(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a leg pad, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left side view of a leg pad in an as-worn configuration according to the present design;

FIG. 2 is a left, front, top perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side, rear perspective view thereof; and,


FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.







