(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a hygienic sheet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a hygienic sheet showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a partially enlarged front view showing a portion defined by lines 7-7 in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 8 is a partially enlarged front reference view showing the portion defined by lines 8-8 in FIG. 7;
 FIG. 9 is a partially enlarged front view showing the portion defined by lines 9-9 in FIG. 7;
 FIG. 10 is a sectional end view of a portion defined by lines 10-10 in FIG. 8;
 FIG. 11 is a sectional end view of a portion defined by lines 11-11 in FIG. 8; and,
 FIG. 12 is a sectional end view of a portion defined by lines 12-12 in FIG. 8.

The article pertaining to the design of the subject application is a hygienic sheet to be used for cleaning a toilet or the like. The sheet of this article is impregnated with a medical agent or the like.

The unevenly spaced broken lines consisting of a long and short dash depict the bounds of the claim, whereas the evenly spaced broken lines depict environmental subject matter. None of the broken lines form a part of the claimed design.

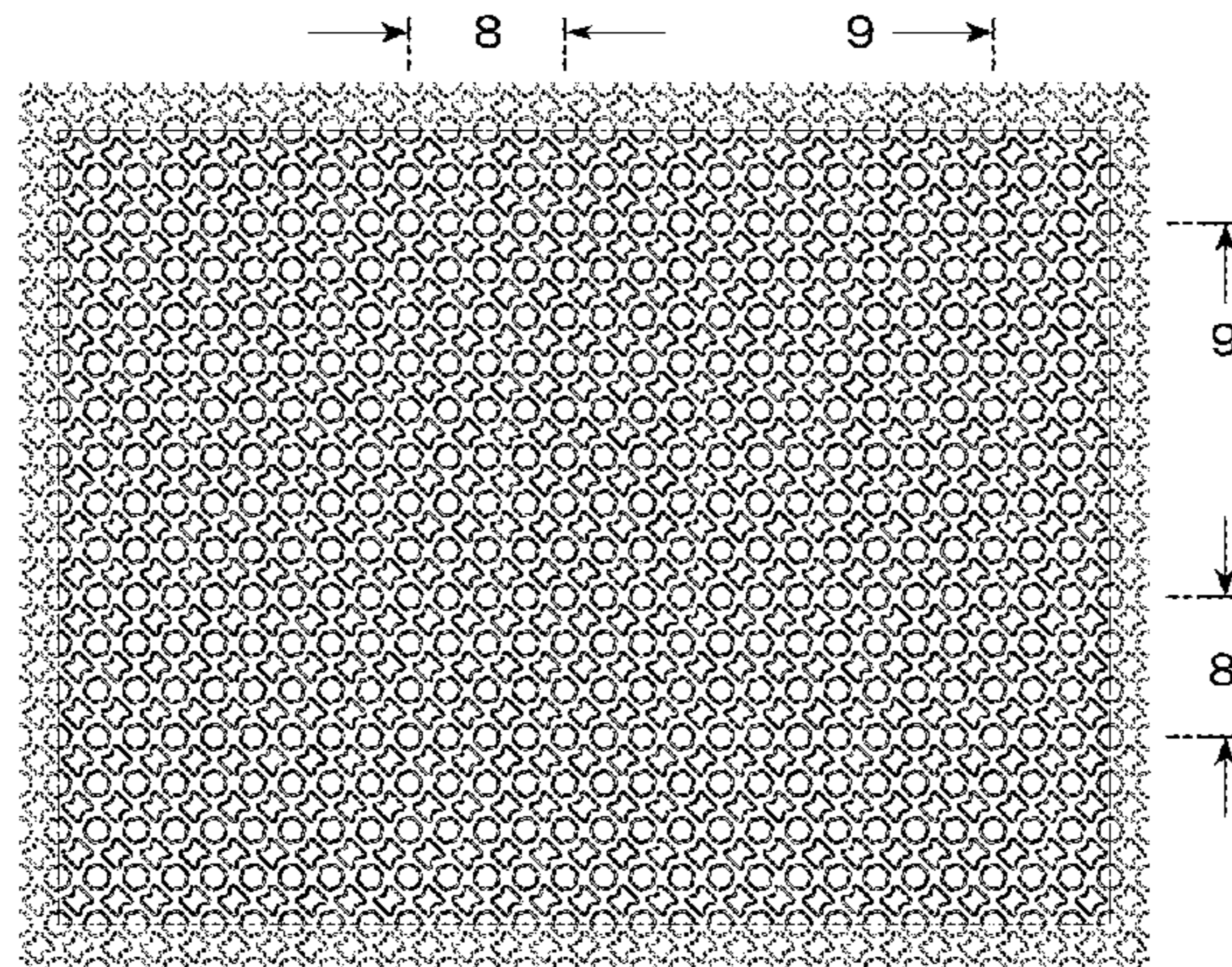

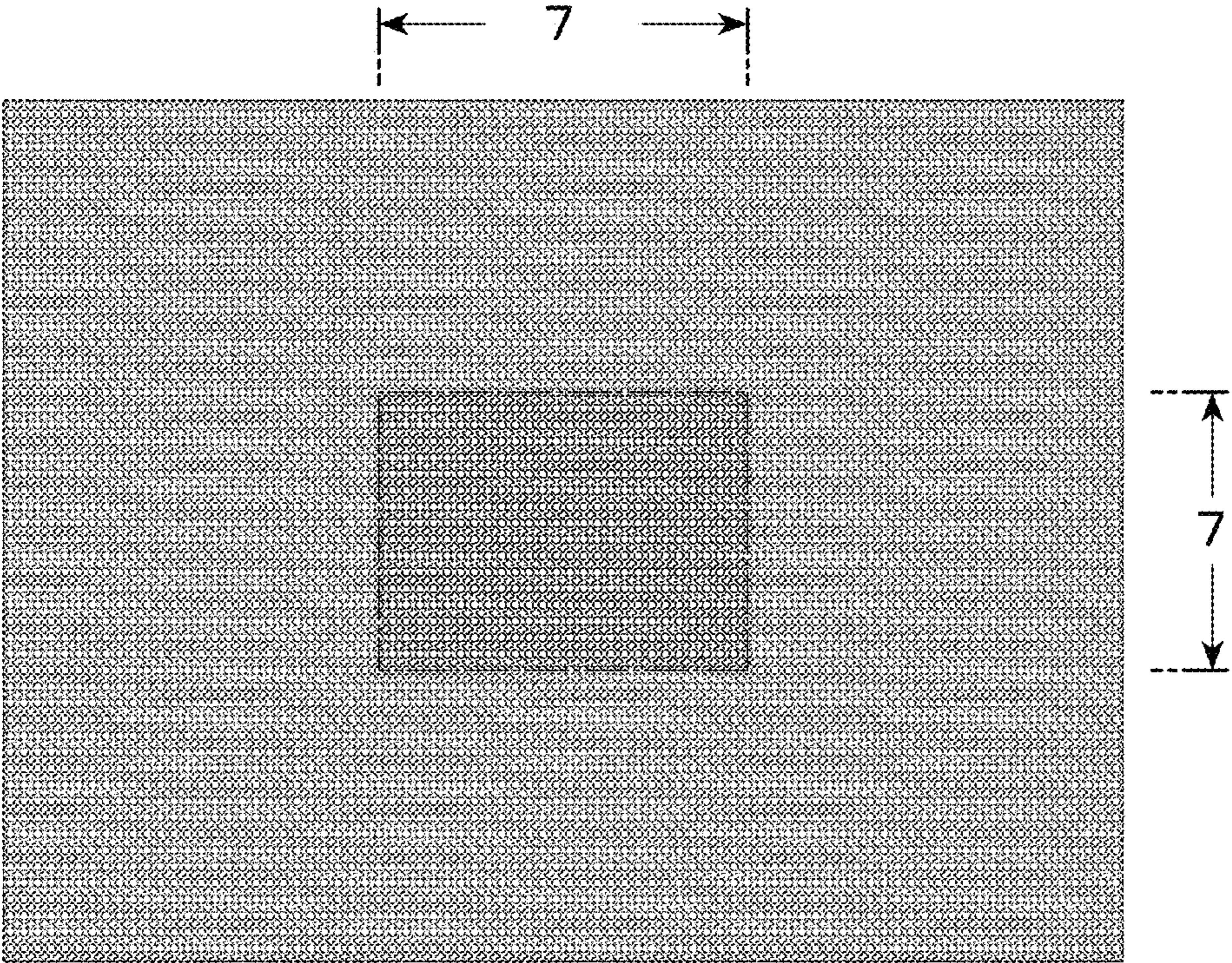

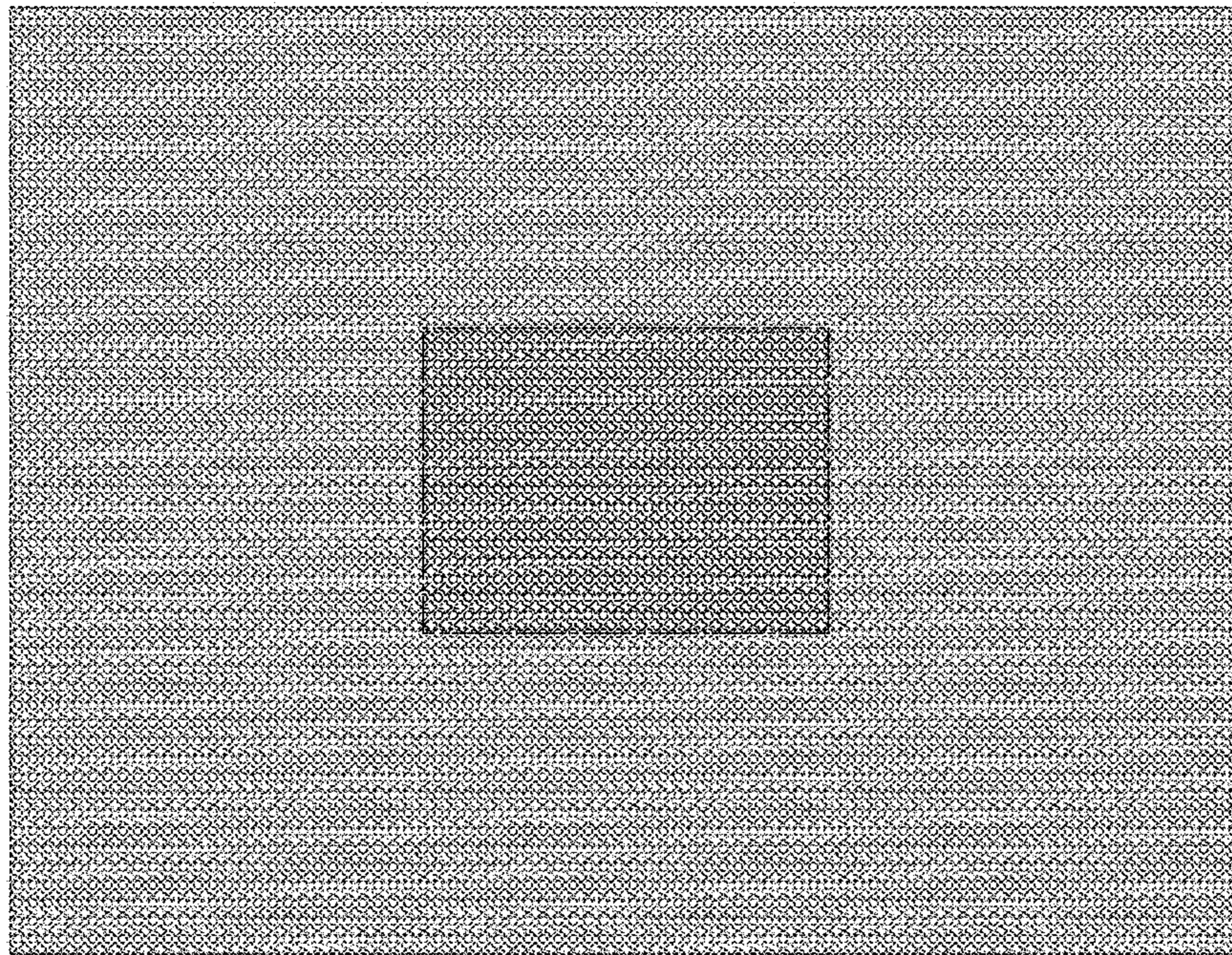

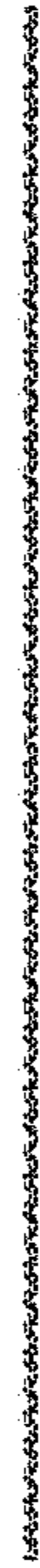

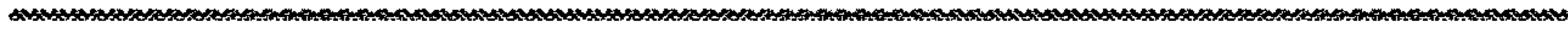

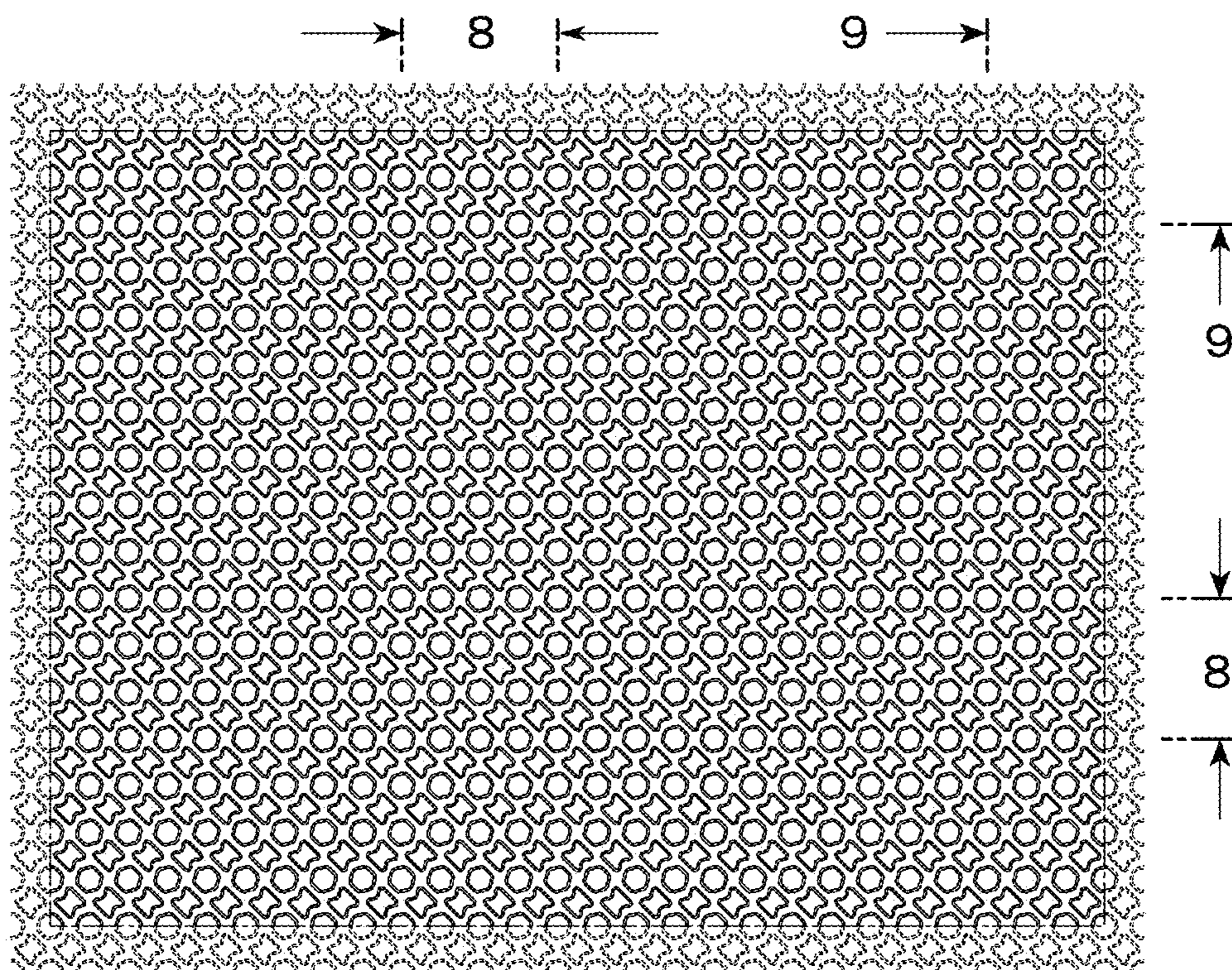

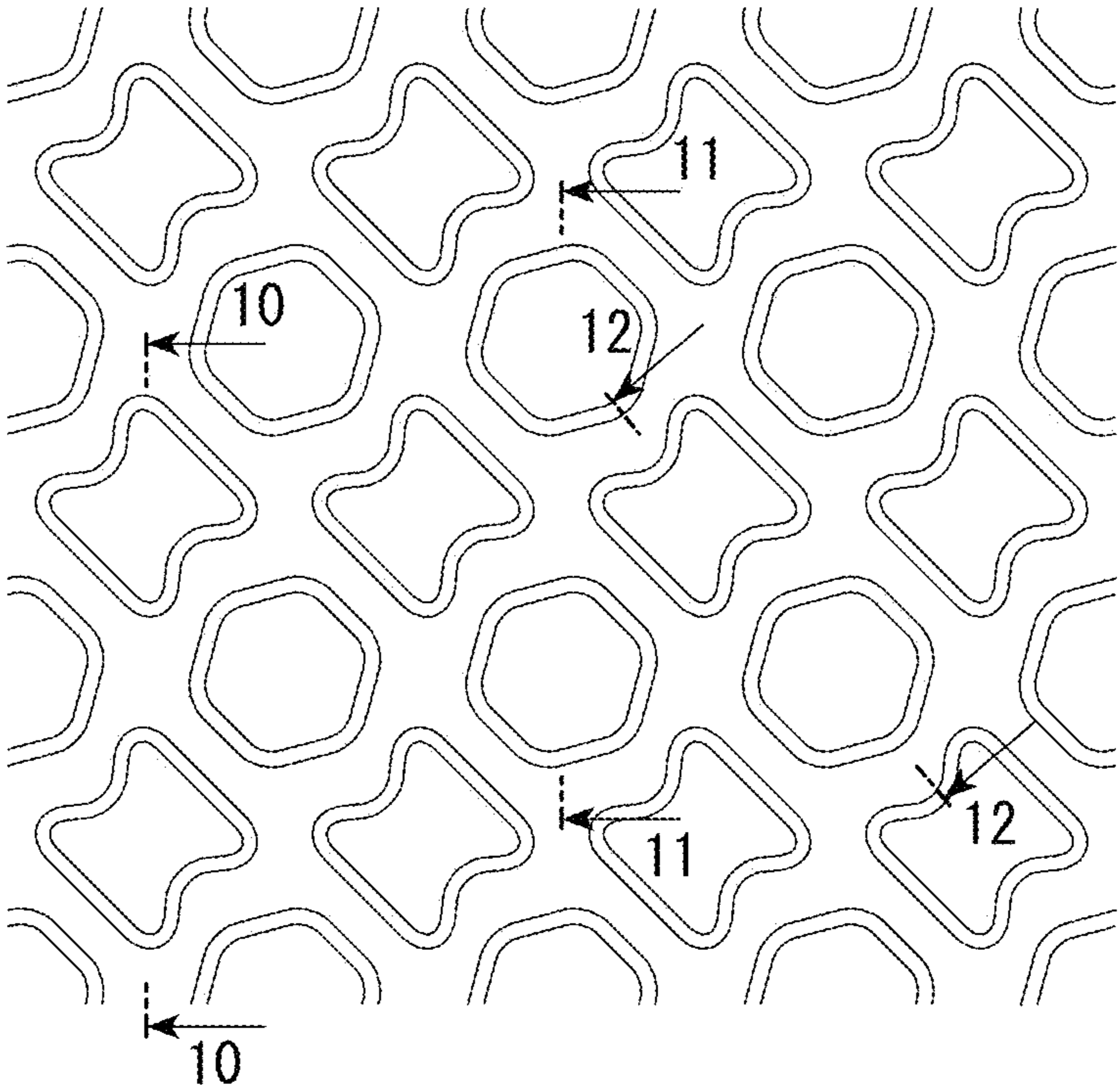

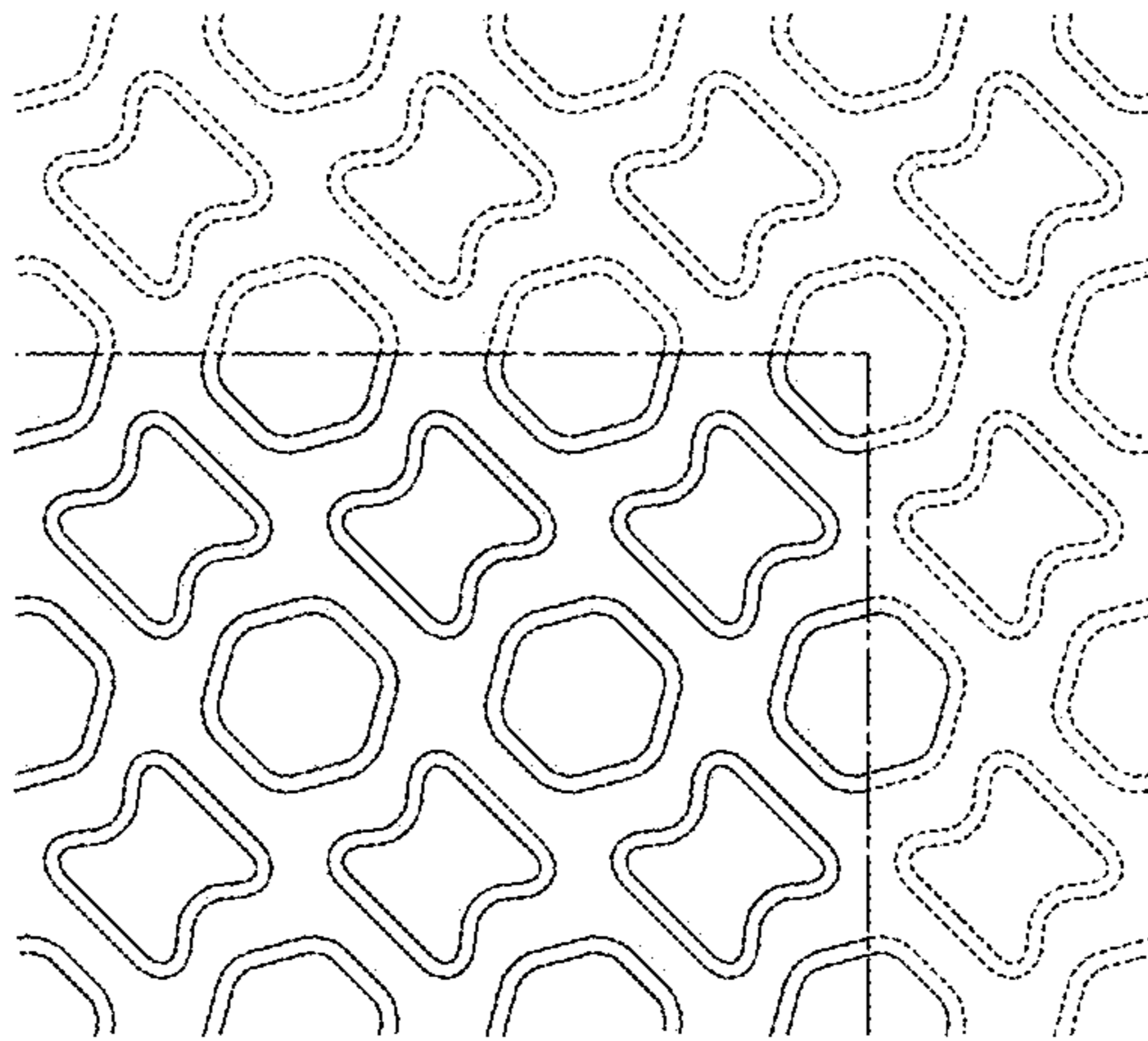

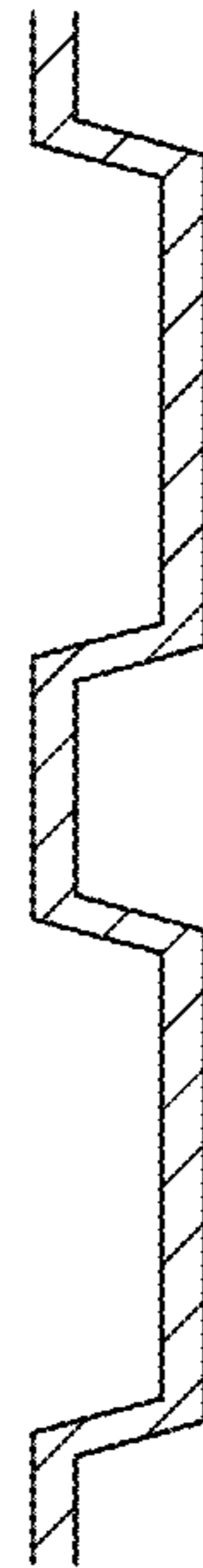
