FIG. 5 is a front view of a clamp with an articulating extension.

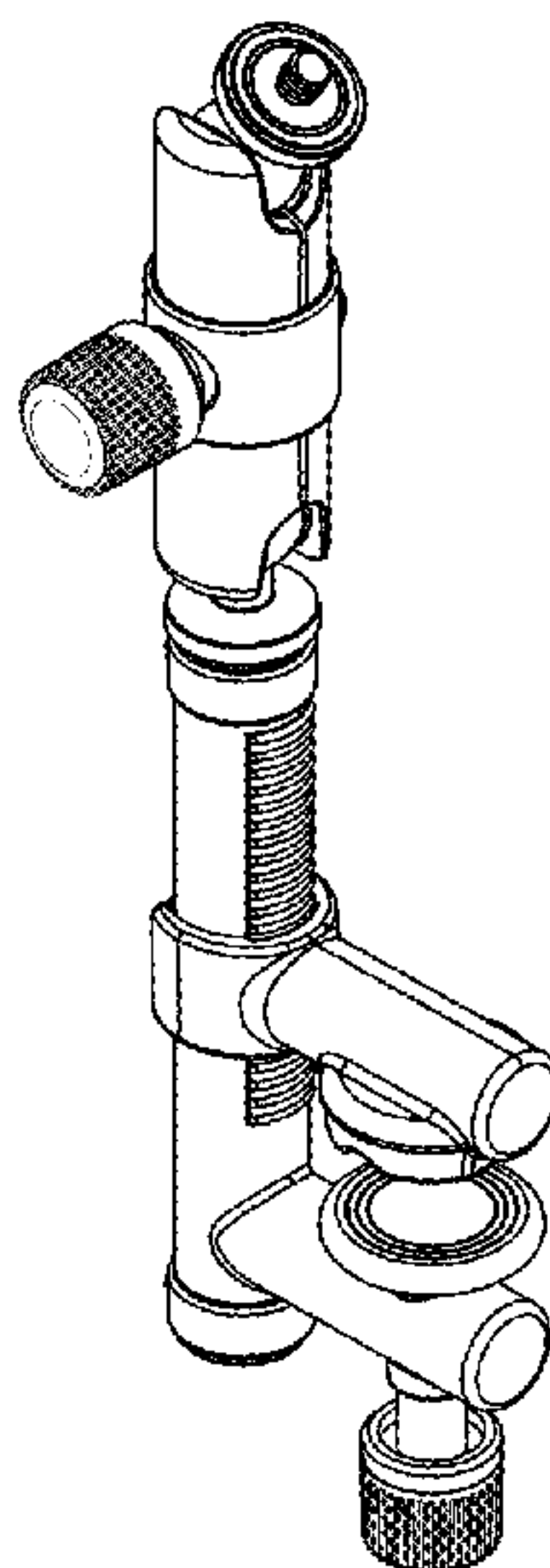
FIG. 6 is a top view of a clamp with an articulating extension.

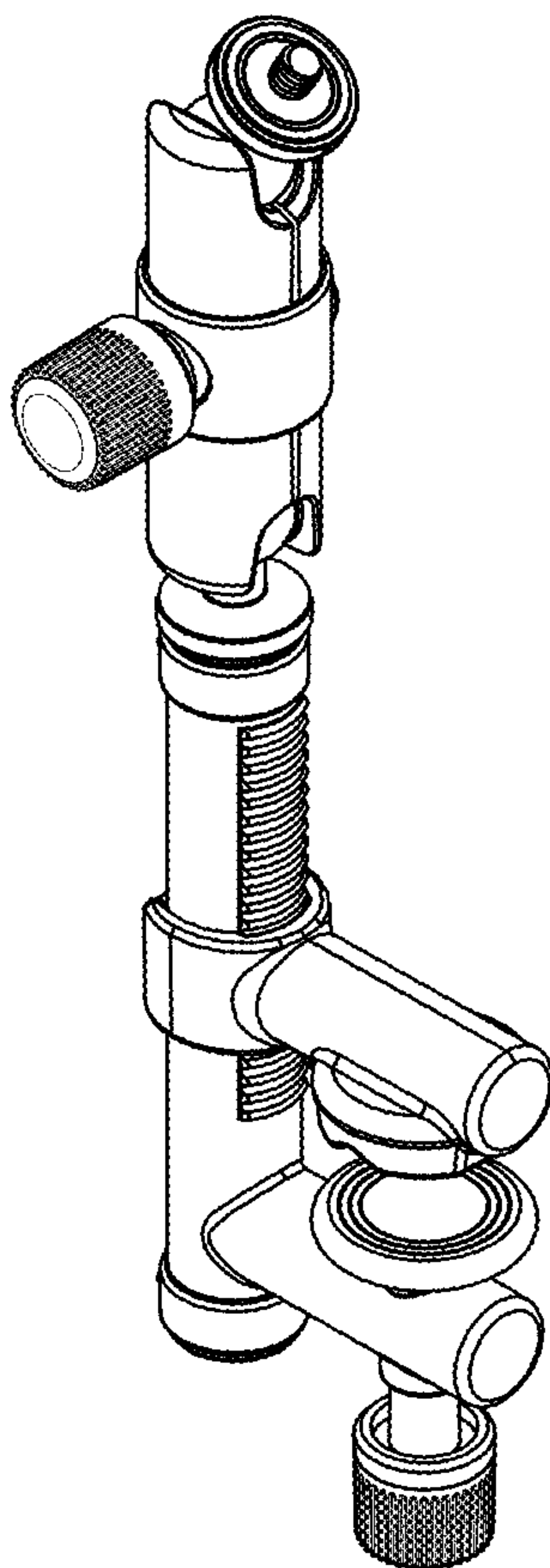

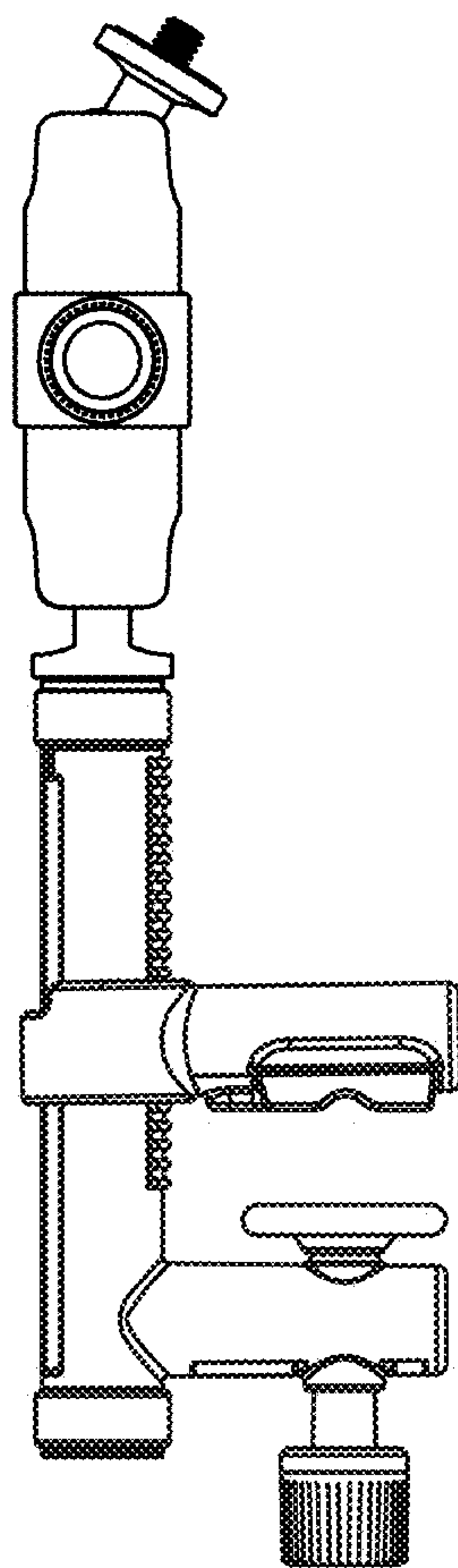

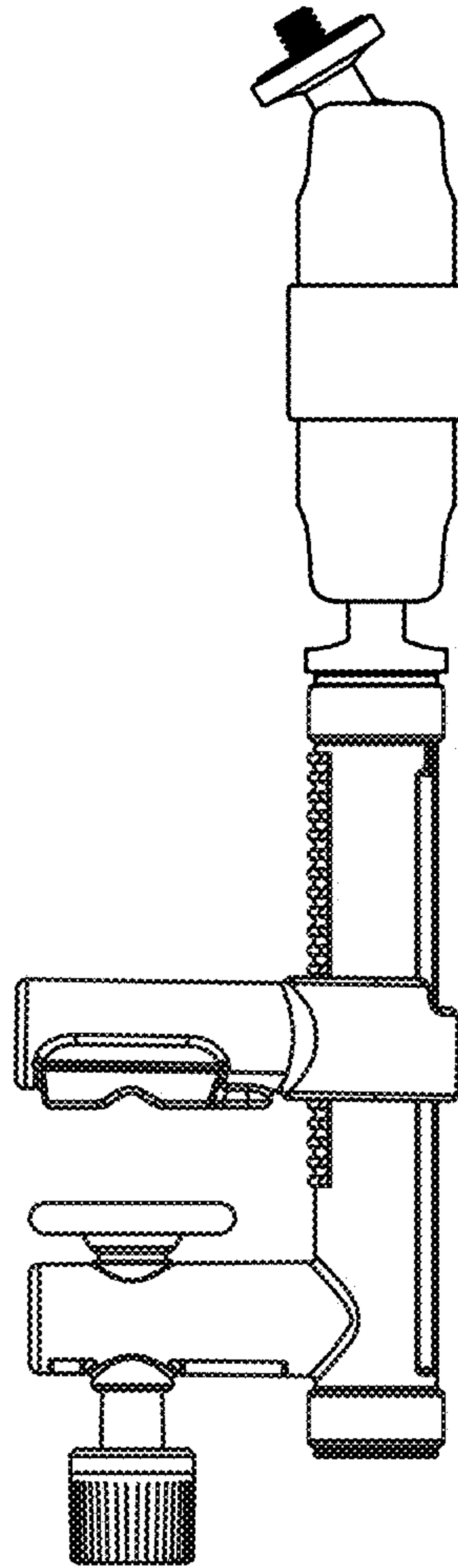

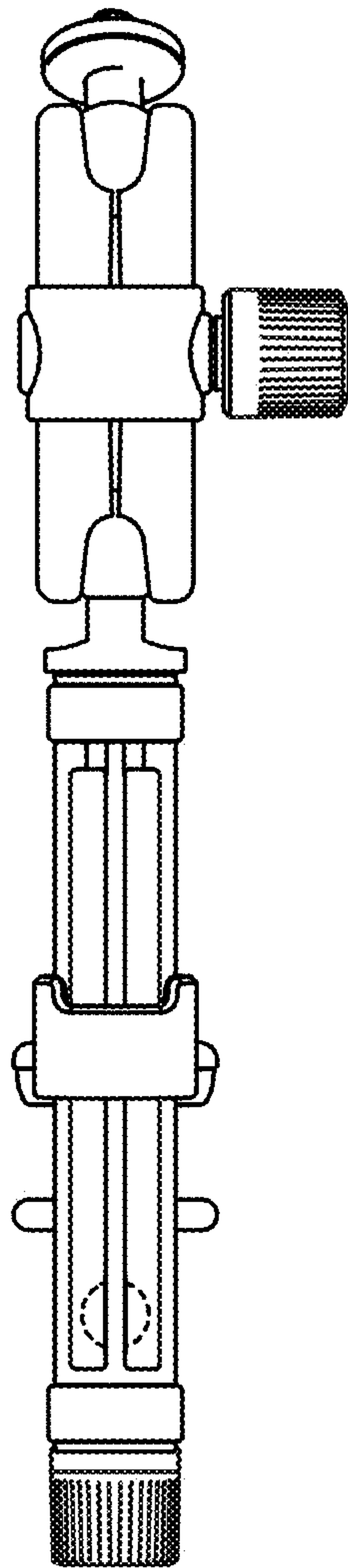

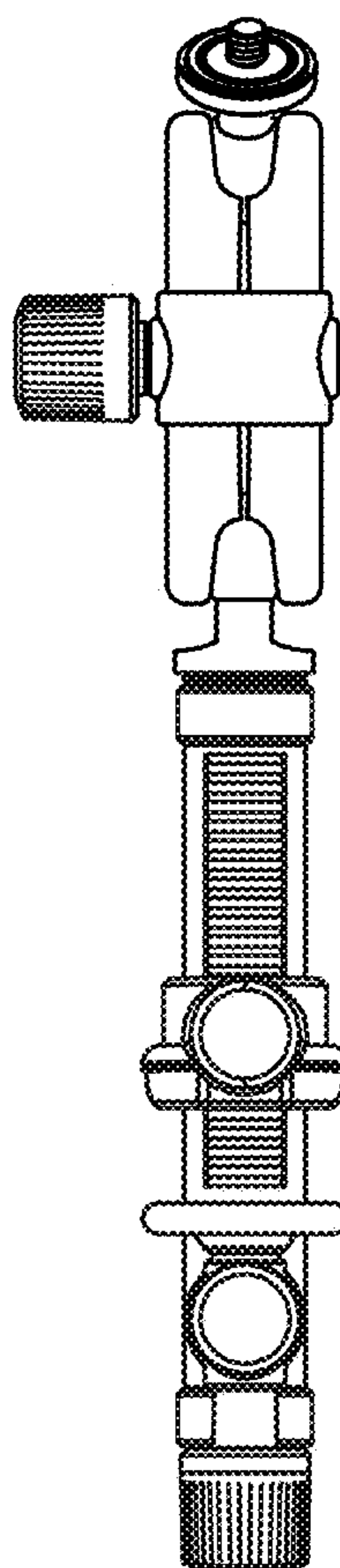

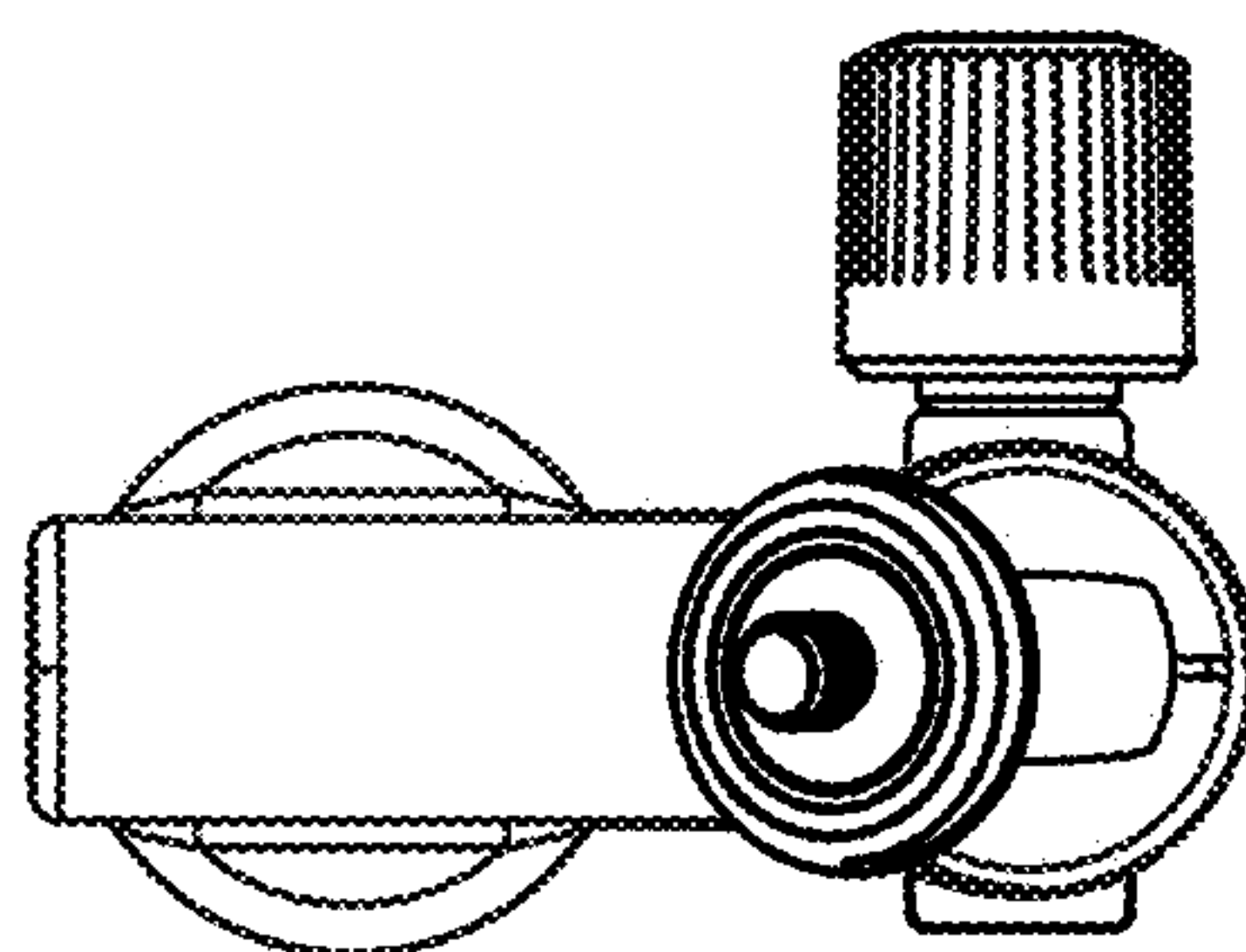

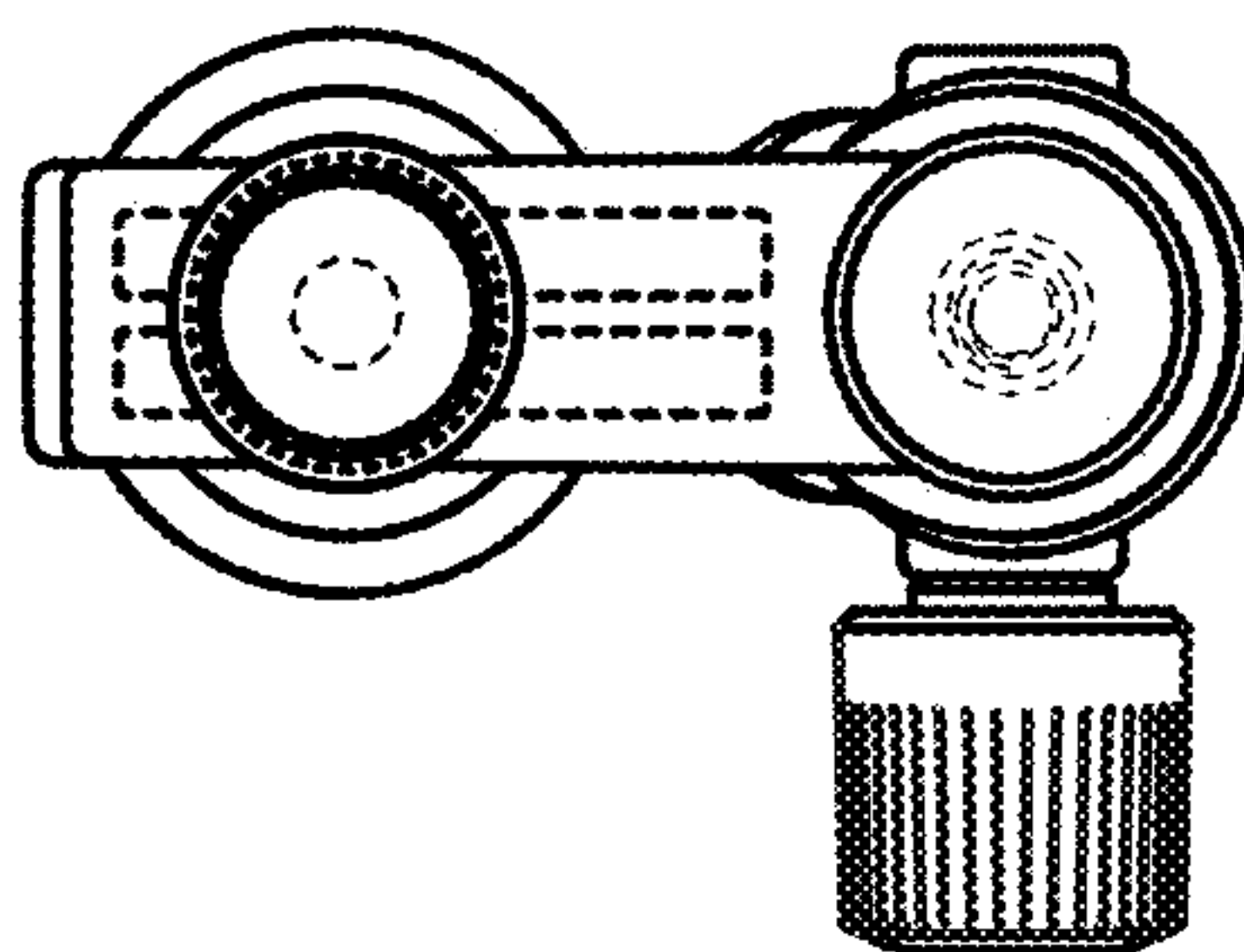

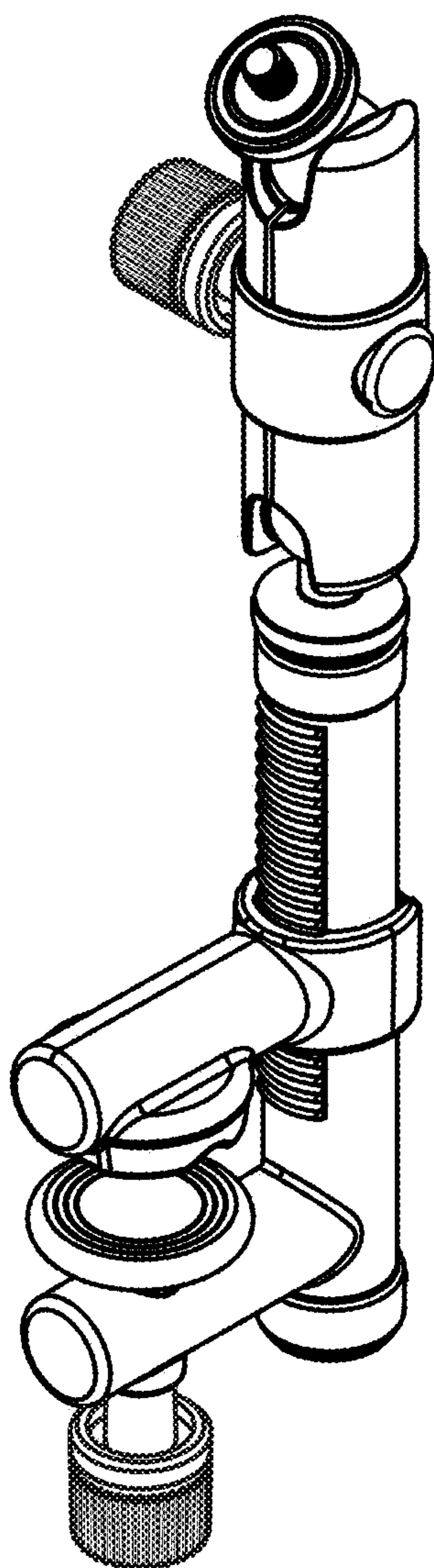
