(57) **CLAIM**

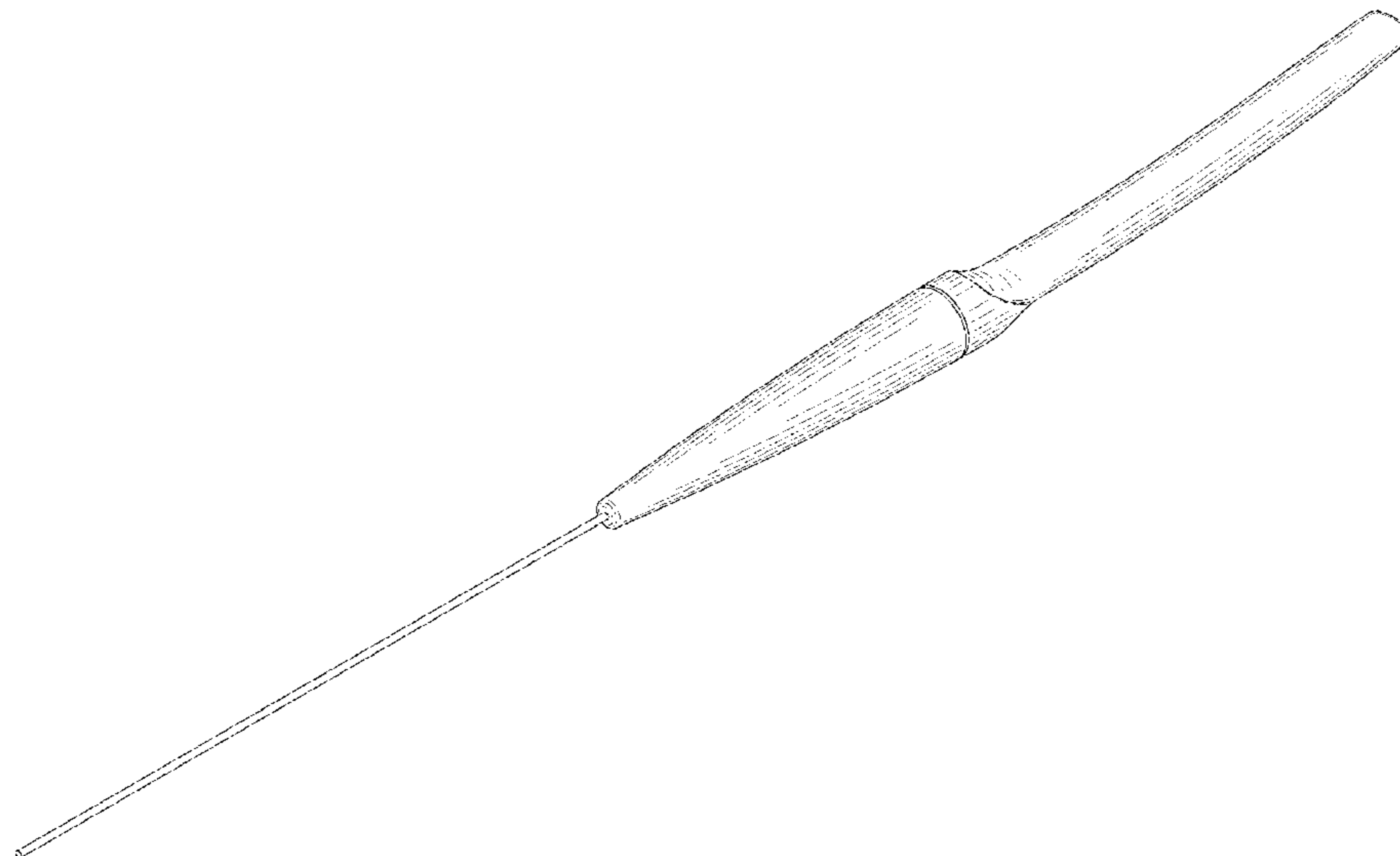
The ornamental design for a baking tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the baking tool according to one embodiment of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a first plan view thereof,
FIG. 3 is a second plan view thereof, opposite from the first plan view;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof,
FIG. 5 is a first end view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a second end view thereof, opposite from the first end view;
FIG. 7 is a top perspective view of the baking tool according to another embodiment of the present invention;
FIG. 8 is a first plan view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a second plan view thereof, opposite from the first plan view;

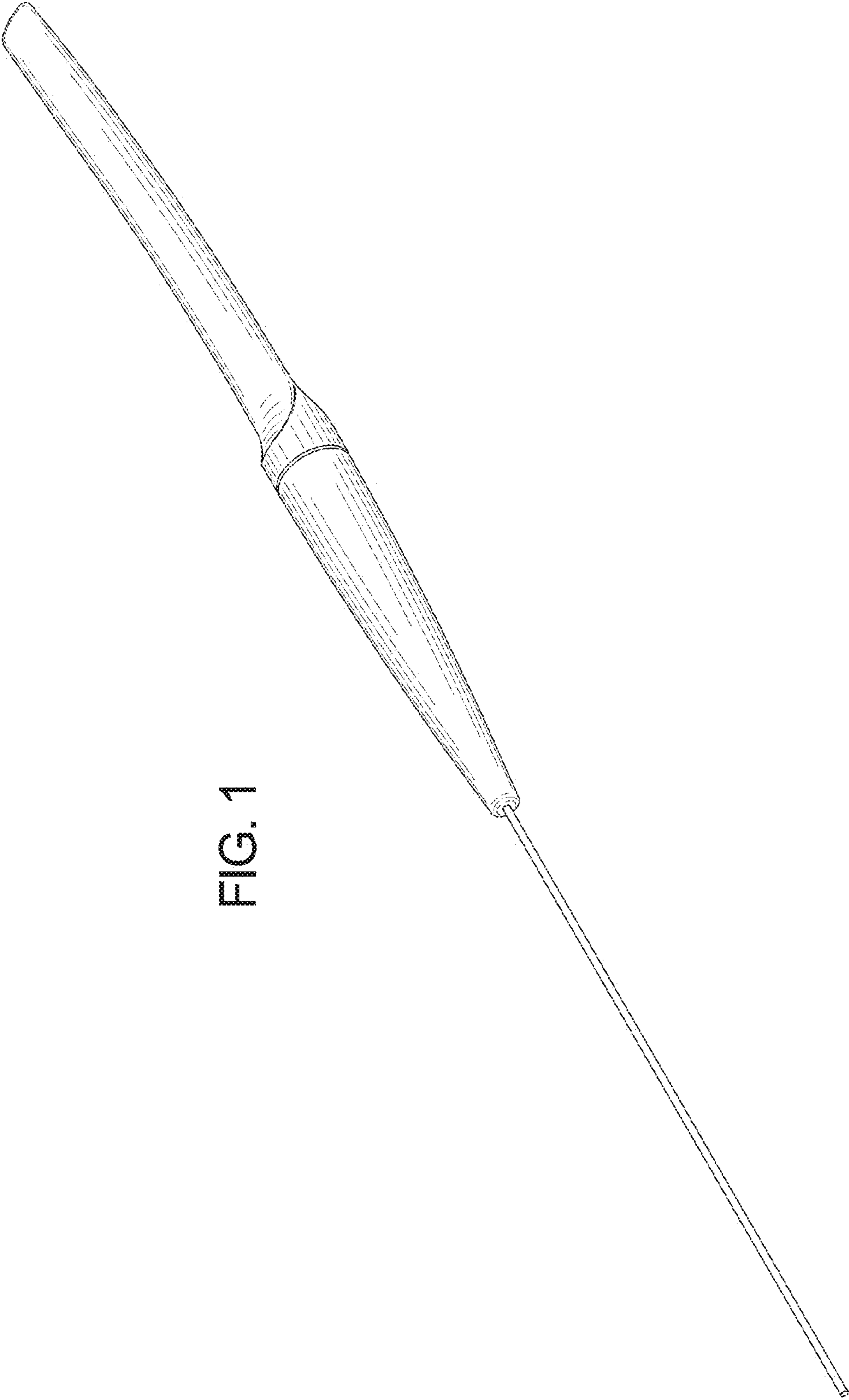

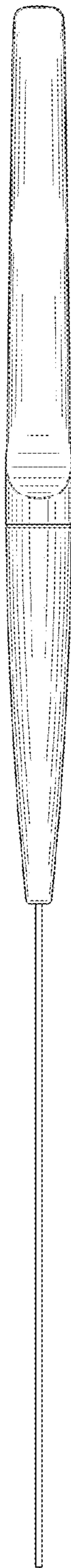

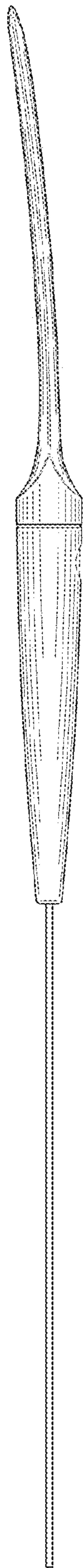

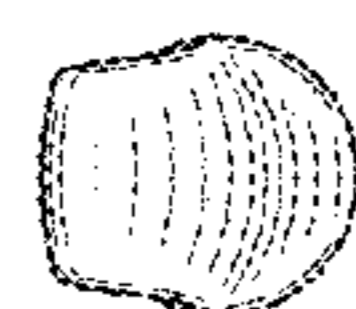

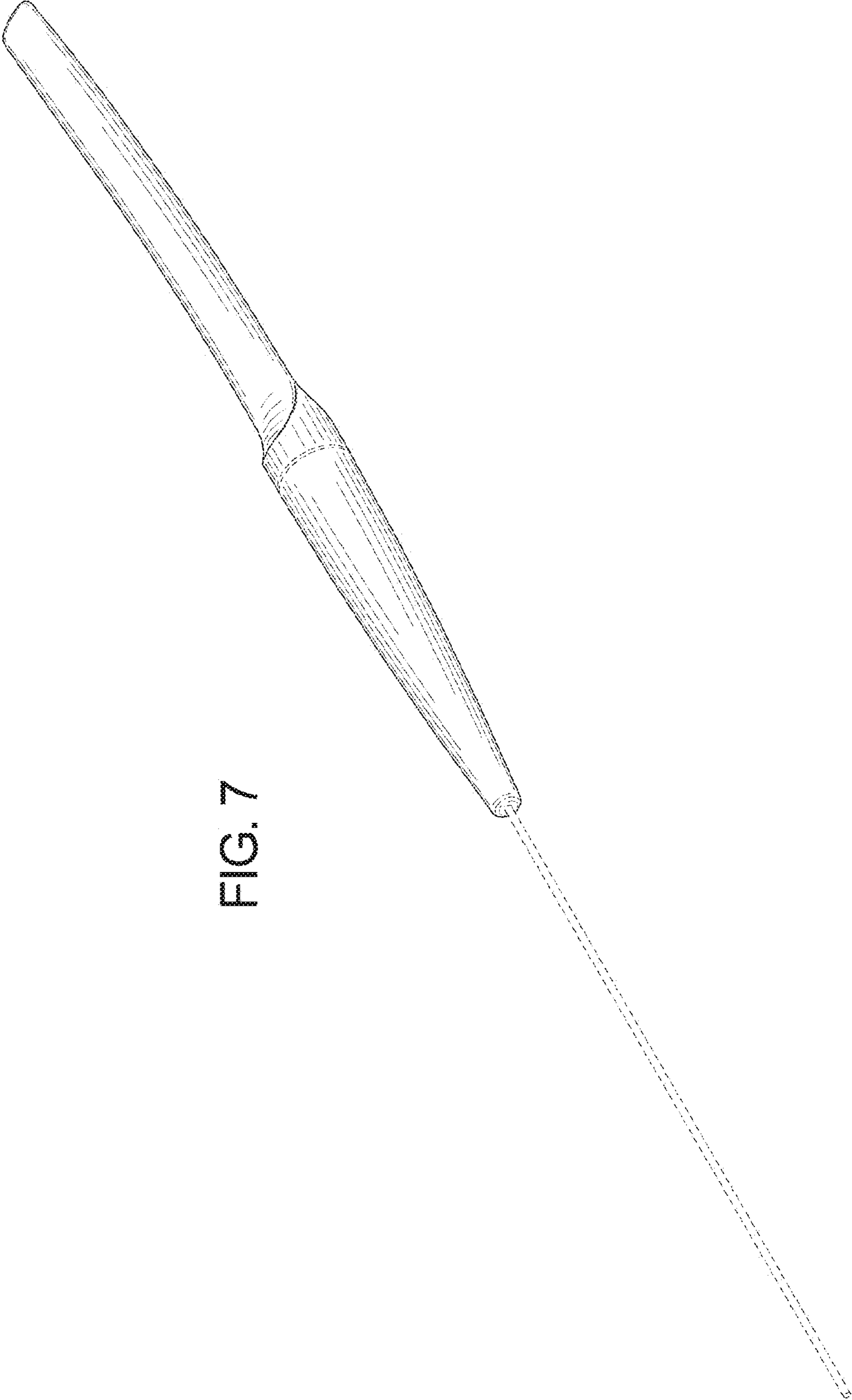

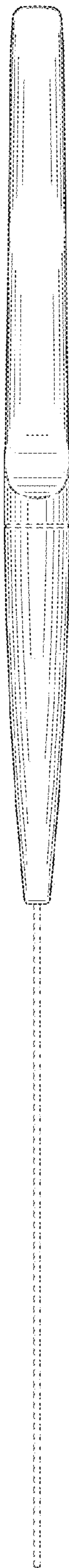

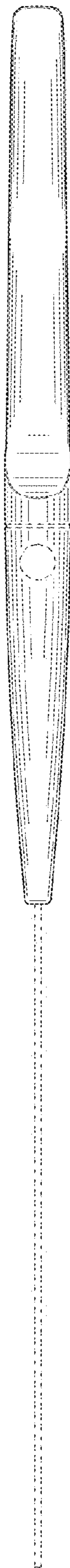

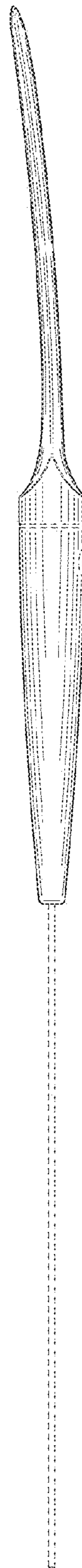
