

The ornamental design for a convertible bag, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom view of a first embodiment of the convertible bag in mat configuration;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the convertible bag of FIG. 1 in mat configuration;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the convertible bag of FIG. 1 in mat configuration;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the convertible bag of FIG. 1 in an intermediate (folded and zipped) configuration;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the convertible bag of FIG. 1 in a bag (drawstrings pulled) configuration;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the convertible bag of FIG. 1 in a bag configuration;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of a second embodiment of the convertible bag in mat configuration;
FIG. 8 is a top view of the convertible bag of FIG. 7 in mat configuration;
FIG. 9 is a side view of the convertible bag of FIG. 7 in mat configuration;
FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the convertible bag of FIG. 7 in an intermediate (folded and zipped) configuration;
FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of the convertible bag of FIG. 7 in a bag (drawstrings pulled) configuration;
FIG. 12 is a perspective view of the convertible bag of FIG. 7 in a bag configuration;
FIG. 13 is a bottom view of a third embodiment of the convertible bag in mat configuration;
FIG. 14 is a top view of the convertible bag of FIG. 13 in mat configuration;
FIG. 15 is a side view of the convertible bag of FIG. 13 in mat configuration;
FIG. 16 is a front elevational view of the convertible bag of FIG. 13 in an intermediate (folded and zipped) configuration;
FIG. 17 is a front elevational view of the convertible bag of FIG. 13 in a bag (drawstrings pulled) configuration; and,
FIG. 18 is a perspective view of the convertible bag of FIG. 13 in a bag configuration.

The broken line showing of portions of the convertible bag is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design.


























