I claim the ornamental design for a pad for capturing cooking grease, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and side perspective view of the pad for capturing cooking grease embodying the design of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top.

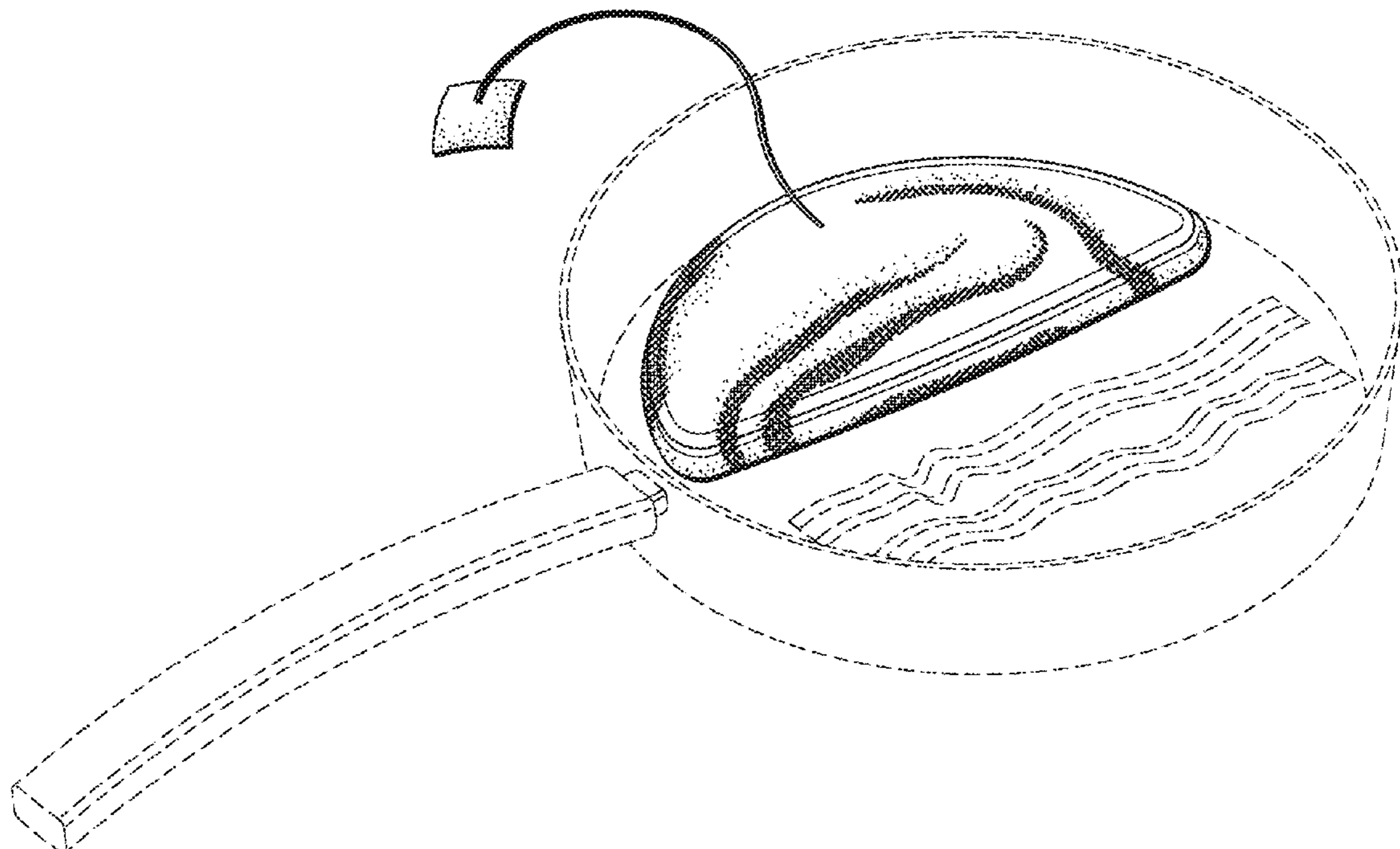
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.

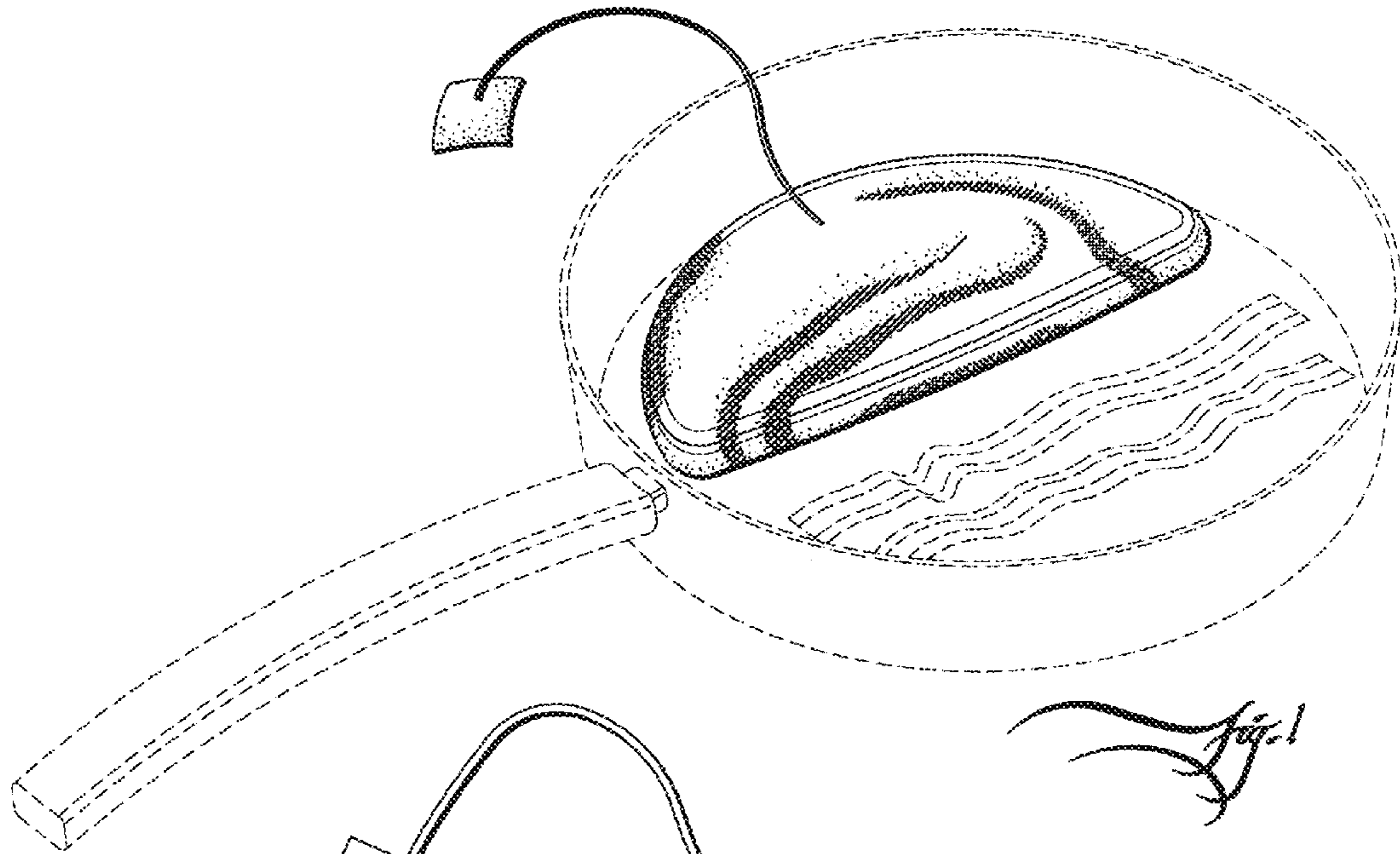

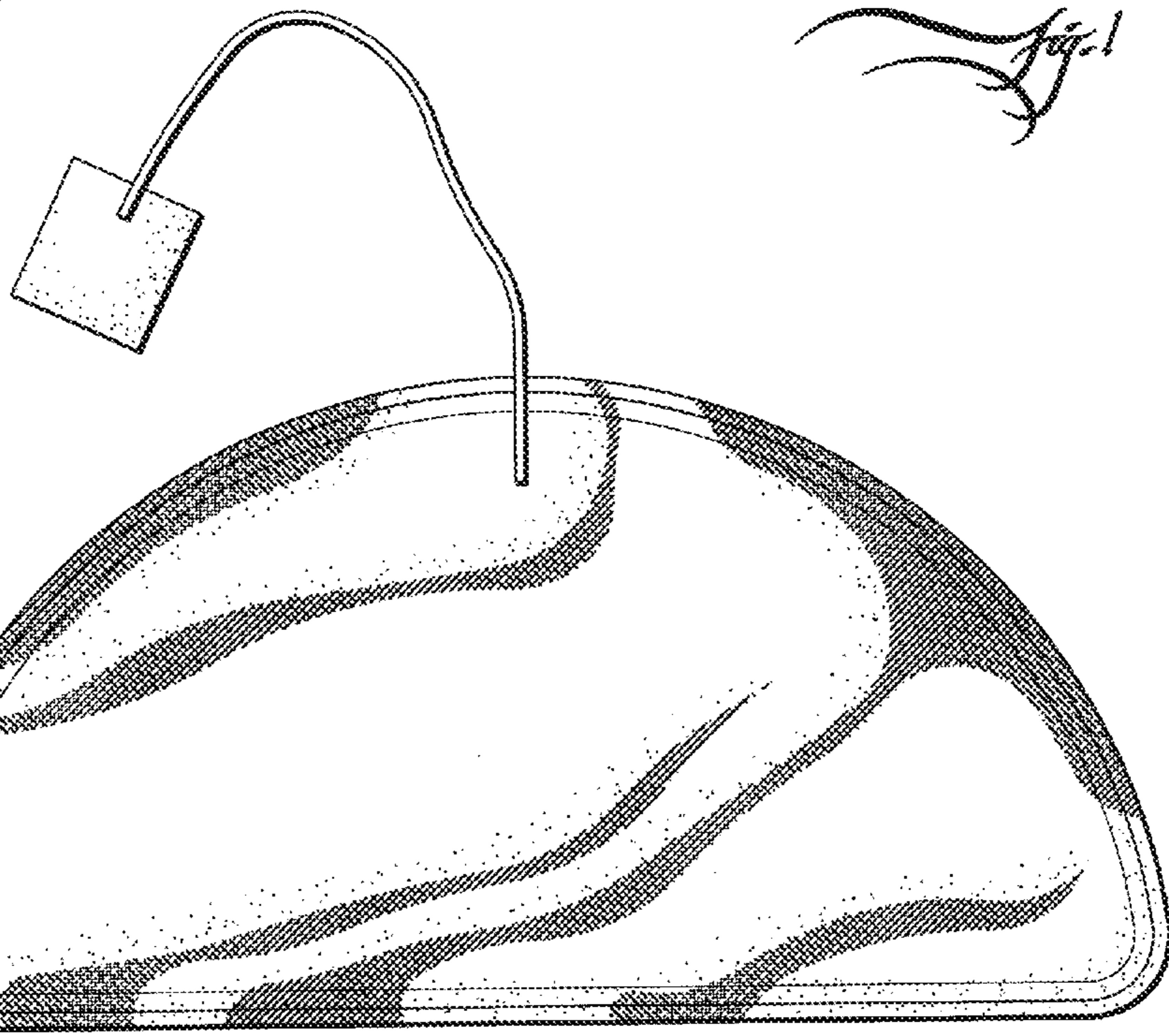

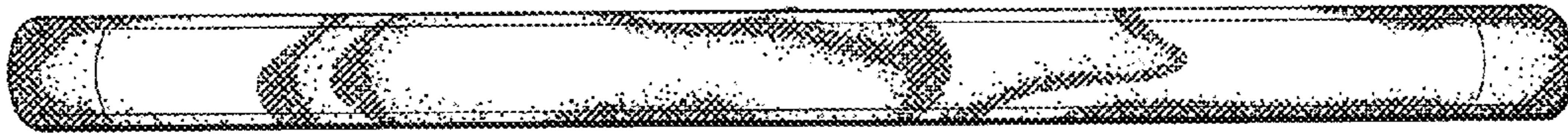

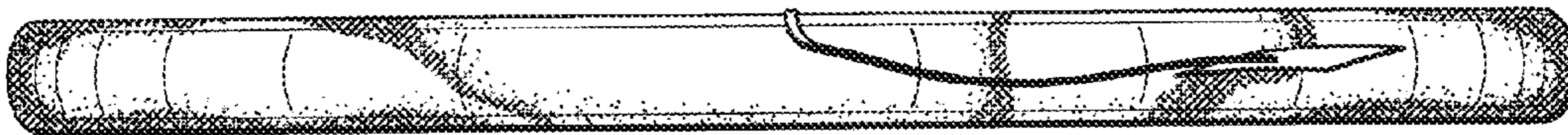
