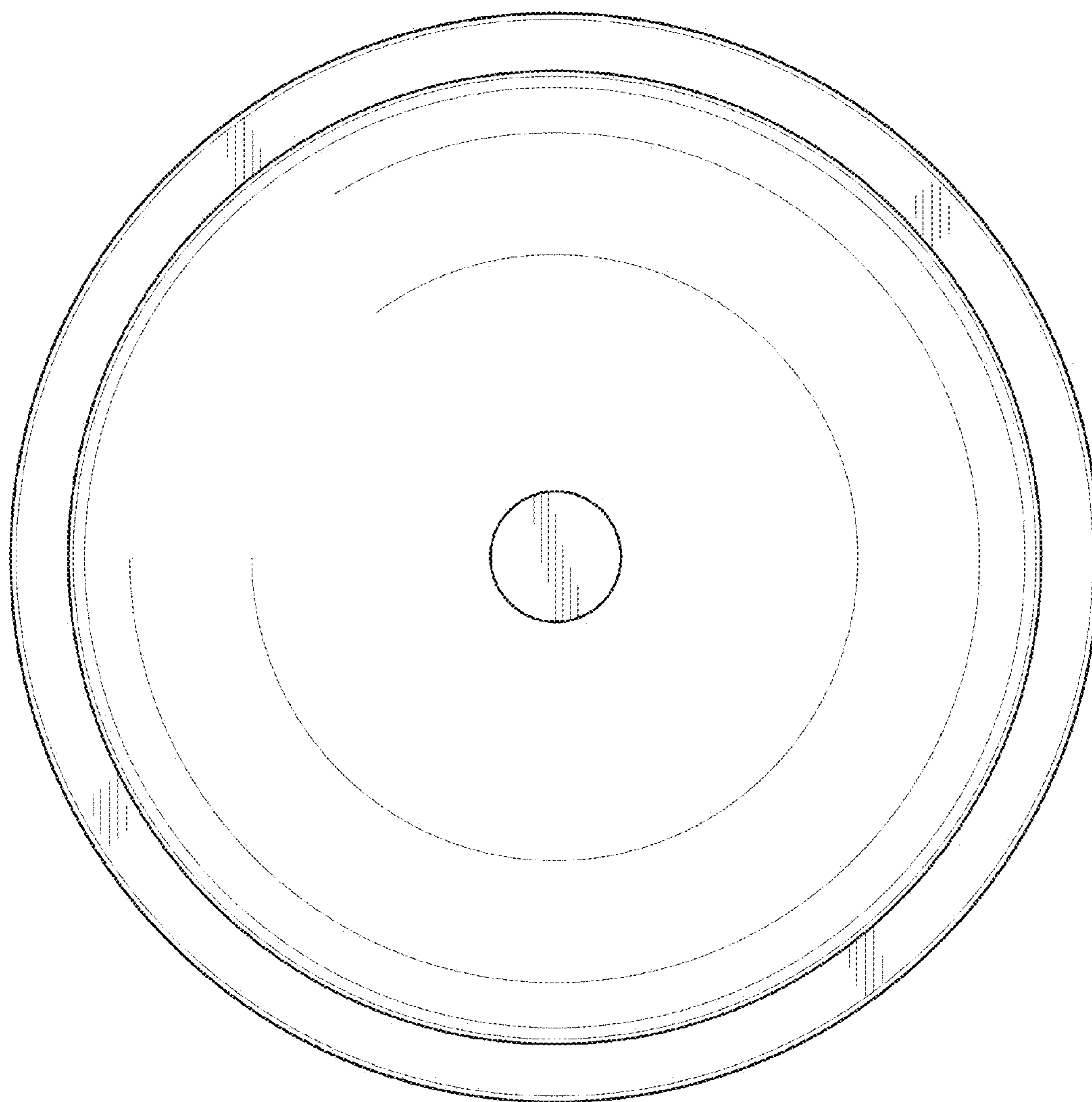

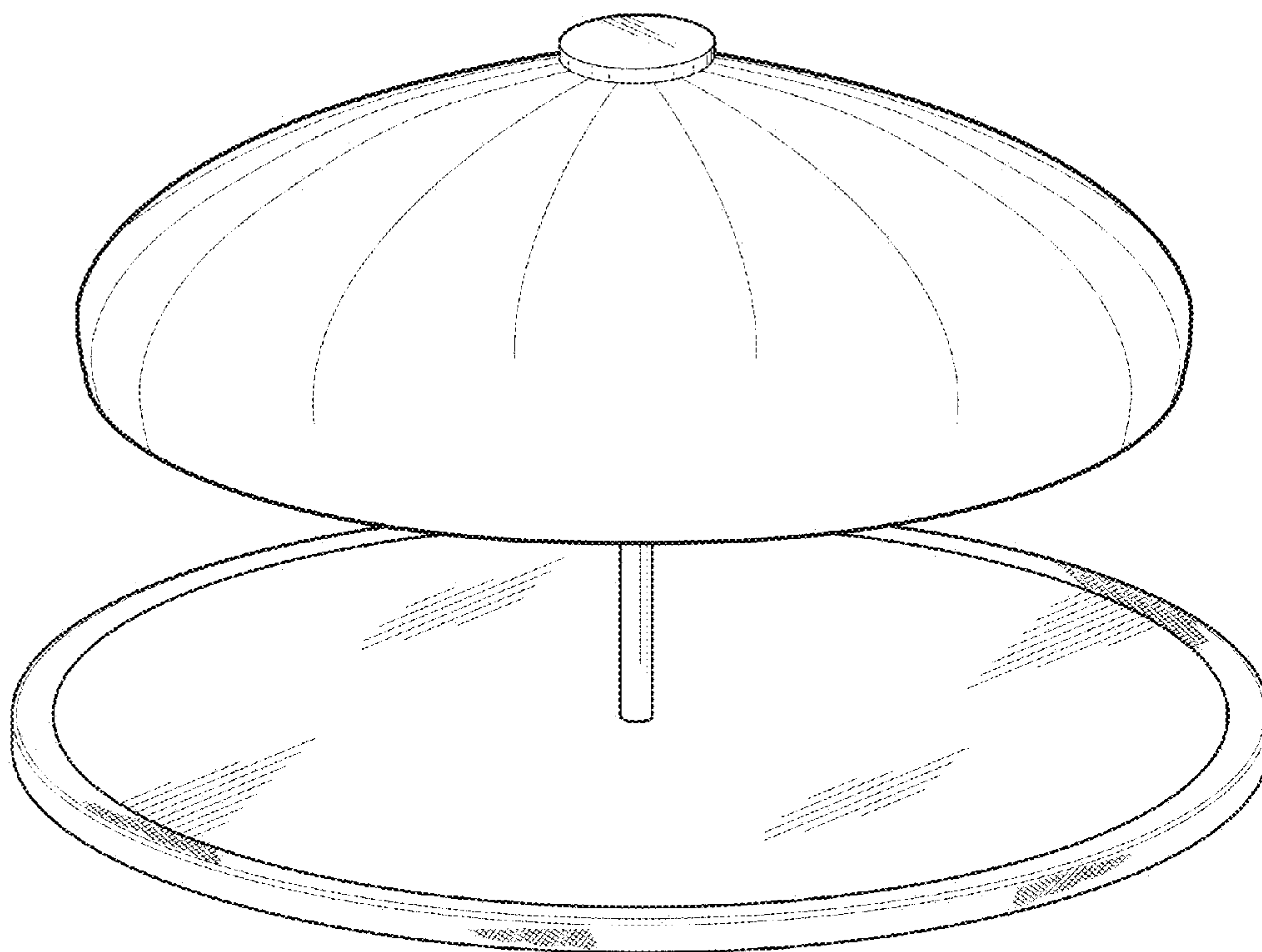
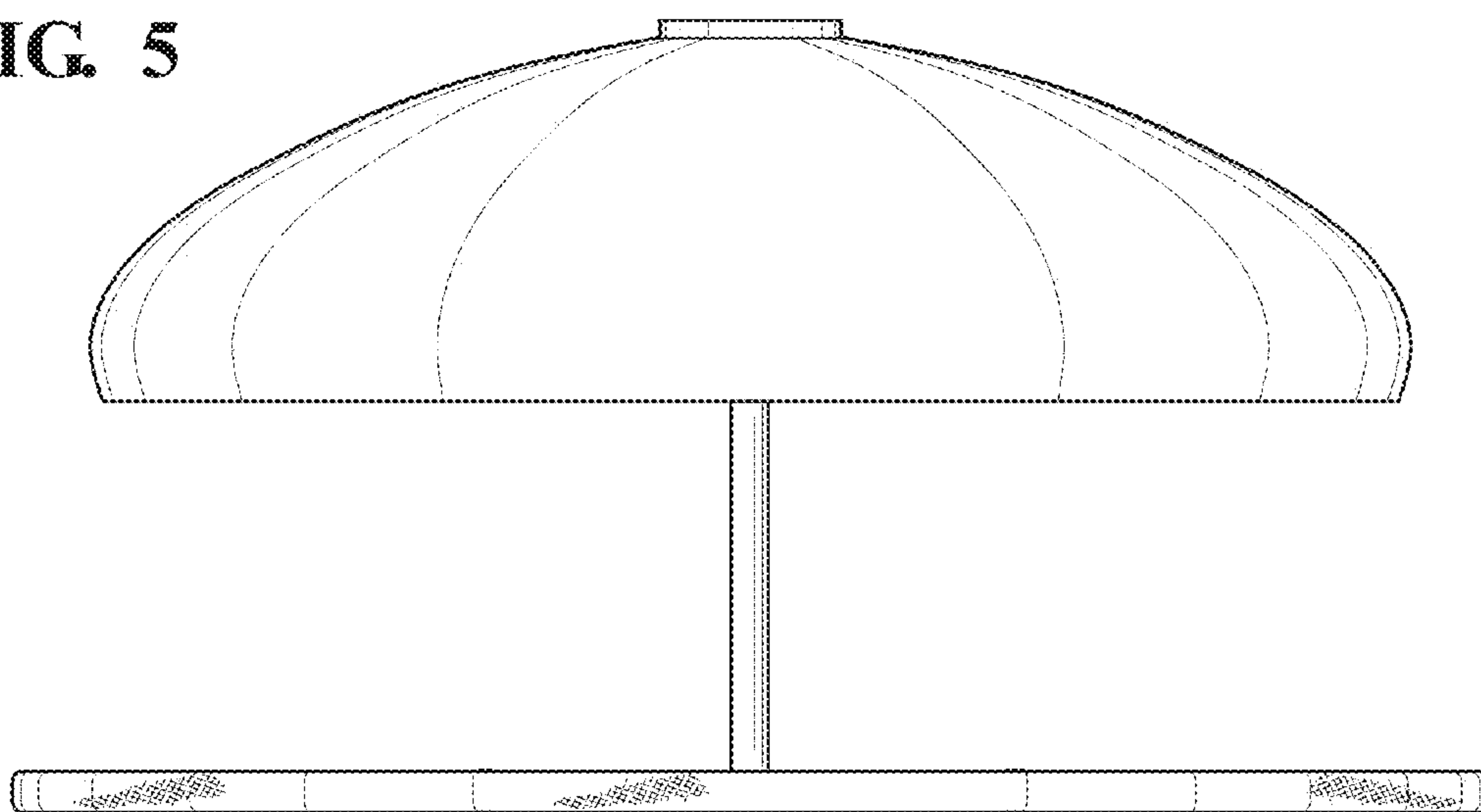

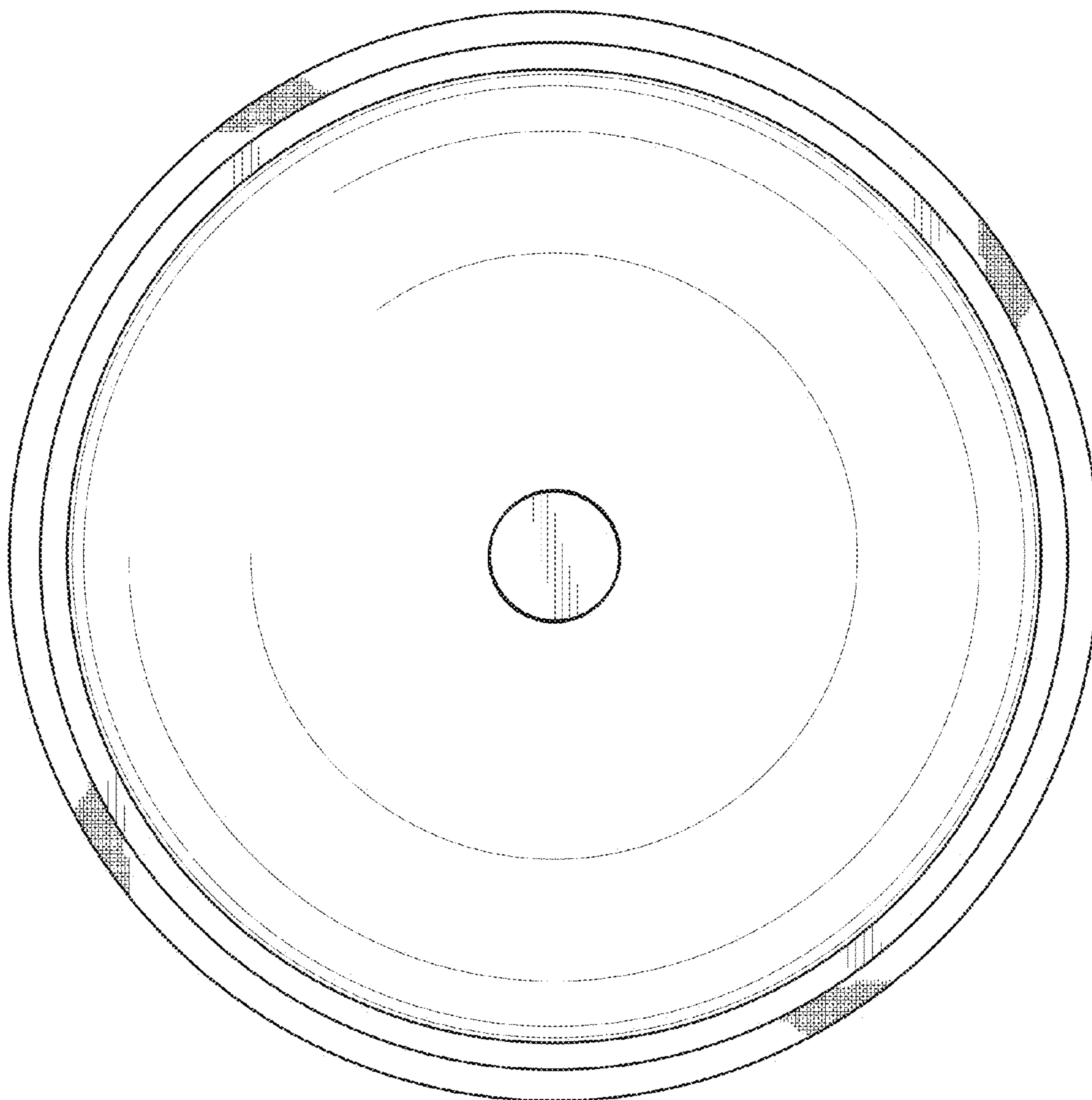

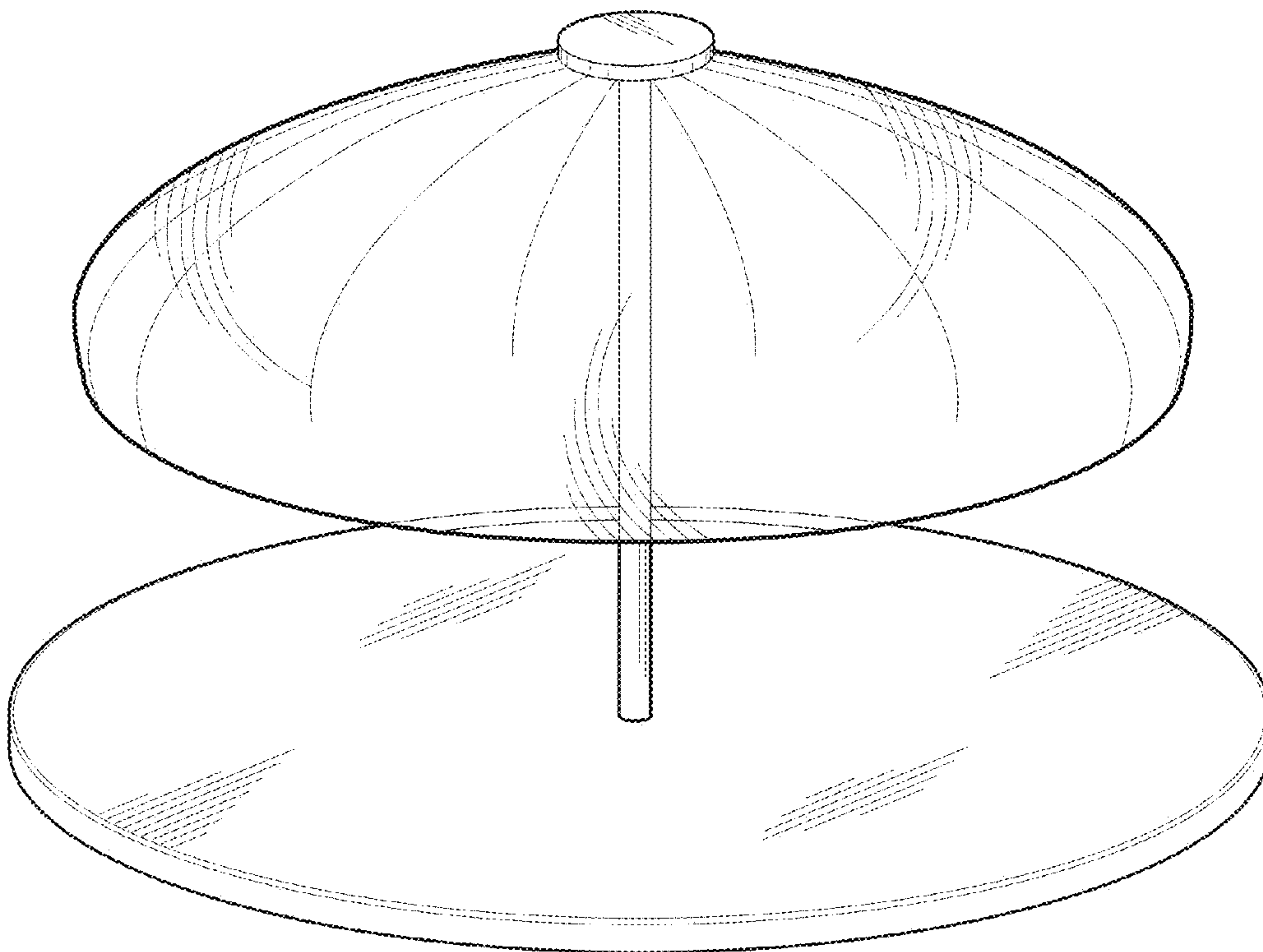
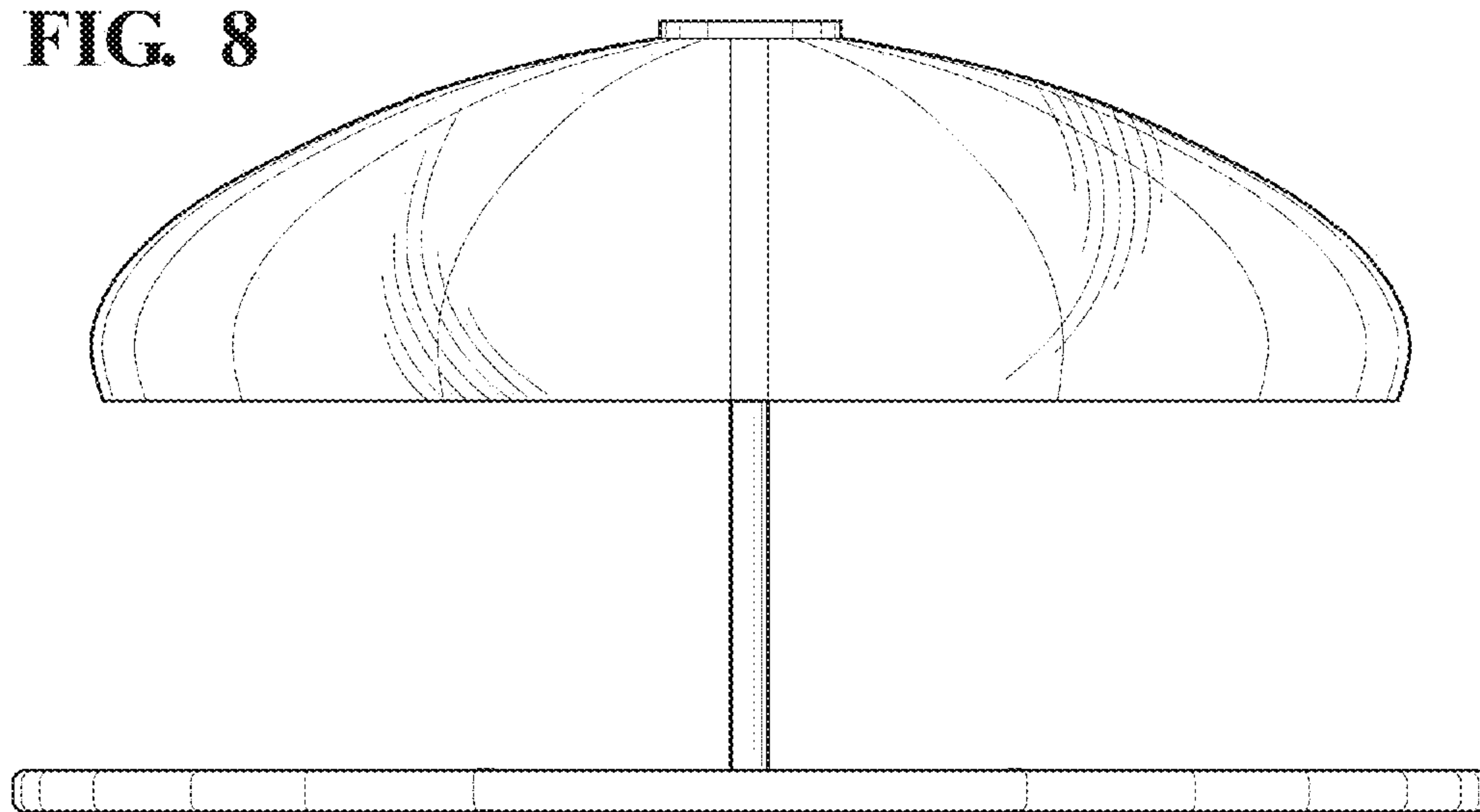

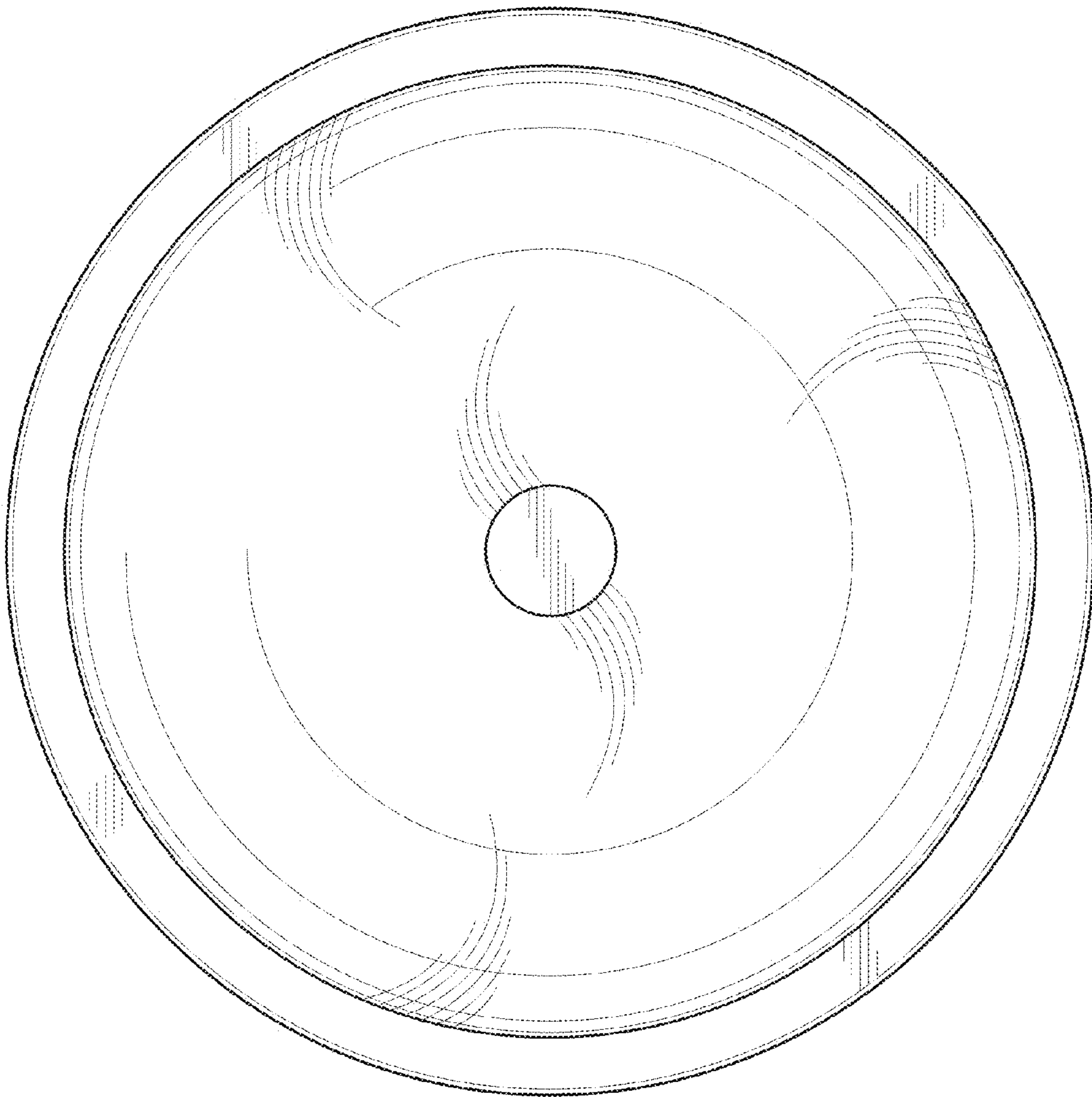

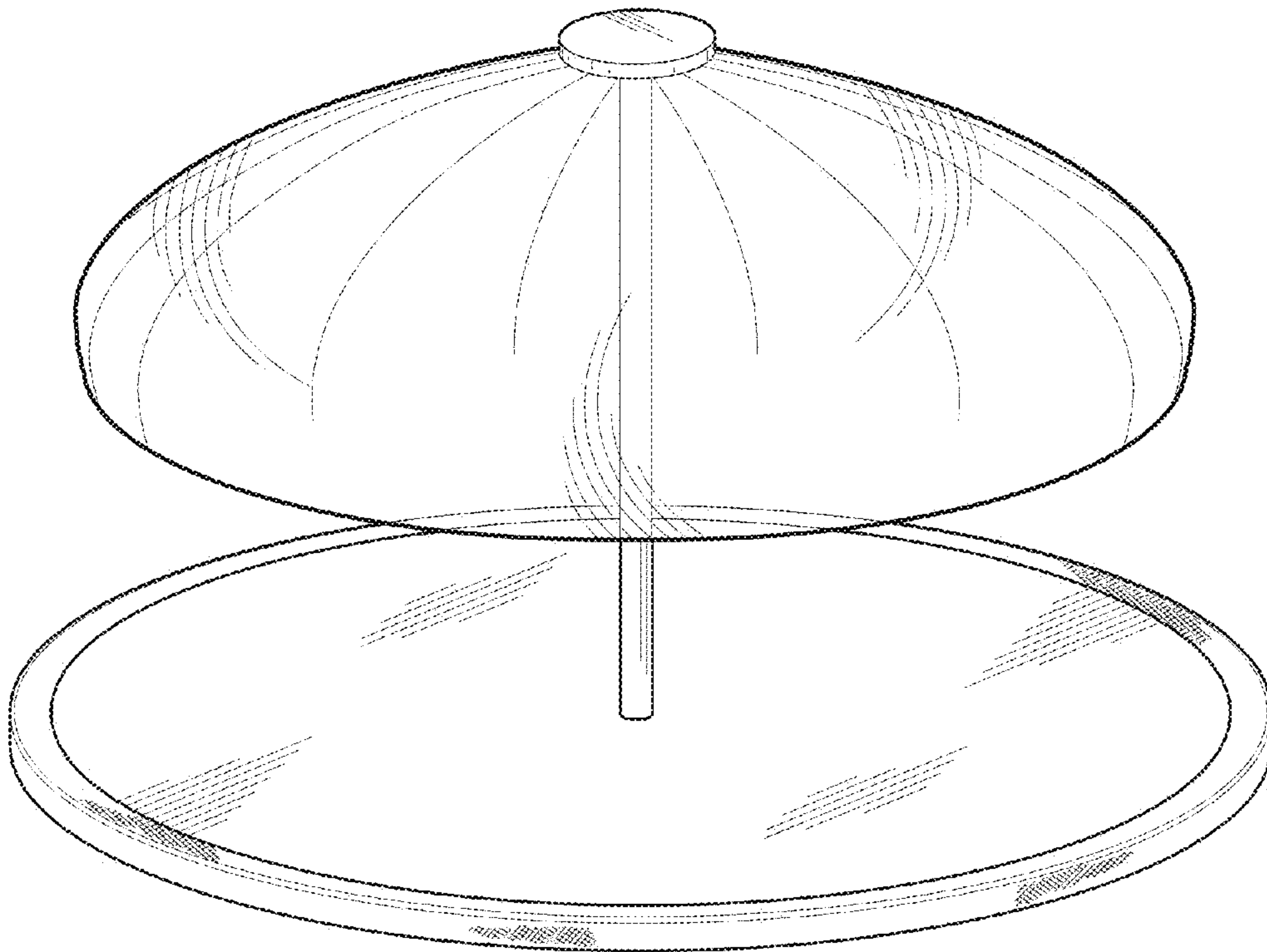
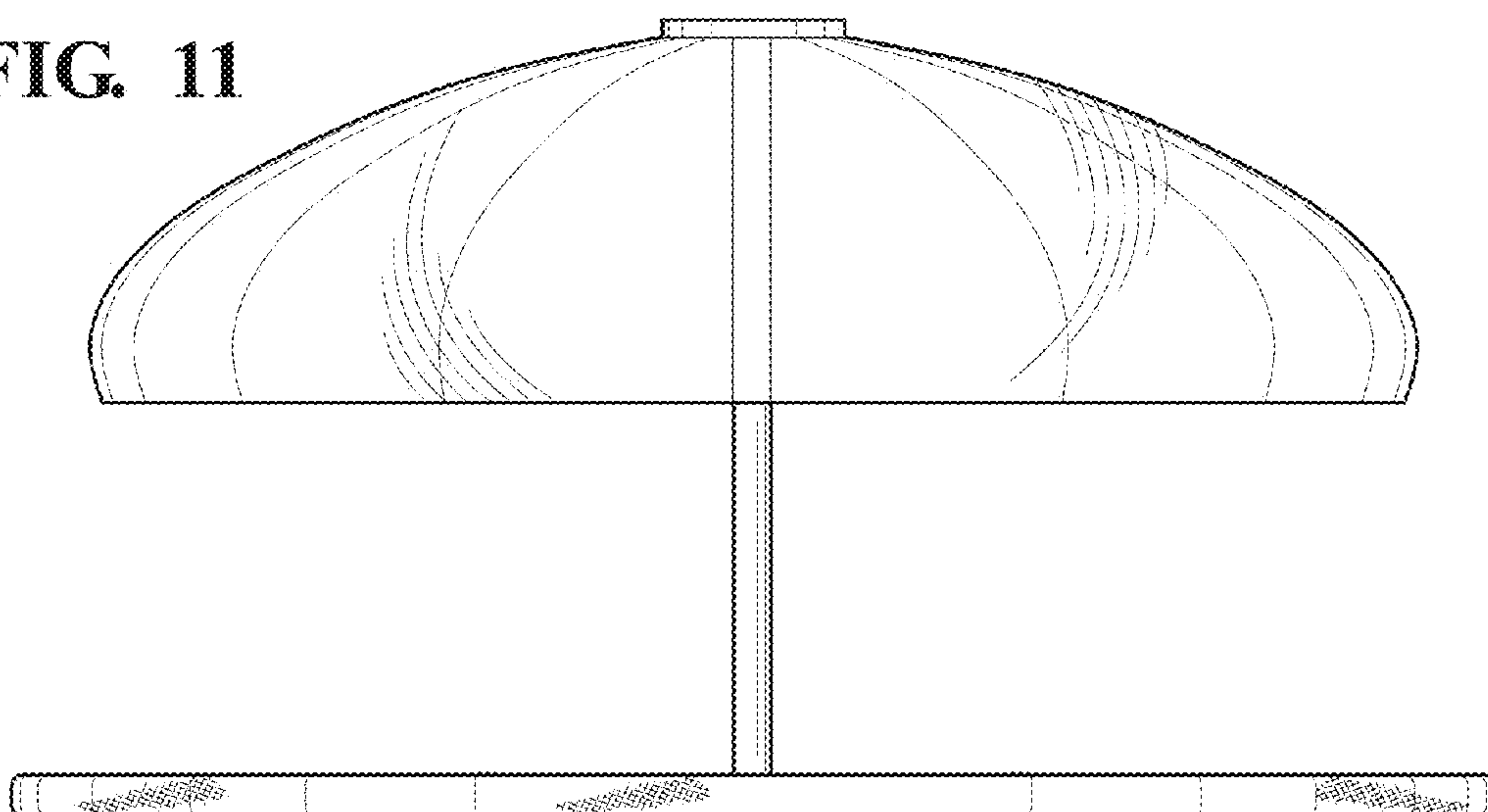

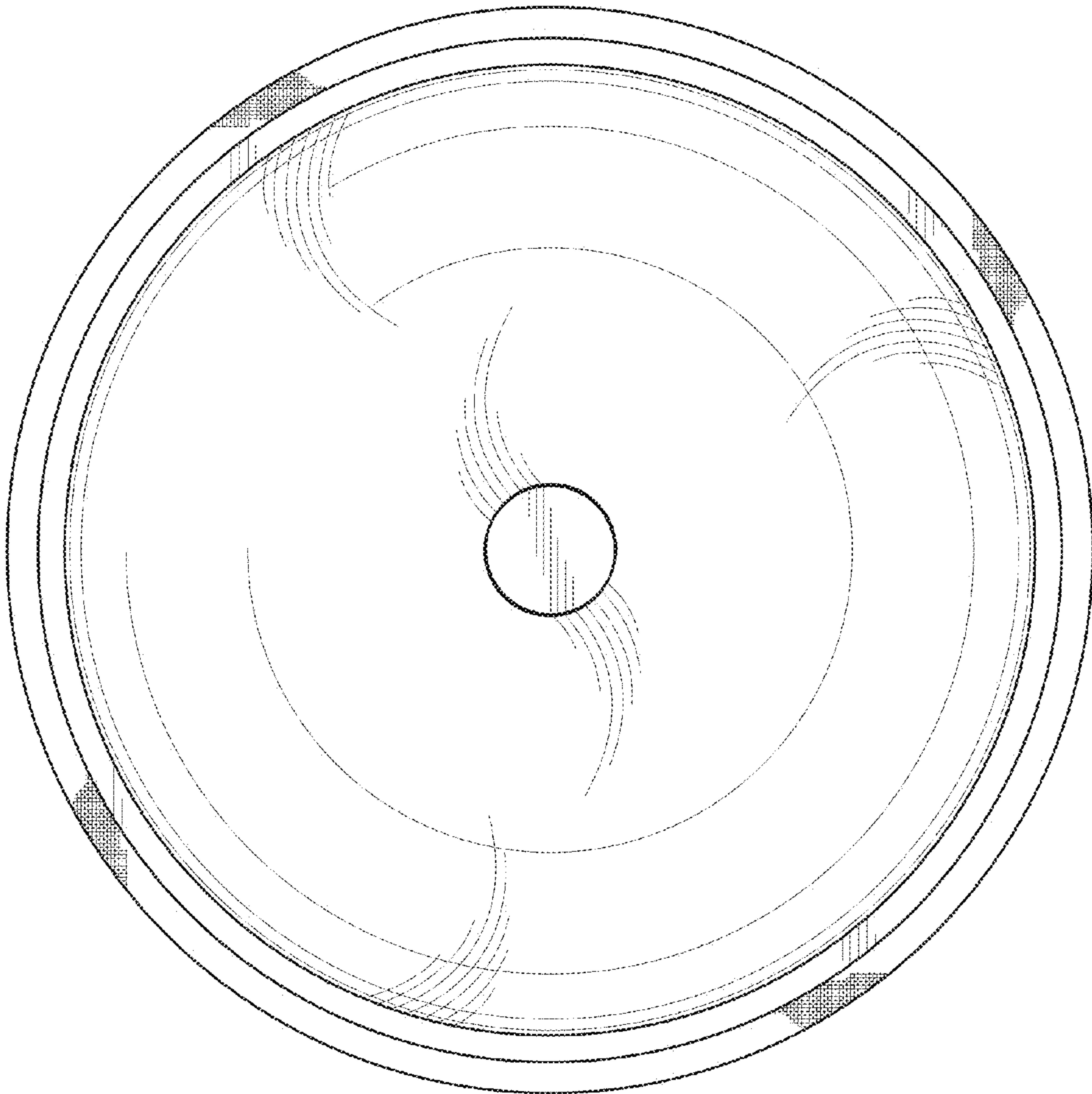
